DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a lighting component
showing one example of the design according to the present
disclosure.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the lighting component of FIG.
1; and,

FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of the lighting component of
FIG. 1; the other sides being symmetrical thereto.

The bottom of the lighting component forms no part of the

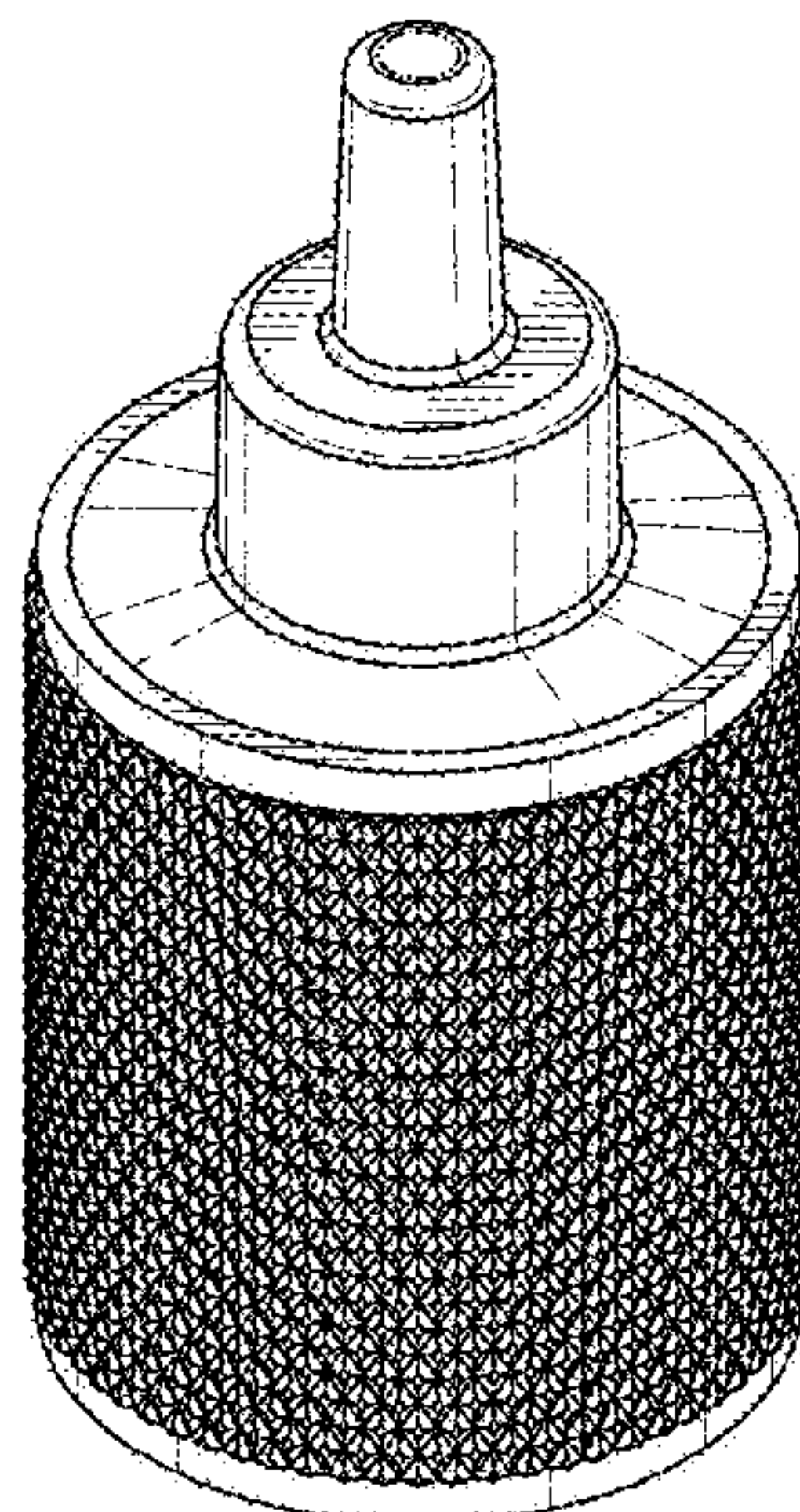

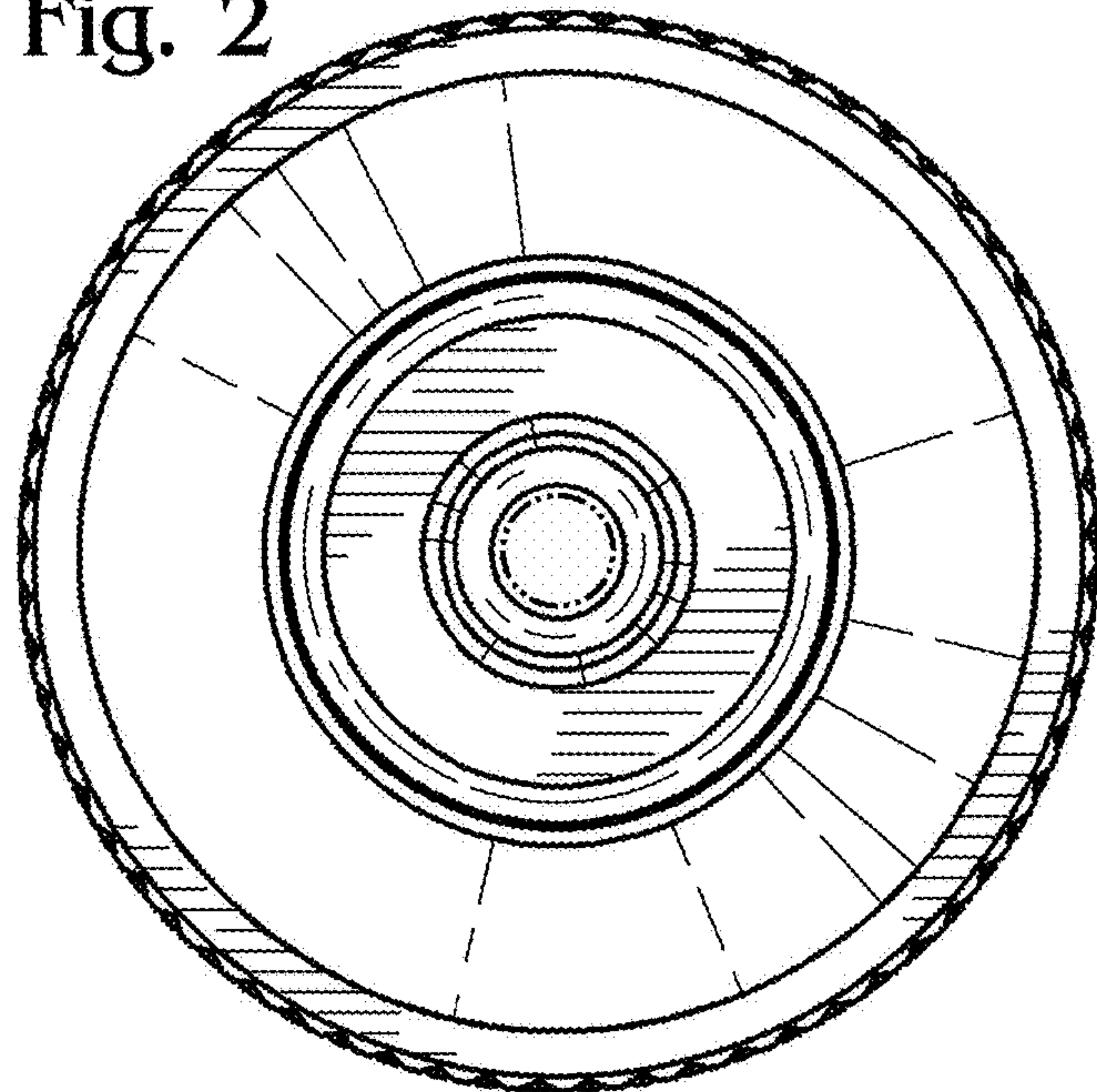

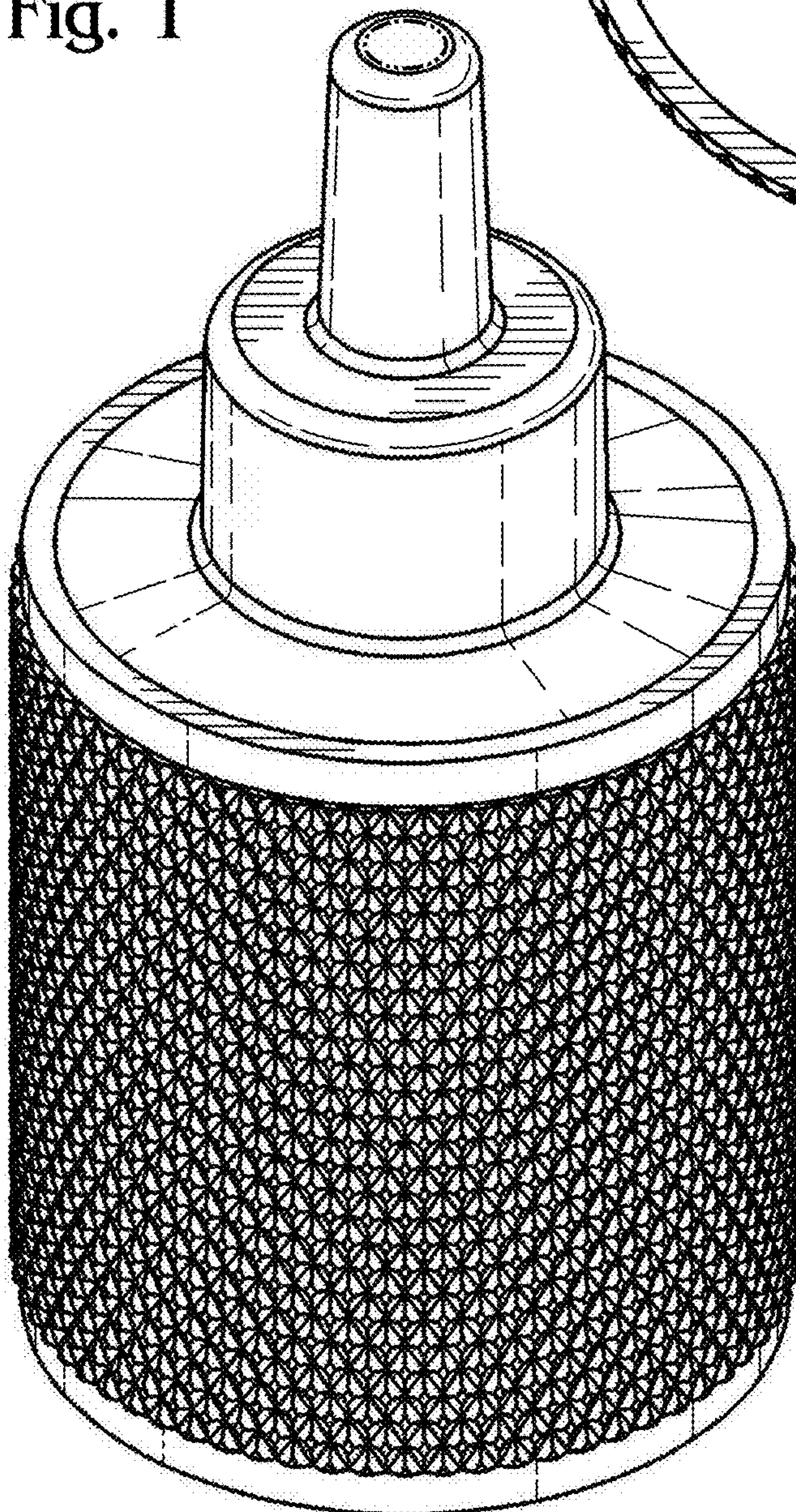
