Applicant’s invention.

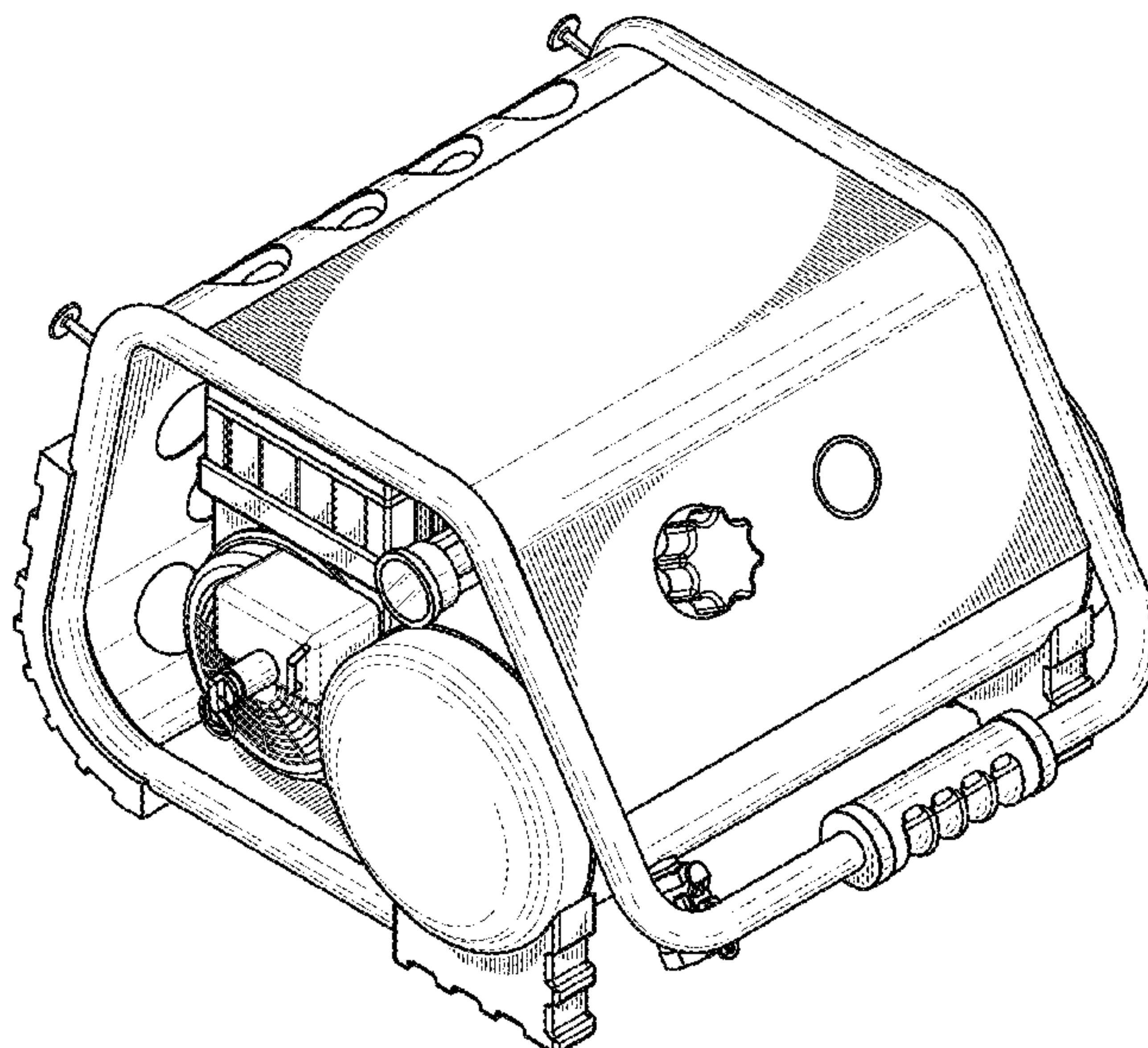
FIG. 4 is a front elevation view of the “compressor” of

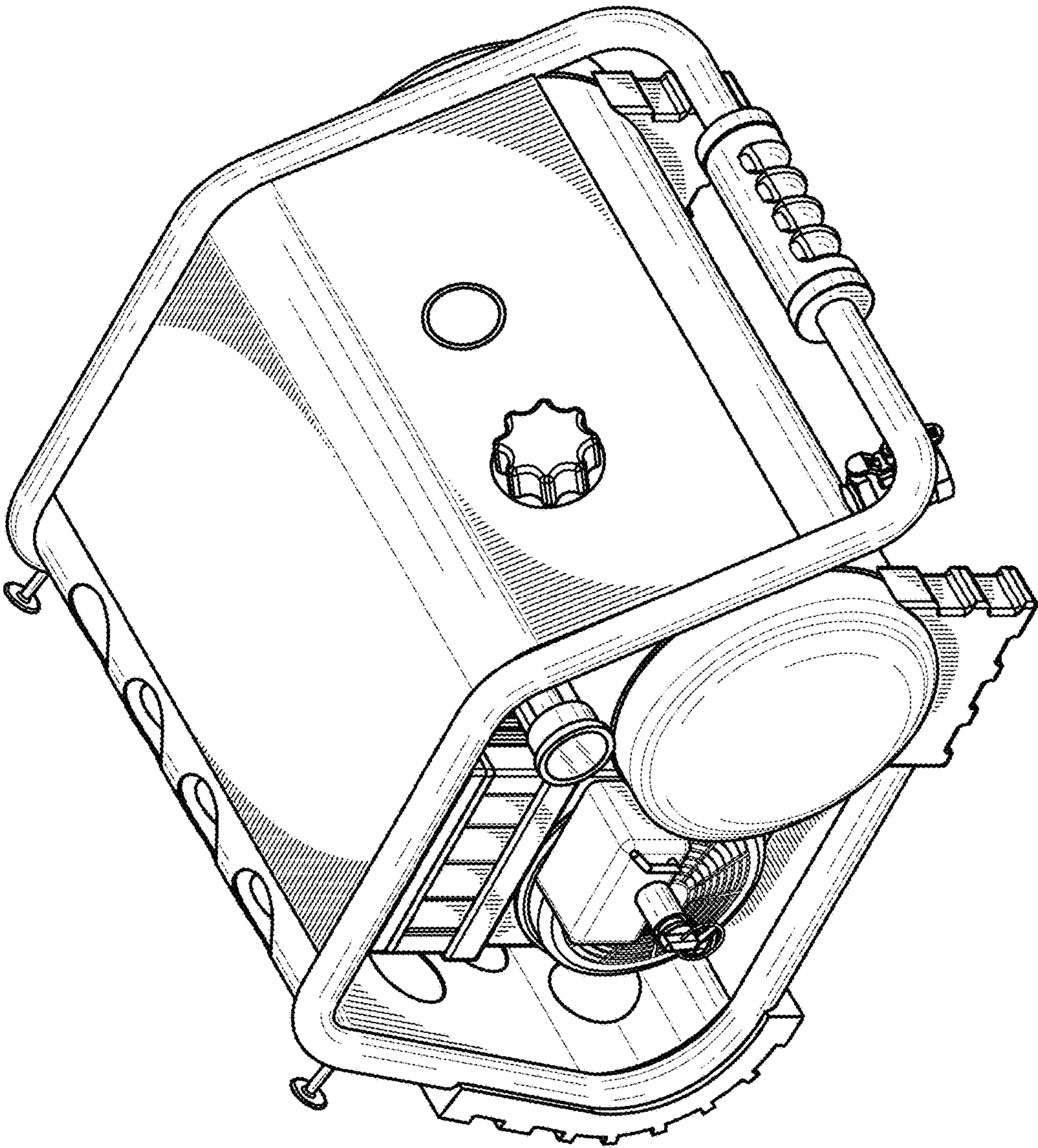

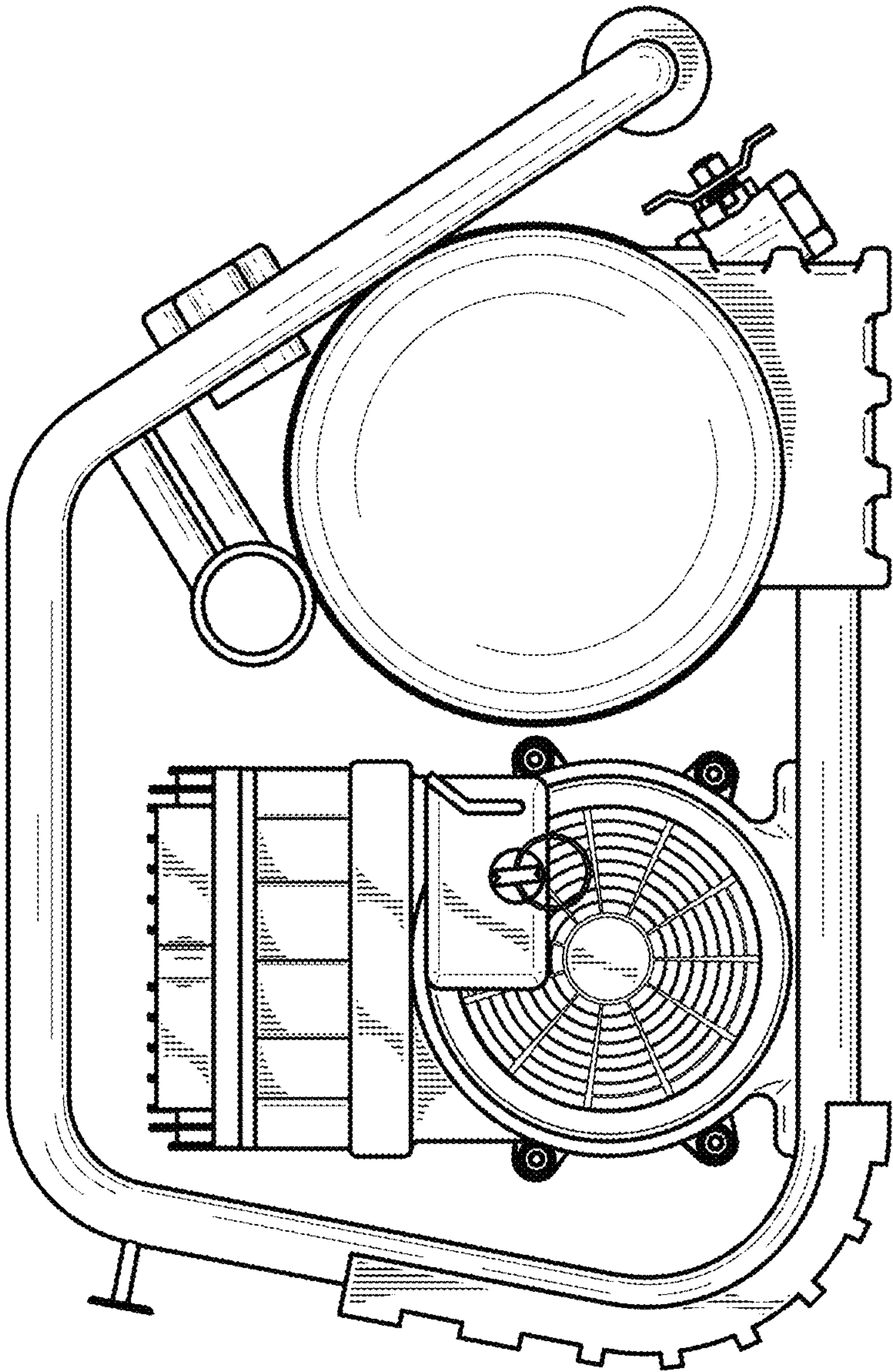

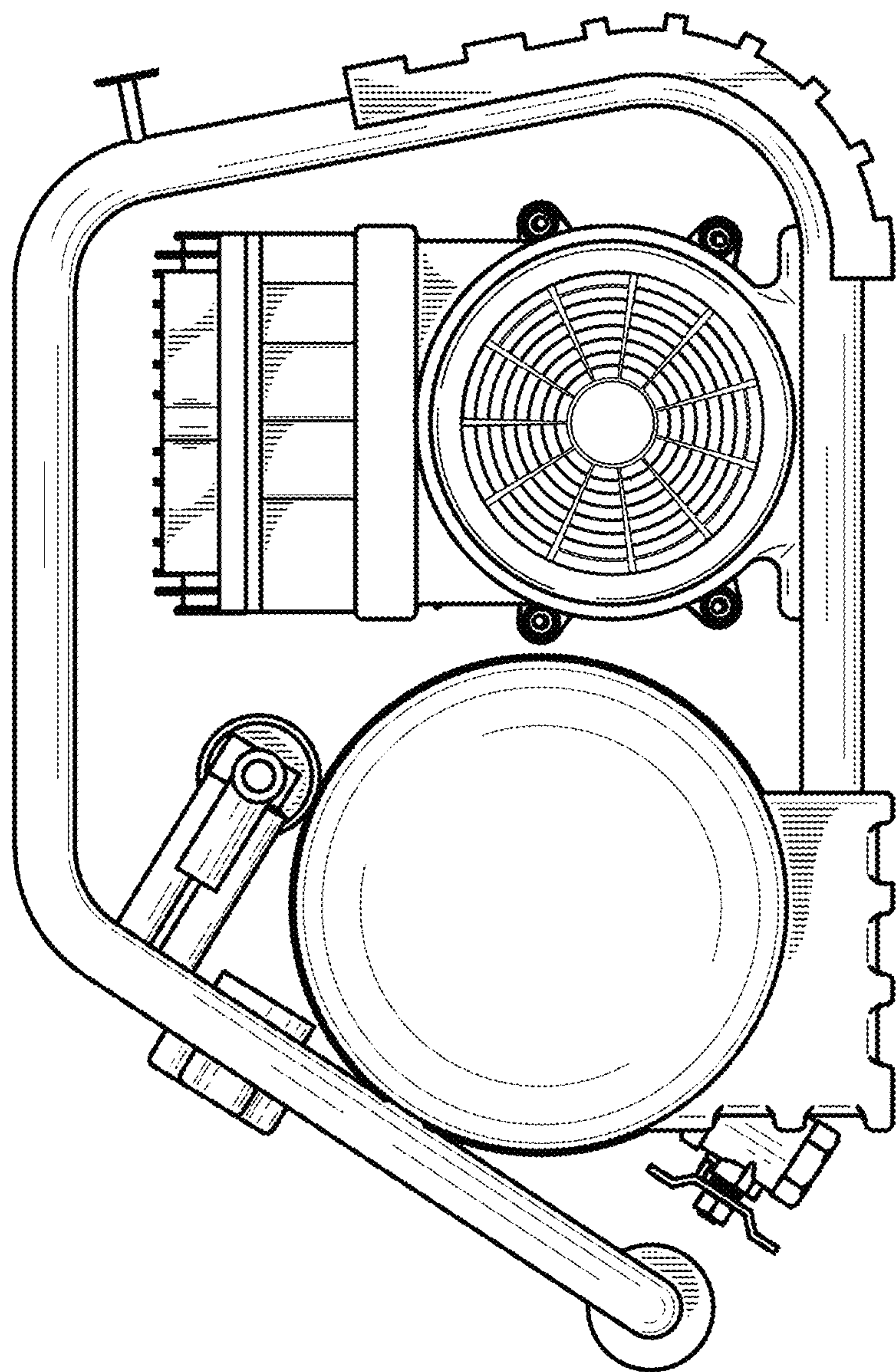

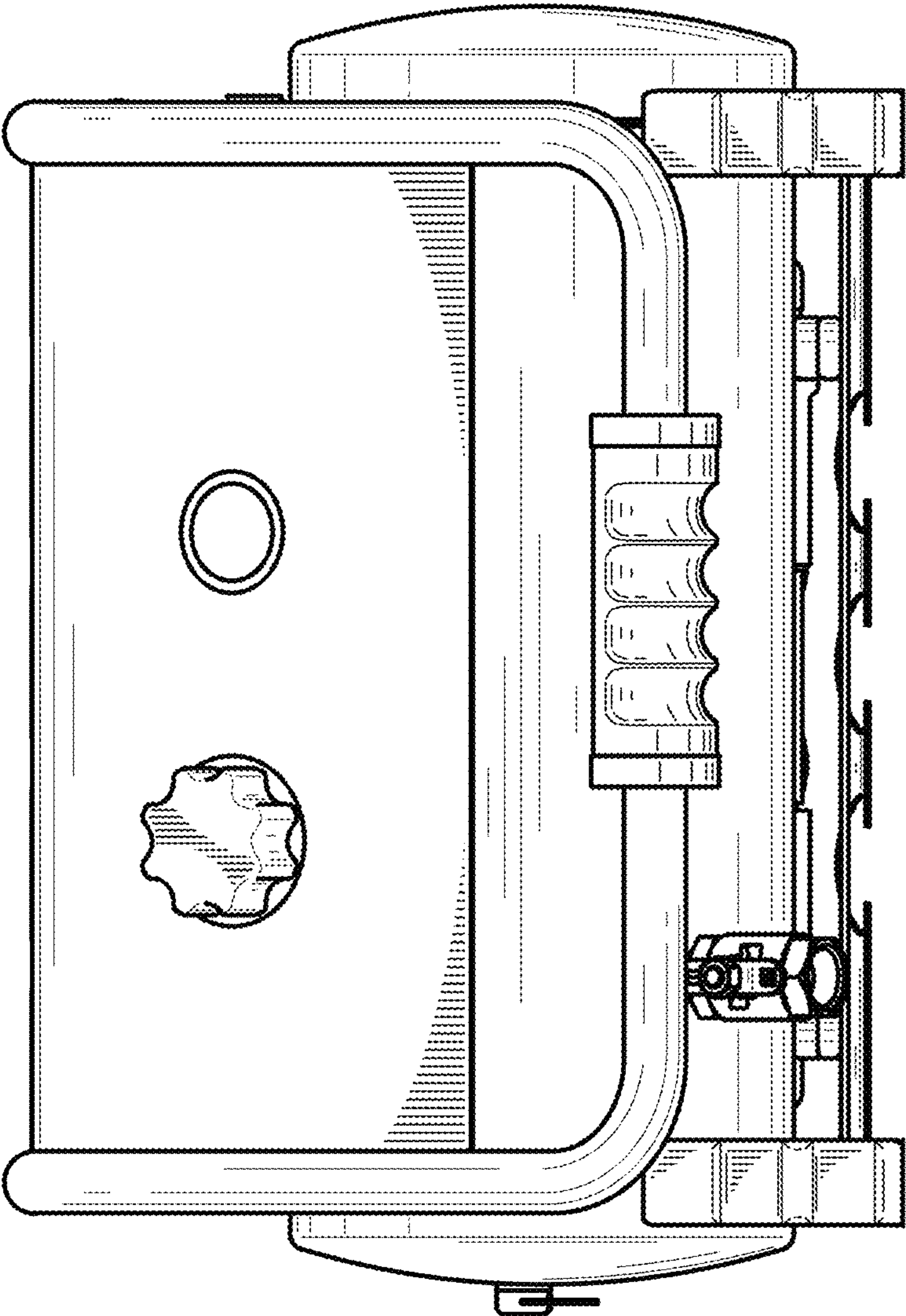

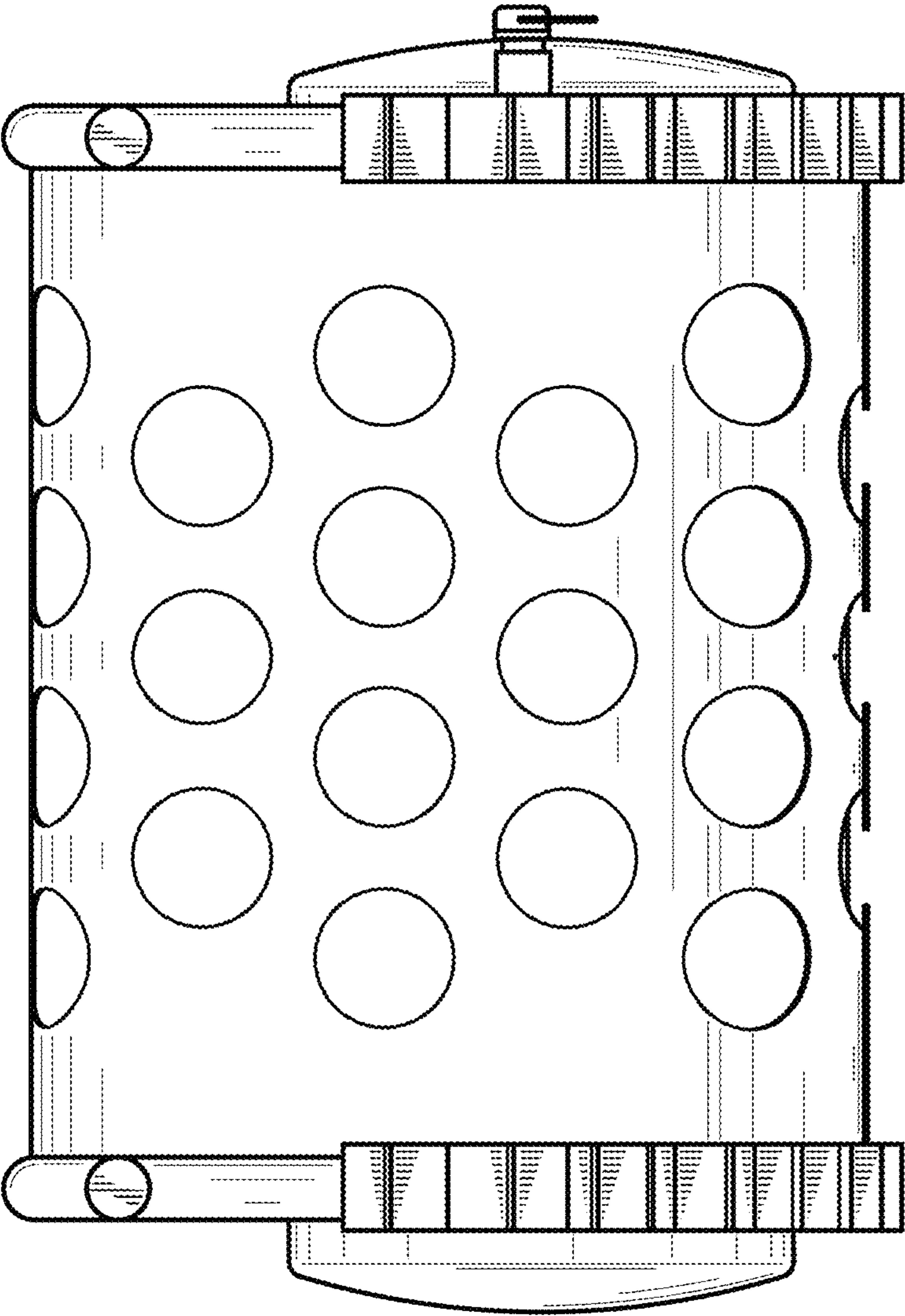

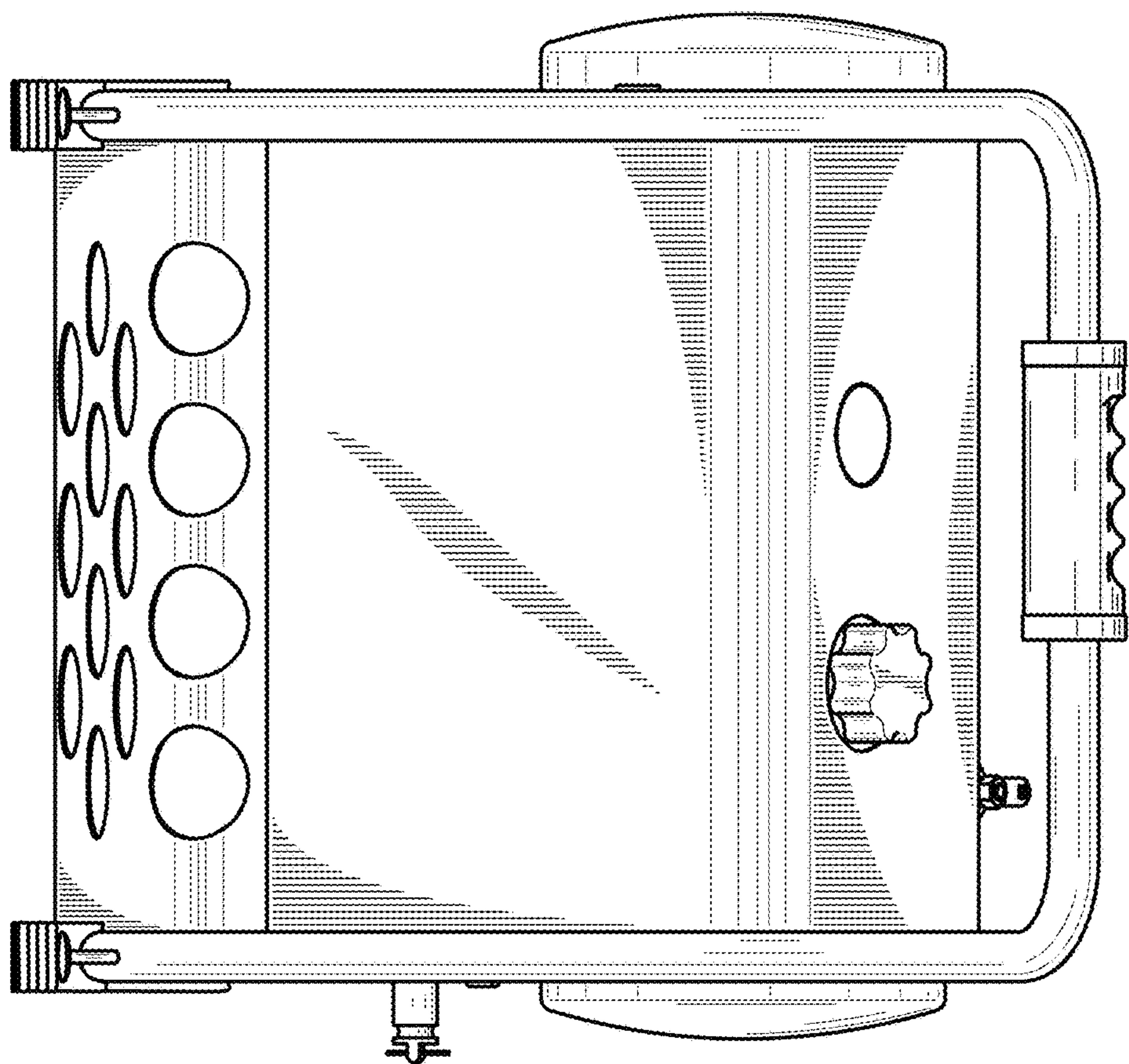

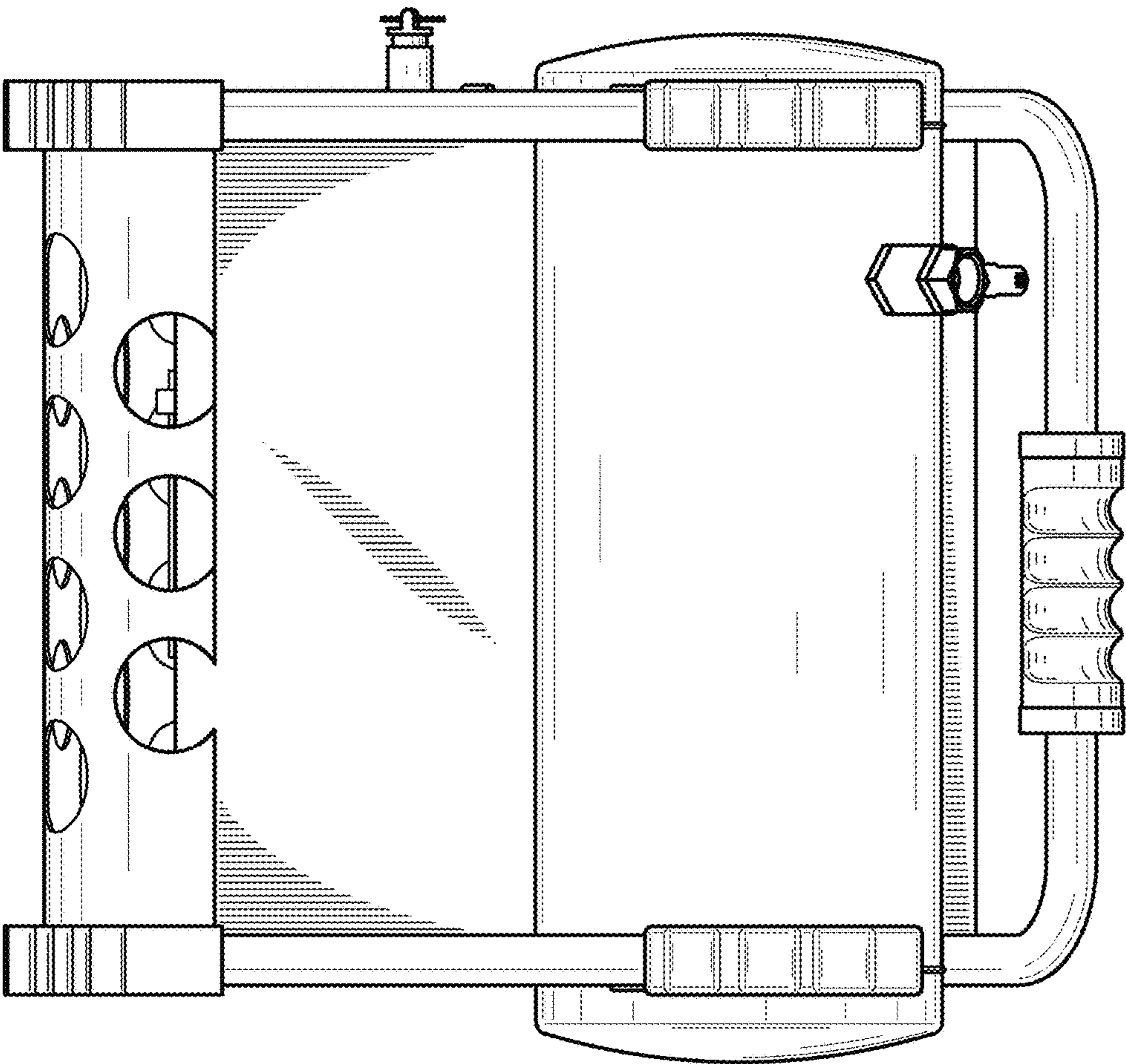
