(57) **CLAIM**

I claim, the ornamental design for a detachable bag, as
shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

shown in FIG. 12;

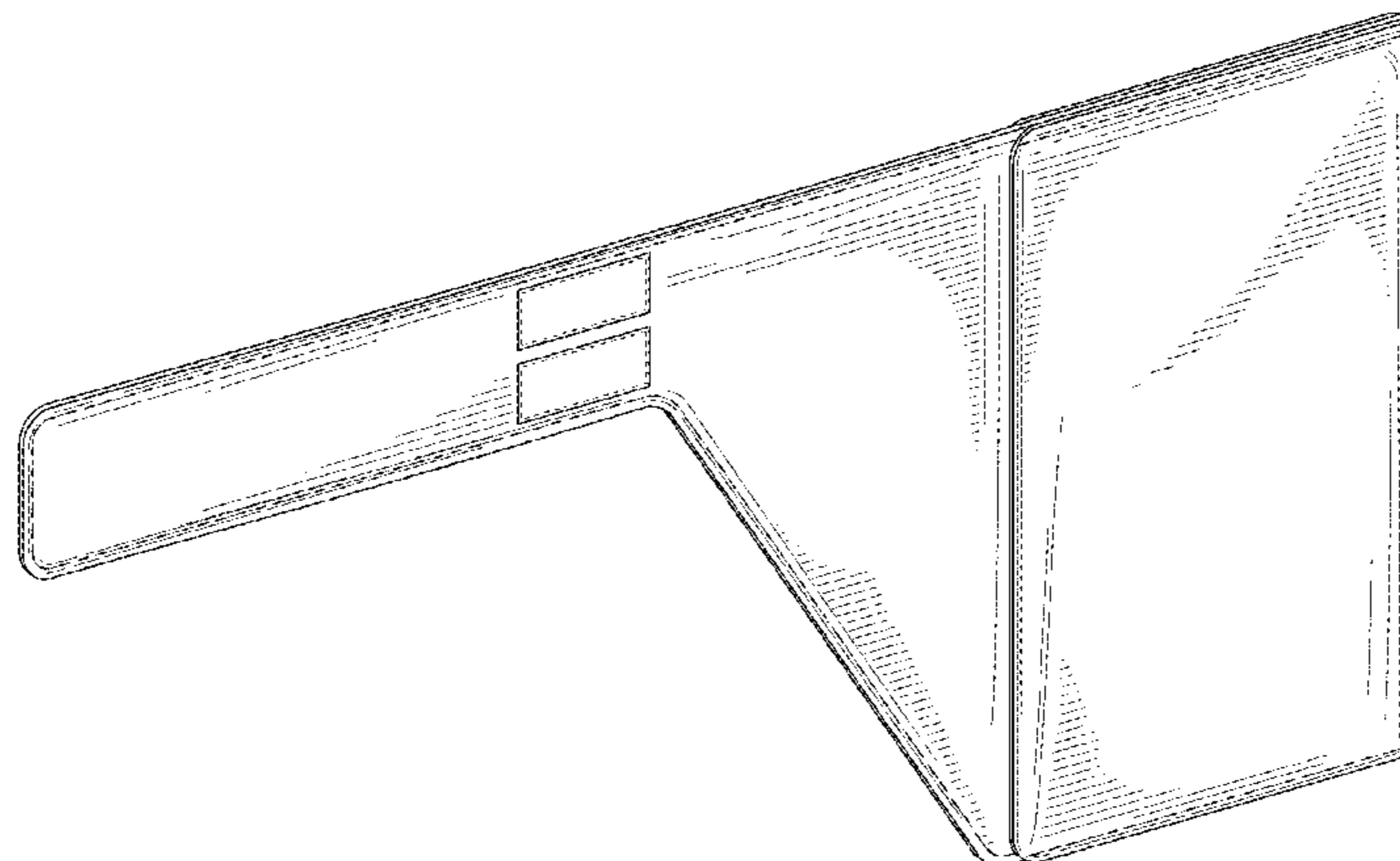
FIG. 20 is a front perspective view of the embodiment shown

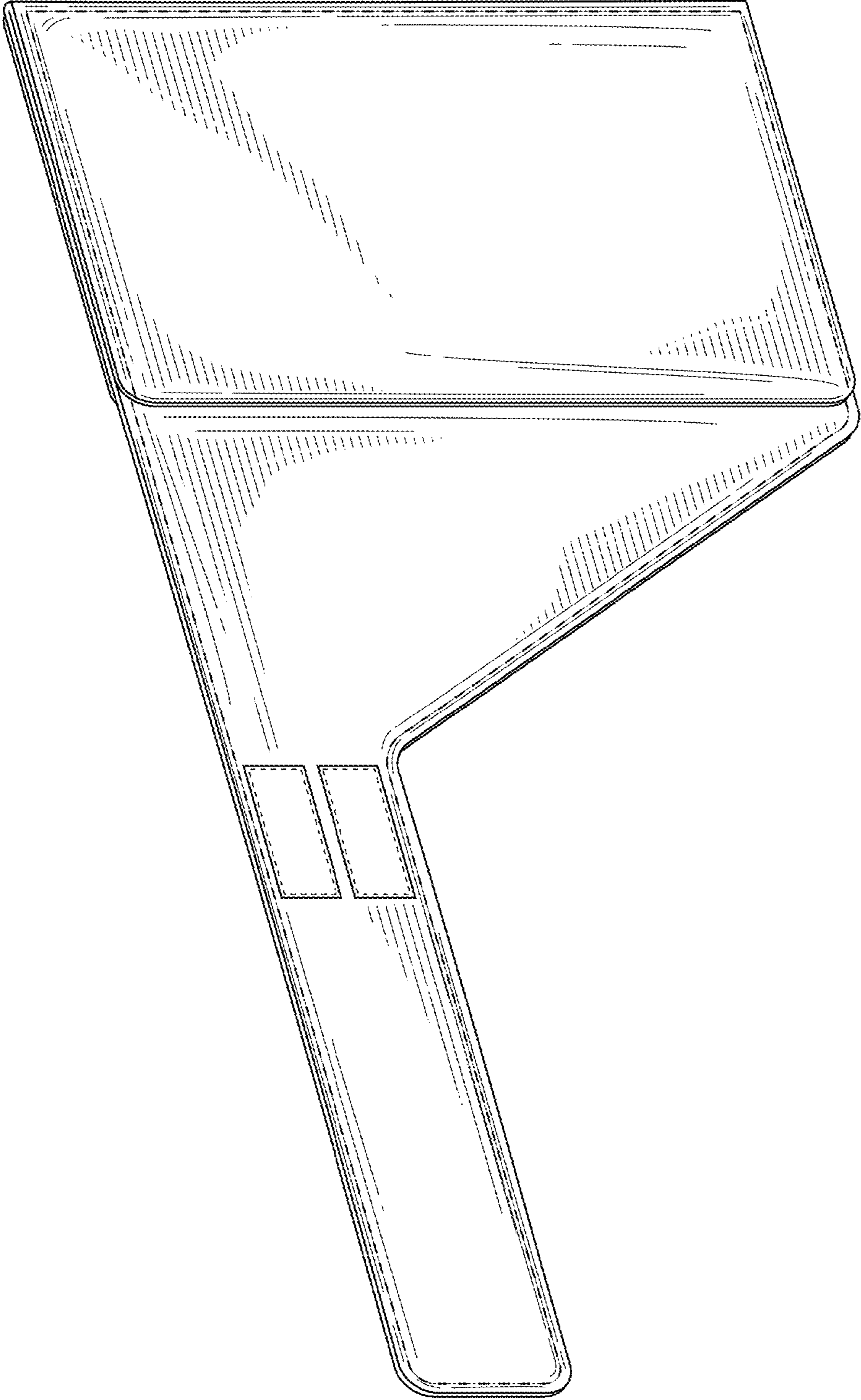

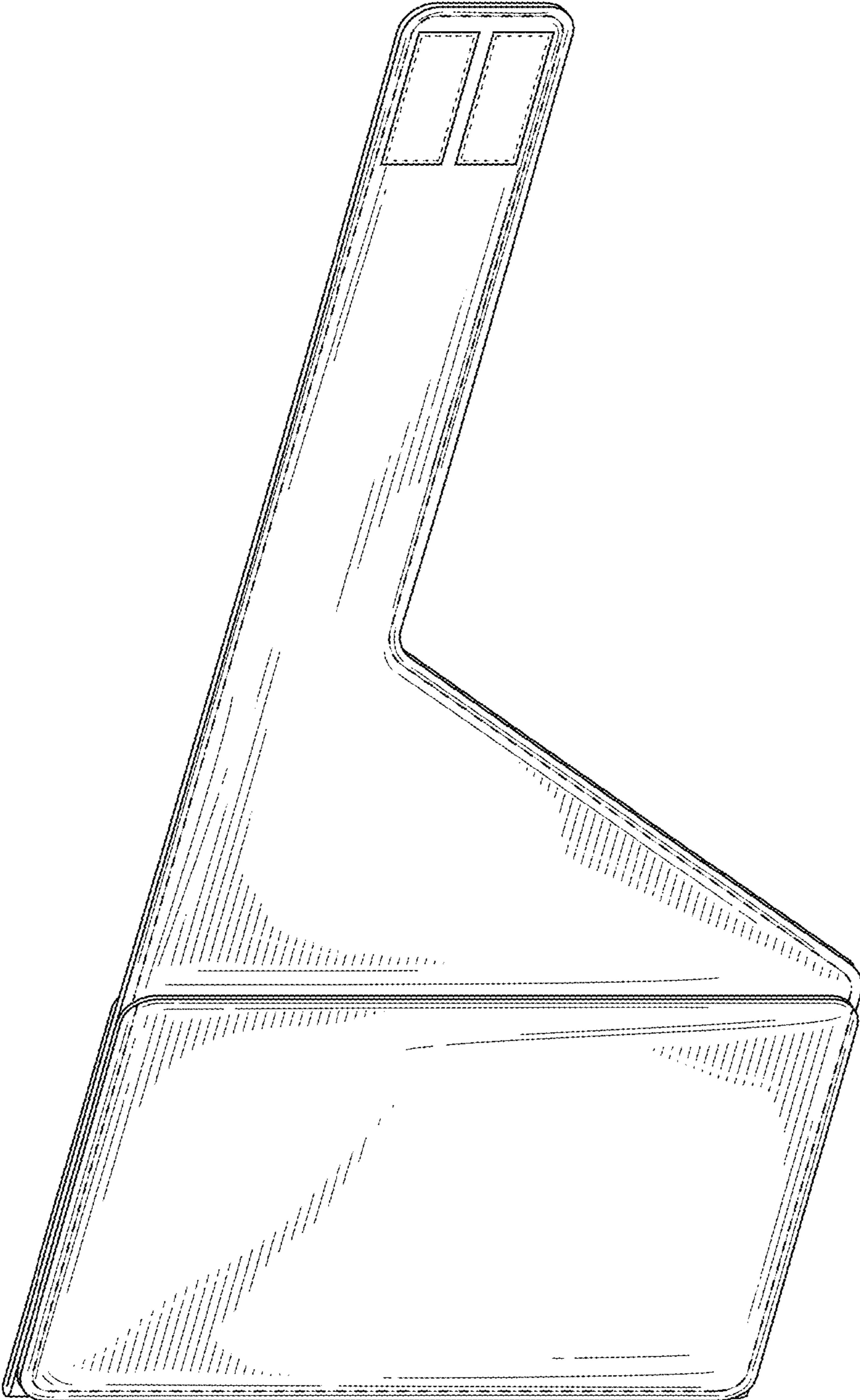

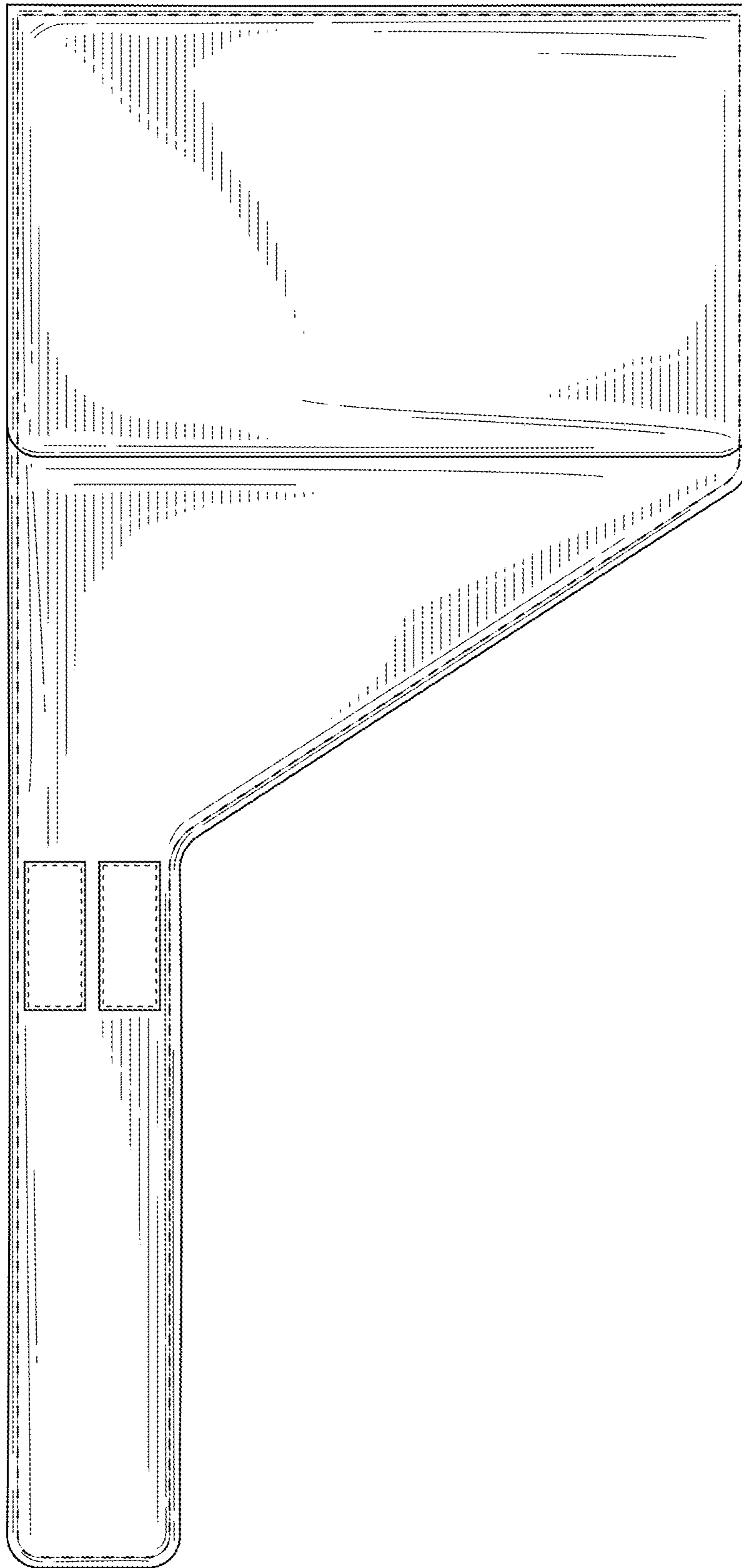

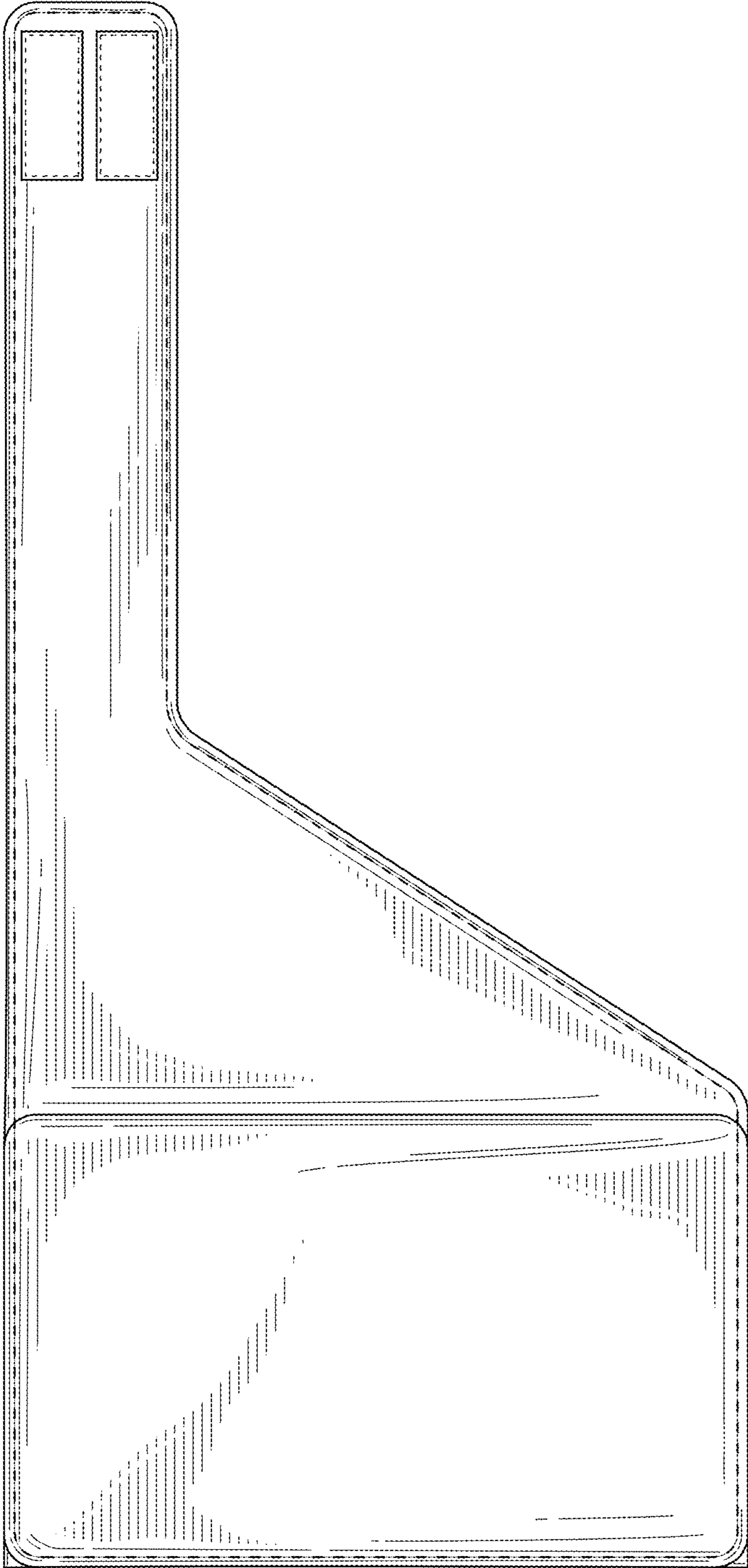

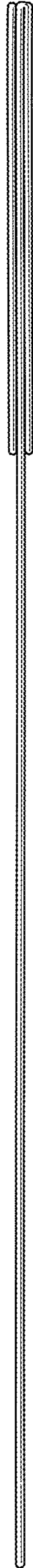

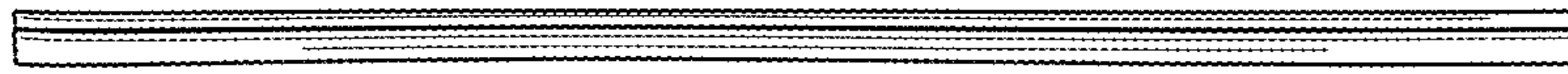

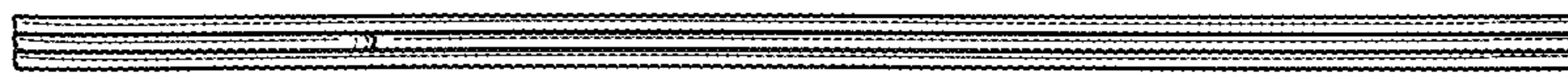

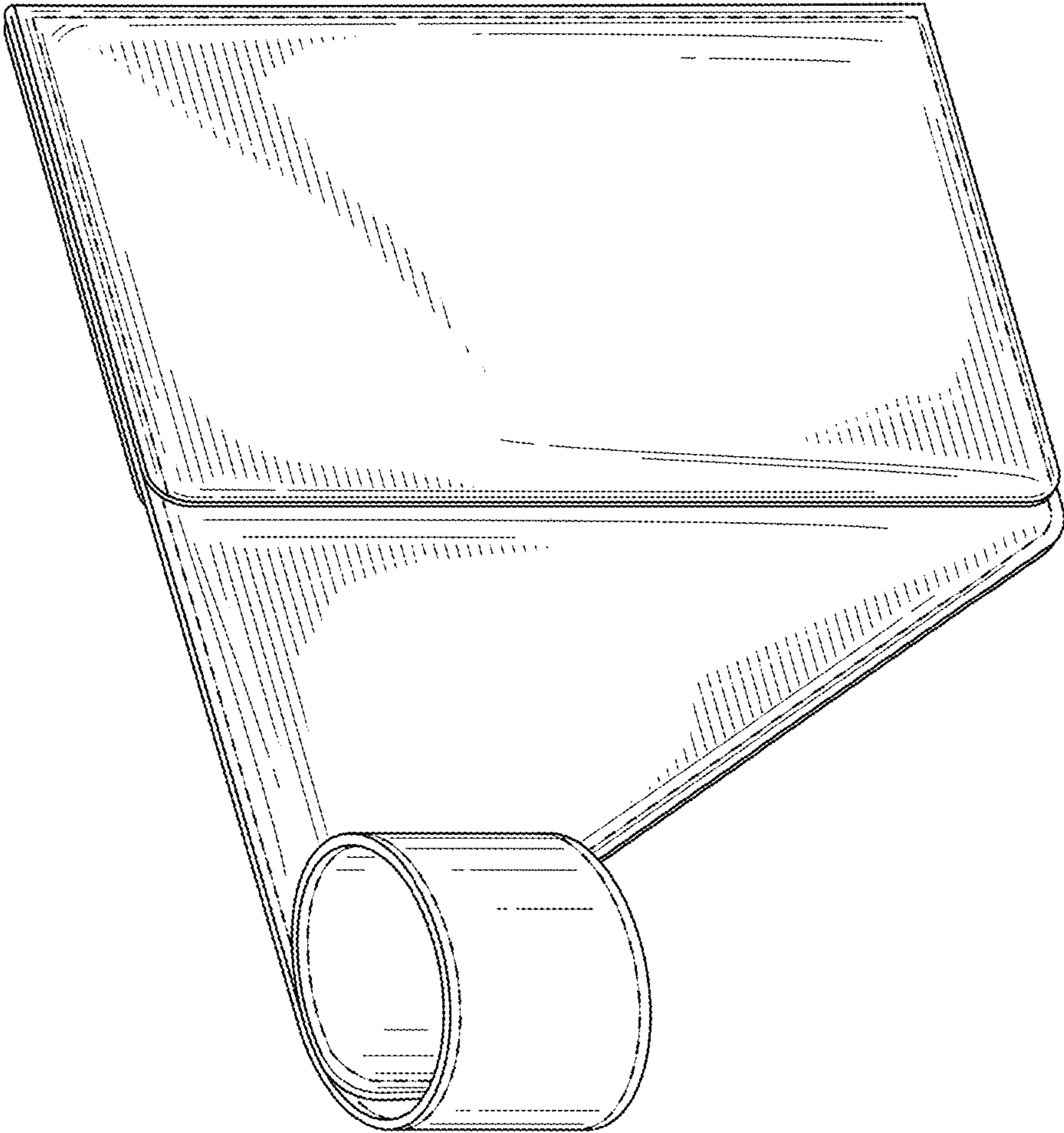

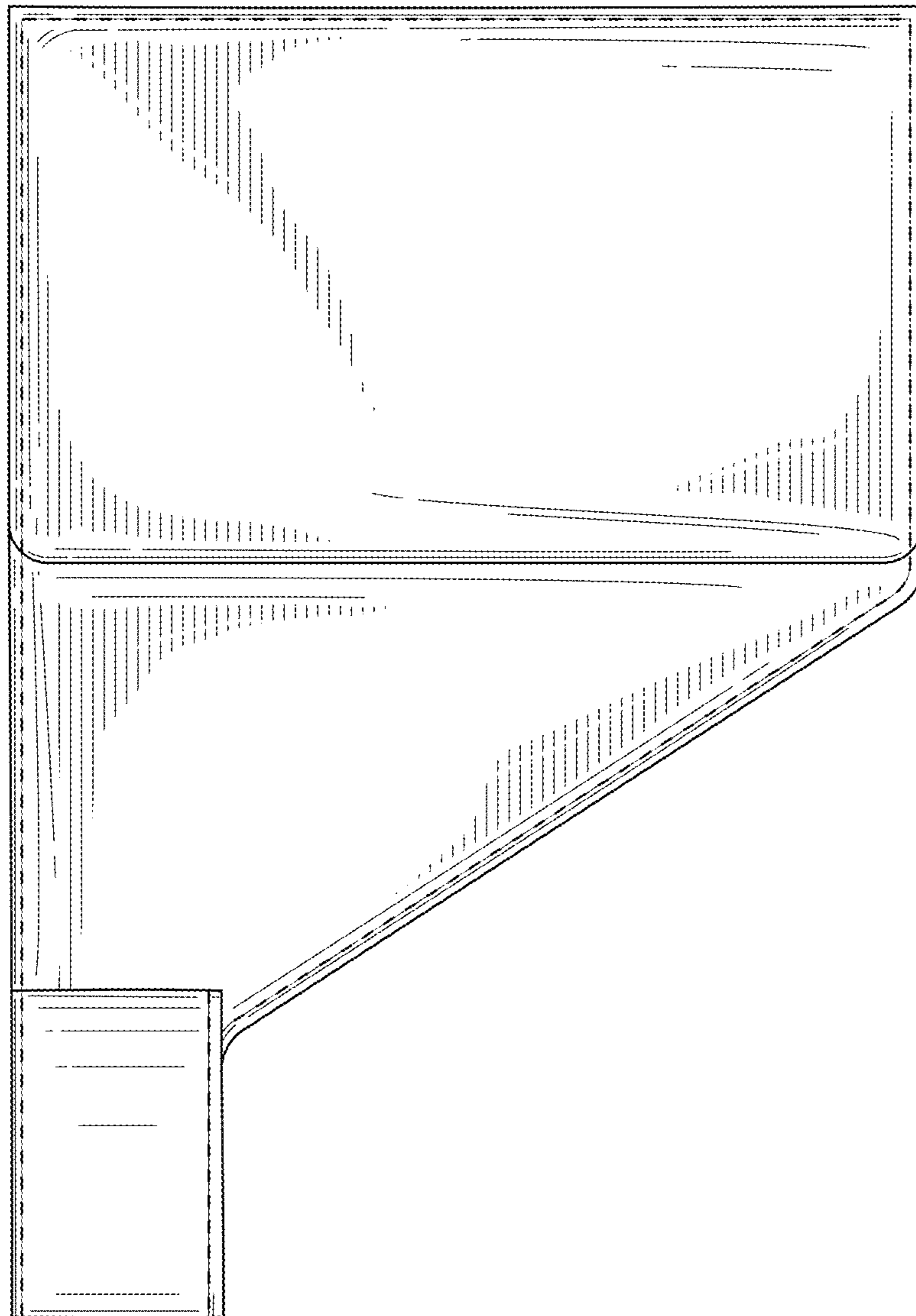

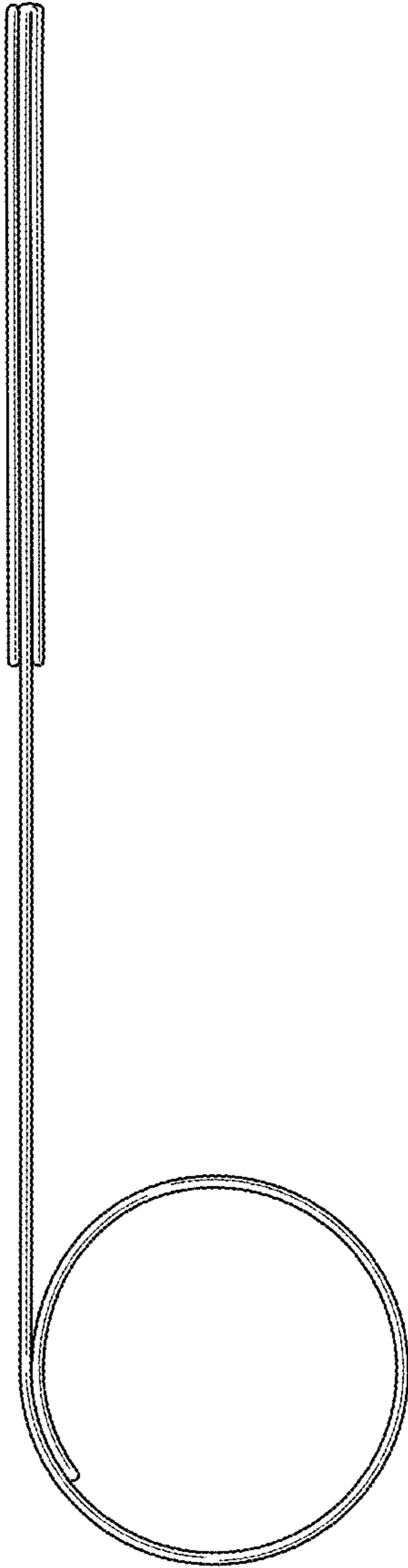

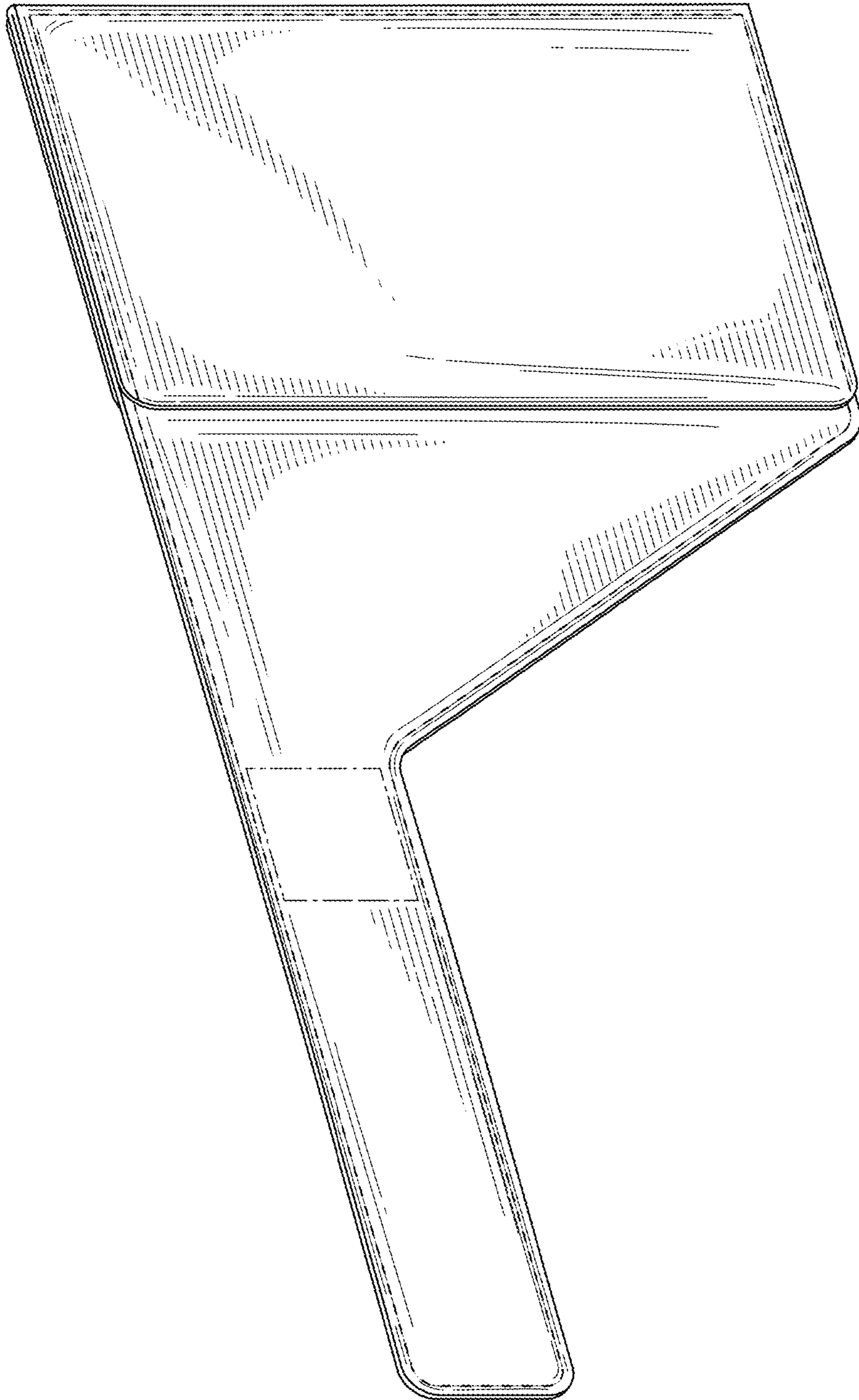

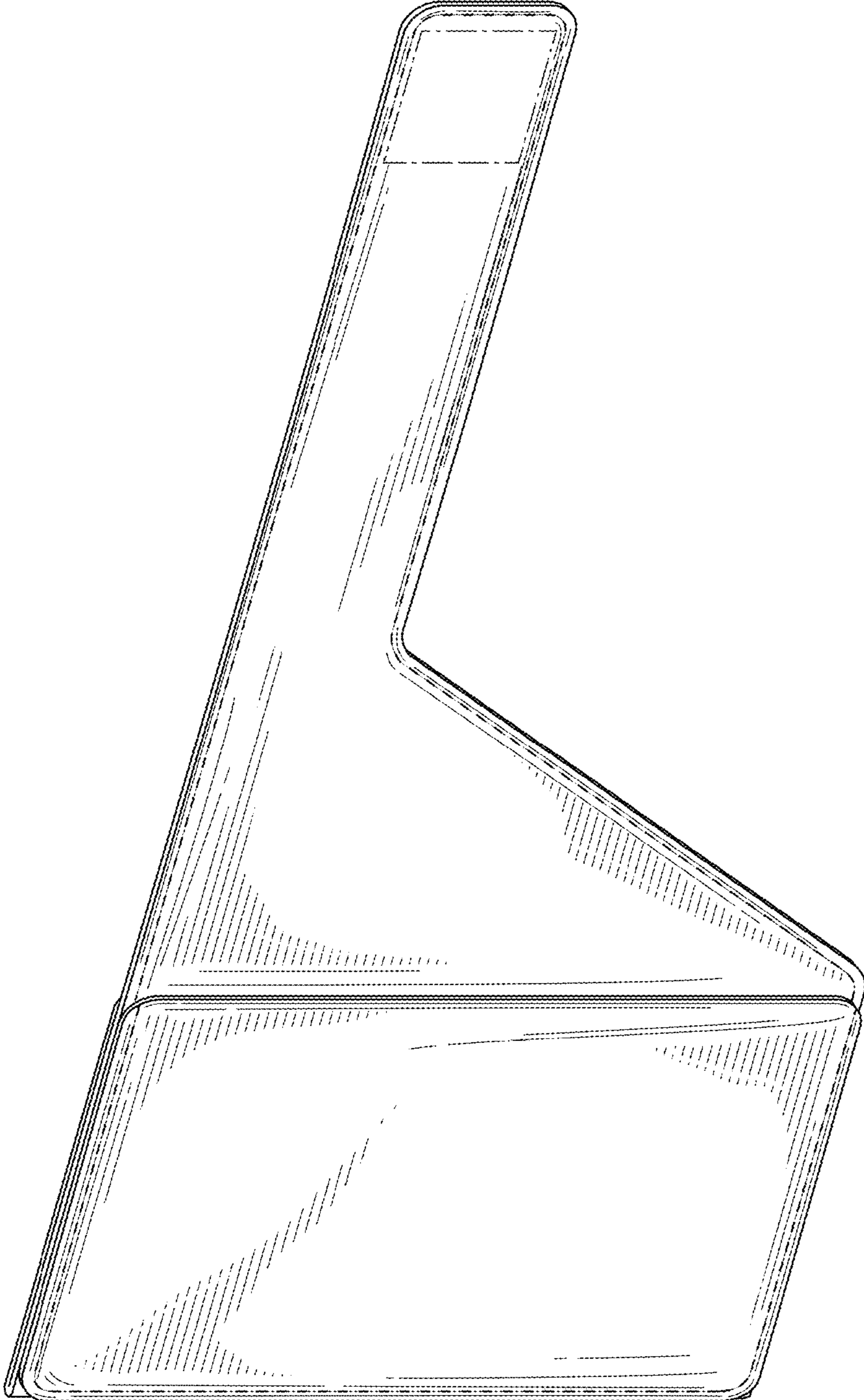

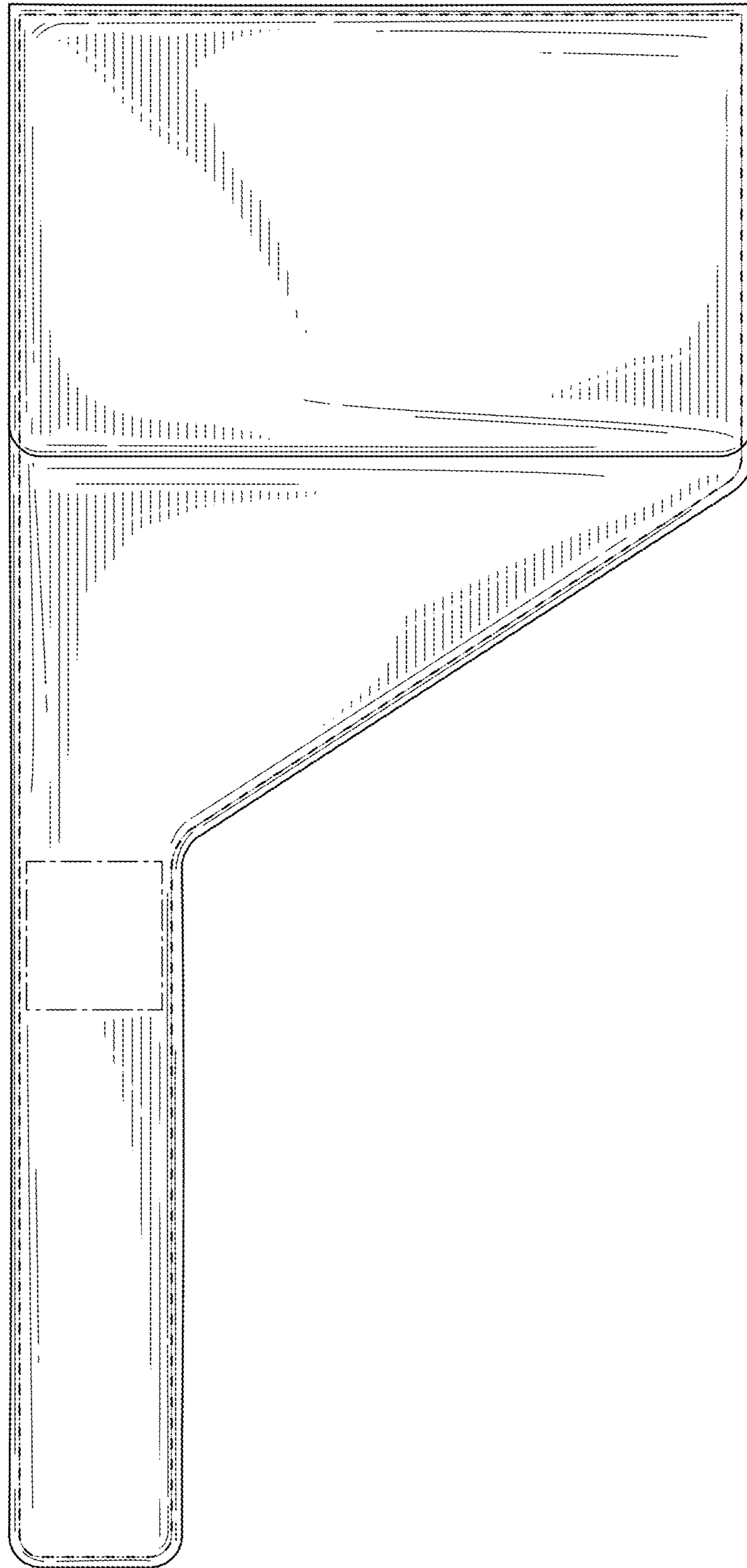

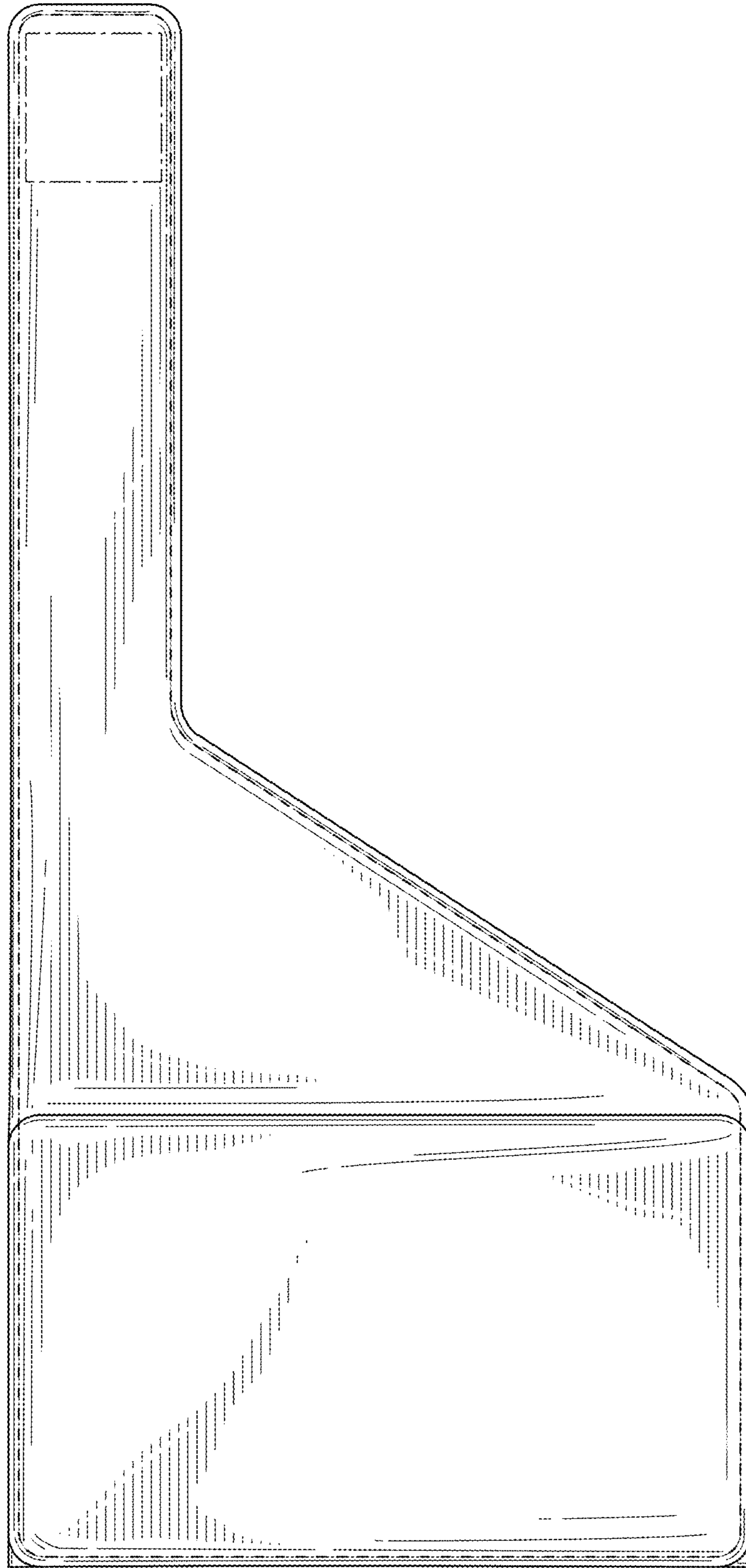

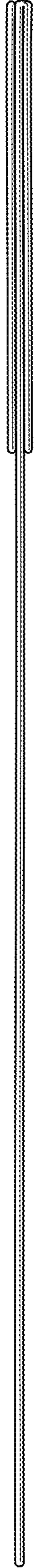

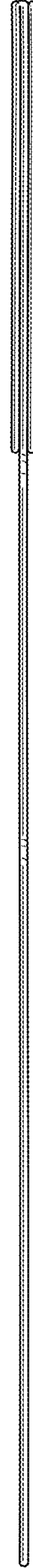

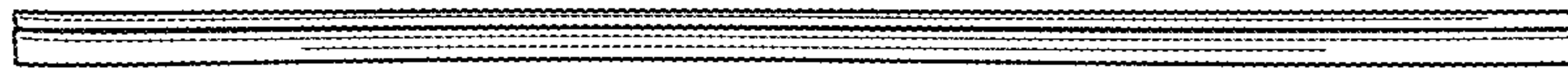

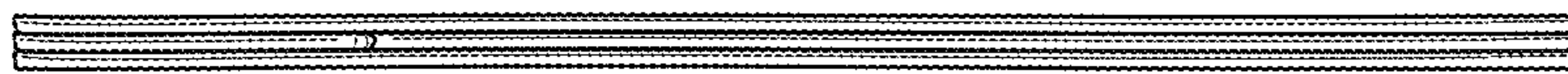

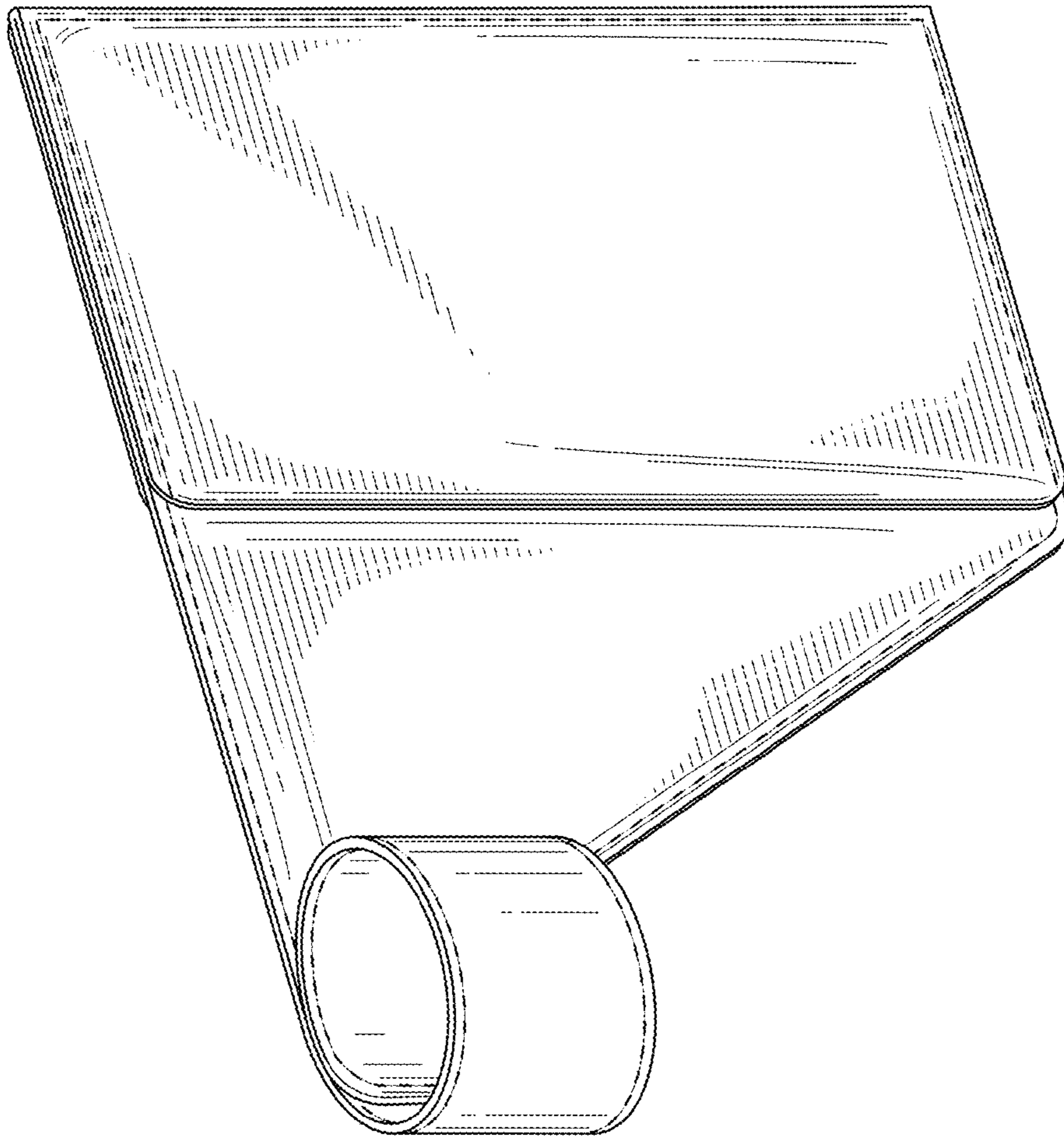

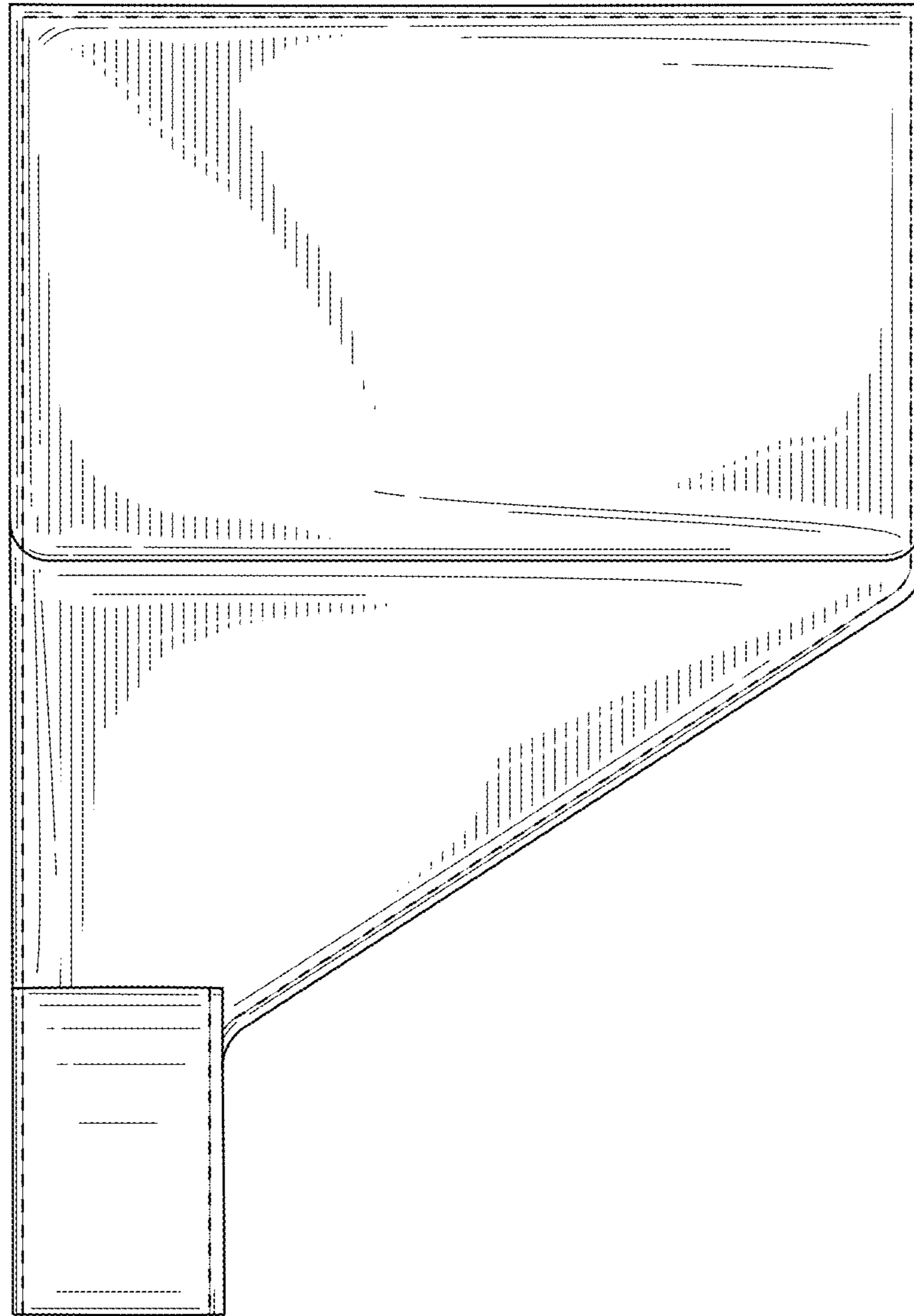

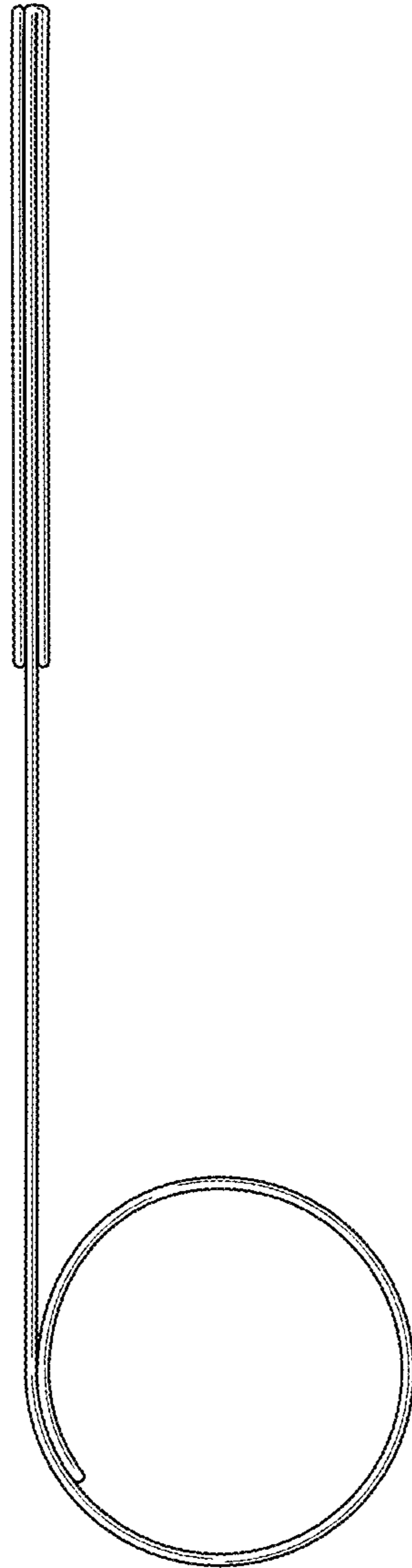
