(57) **CLAIM**

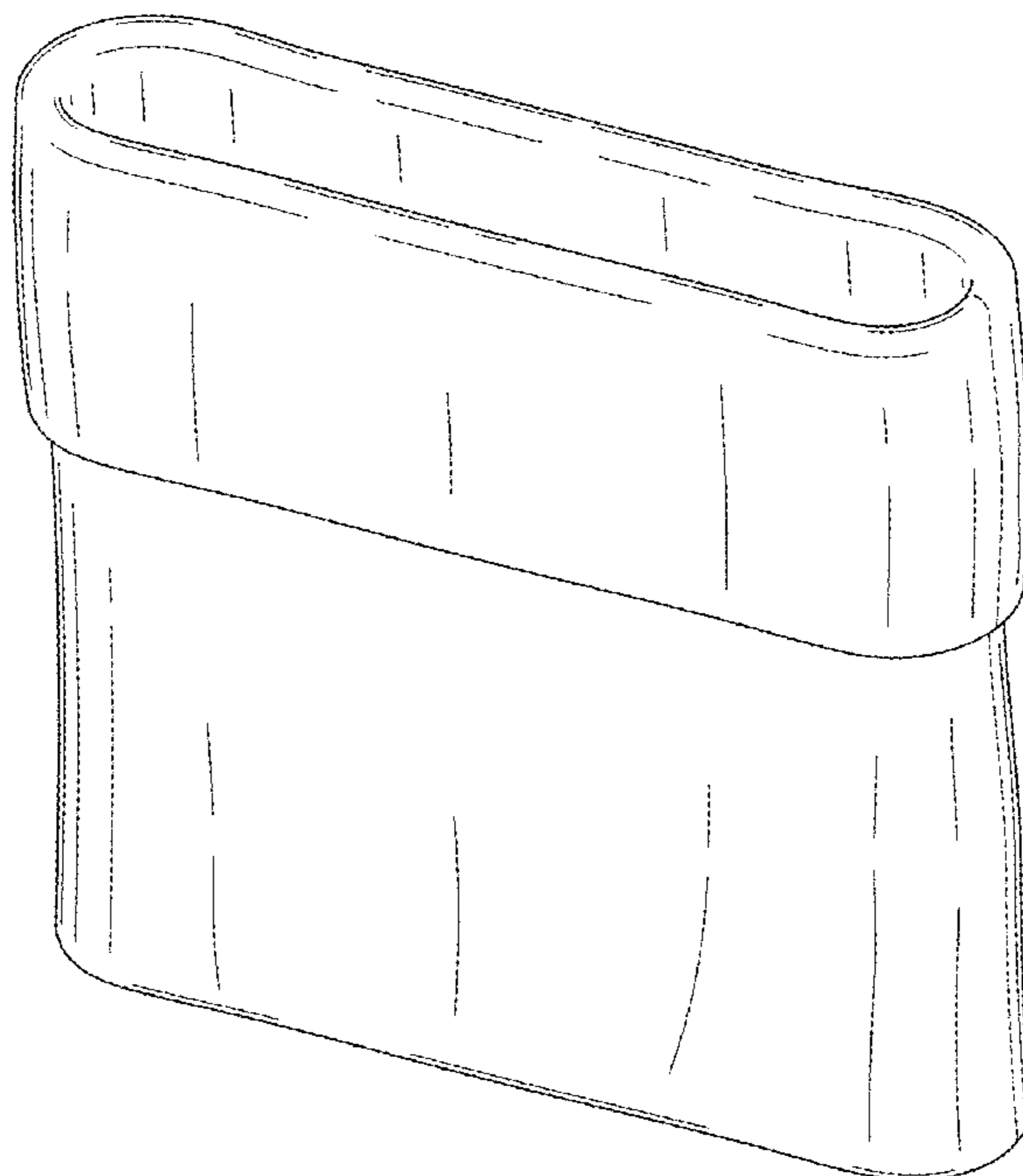
The ornamental design for a wearable blanket, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

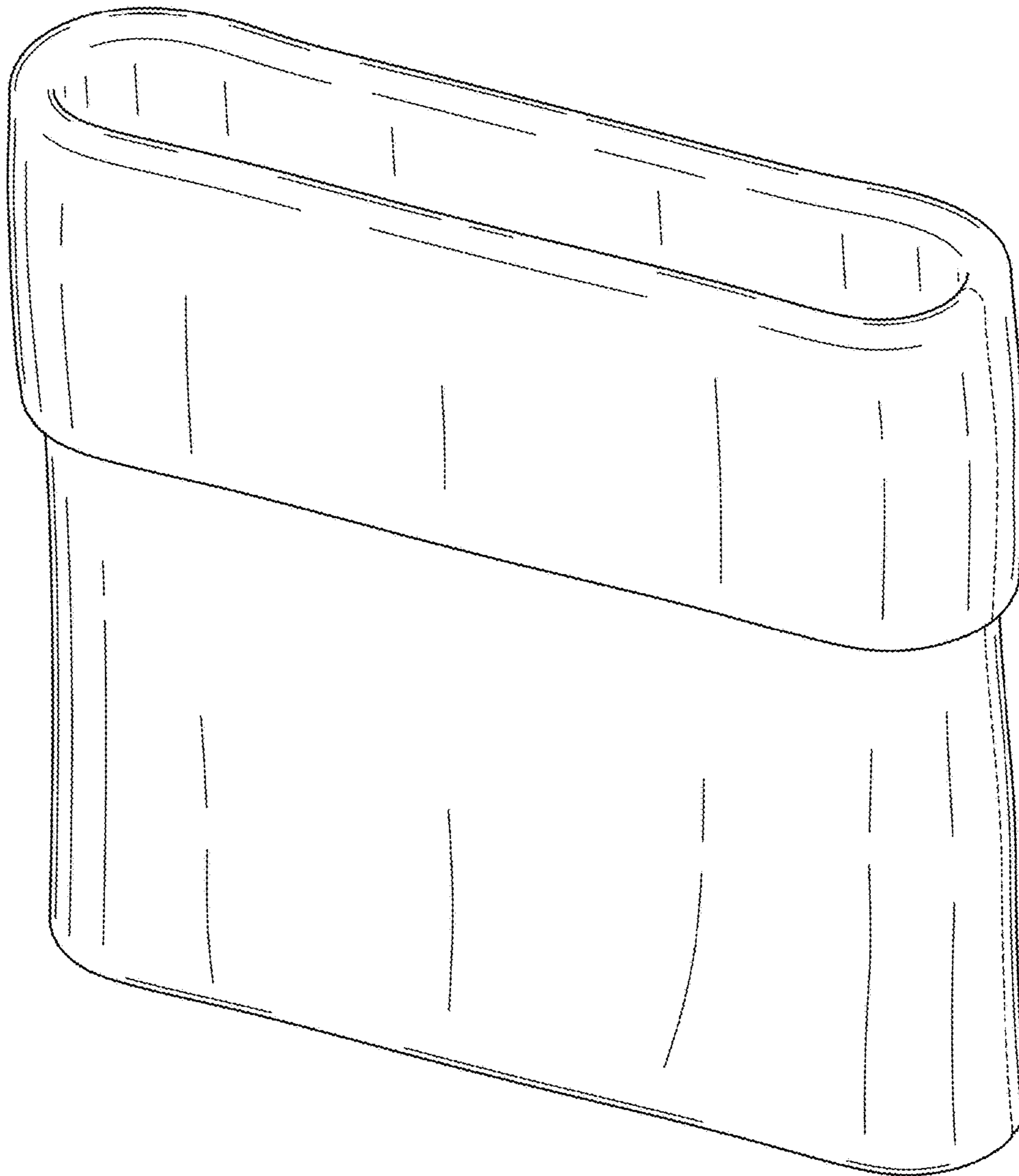

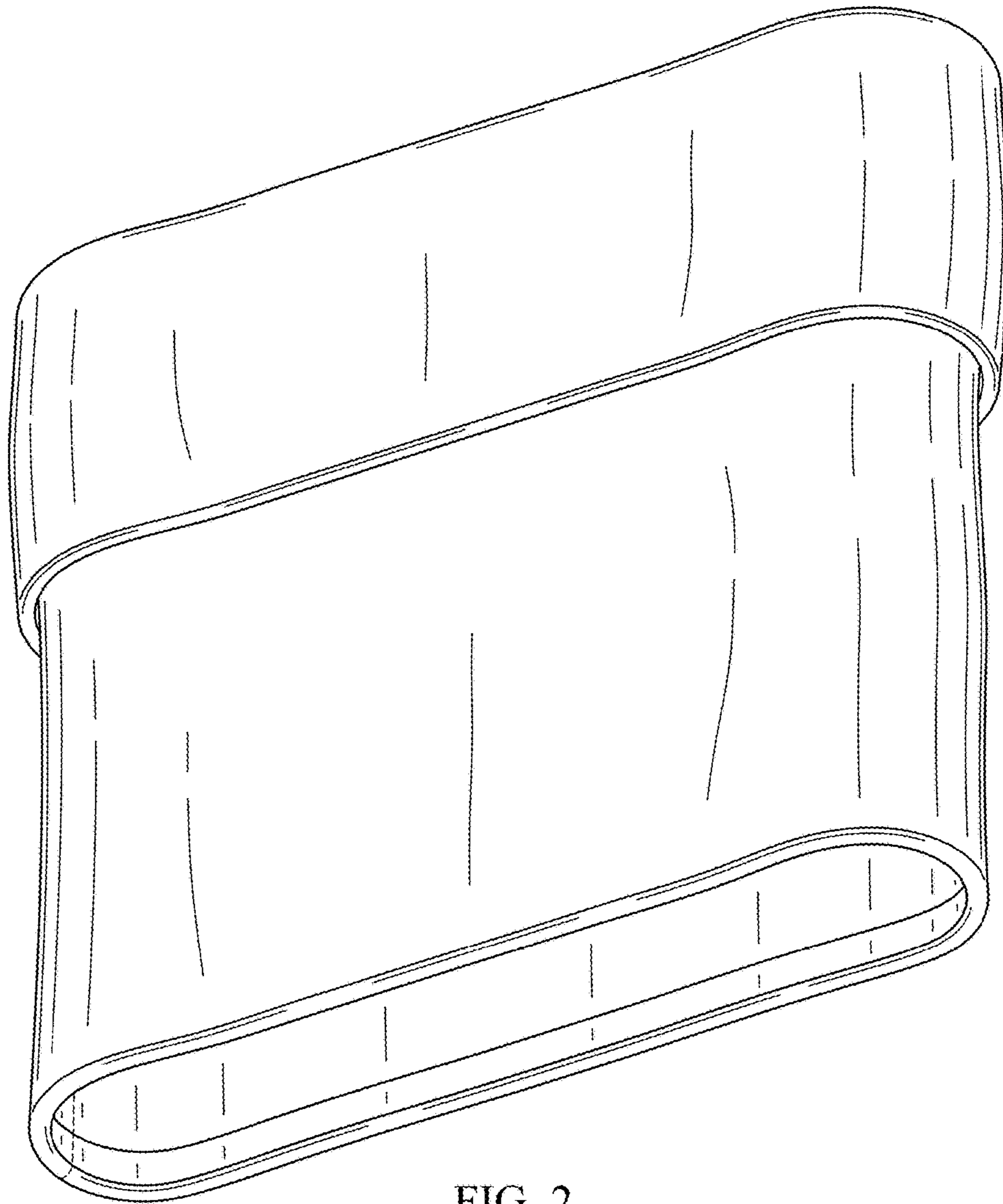

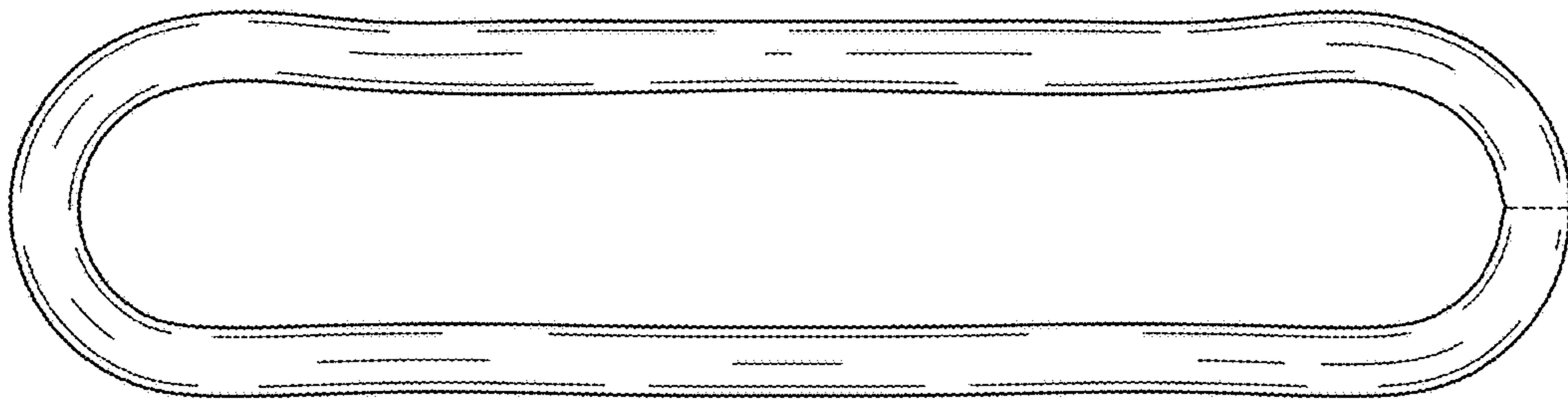

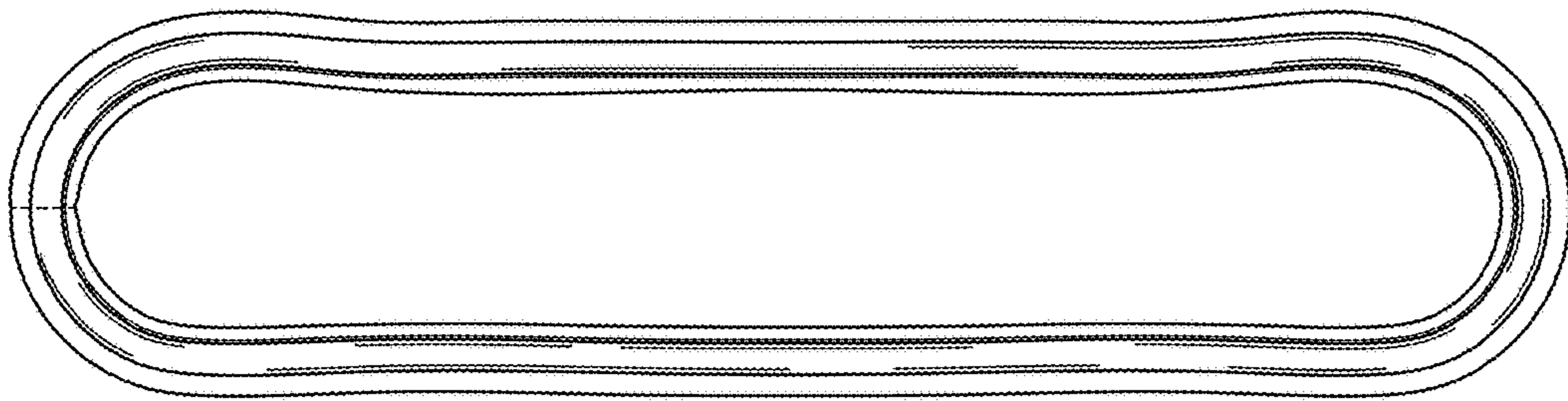

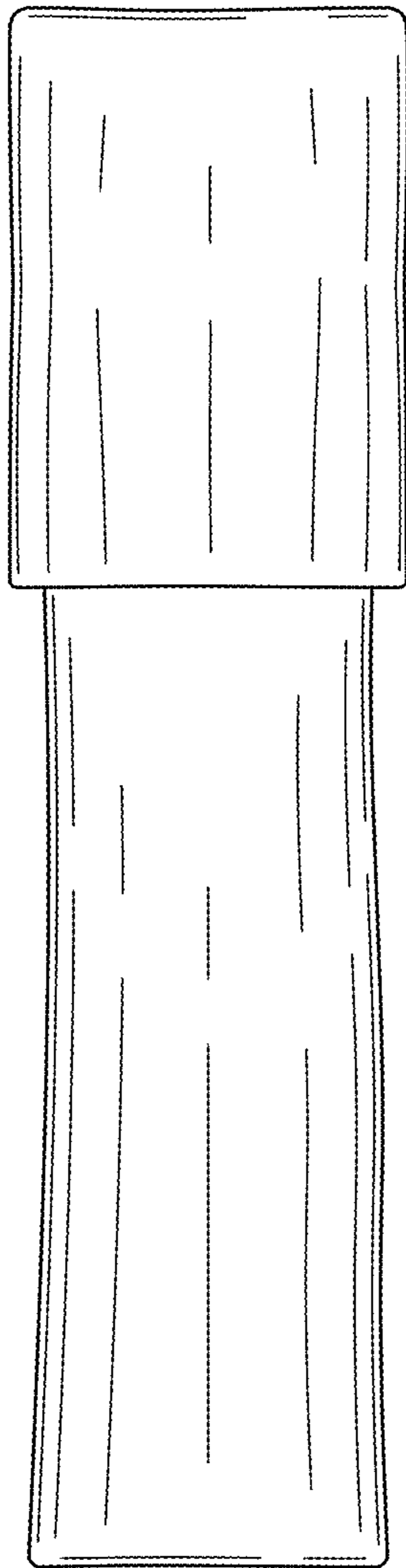

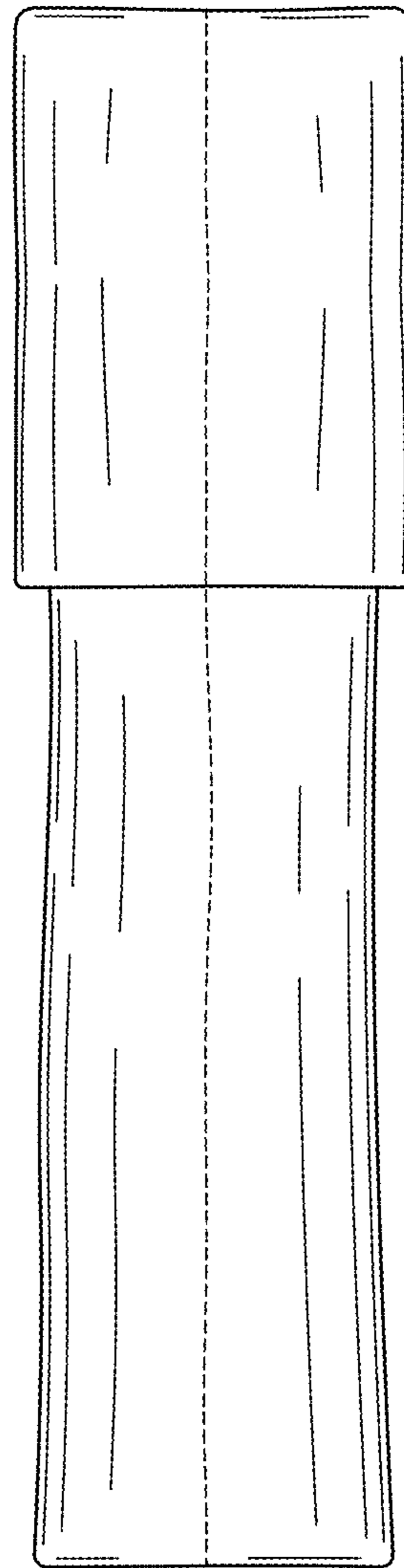

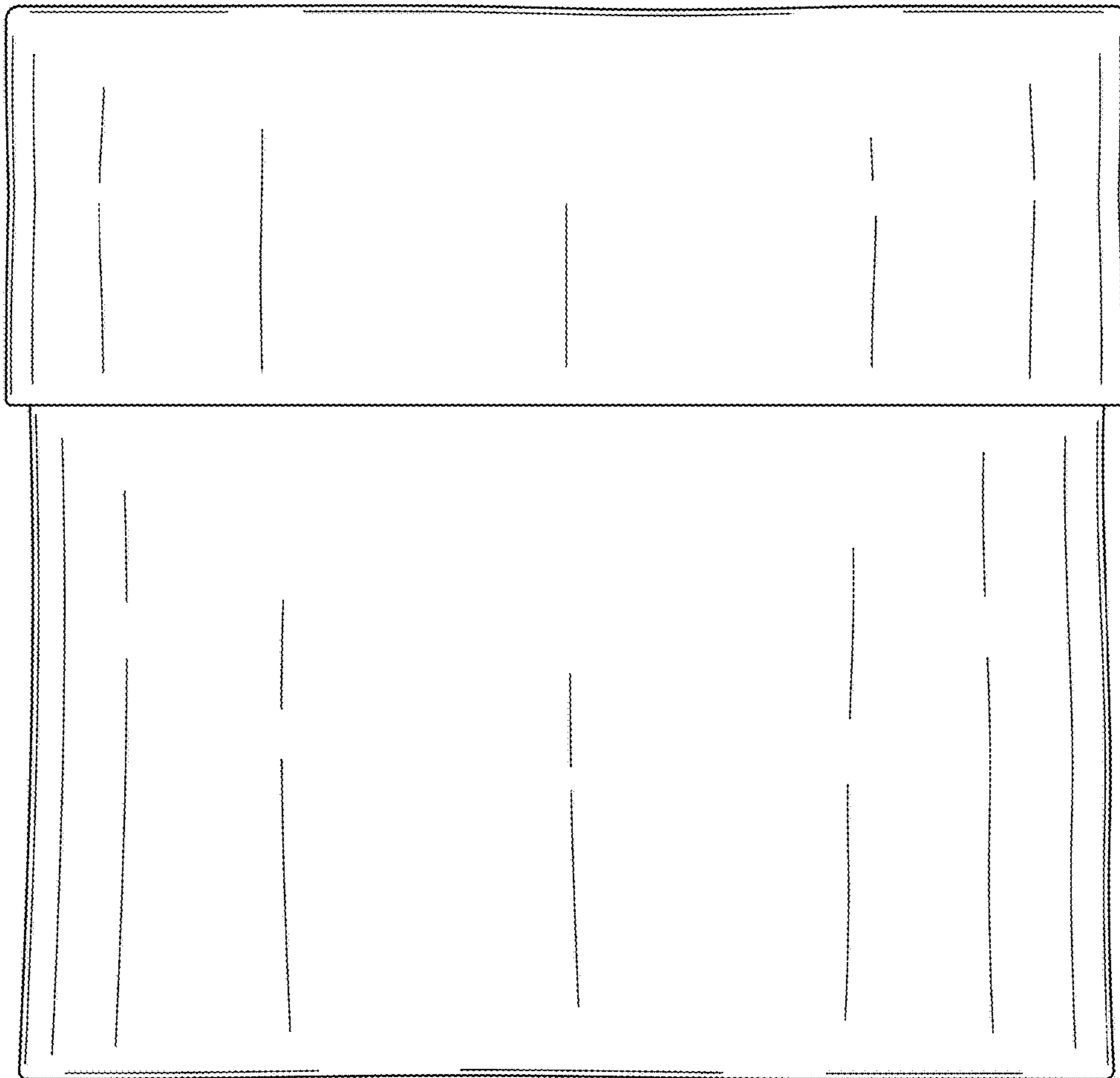

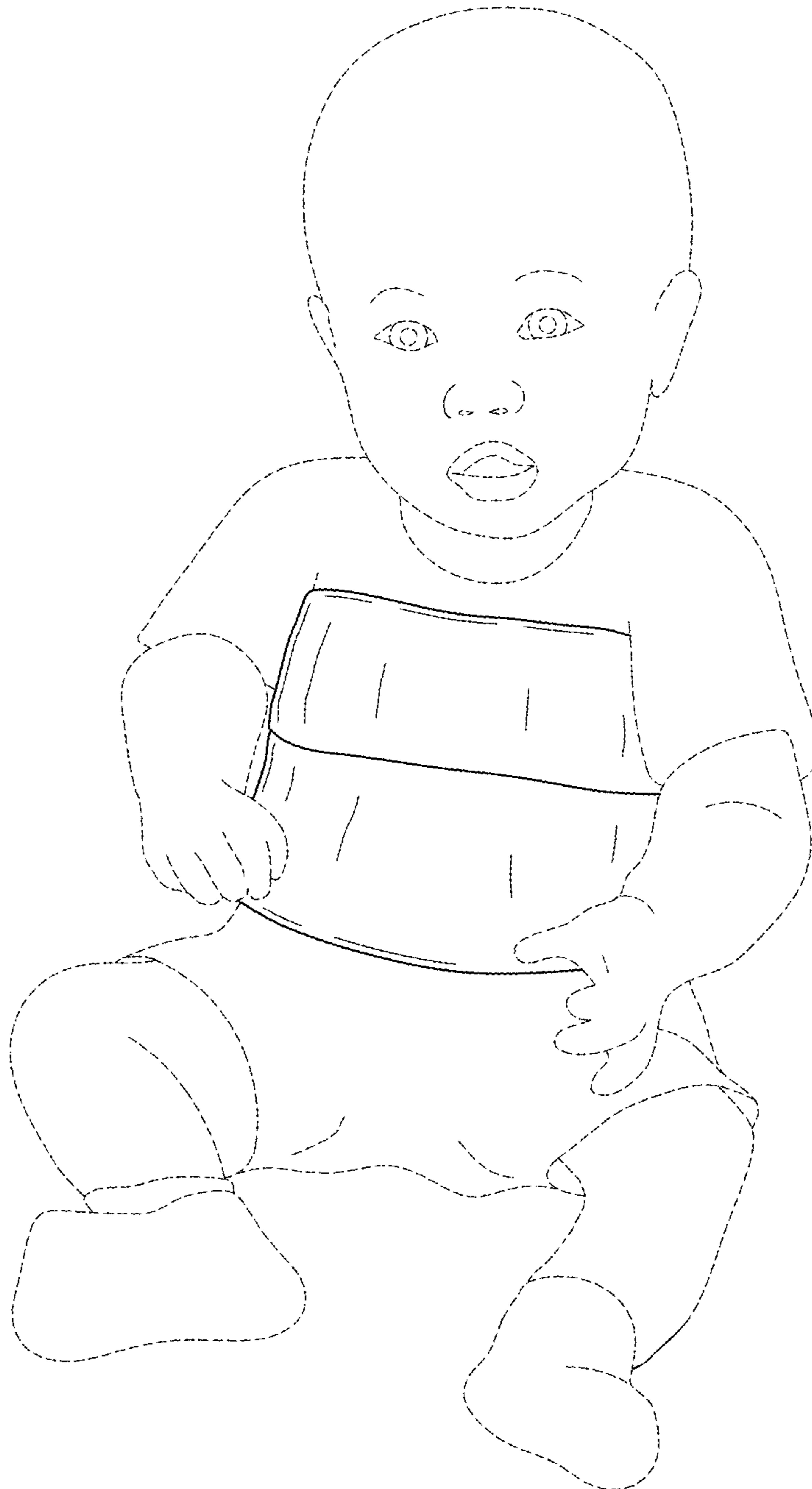

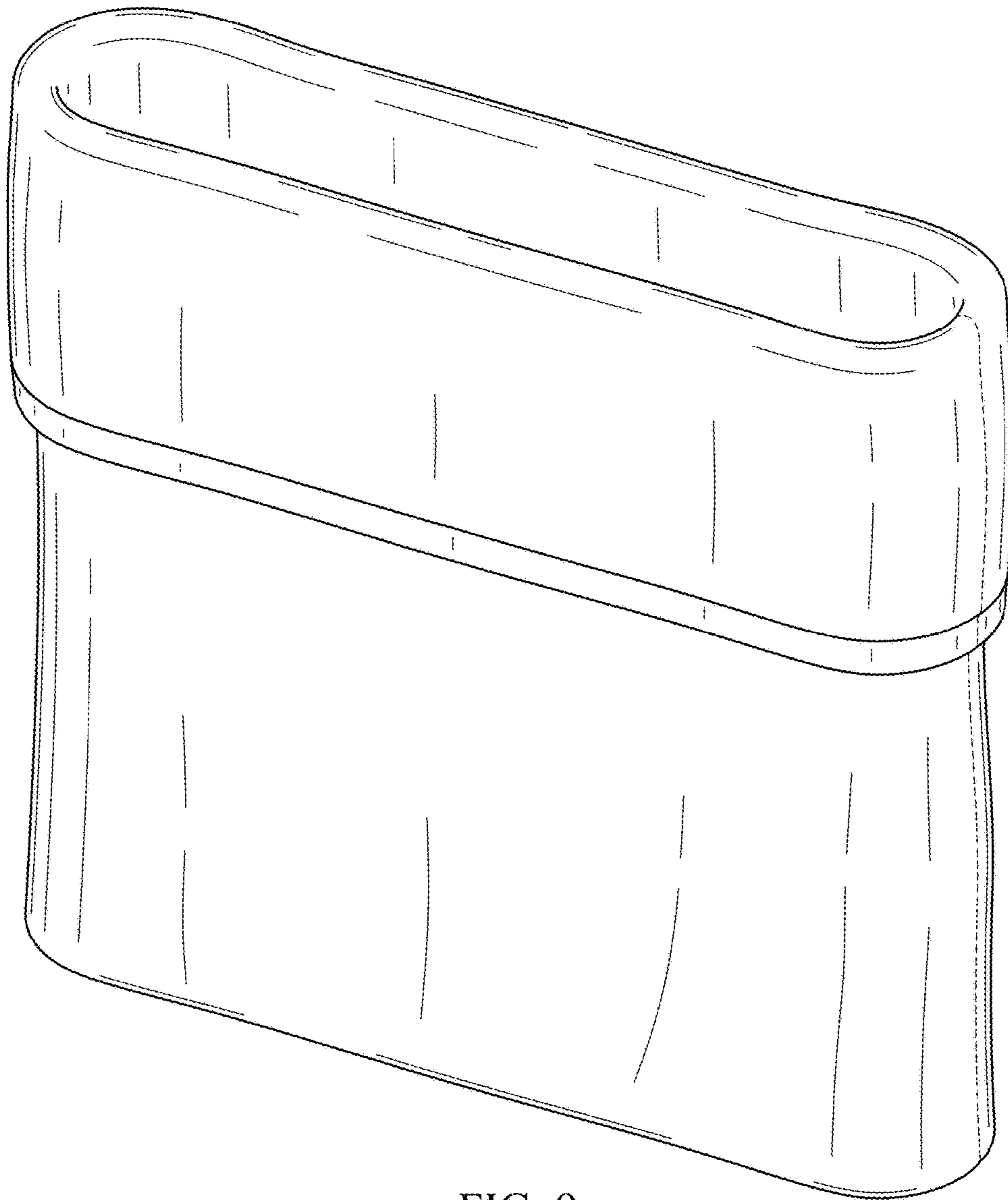

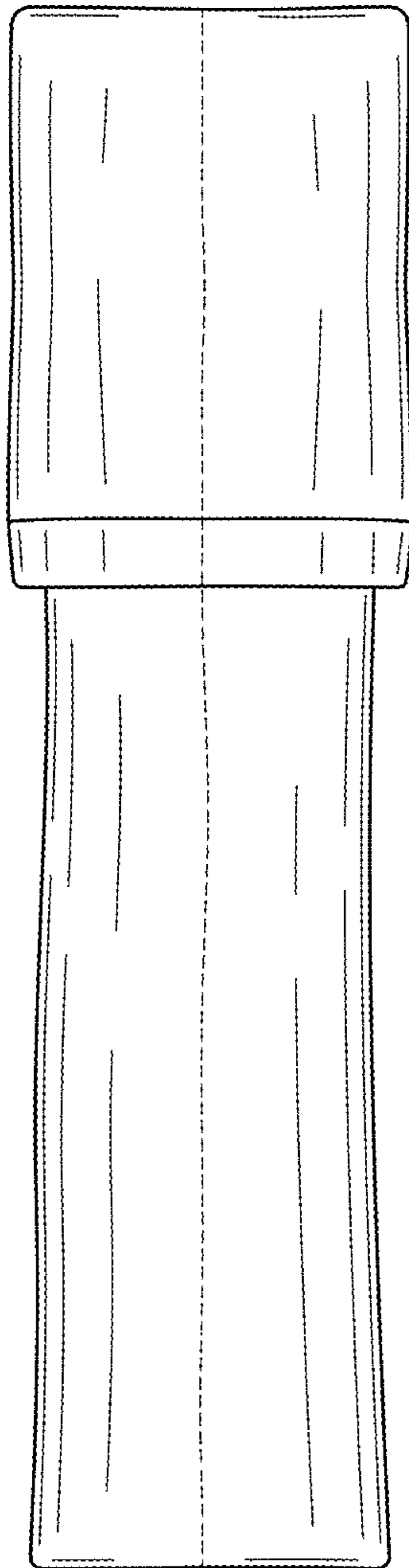

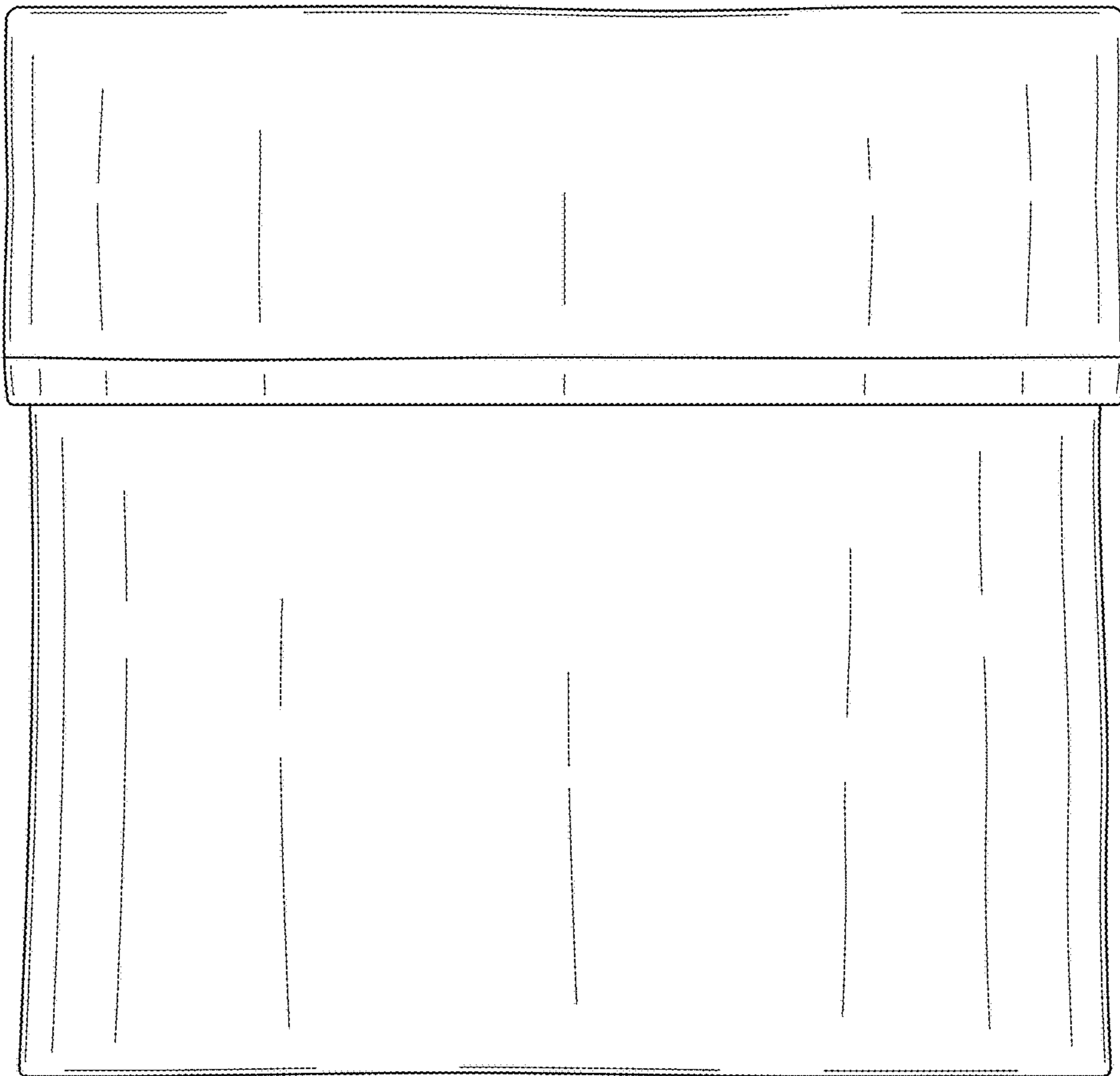

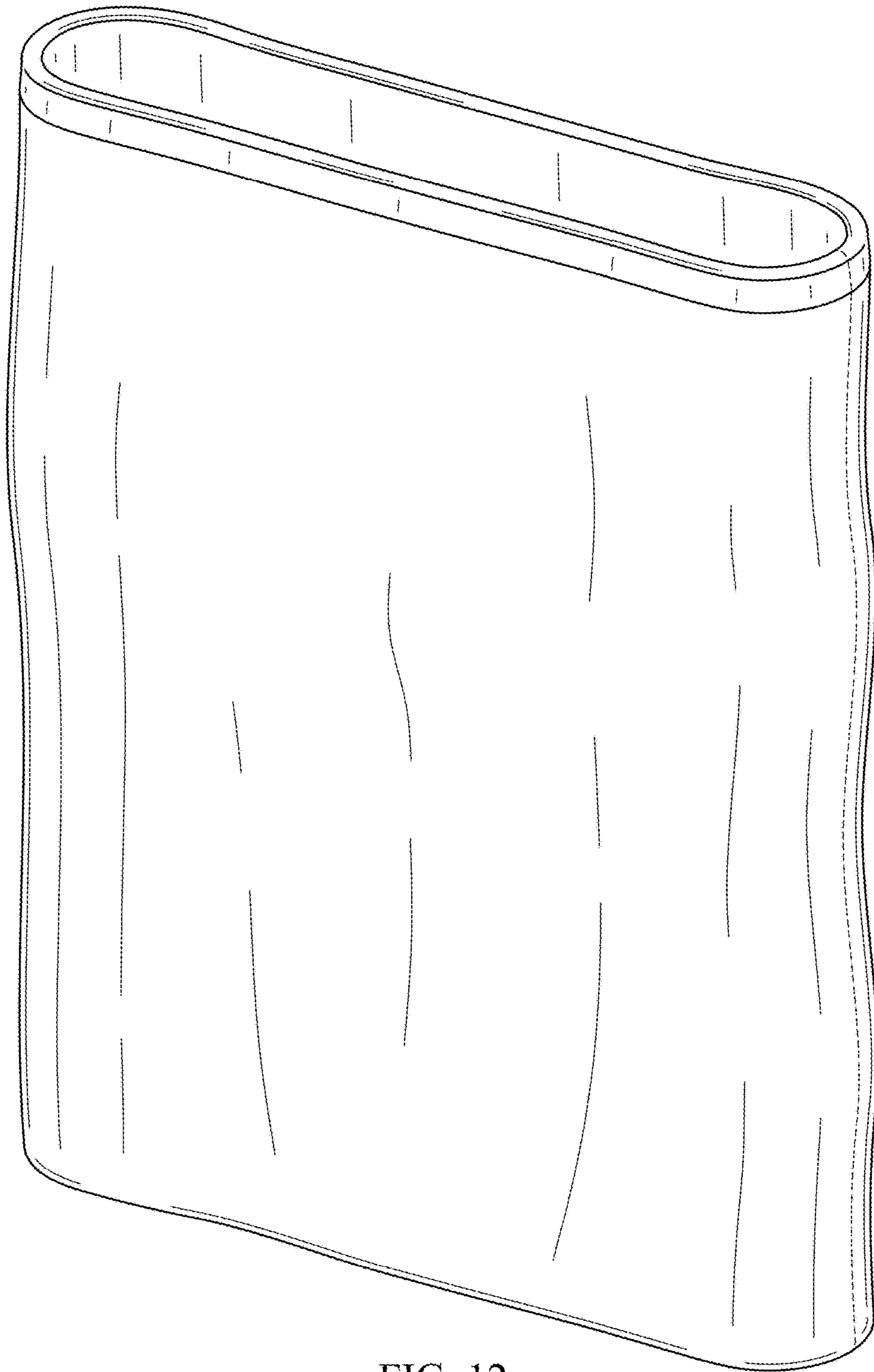

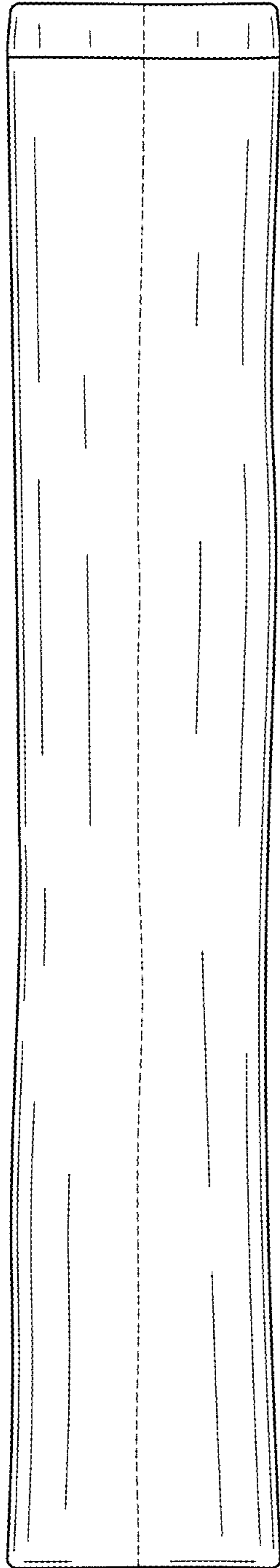

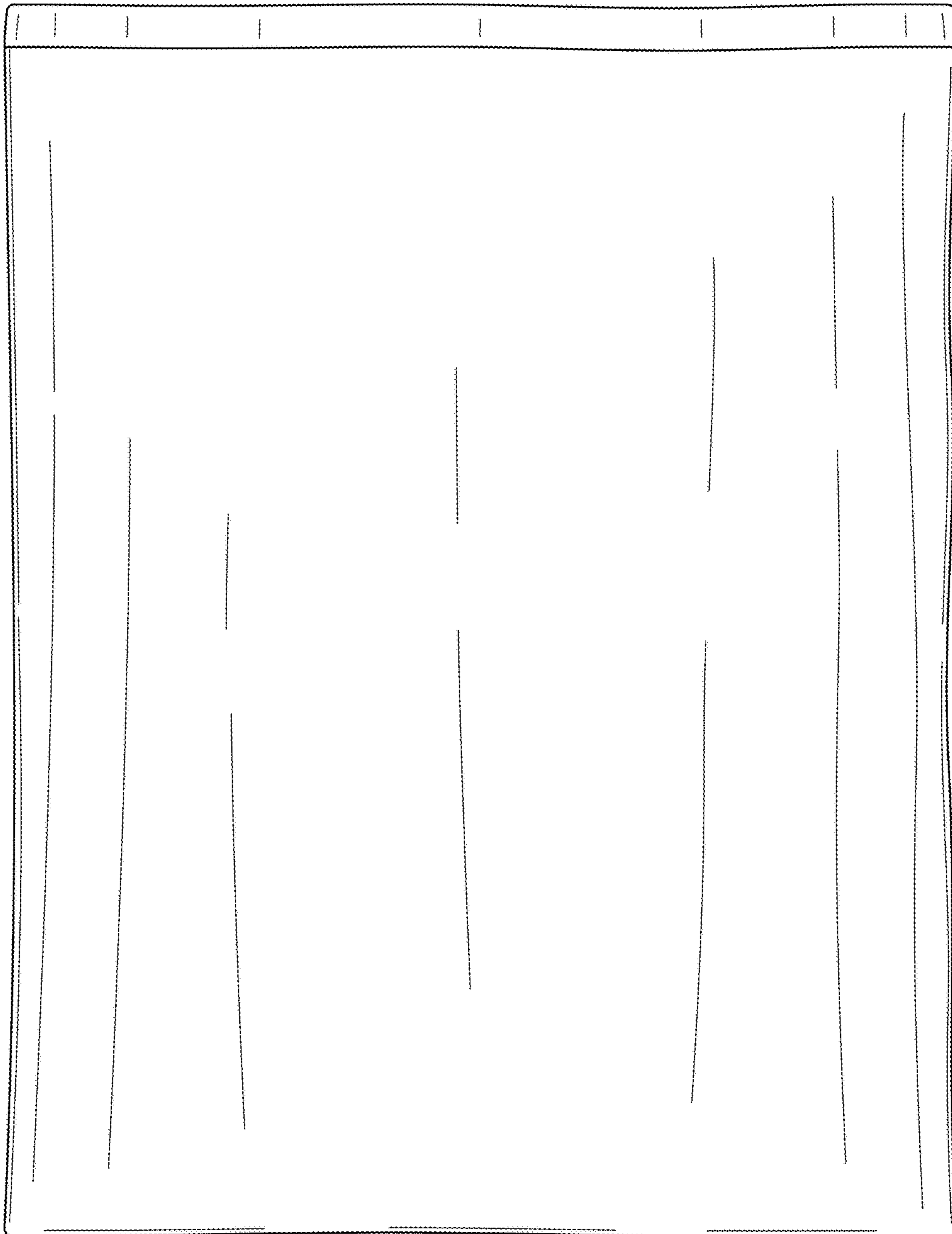
