FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the tow hook step combination, in accordance with the present invention;

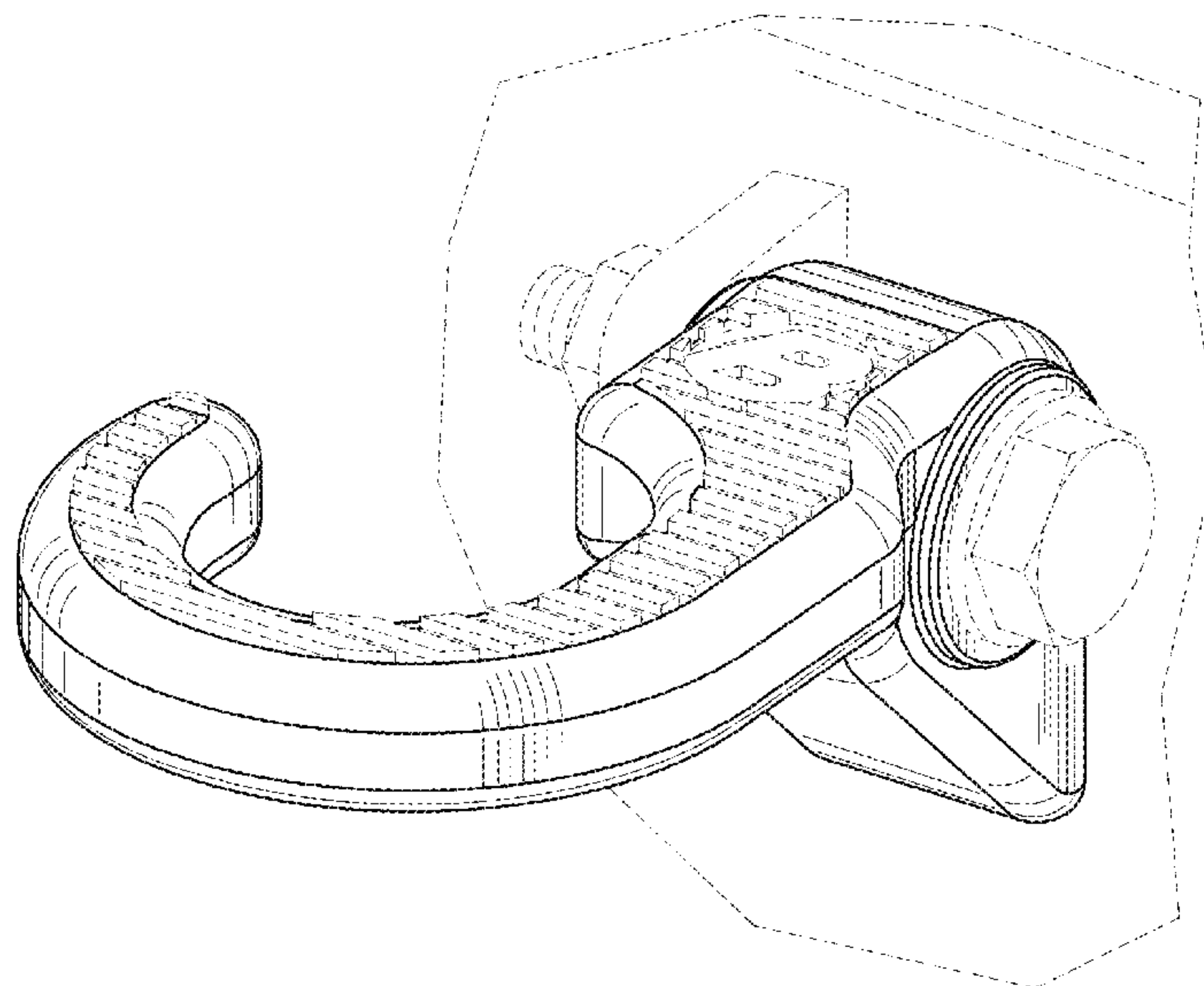
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the tow hook step combination, in accordance with the present invention

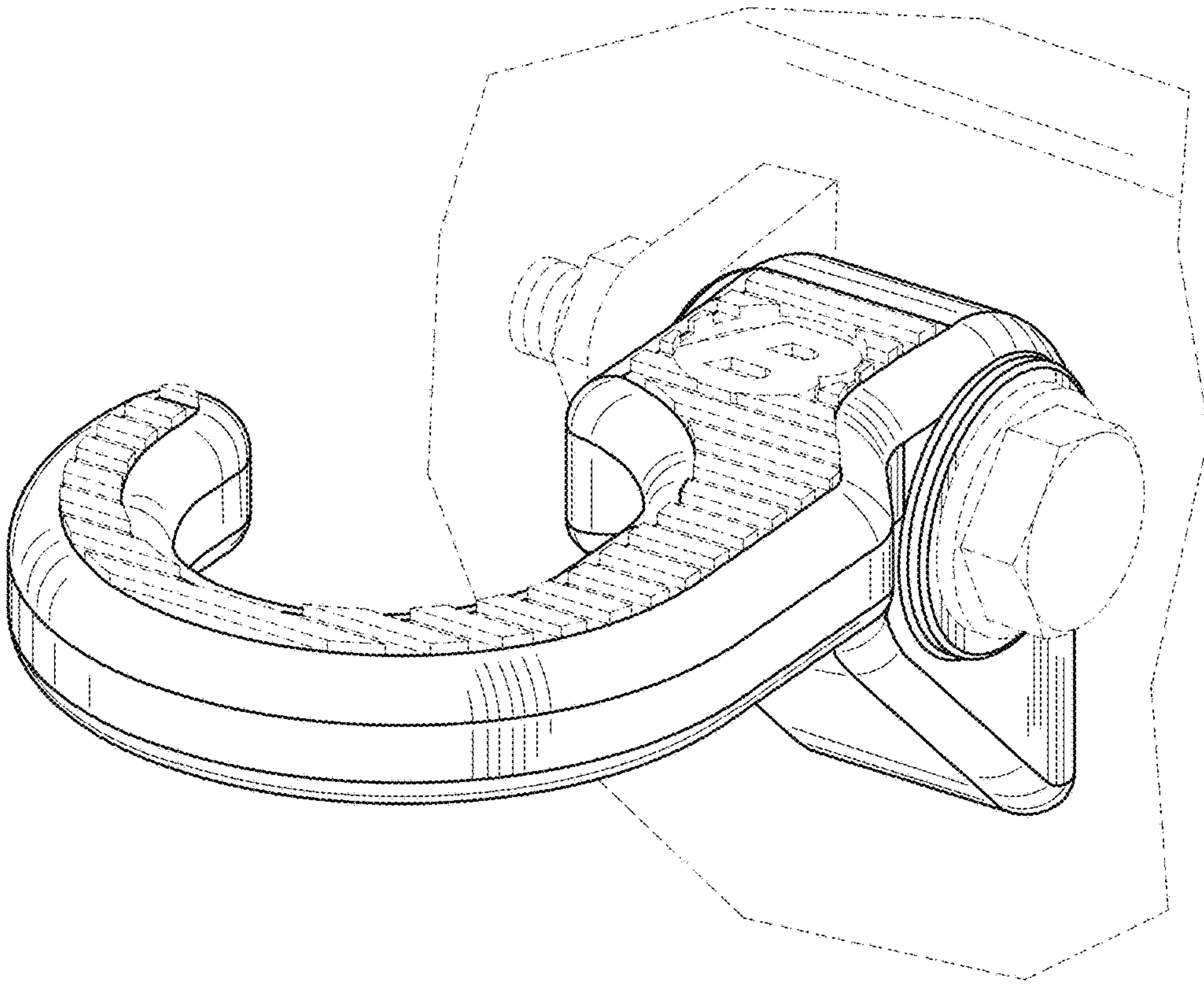

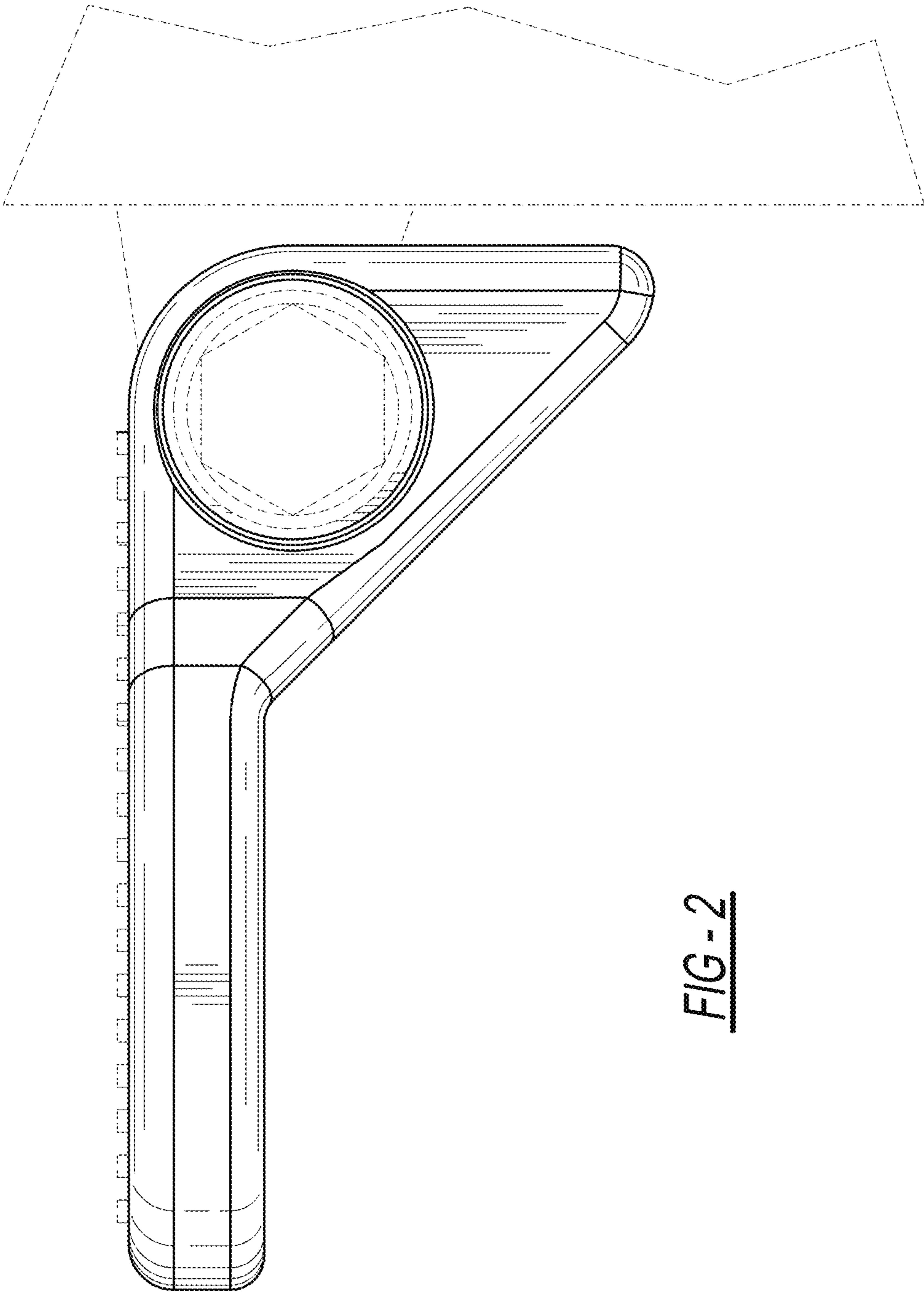

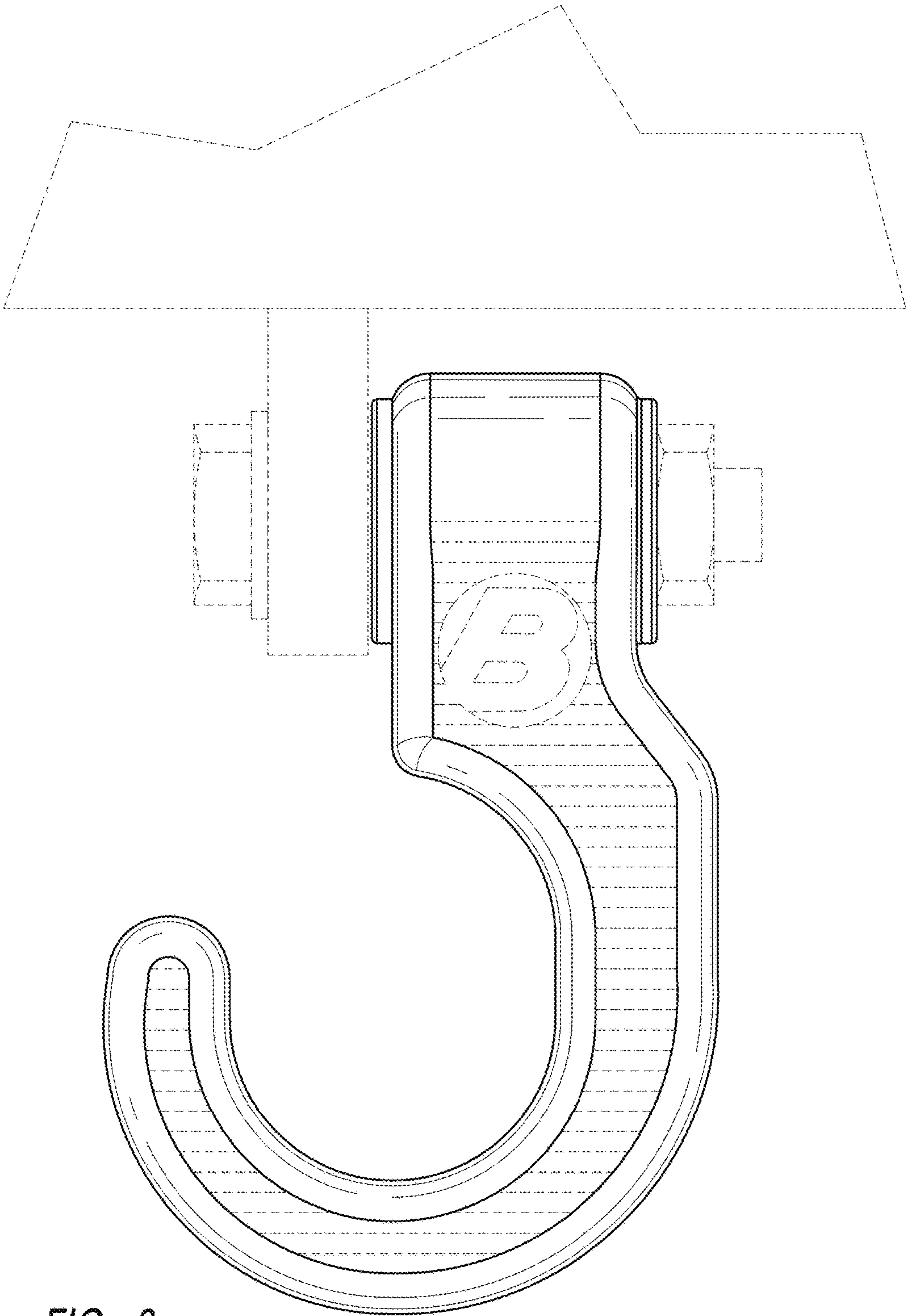

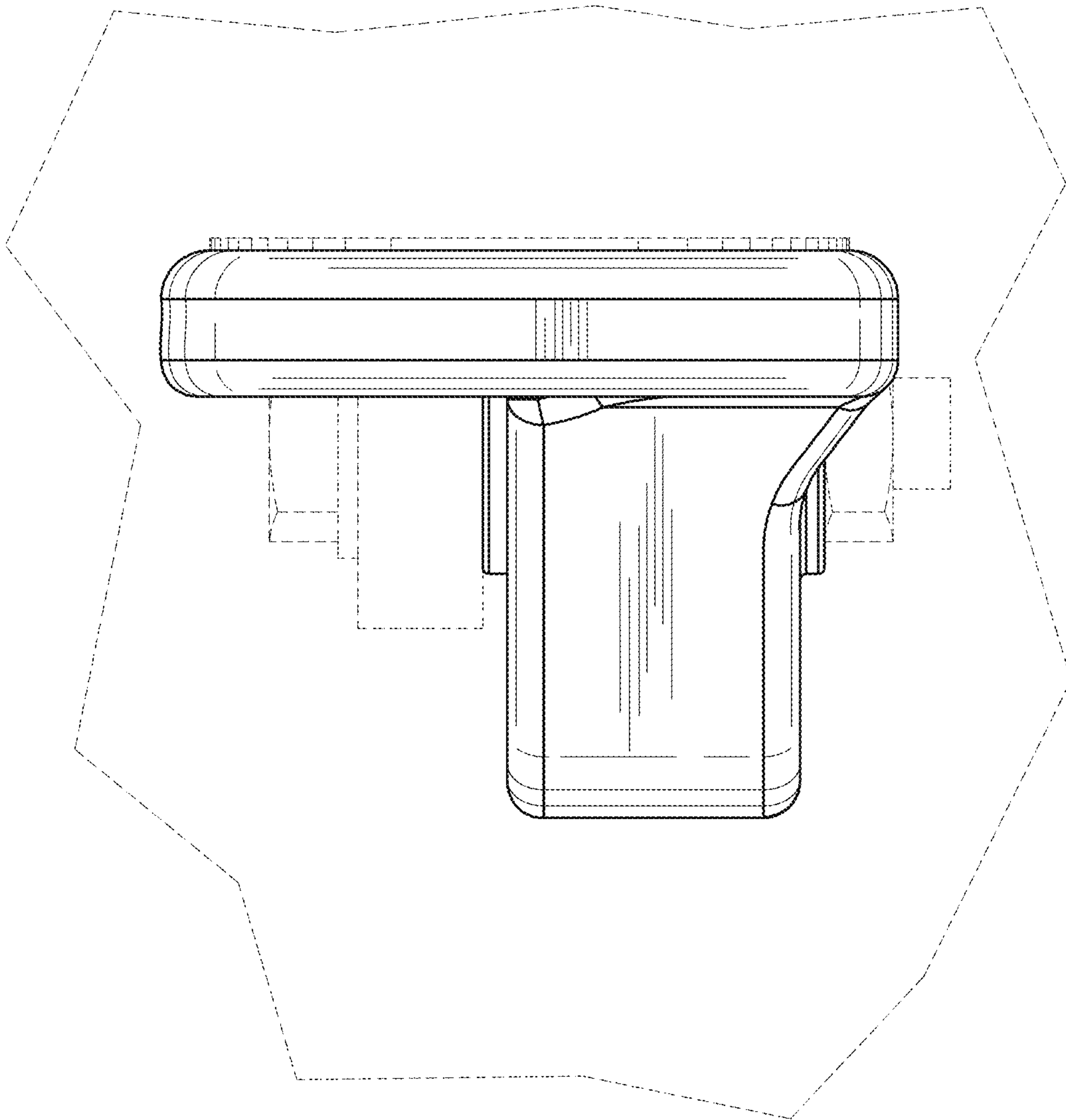

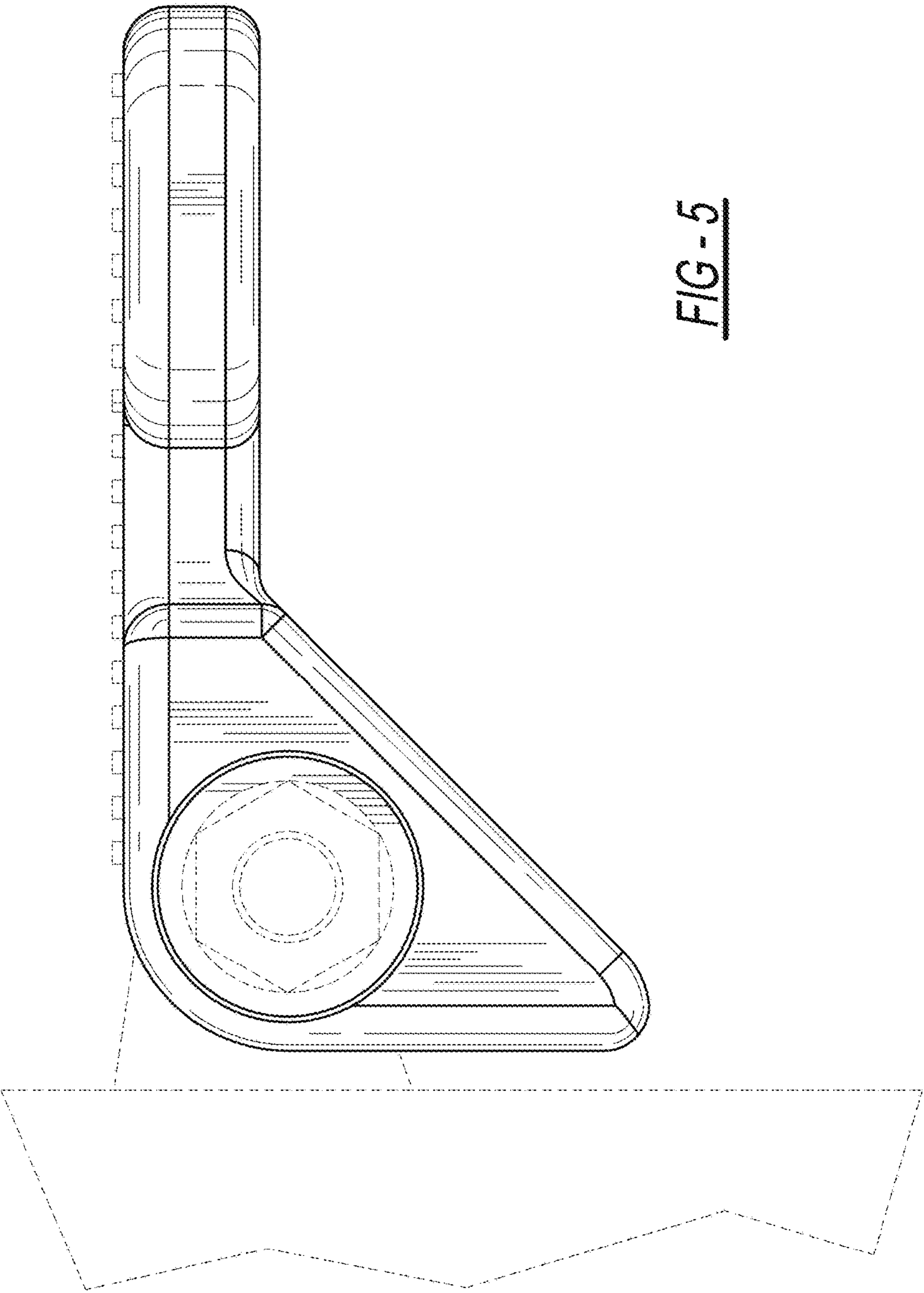

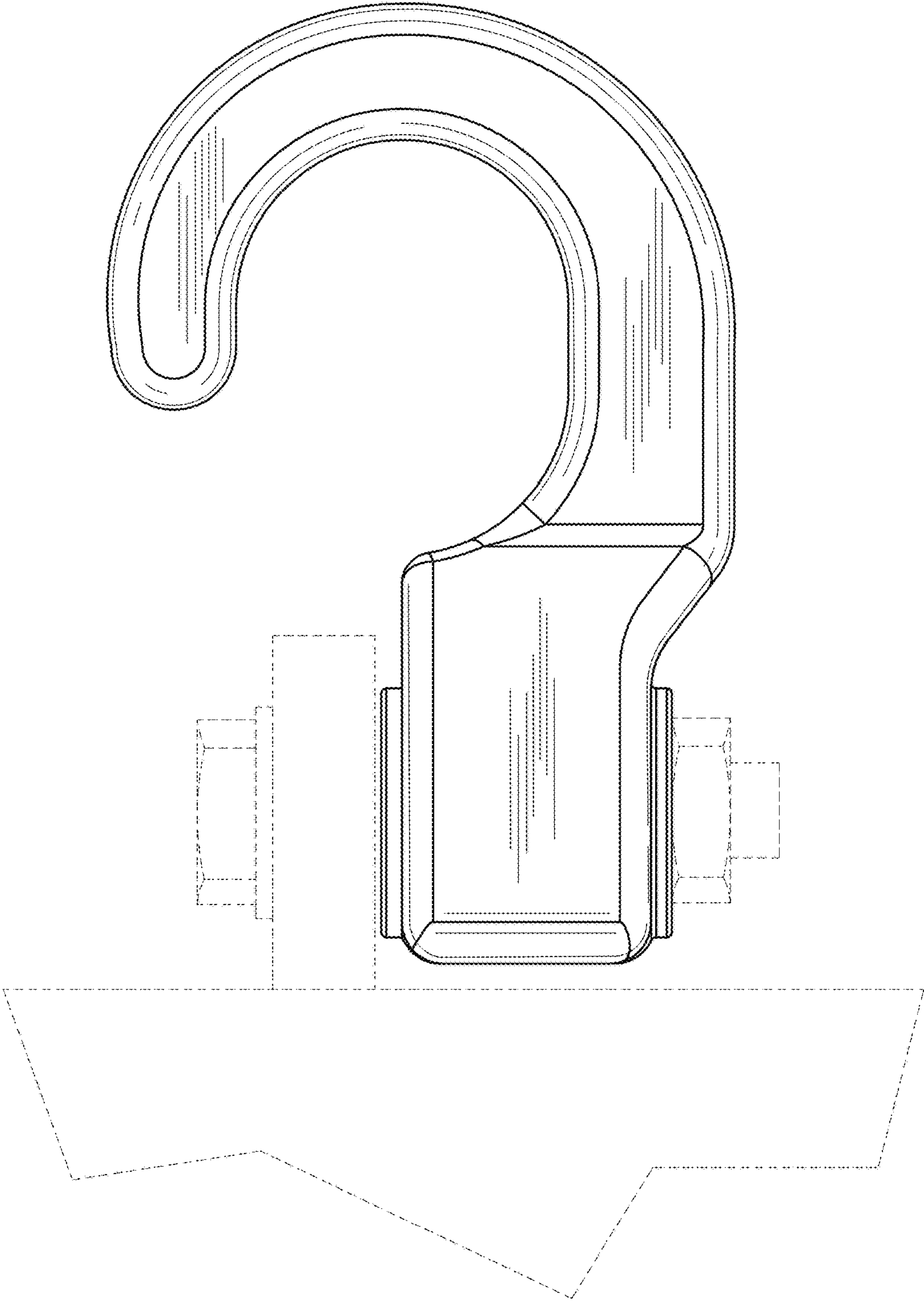
