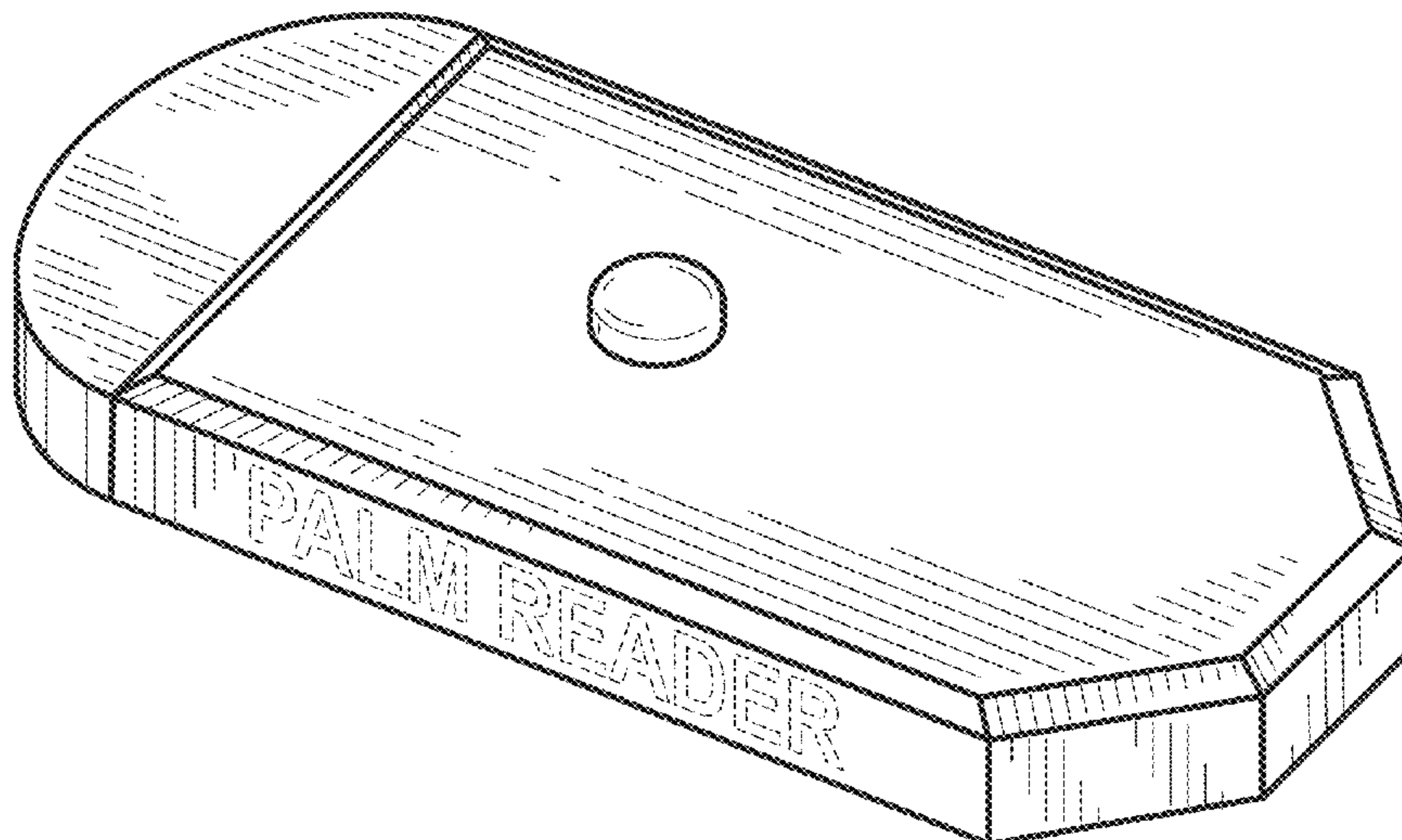
(57) **CLAIM**

I claim the ornamental design for a blood sampling device,
as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a blood sampling device
according to the invention;
FIG. 2 is another perspective view of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a left side view of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is an inverted right side view of the device of FIG.
1;
FIG. 5 is a front elevation of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the device of FIG. 1;
FIG. 7 is a rear elevation of the device of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the device of FIG. 1.
The broken lines shown in FIGS. 1-4 illustrate portions of
the blood sampling device that form no part of the claimed
design.

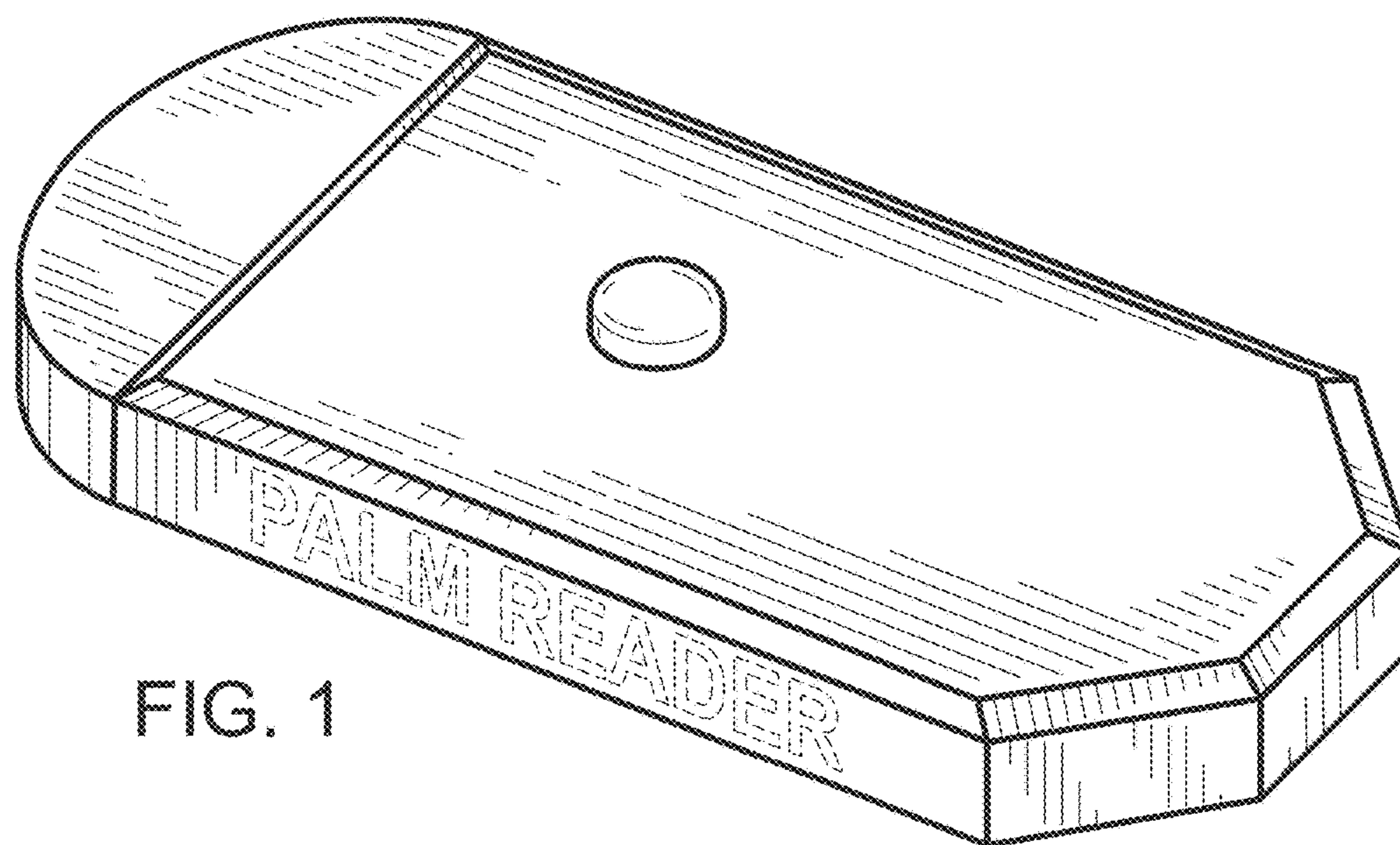

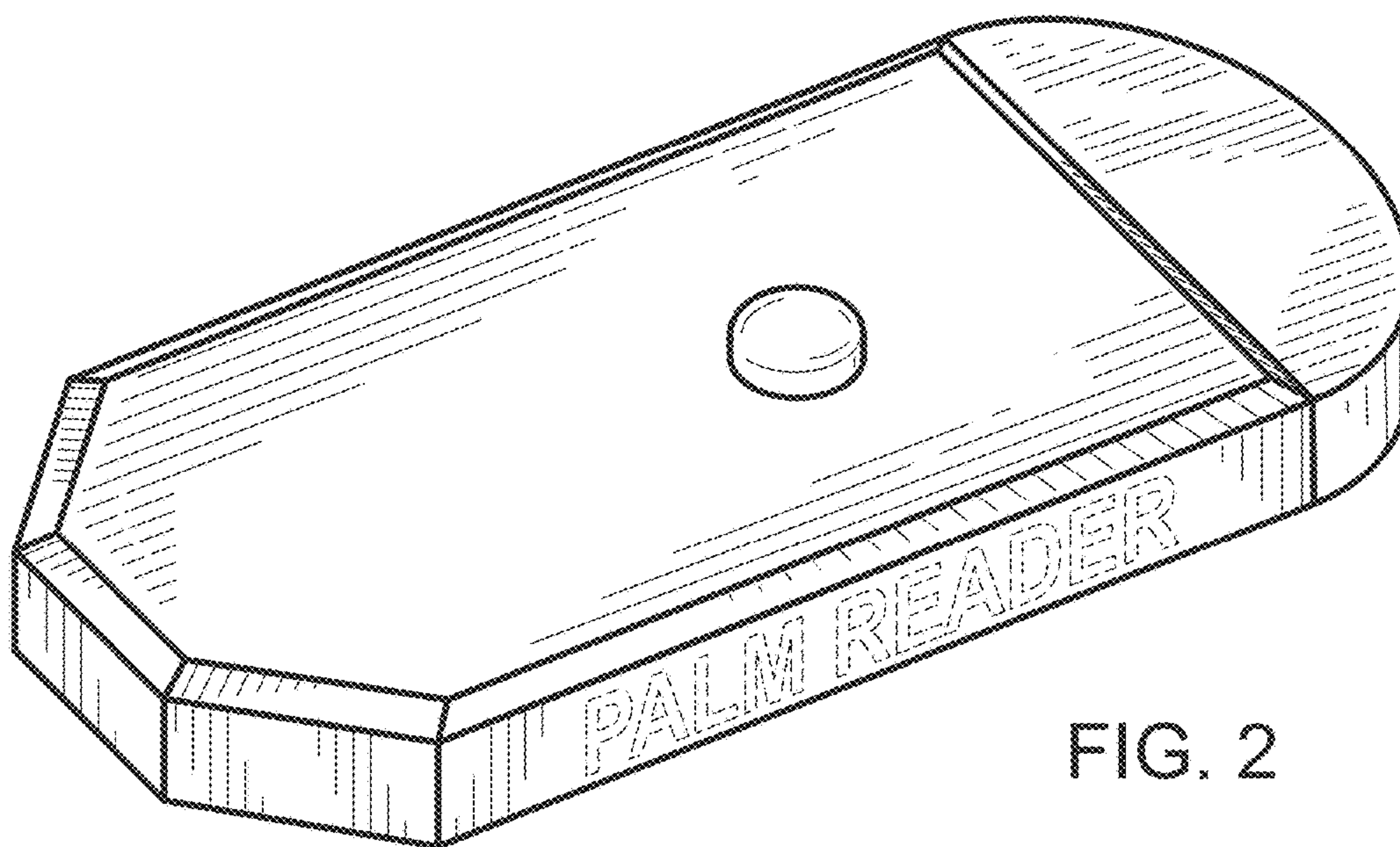

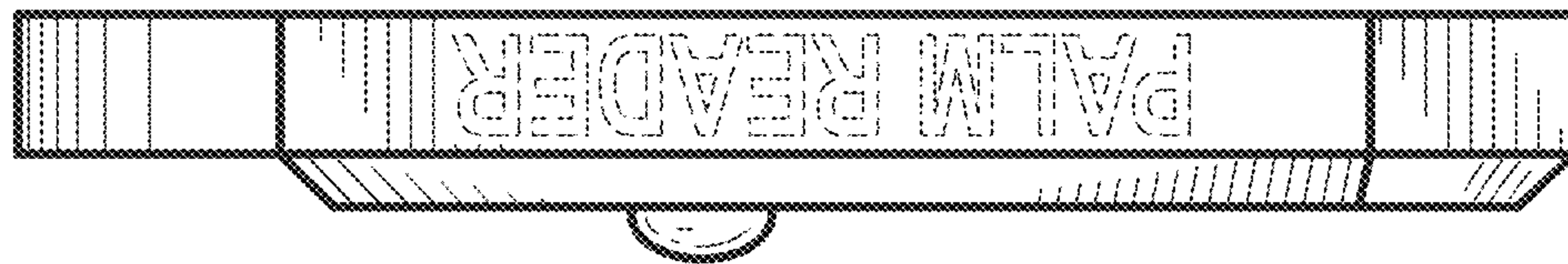

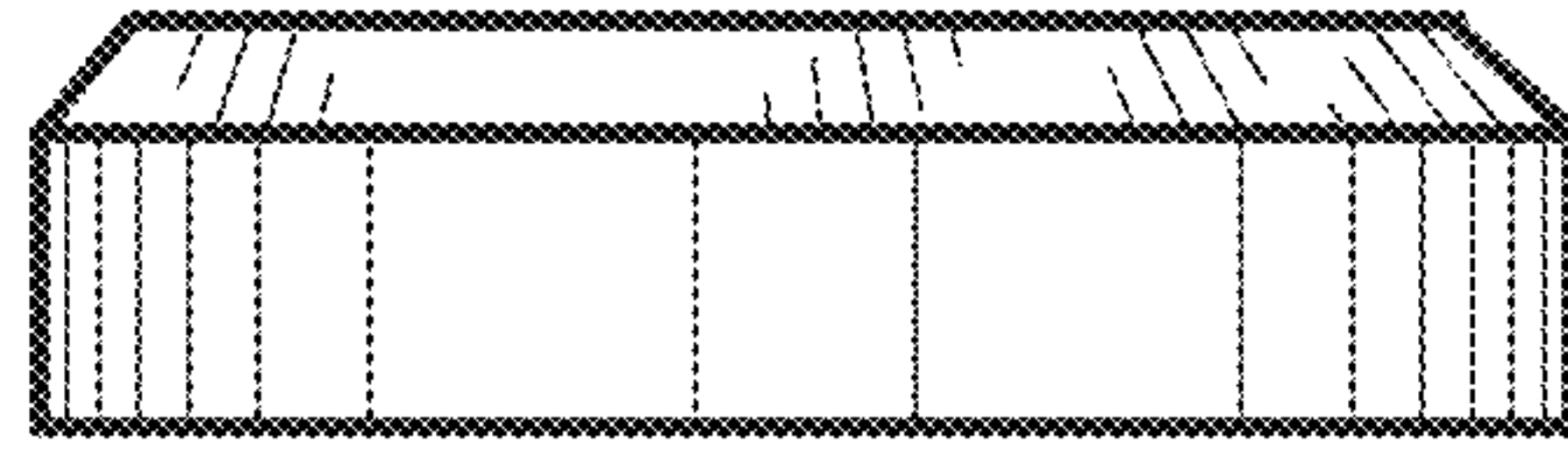

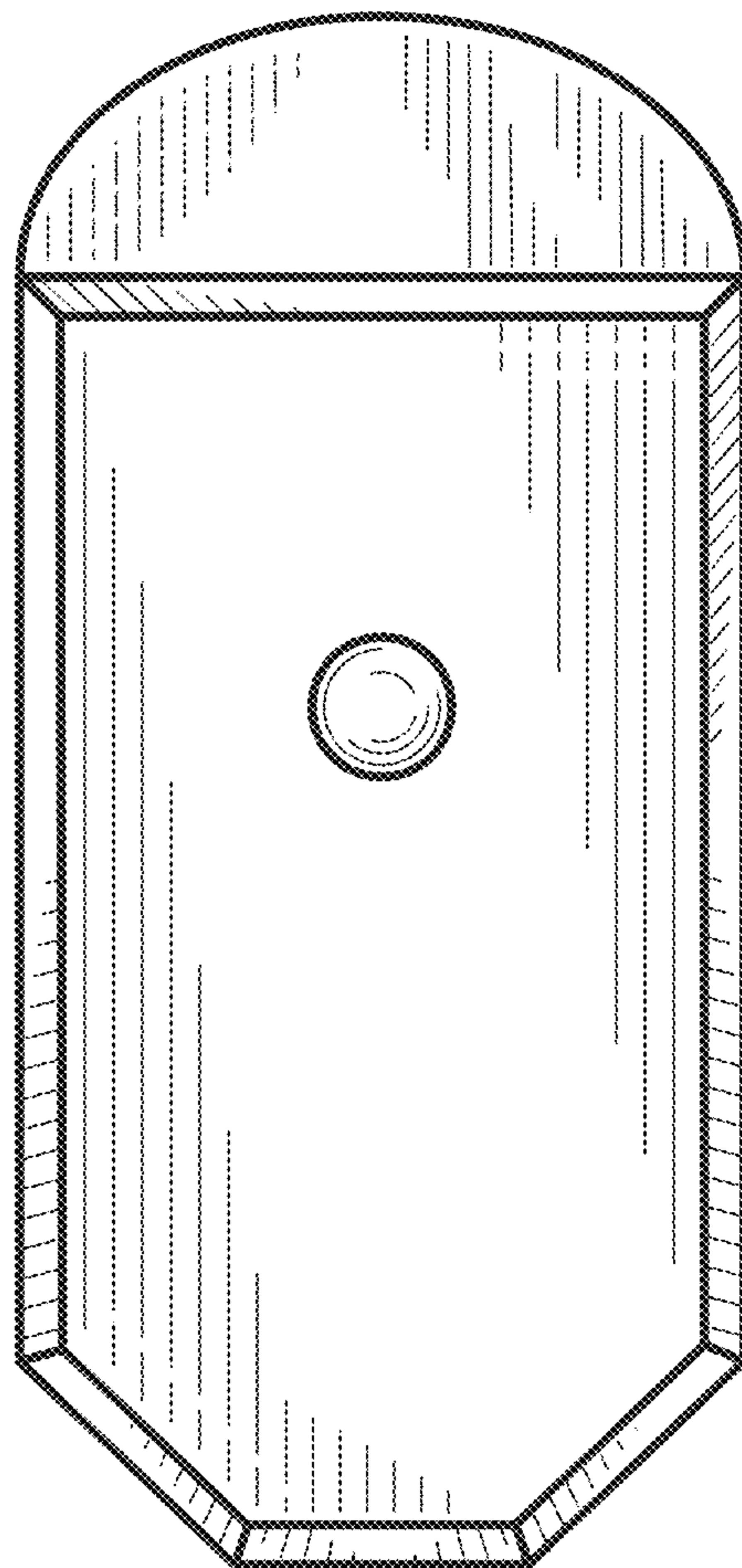

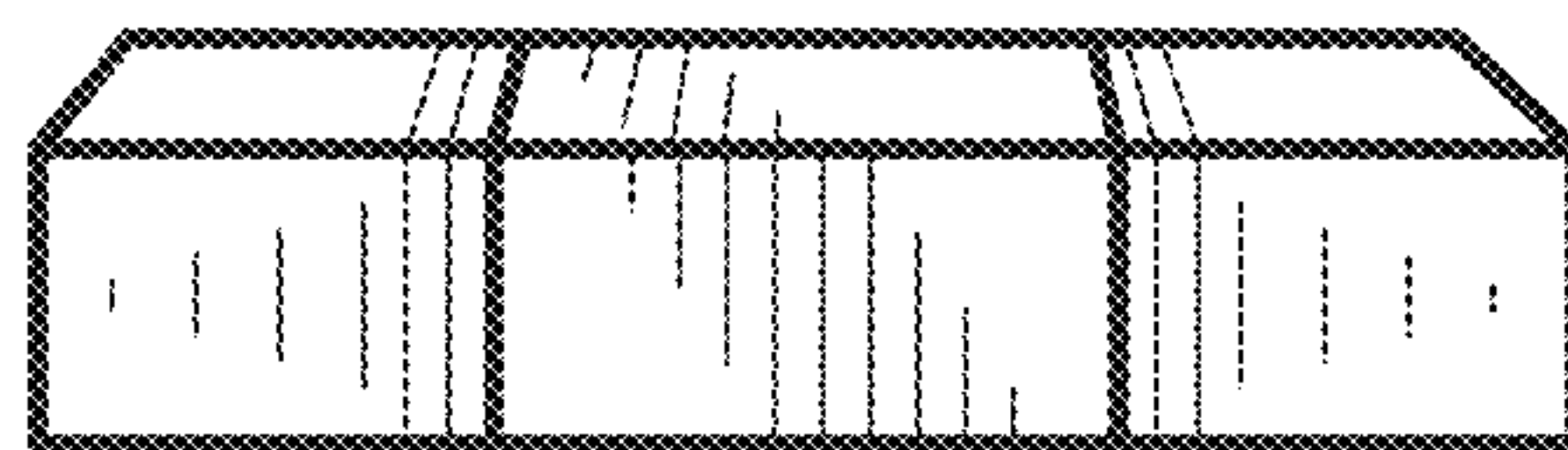

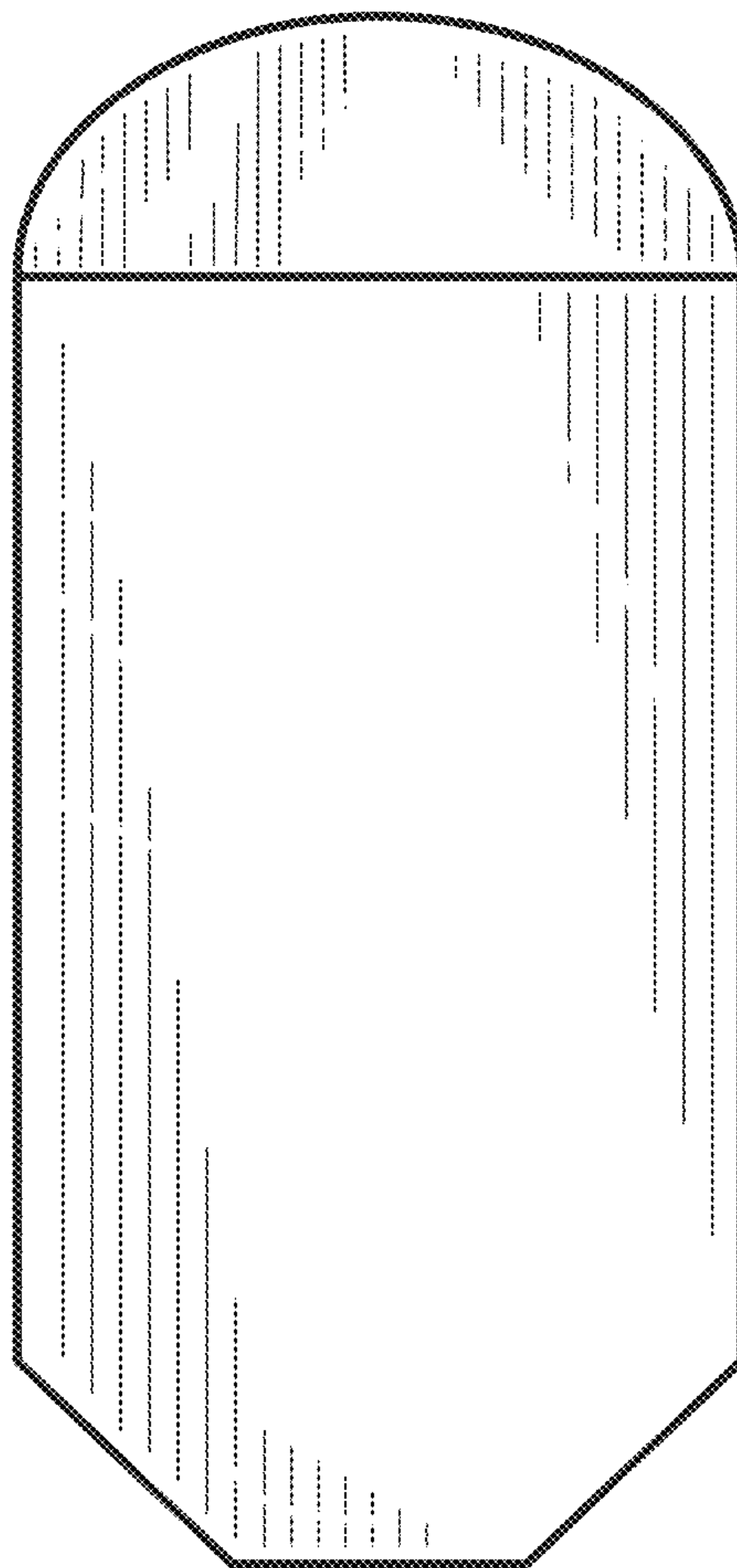
