FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.

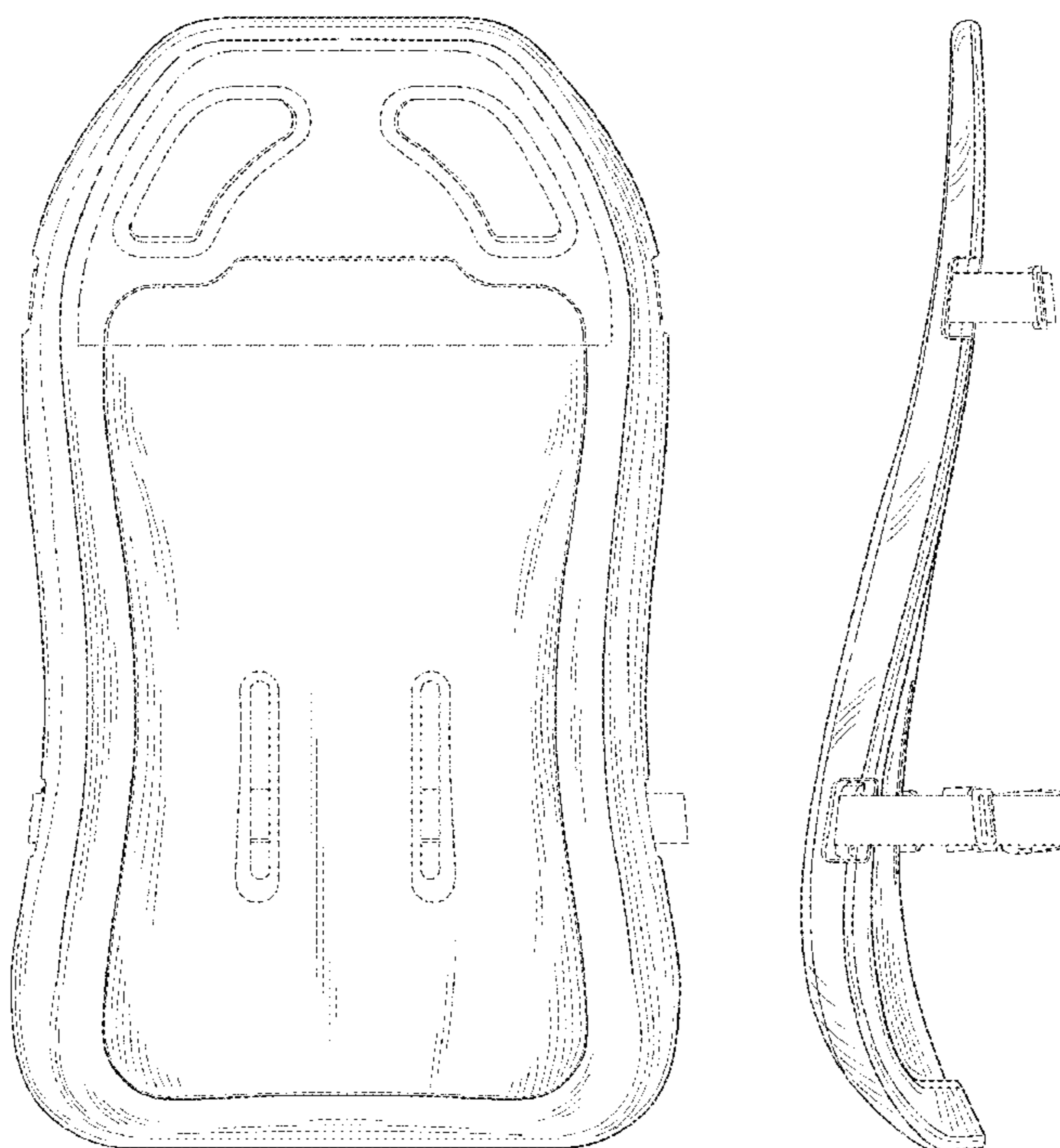
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 1.

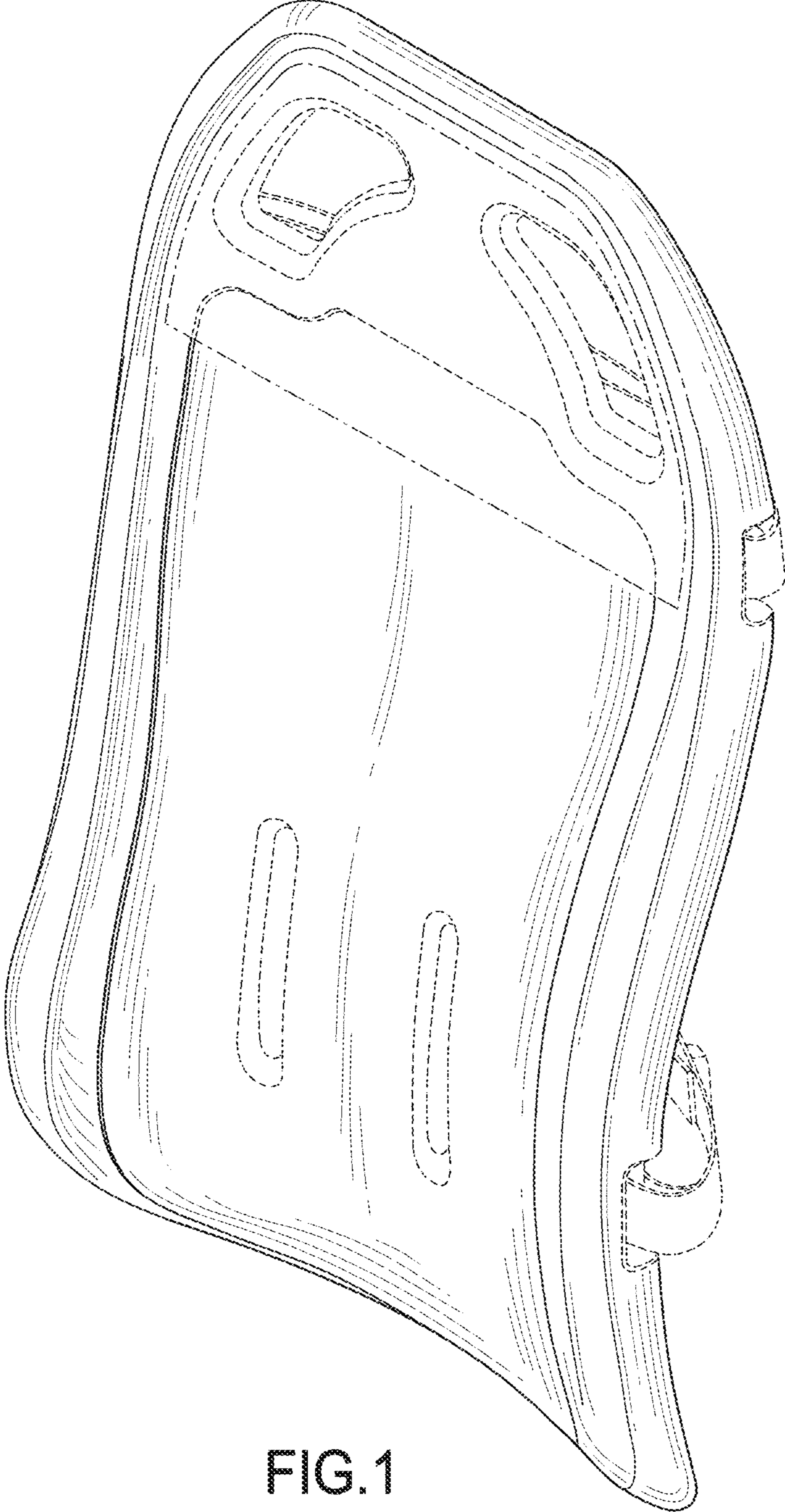

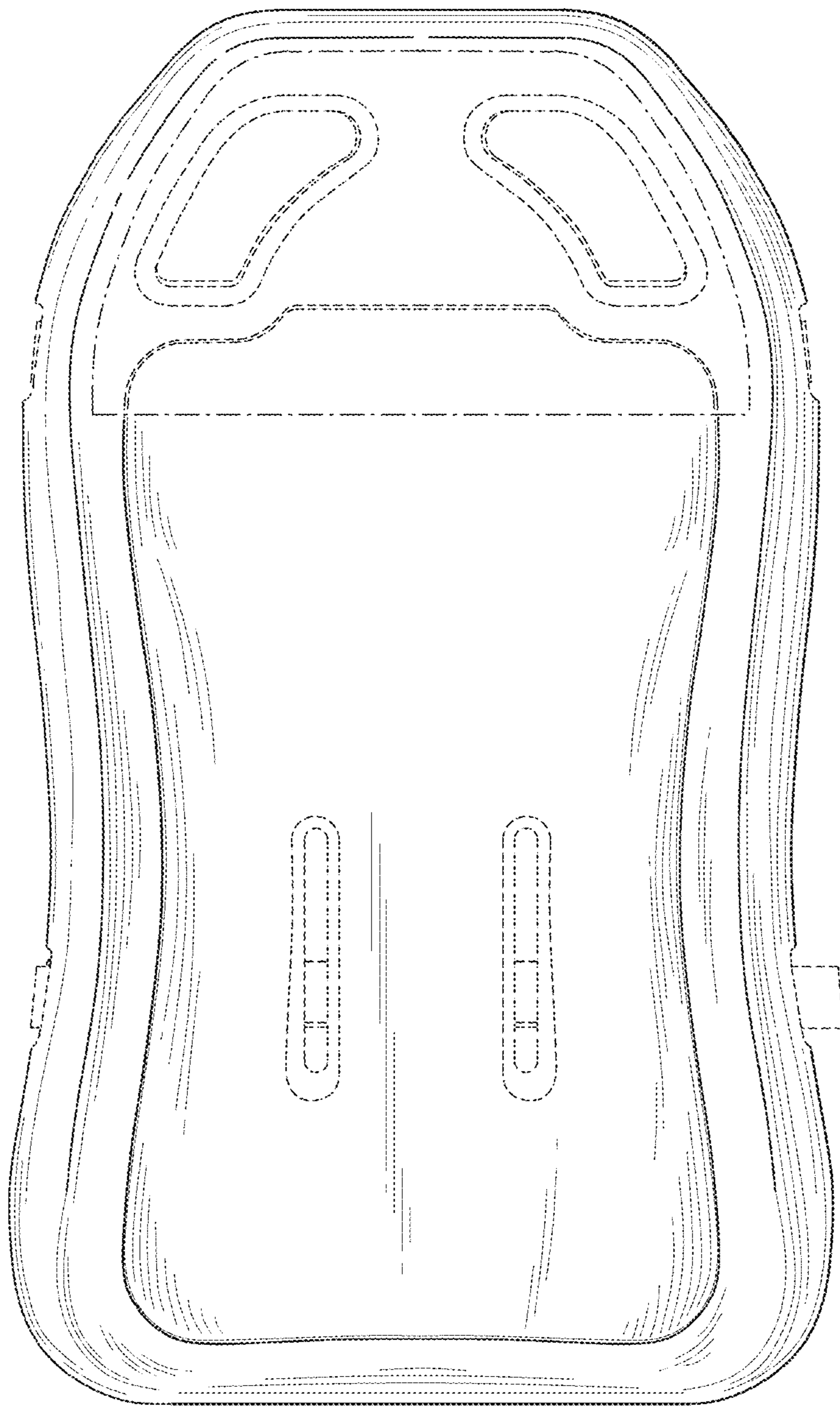

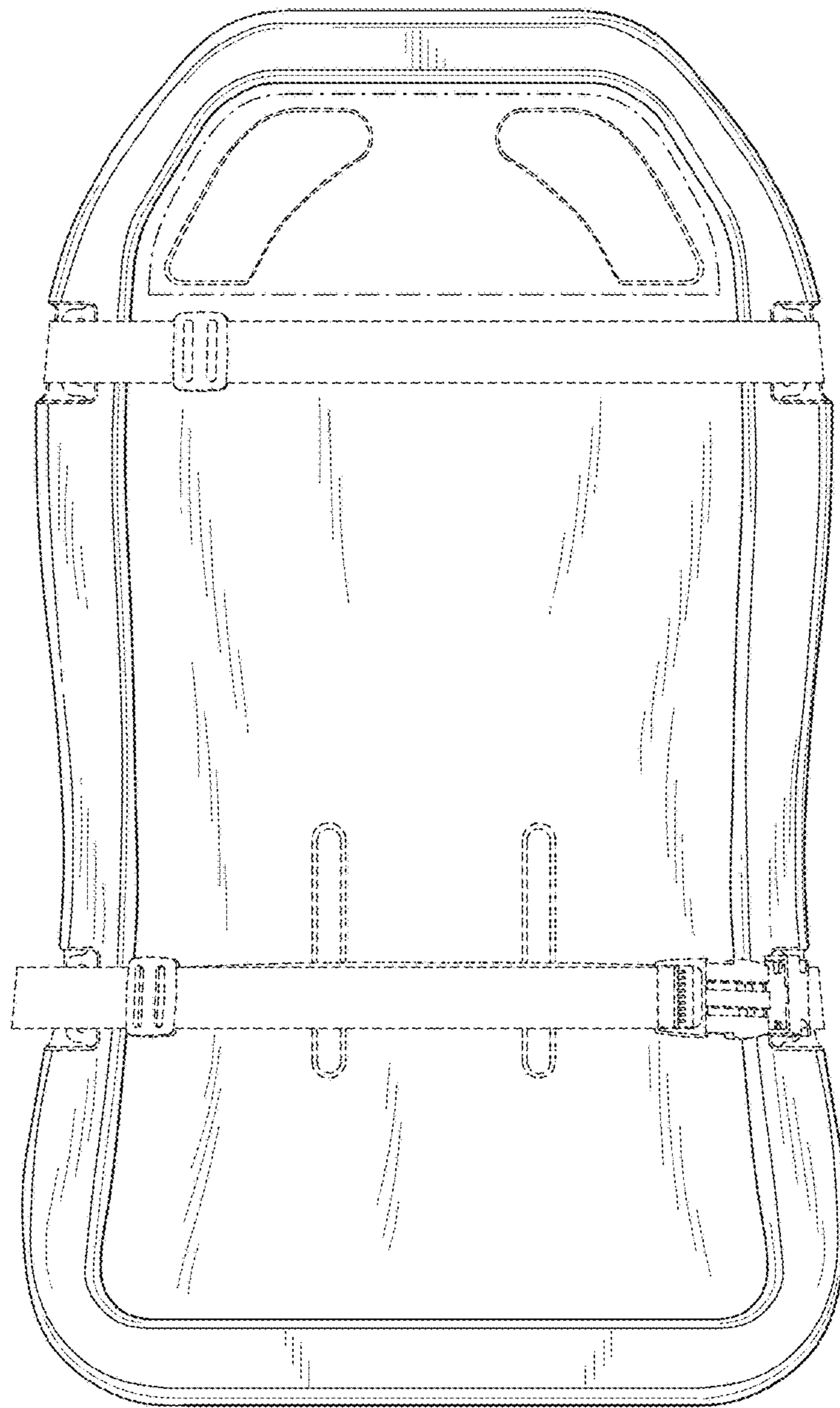

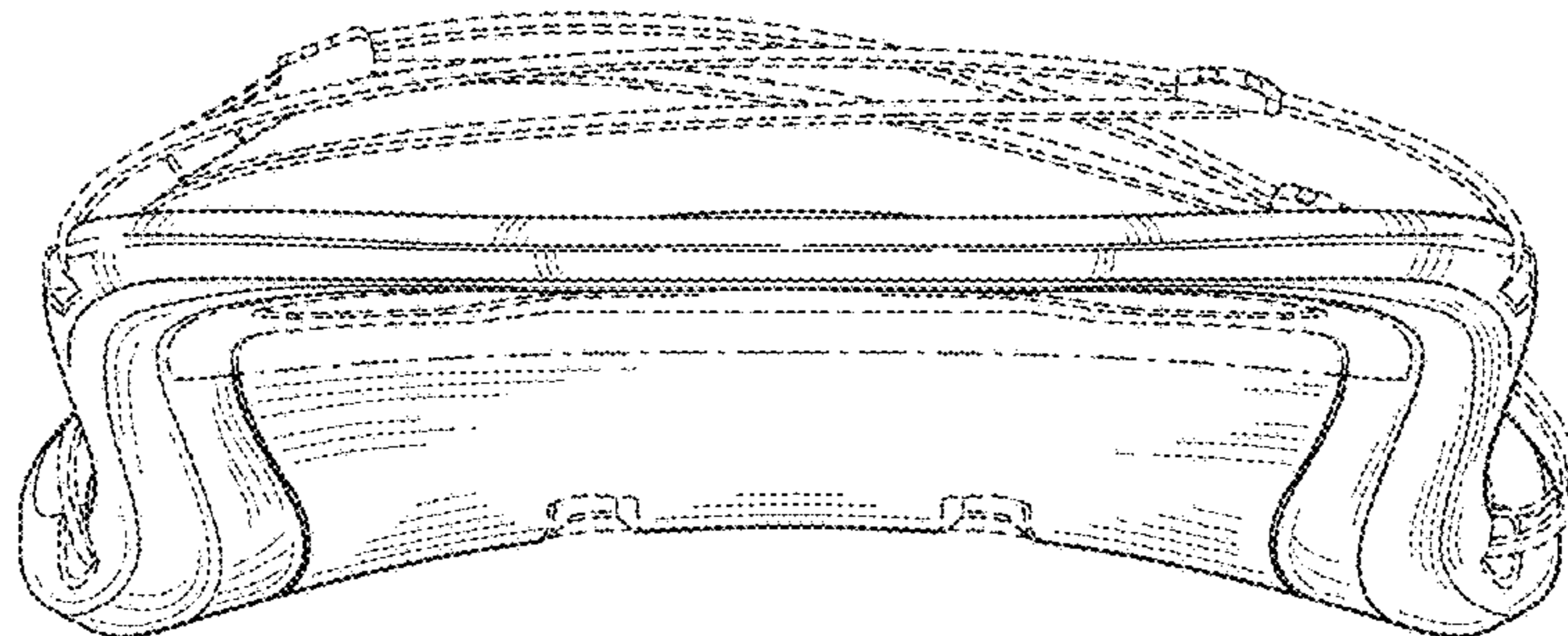

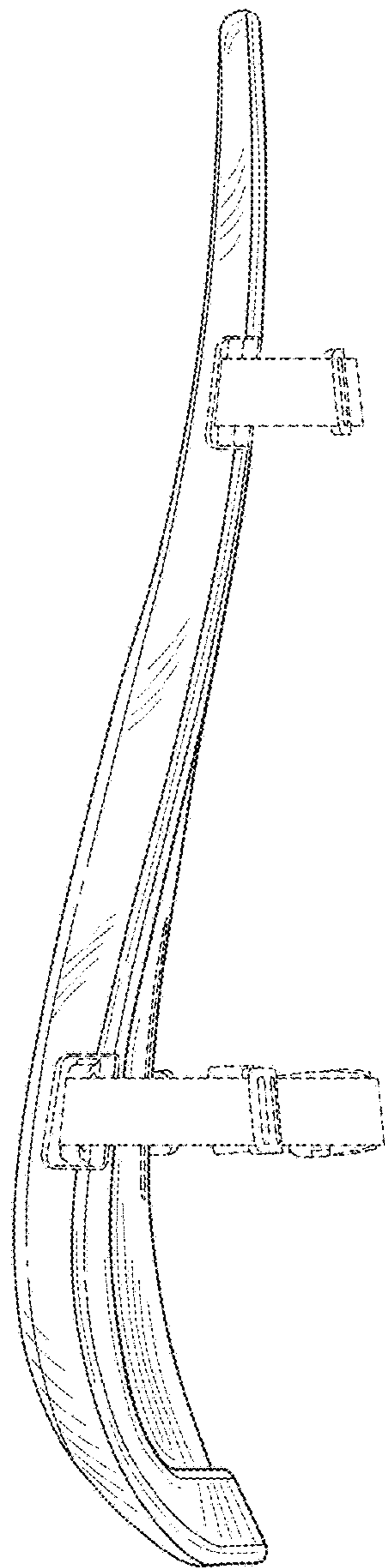
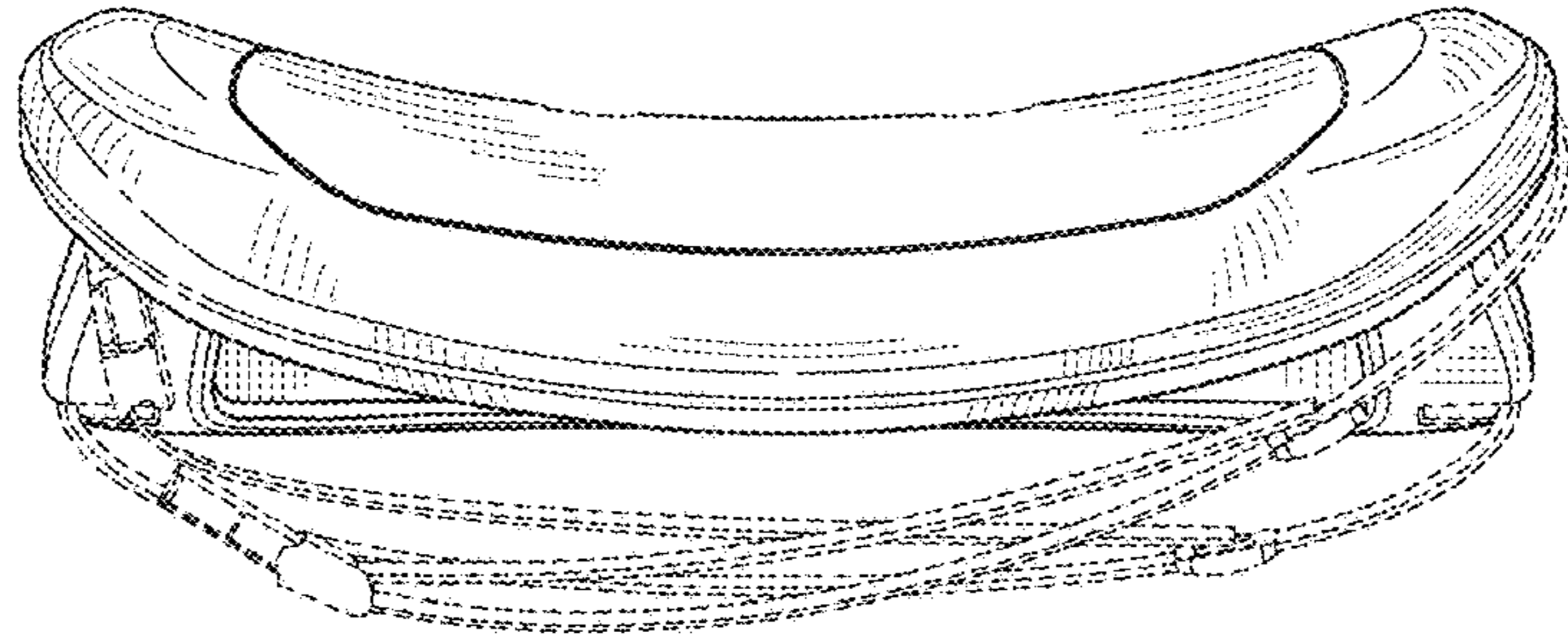

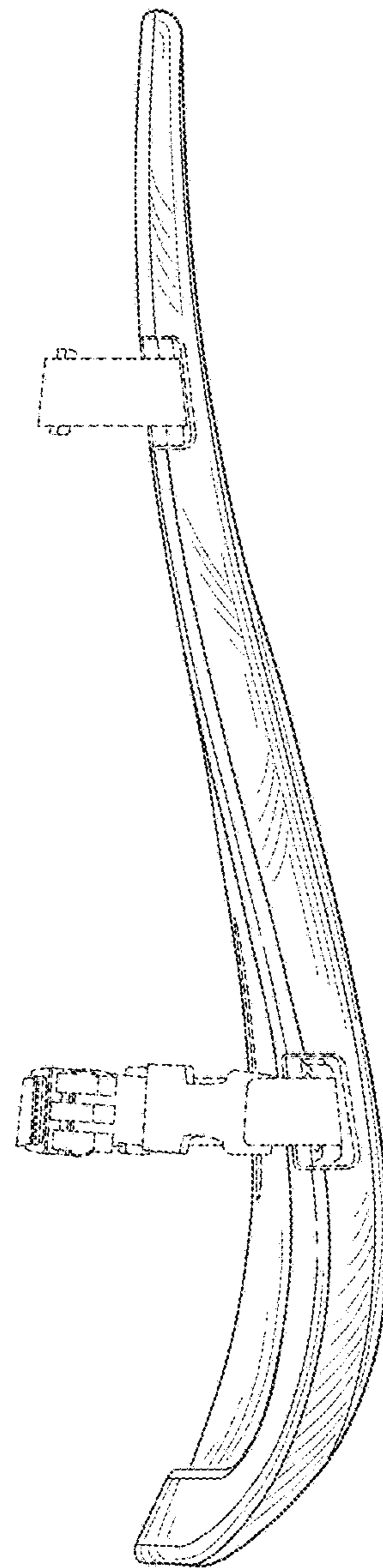
