FIG. 5 is a second side view thereof.

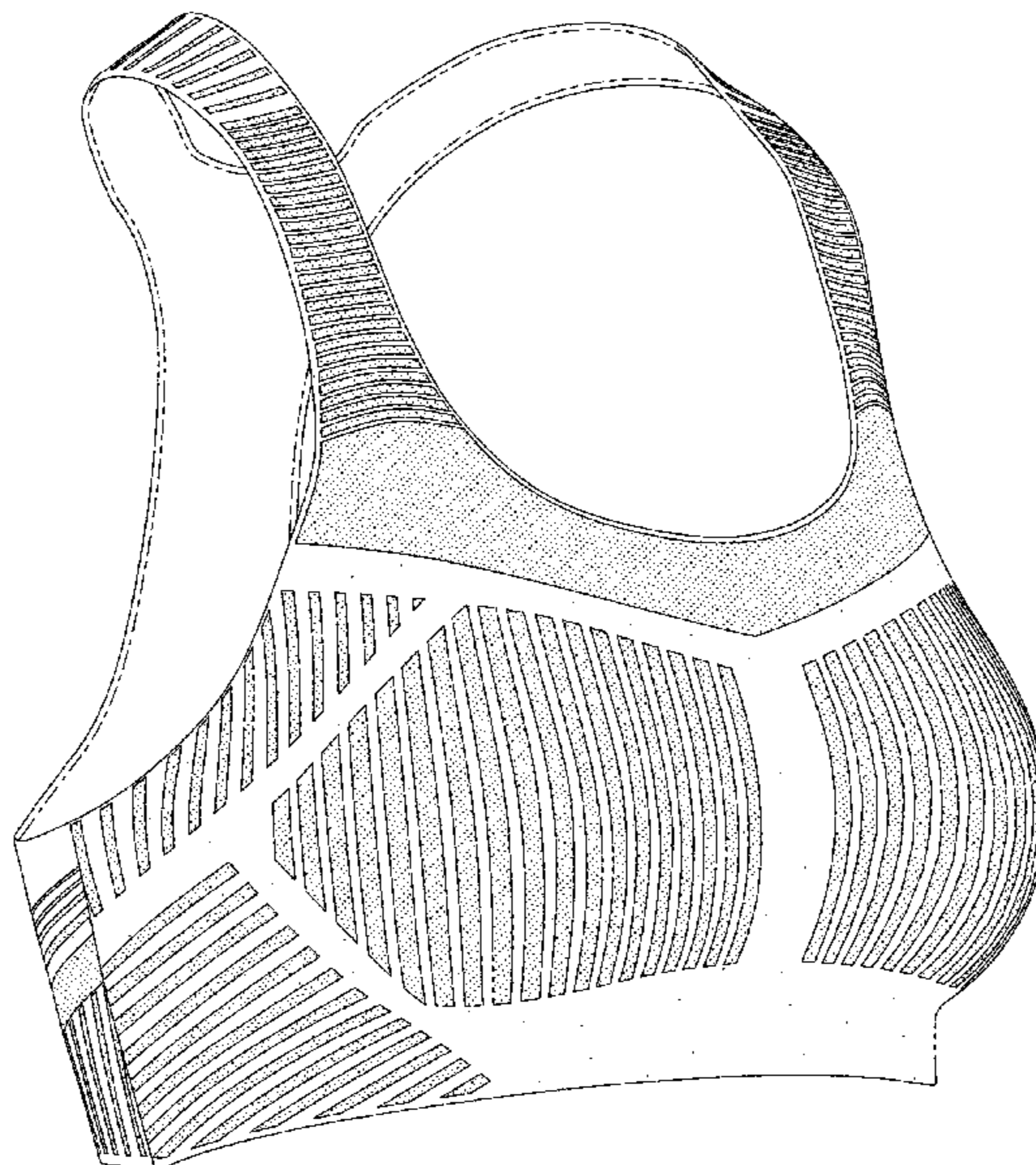

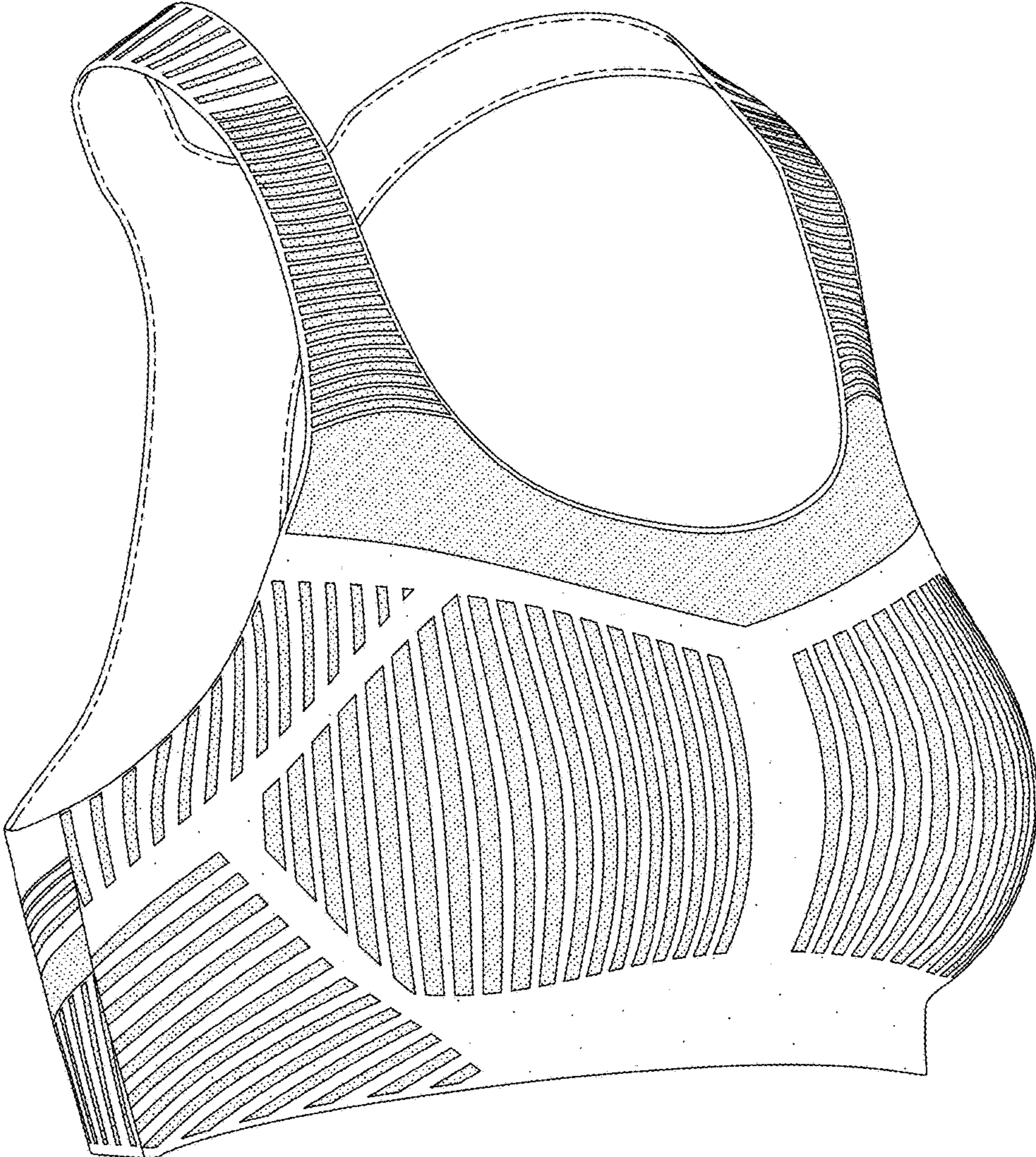

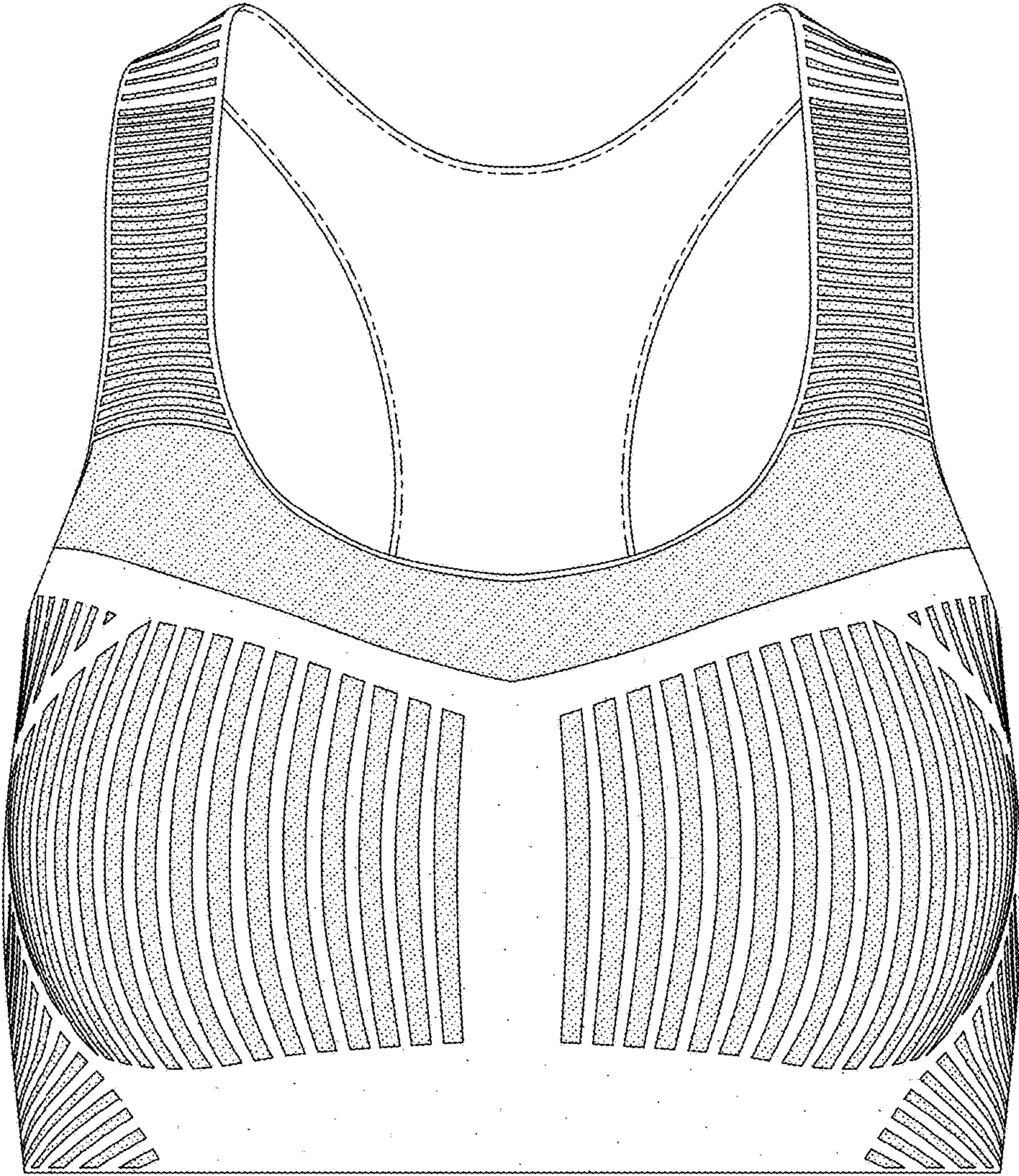

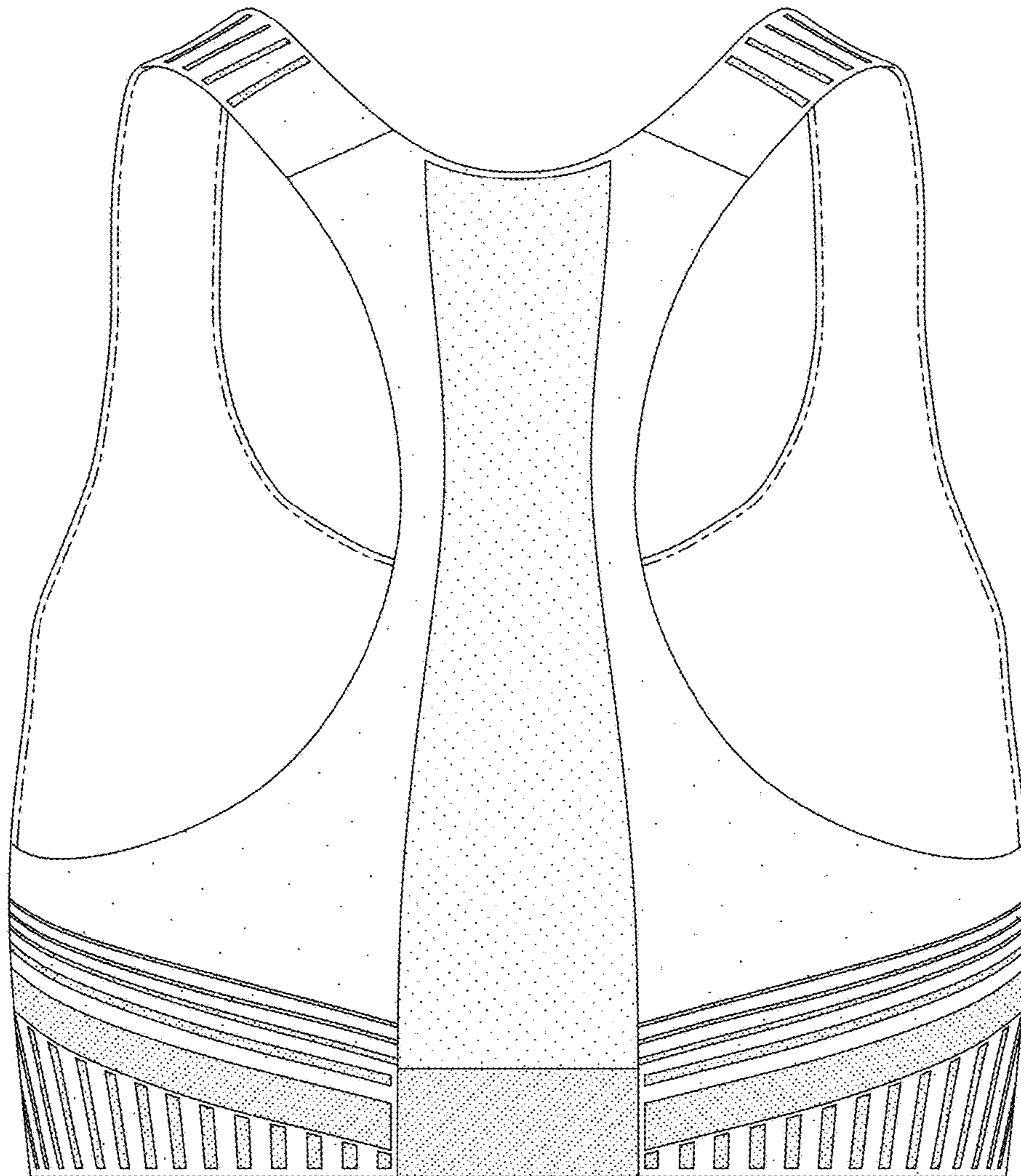

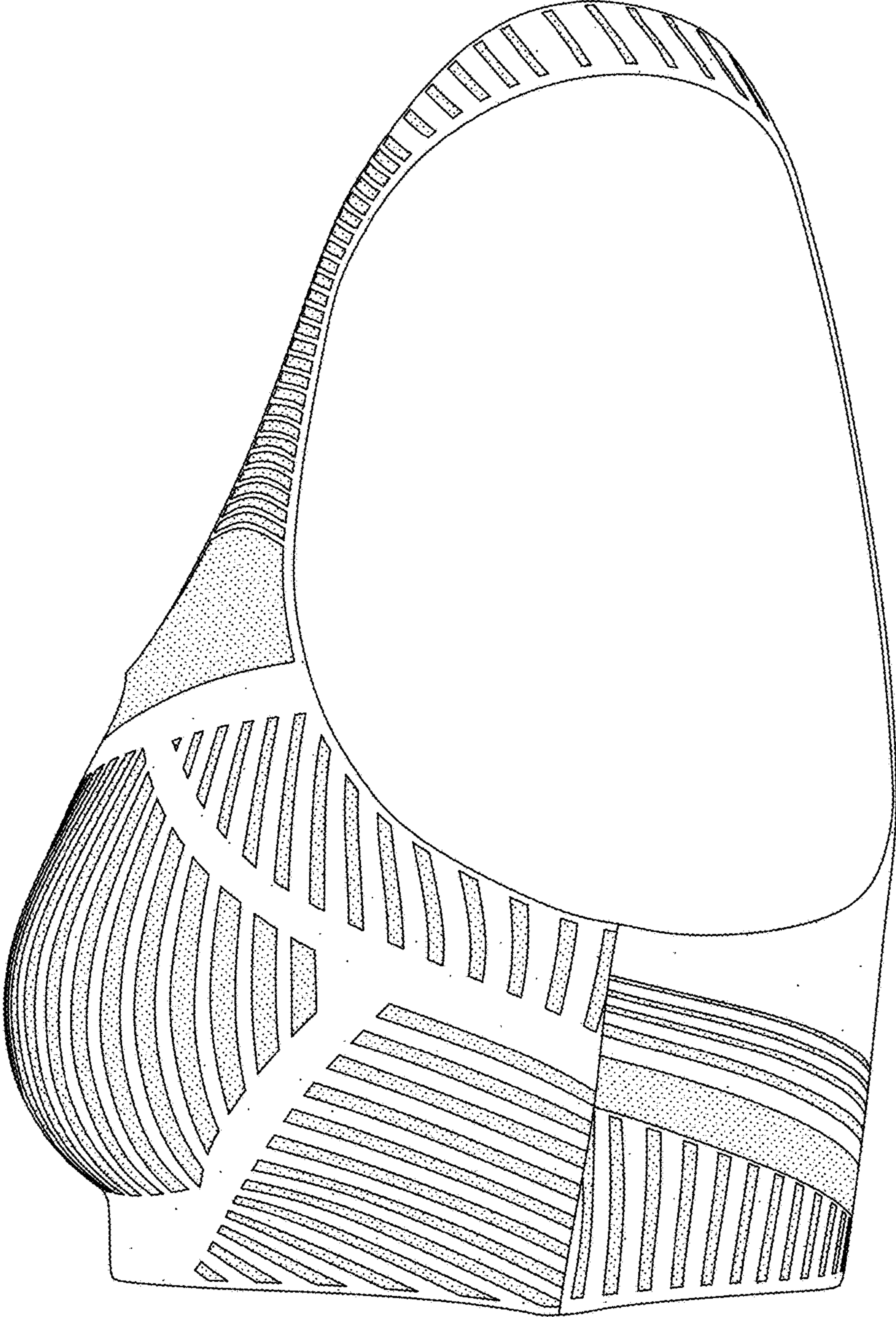

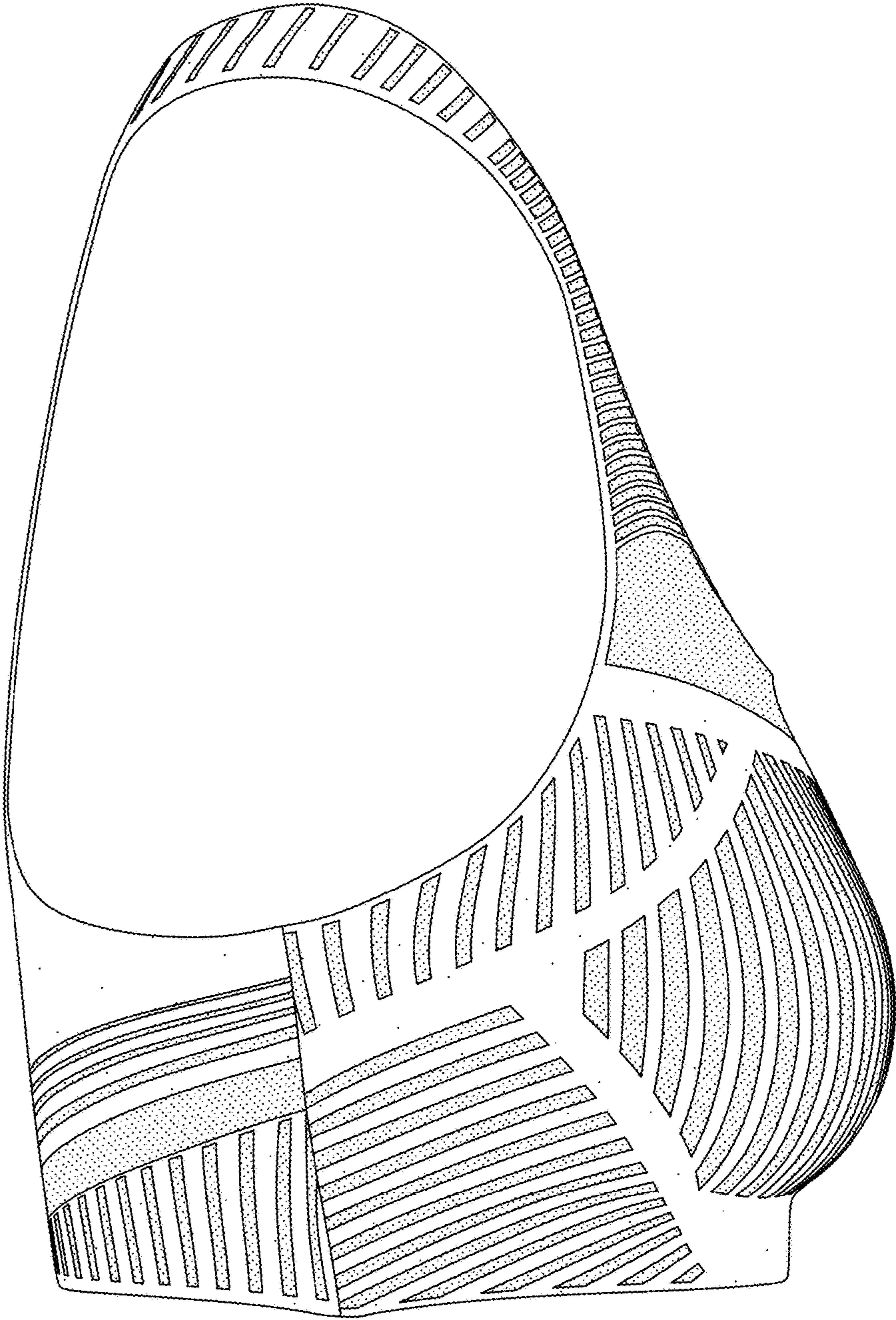
