FIG. 5 is a side view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

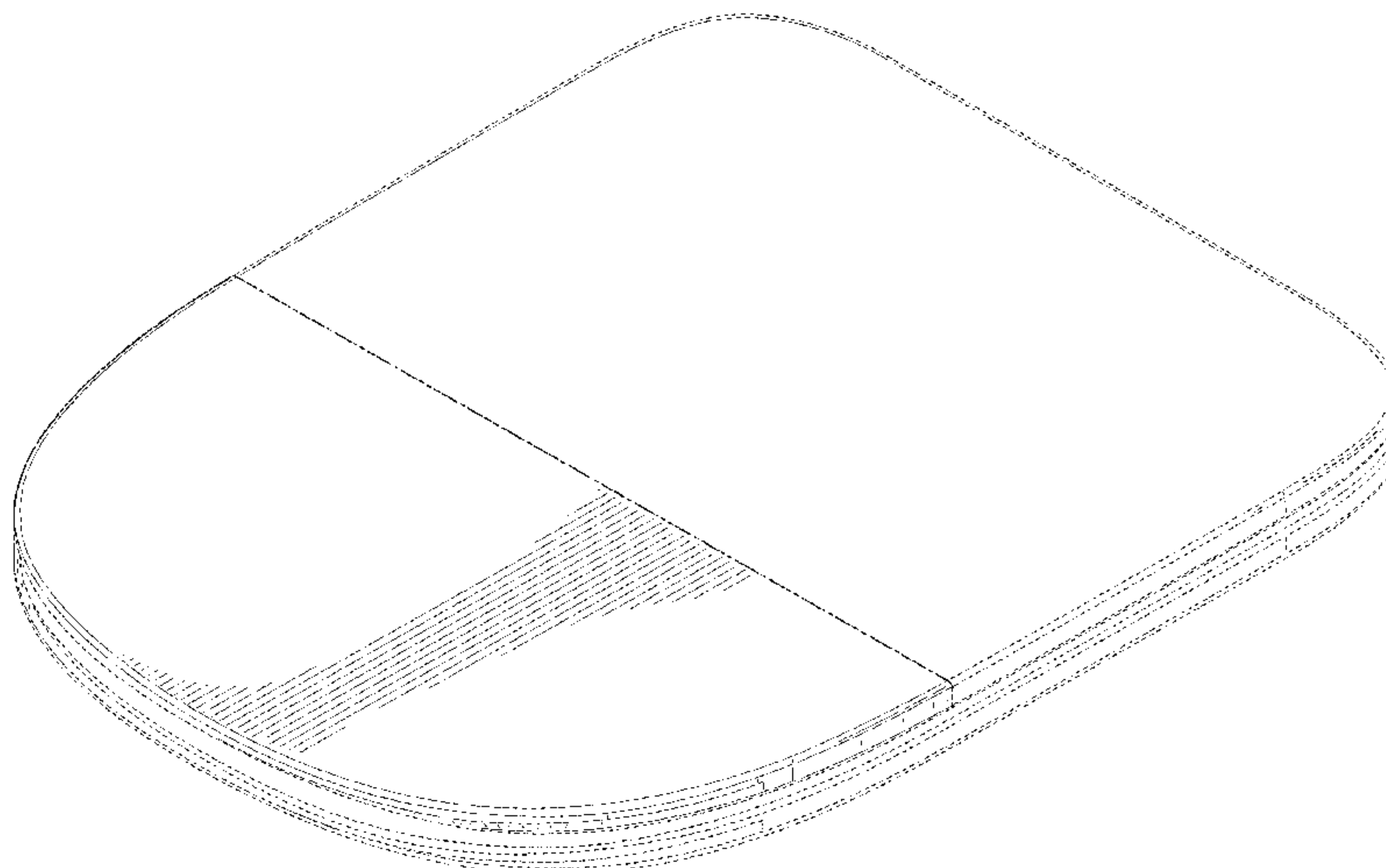
FIG. 6 is another side view of the embodiment of FIG. 1;

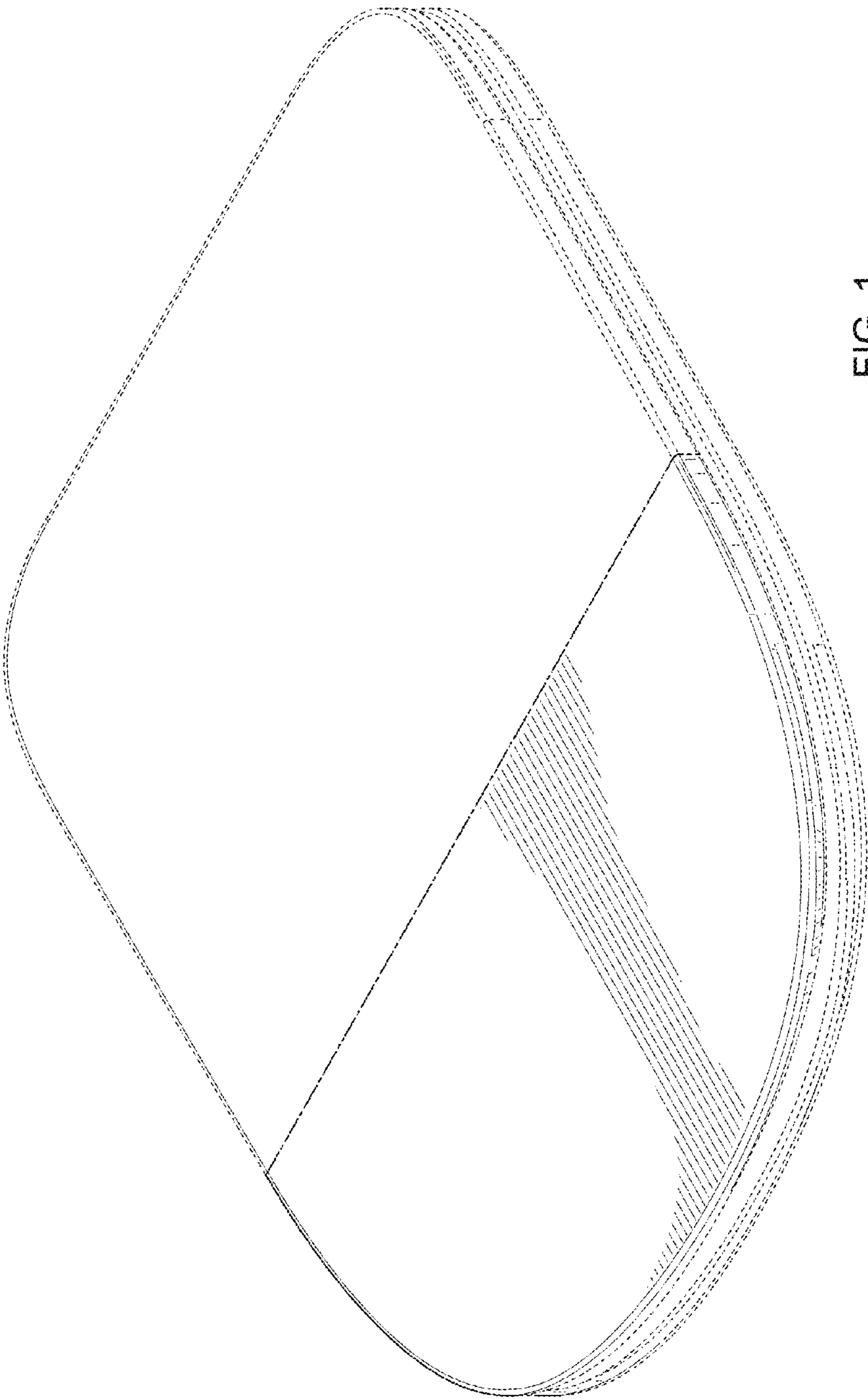
FIG. 7 is a top view of the embodiment of FIG. 1; and,

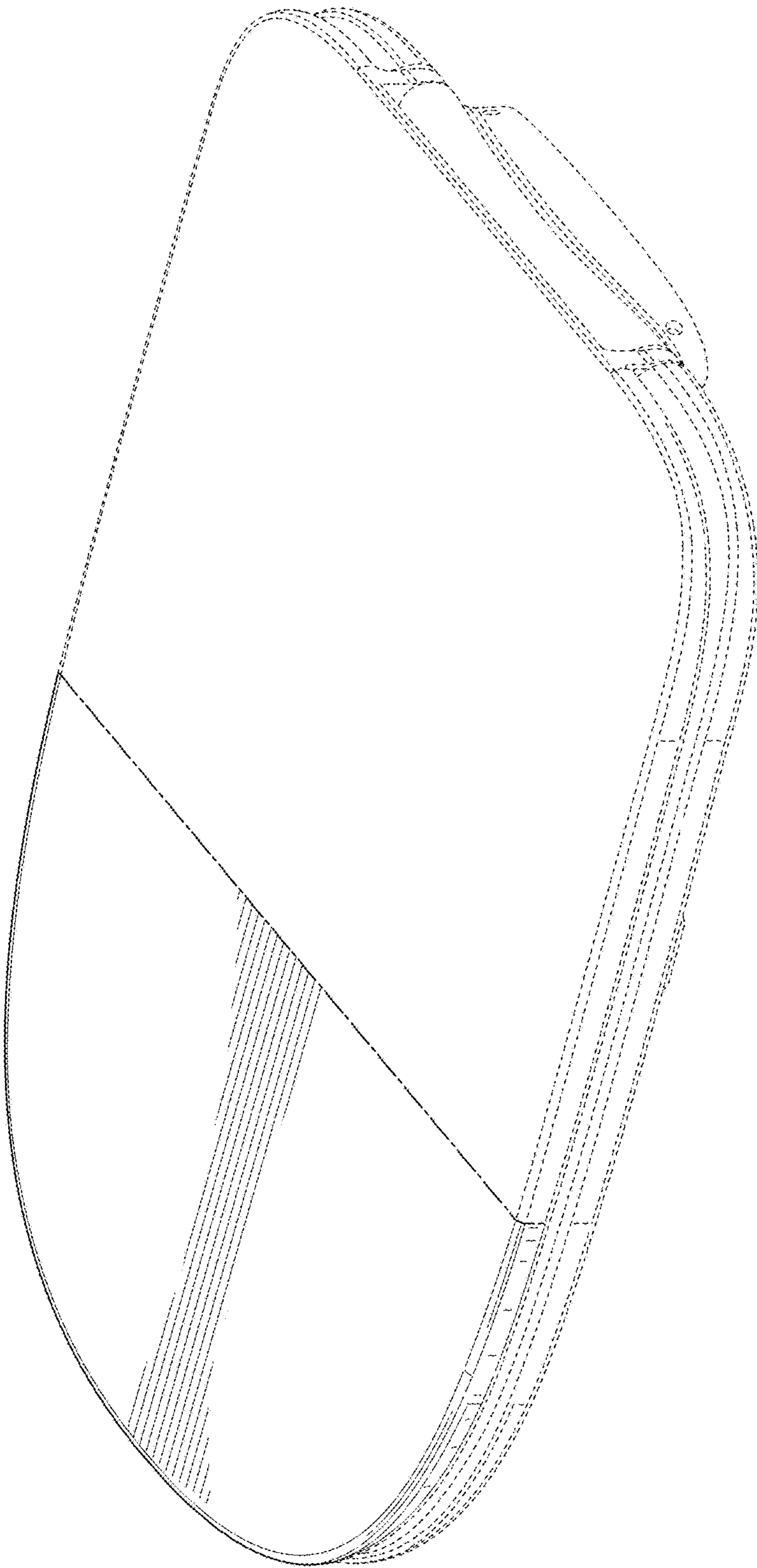

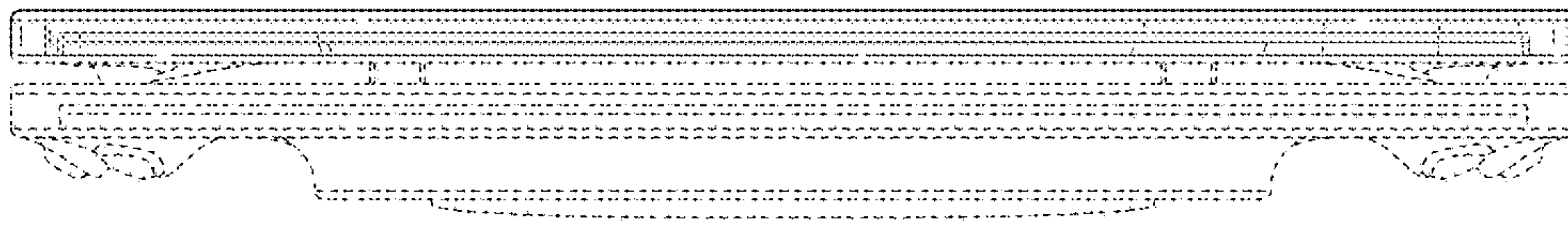

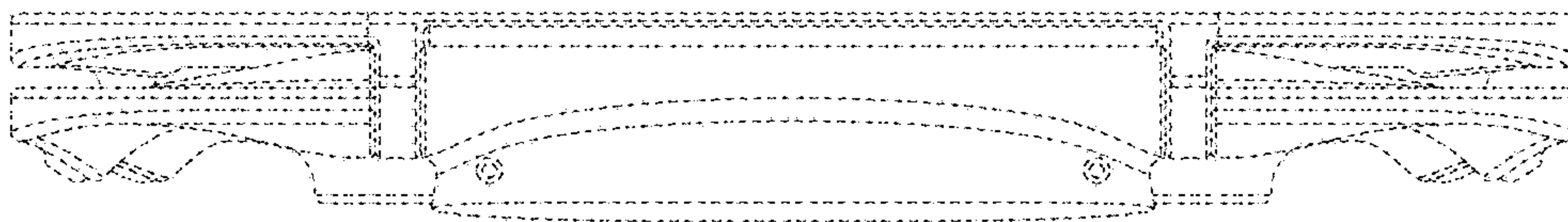

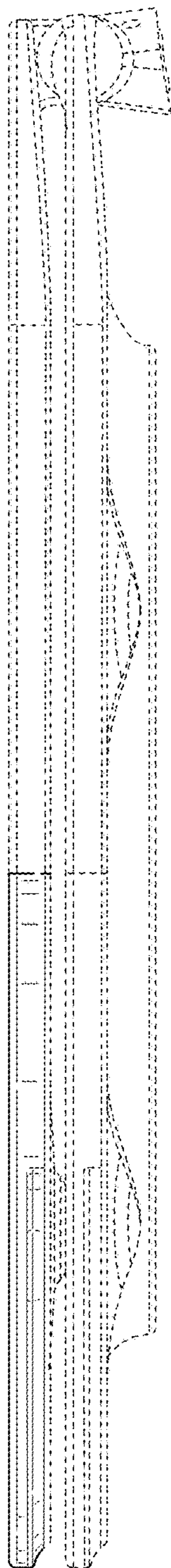

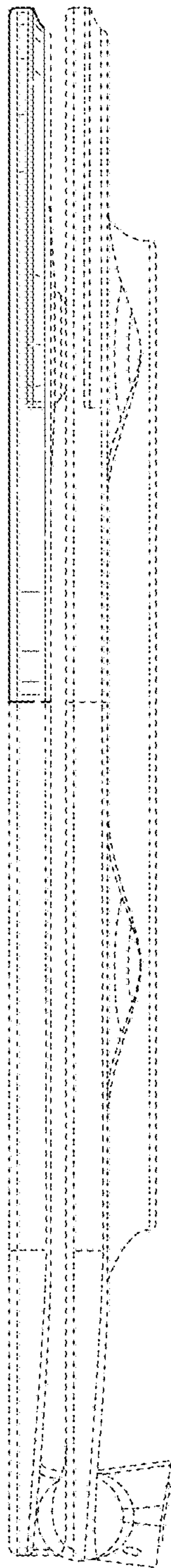

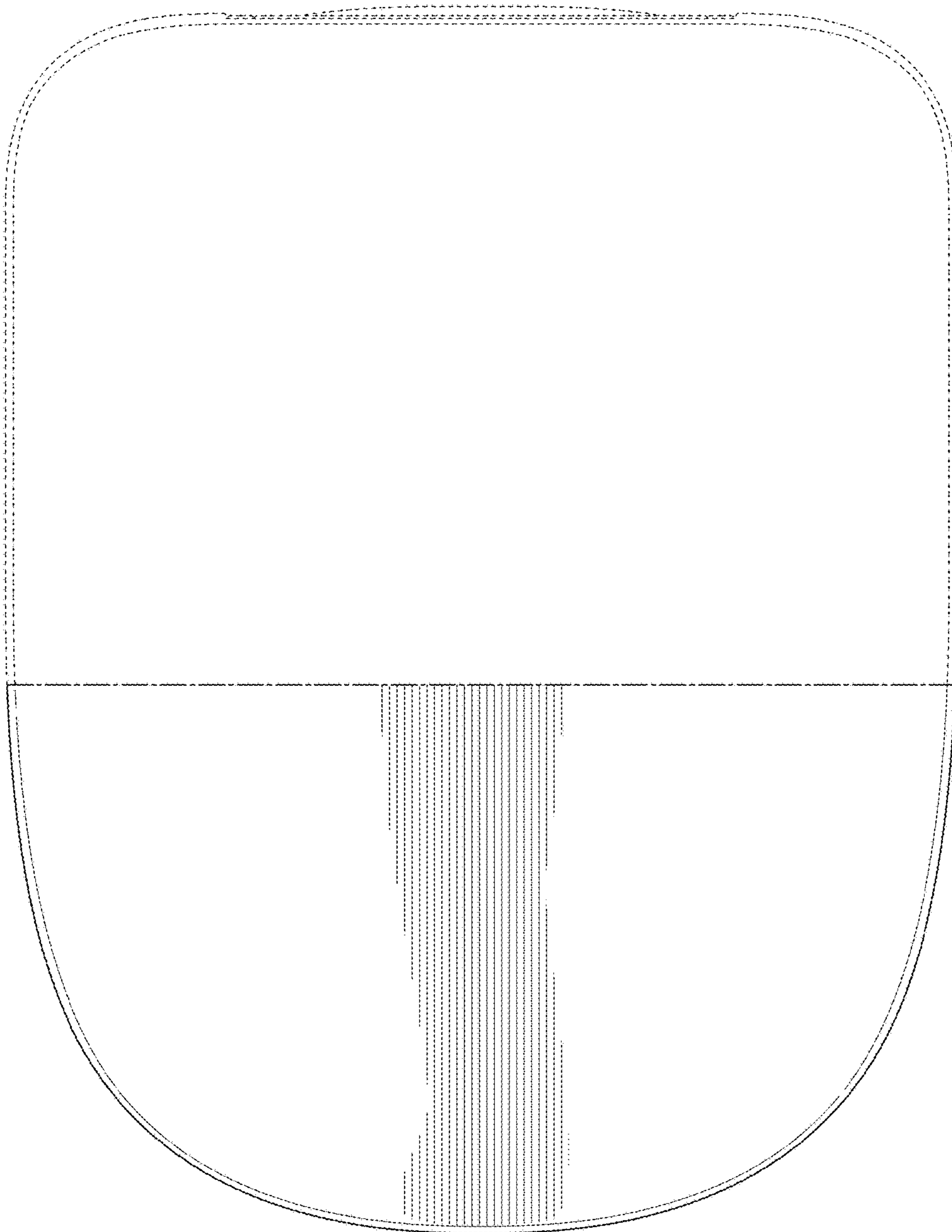

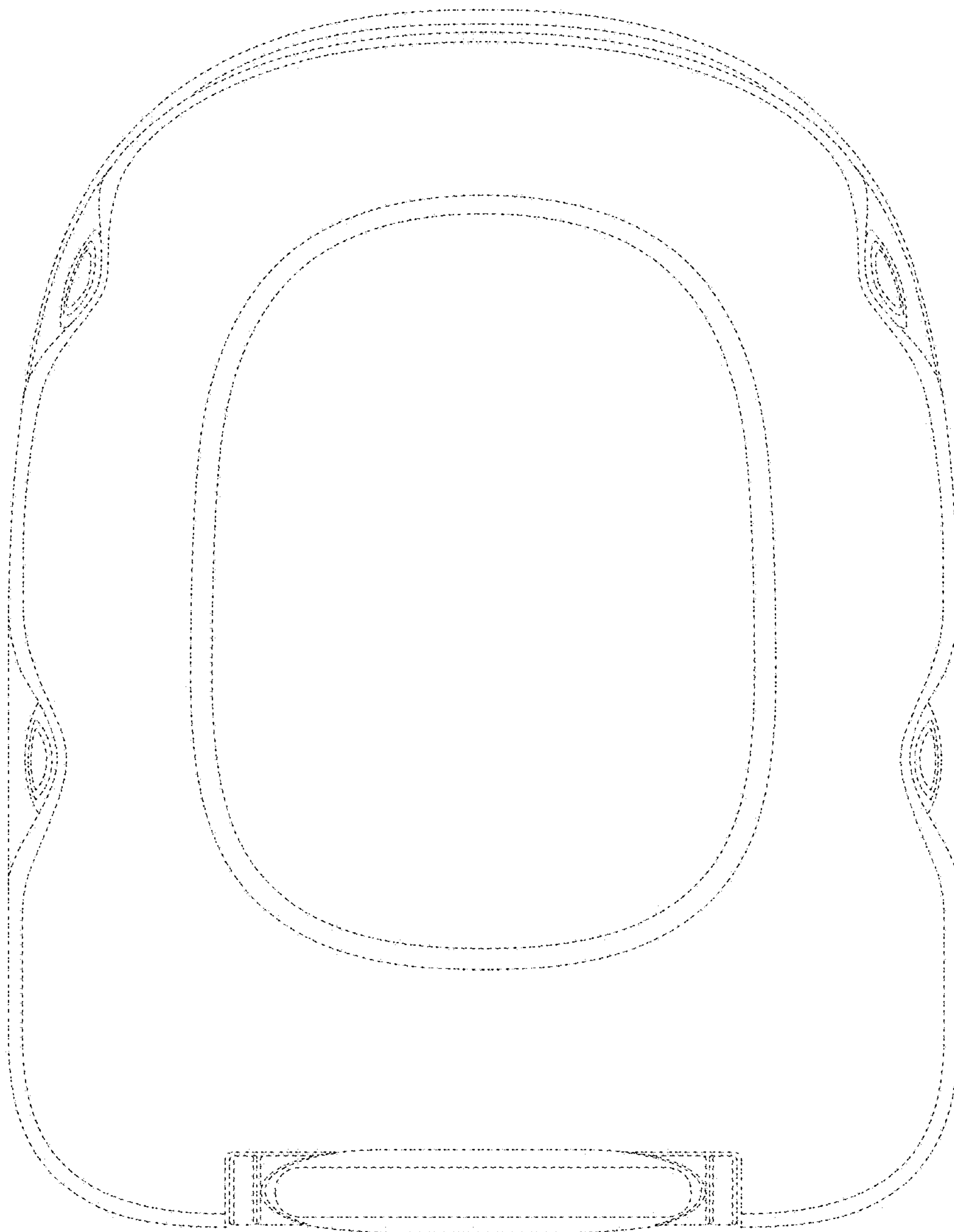
