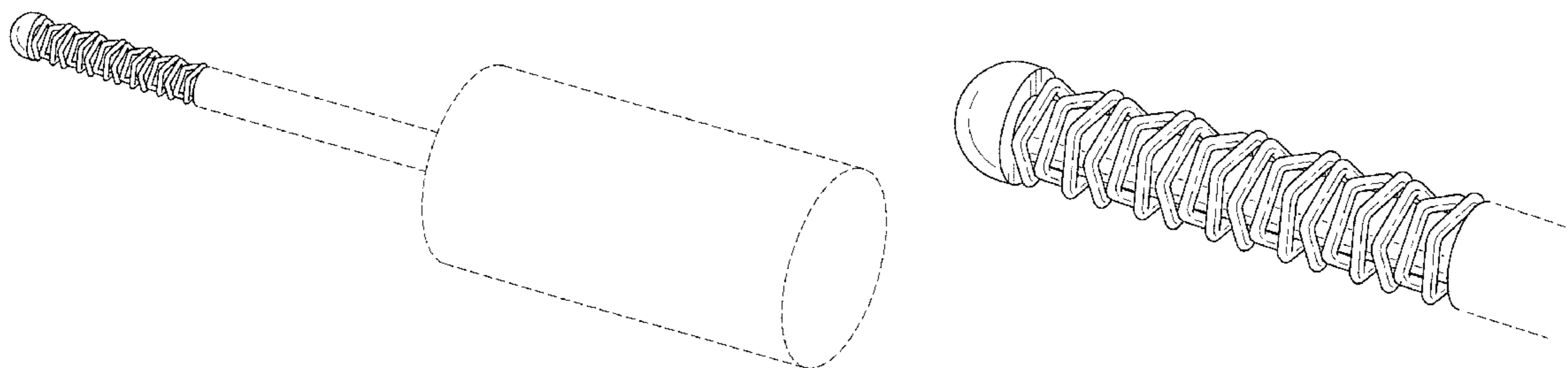

(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cosmetic applicator, as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the cosmetic applicator;  
 FIG. 2 is a plan view of the embodiment of the cosmetic applicator;  
 FIG. 3 is a bottom view of the embodiment of the cosmetic applicator;  
 FIG. 4 is a side view of the embodiment of the cosmetic applicator;  
 FIG. 5 is an opposite side view of the embodiment of the cosmetic applicator;  
 FIG. 6 is a left end view of the embodiment of the cosmetic applicator from FIG. 3;  
 FIG. 7 is a right end view of the embodiment of the cosmetic applicator from FIG. 3;  
 FIG. 8 is an enlarged perspective view of the cosmetic applicator from an angle;  
 FIG. 9 is an enlarged perspective view of the cosmetic applicator from a different angle;  
 FIG. 10 is an enlarged top view of the embodiment of the cosmetic applicator;  
 FIG. 11 is a cross-sectional view of the cosmetic applicator along line 11-11 in FIG. 10; and,  
 FIG. 12 is a cross-sectional view of the cosmetic applicator along line 12-12 in FIG. 10.  
 An application part of the cosmetic applicator is a coil spring wound around a shaft having a circular cross-section. The coil spring has a helical shape in which polygonal wire loops continue and each of the loops shifts relative to an immediately preceding loop by a predetermined angle. The application part of the cosmetic applicator is indicated by solid lines and is the part for which the design patent is requested, while the parts indicated by broken lines indicate environmental structure that forms no part of the design to be patented.

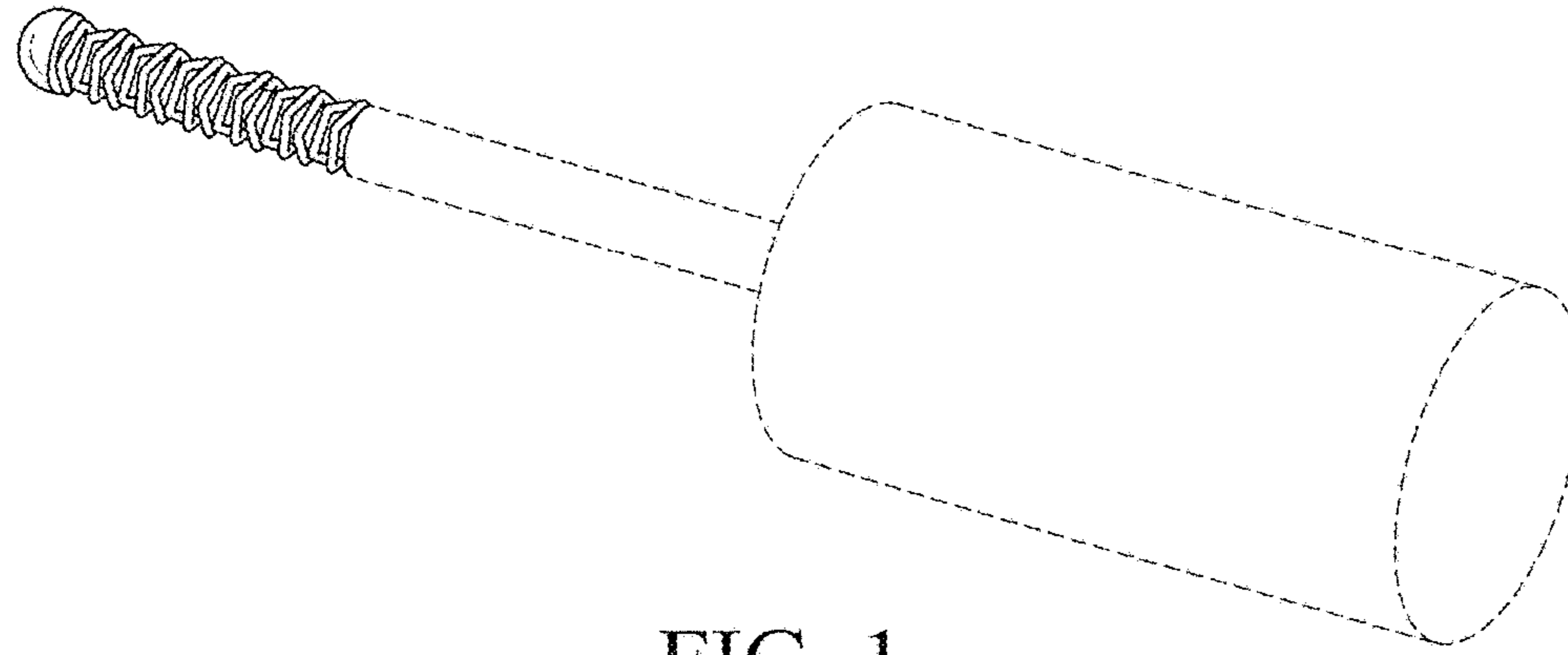

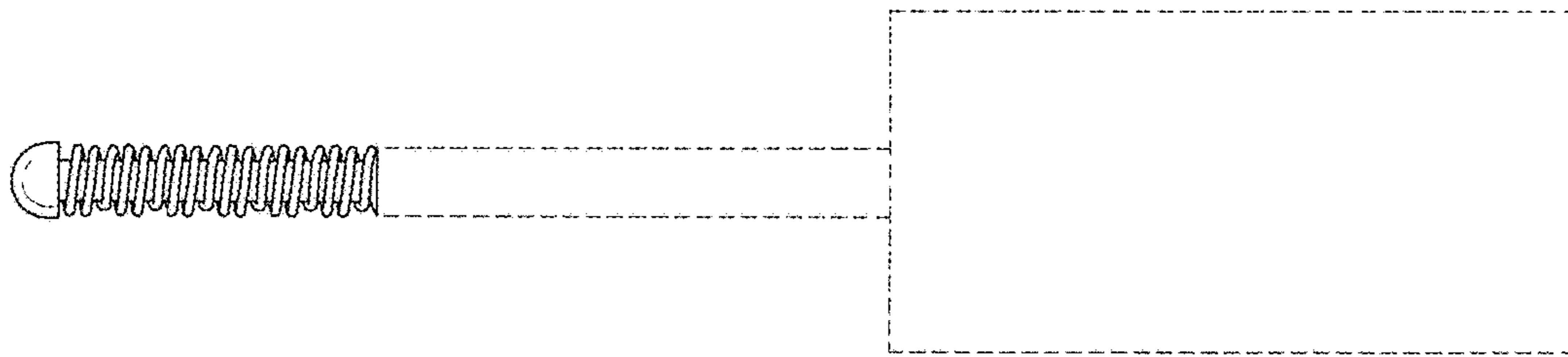

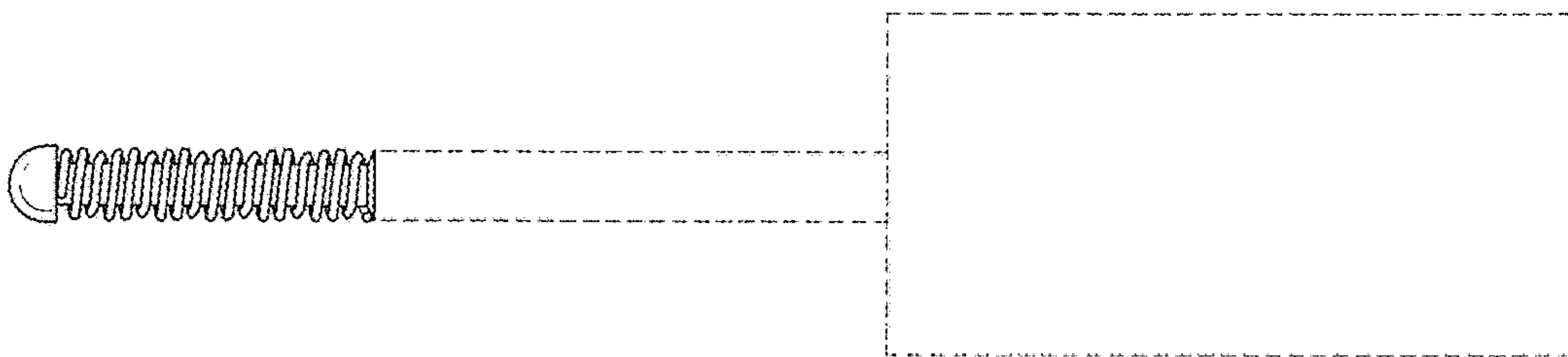

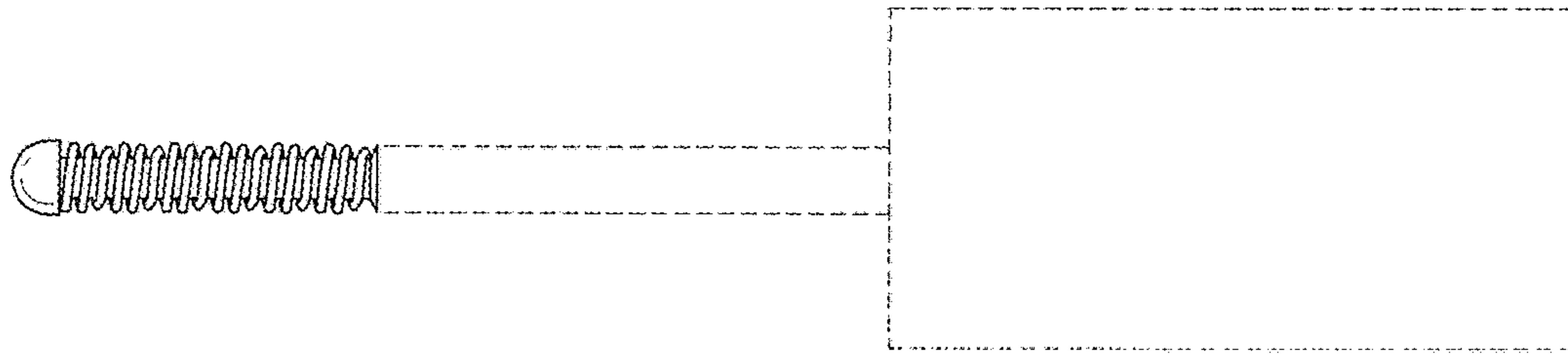

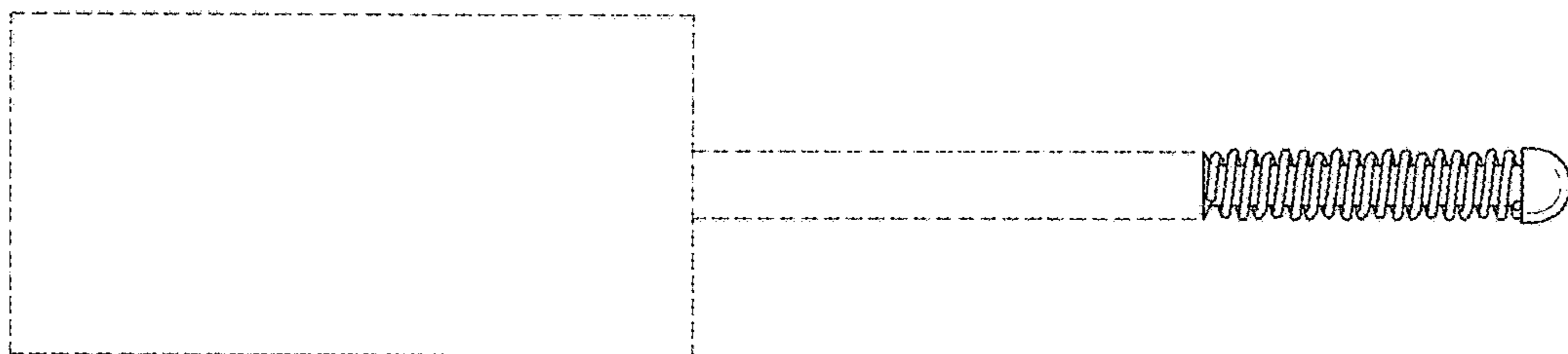

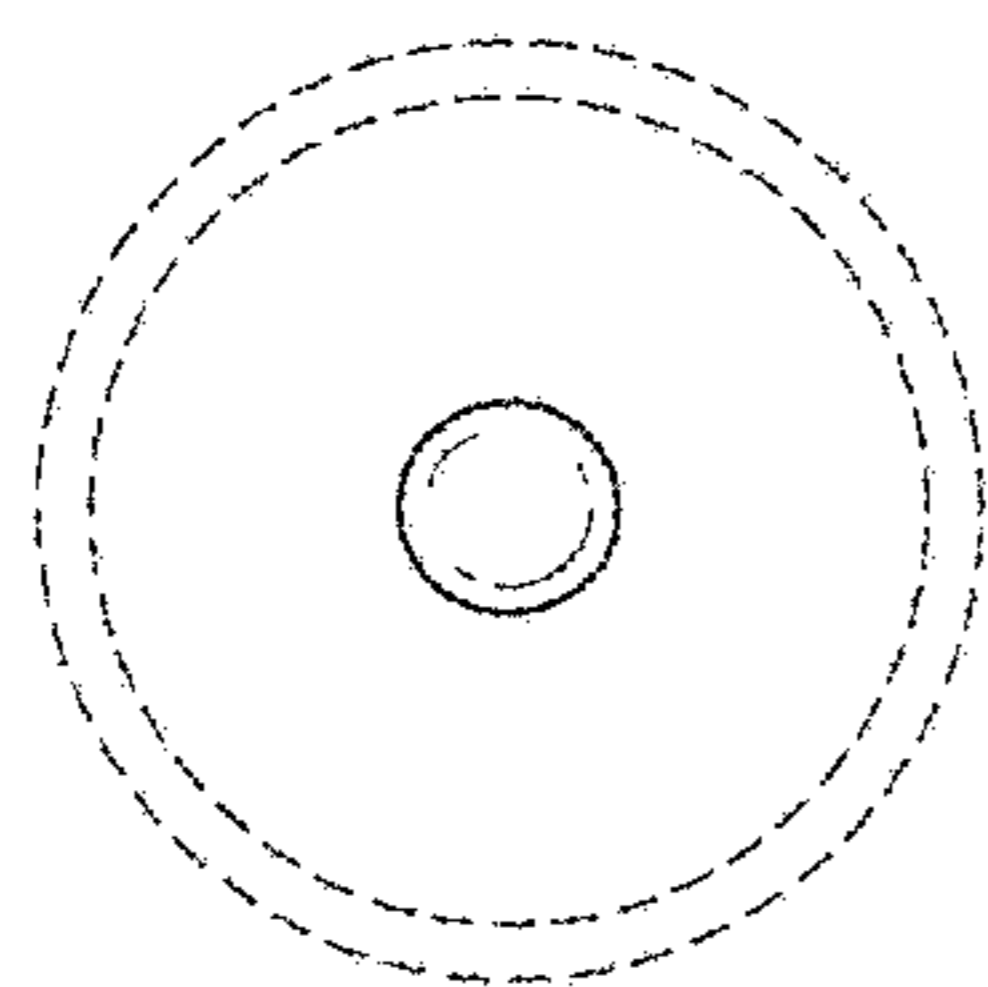

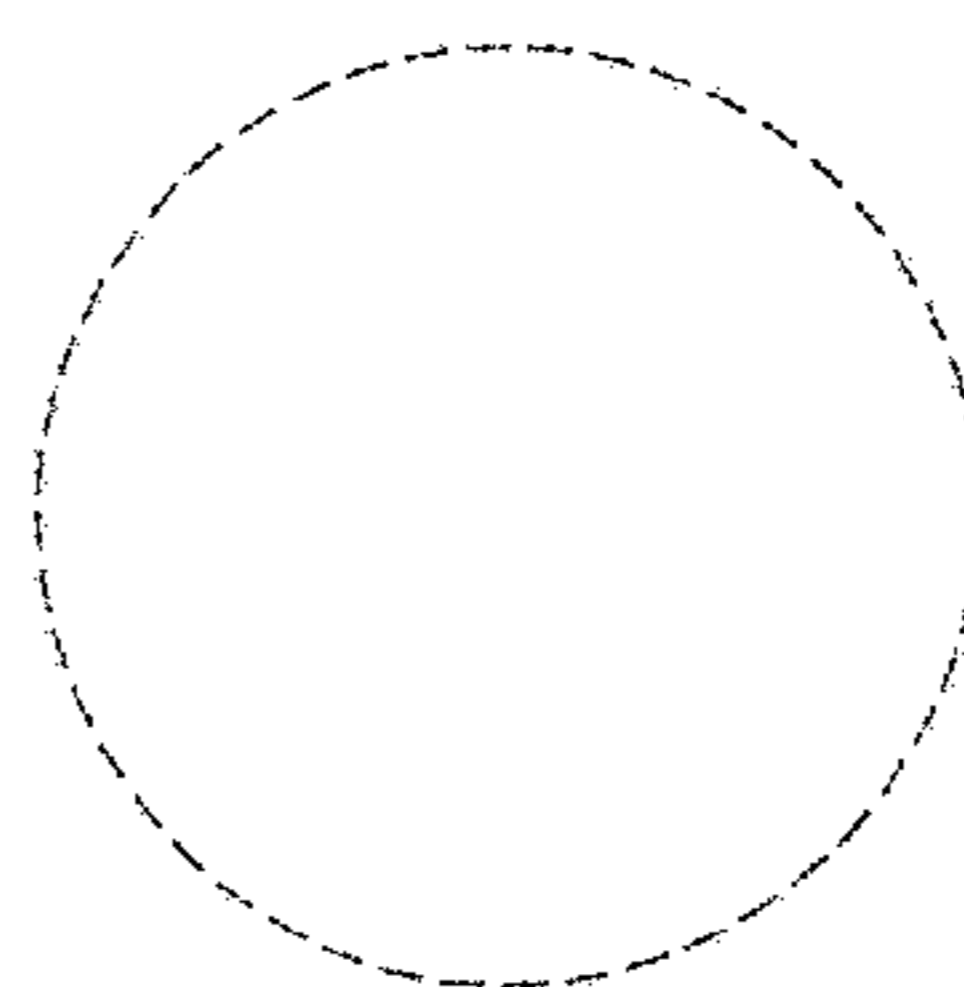
