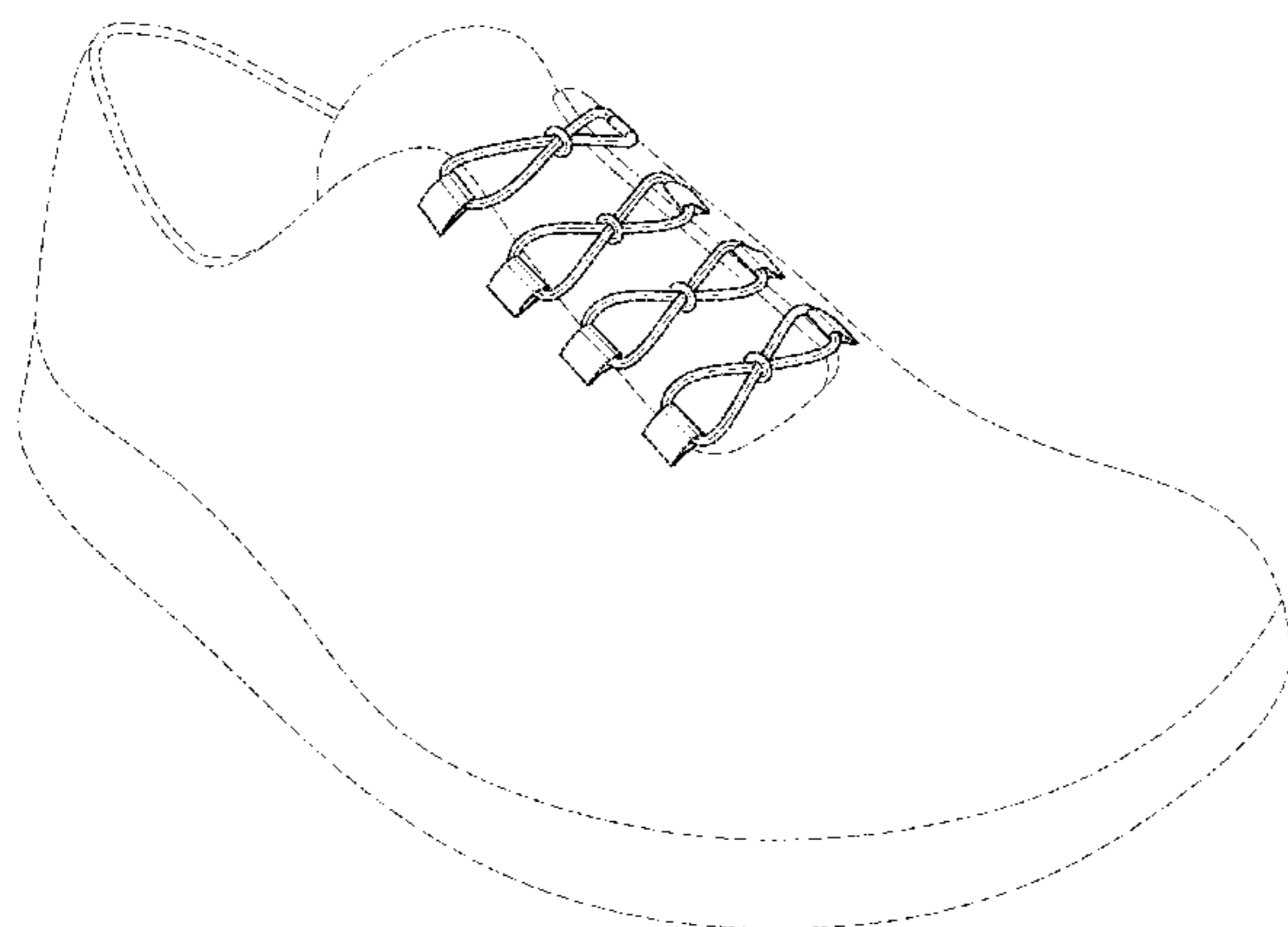
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first exemplary embodiment of a shoe upper in accordance with my new design. FIG. 2 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear elevation view thereof and FIG. 7 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second exemplary embodiment of a shoe upper in accordance with my new design. FIG. 9 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 10 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 11 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 12 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 13 is a rear elevation view thereof; and, FIG. 14 is a front elevation view thereof. The broken lines shown in the drawings represent portions of the shoe upper that form no part of the claimed design.

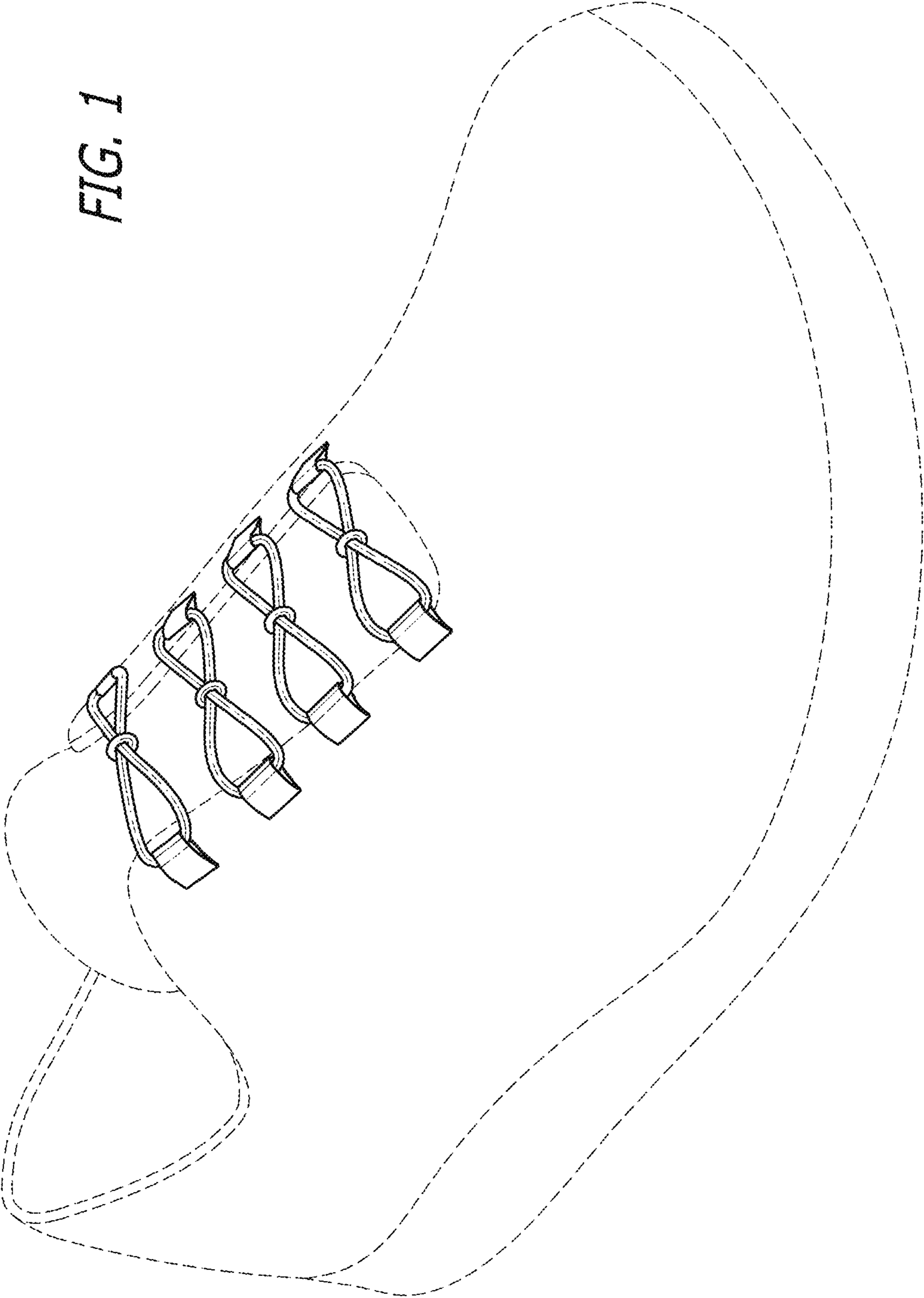

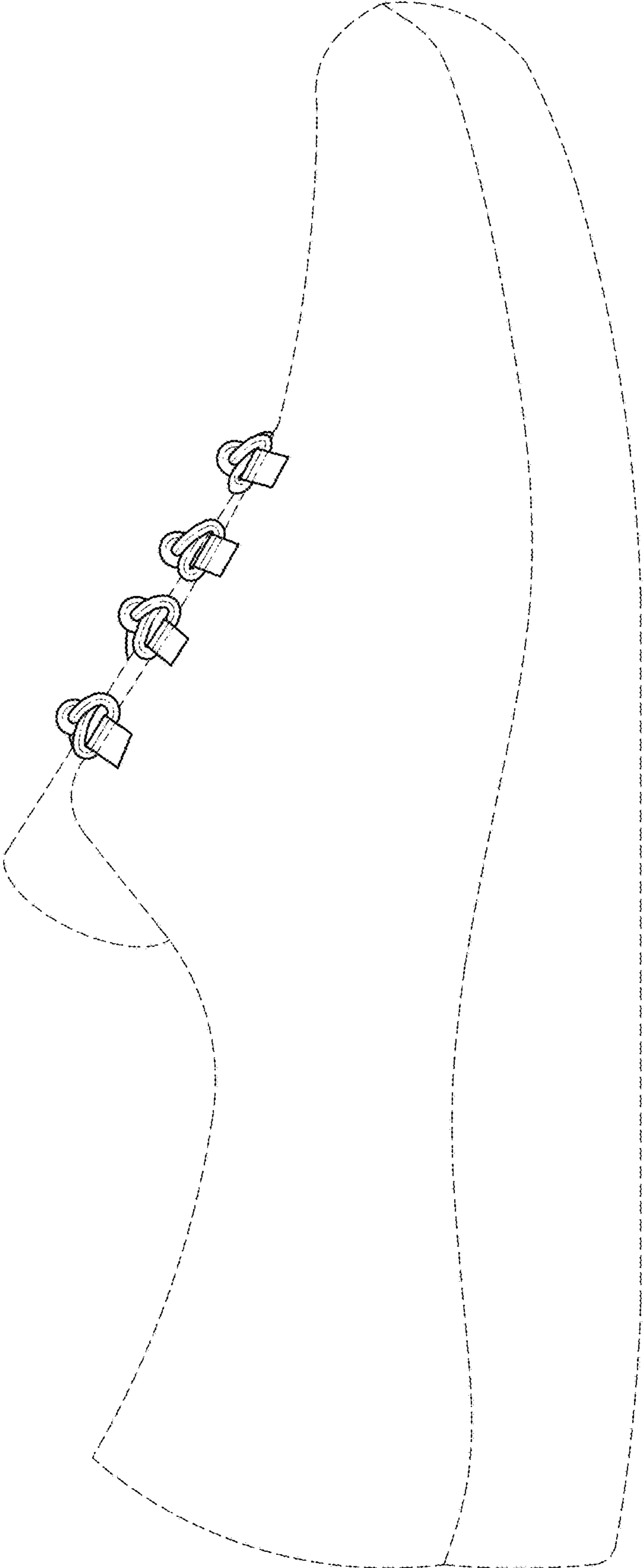

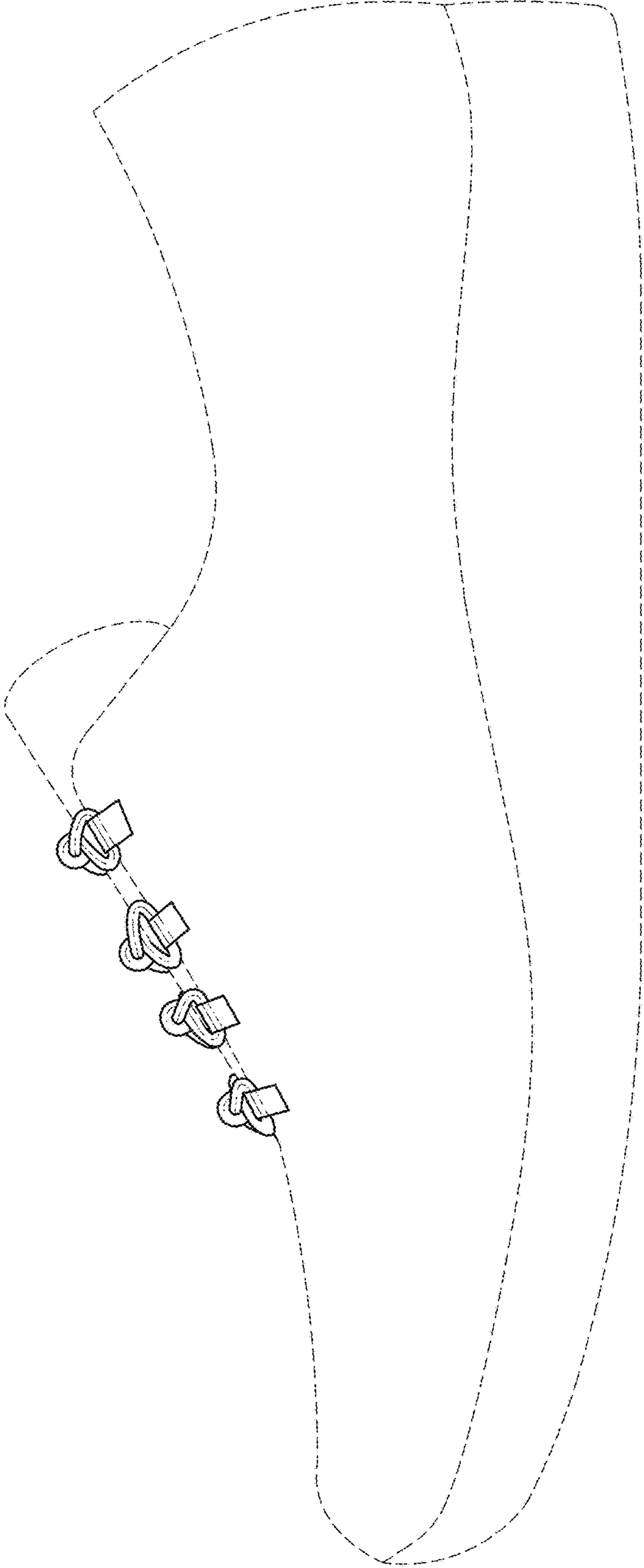

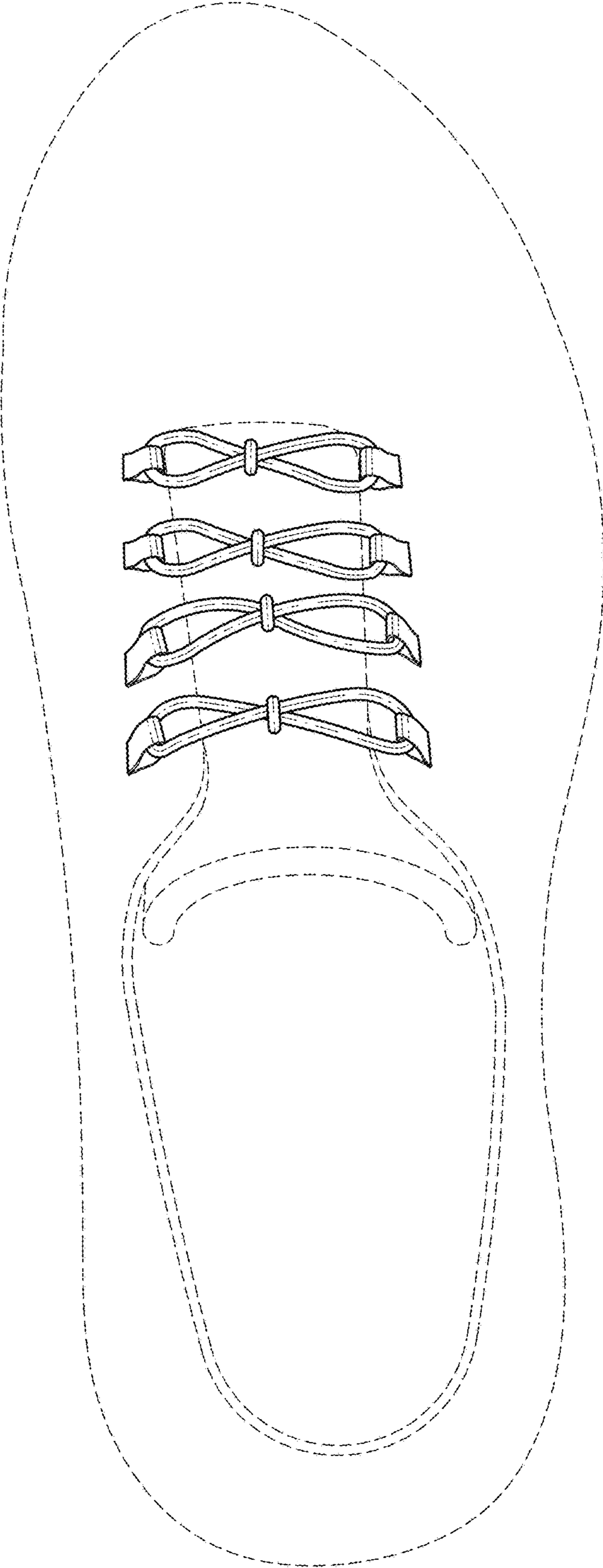

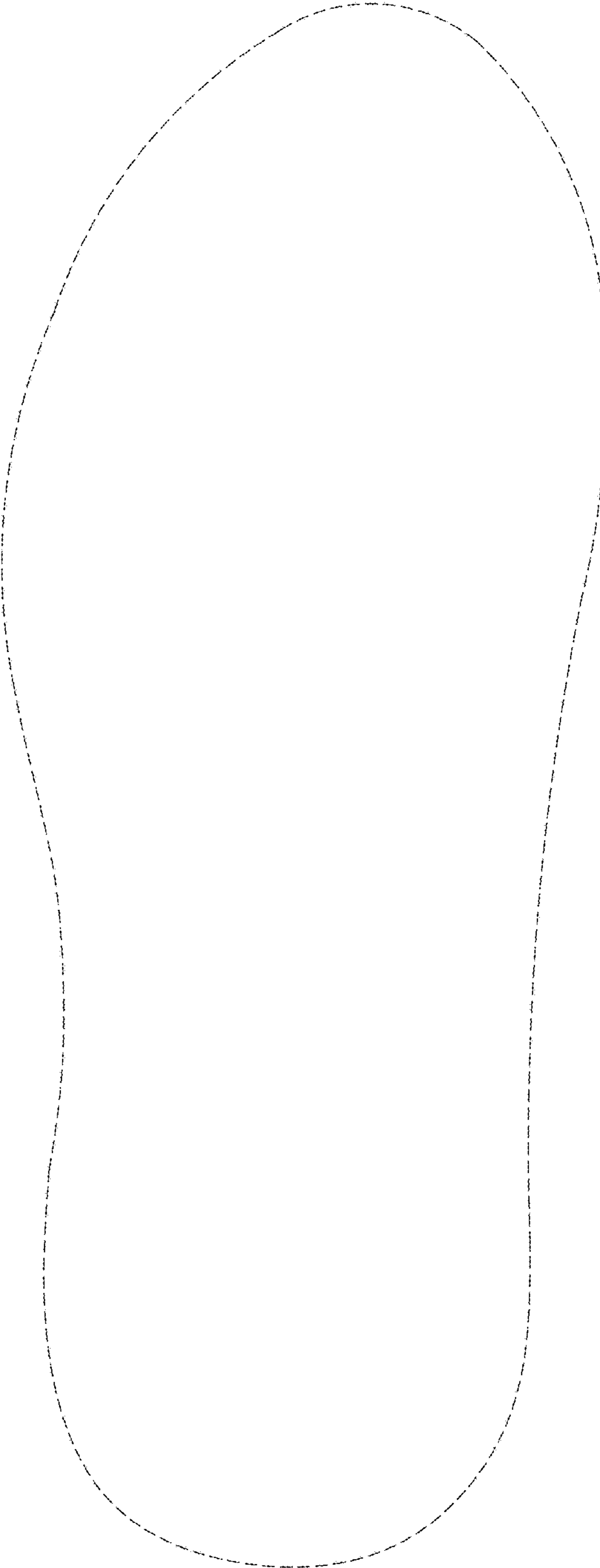

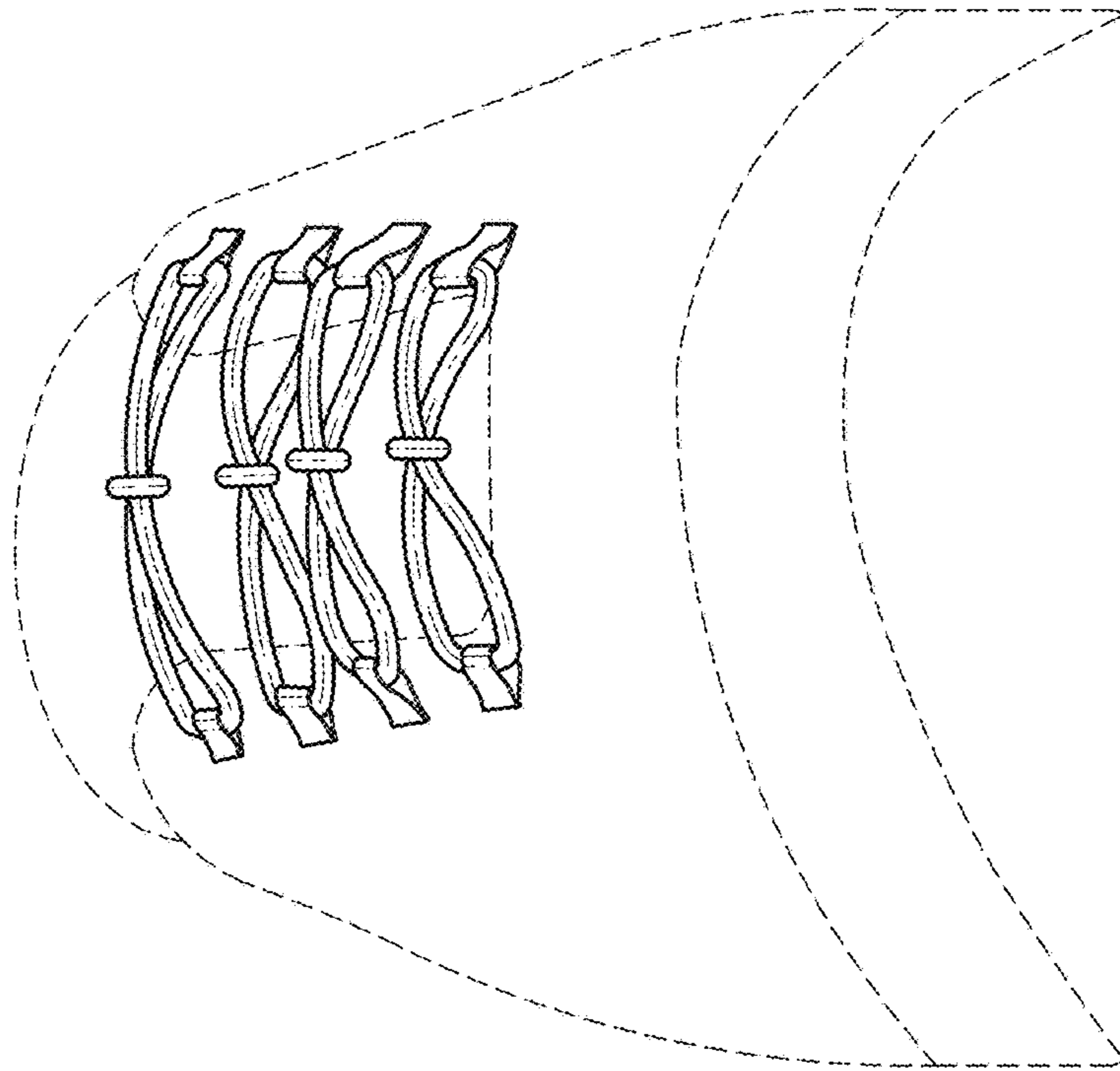

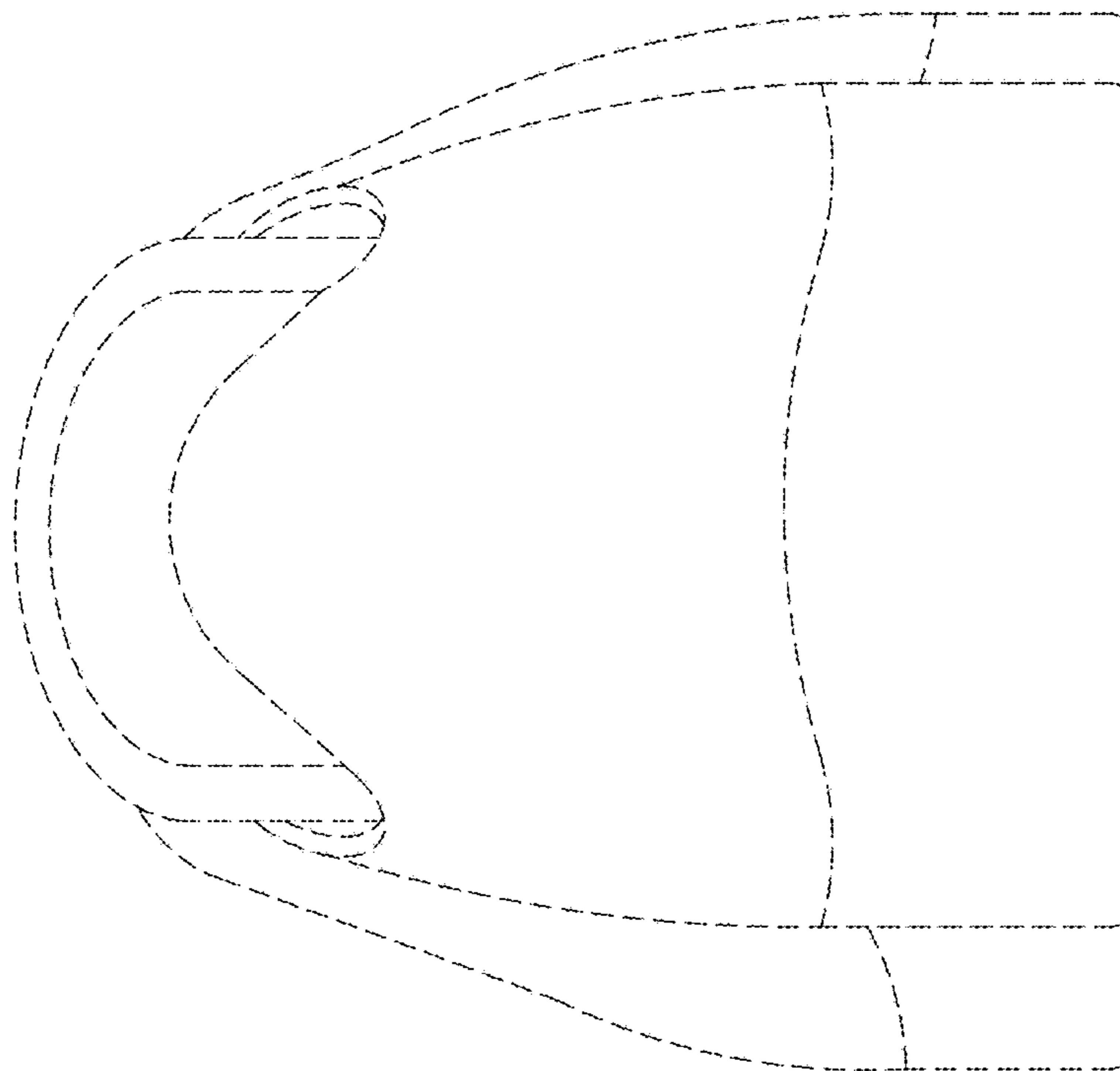
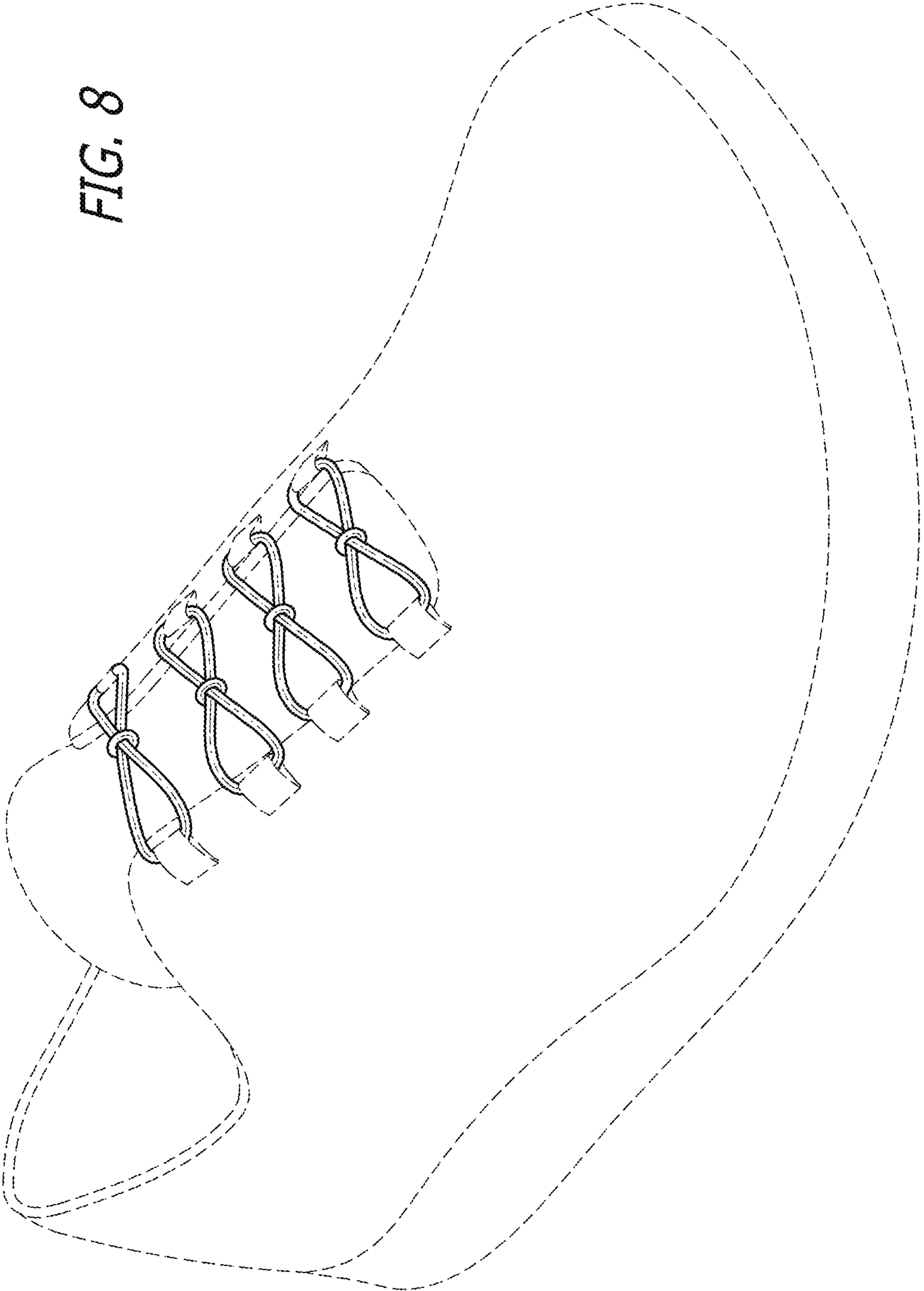

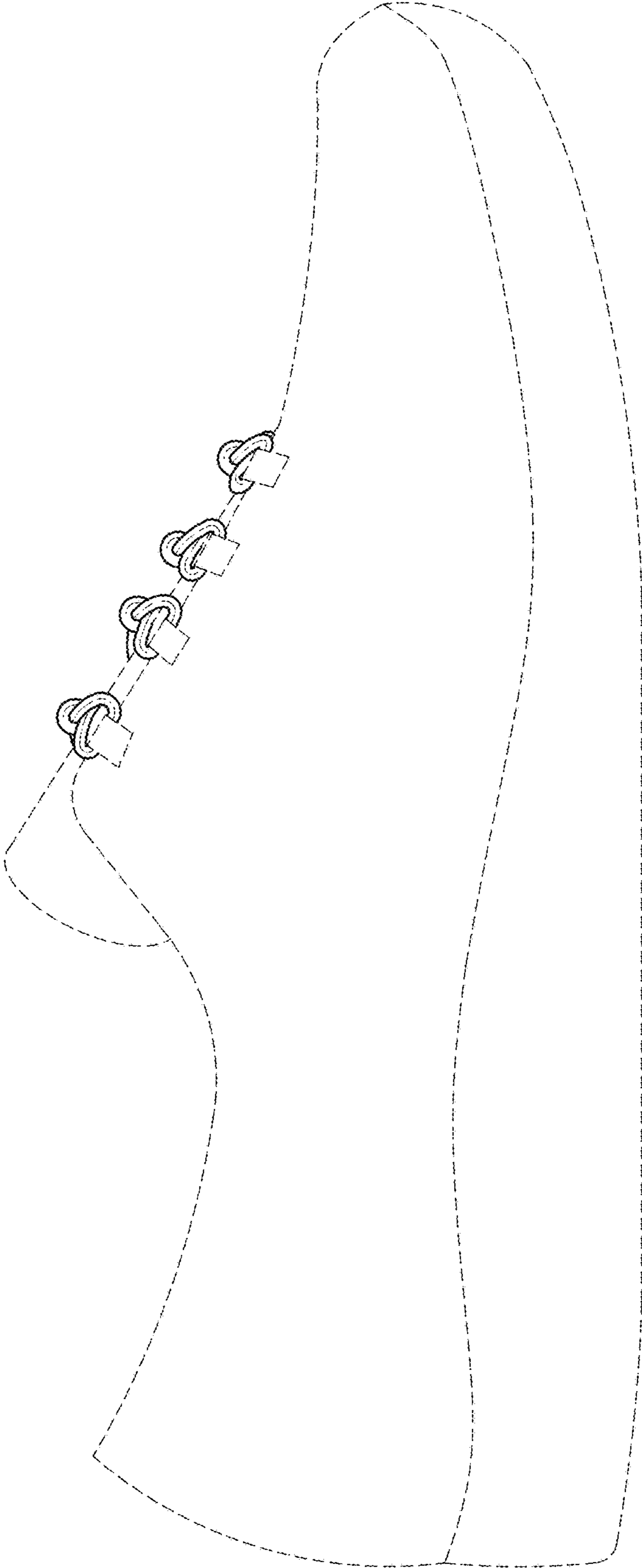
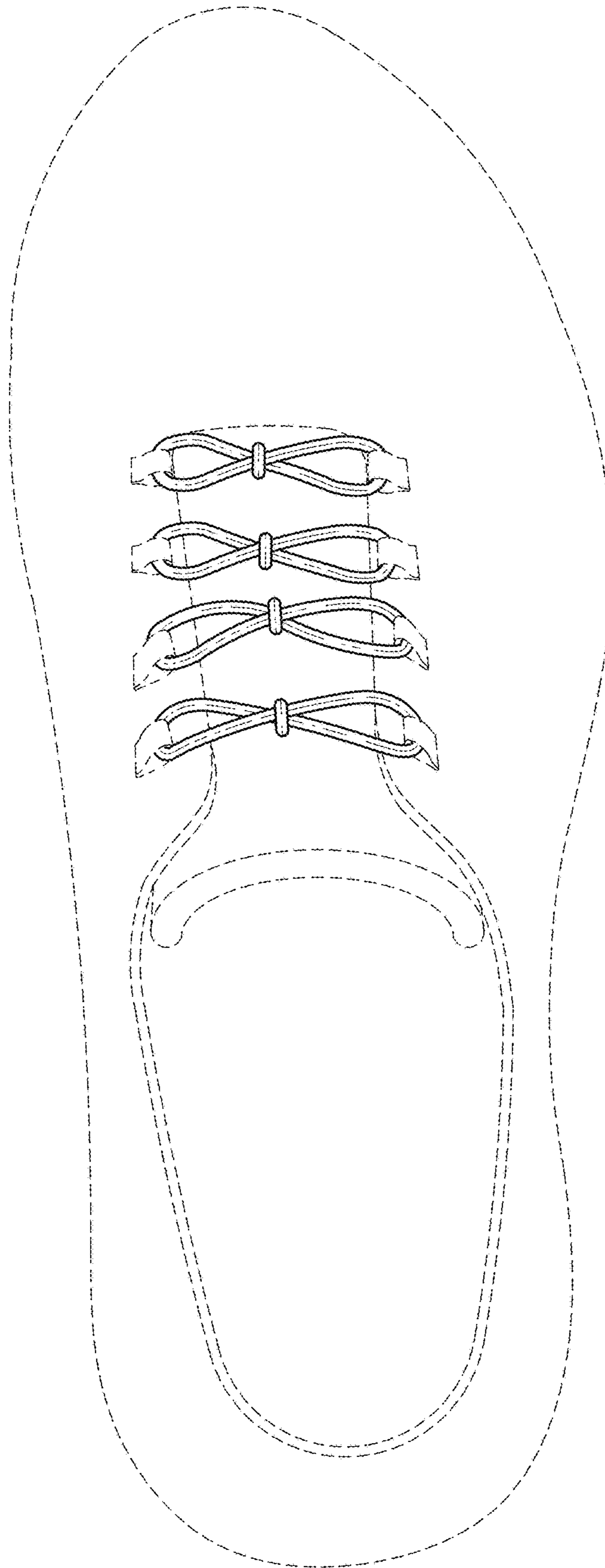

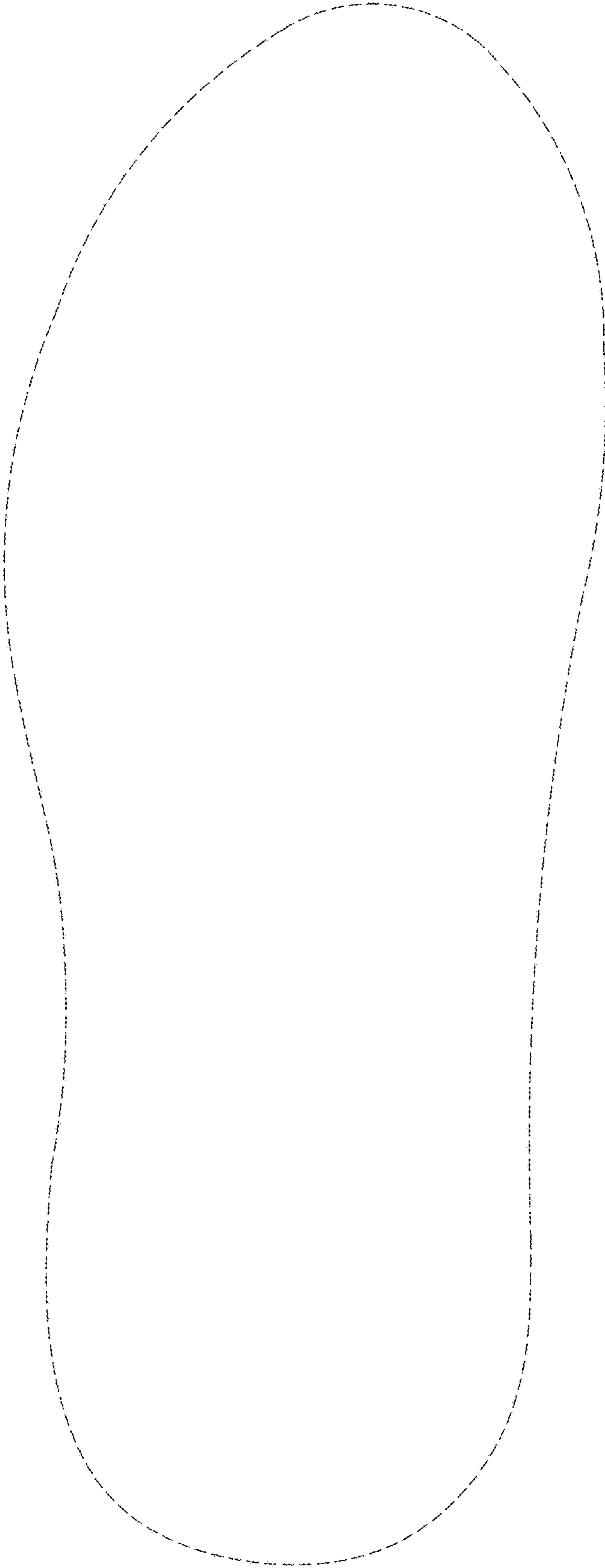

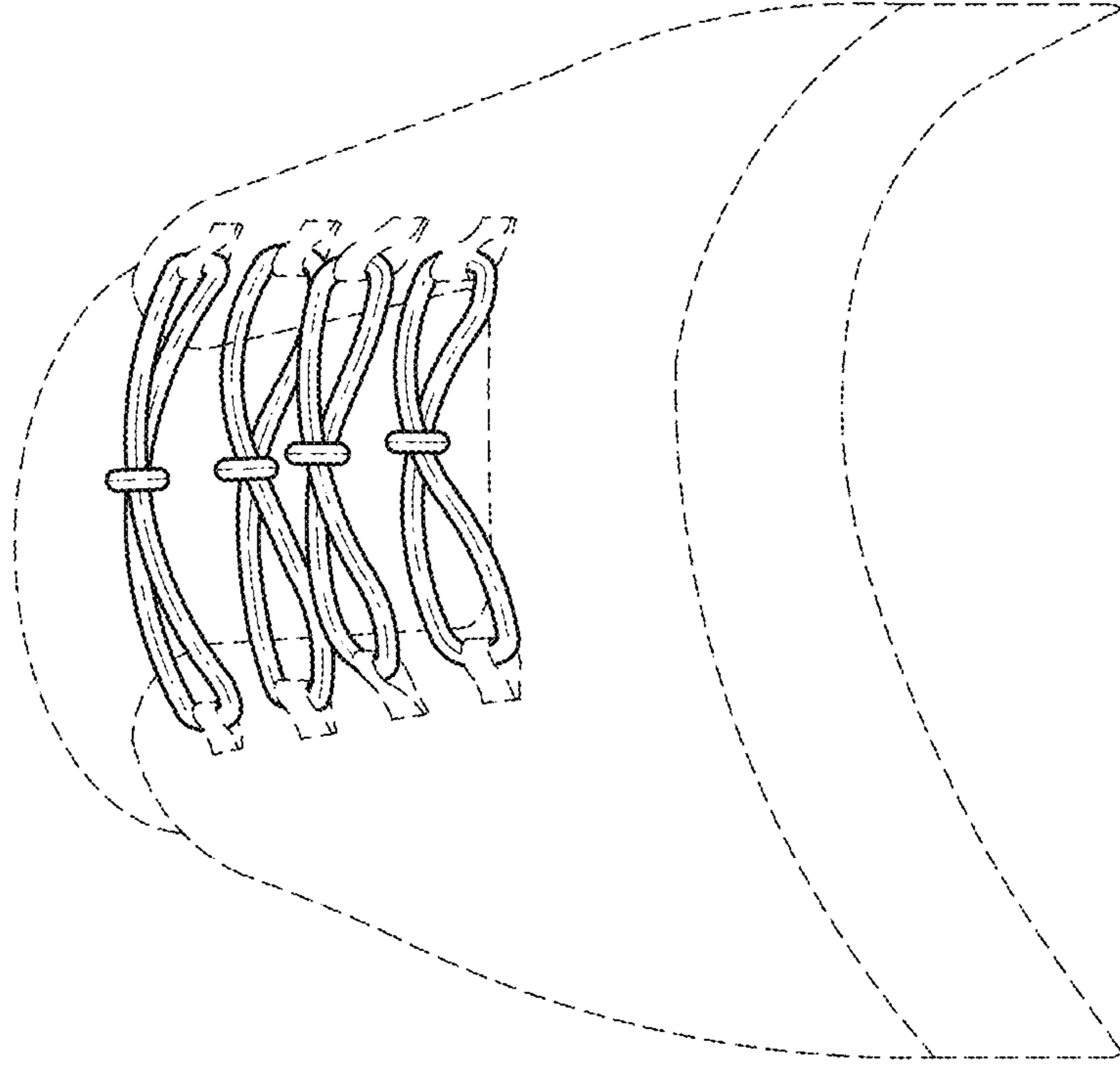
