FIG. 4 is a right side view of the chair pad;

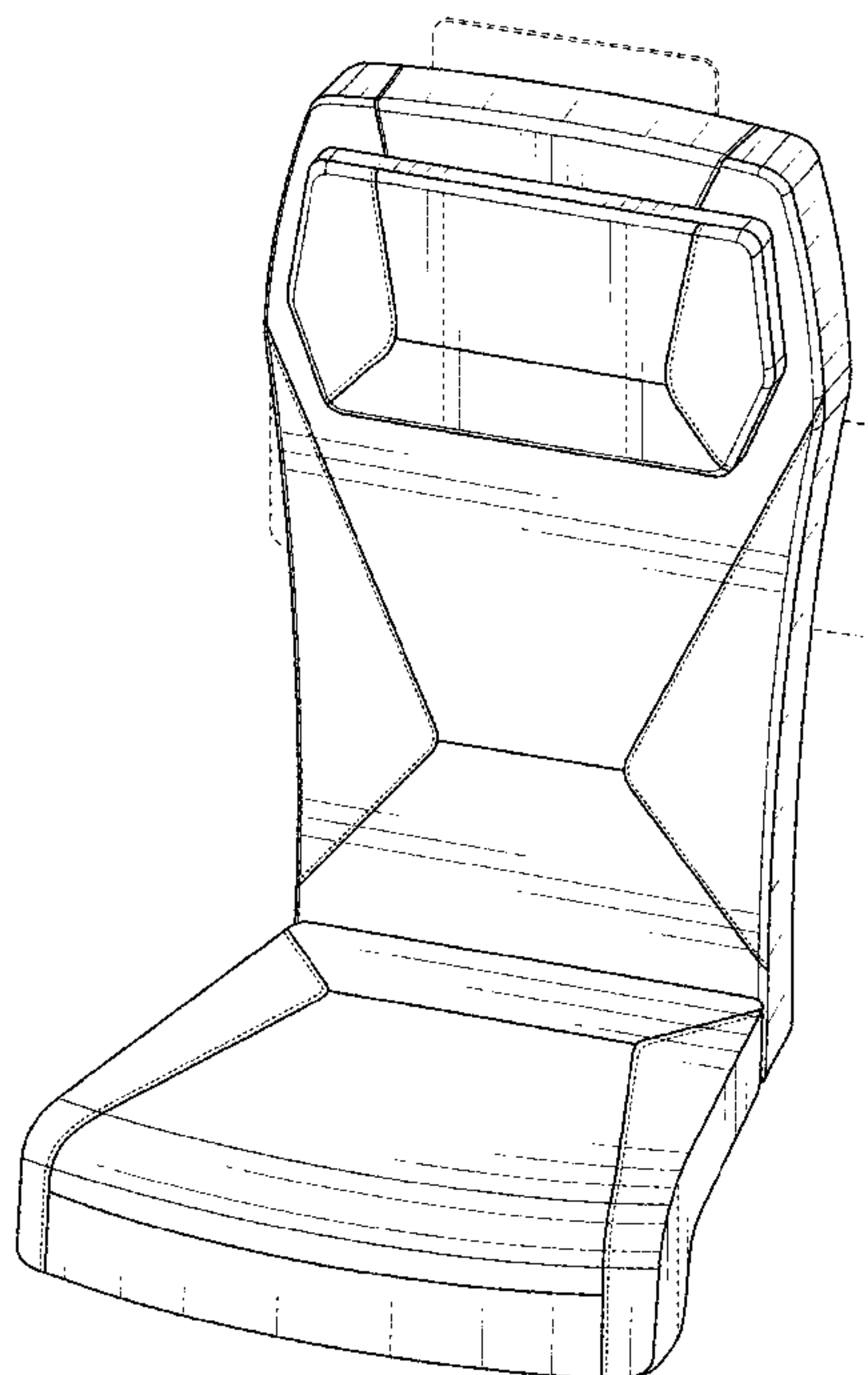
FIG. 5 is a left side view of the chair pad;

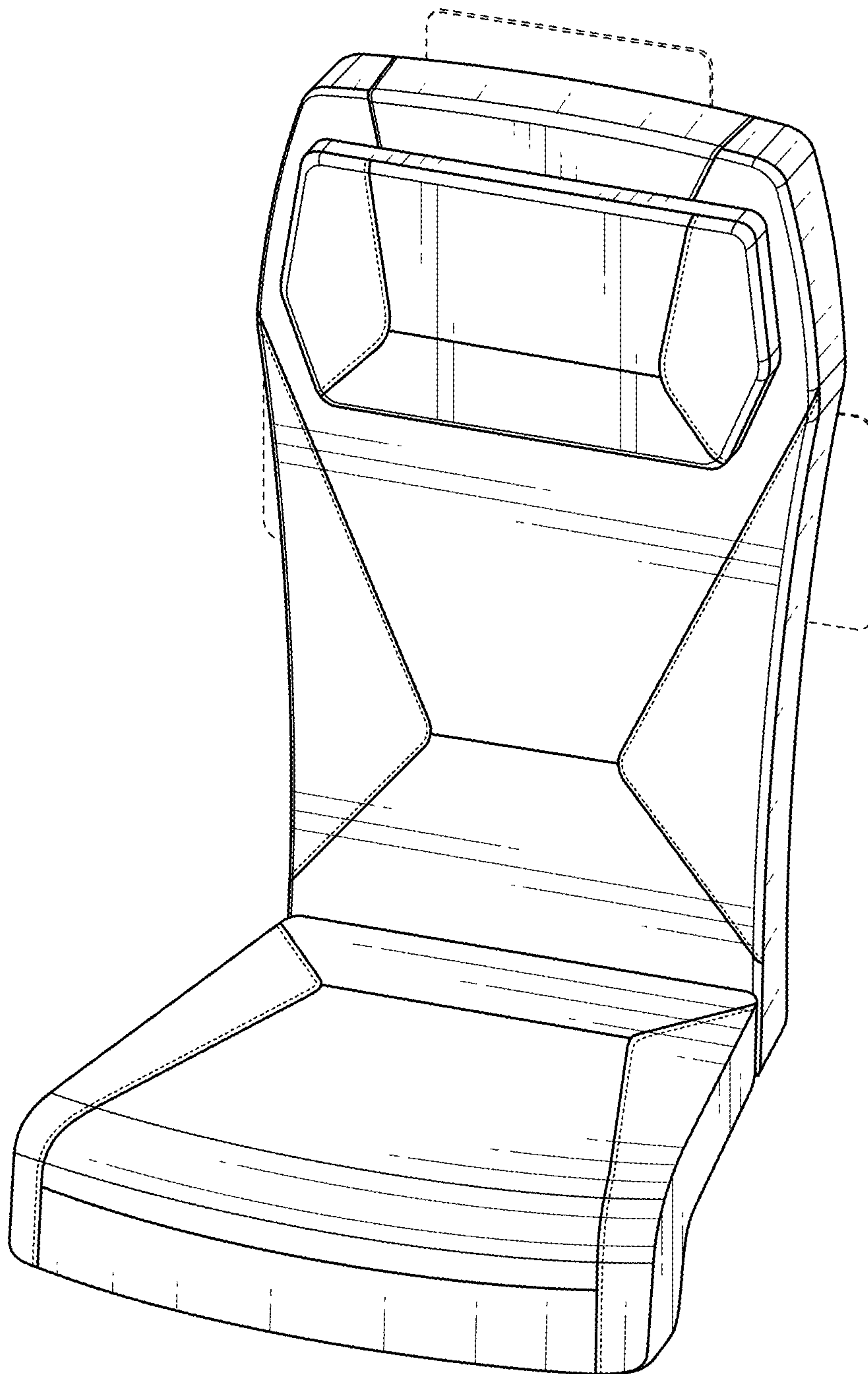

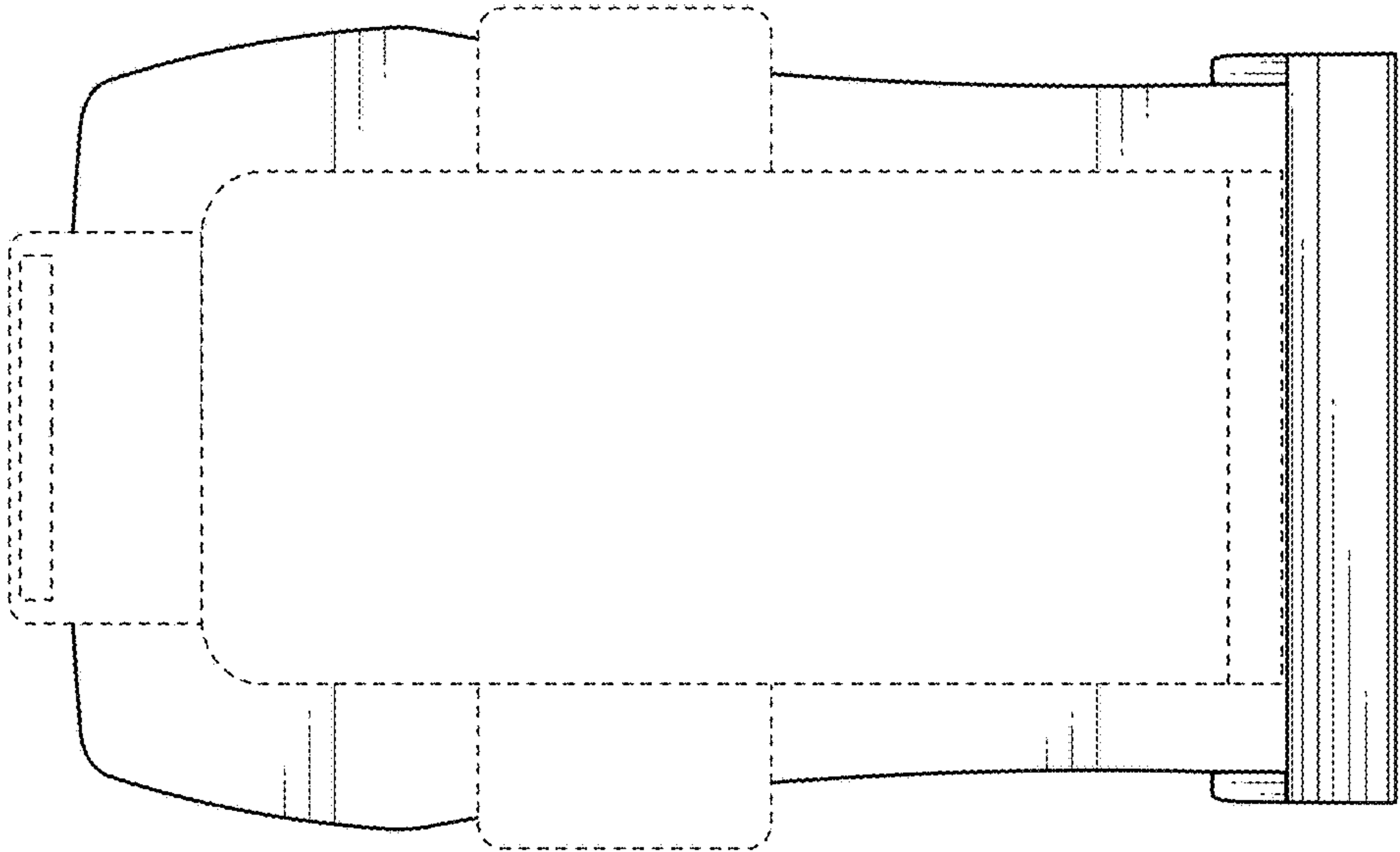

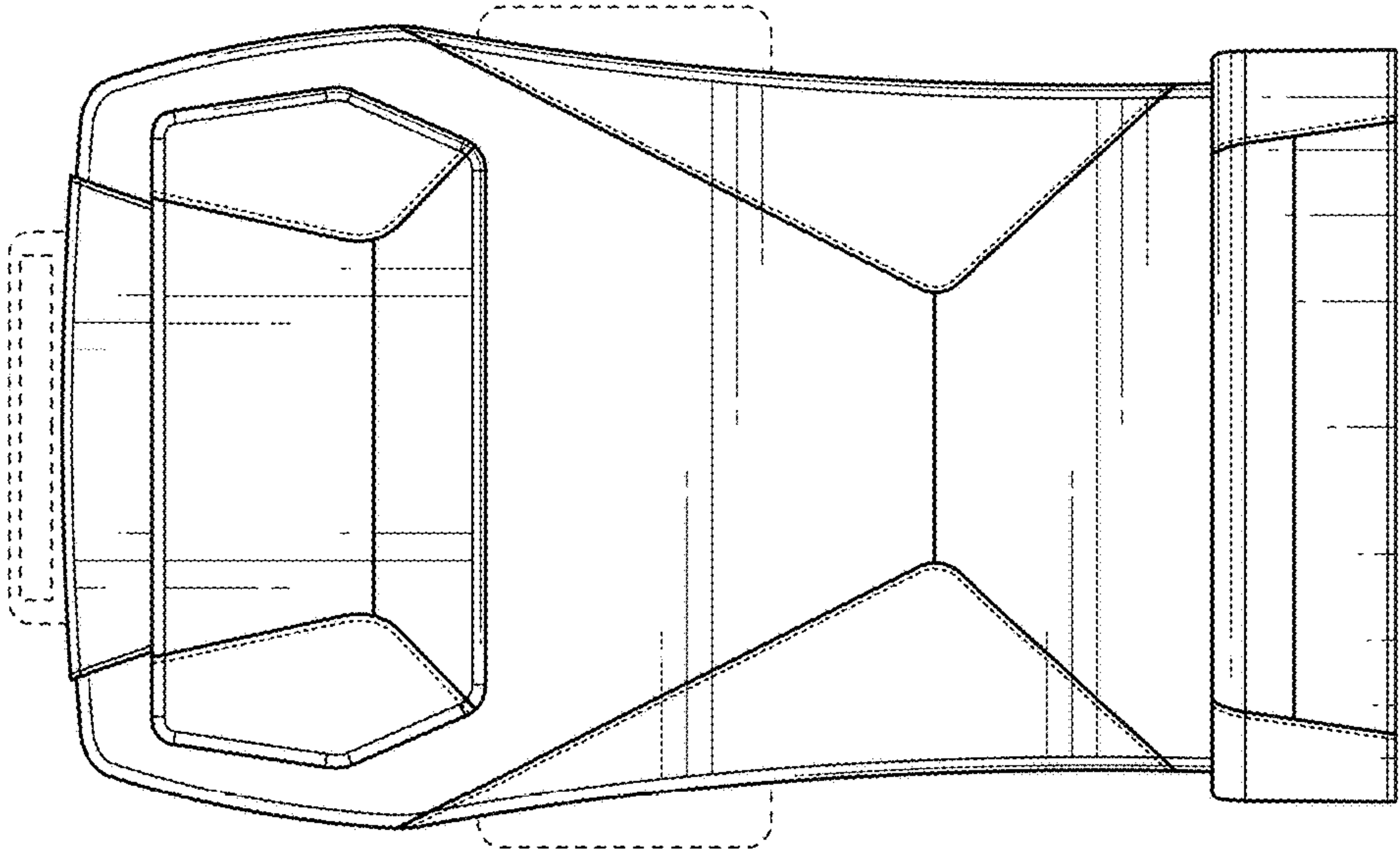

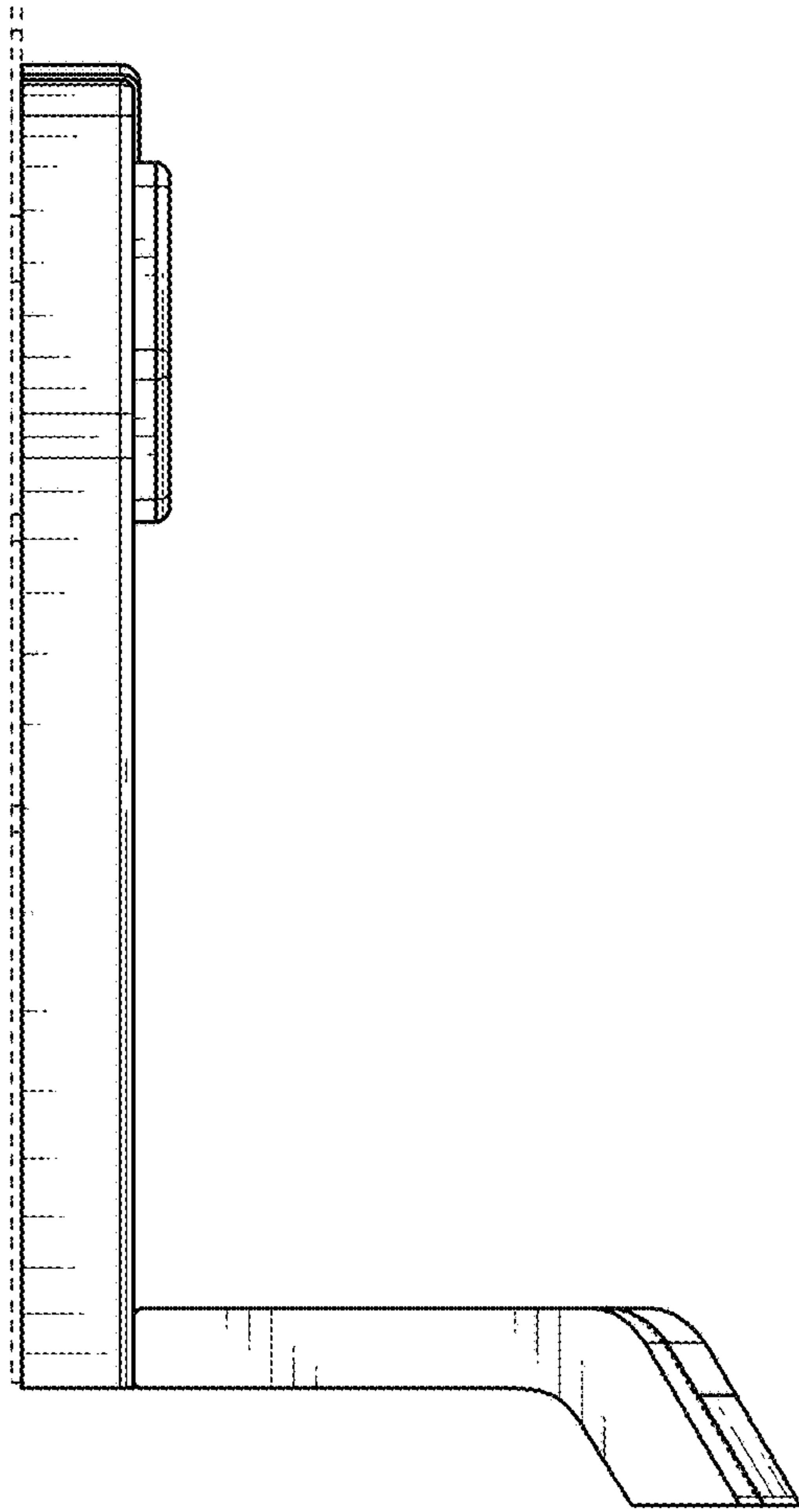

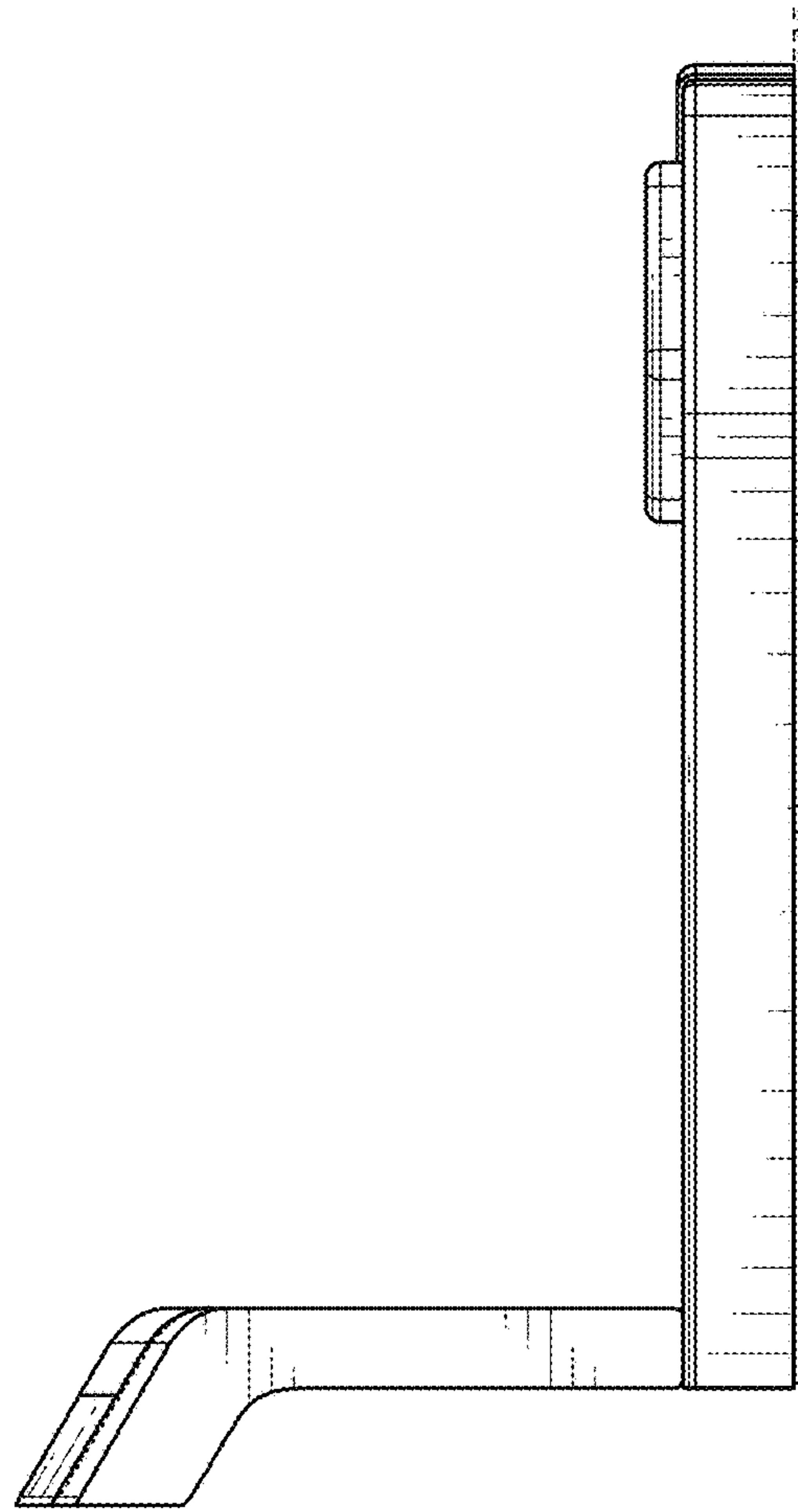

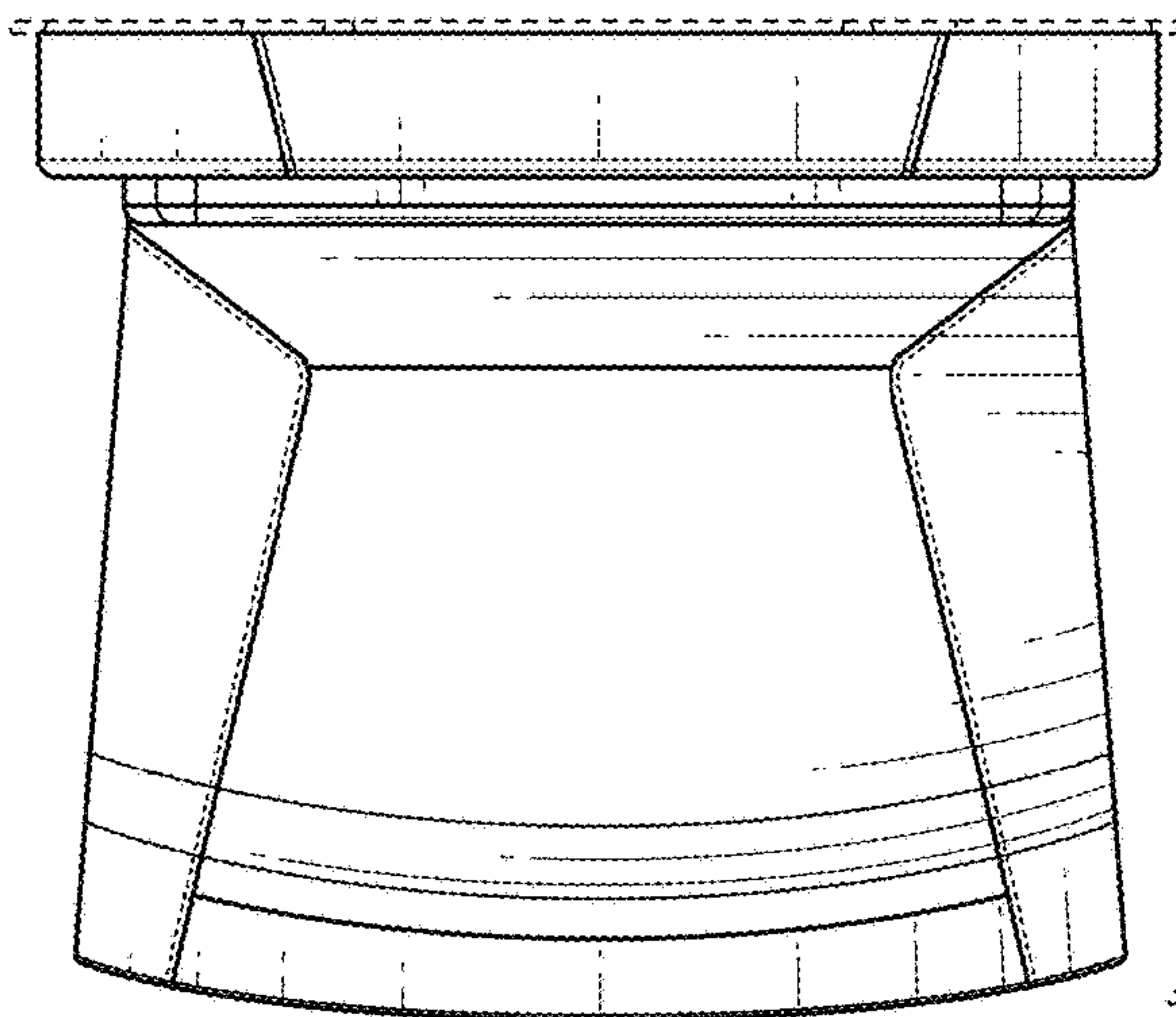

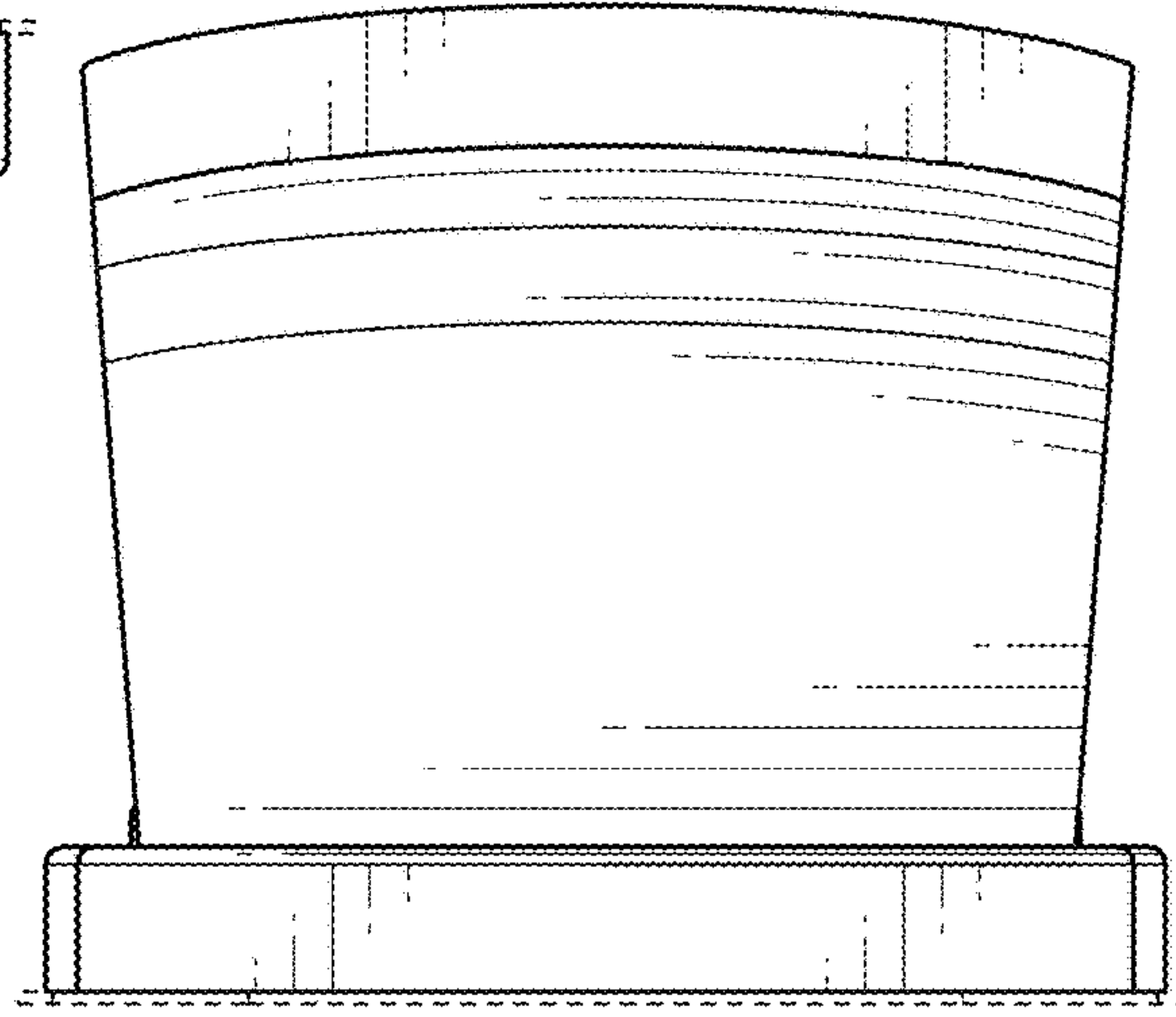
