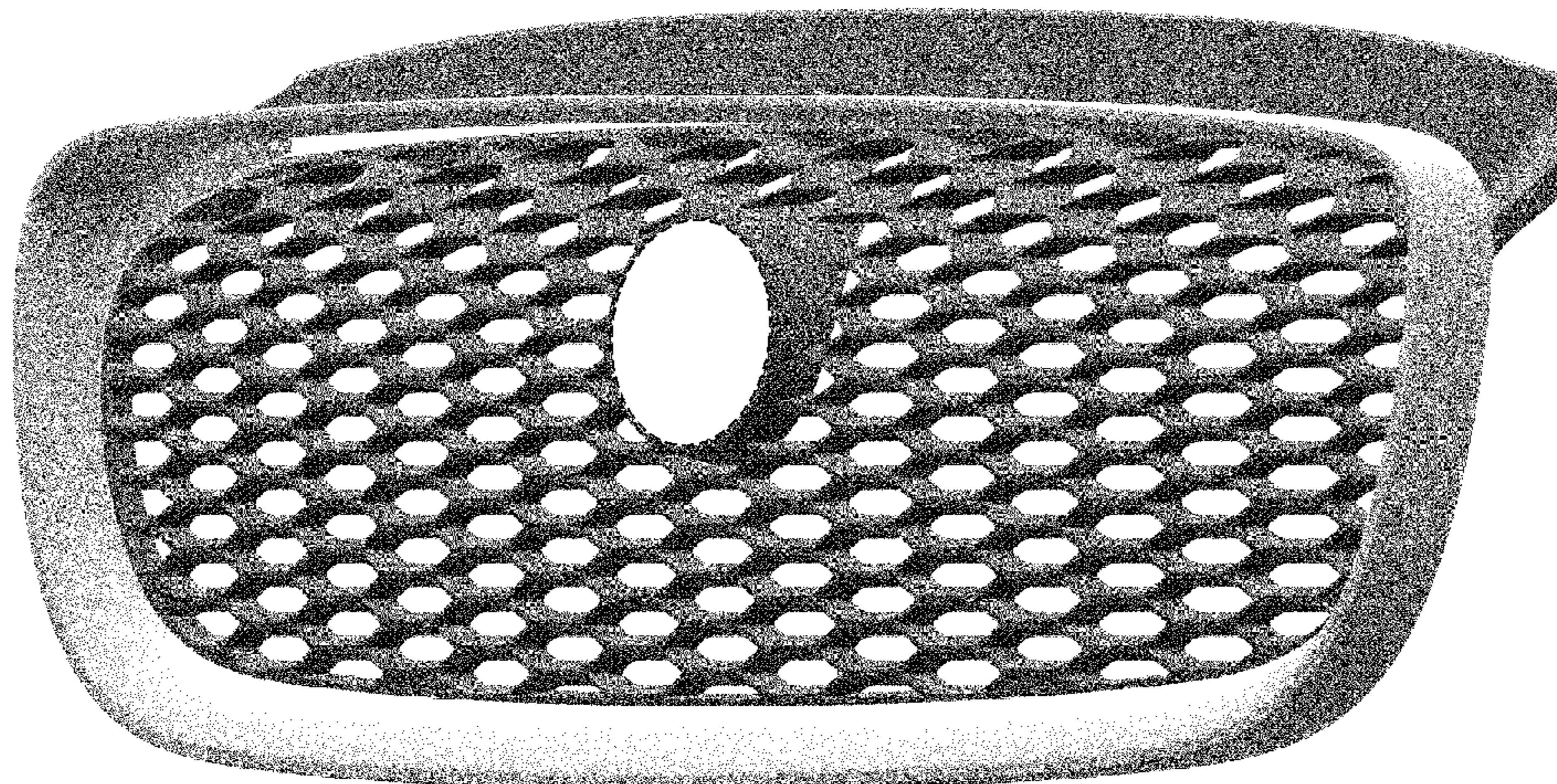
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a grille, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front right perspective view of a grille for a vehicle according to the present invention.
FIG. 2 is a front left perspective view of the grille shown in FIG. 1.
FIG. 3 is a rear left perspective view thereof.
FIG. 4 is a rear right perspective view thereof.
FIG. 5 is a front view thereof.
FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof.
FIG. 7 is a left side view thereof.
FIG. 8 is a right side view thereof.
FIG. 9 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 10 is a front left perspective view of the grille shown in FIGS. 1-9, mounted to a vehicle, and the rest of the vehicle shown in de-emphasized and half-tone portions so as to illustrate environmental structure. These portions form no part of the claimed invention. More particularly, in FIG. 10, the inventive grille is shown within the outer, larger broken line, but outside of the inner, smaller broken. The broken lines form no part of the invention, but instead represent unclaimed boundaries.

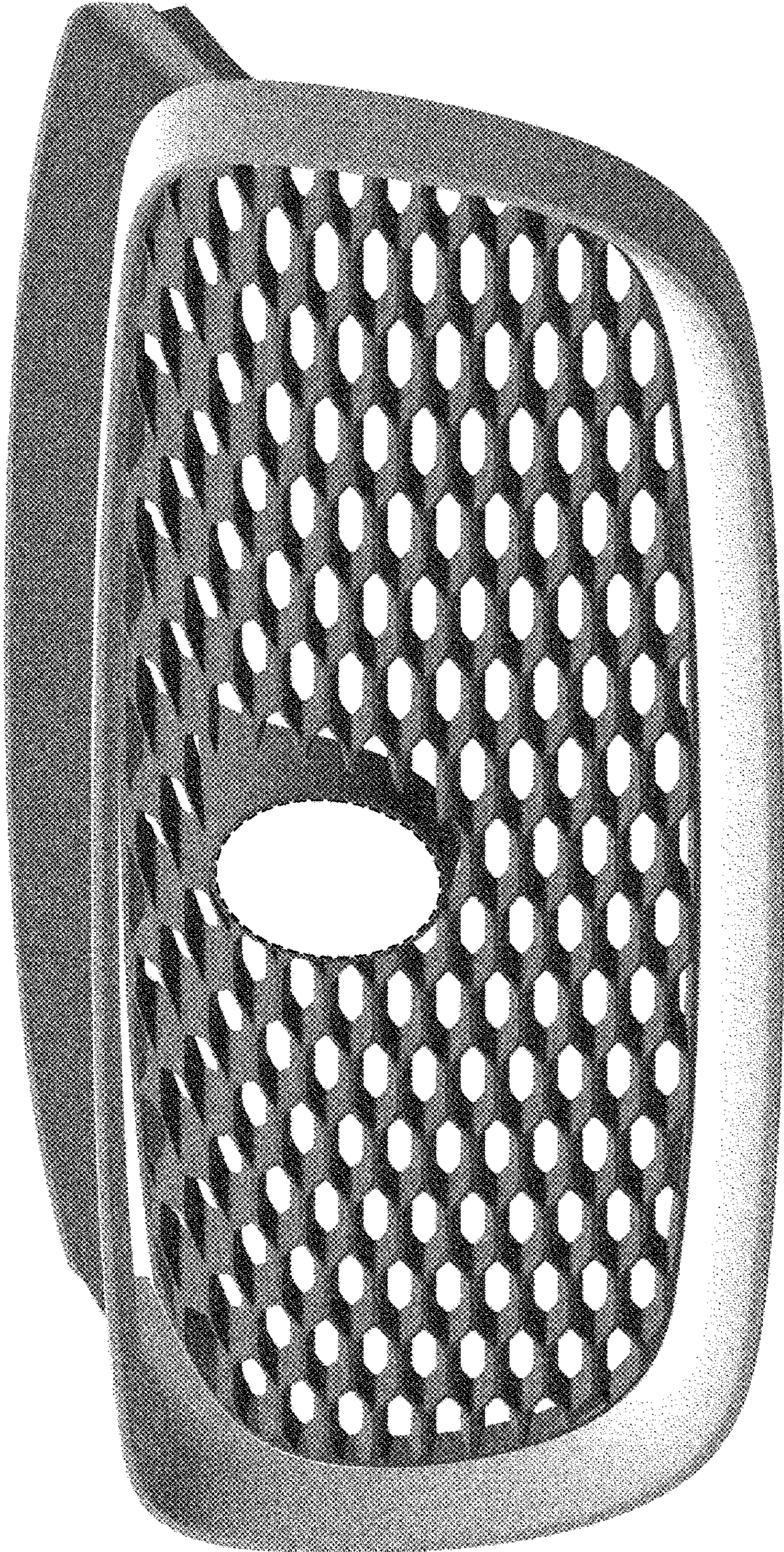

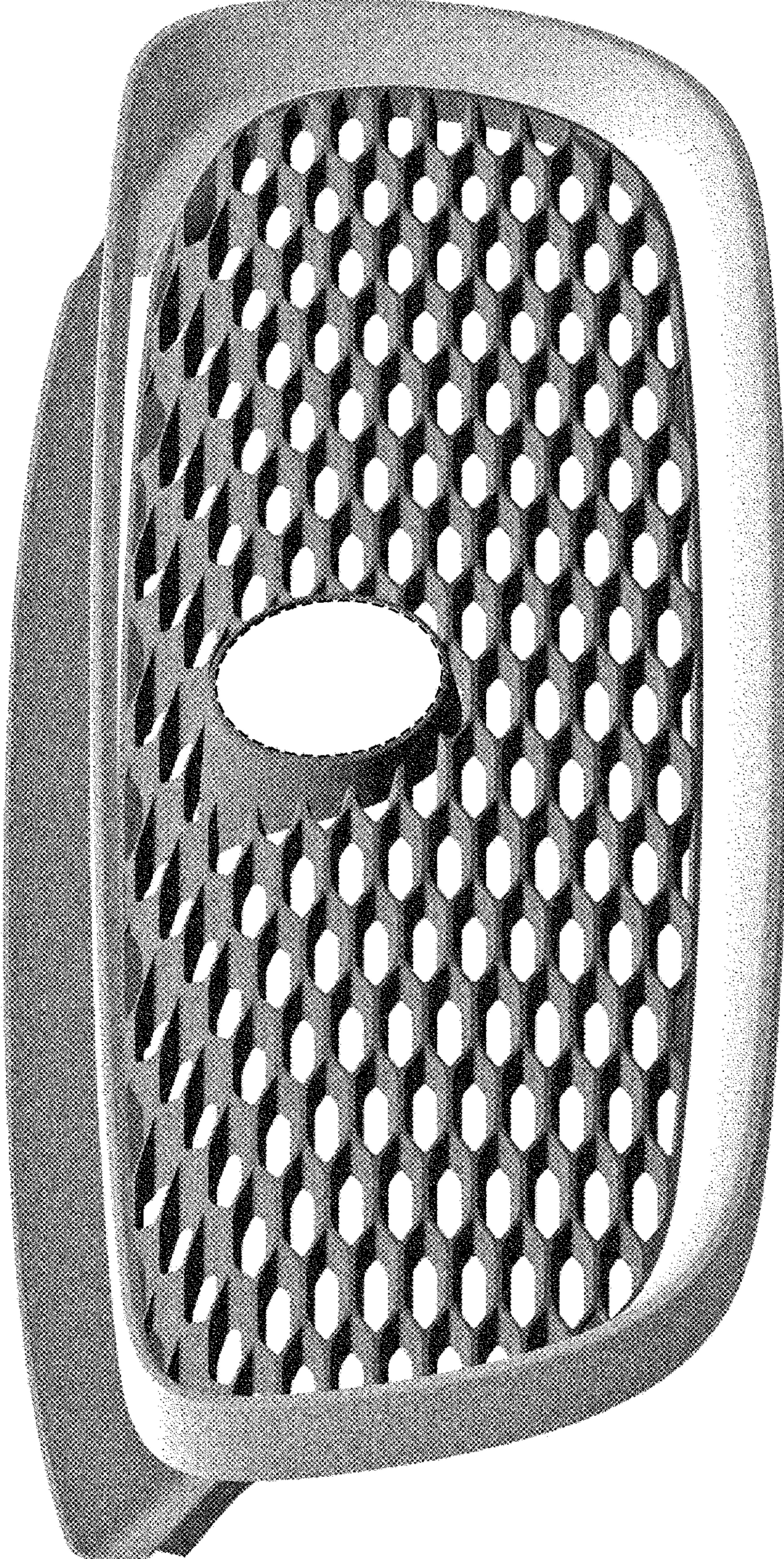

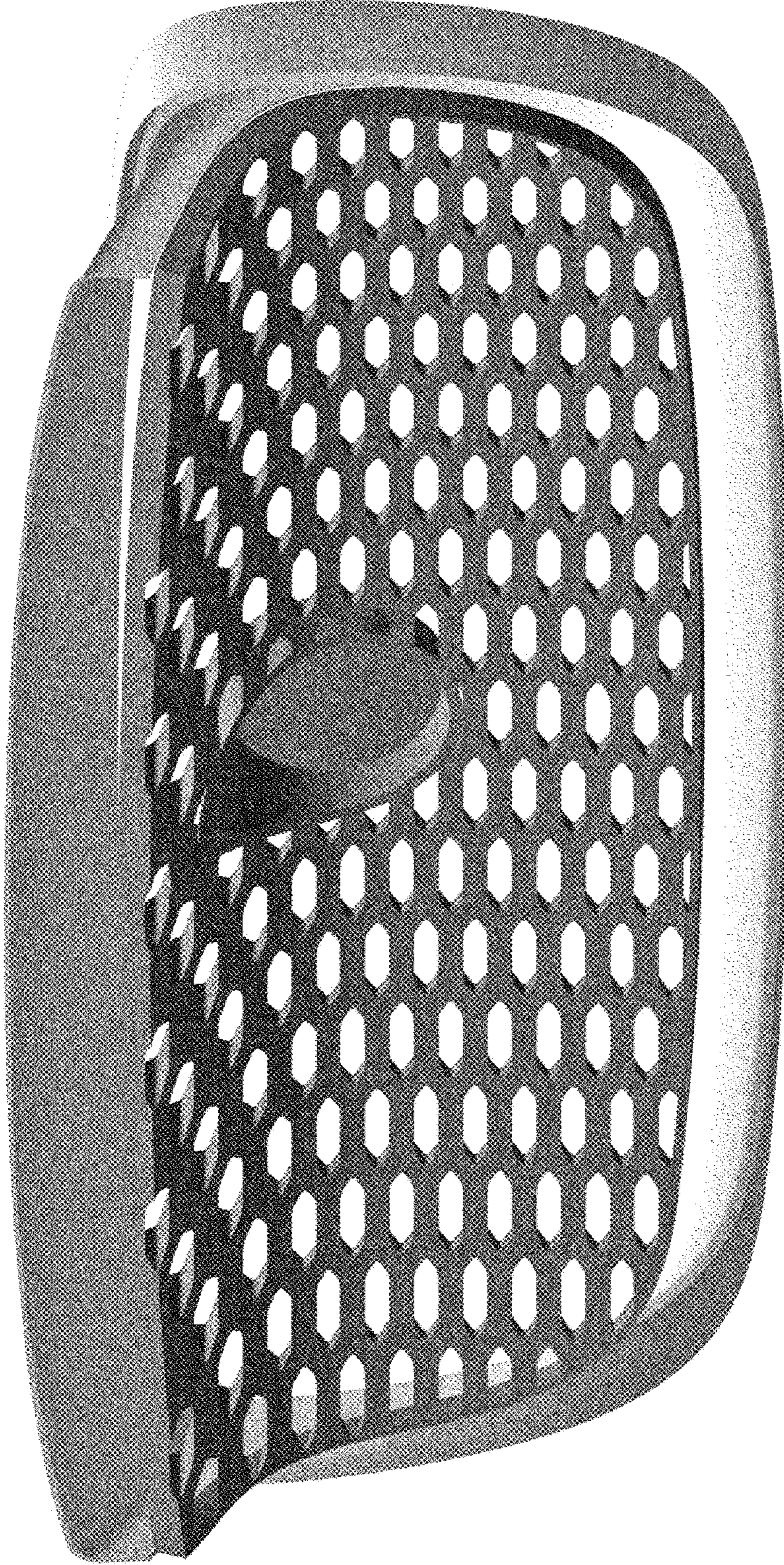

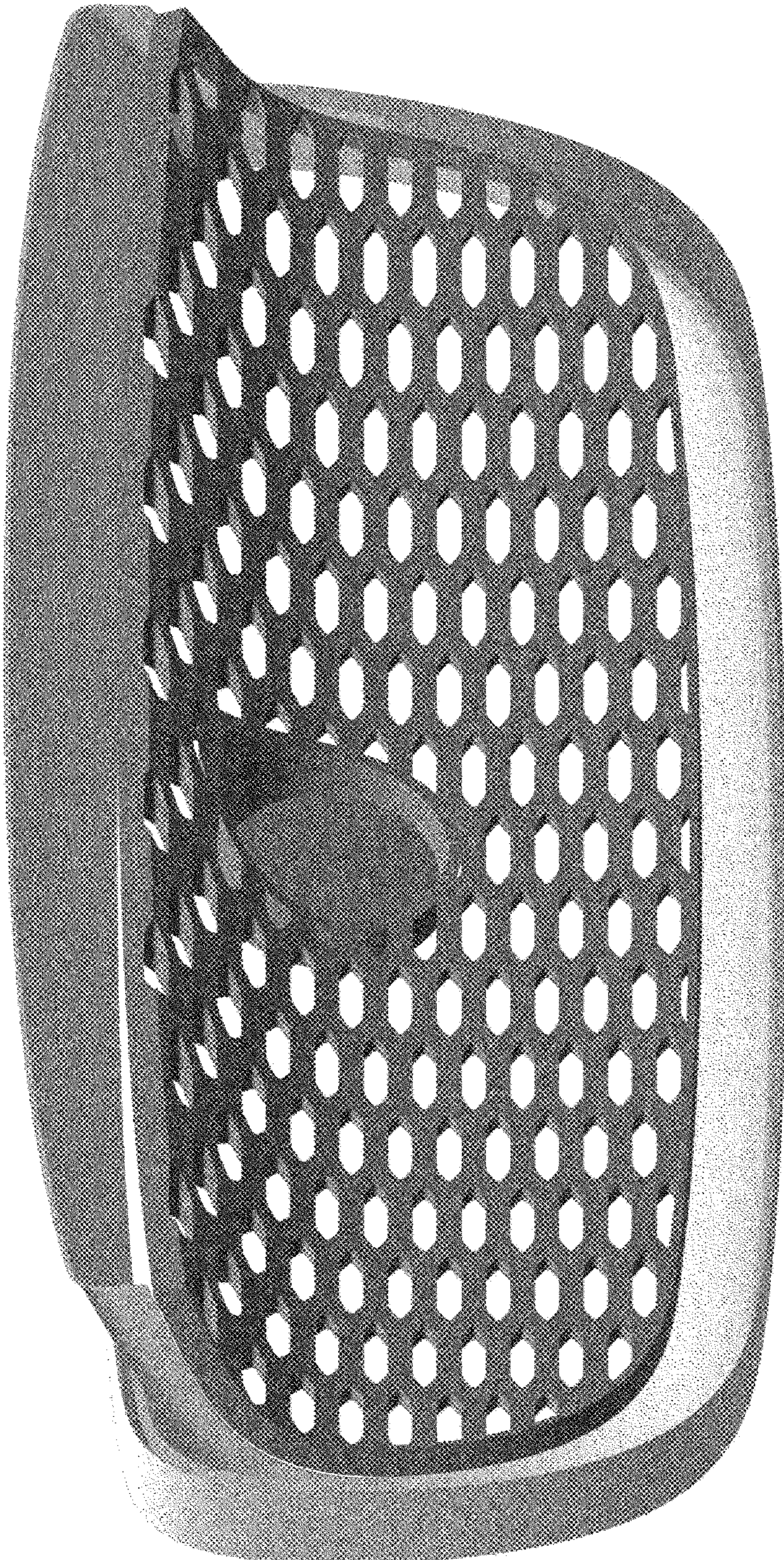

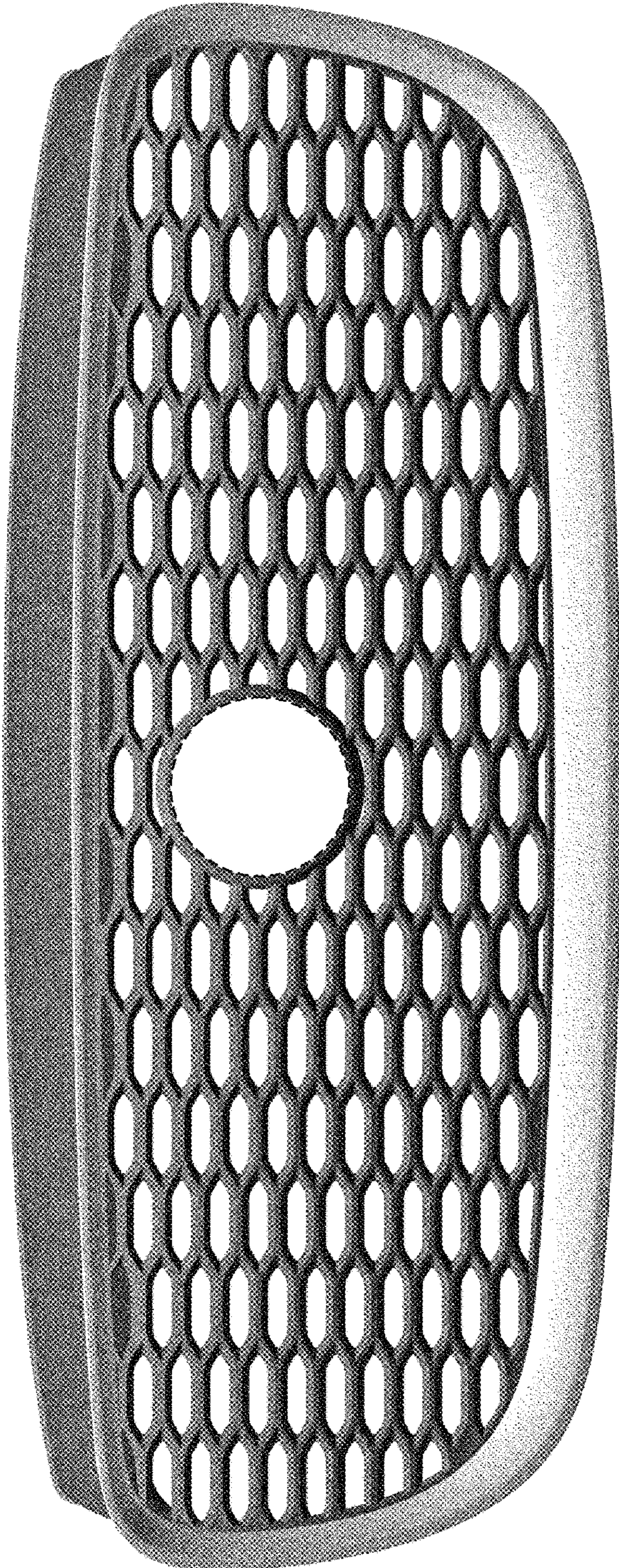

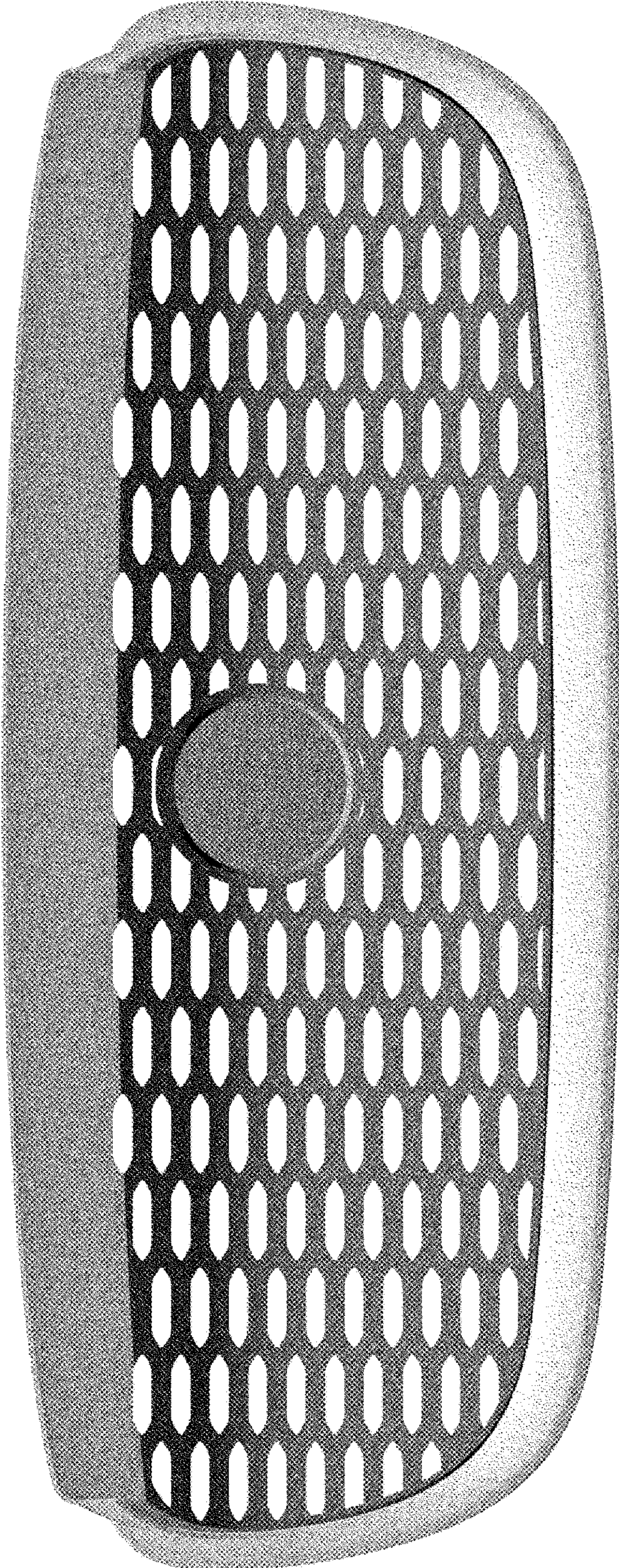

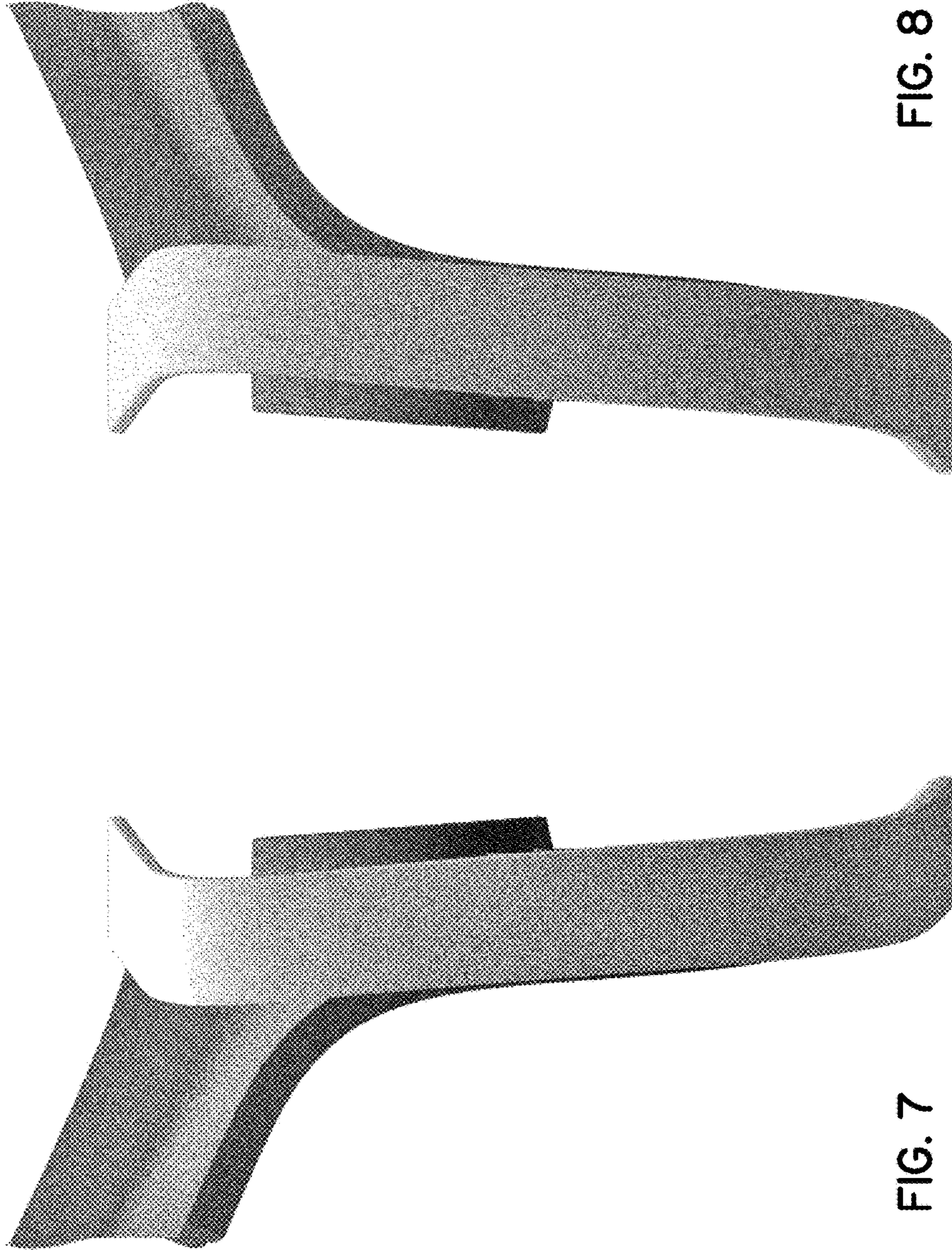

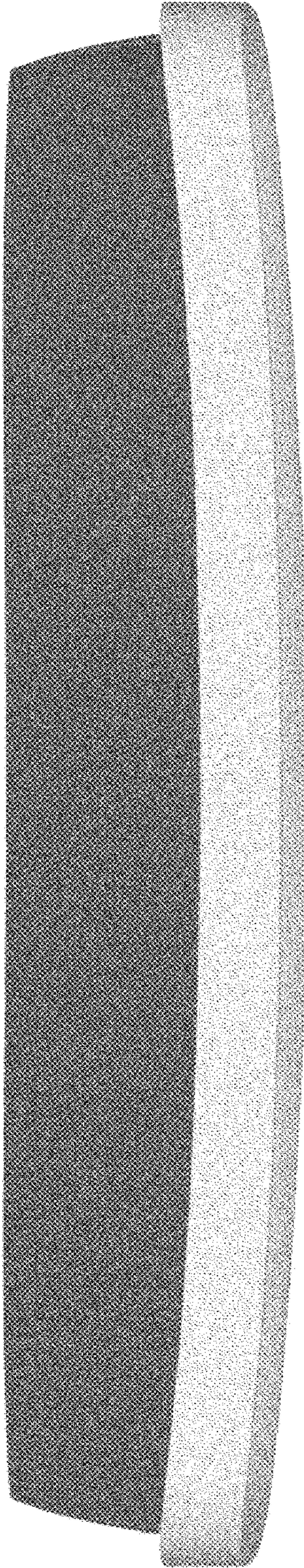

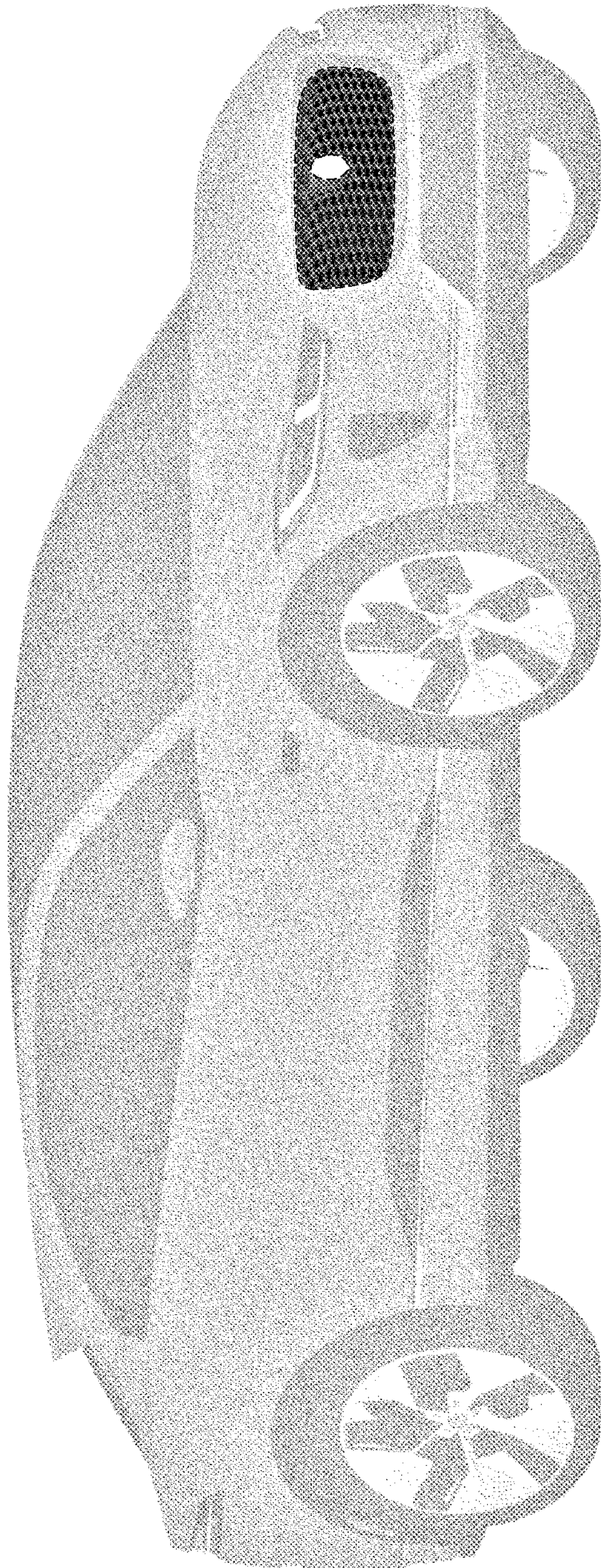
