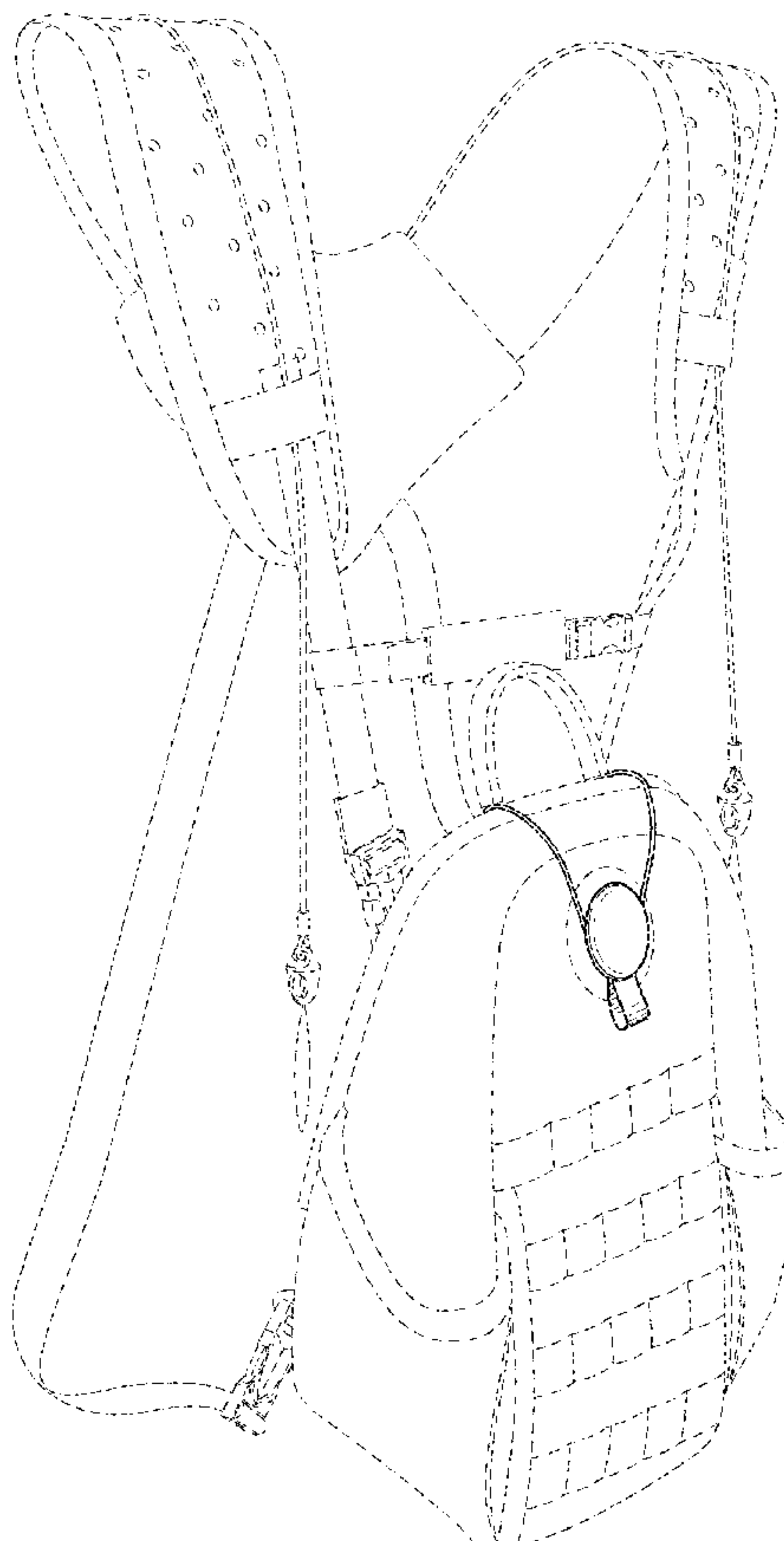

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top, left-side perspective view of the binocular case;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and,

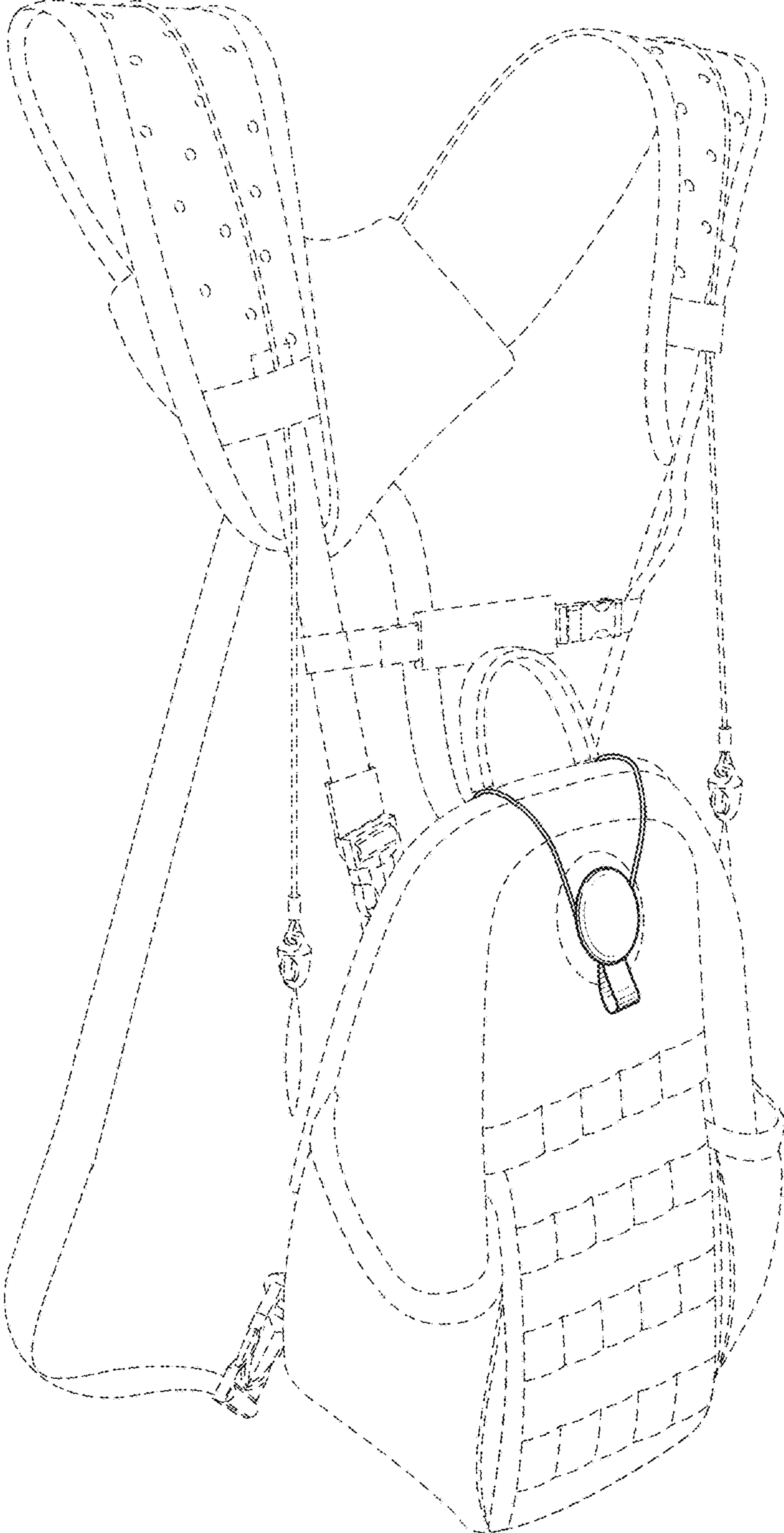

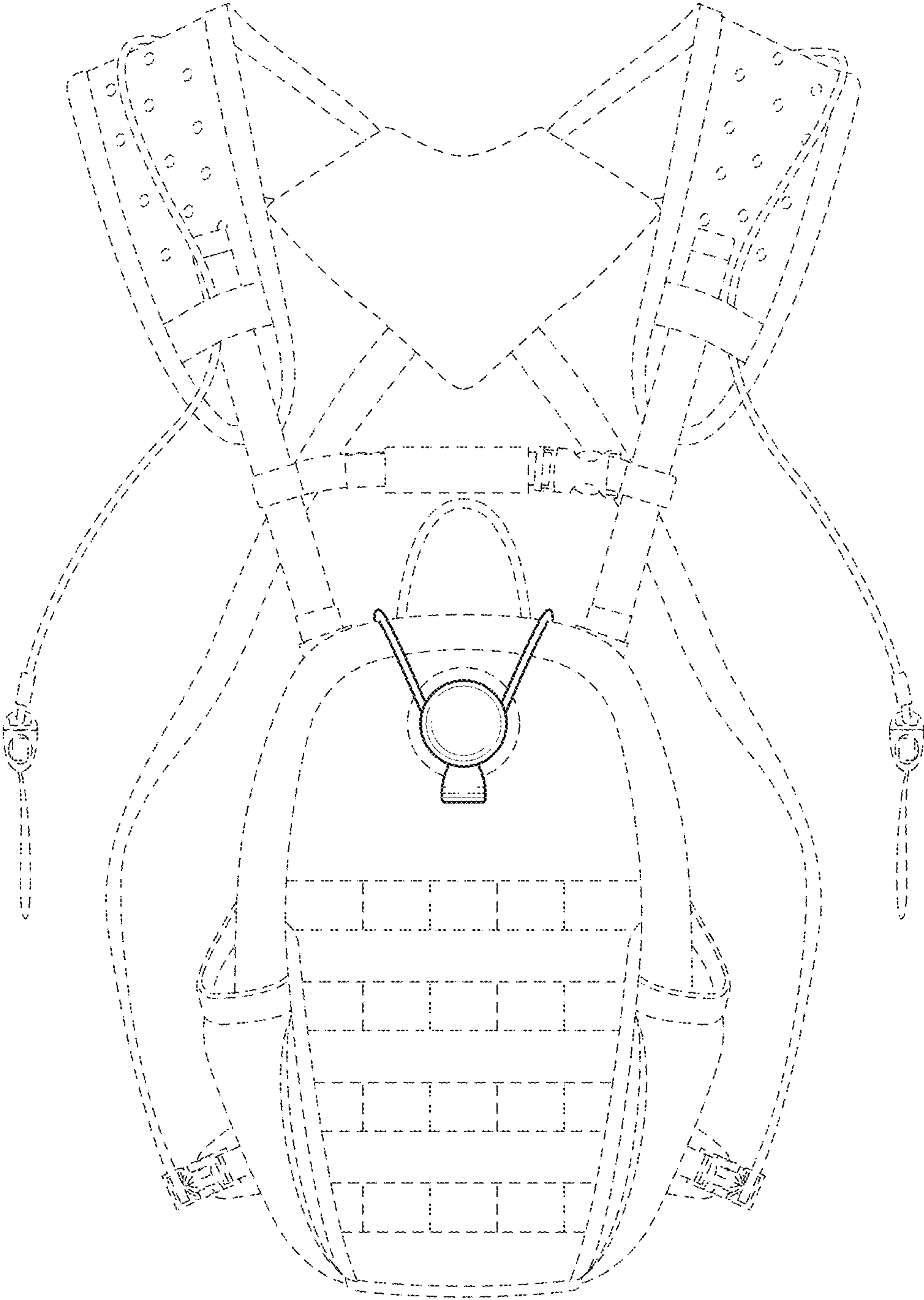

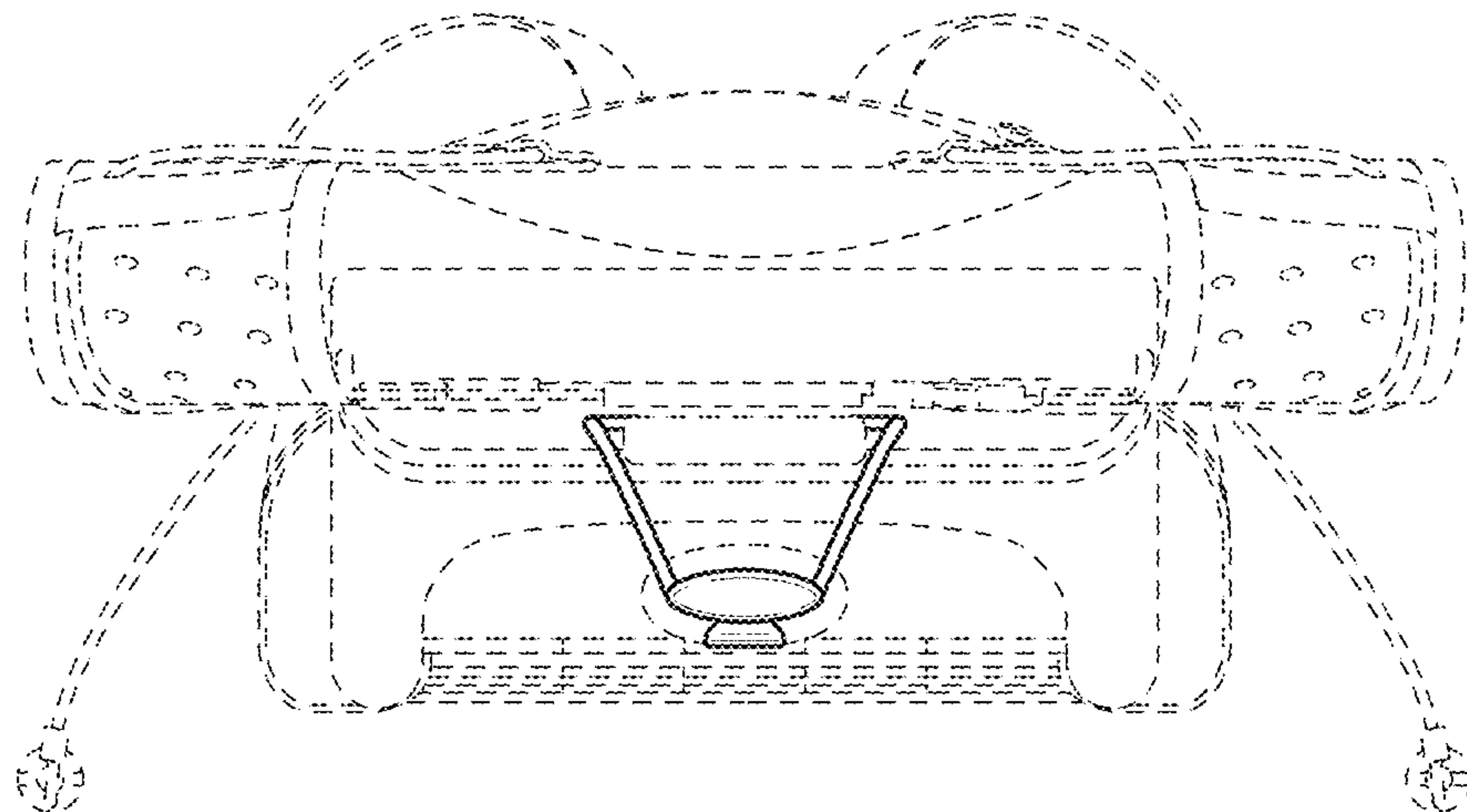

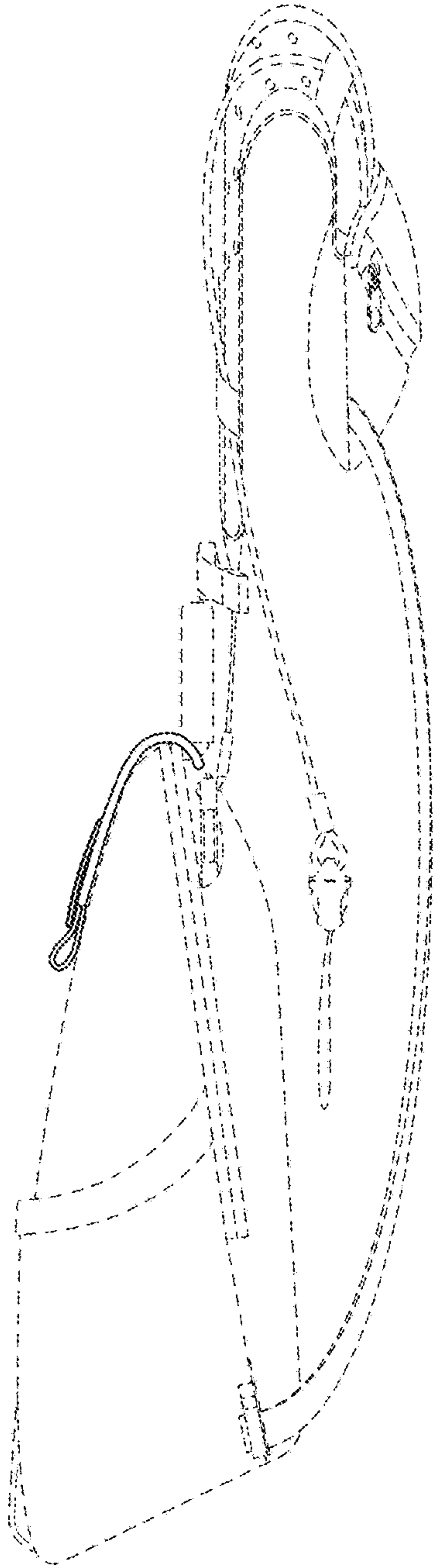

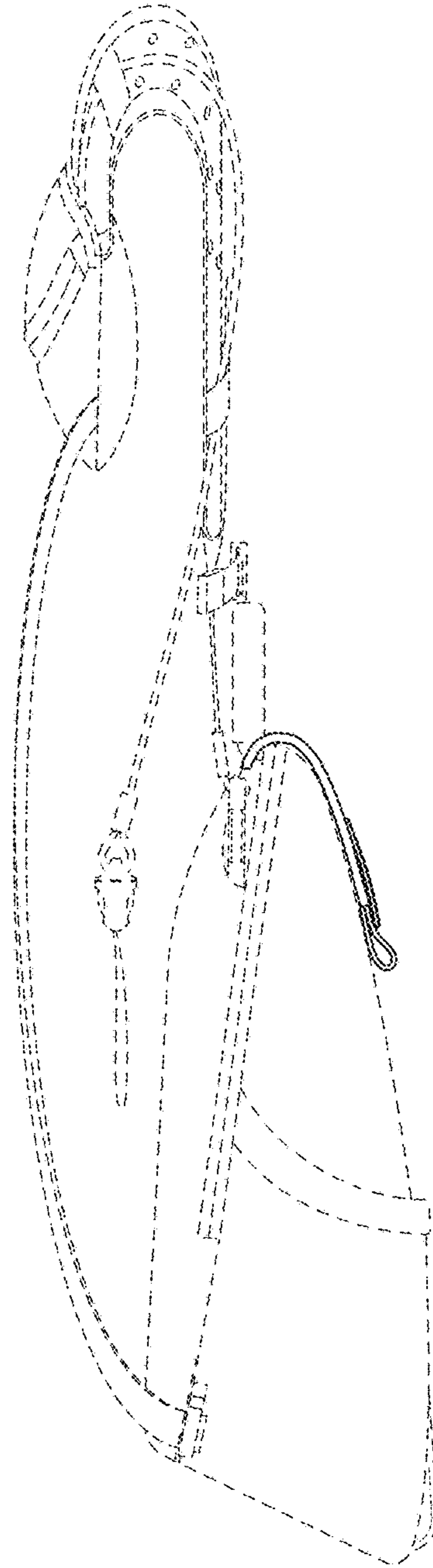

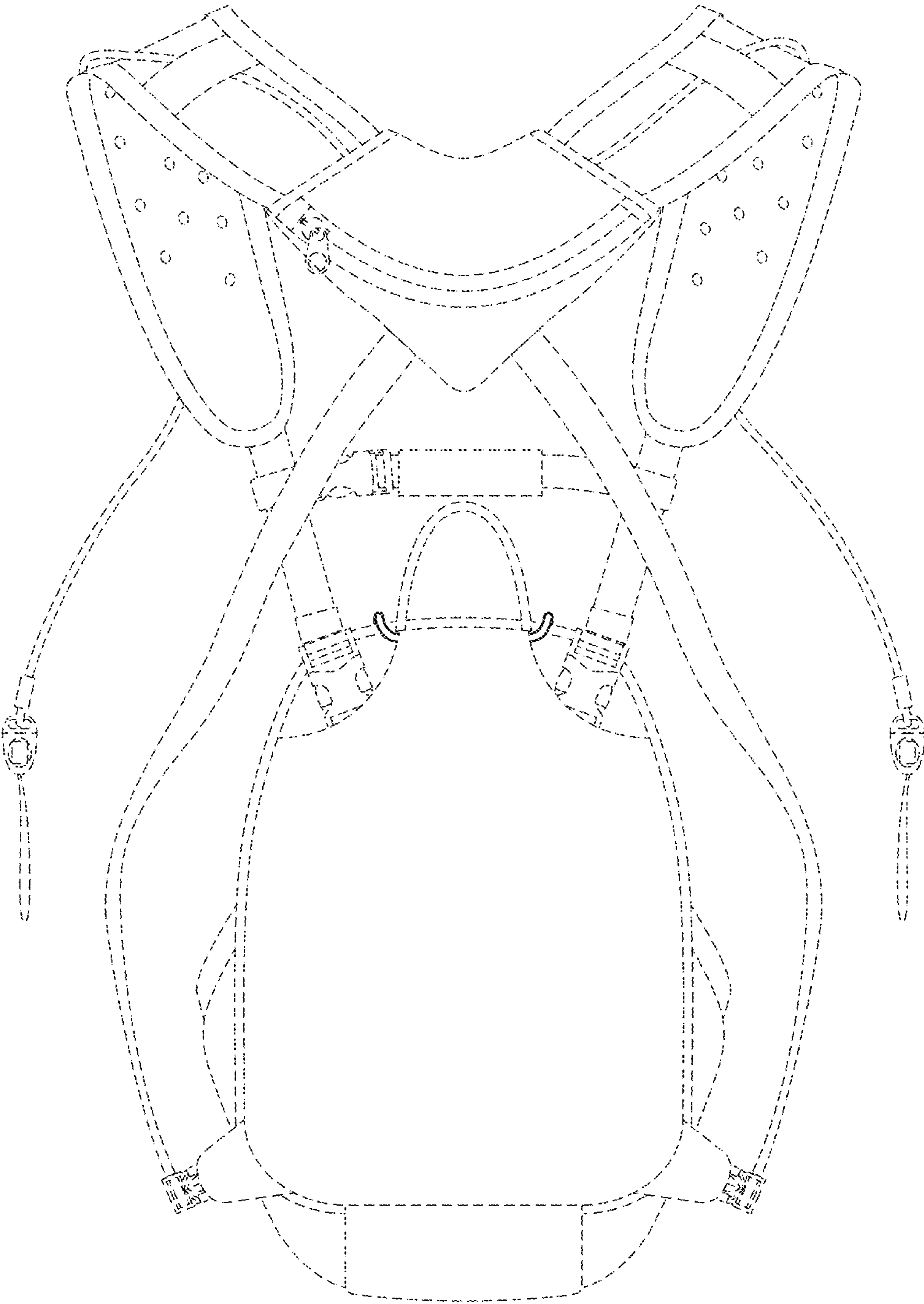

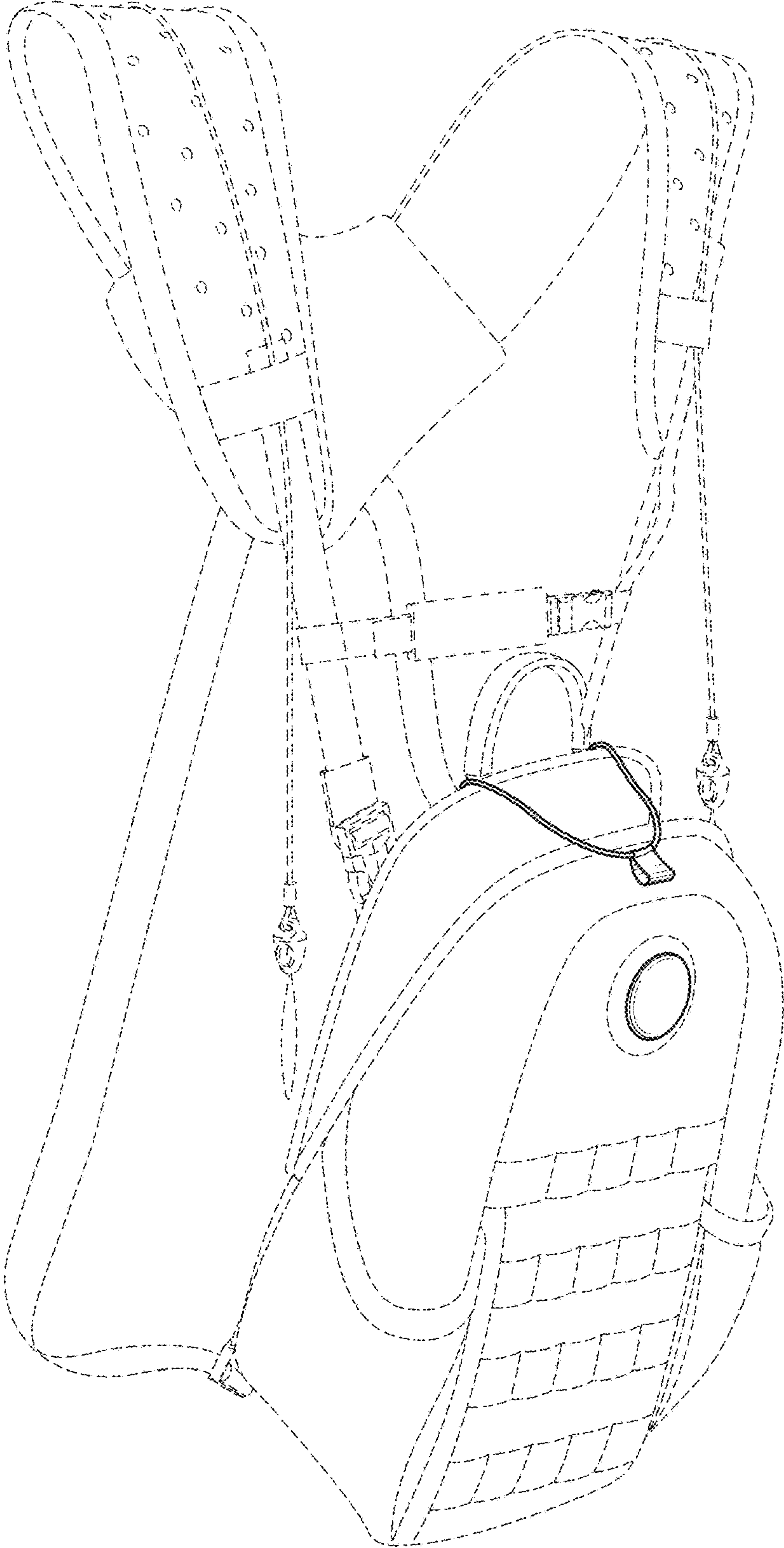
