of another embodiment of the claimed design;

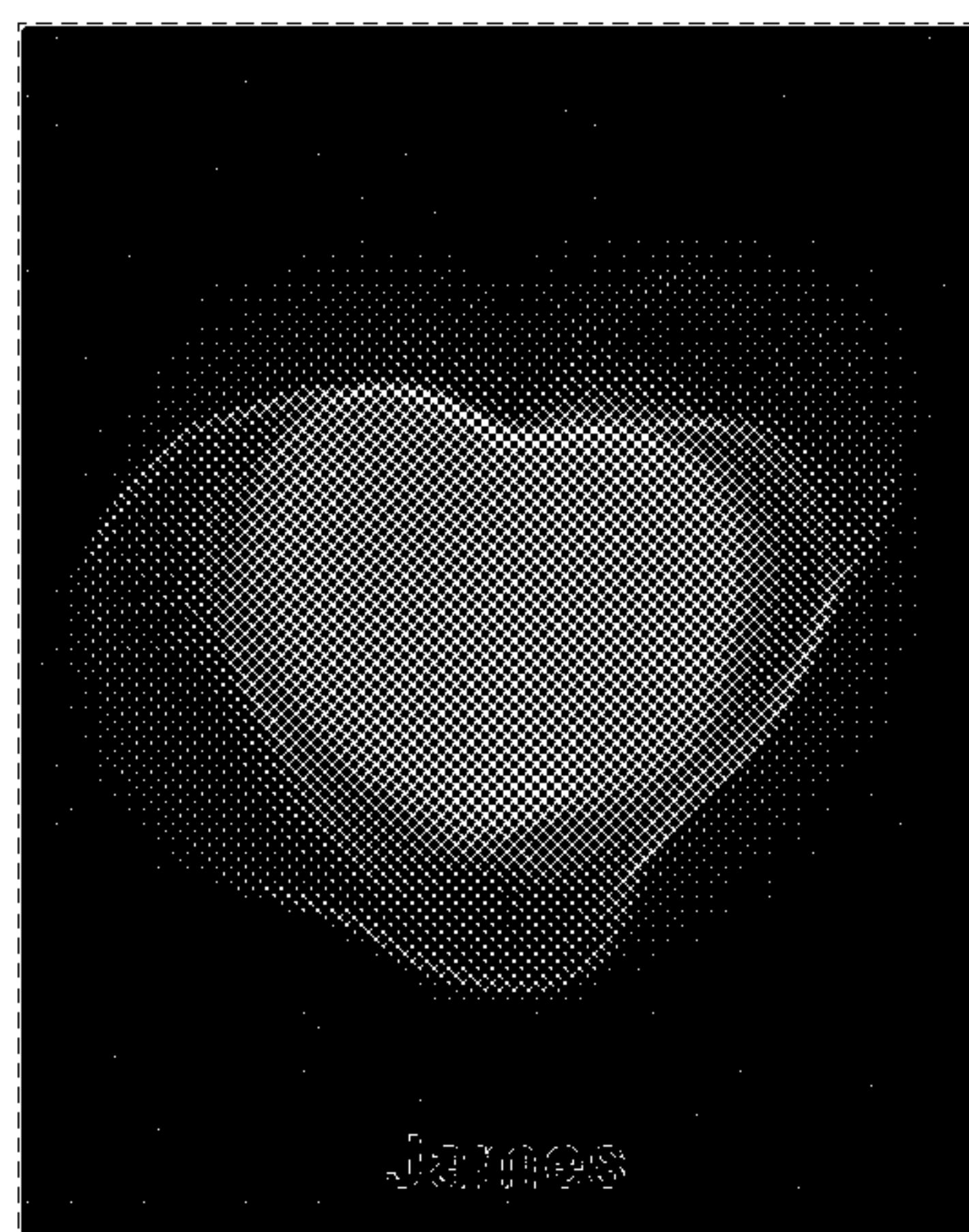
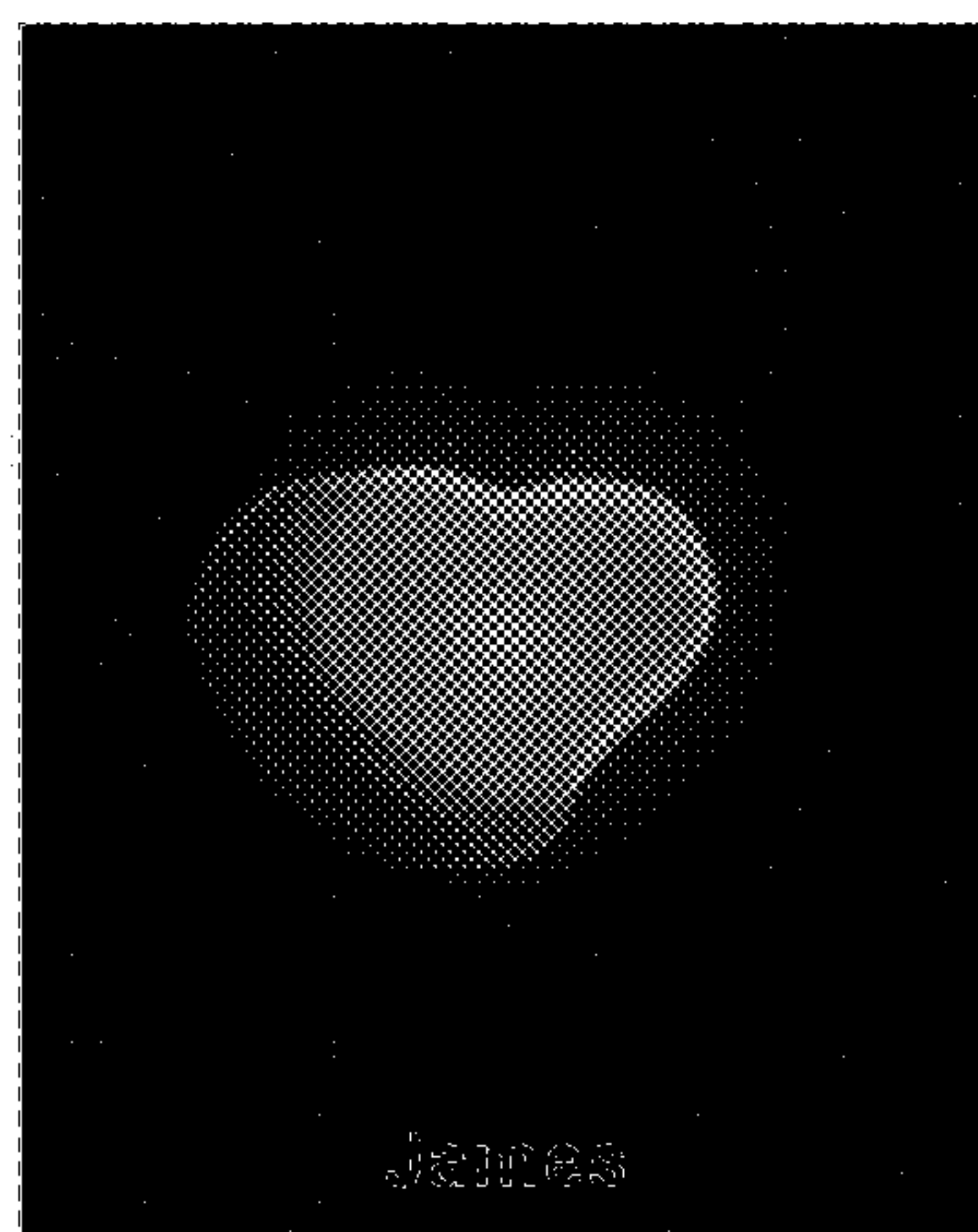
FIG. 7 is a second image thereof;

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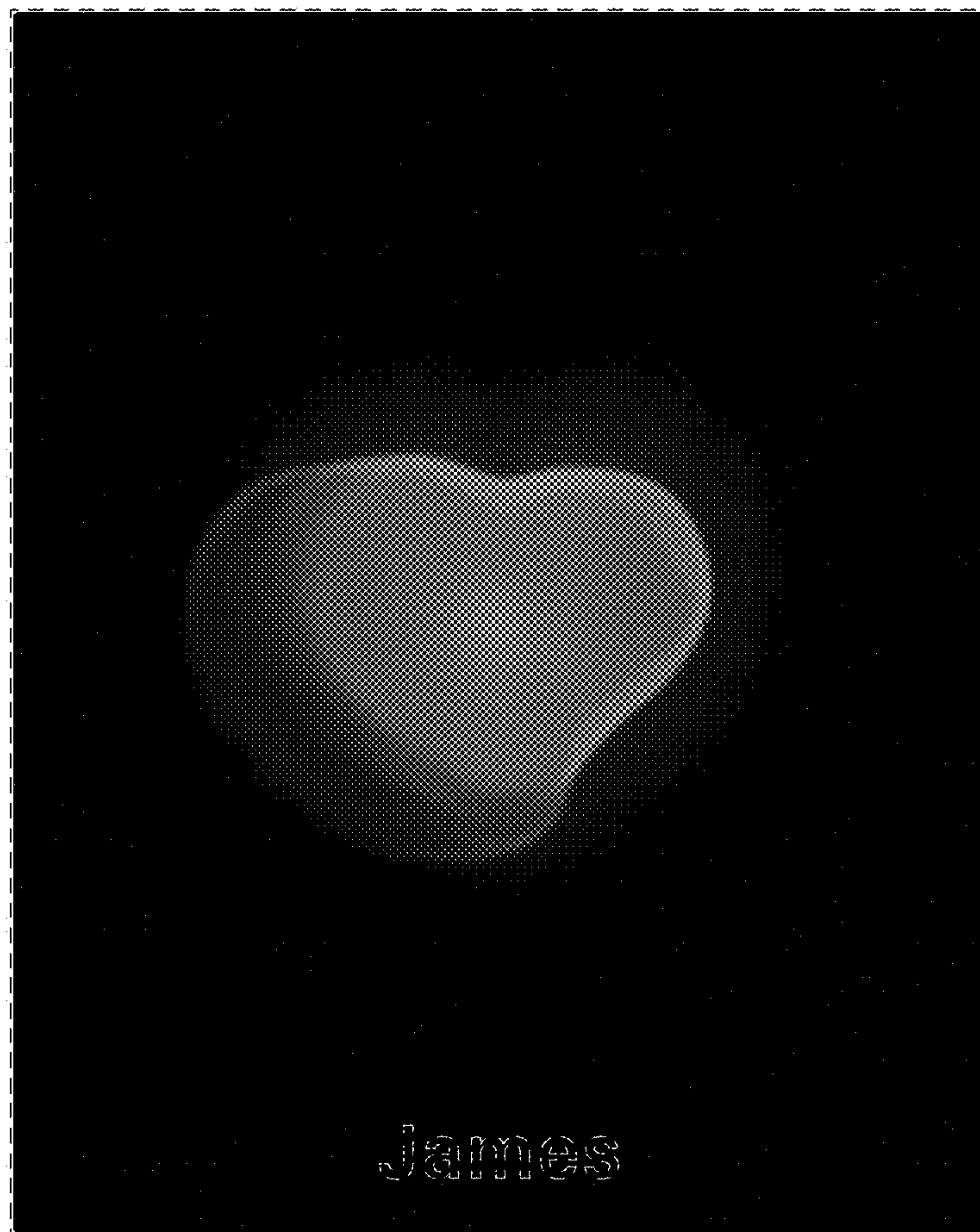

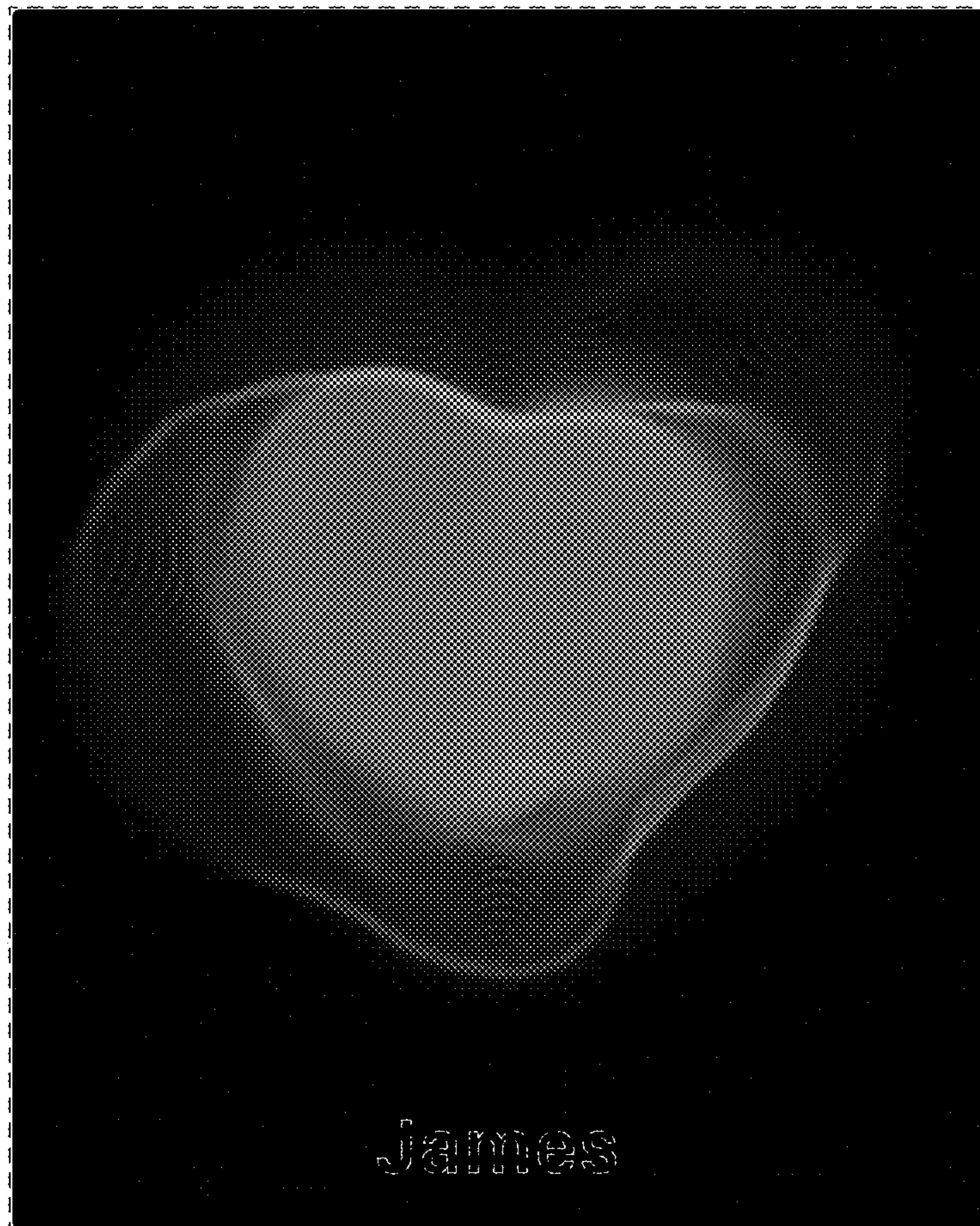

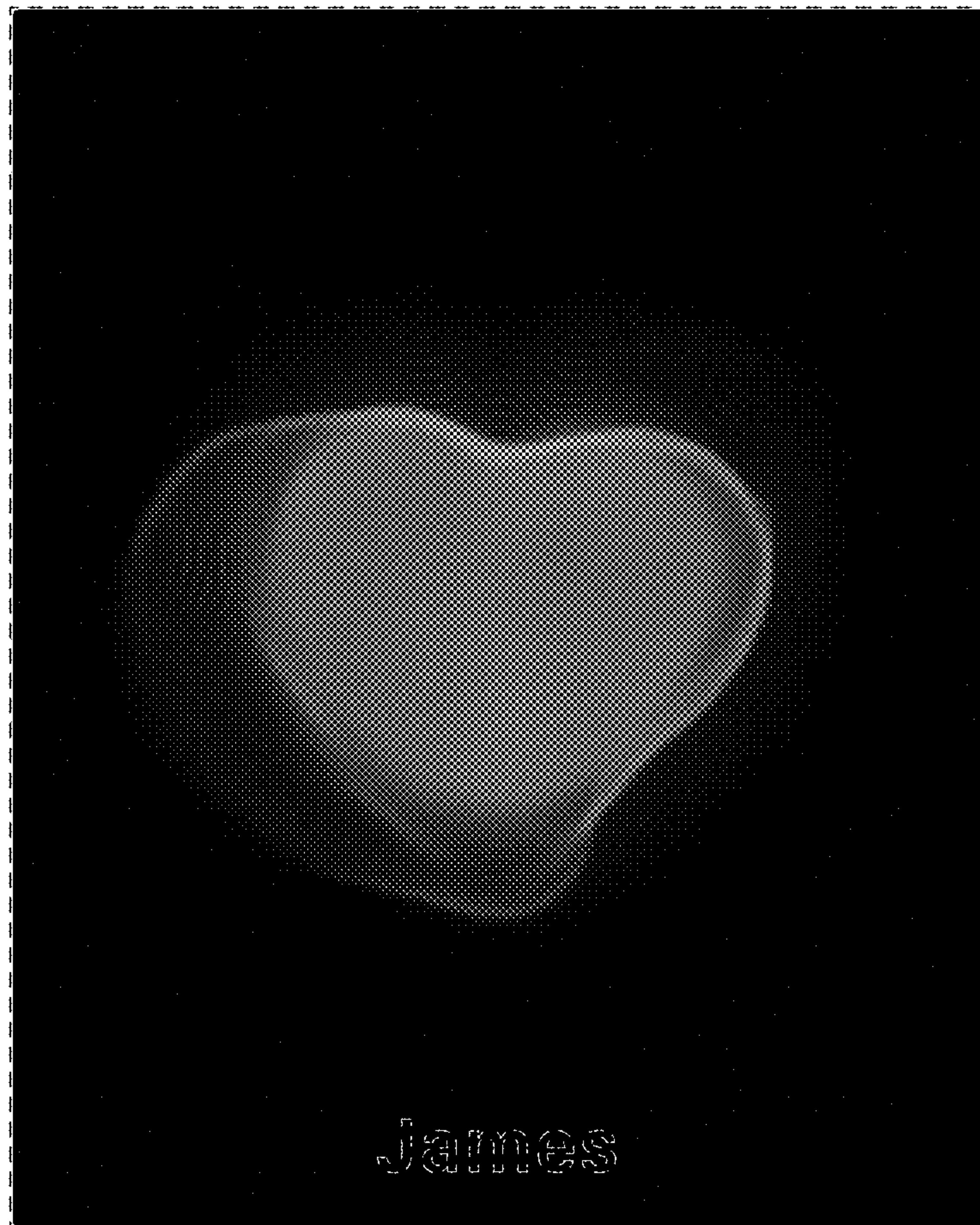

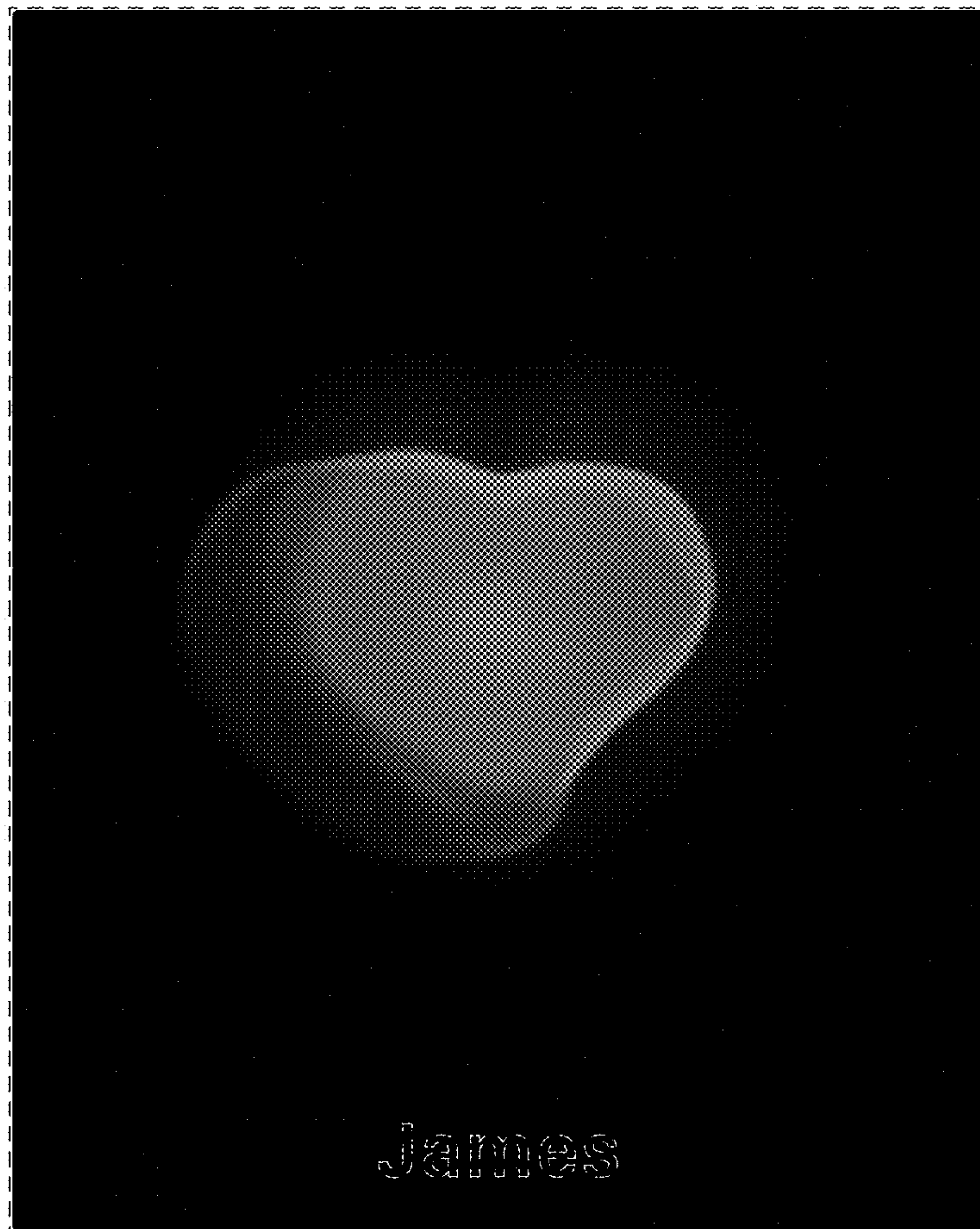

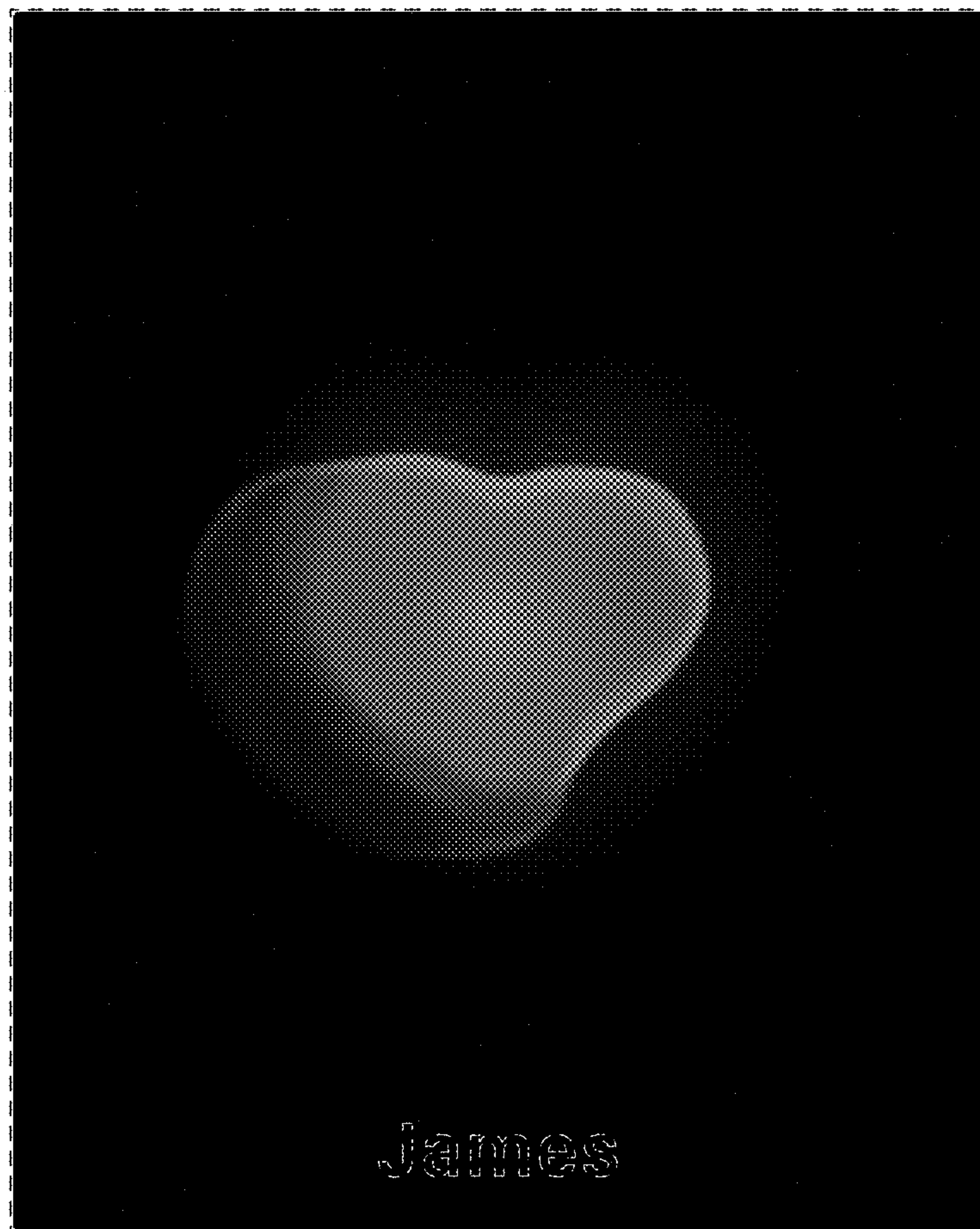

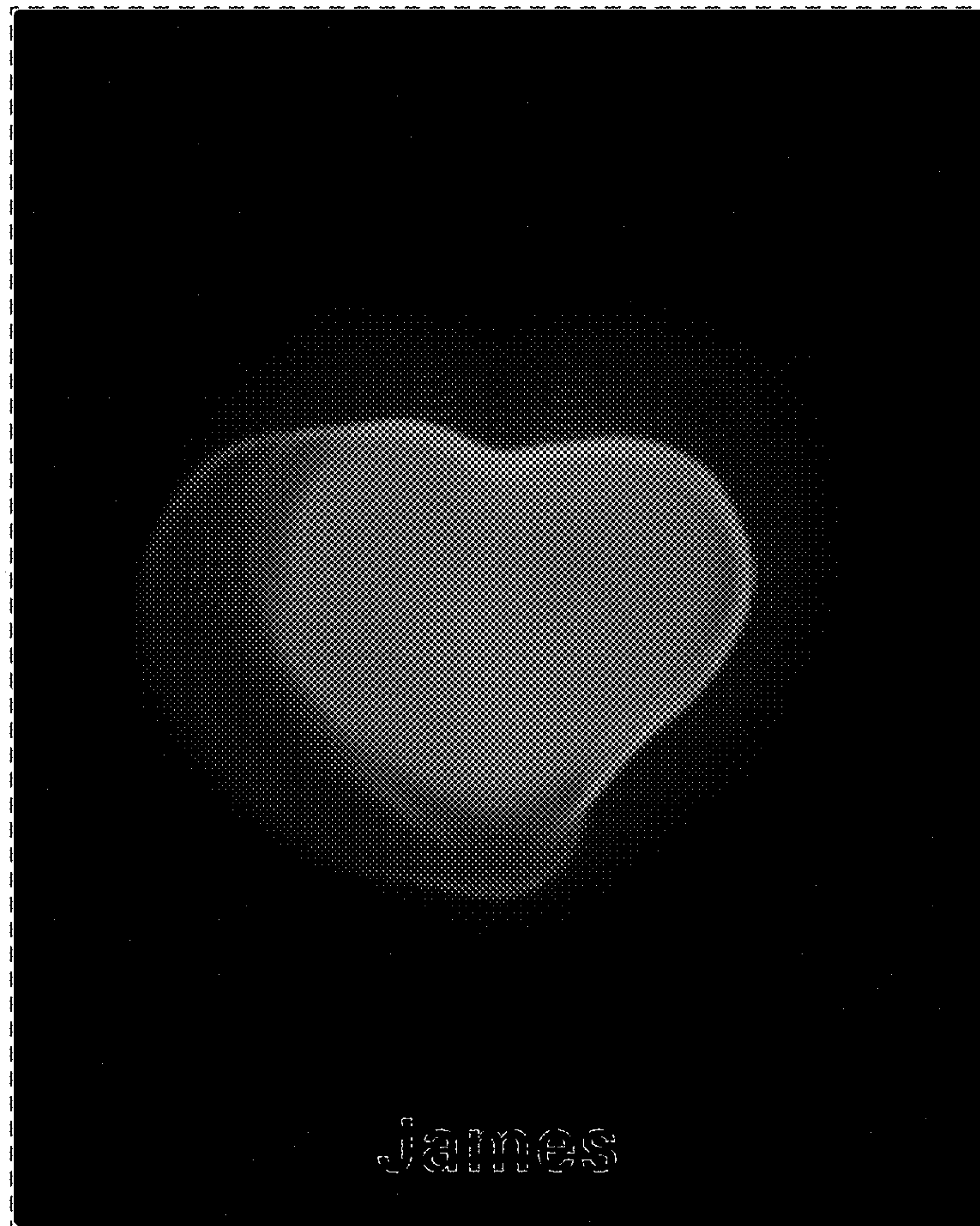

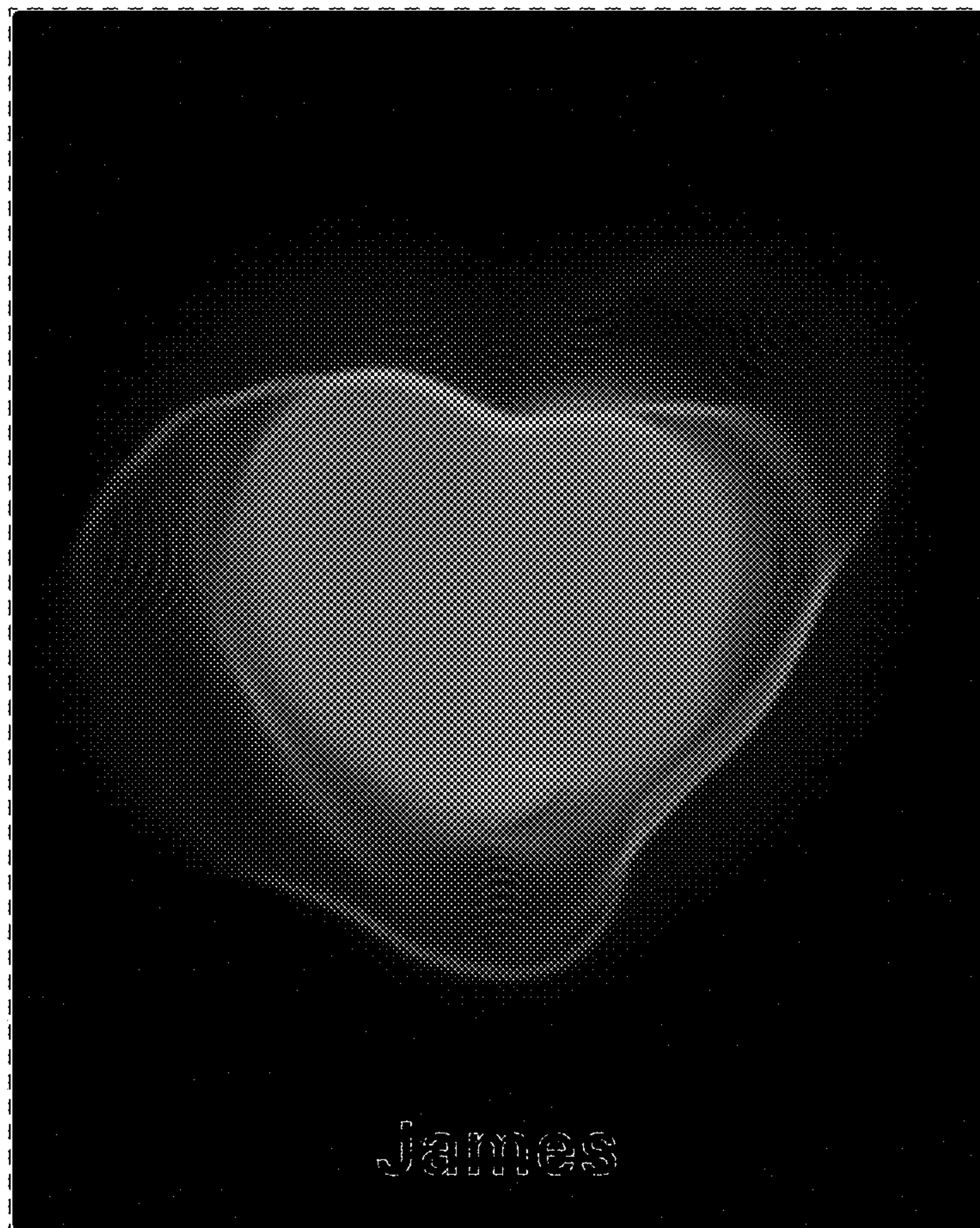

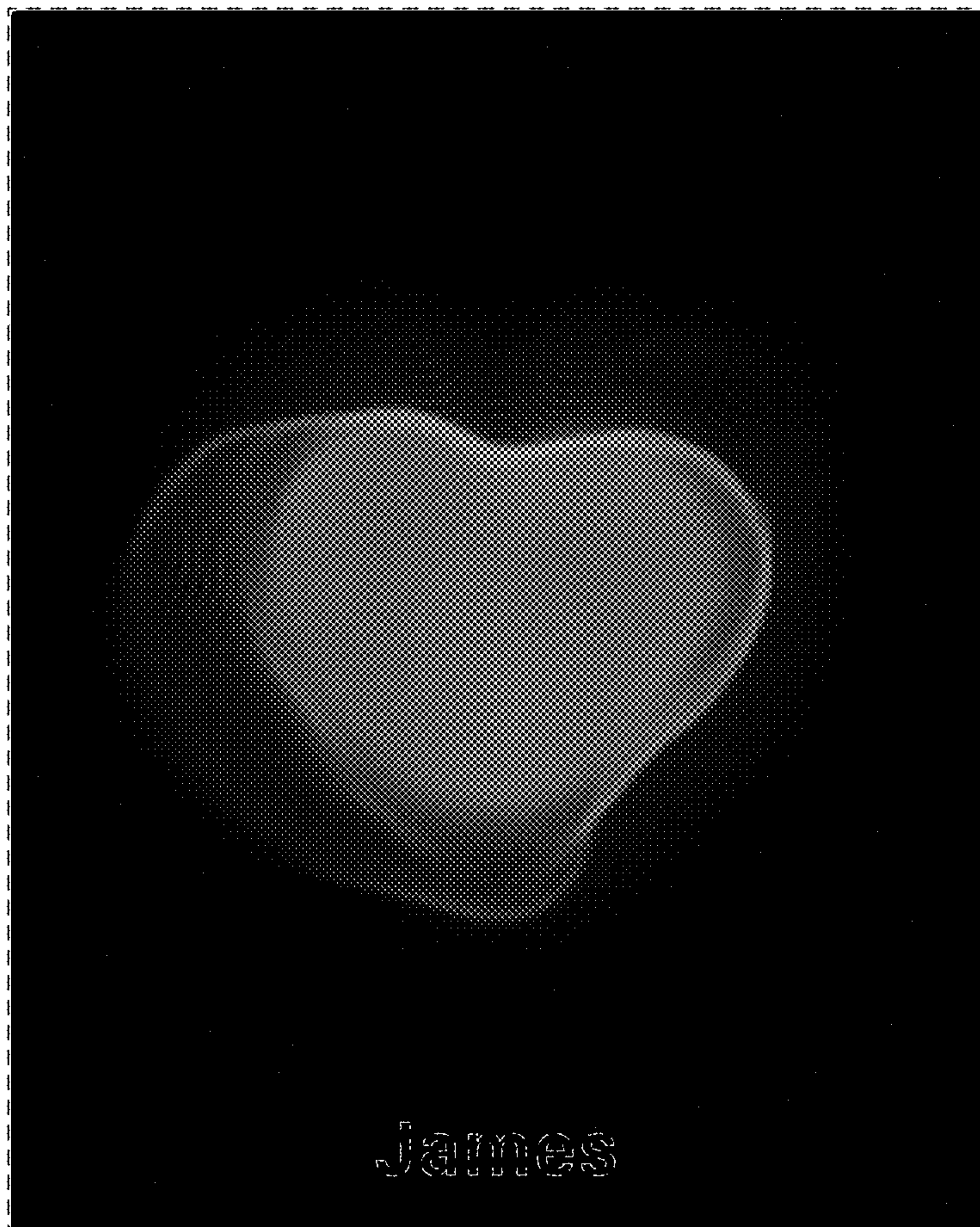
