FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a material removal/polishing tool, showing the new design.

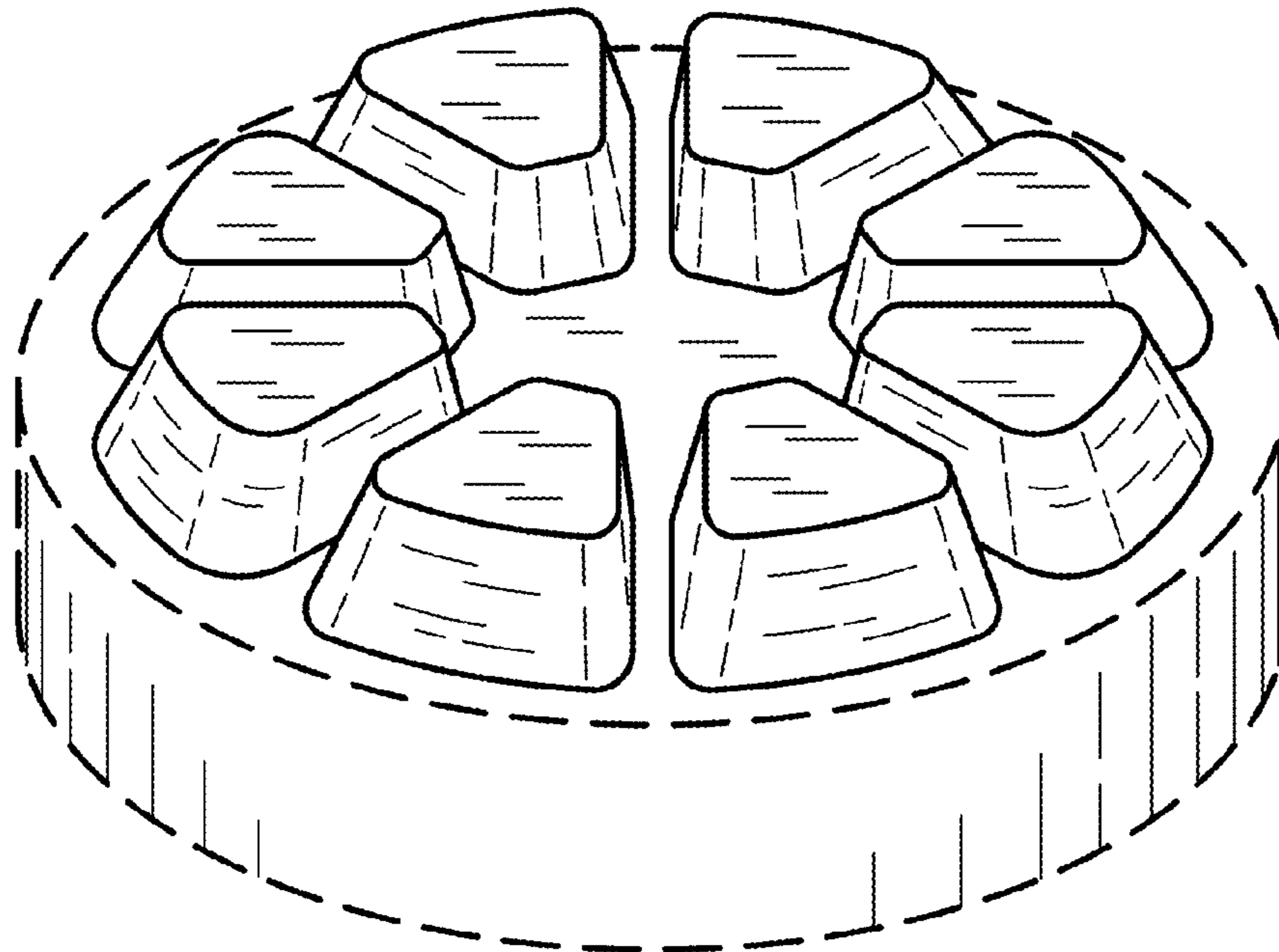
FIG. 2 is top view of the polishing tool shown in FIG. 1.

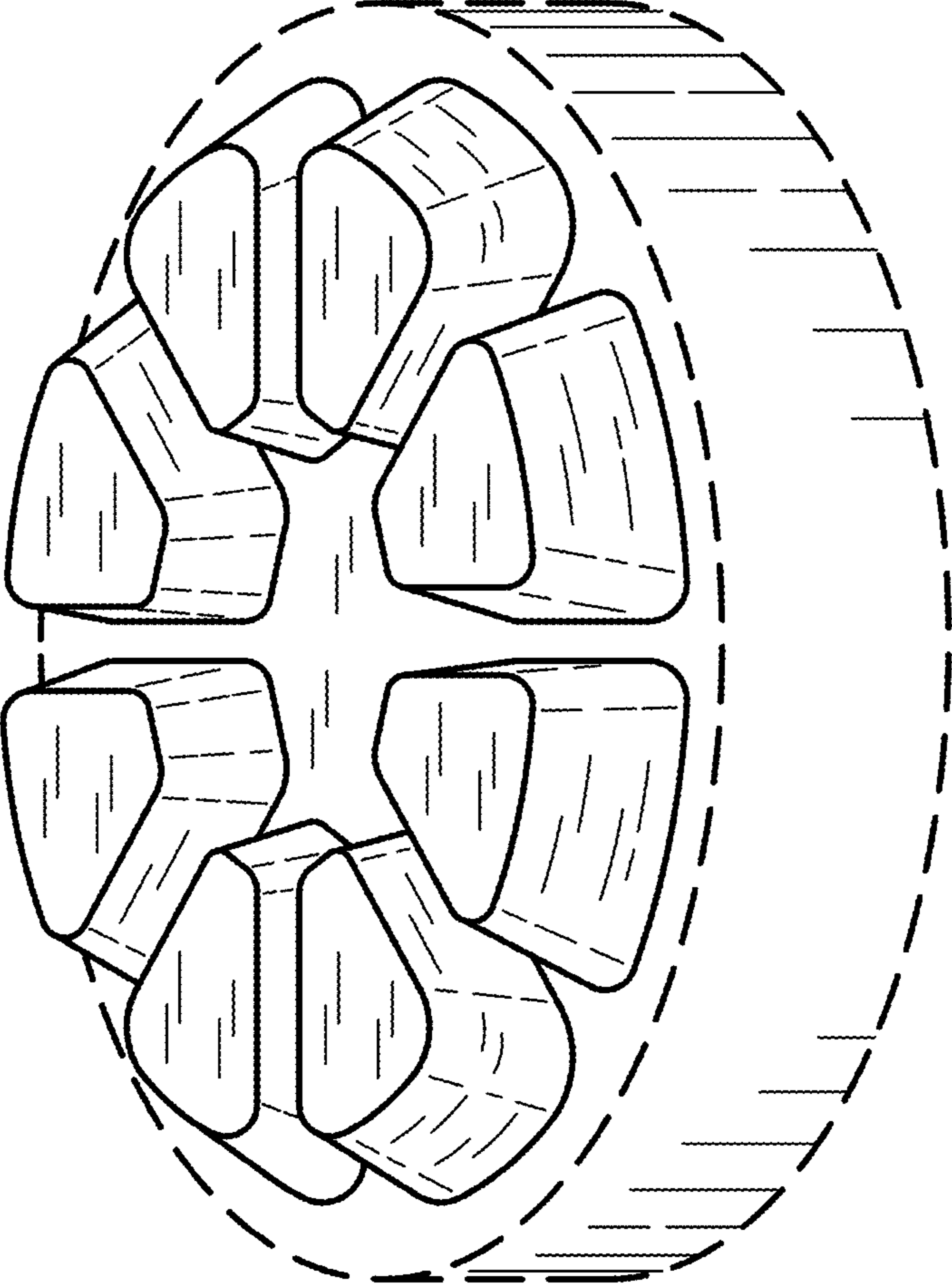

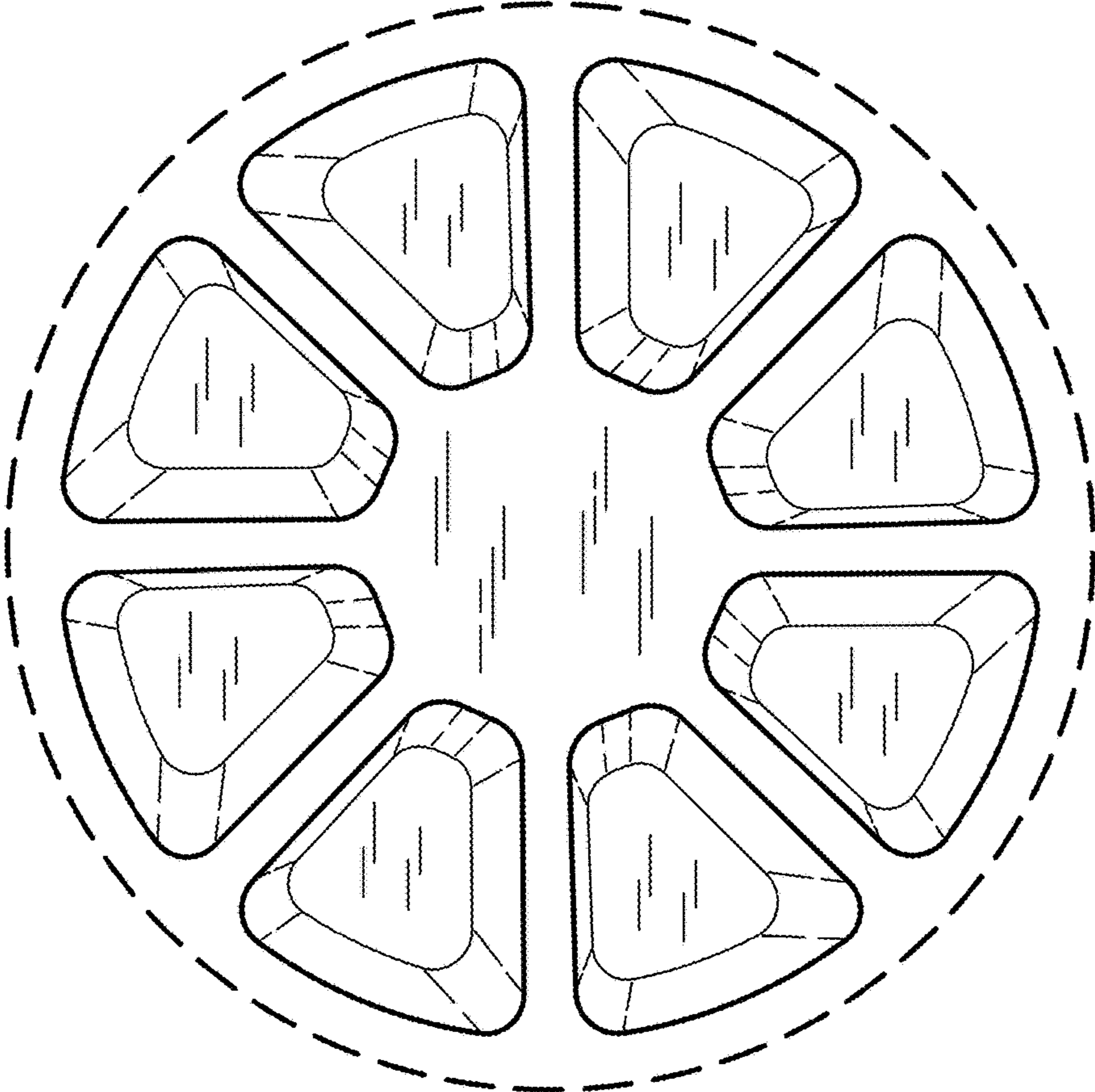

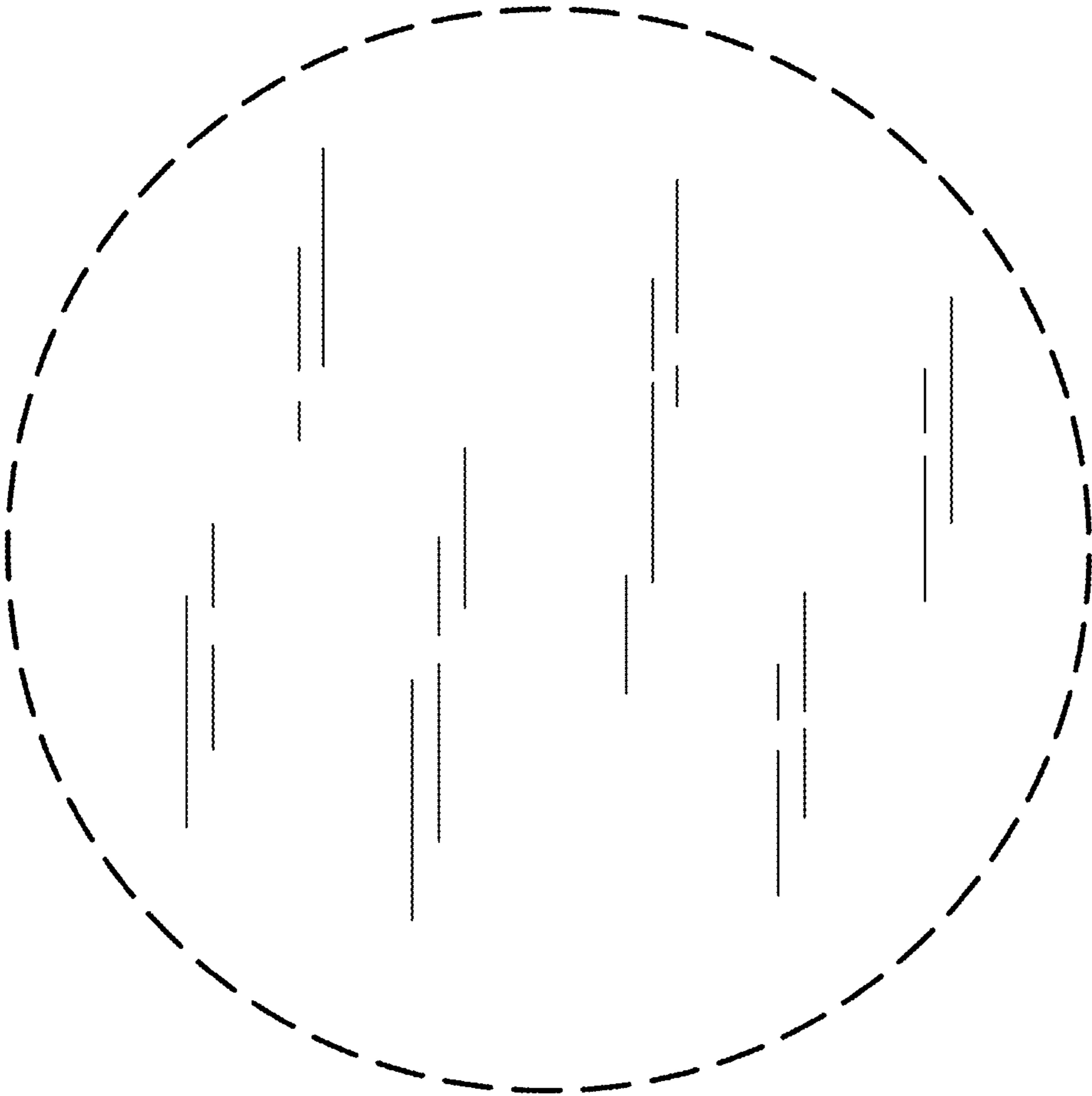

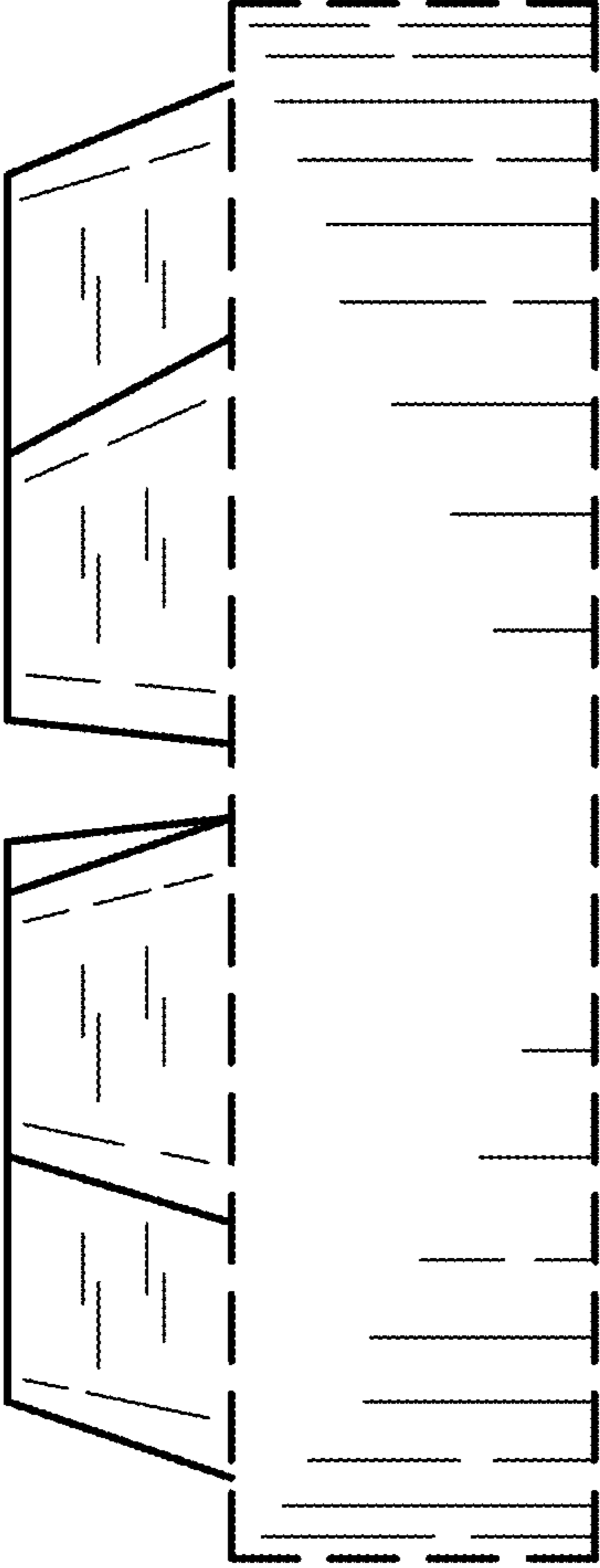
