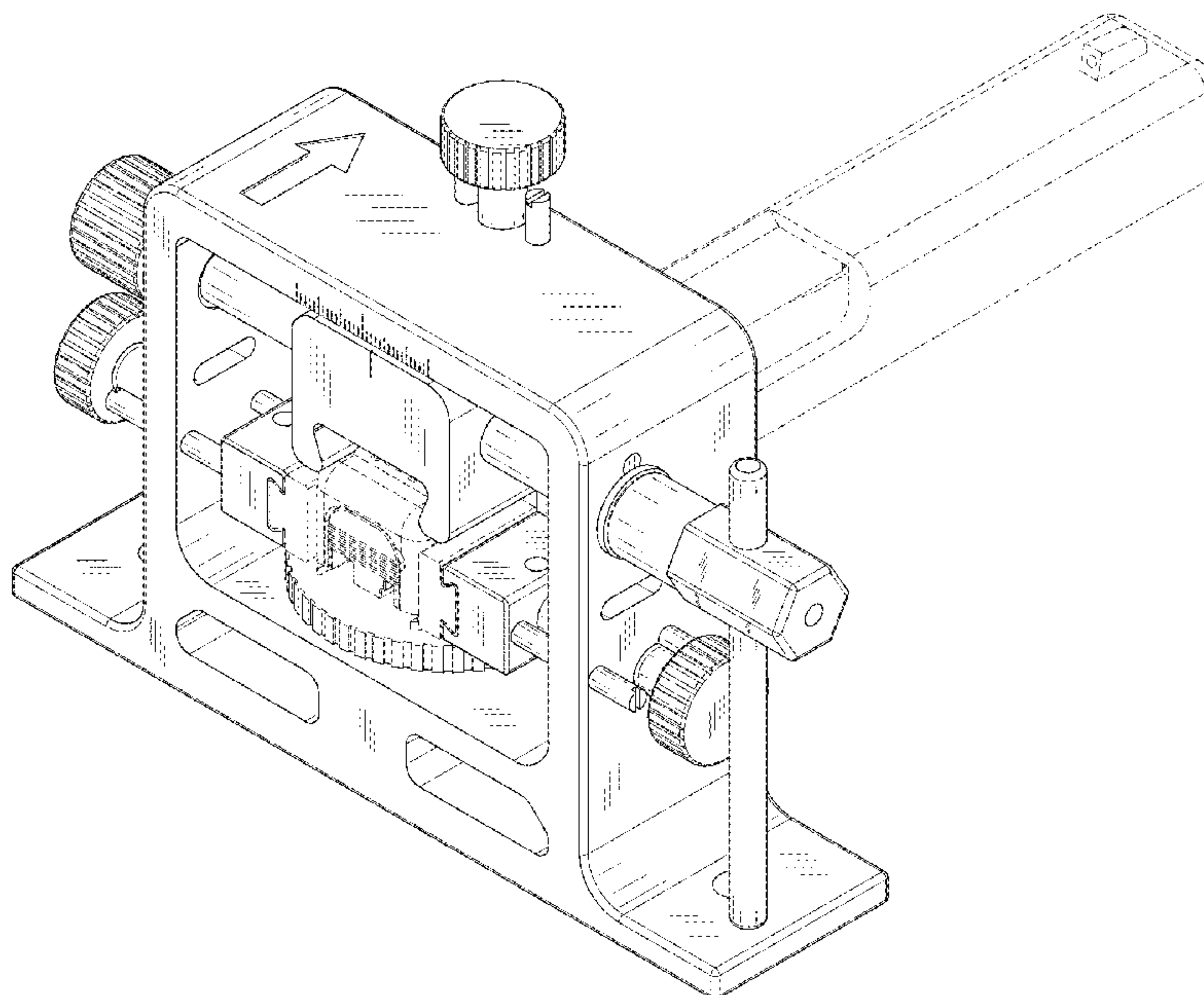
The ornamental design for a sight adjustment tool, as shown and described.

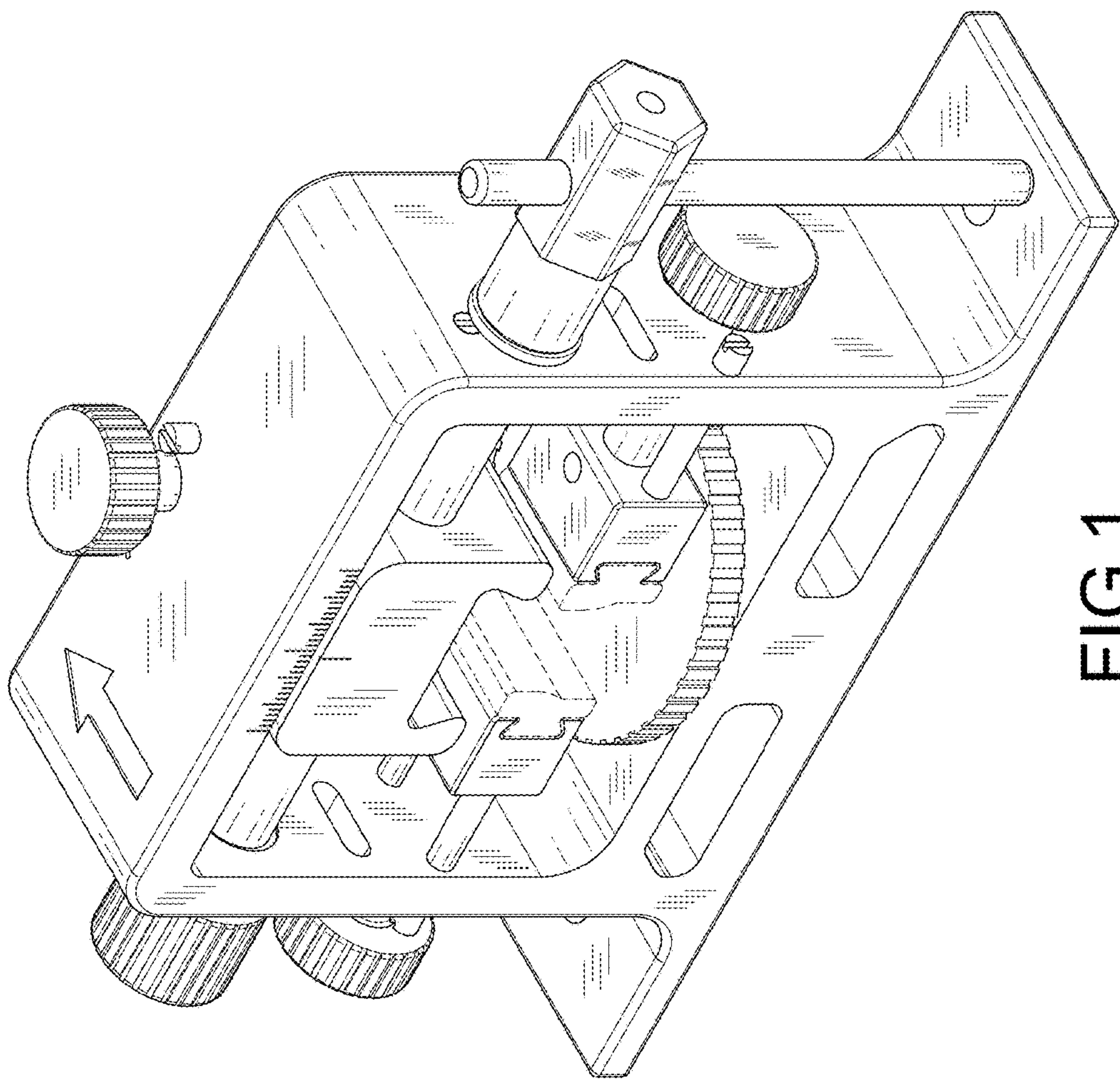

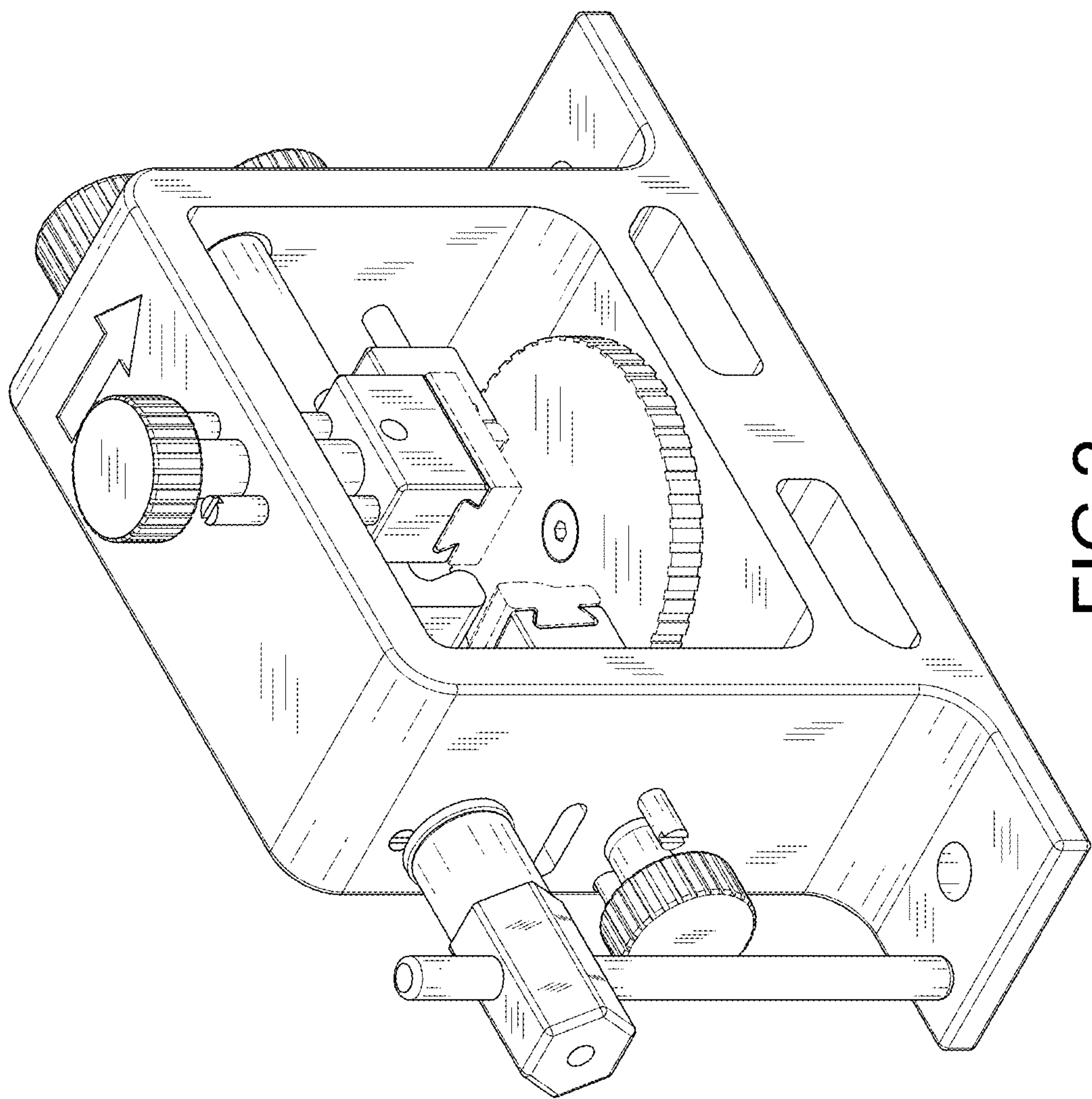

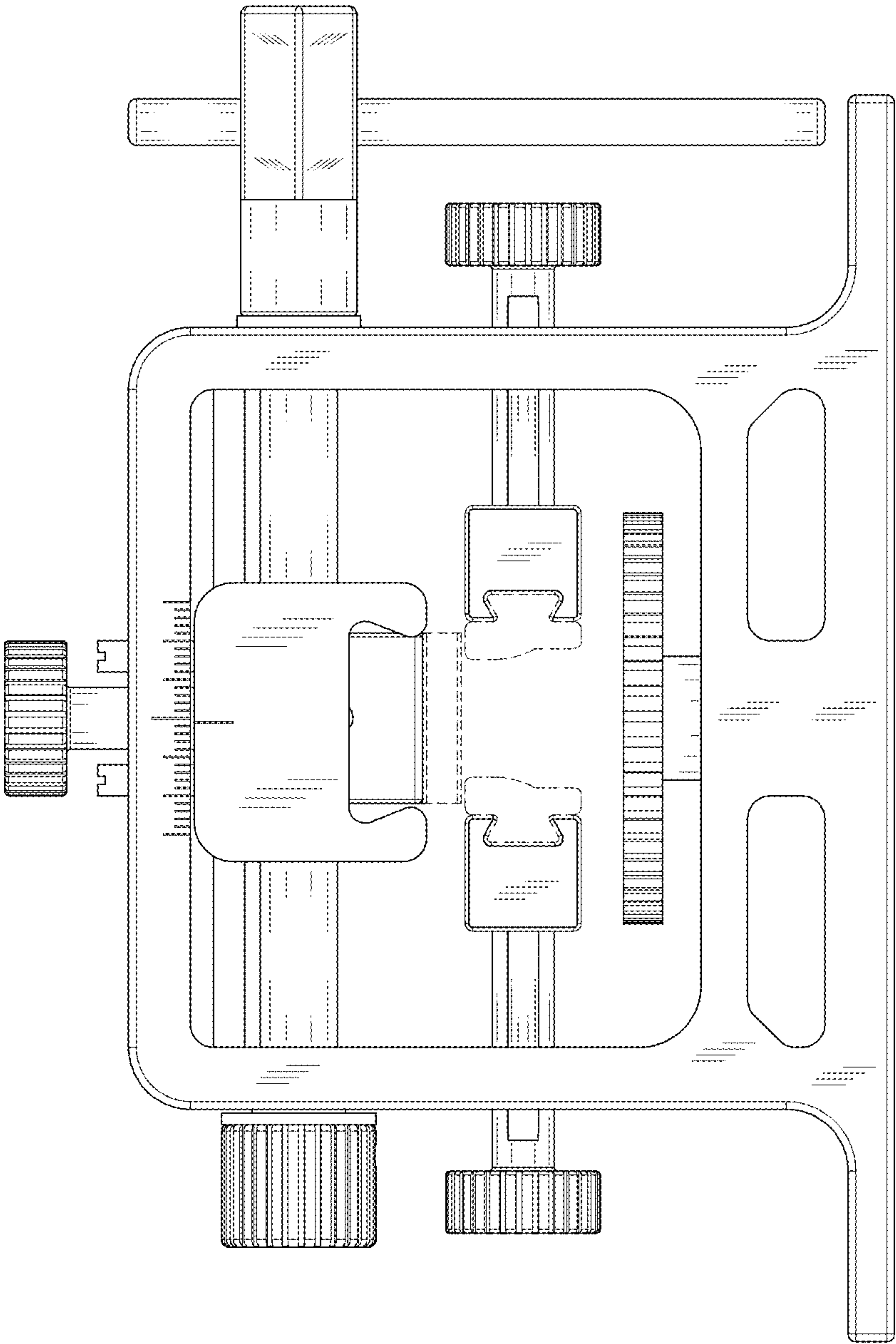

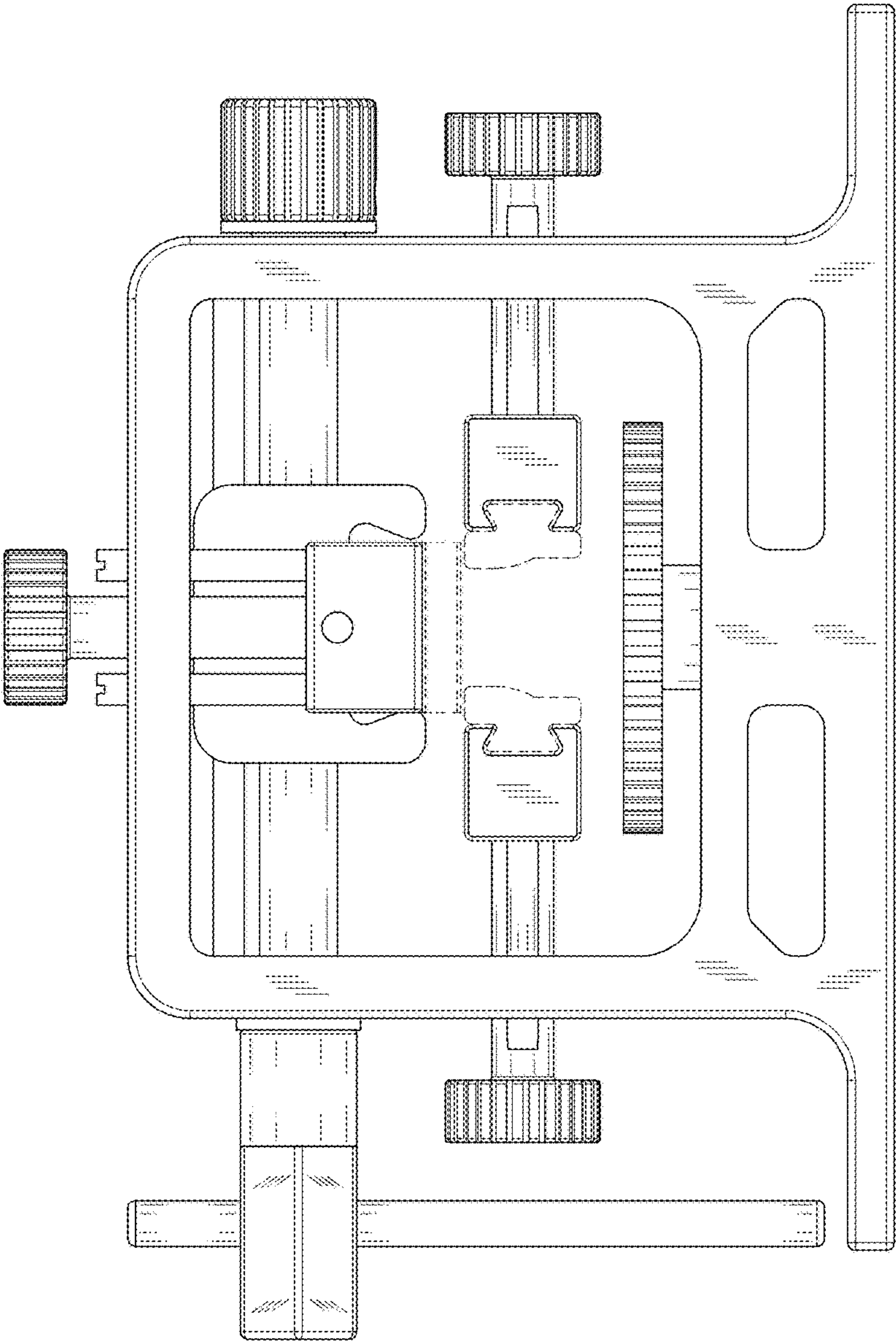

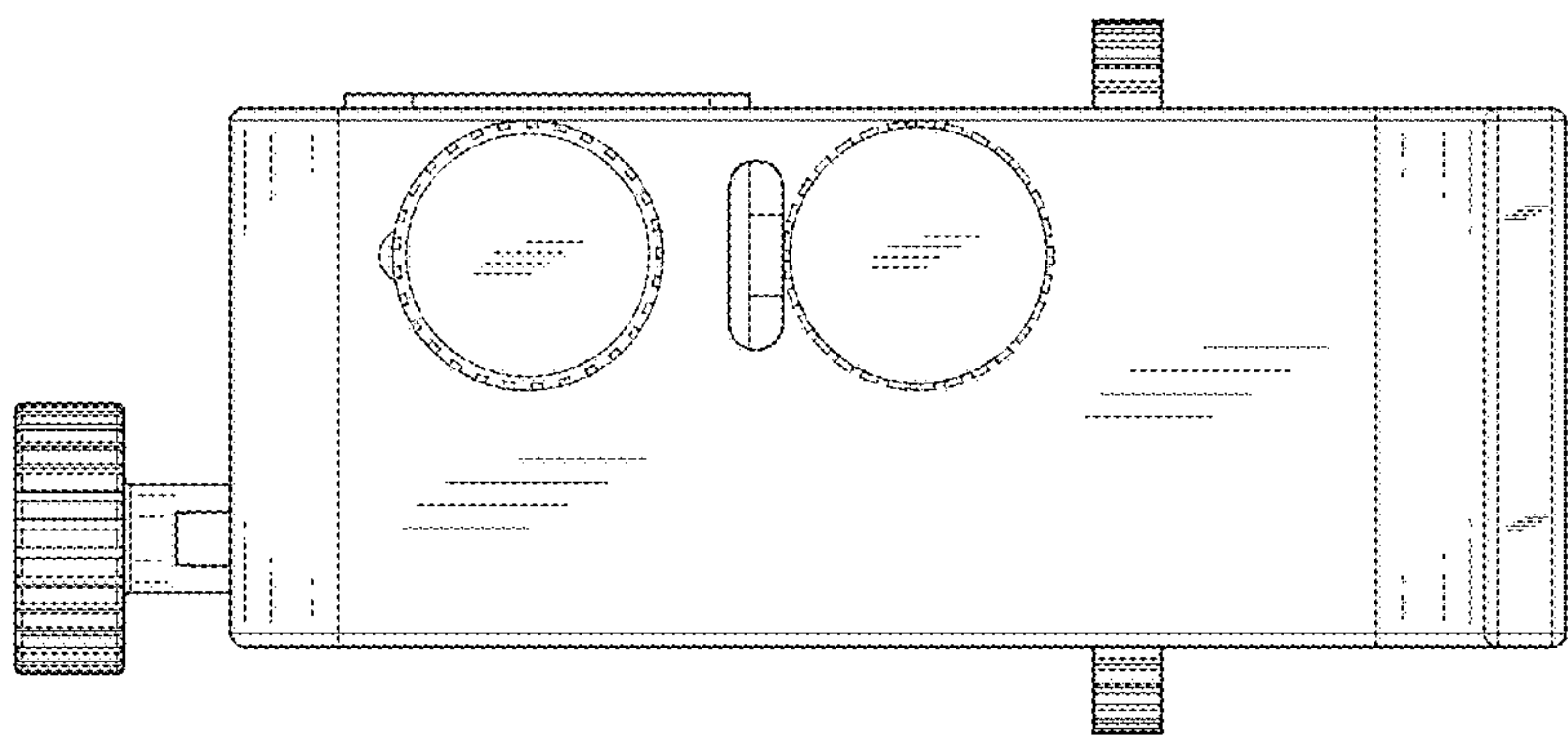

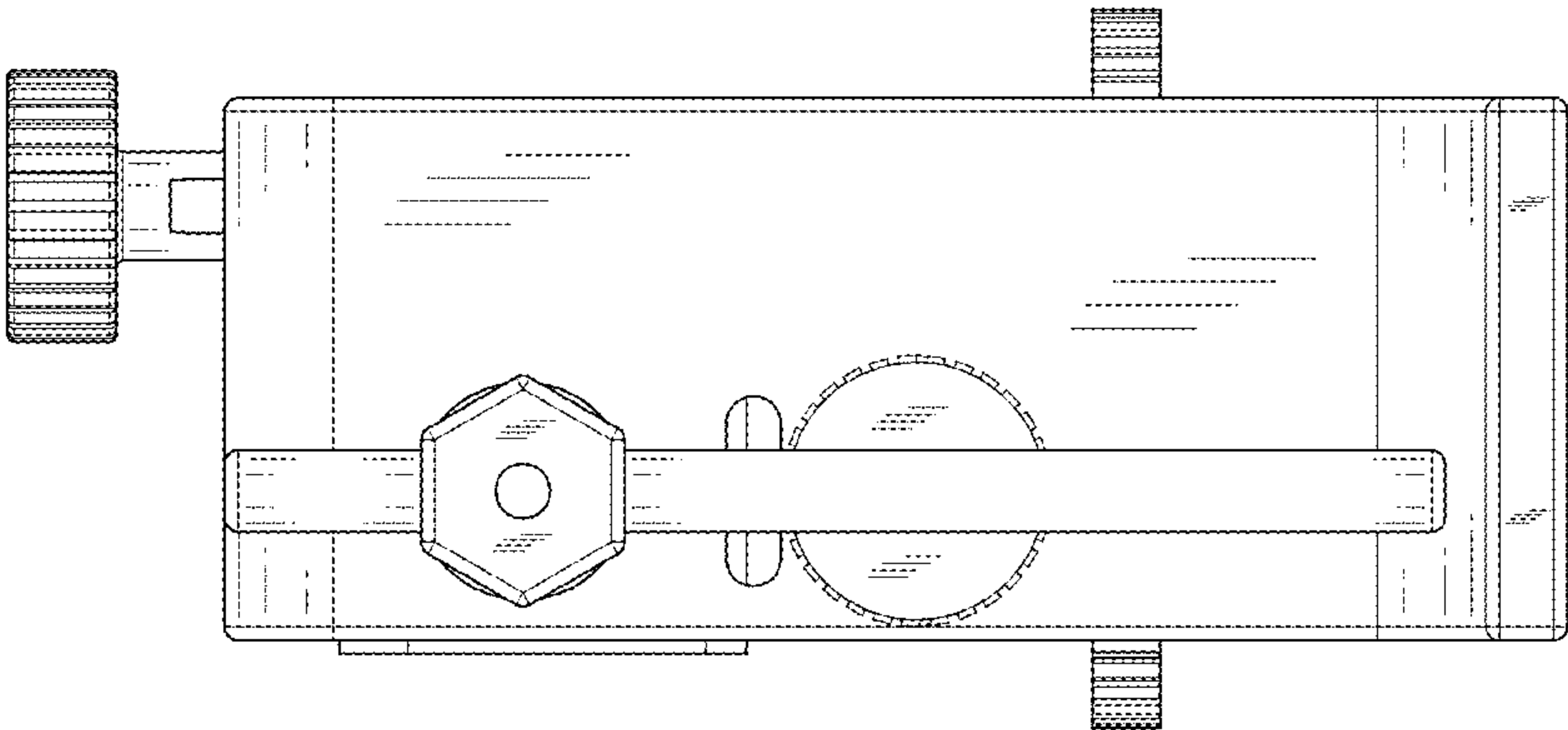

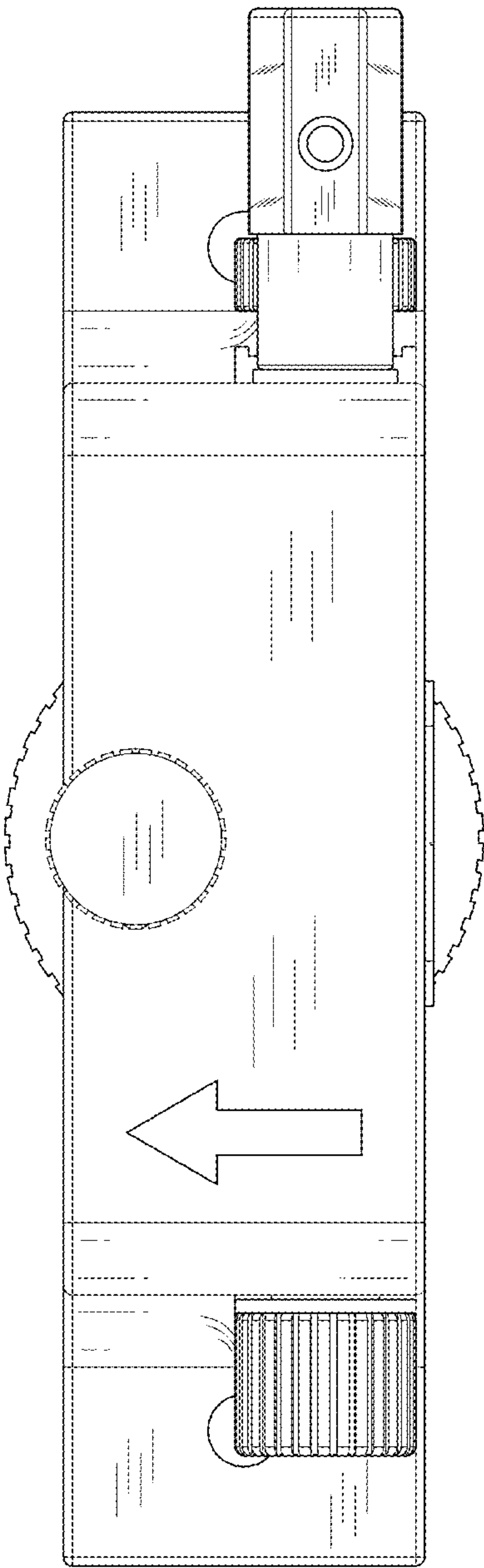

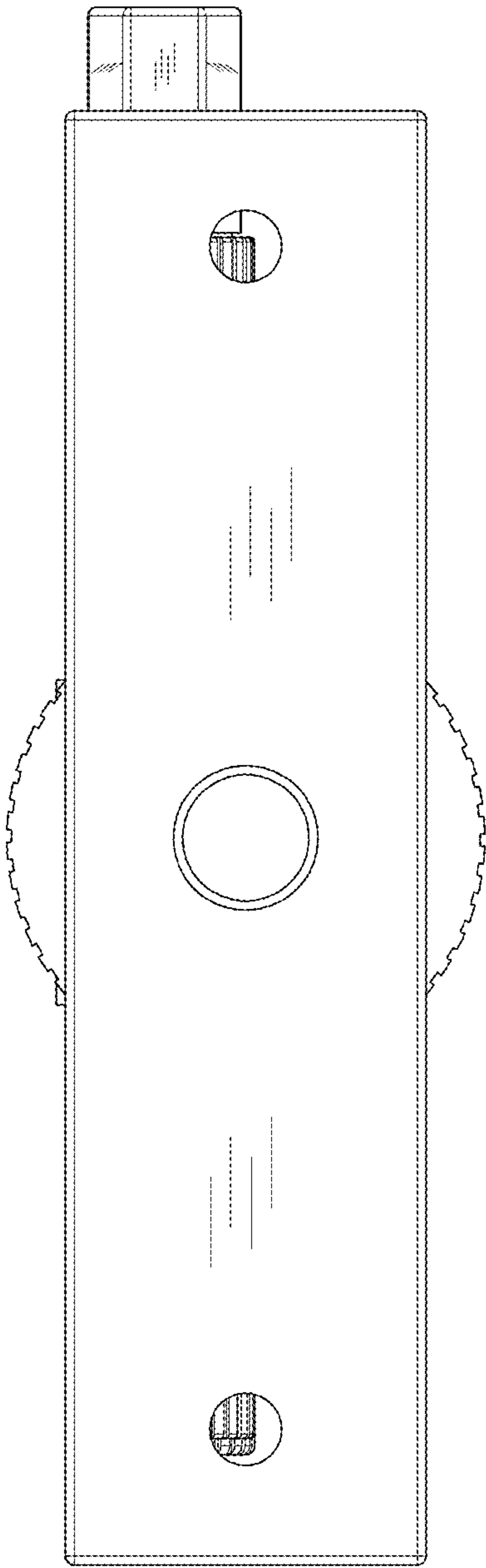

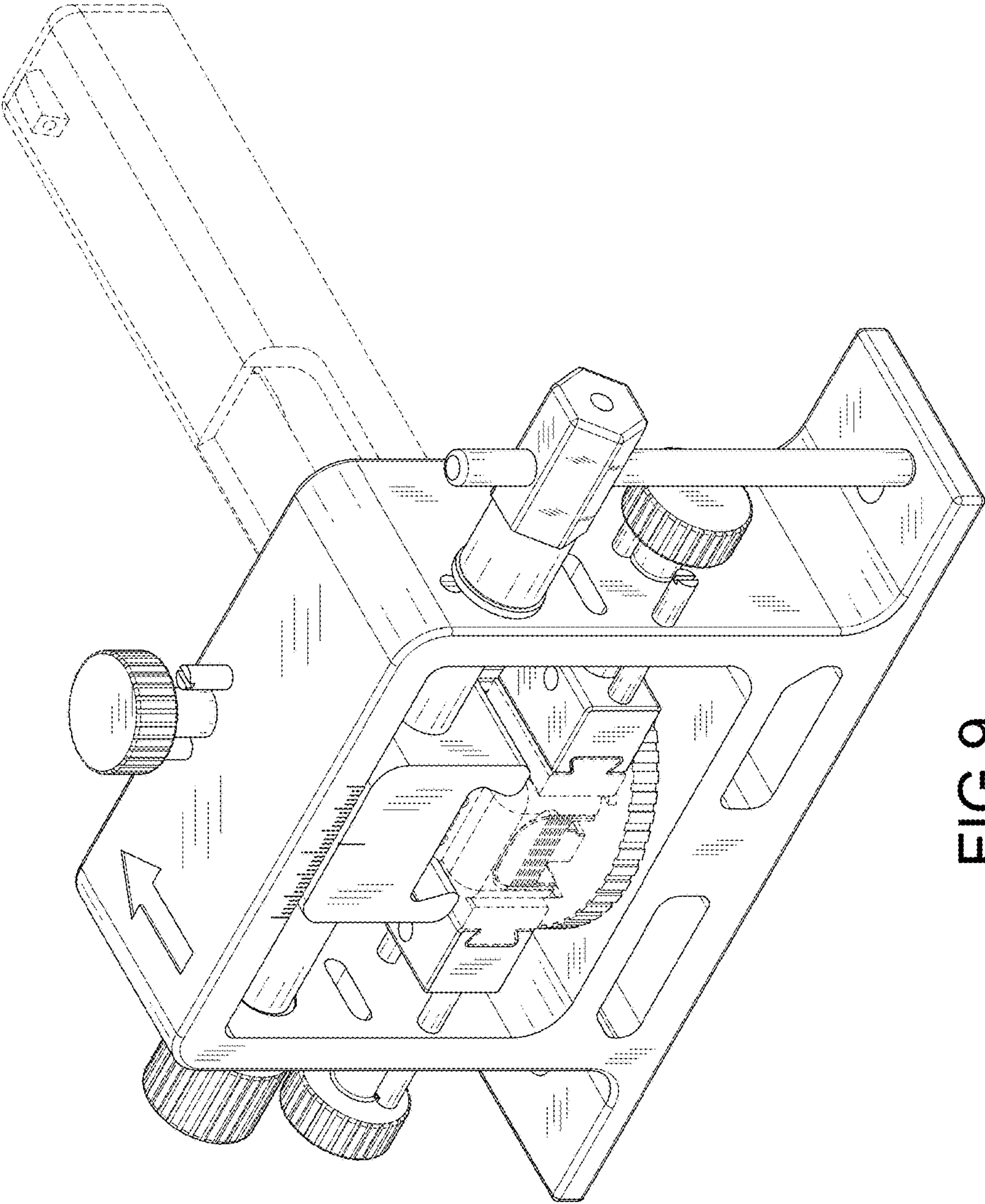
