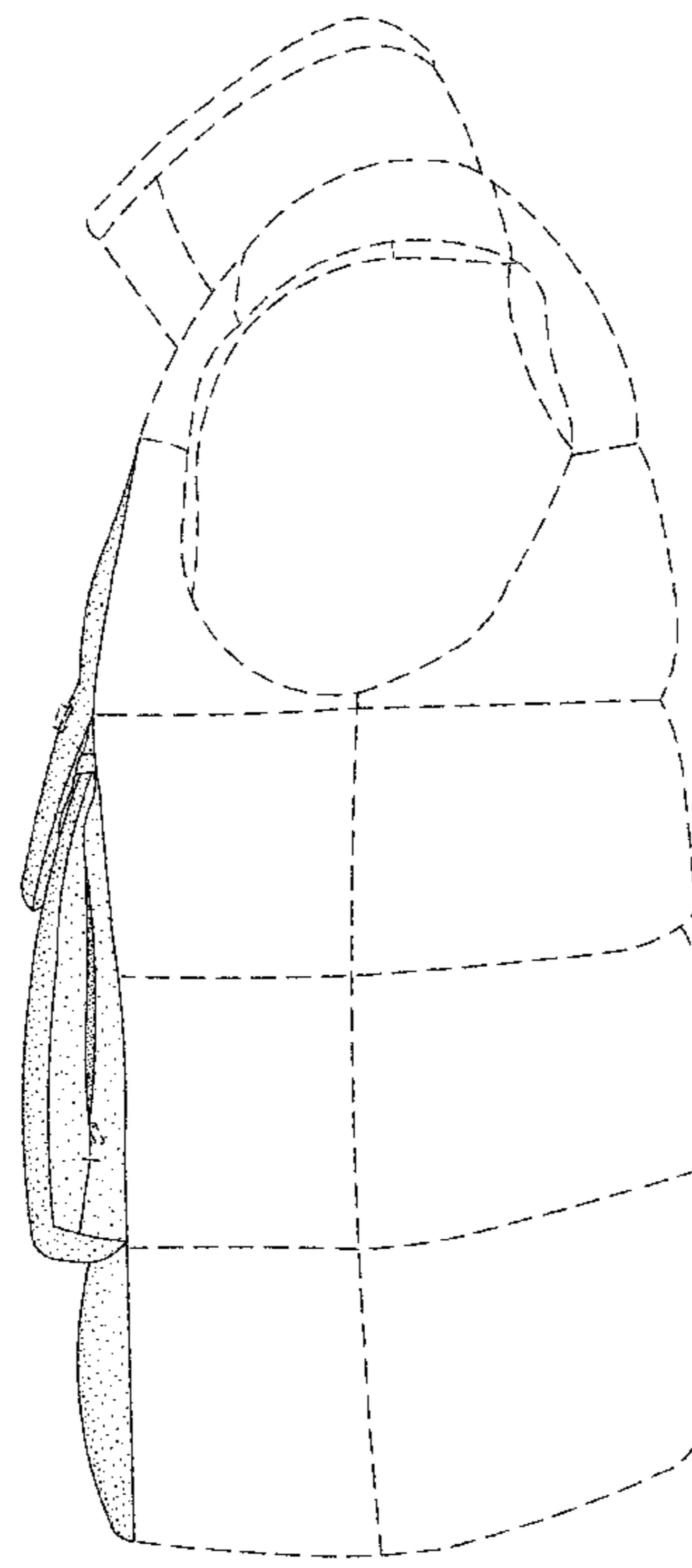
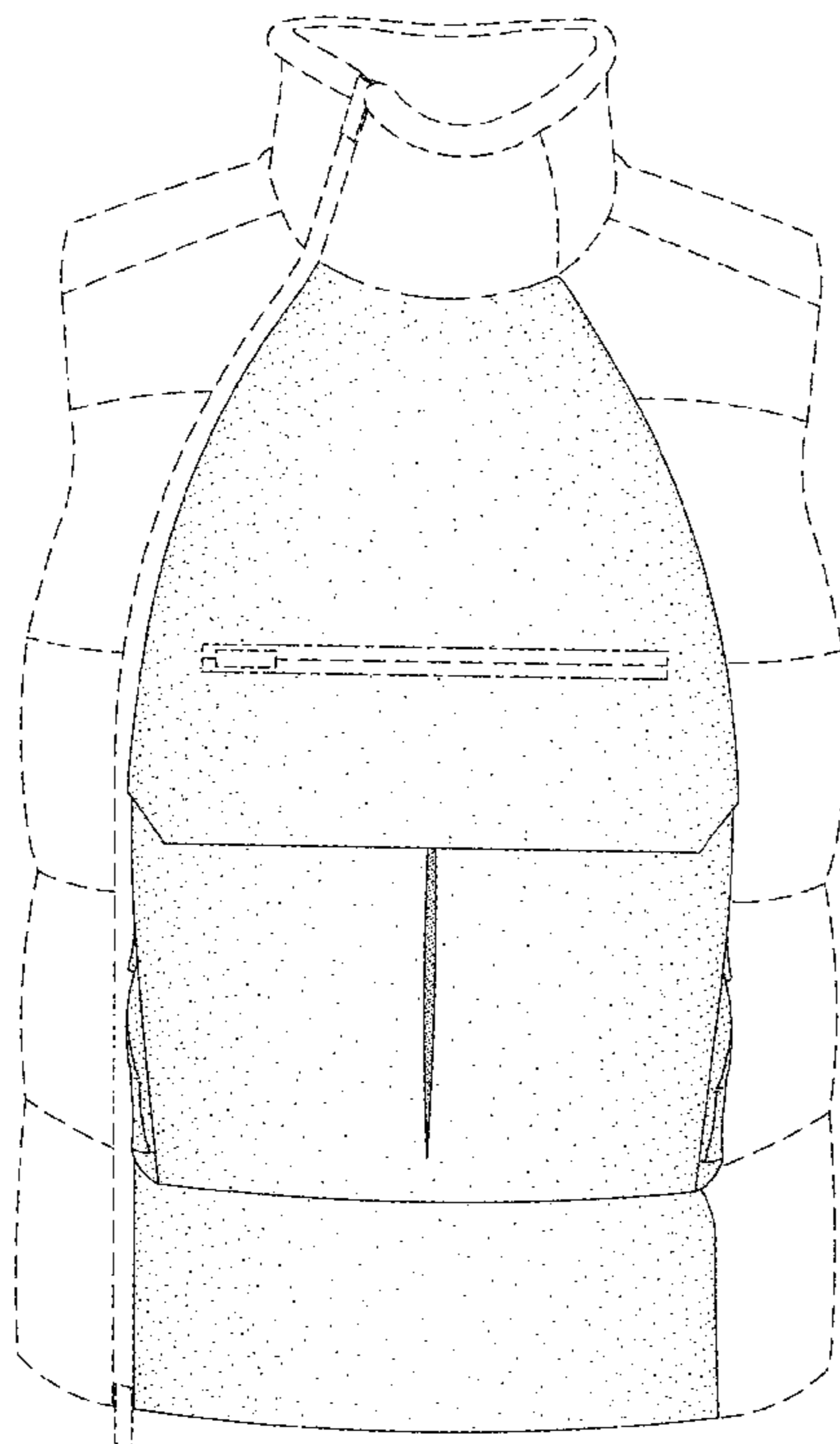
The ornamental design for a garment, as shown and described.

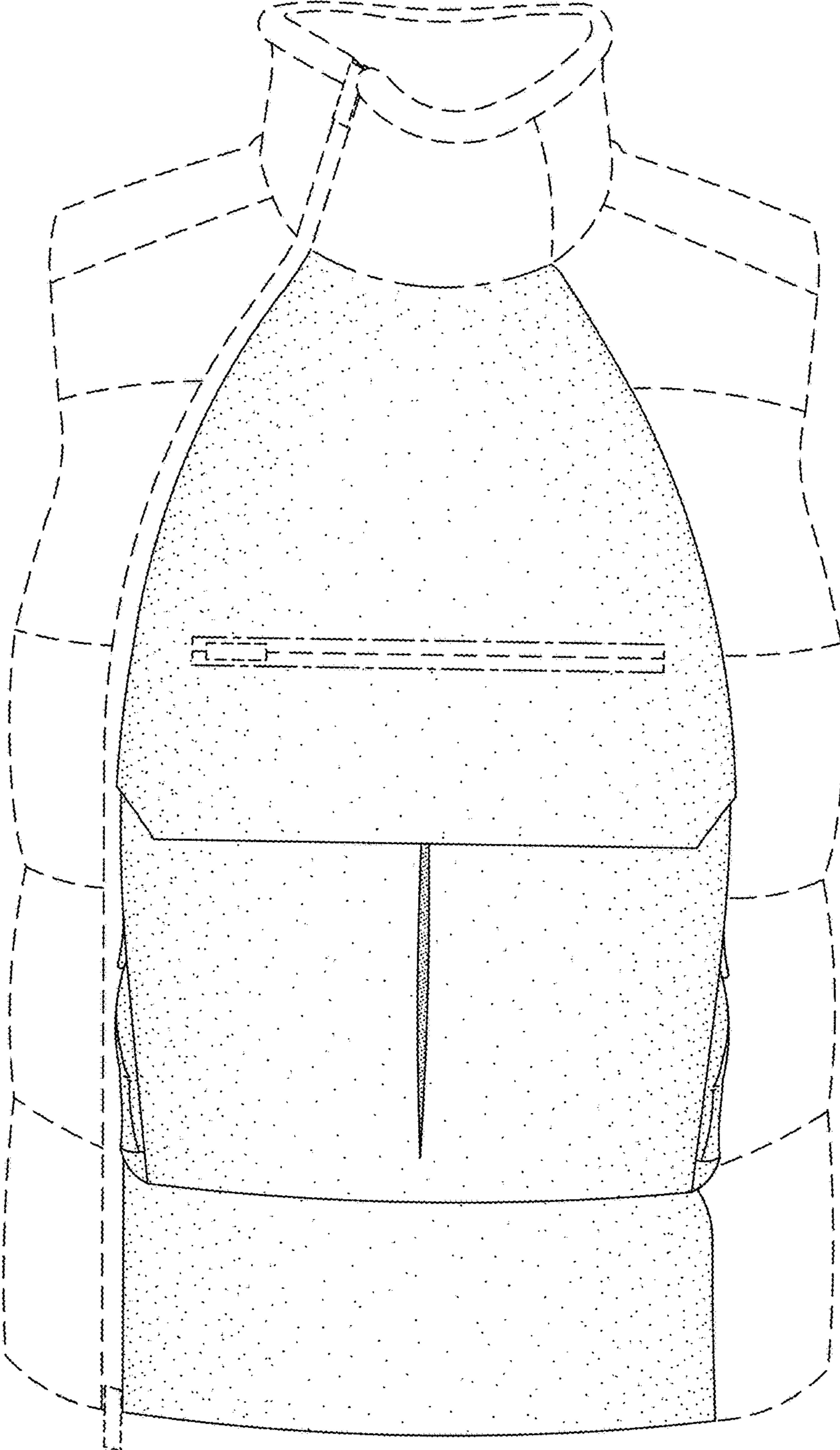
**DESCRIPTION**

in the open position.

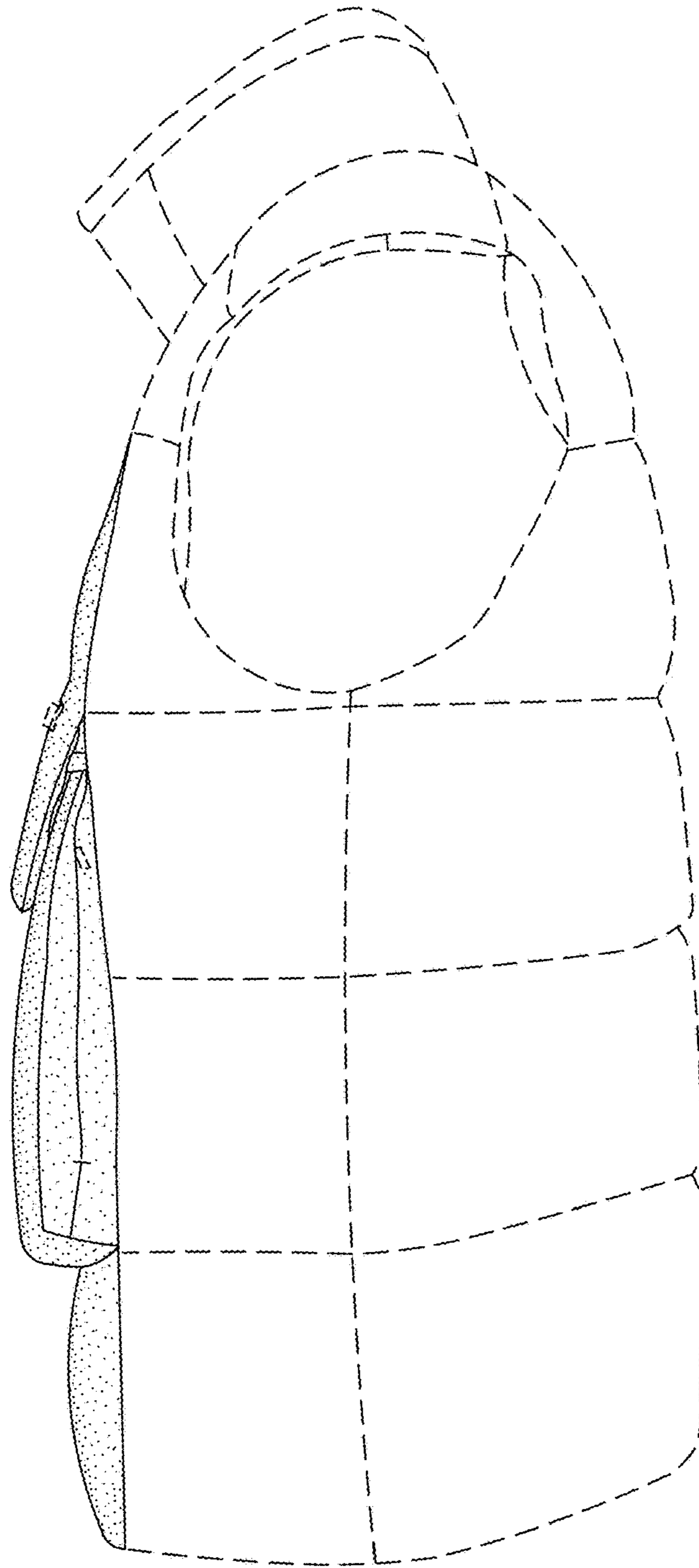

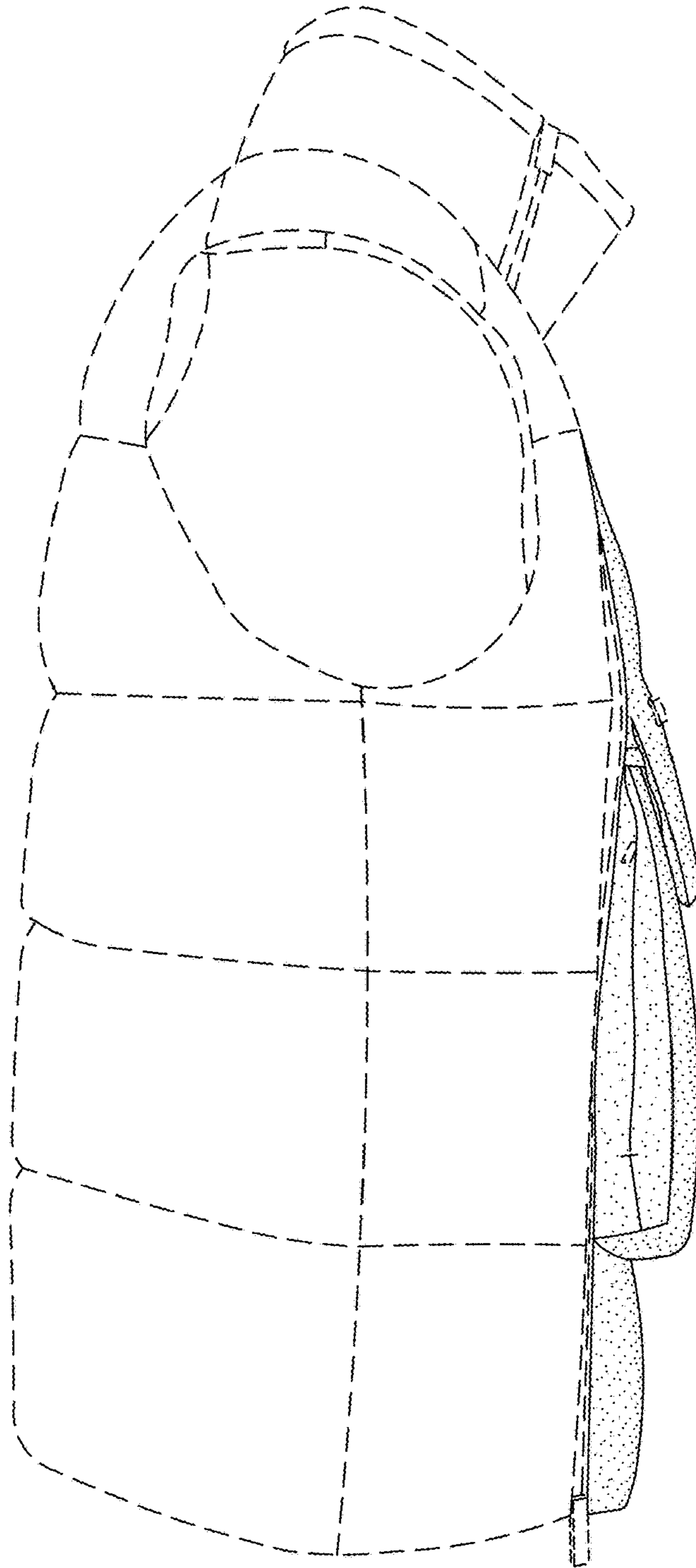

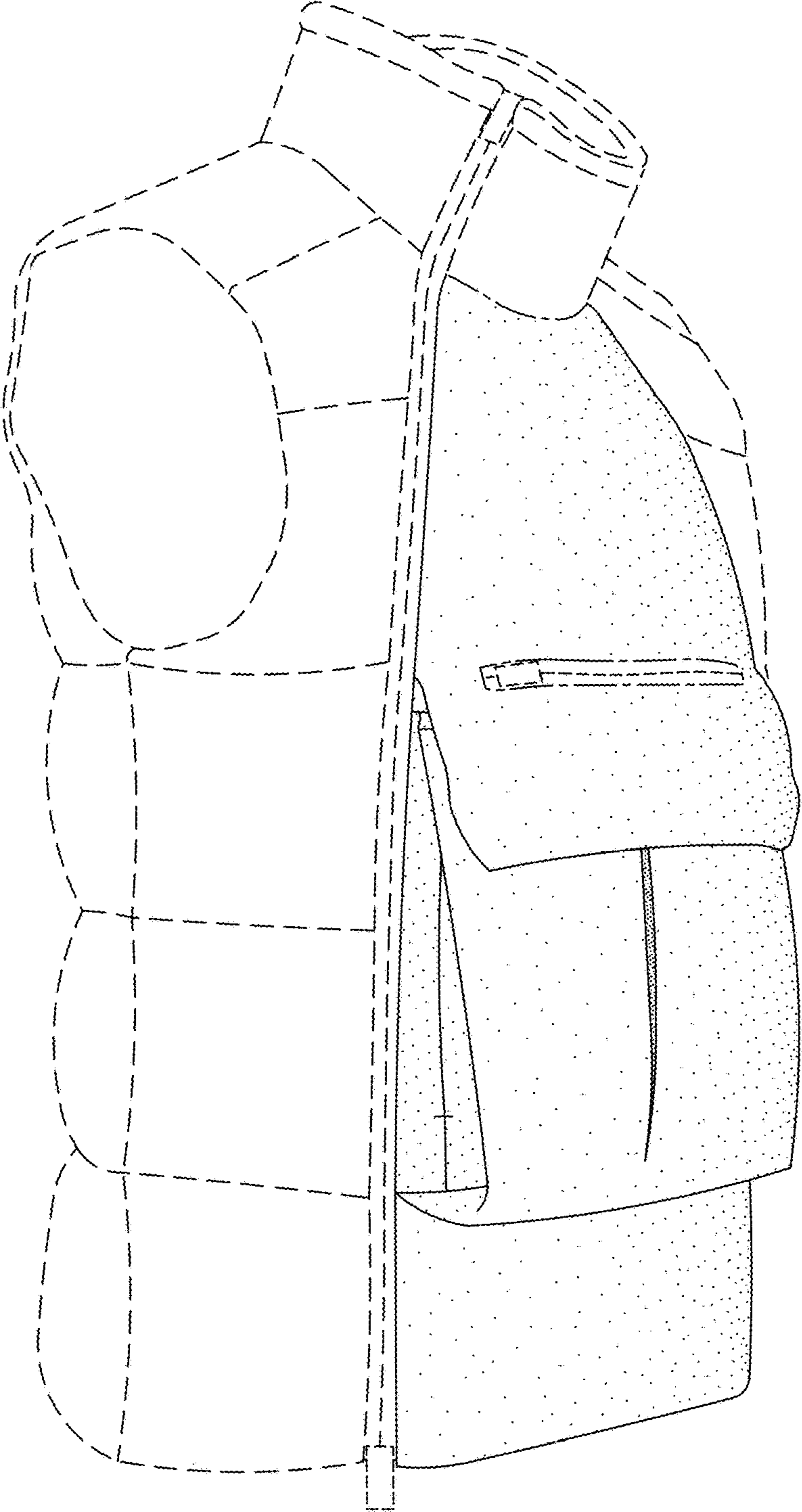
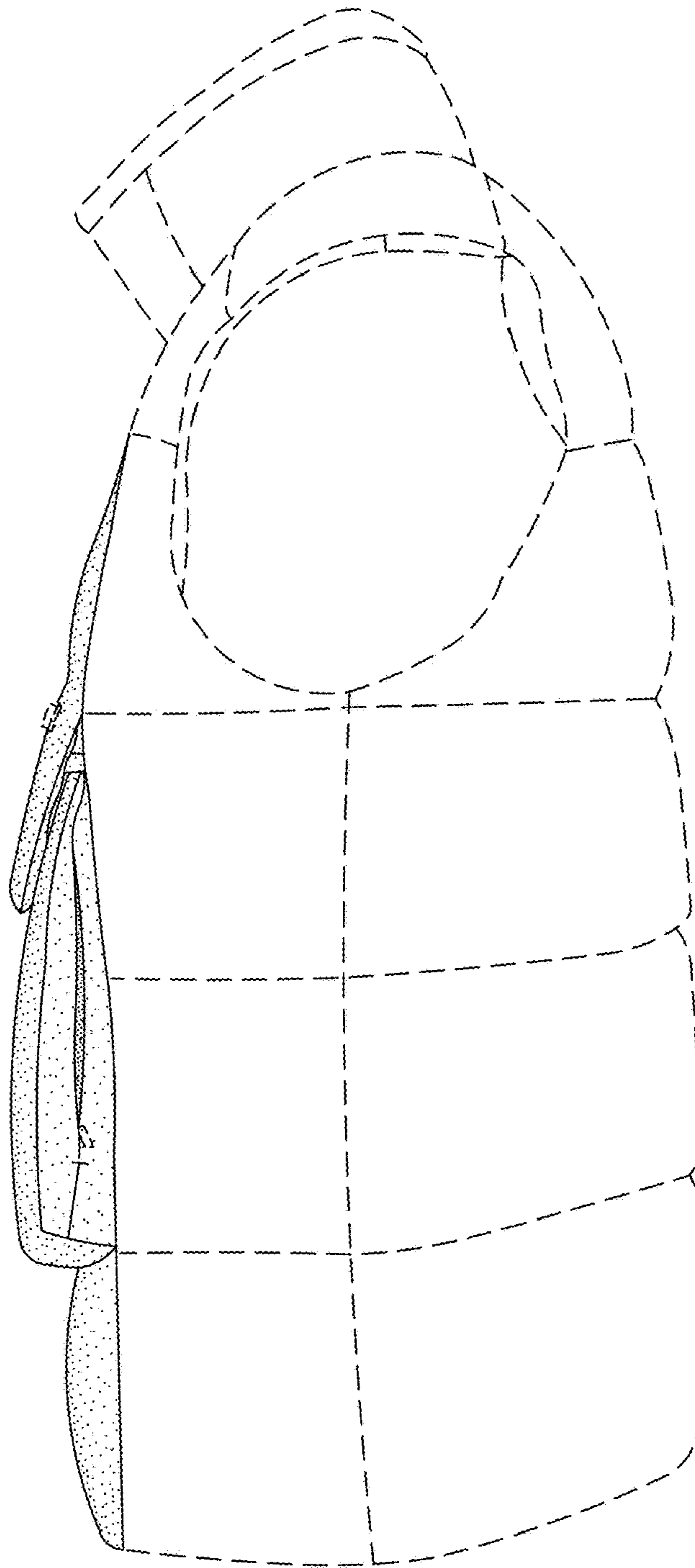
