The ornamental design for a picture frame, as shown and described.

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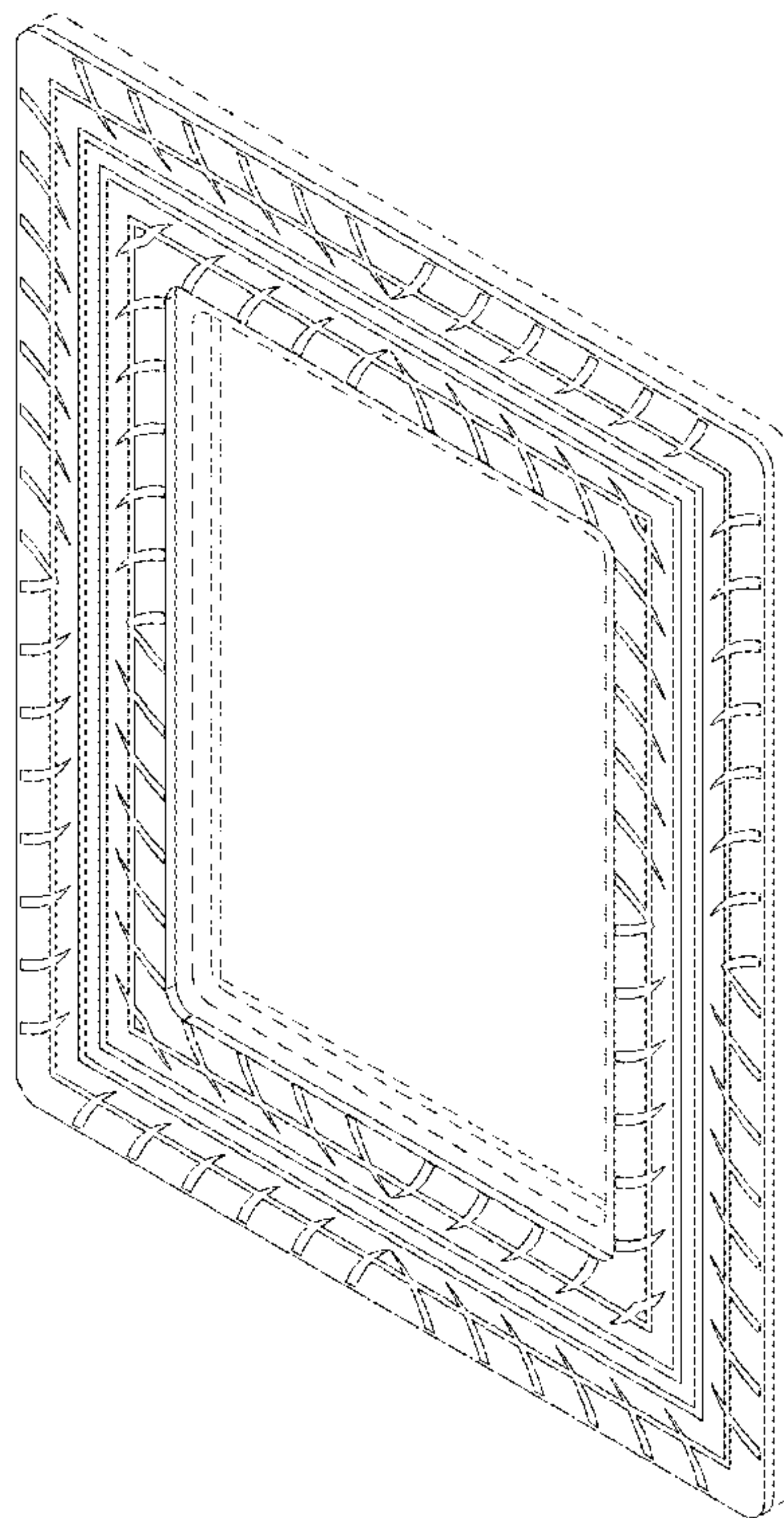
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DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top front perspective view of a picture frame; FIG. 2 is a front elevation view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevation view thereof, with the left side elevation view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 5 is a top elevation view thereof; and, FIG. 6 is a bottom elevation view thereof. The broken lines shown in the drawings depict a backing of the picture frame that form no part of the claimed invention.

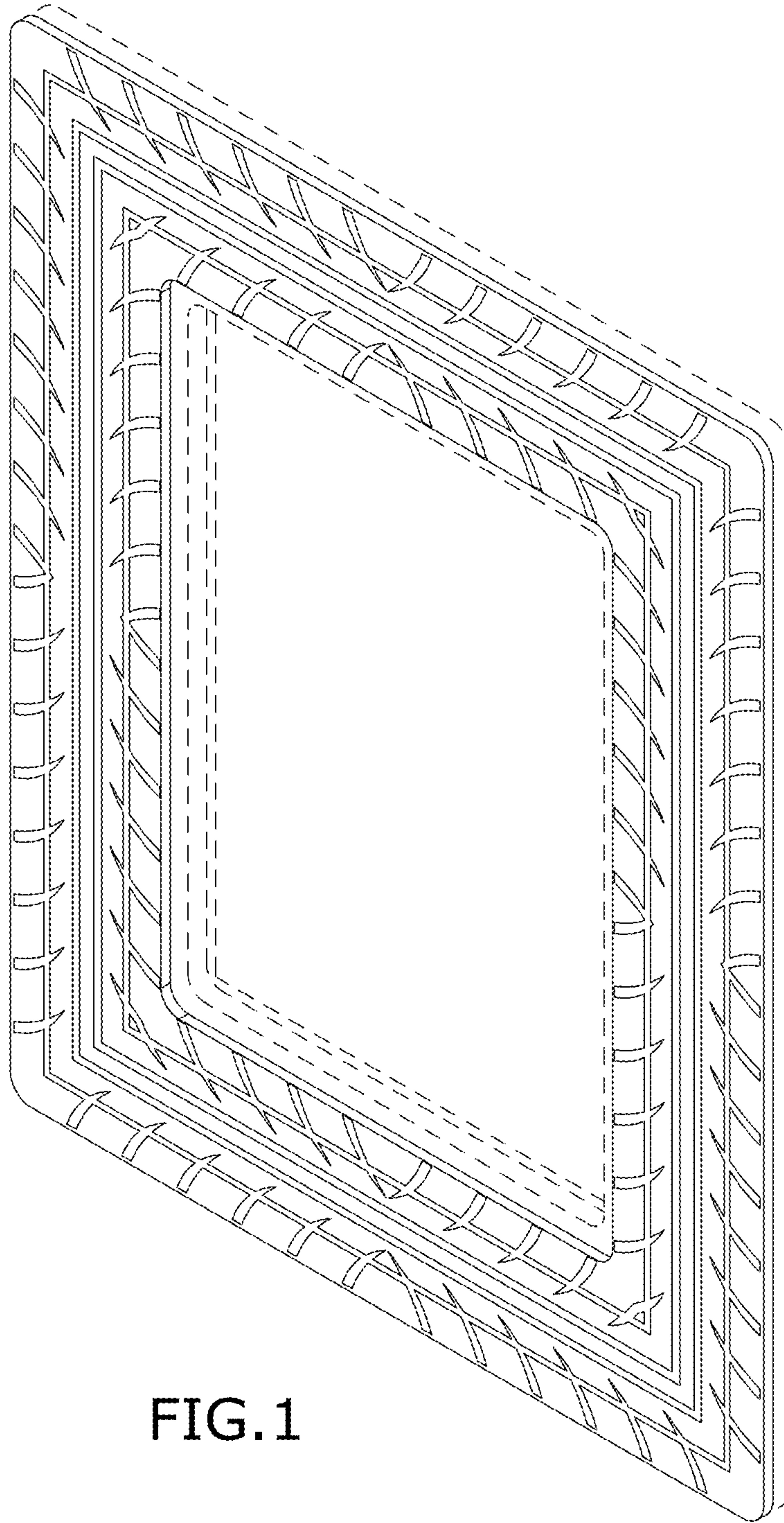

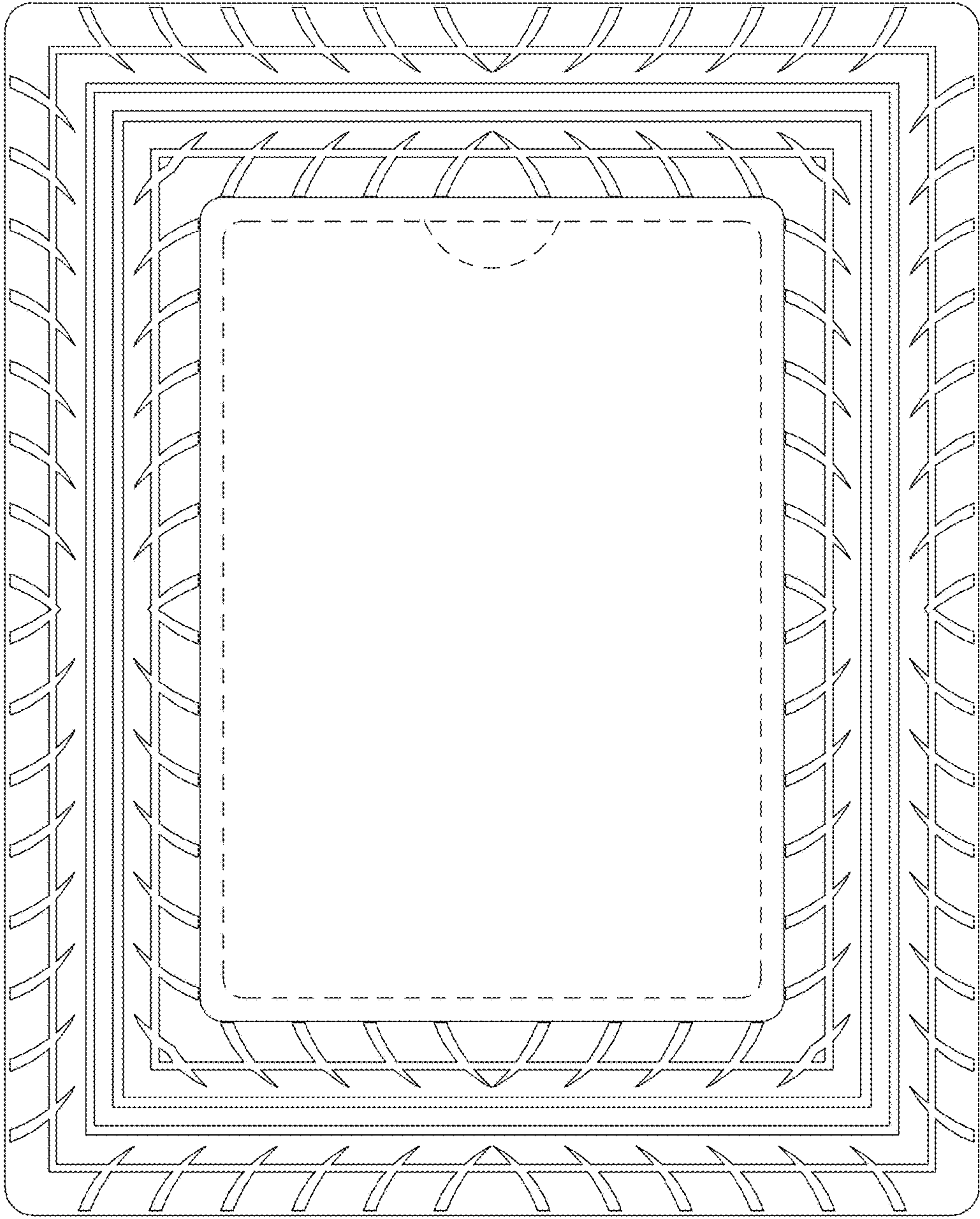

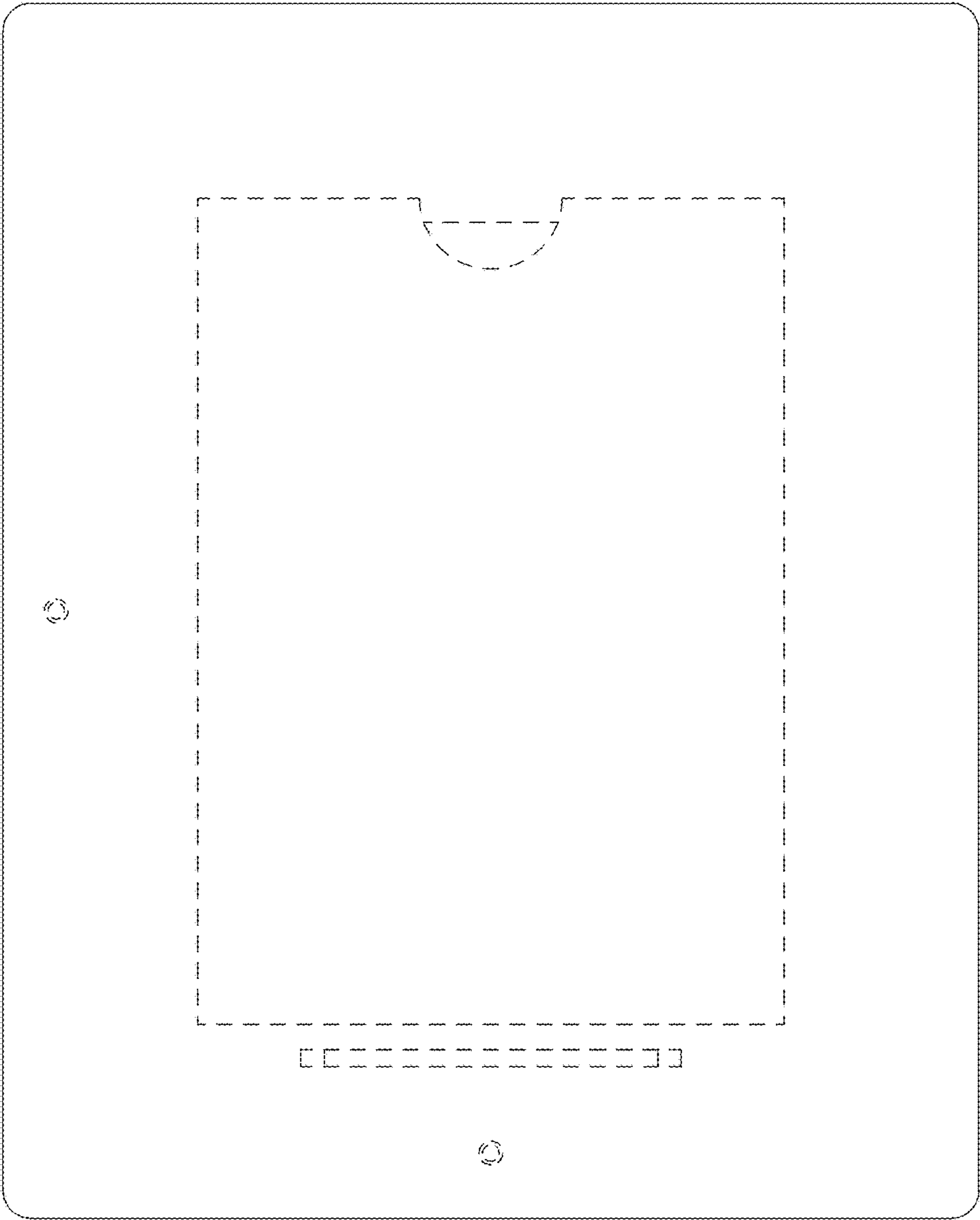

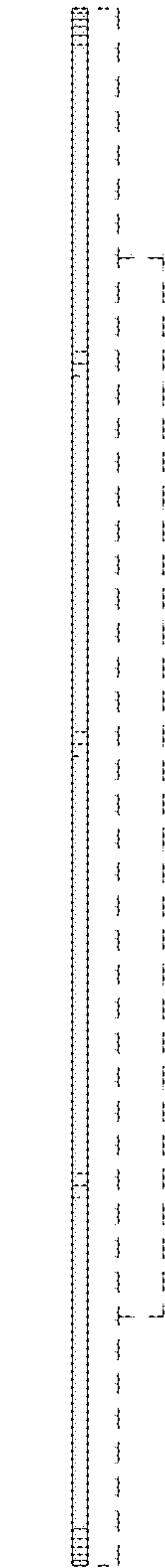

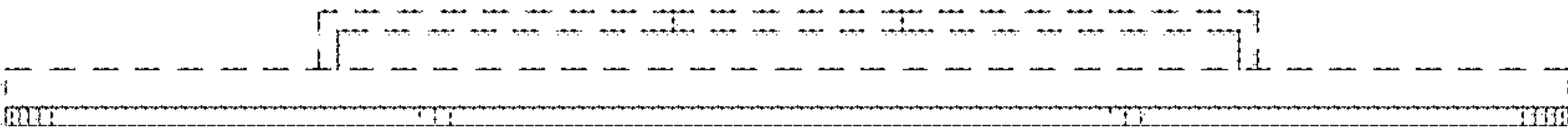

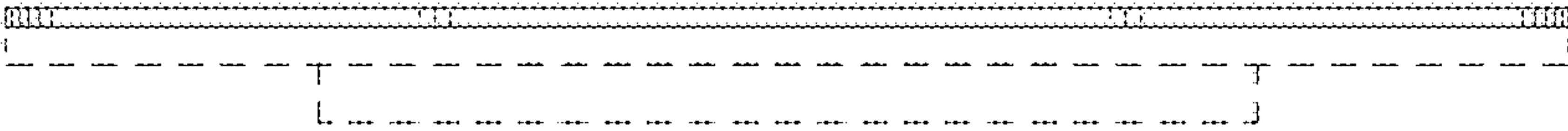
