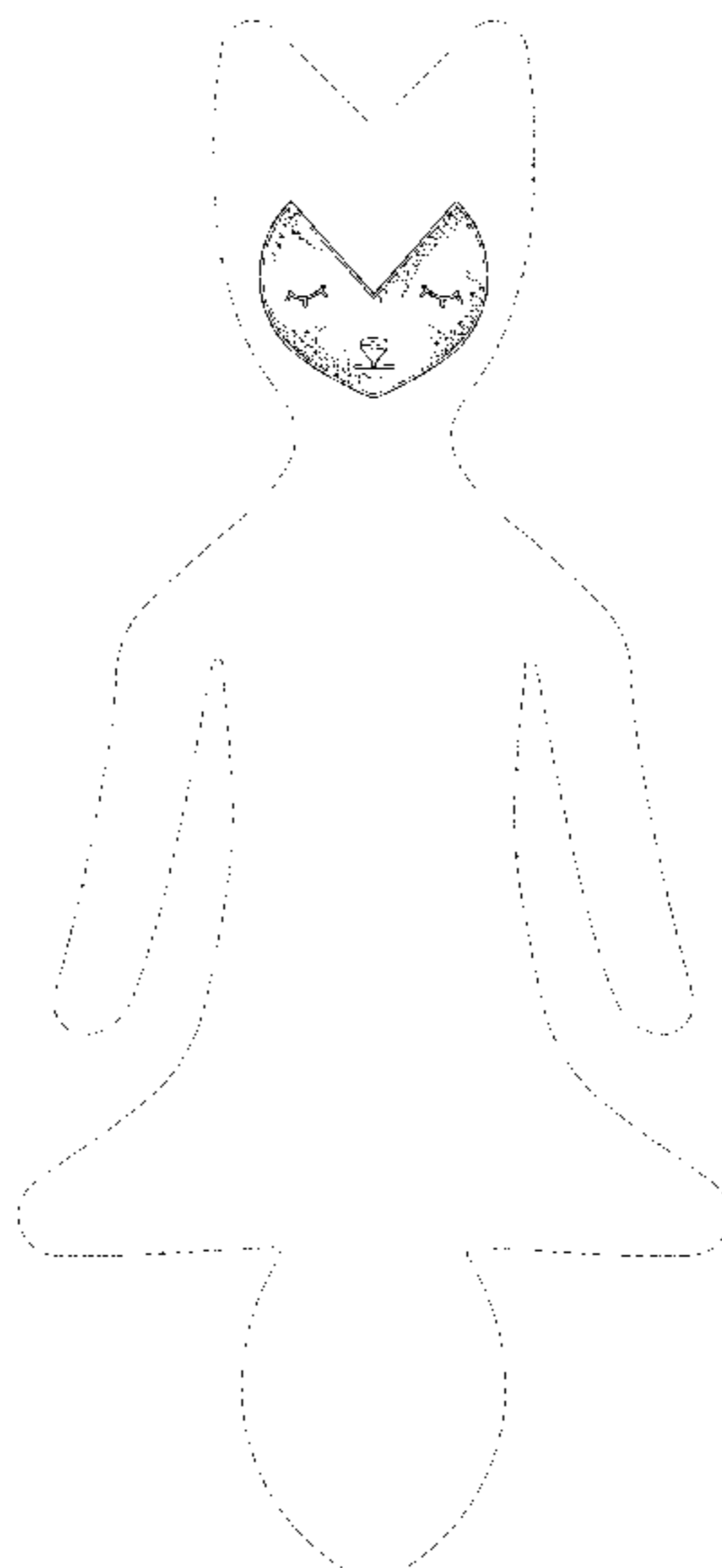
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a plush toy, as shown and described.

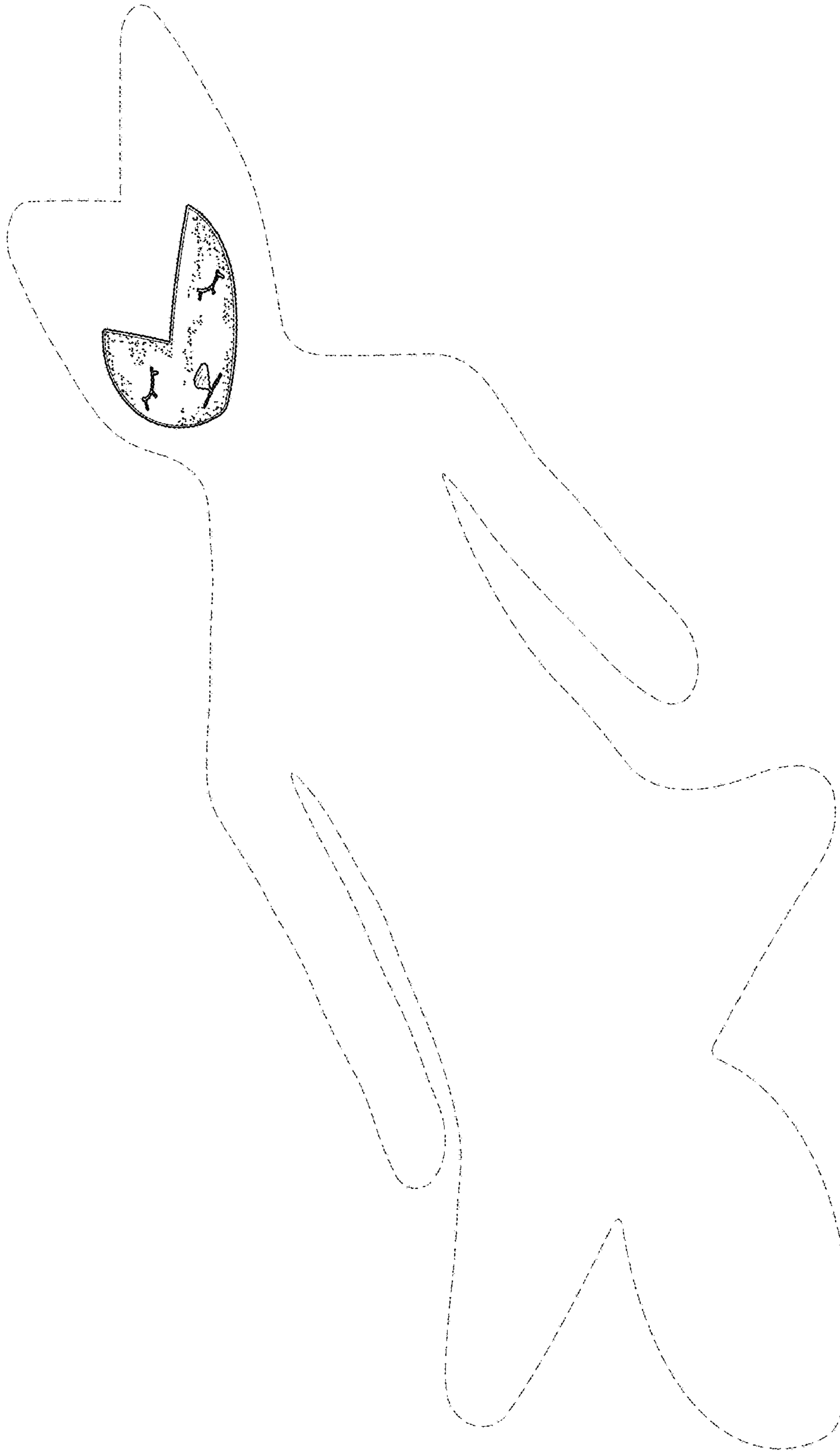

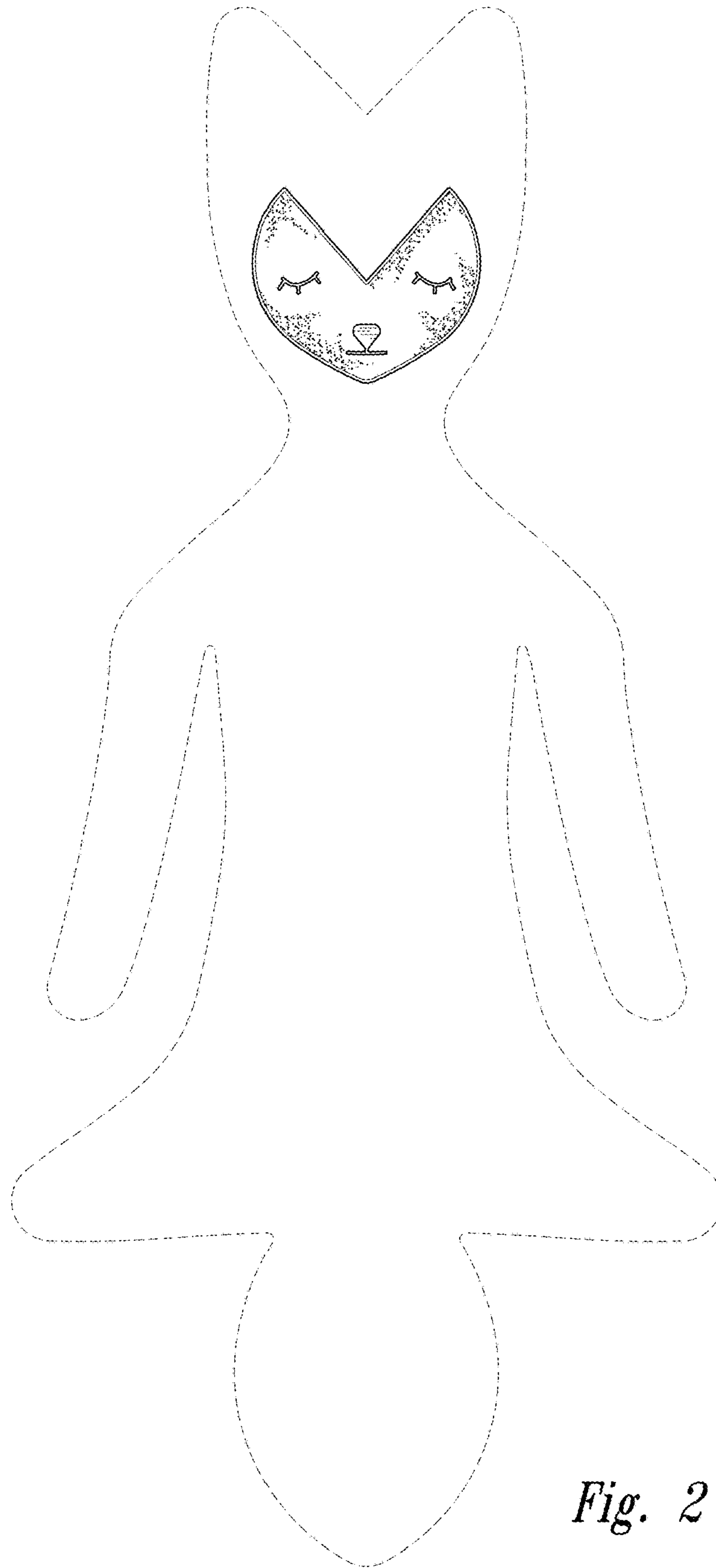

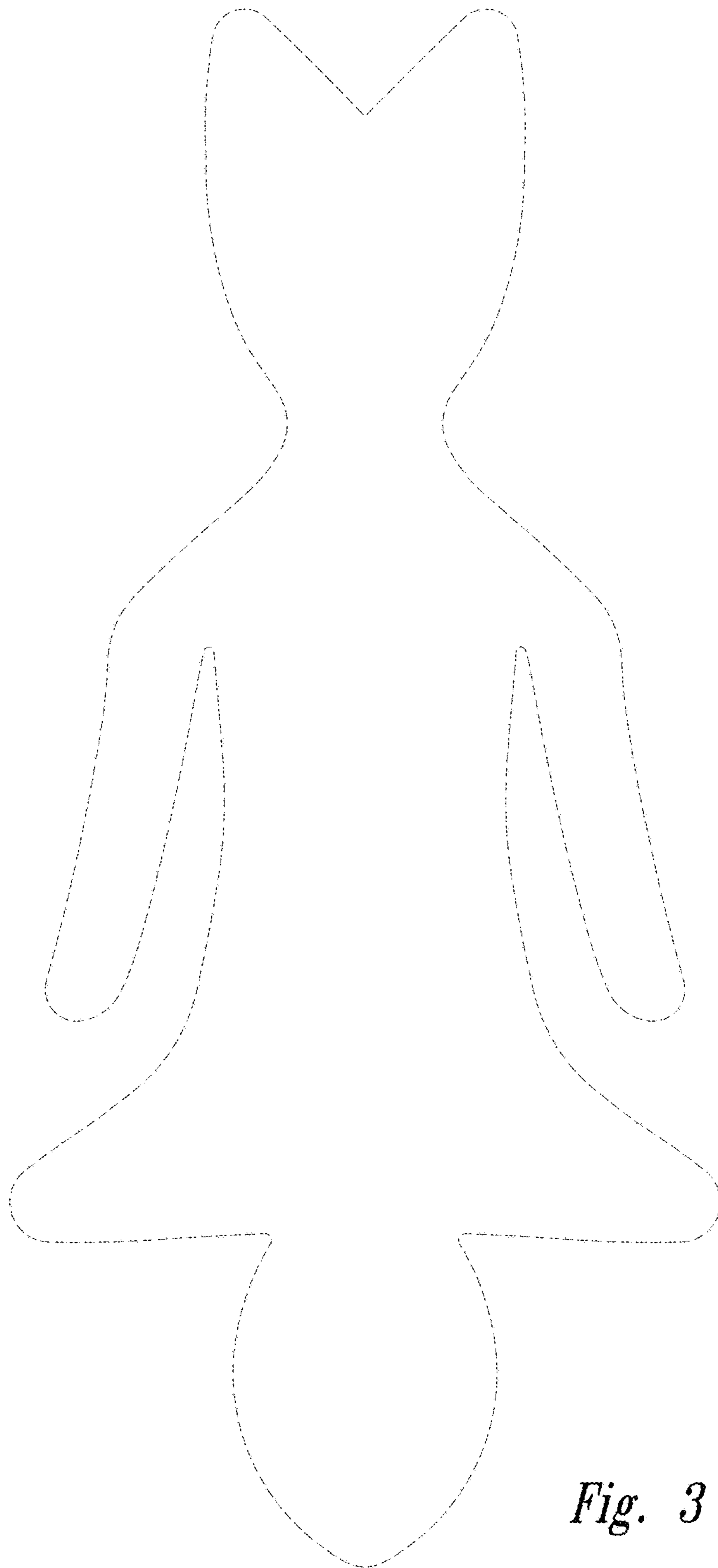

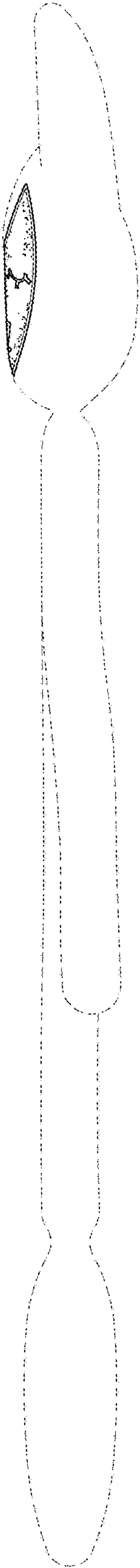

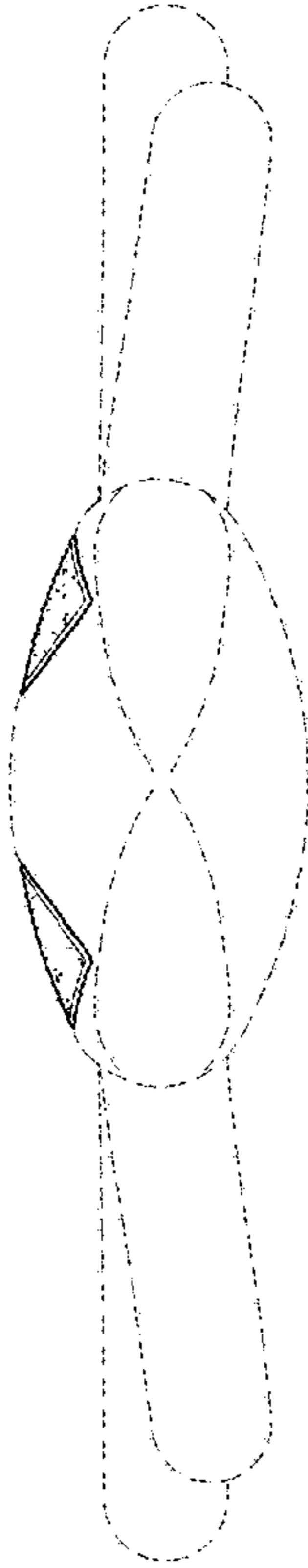

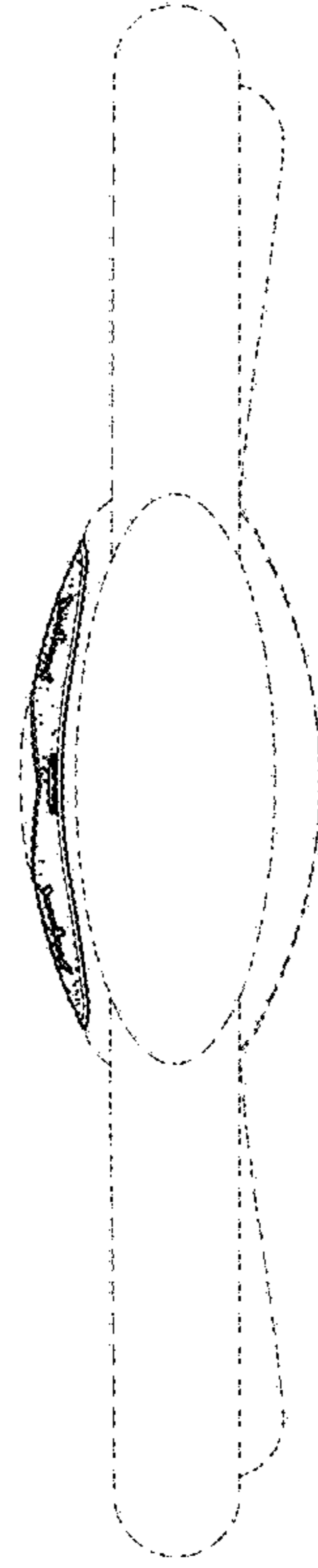
