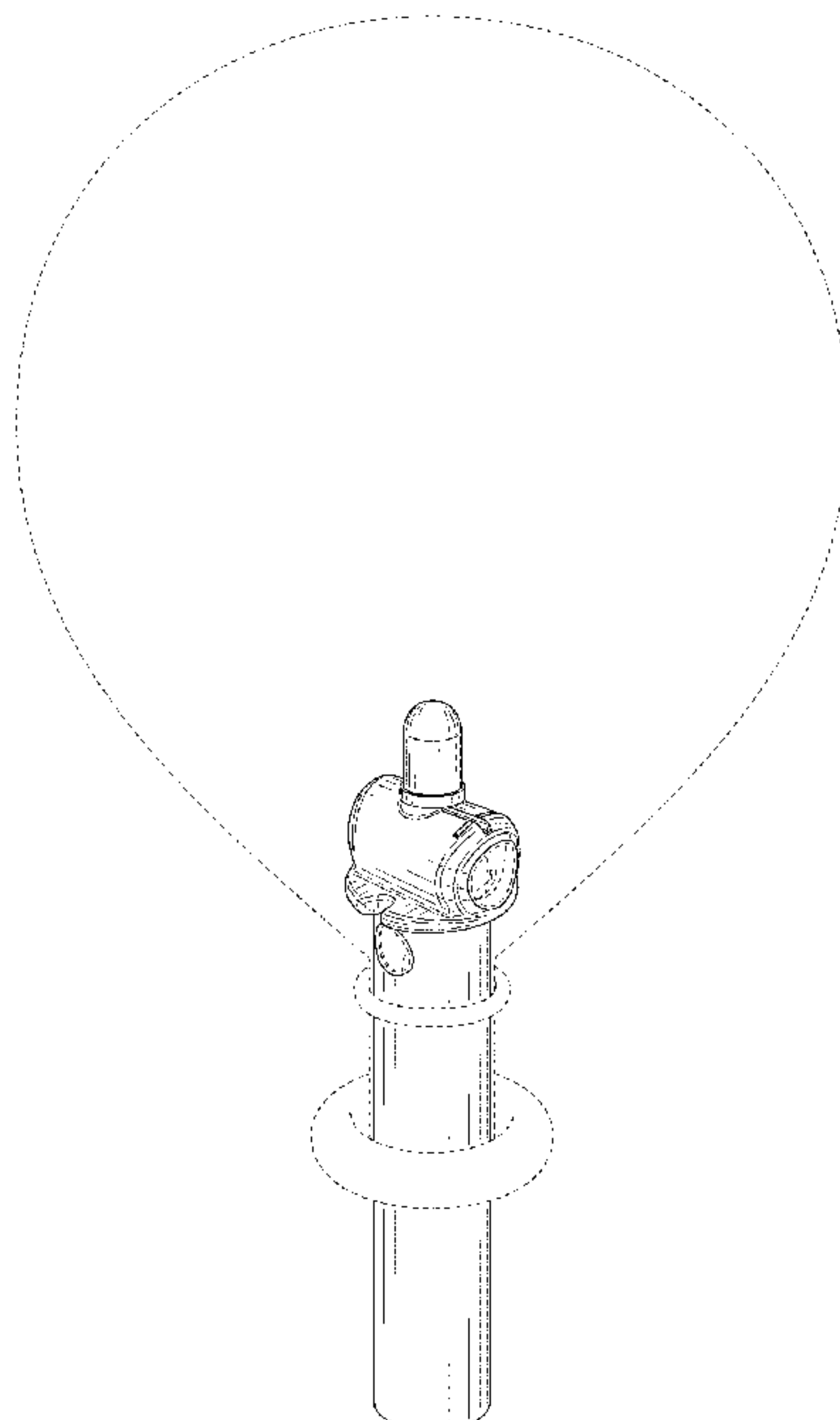
FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a balloon illuminating

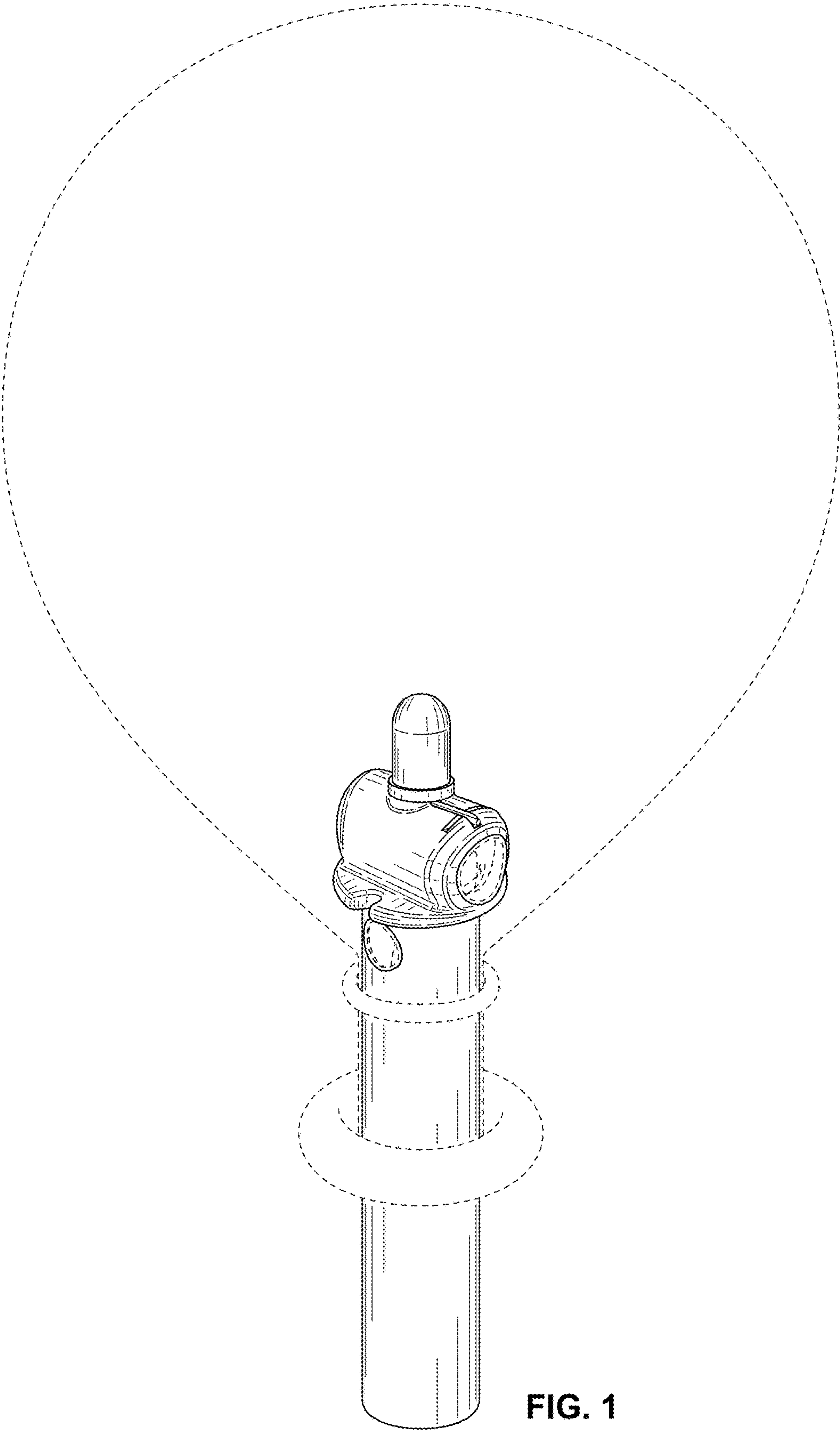

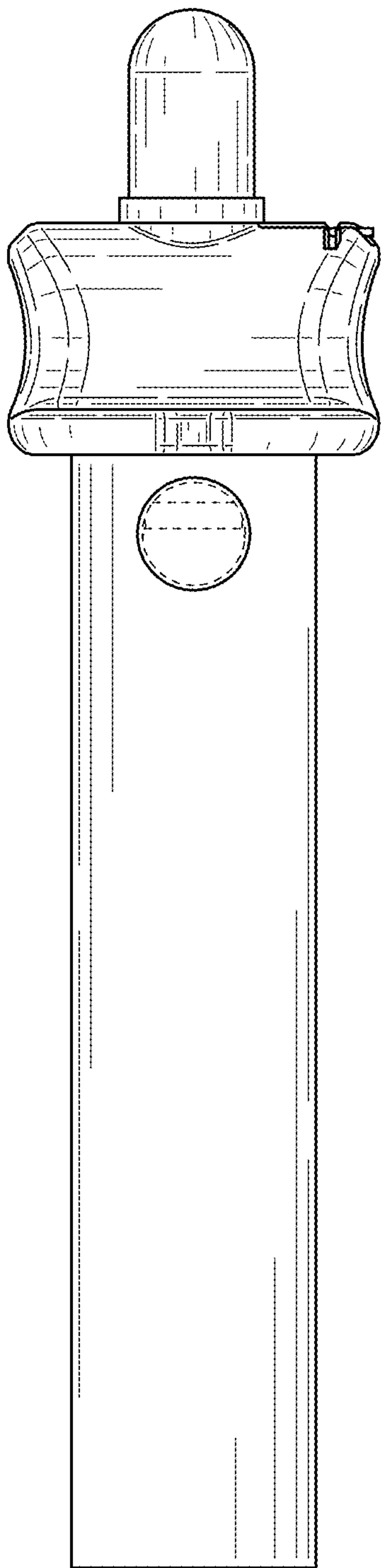

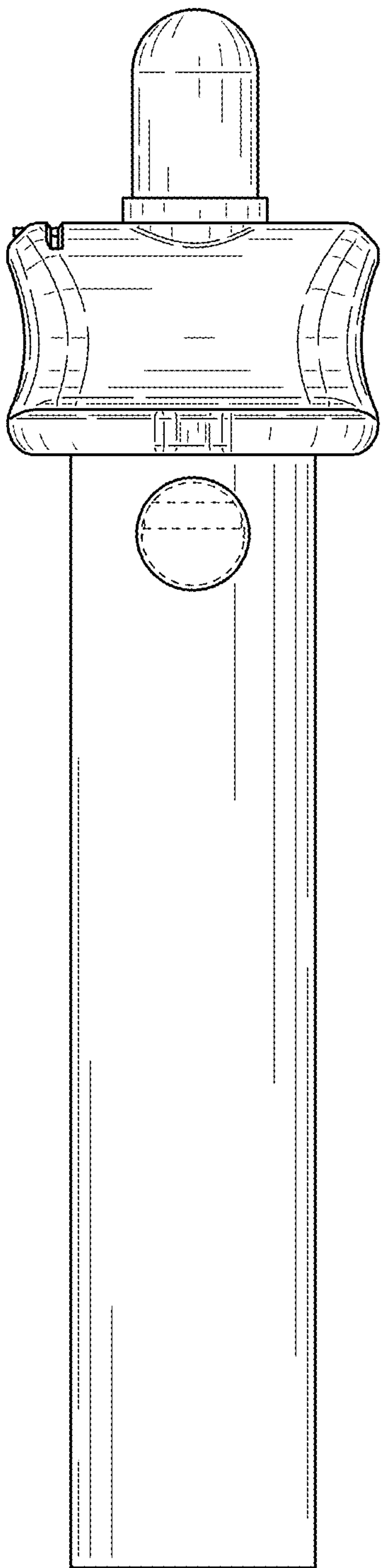

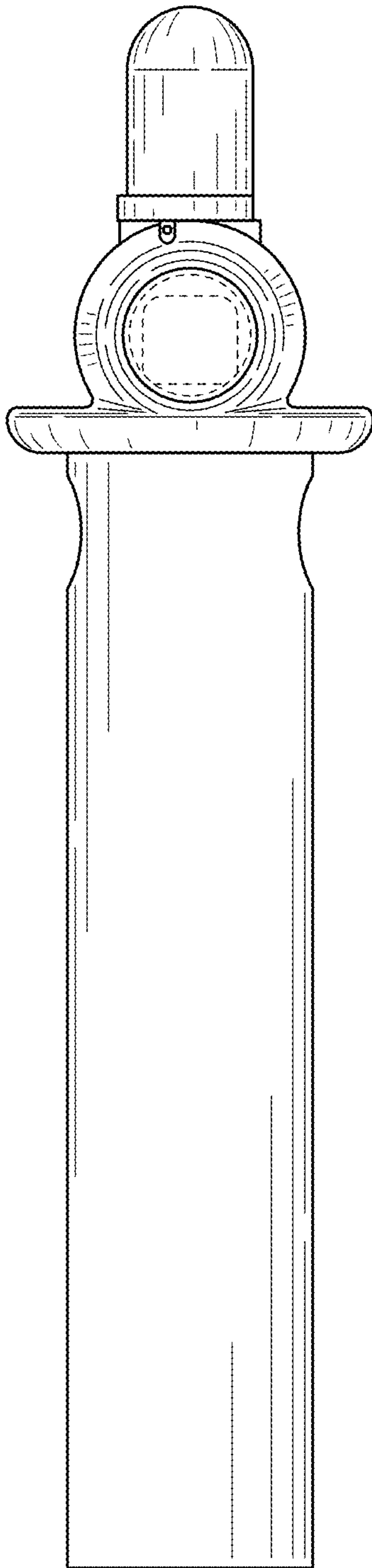

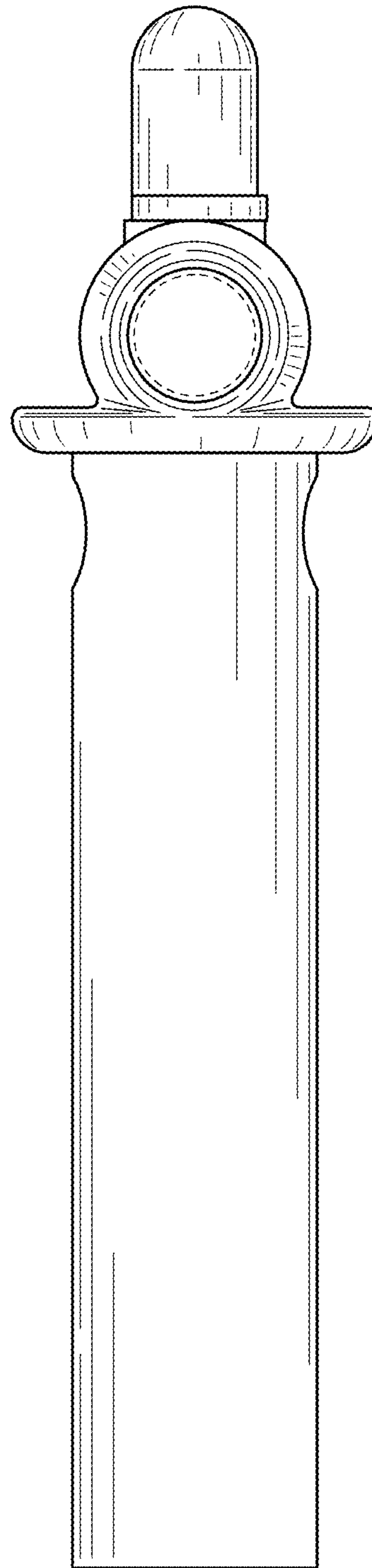

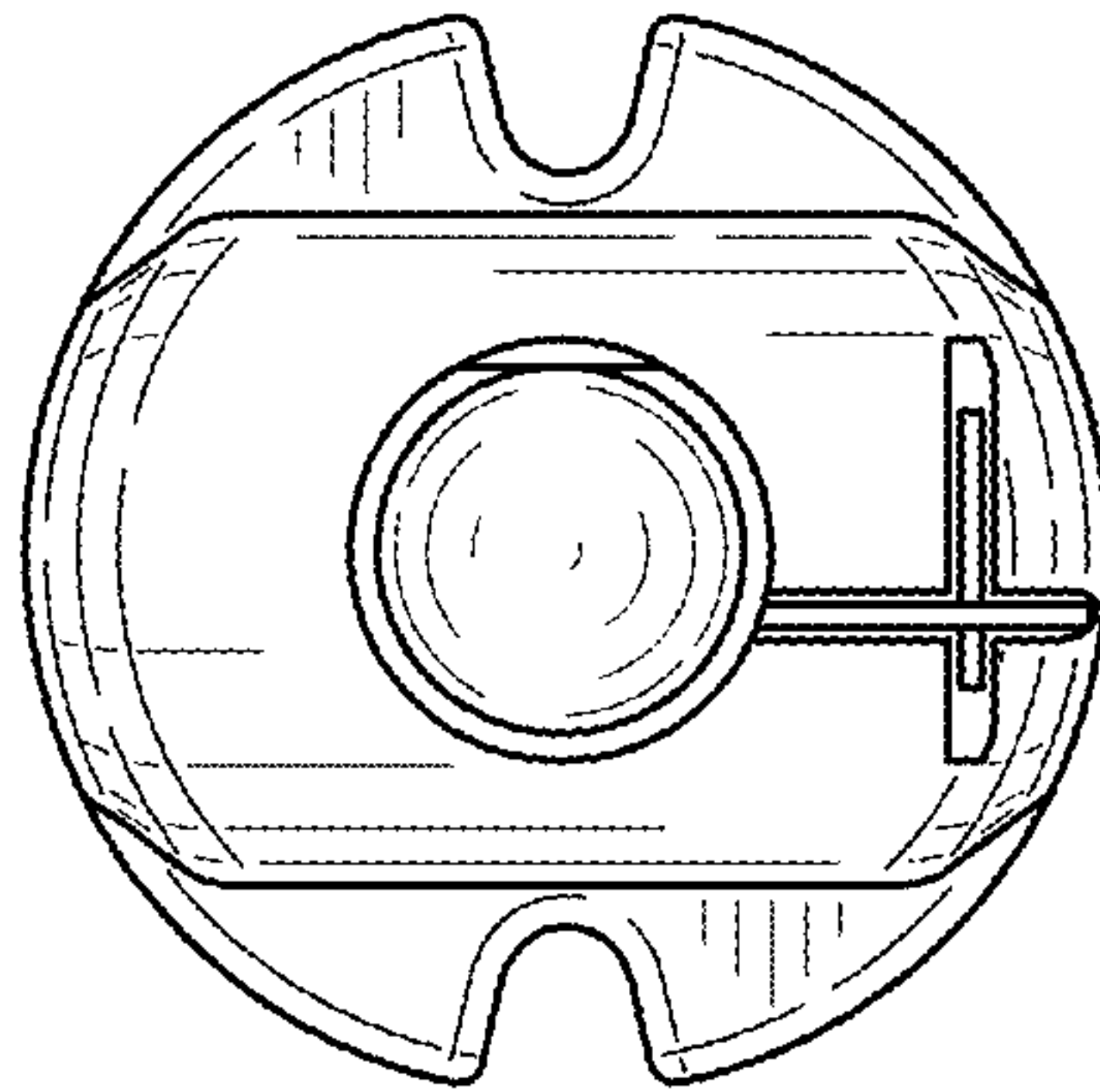

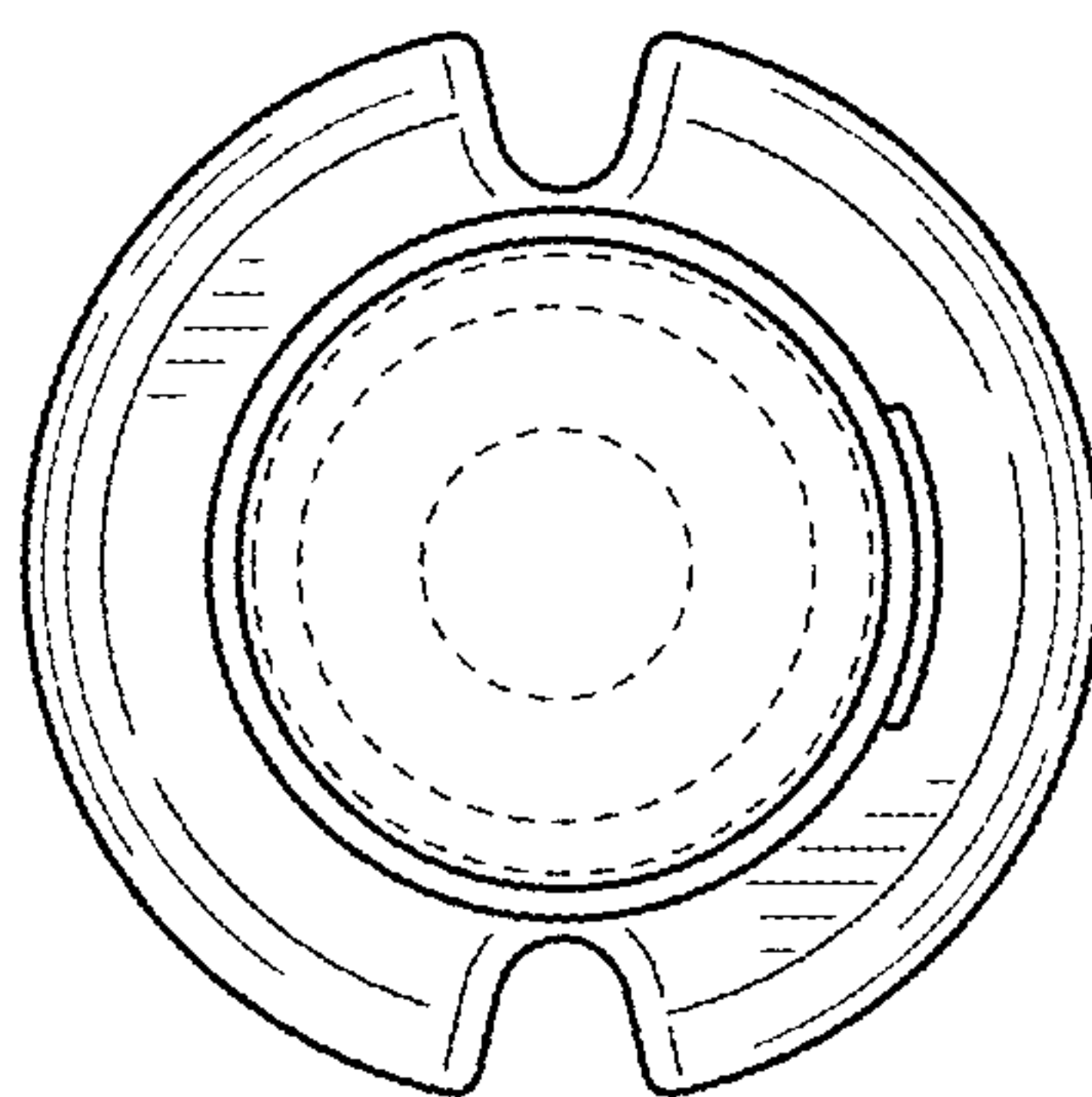
