(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an aircraft galley monument, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an aircraft galley monument.

FIG. 2 is a front side view of a claimed portion thereof of the aircraft galley monument.

FIG. 3 is a back side view of the aircraft galley monument.

FIG. 4 is a first side view of the aircraft galley monument.

FIG. 5 is an opposite side view of the aircraft galley monument.

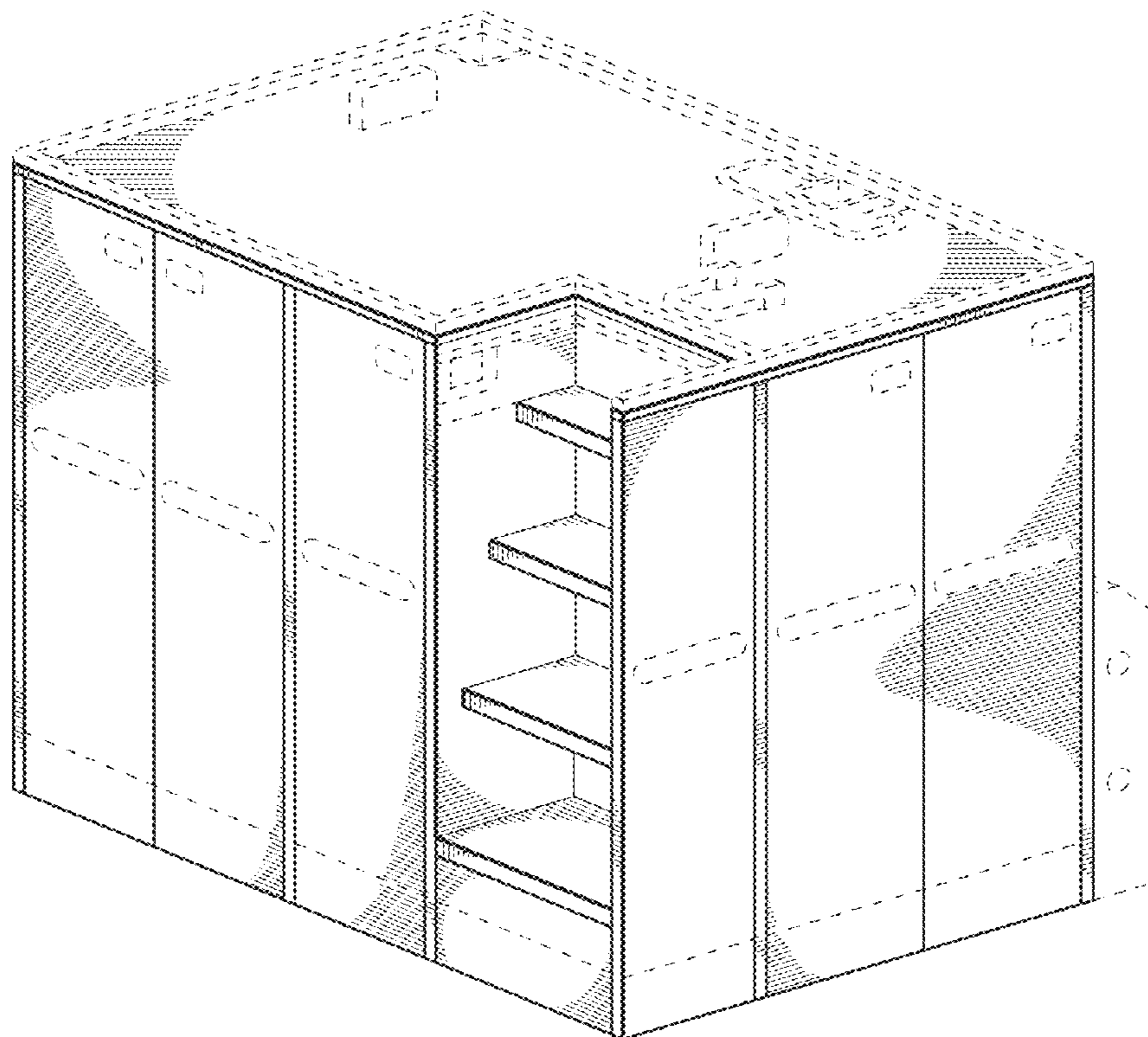
FIG. 6 is a top view of the aircraft galley monument.

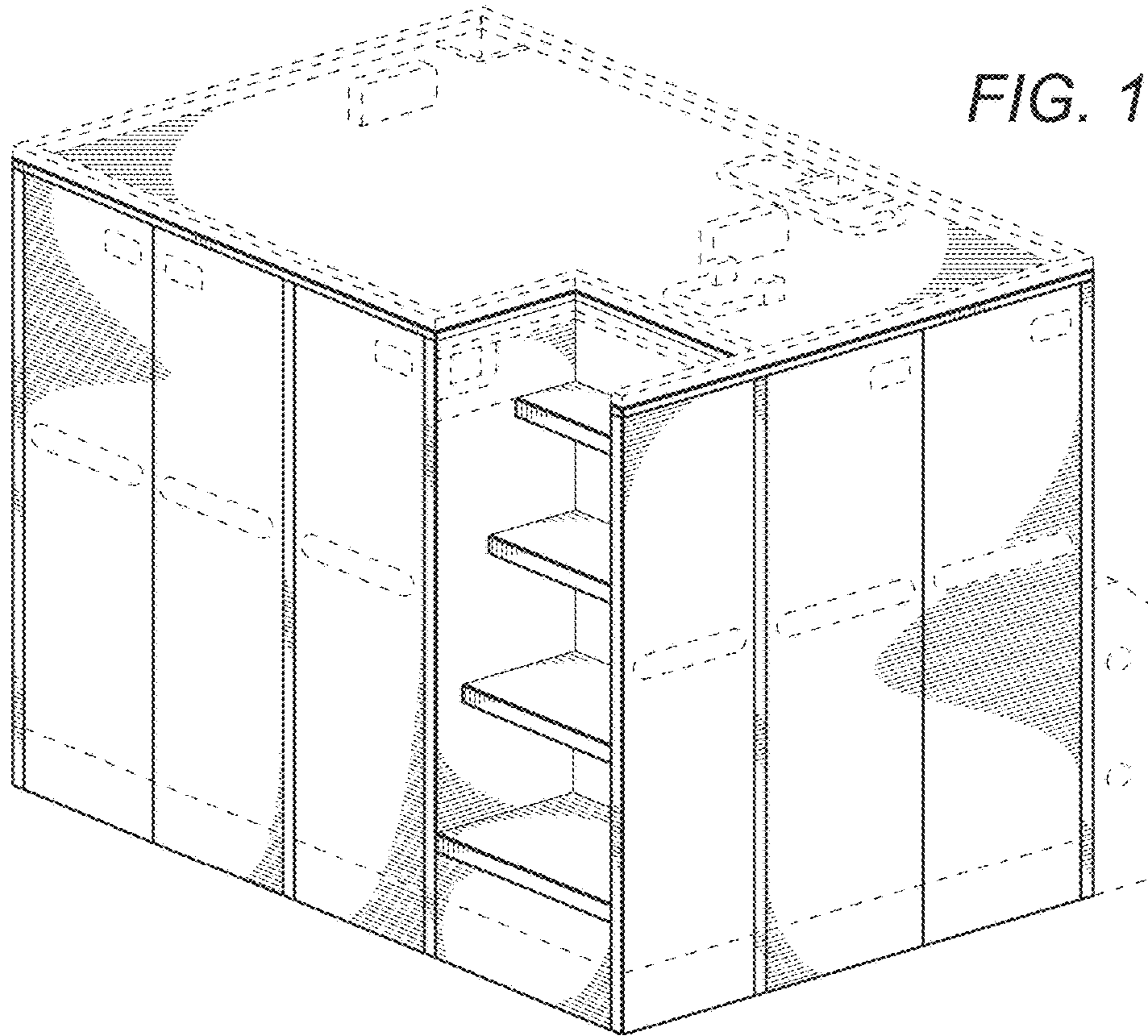
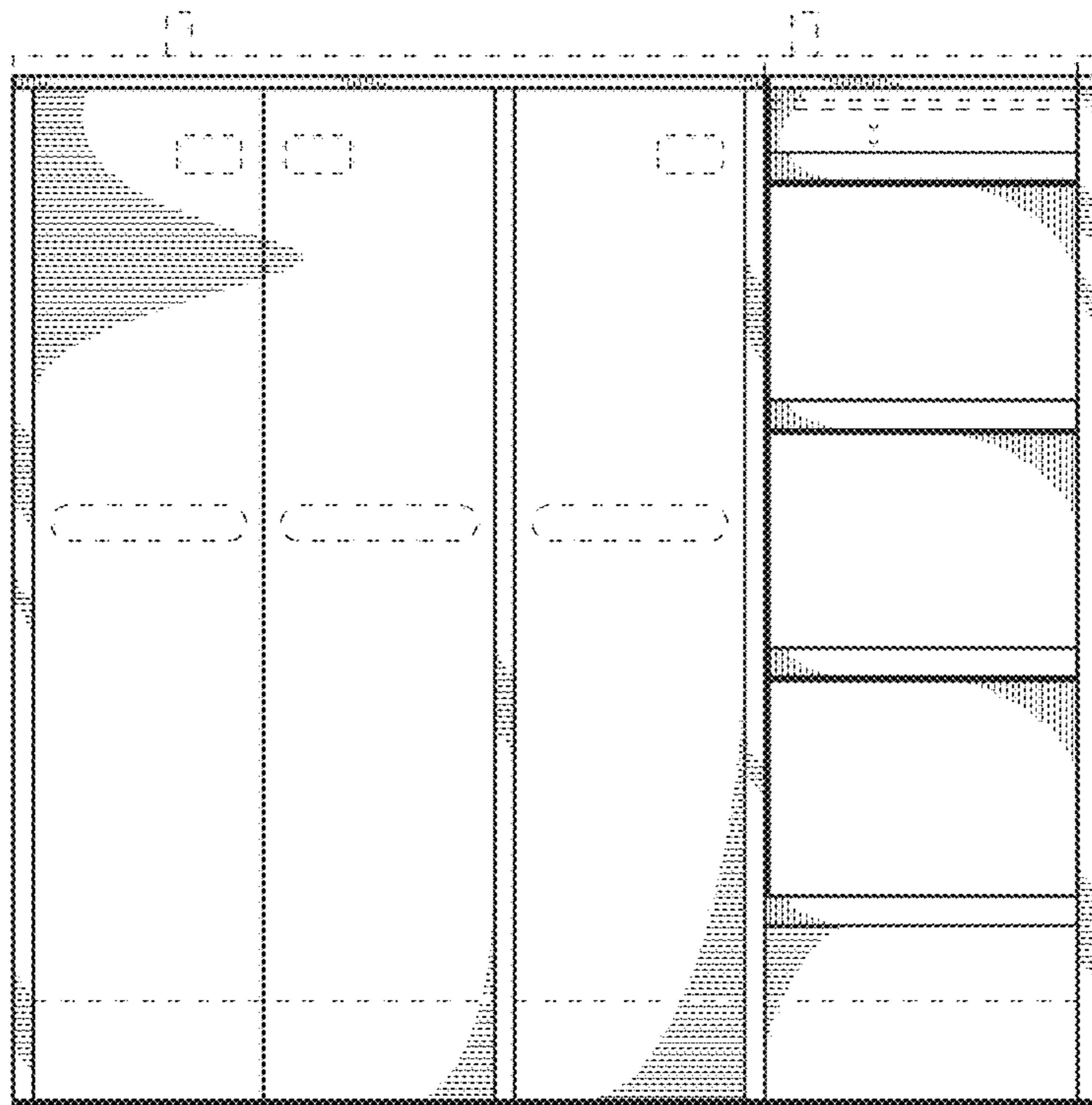

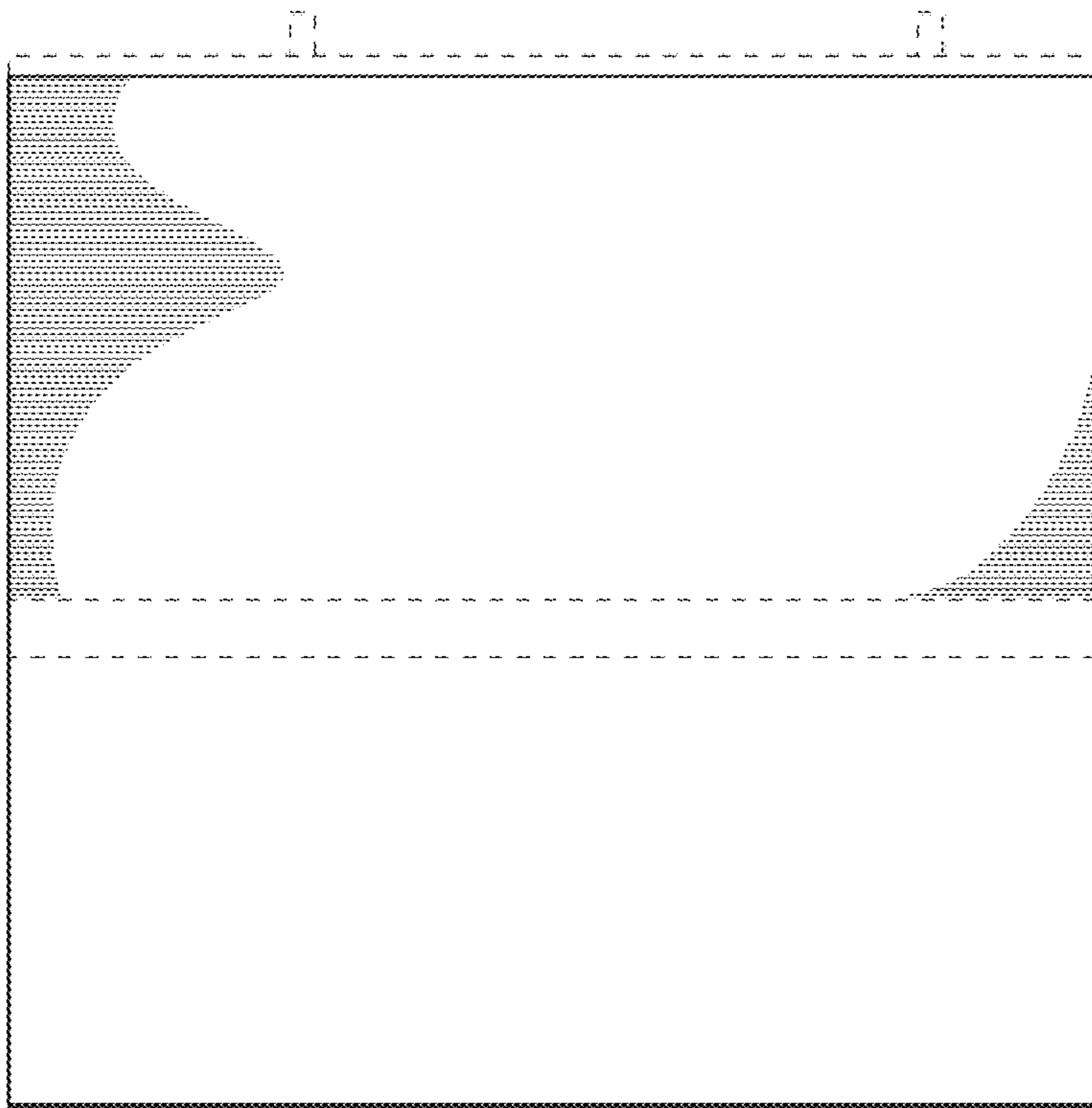

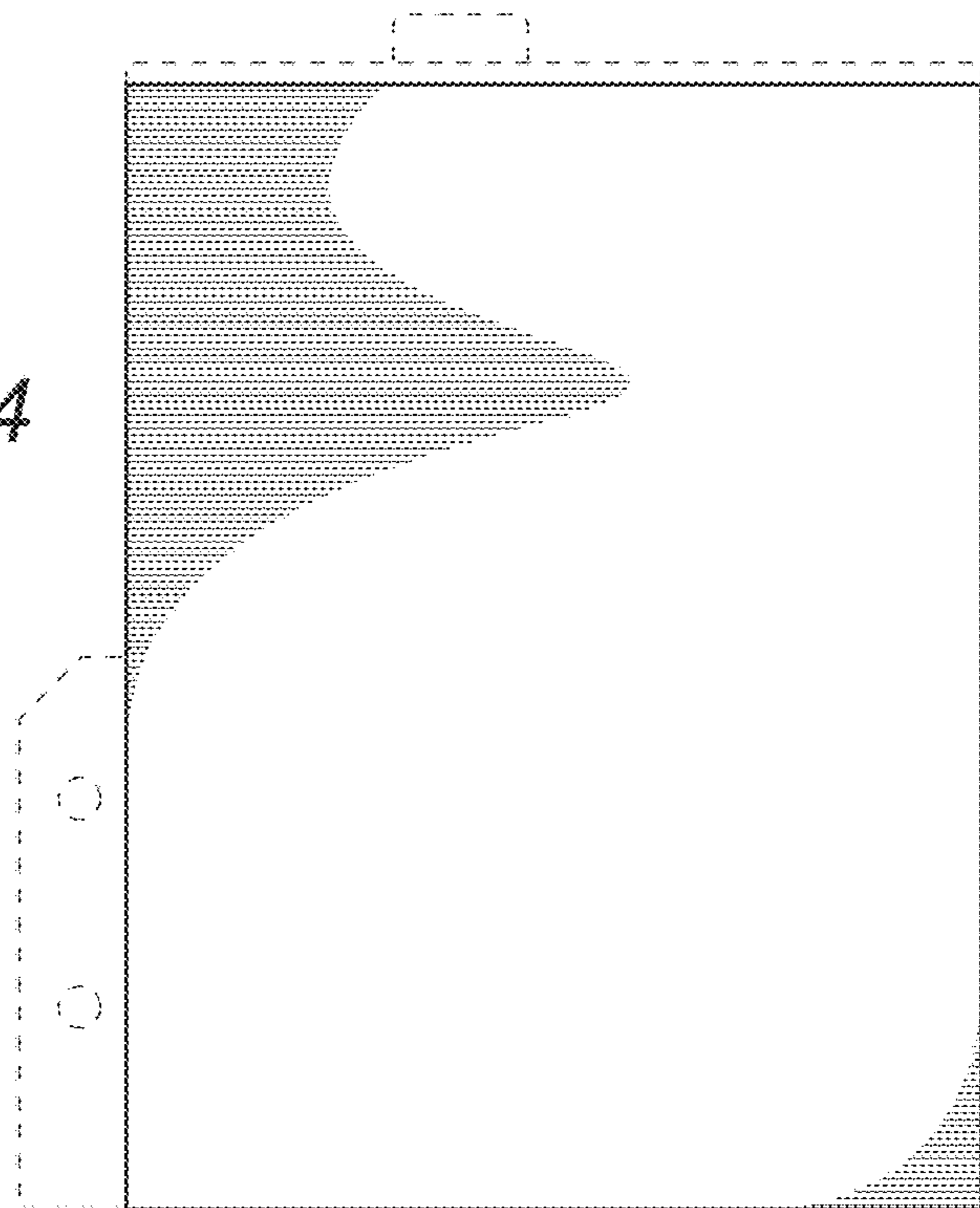

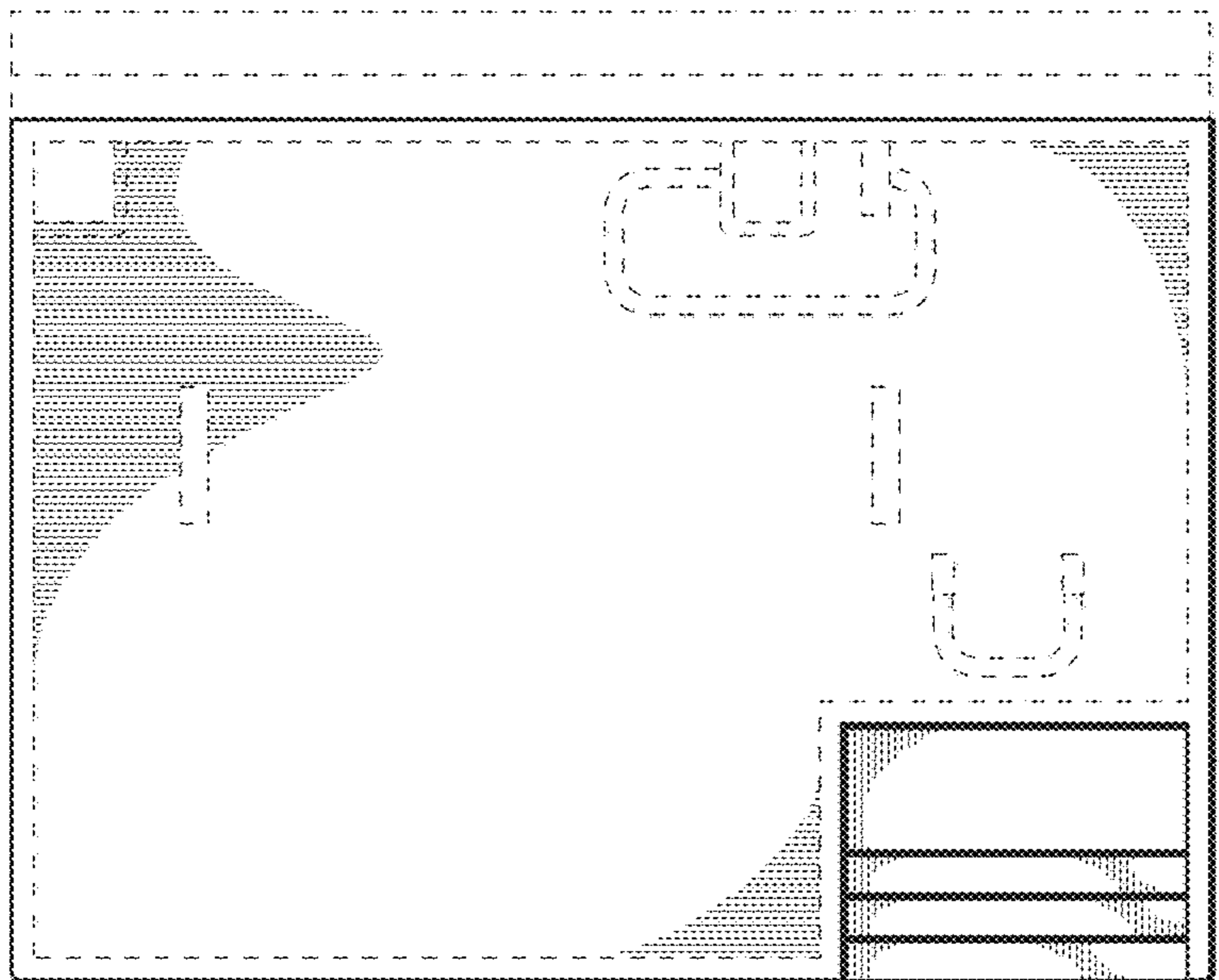
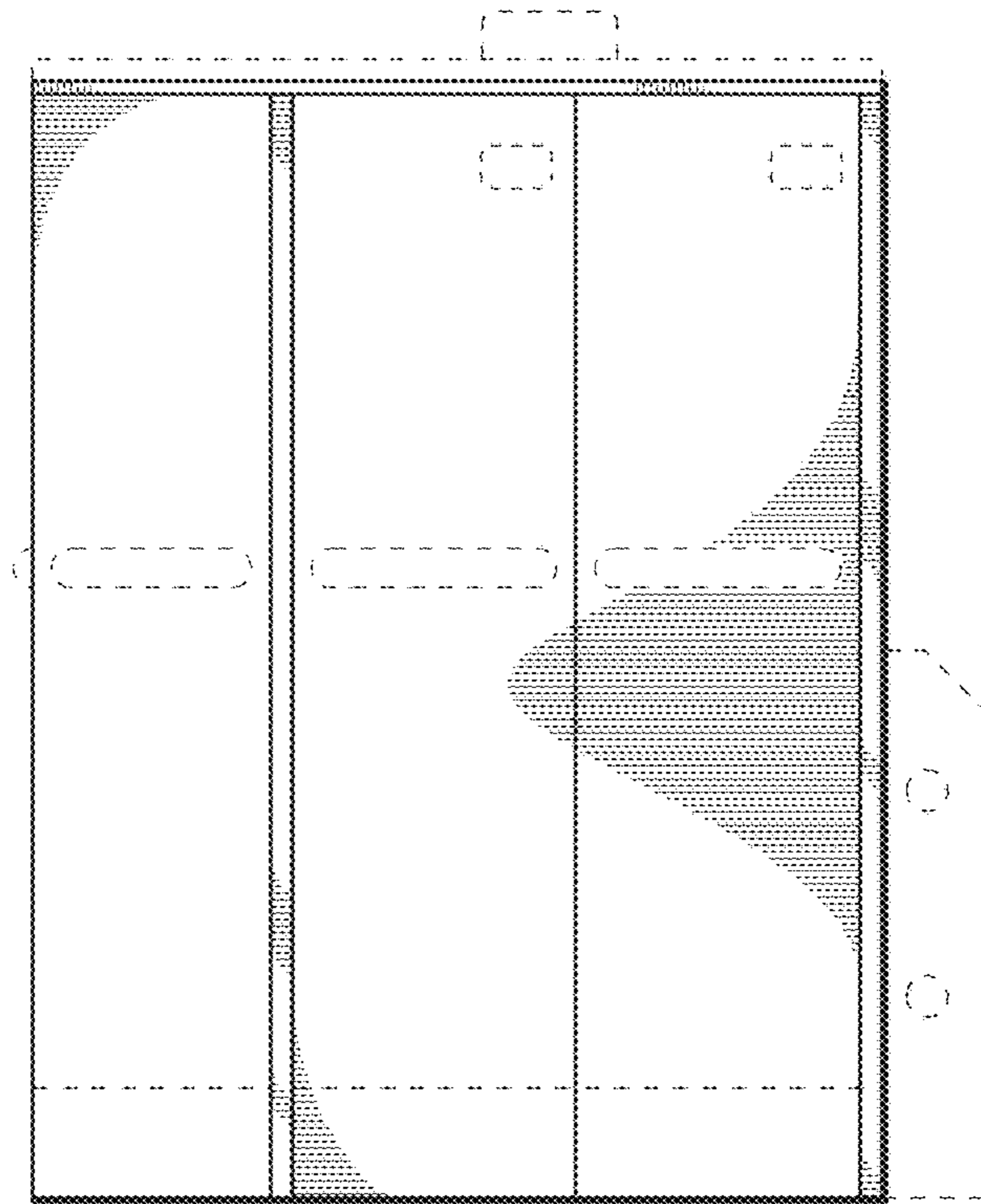

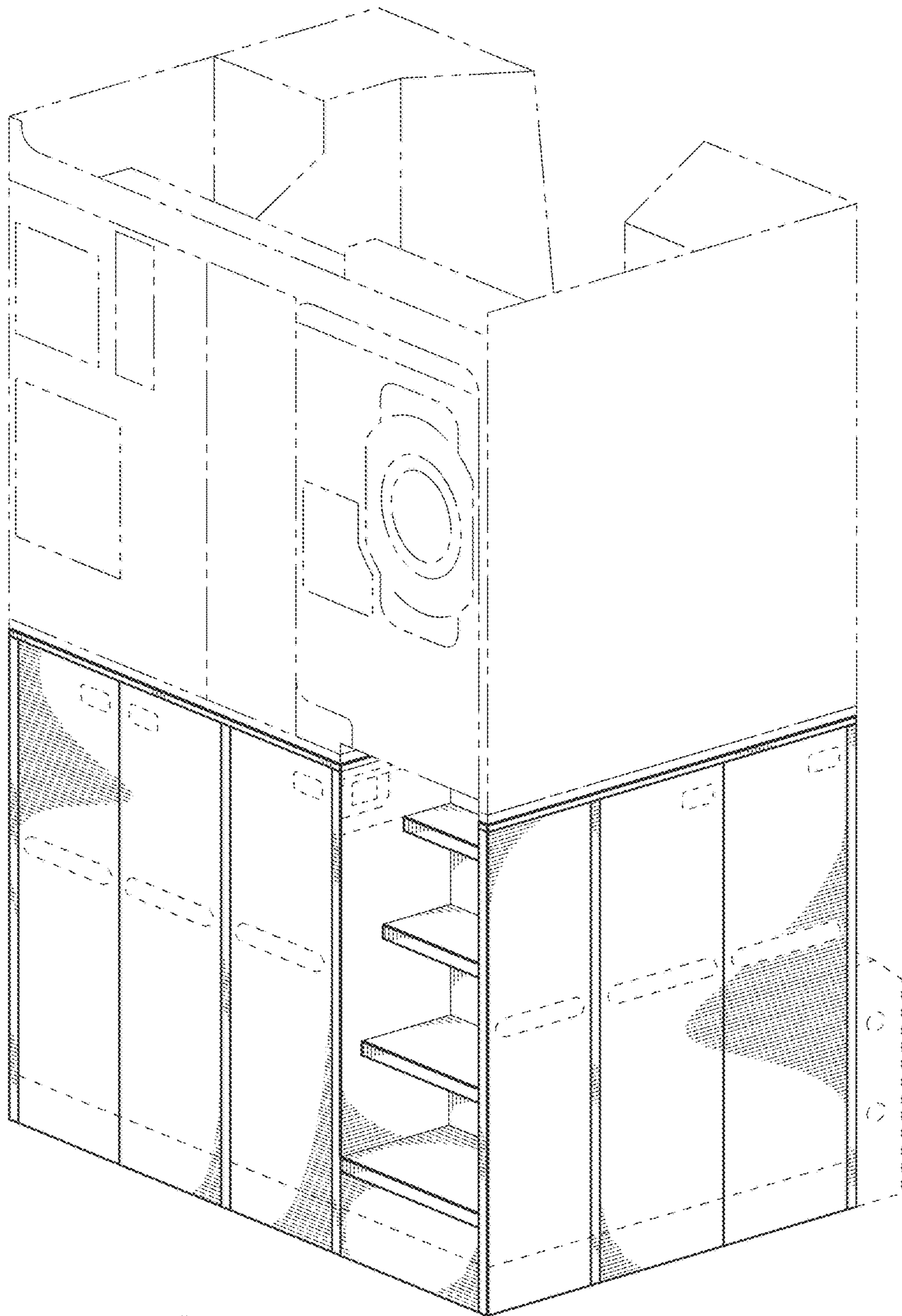

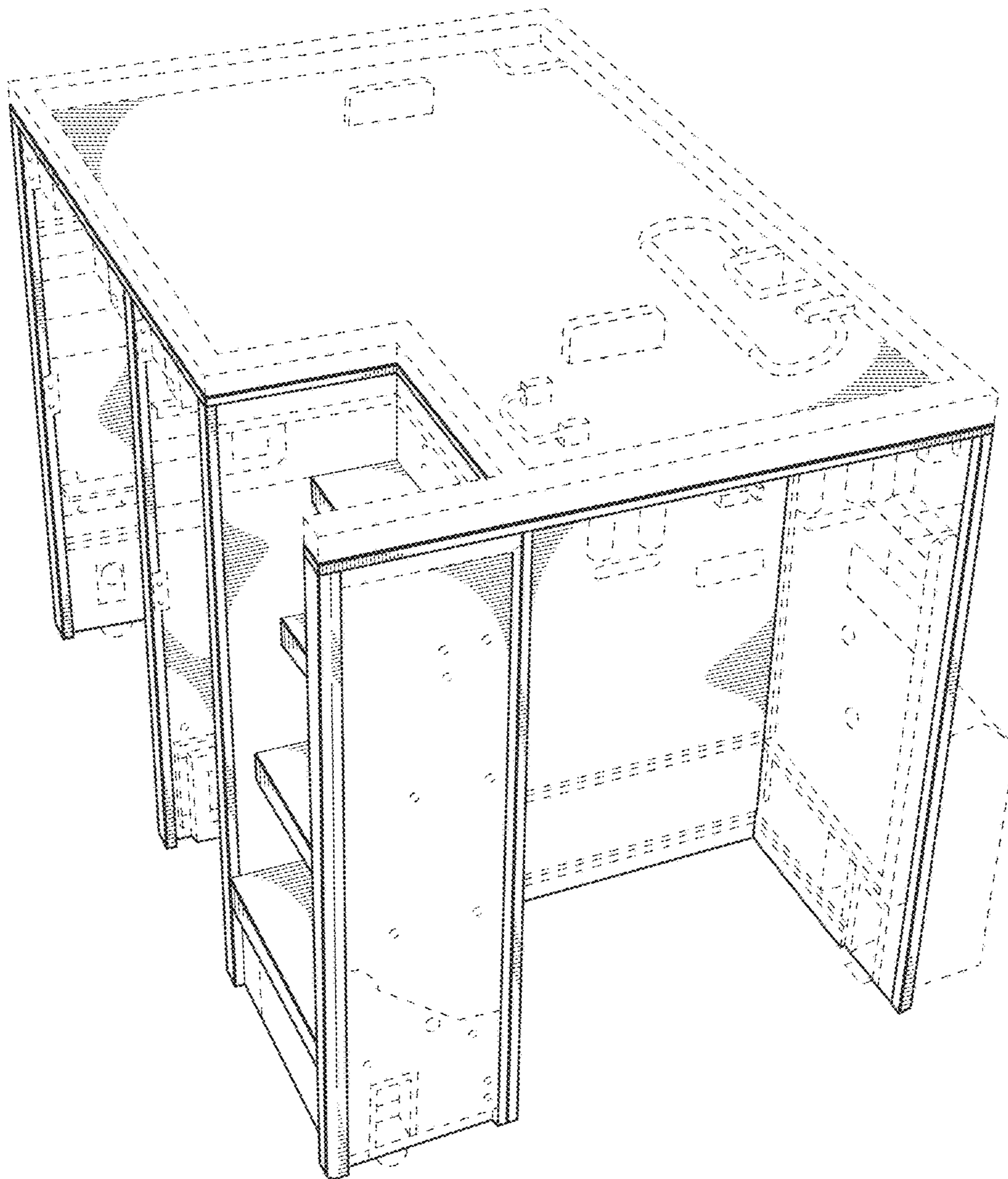
