(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a container with surface pattern, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front view of a container with surface pattern showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a front-left perspective view thereof.

FIG. 3 is a front view of the container with surface pattern according to another embodiment; and,

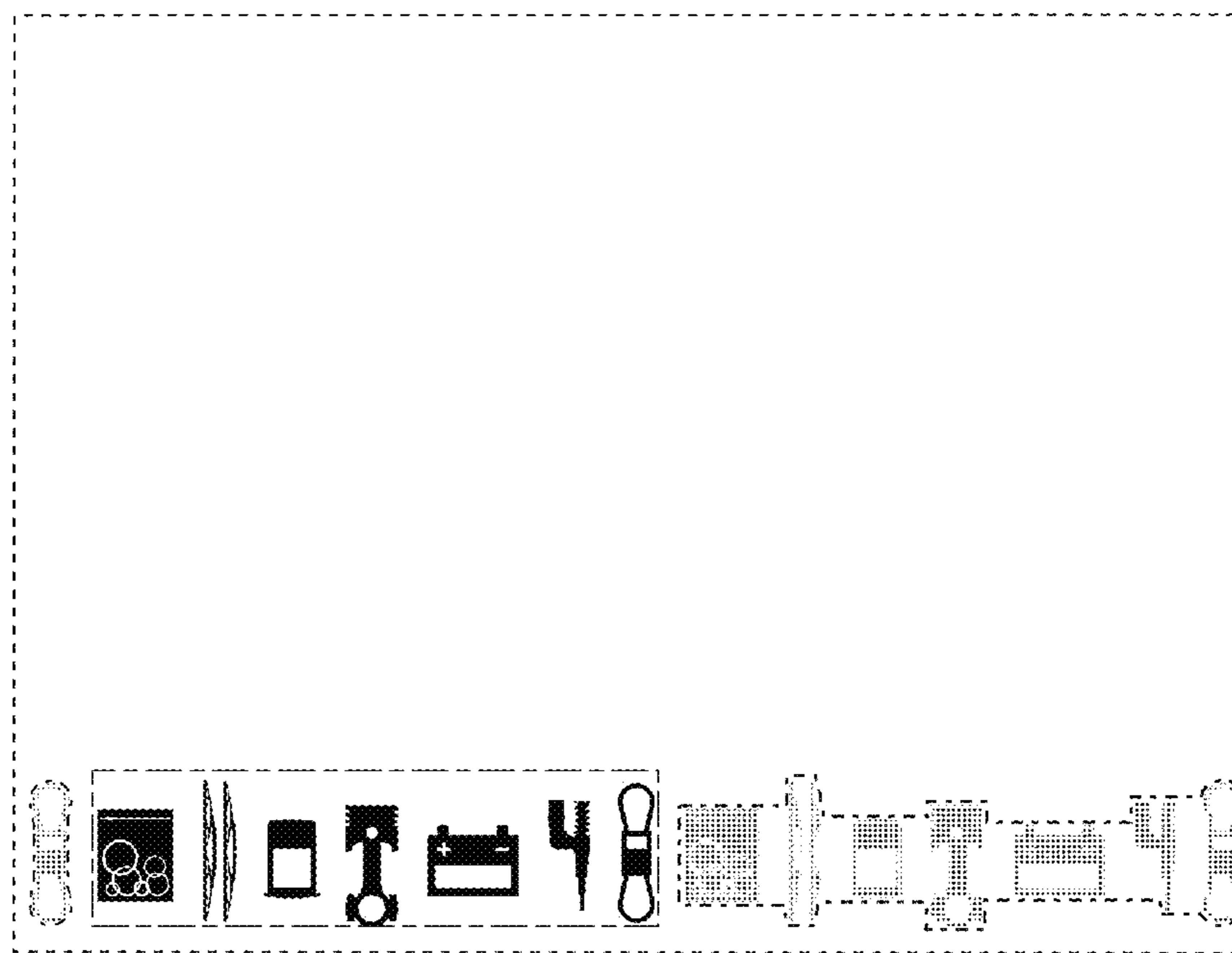
FIG. 4 is a front-left perspective view thereof.

The broken lines represent edges of the container that form no part of the claimed design.

The long/short dash broken lines represent an unclaimed boundary and form no part of the claimed design, the area between the long/short dash broken lines and the broken lines being unclaimed.

The portions shown in half-tone and outlined in dash-dot lines form no part of the claimed design.

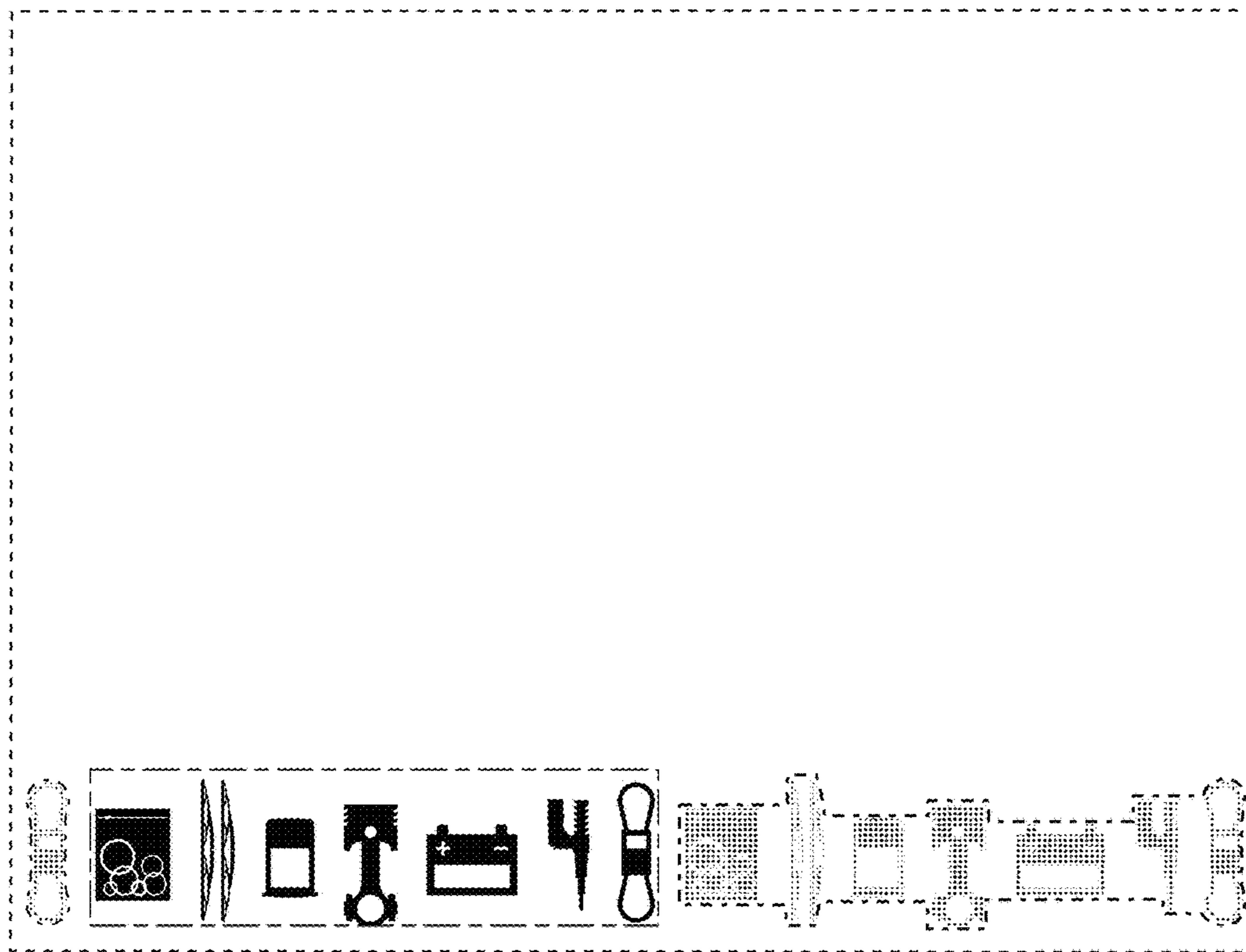

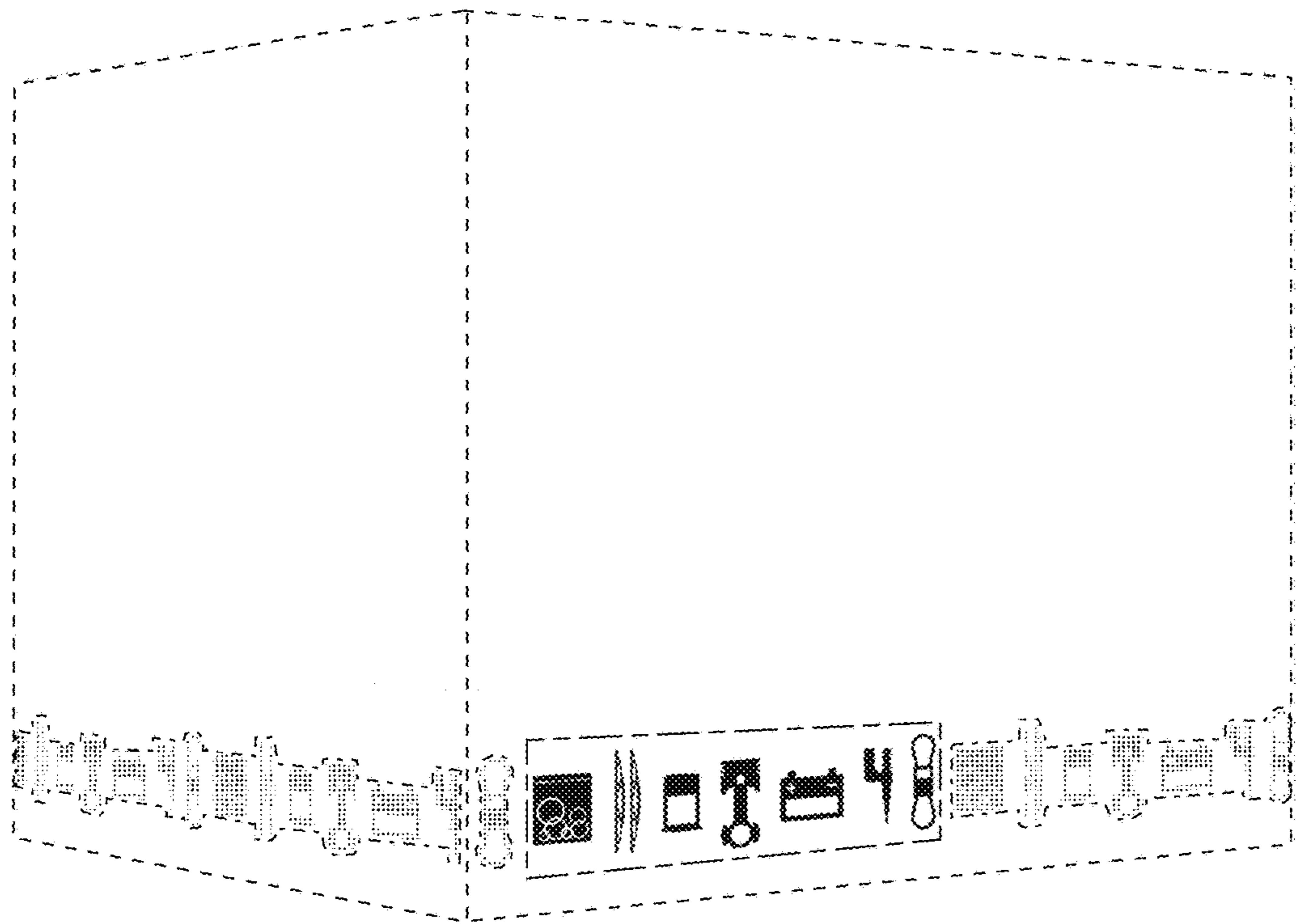

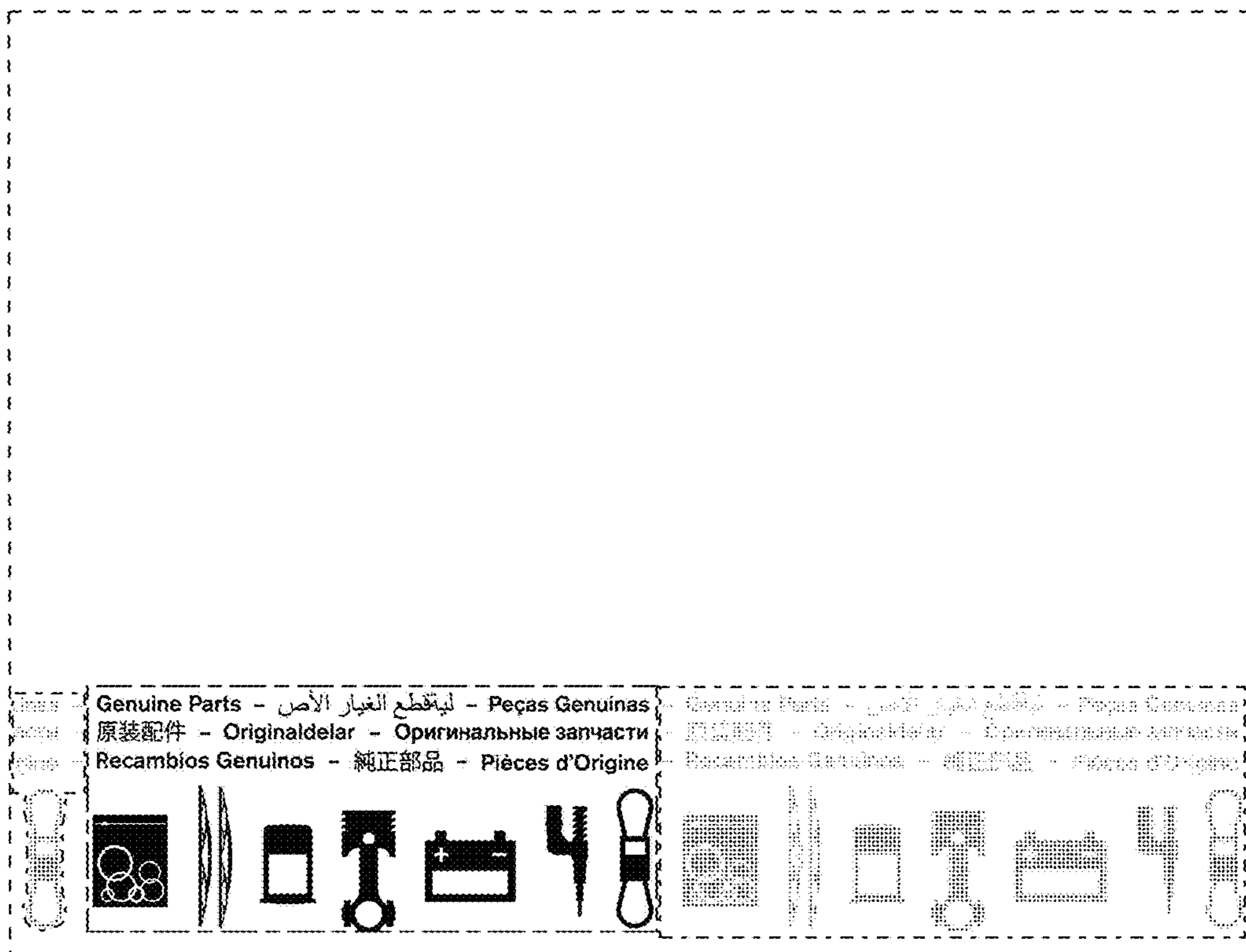

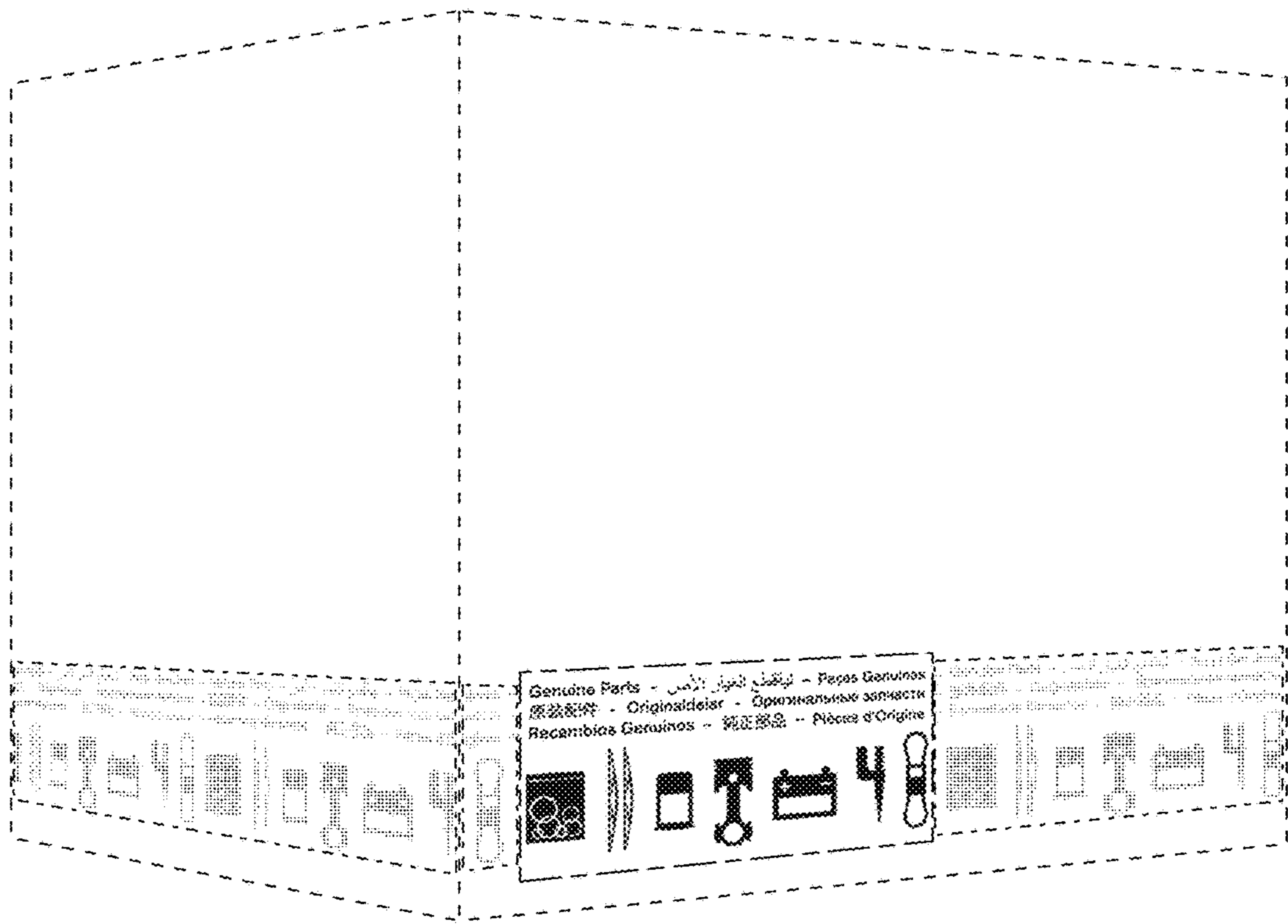
