(57) **CLAIM**

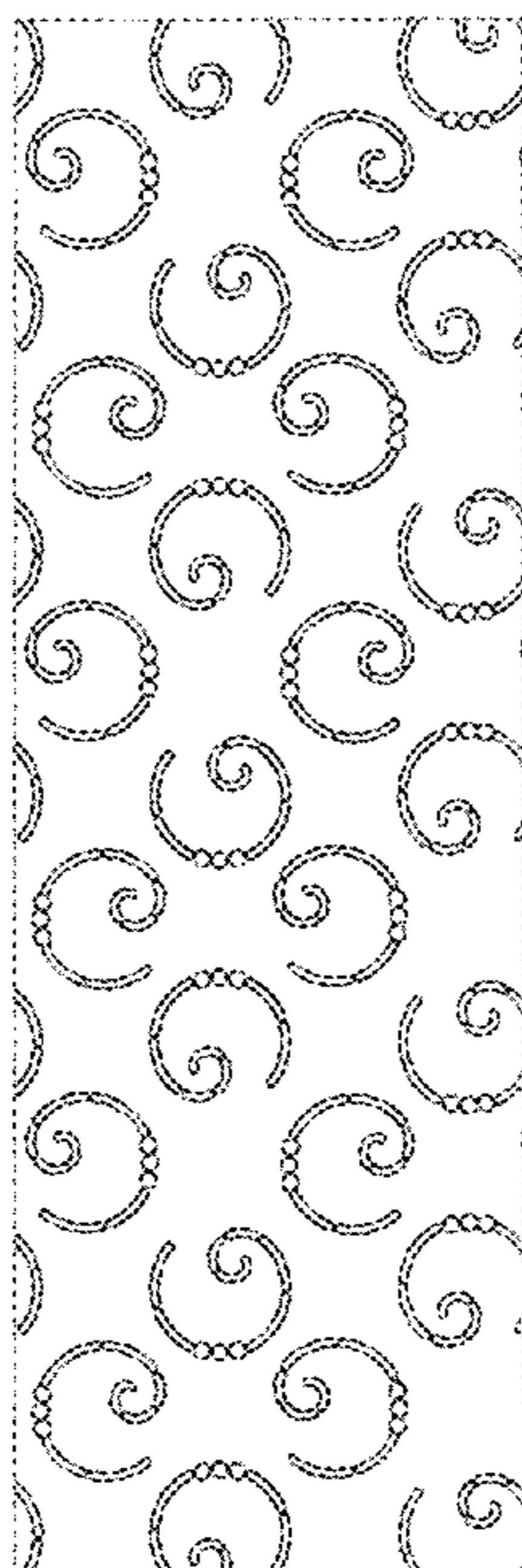
The ornamental design for a paper product with pattern, as shown and described.

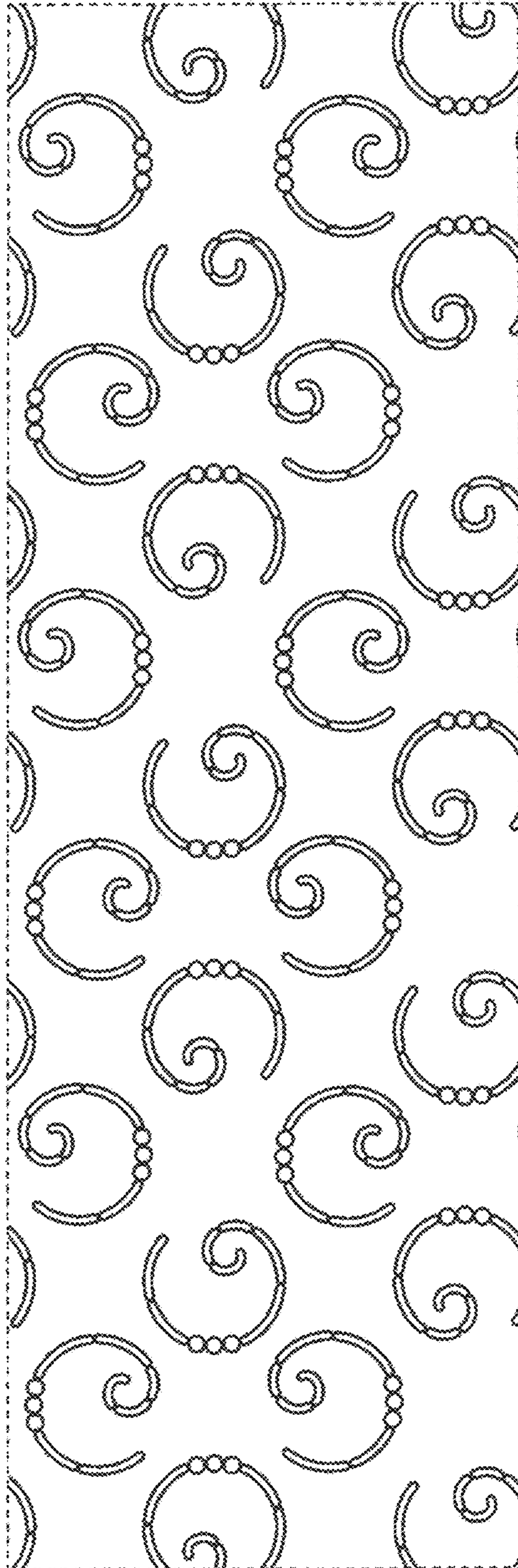

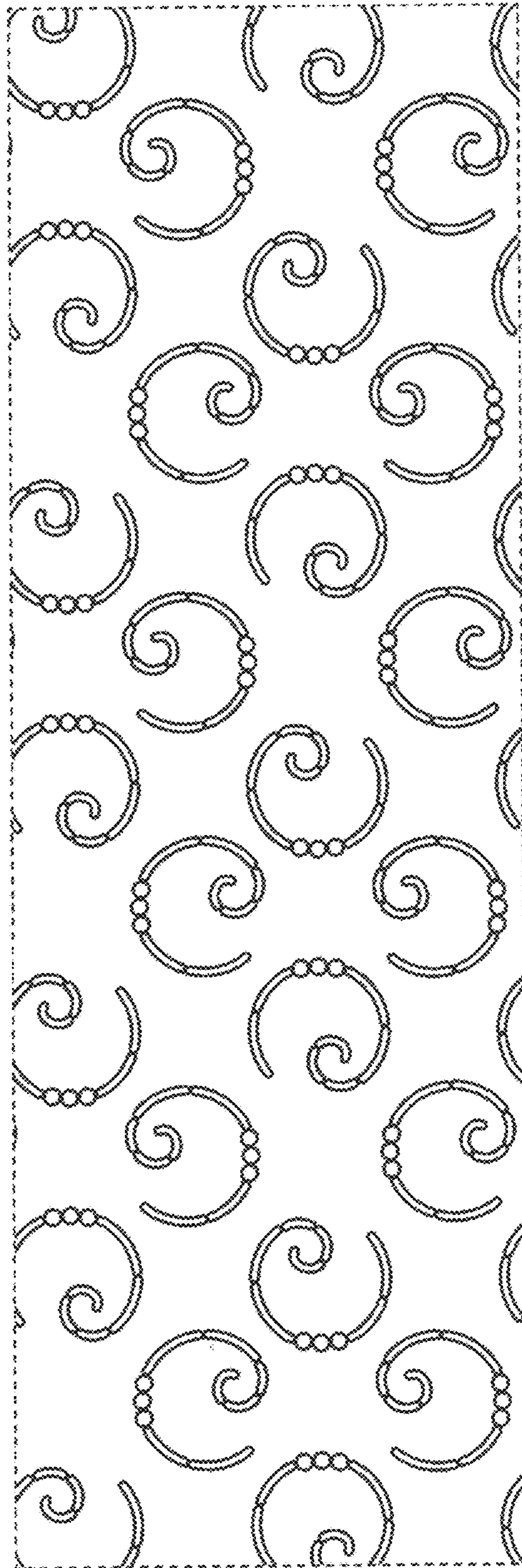
