The ornamental design for a shoe midsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side view of a shoe showing my design according to a first embodiment;
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof; and,
FIG. 4 is a rear view thereof.

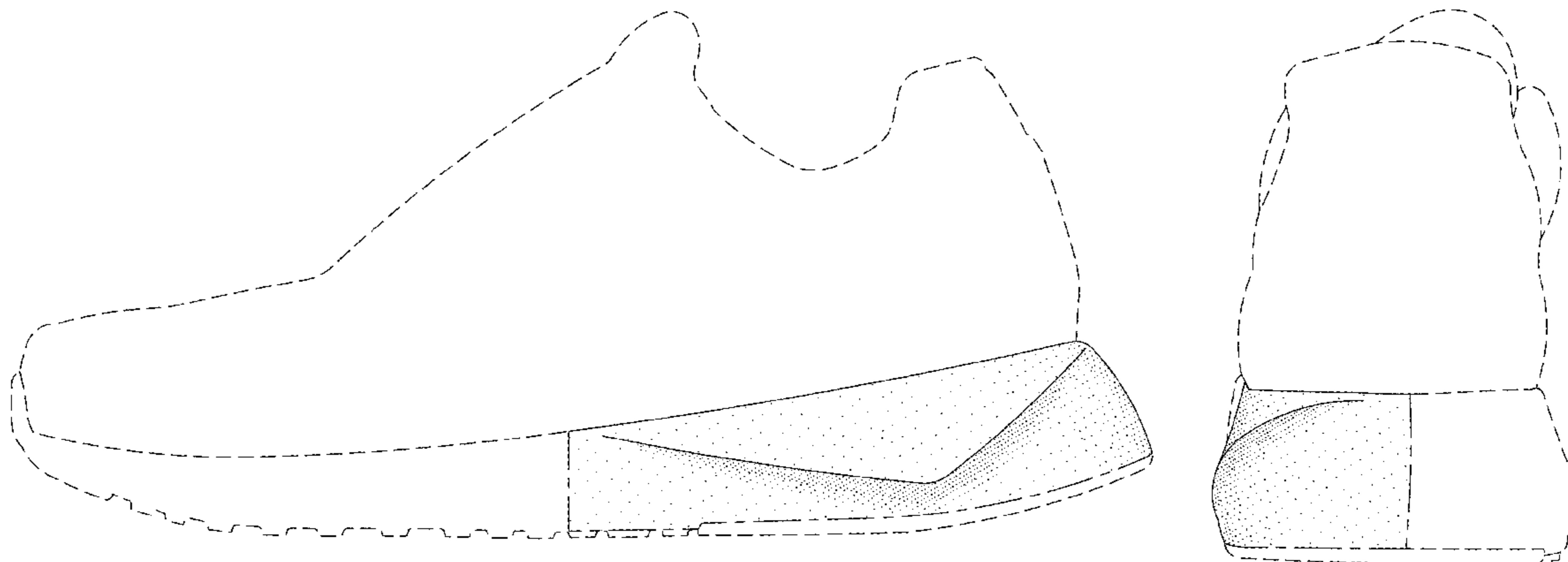

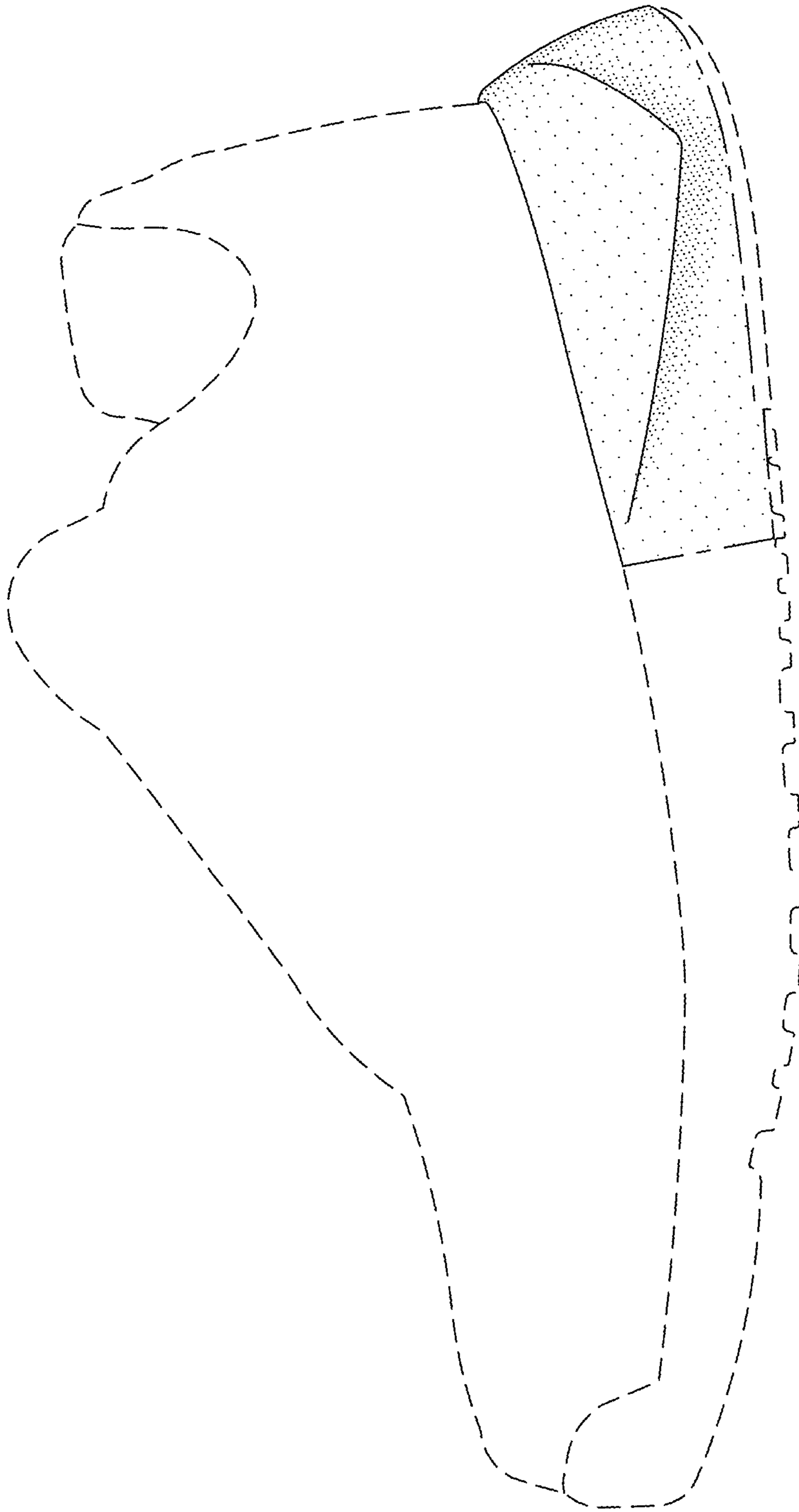

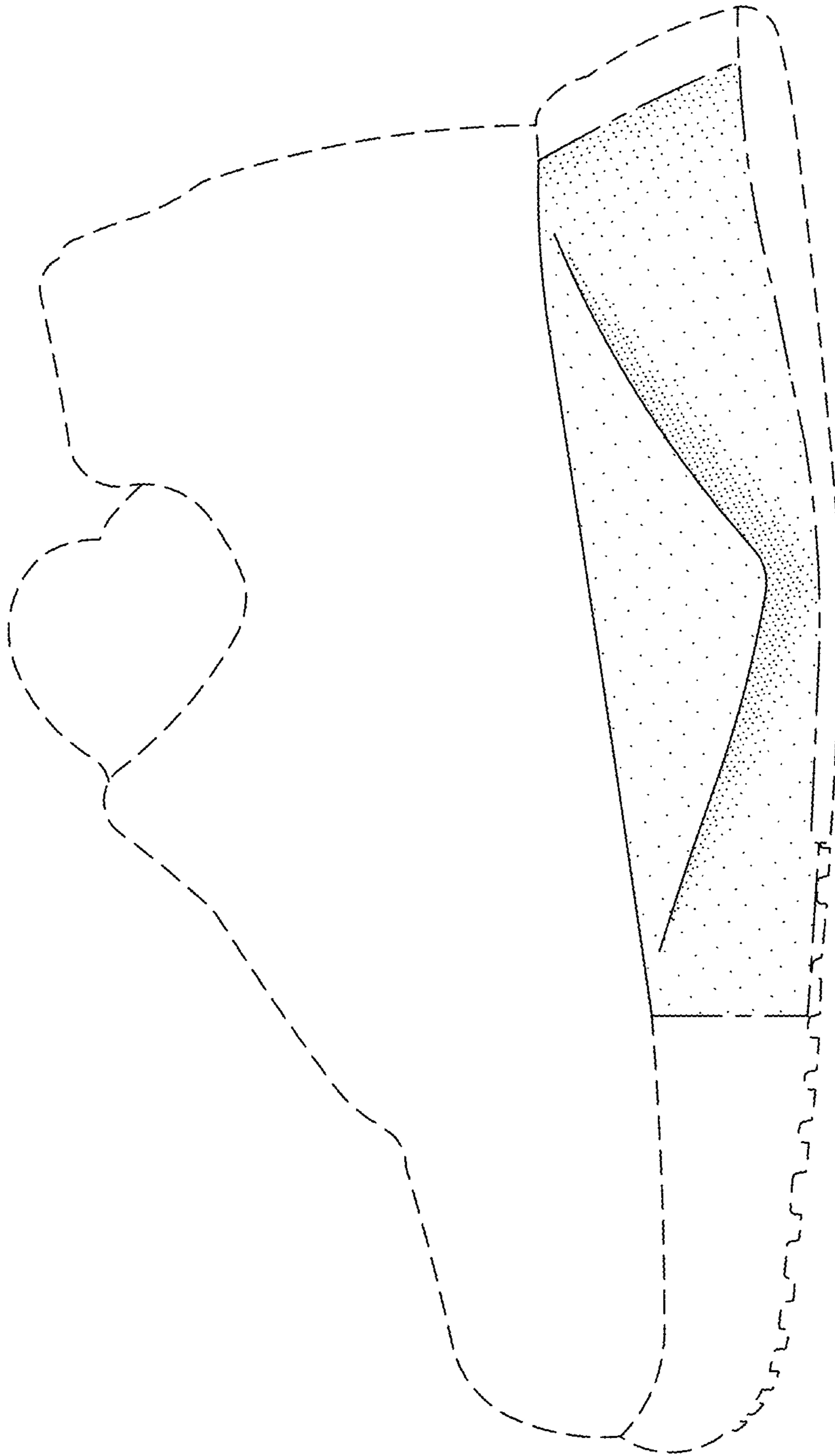

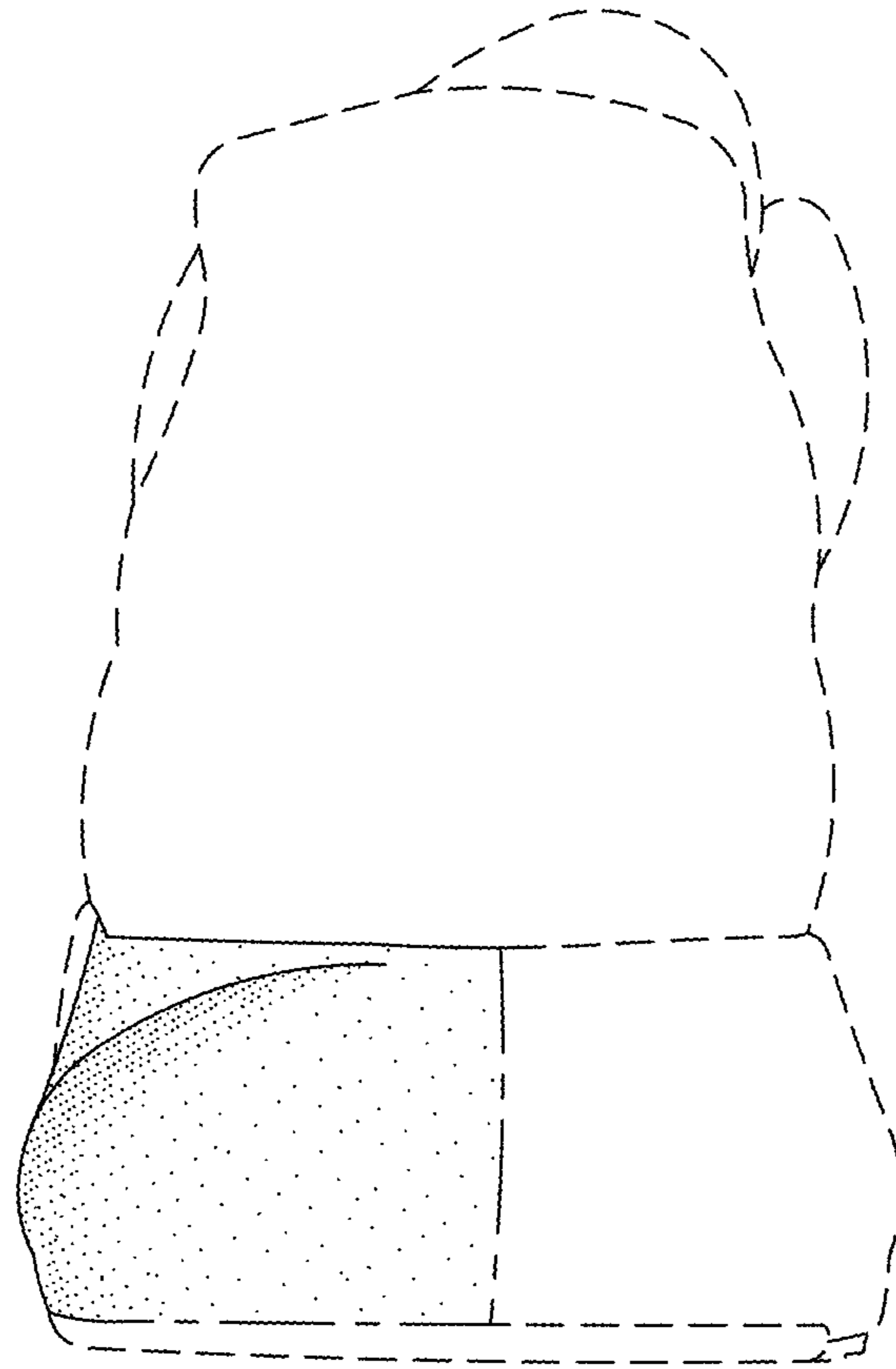
