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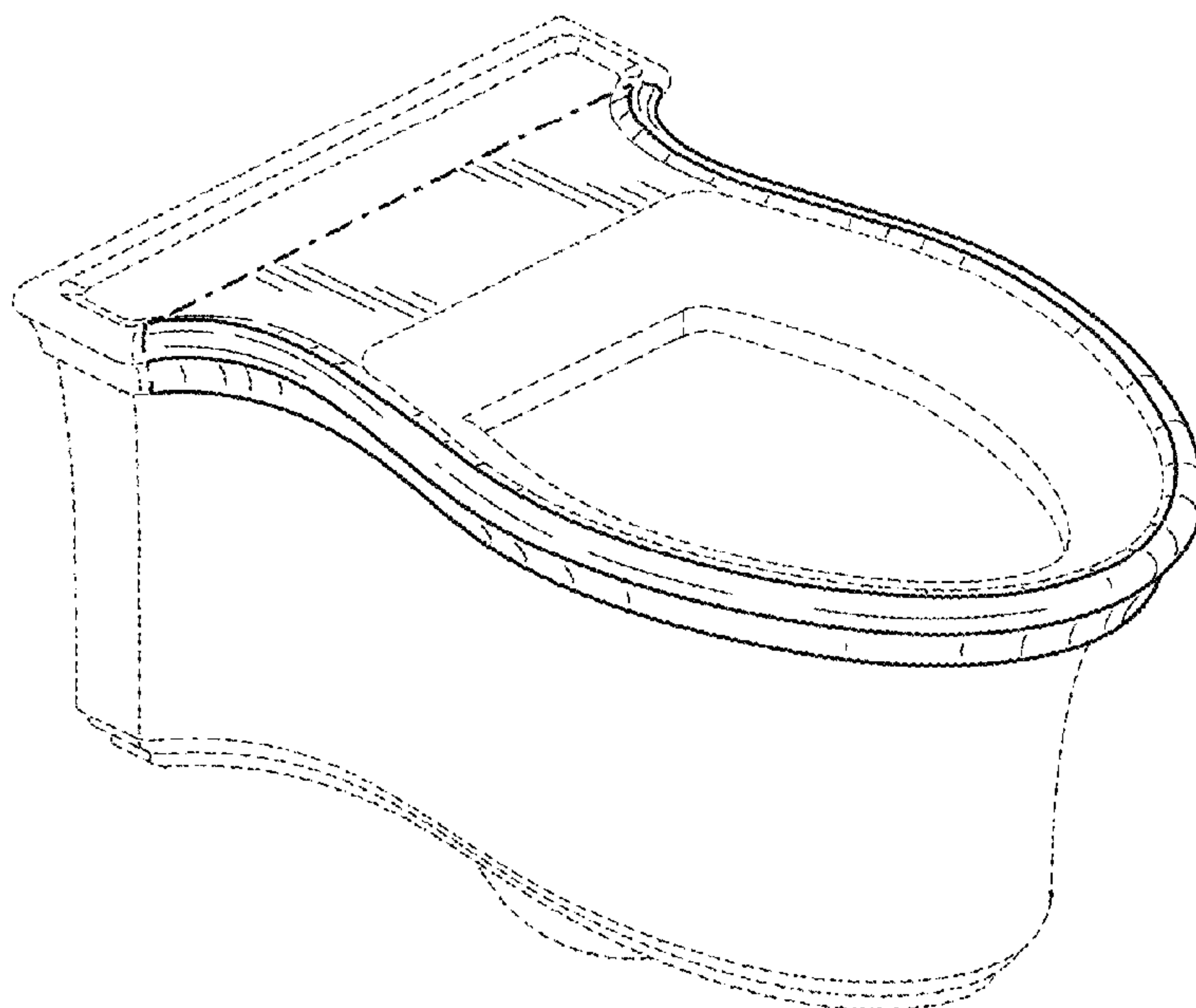
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toilet;
FIG. 2 is a front view of the toilet shown in FIG. 1;

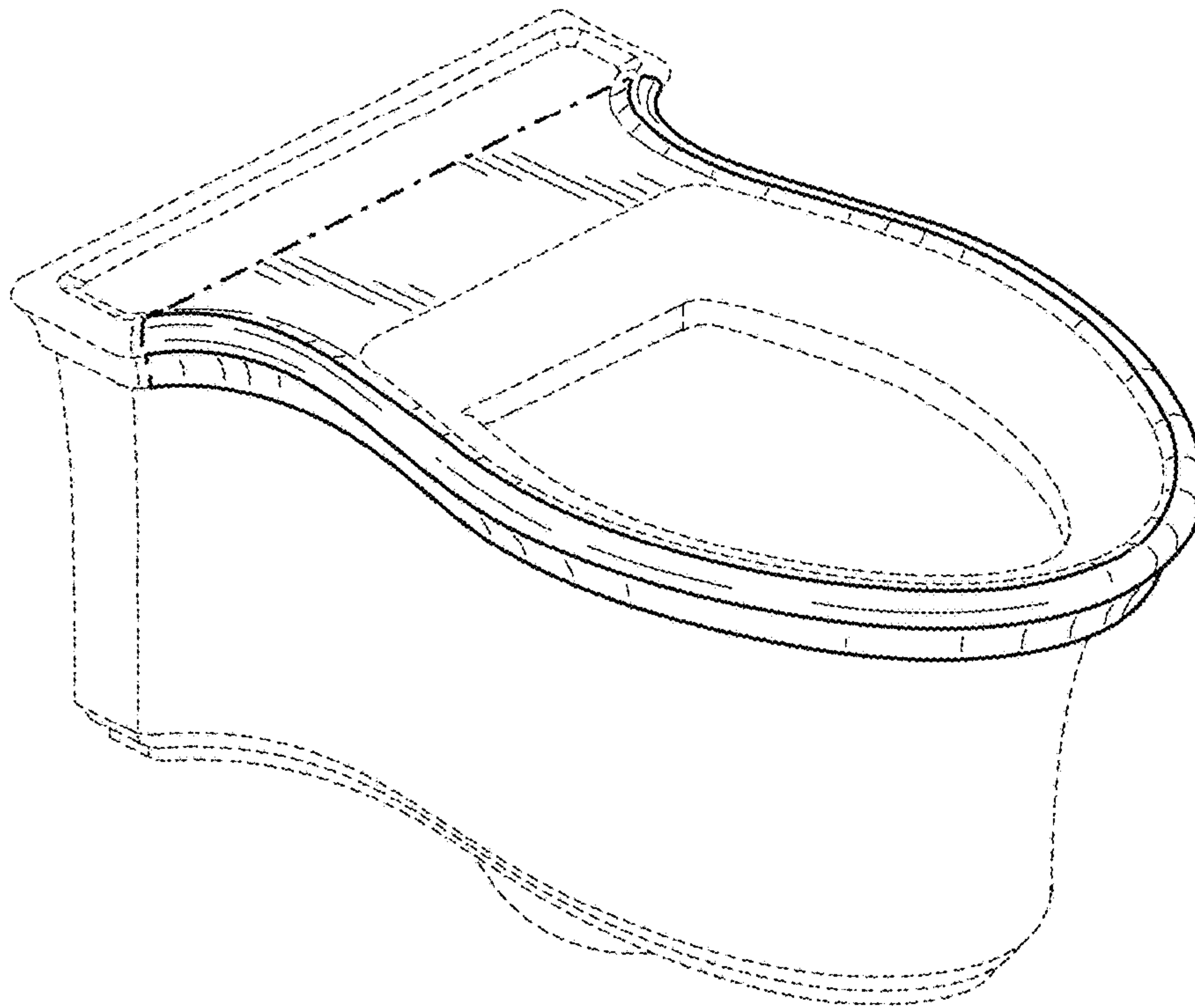

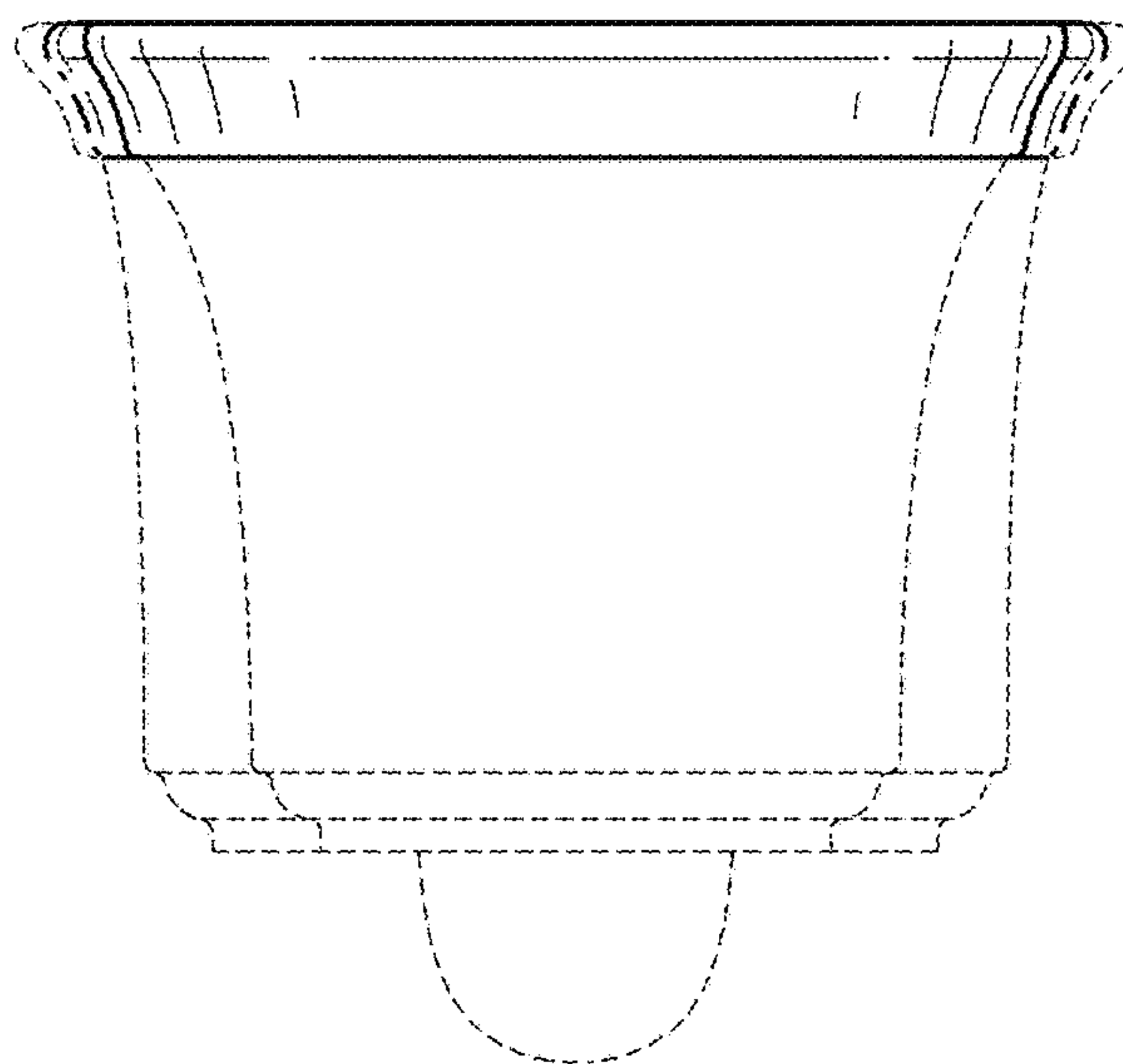

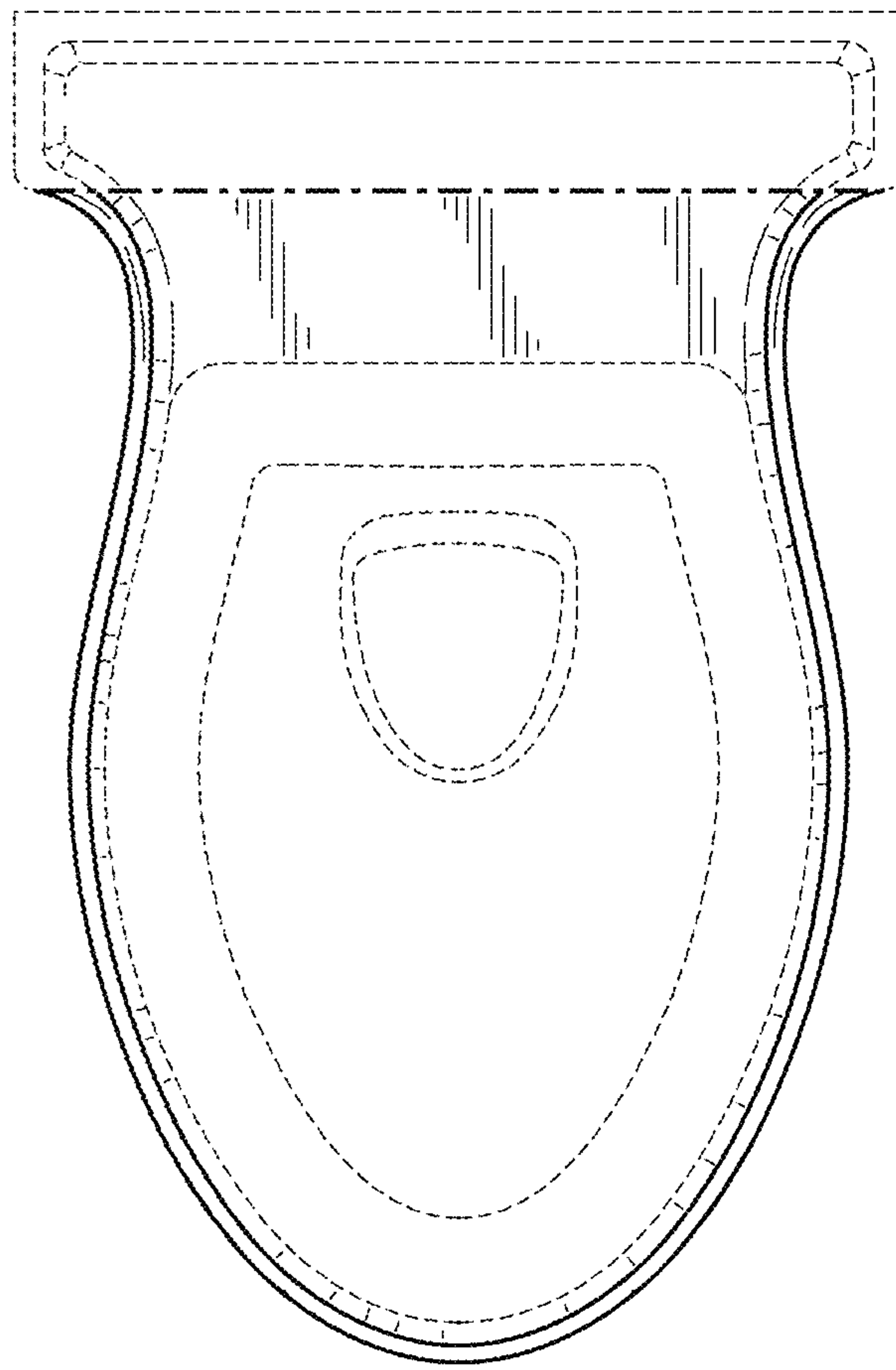

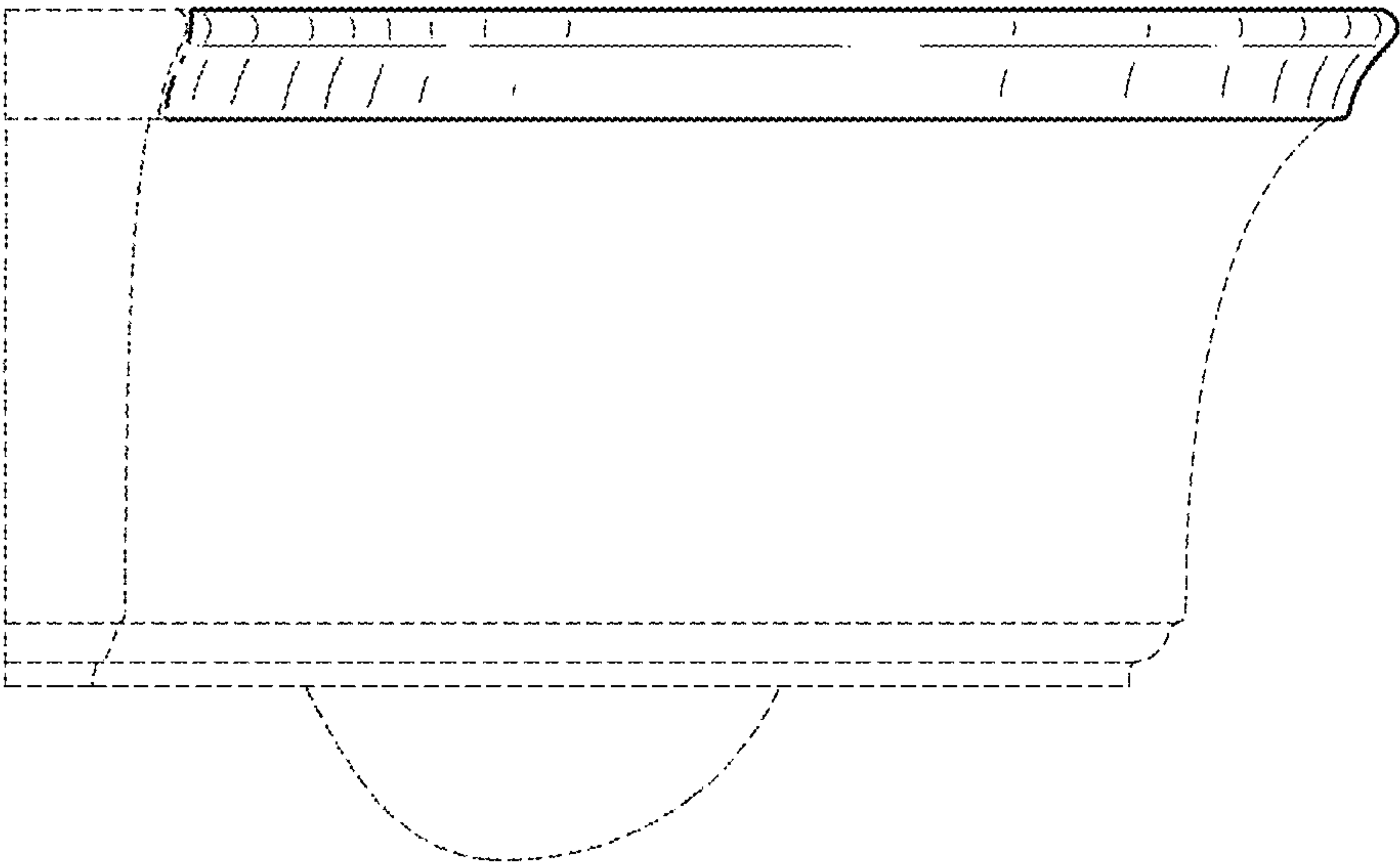

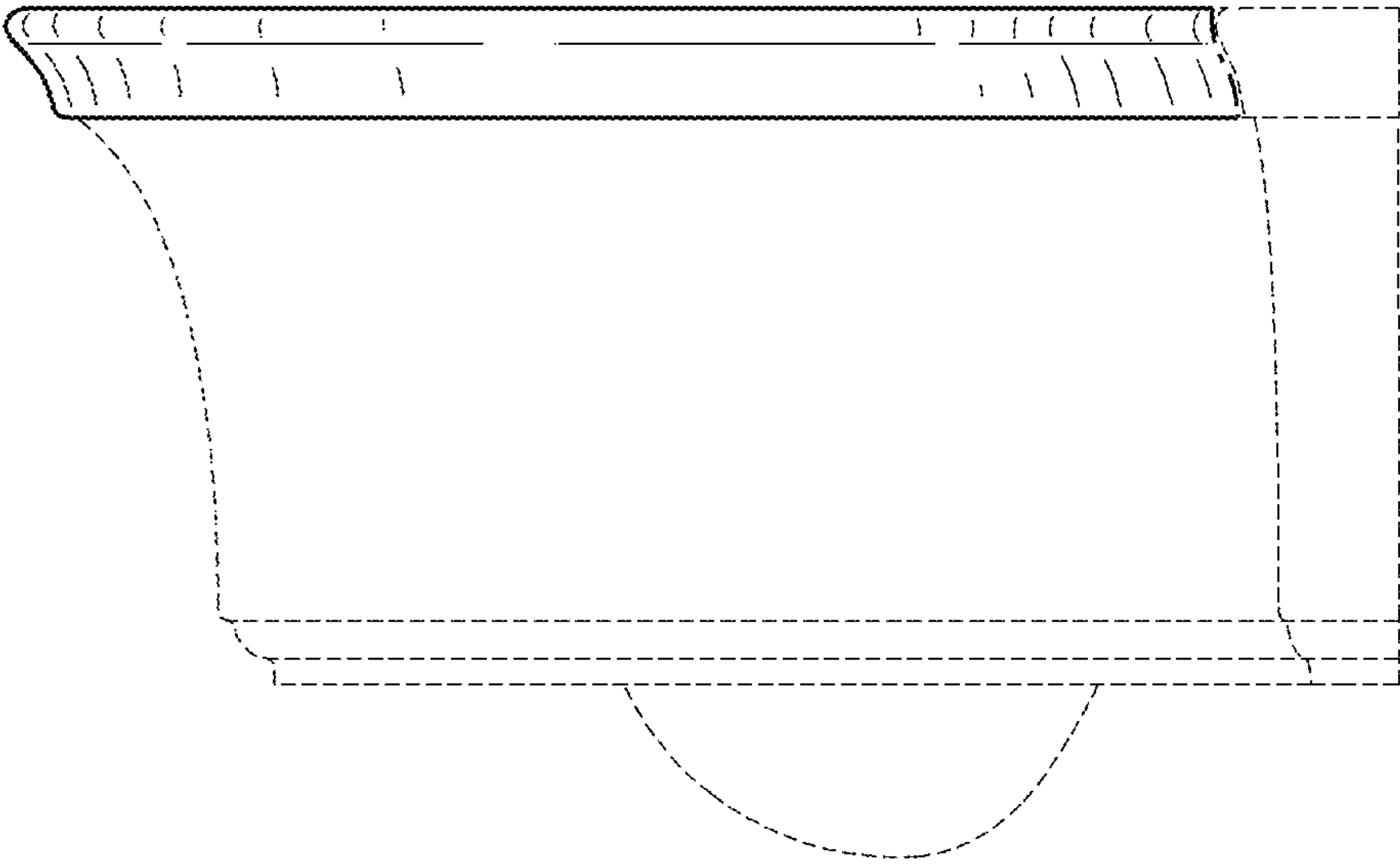
