DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a stand for monitor, showing our new design;

FIG. 10 is another right side view thereof, shown in an environment of use;

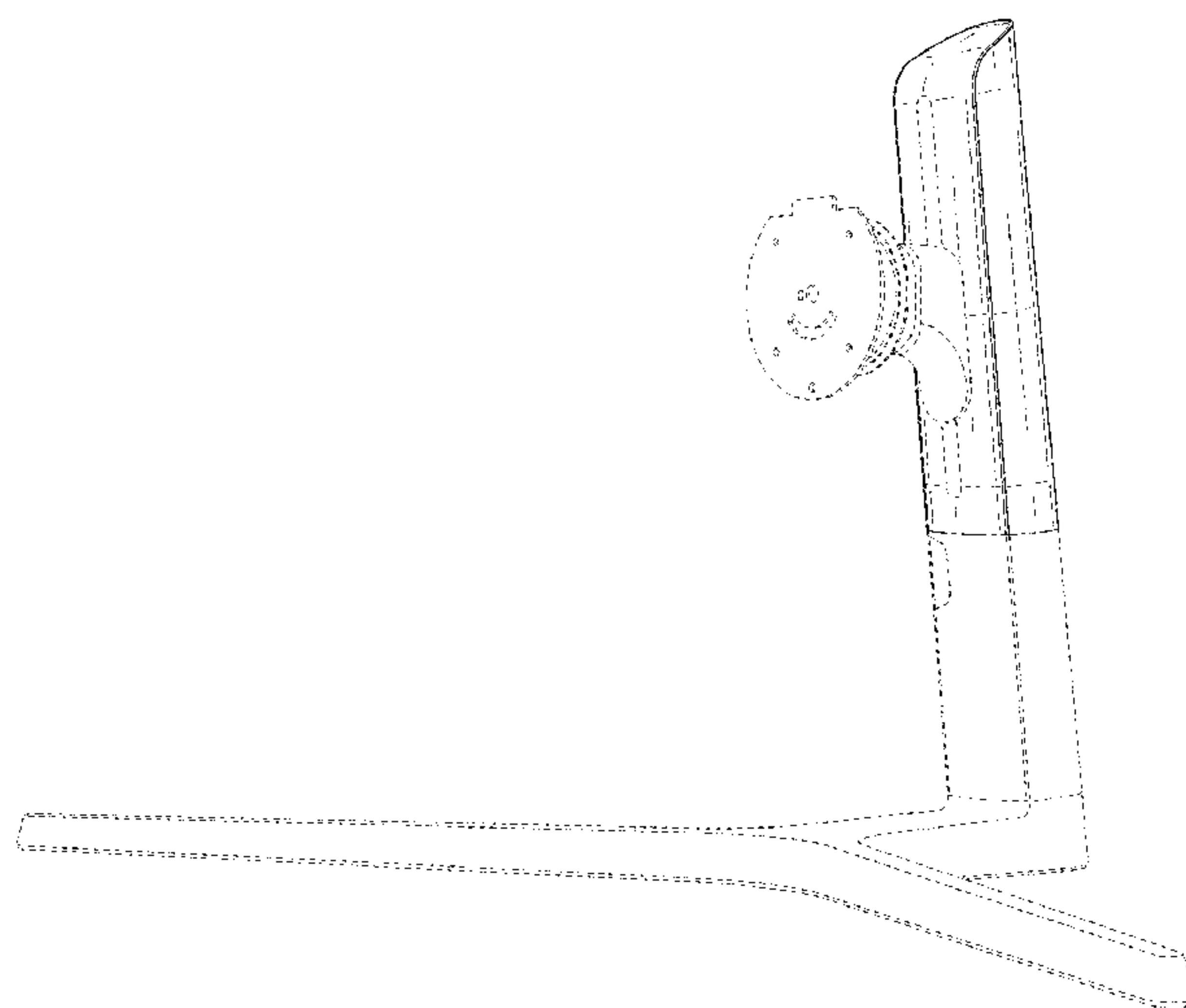
FIG. 11 is another right side view thereof, shown in an environment of use; and,

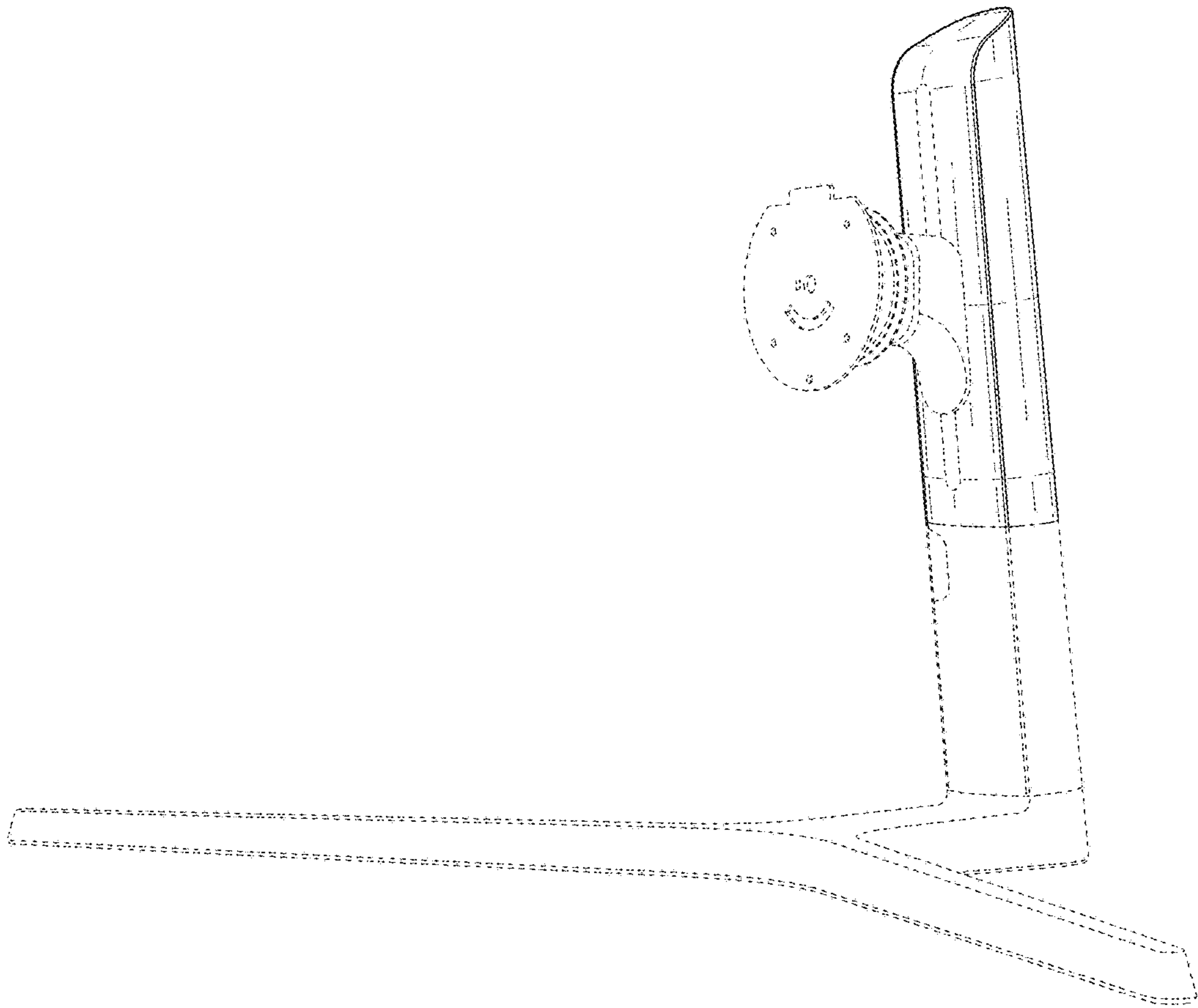

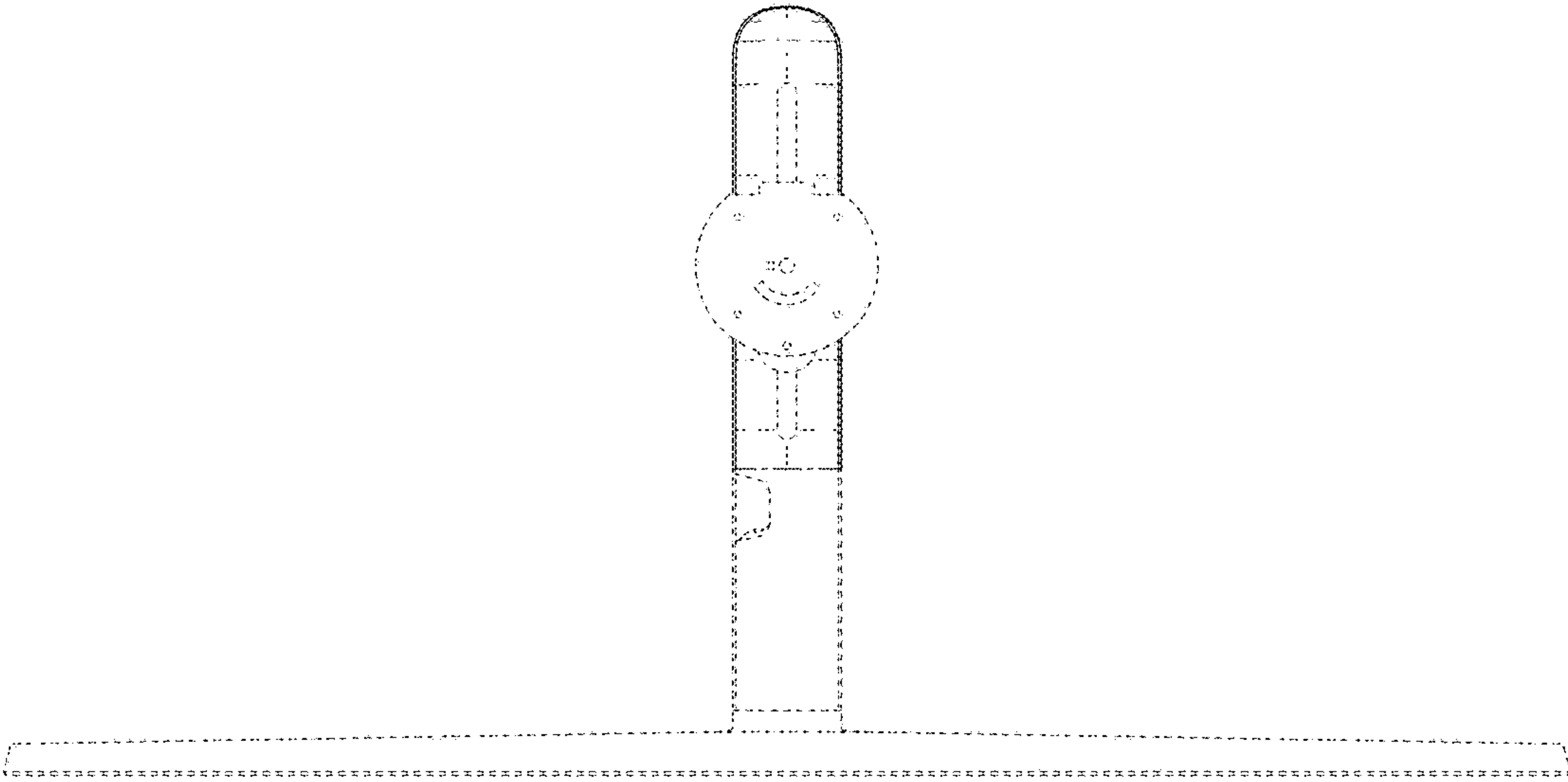

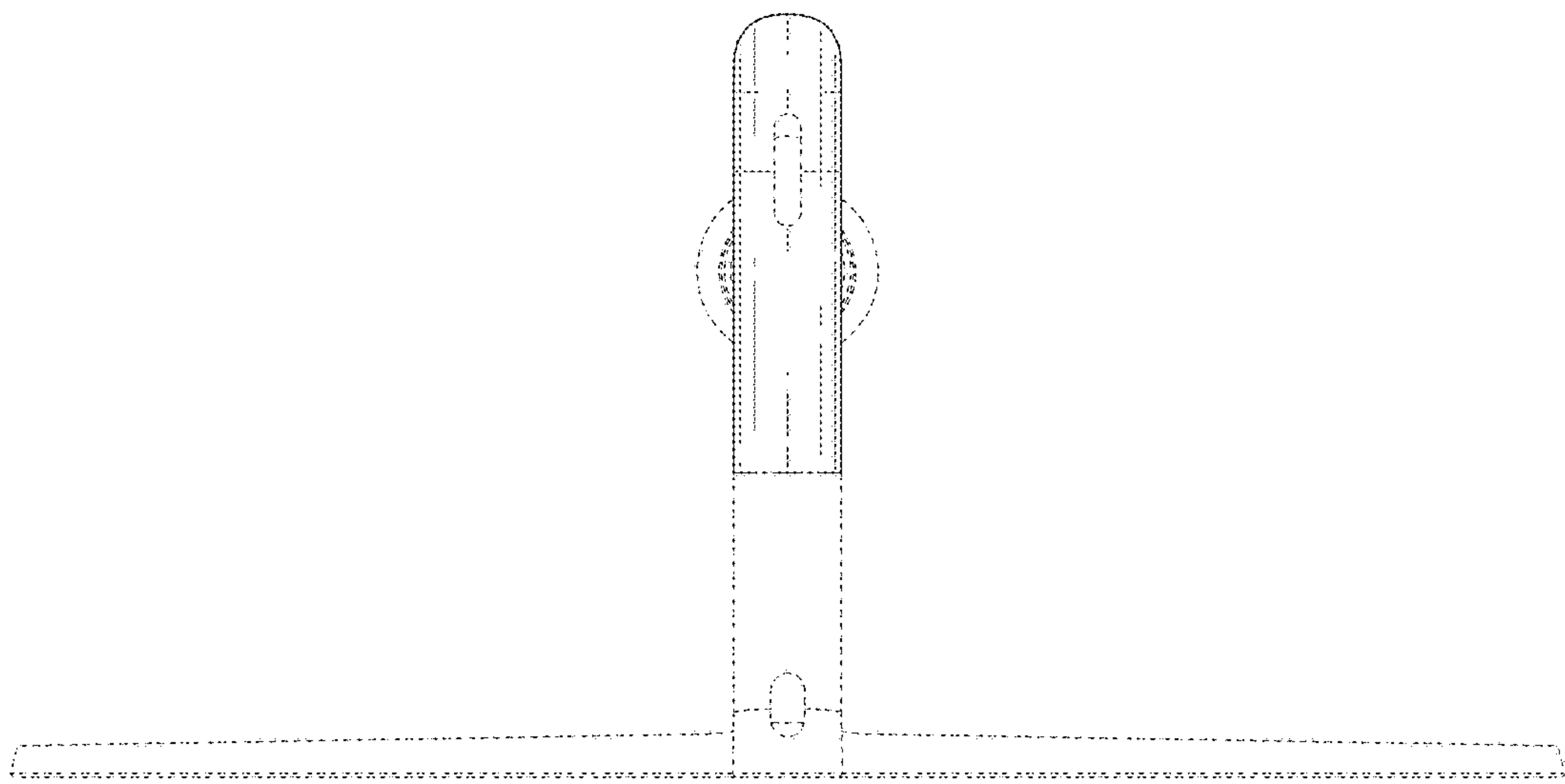

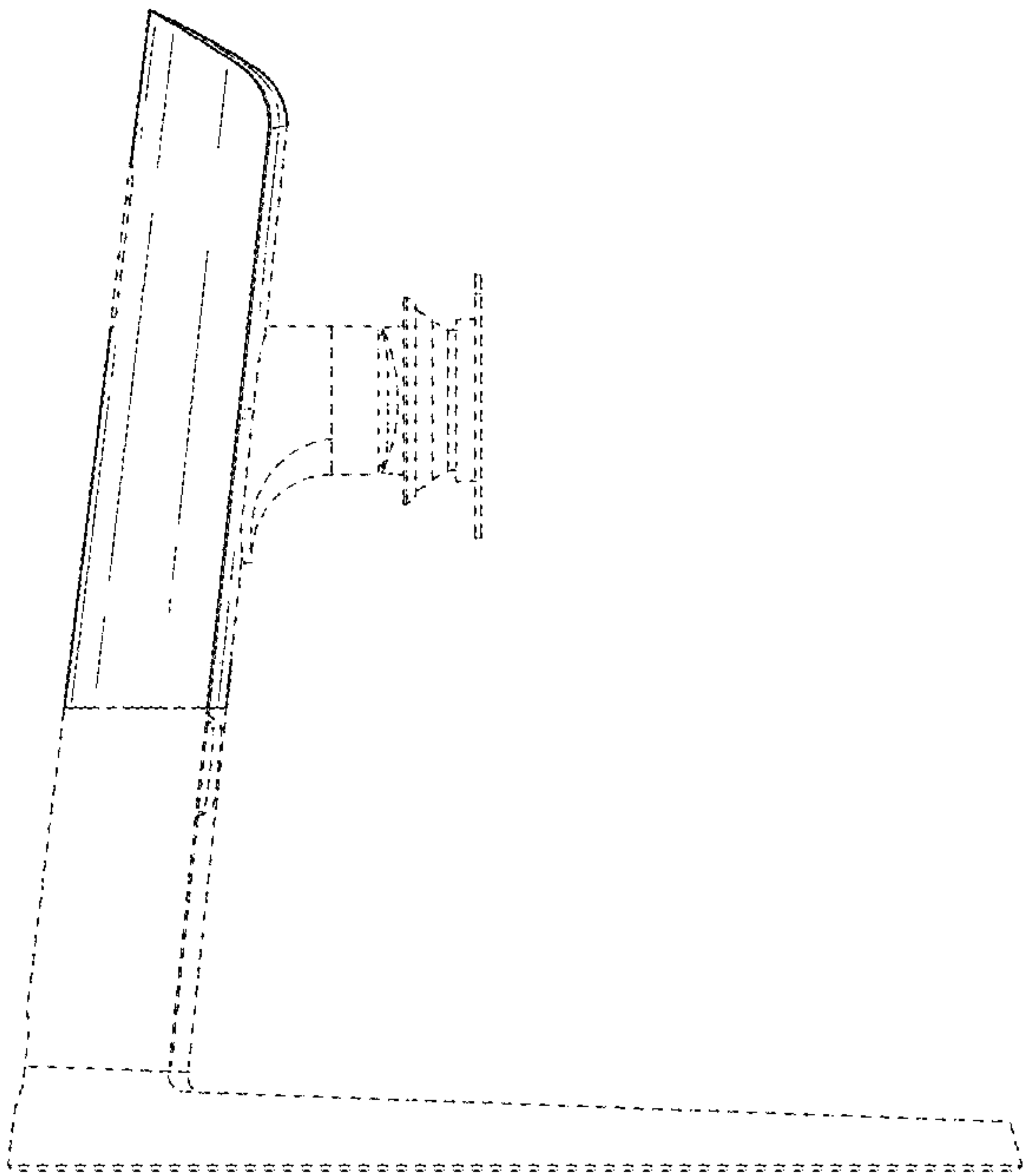

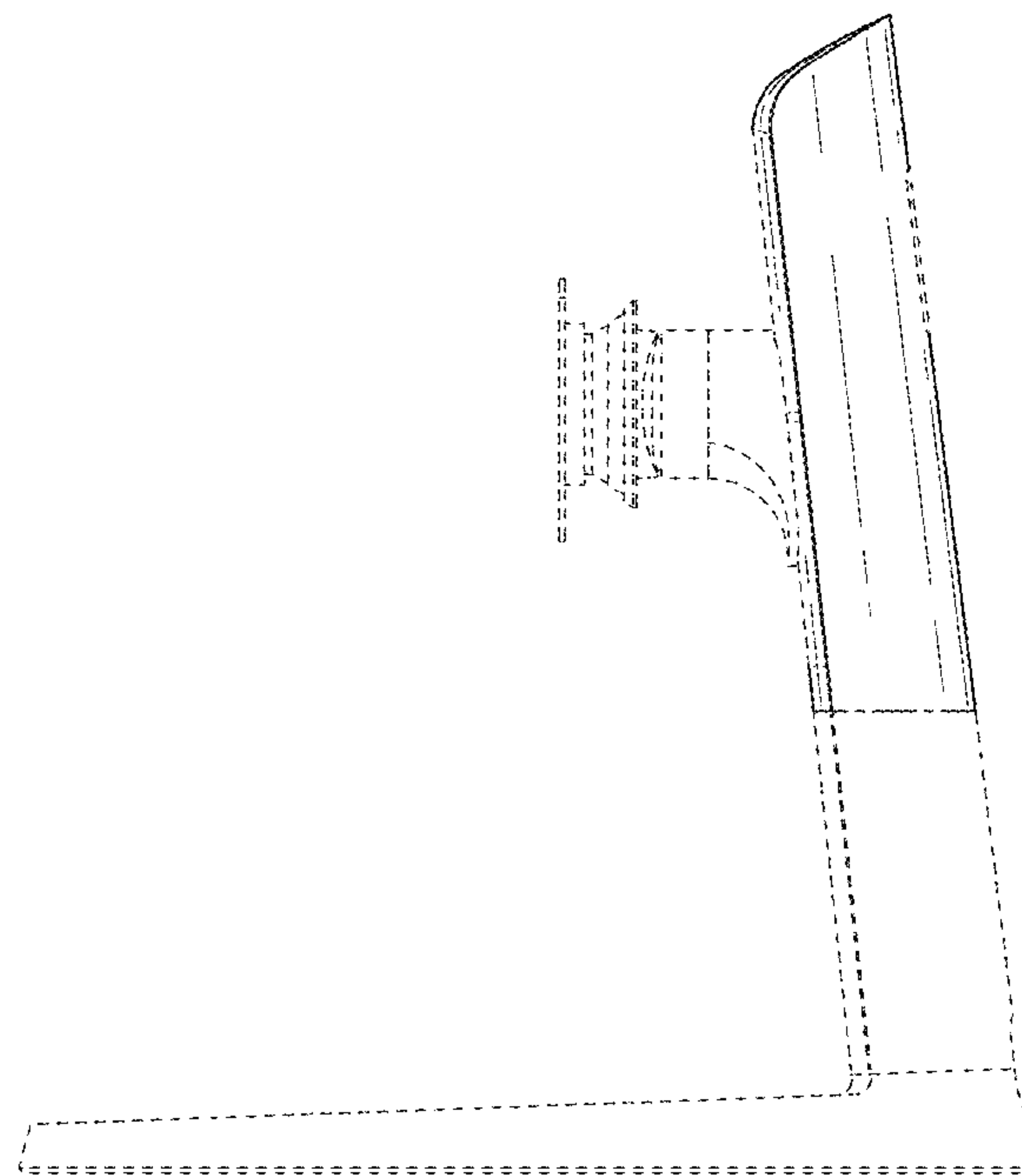

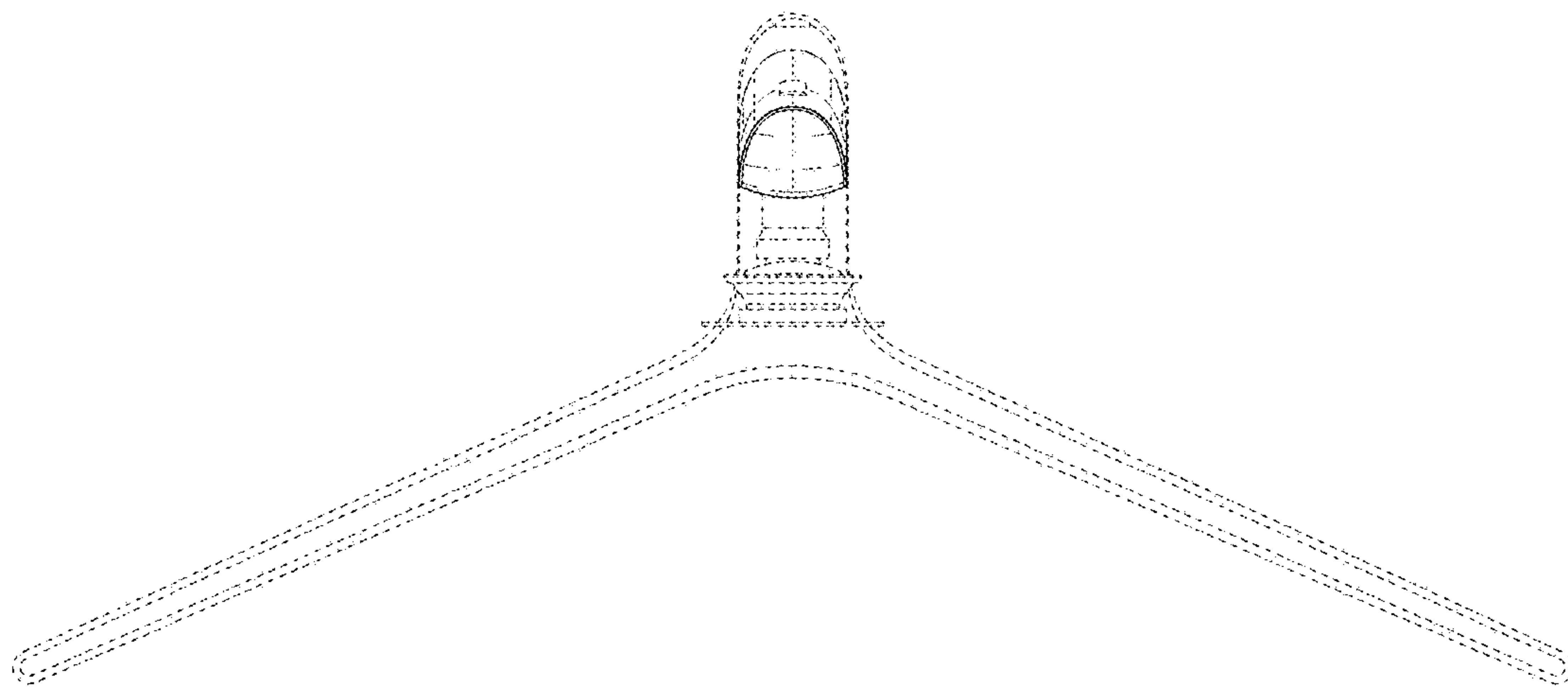

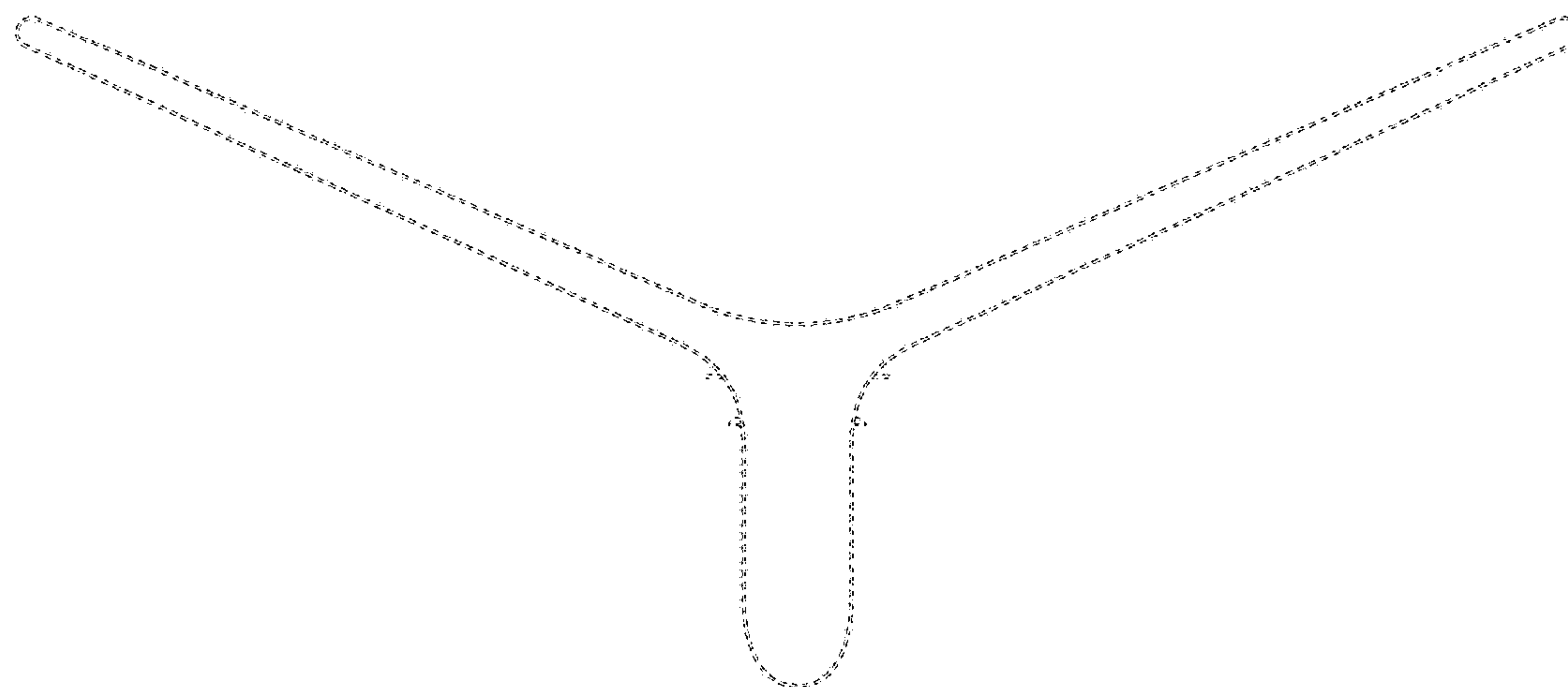

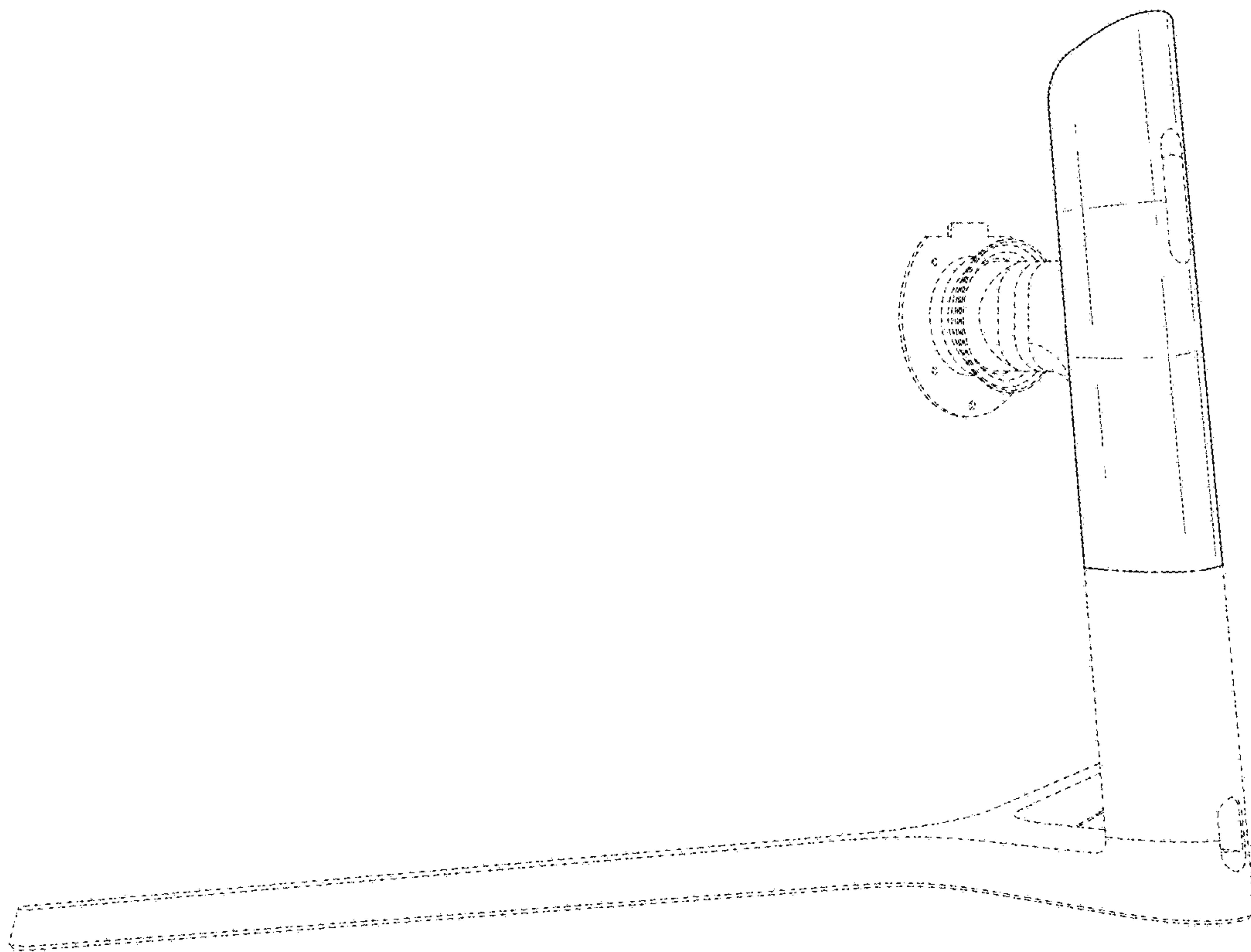

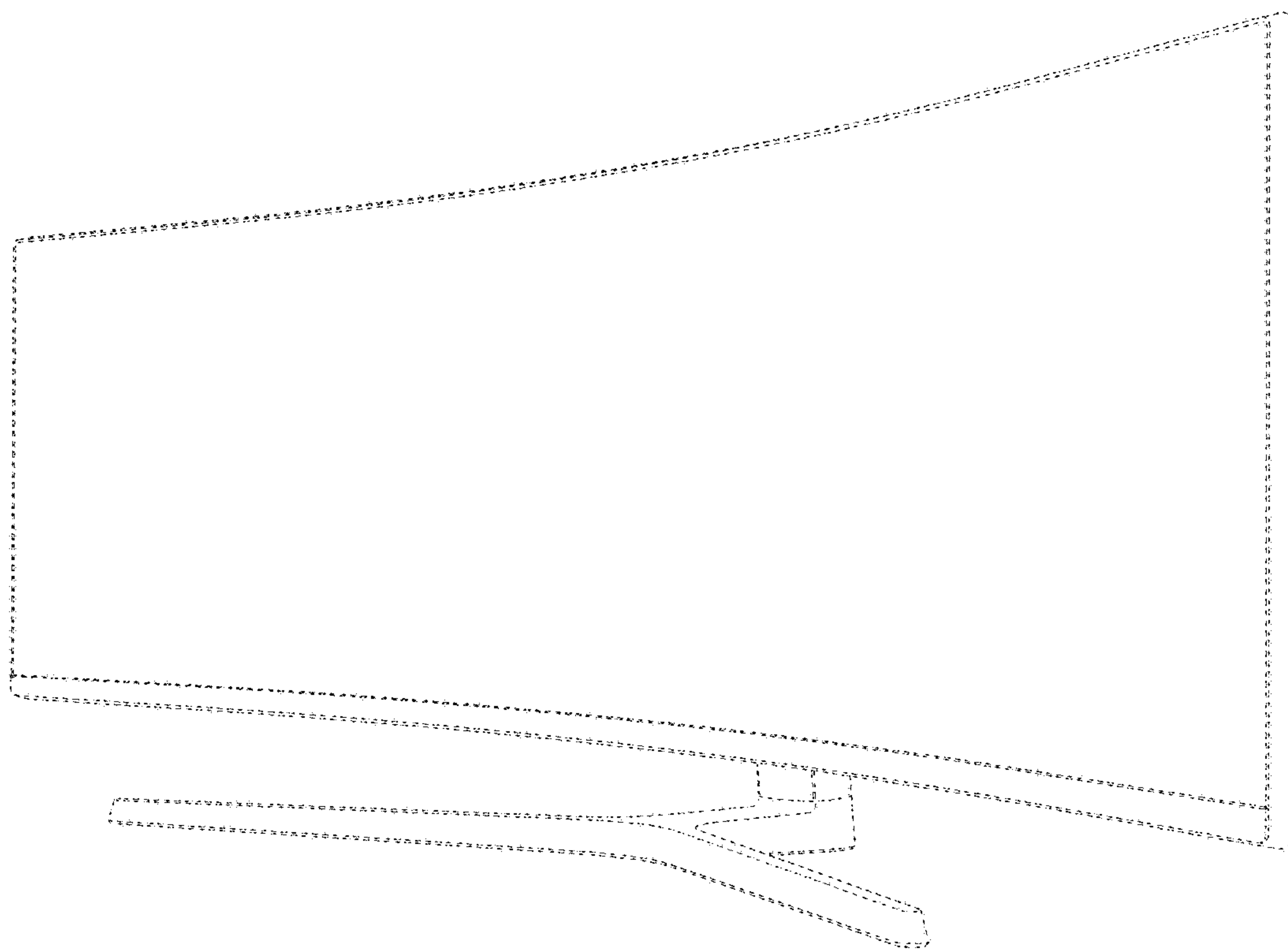

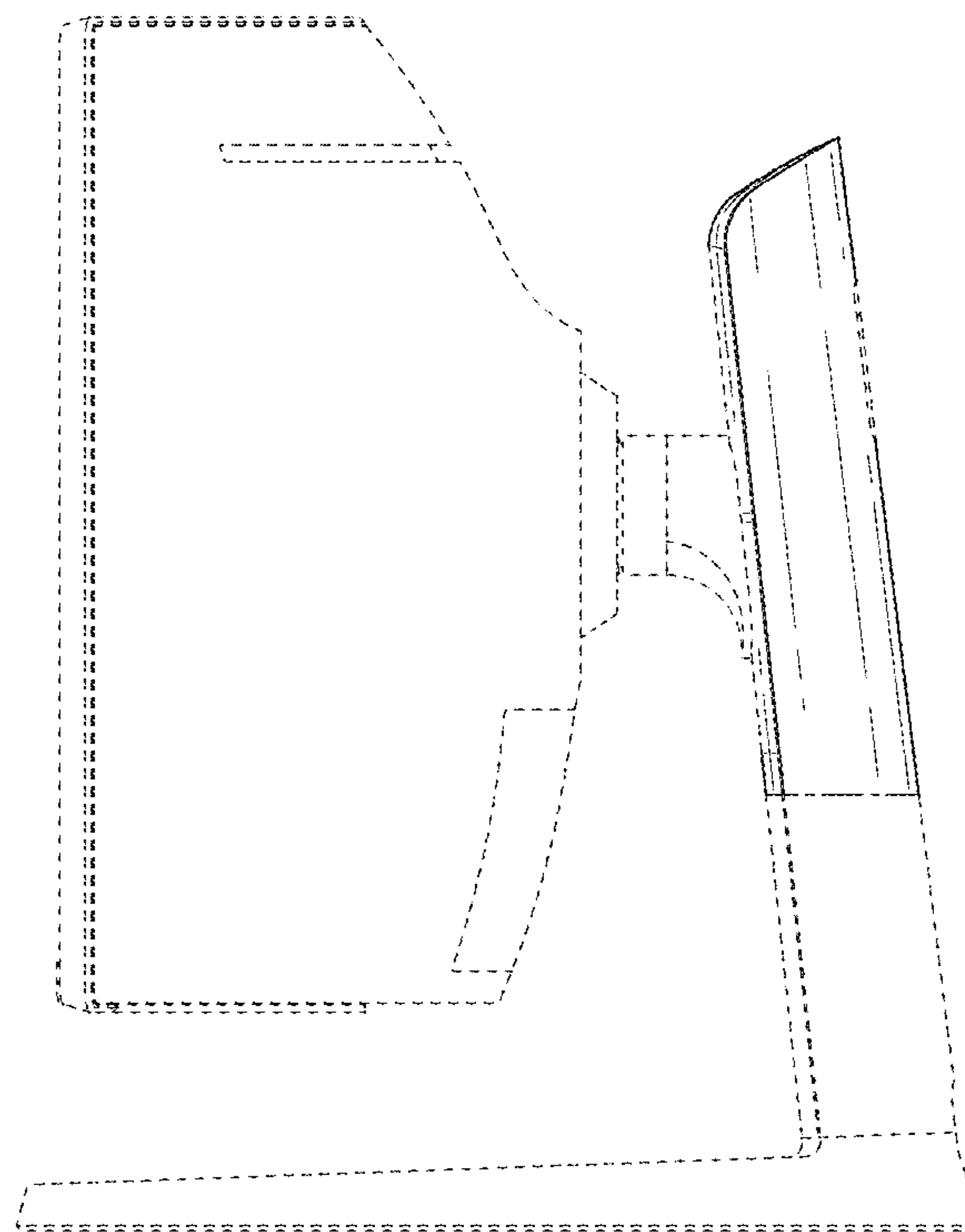

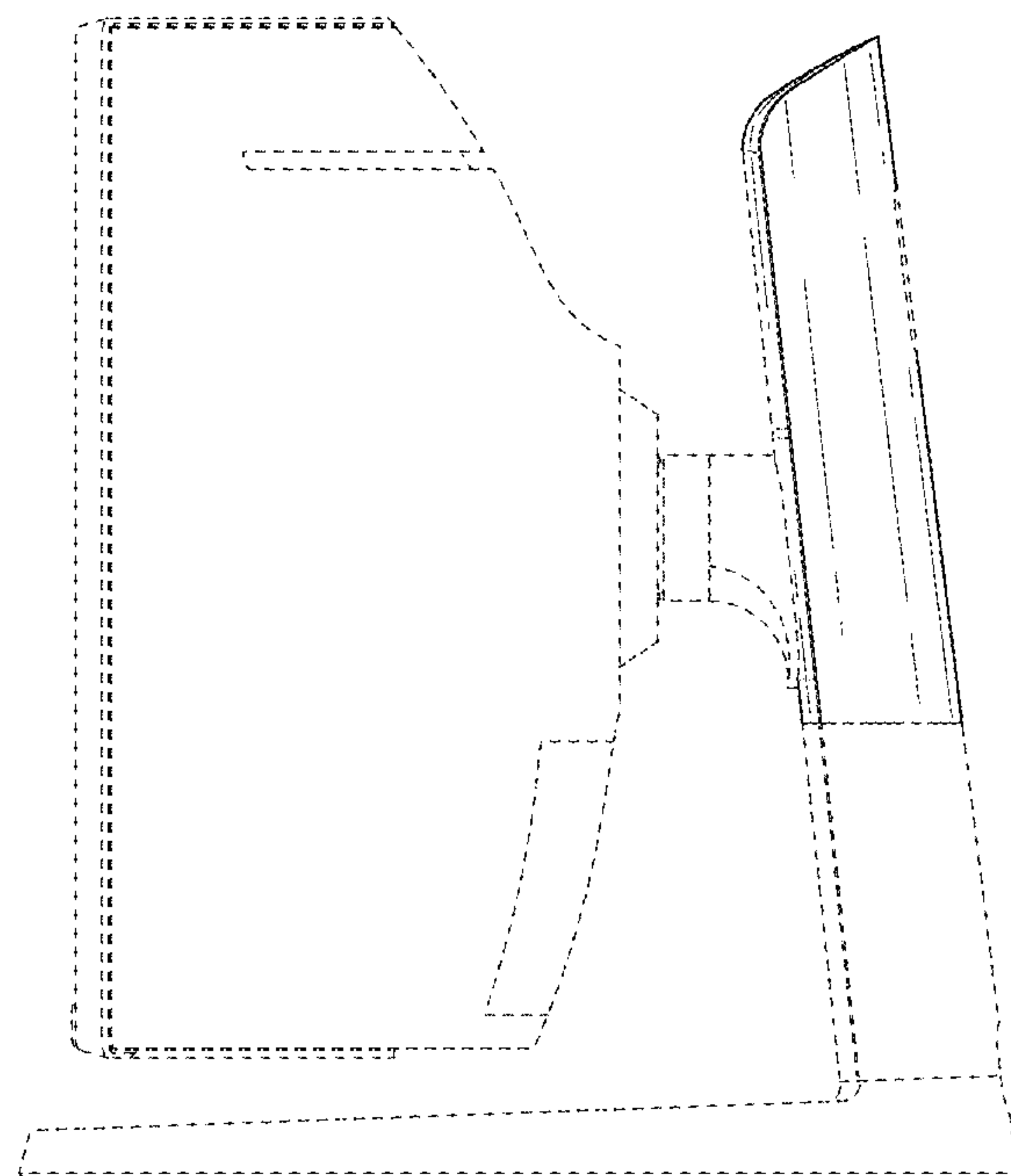
