**DESCRIPTION**

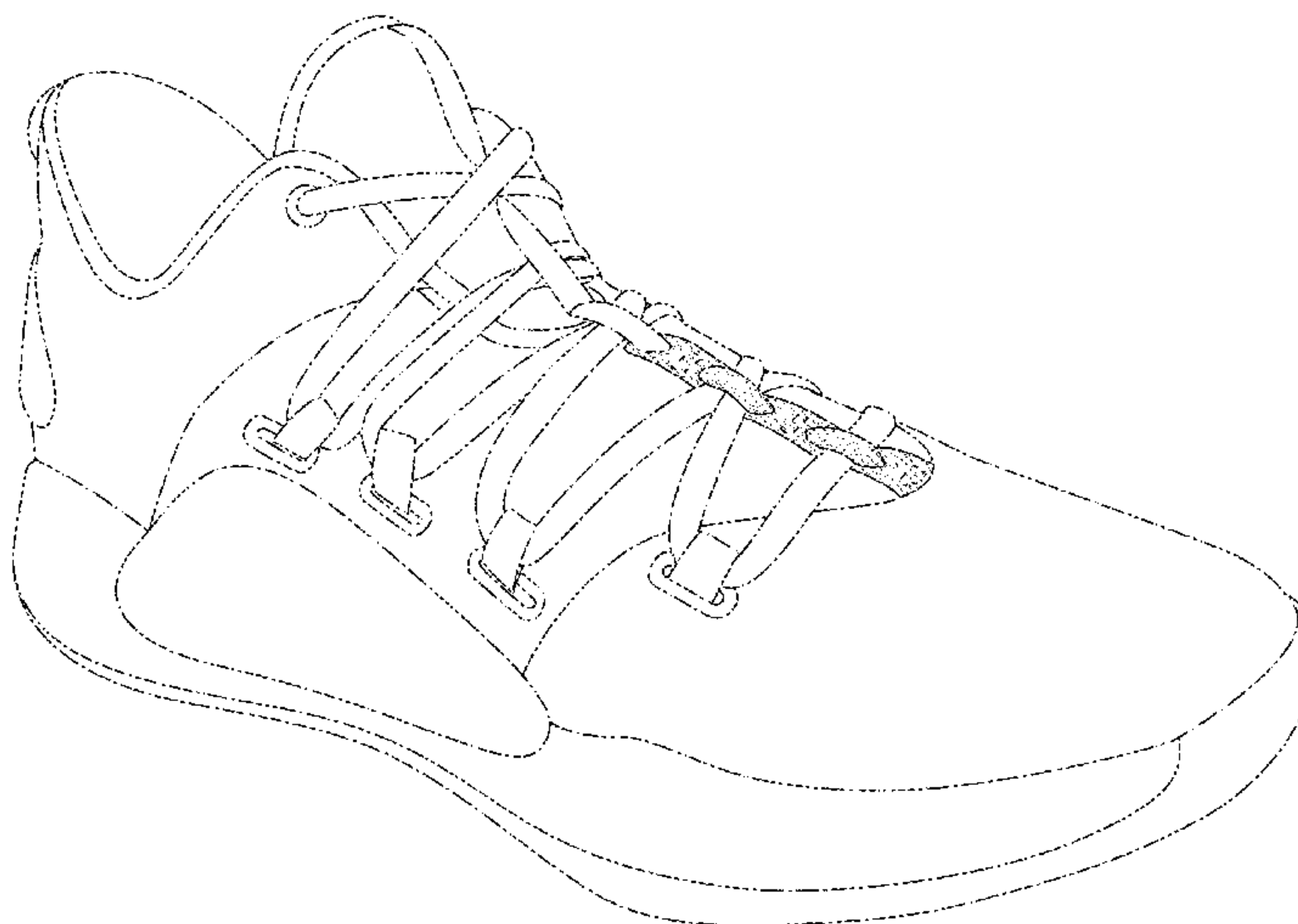
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a shoe showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a front view thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a top view thereof.

The uneven-length broken lines immediately adjacent to the shaded area define the bounds of the claimed design and form no part thereof. The even-length broken lines within the shaded area represent stitching which forms no part of the claimed design. The uneven-length broken lines showing the remainder of the shoe represent unclaimed subject matter and form no part of the claimed design.

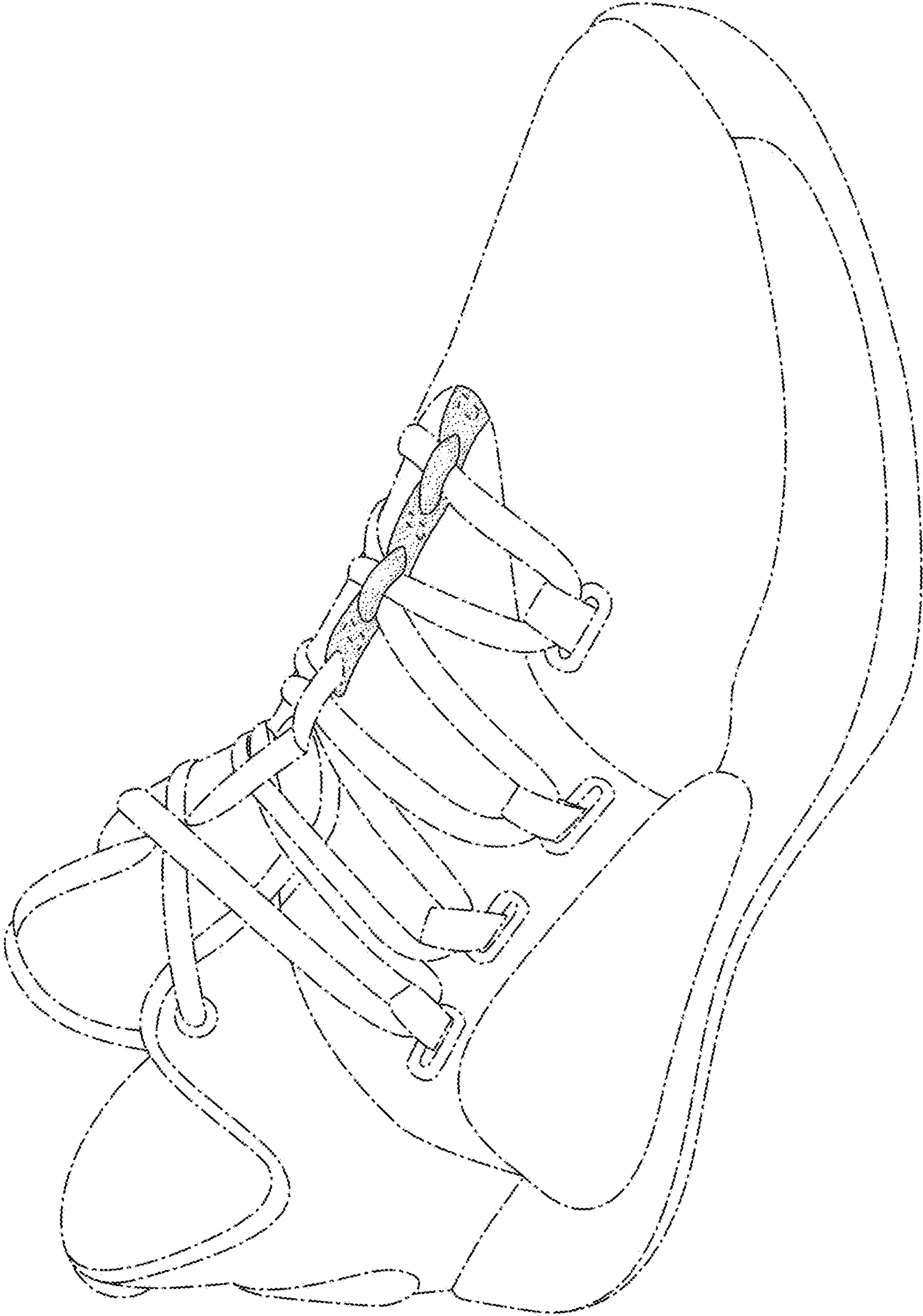

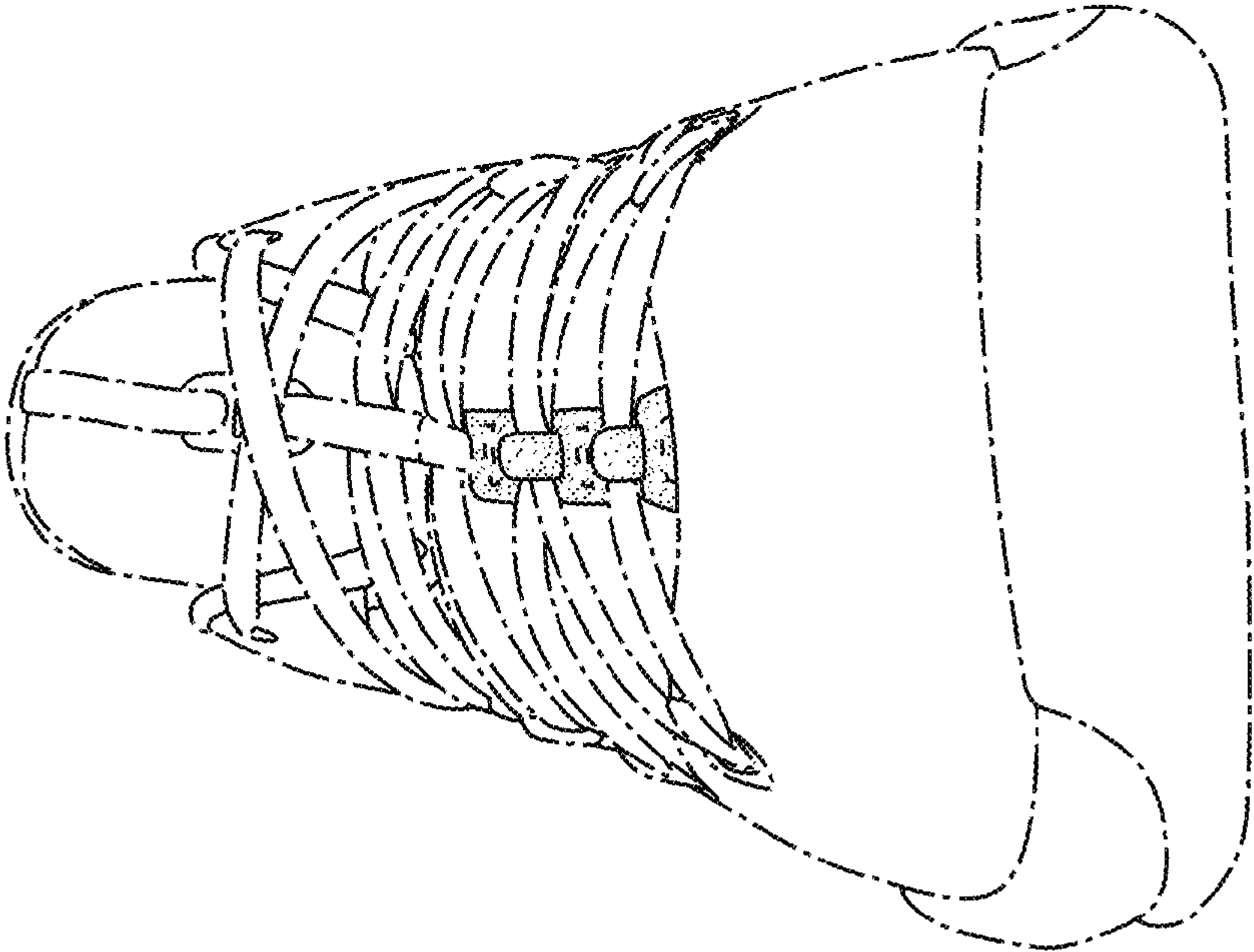

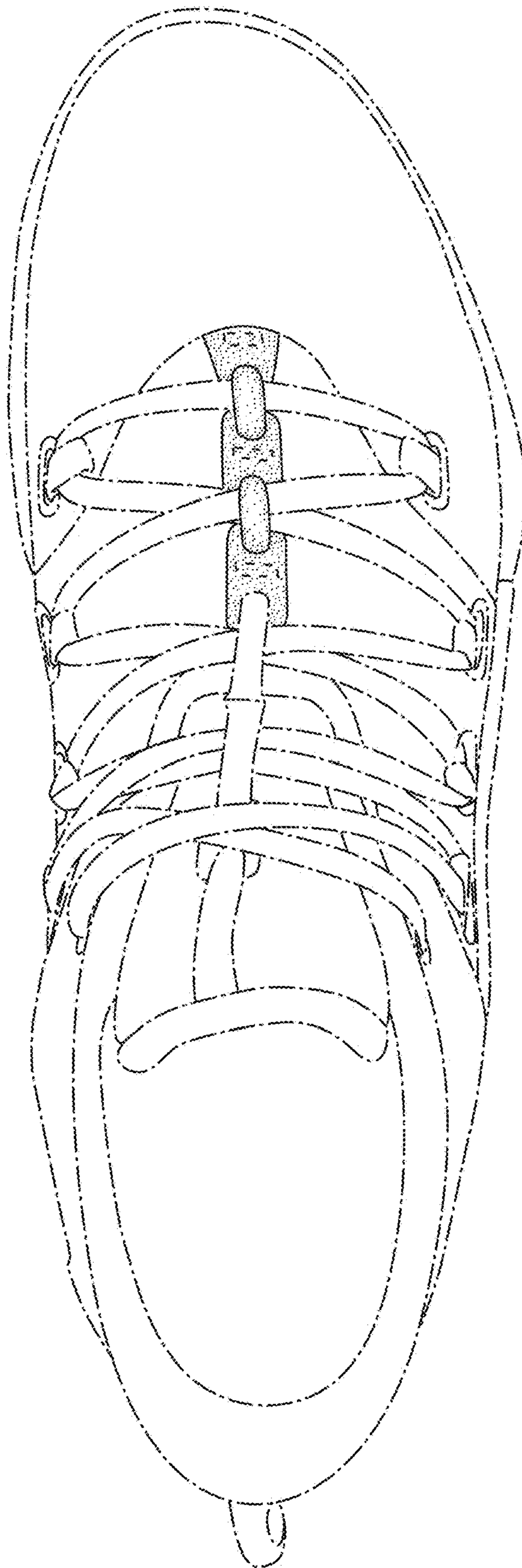
