FIG. 3 is a bottom thereof;

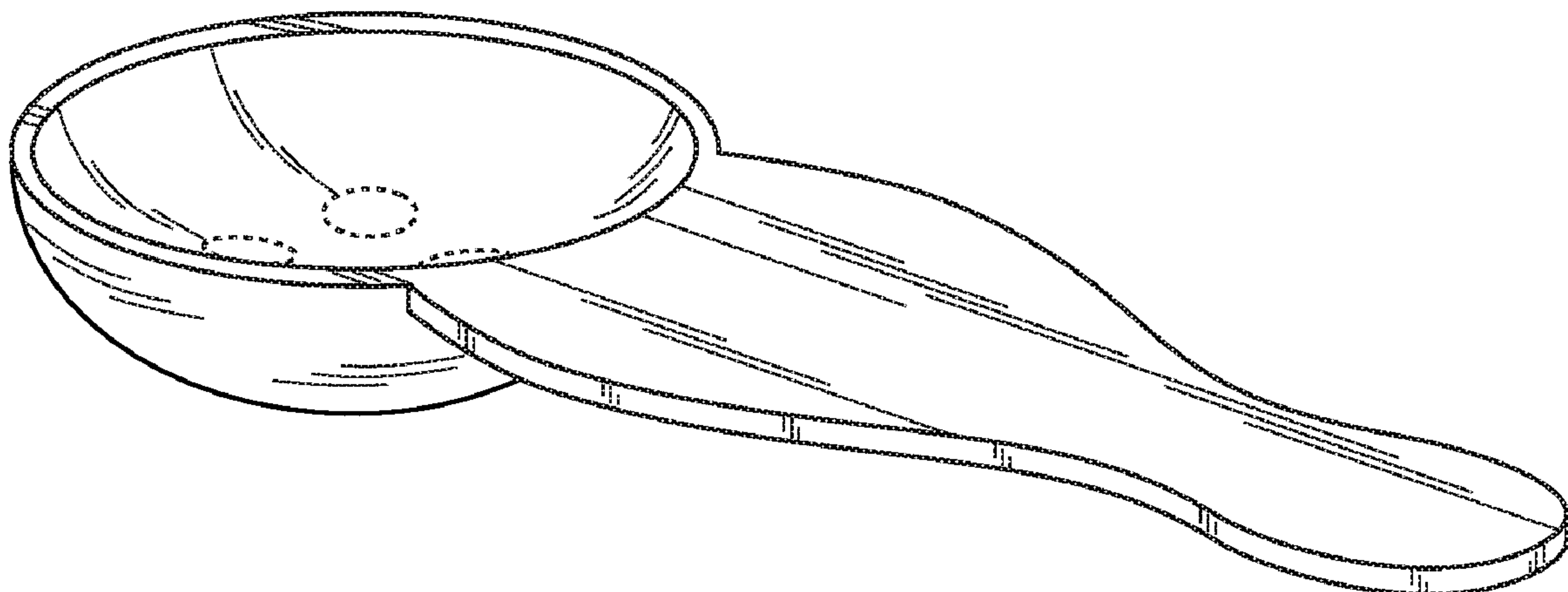
FIG. 4 is a front side view thereof;

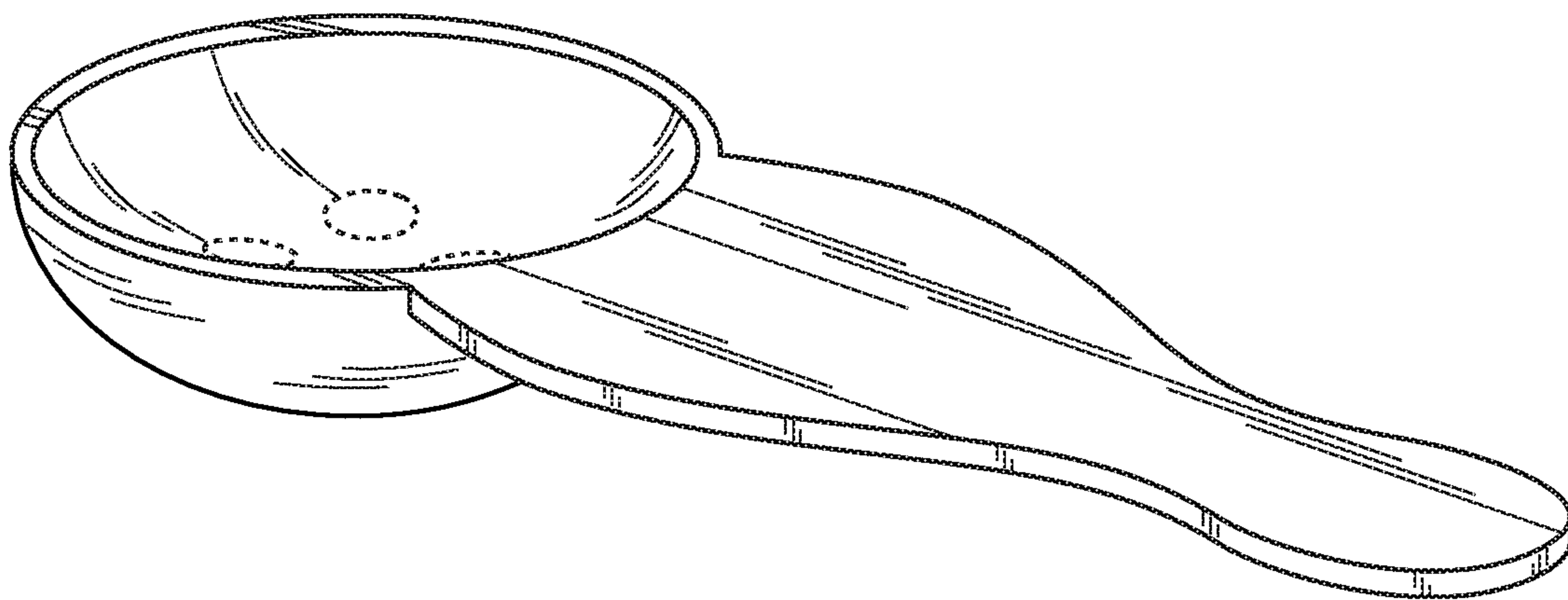

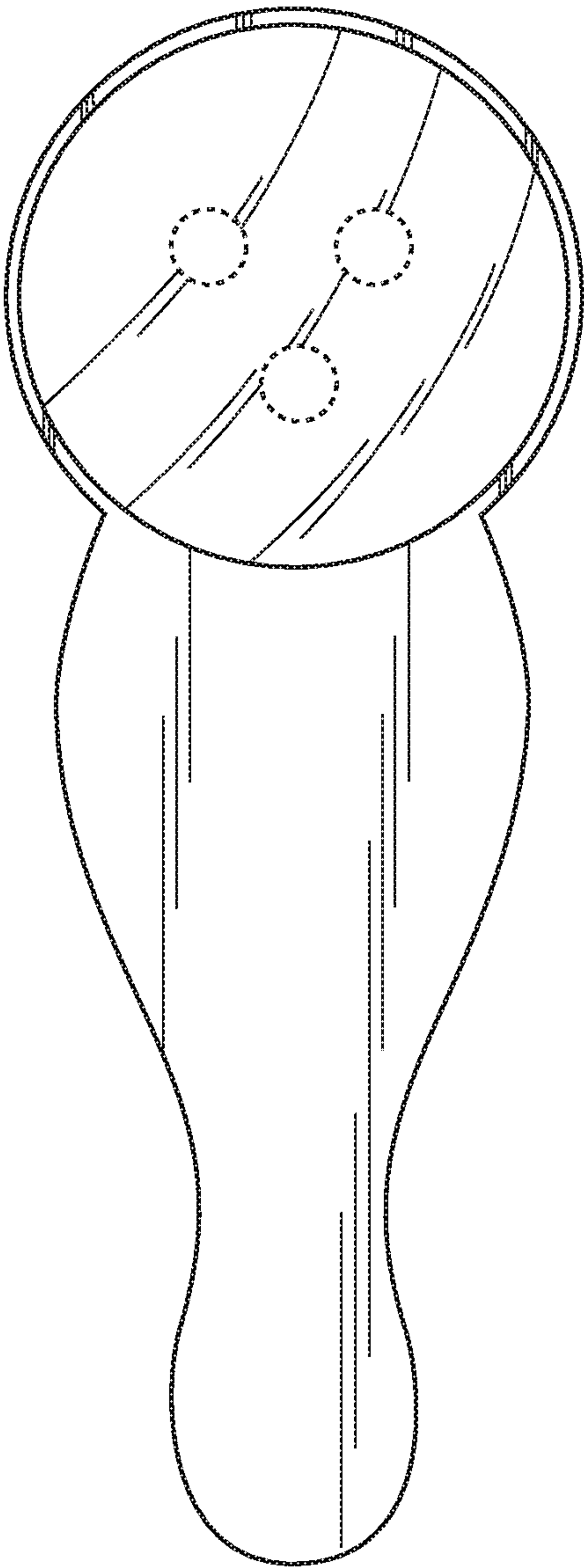

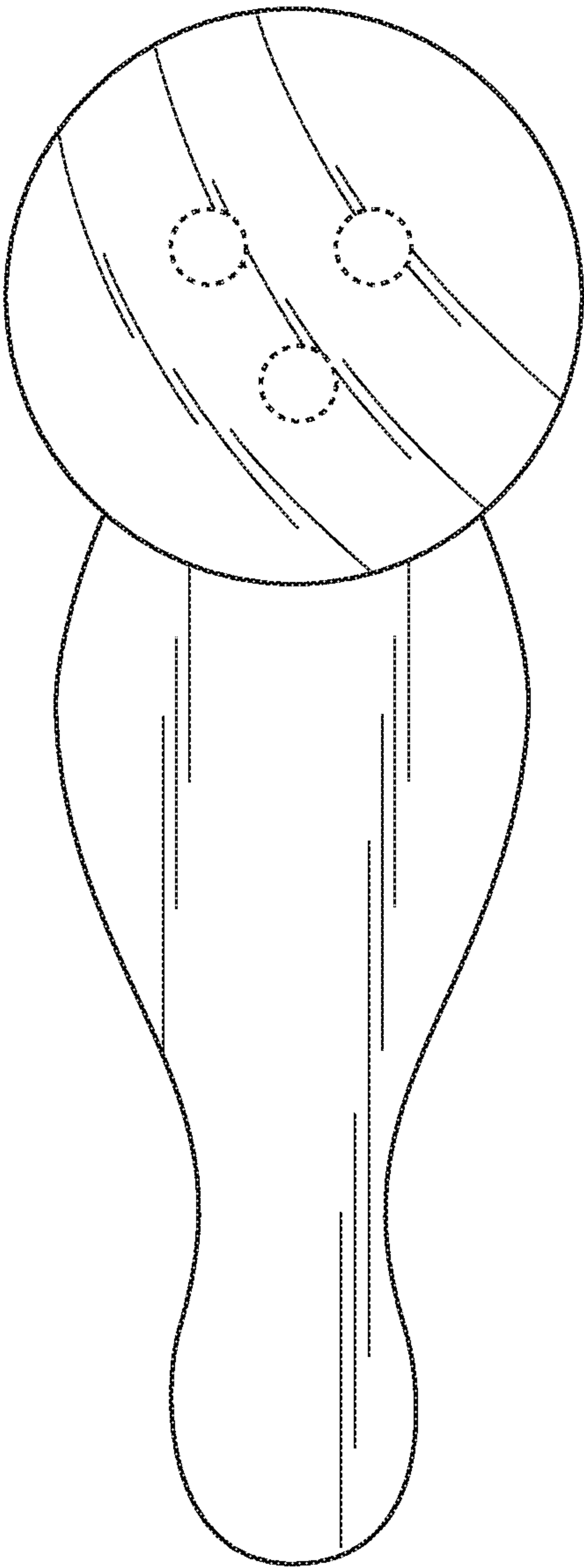

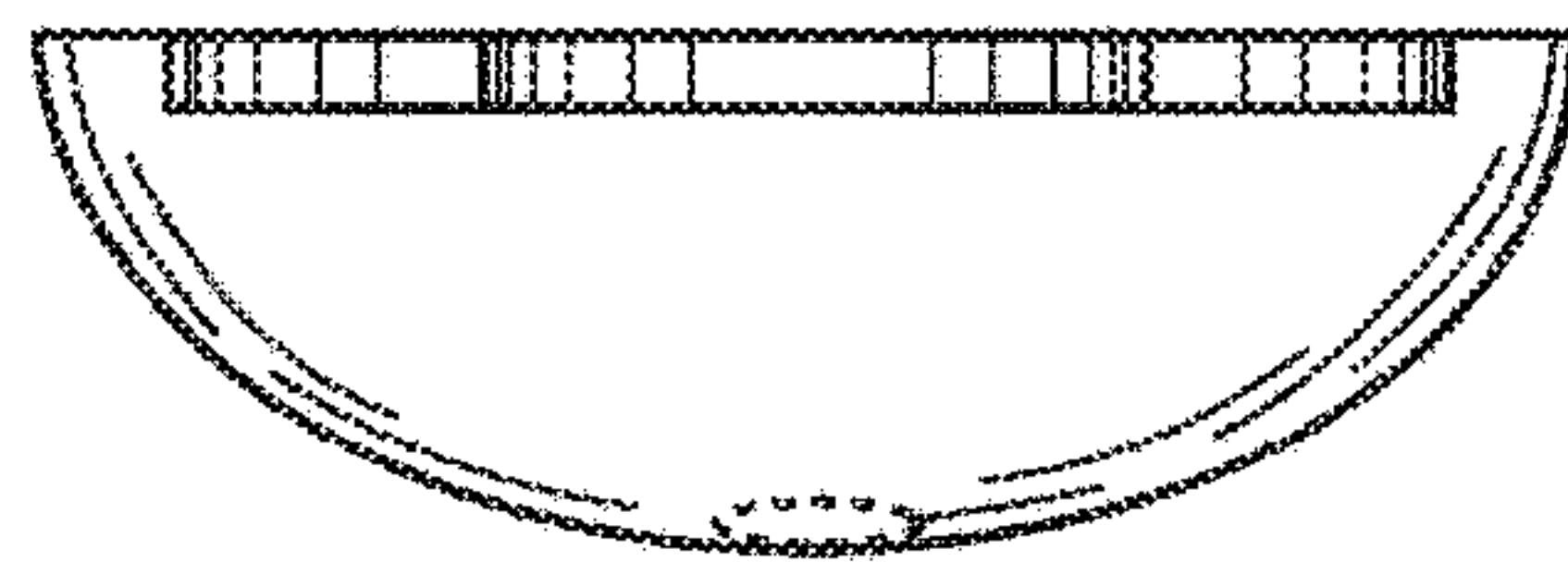

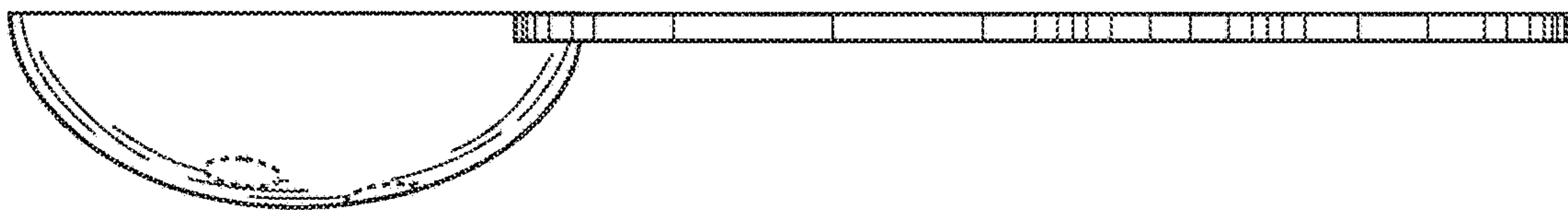
