FIG. 6 is a left side view thereof;

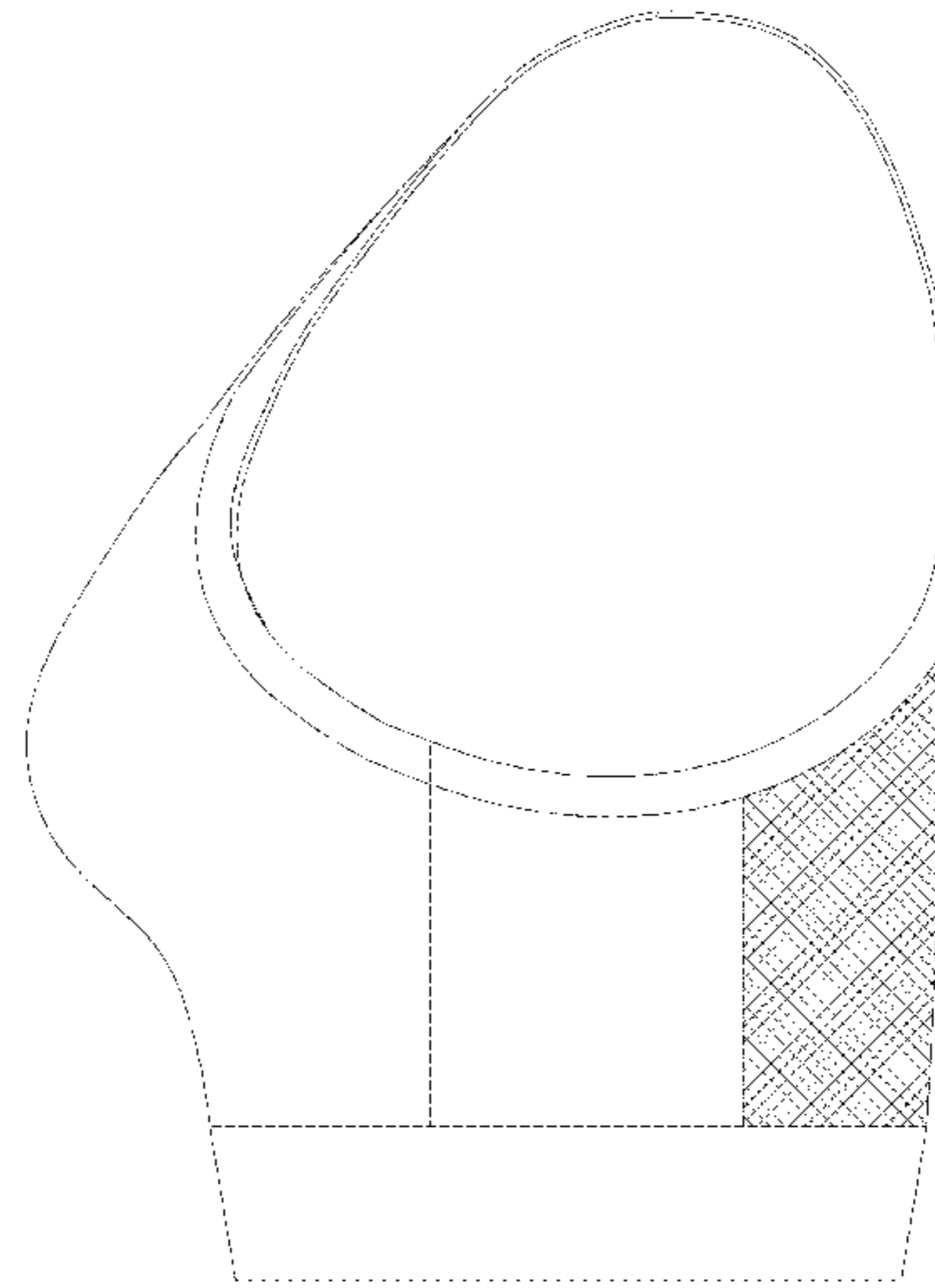
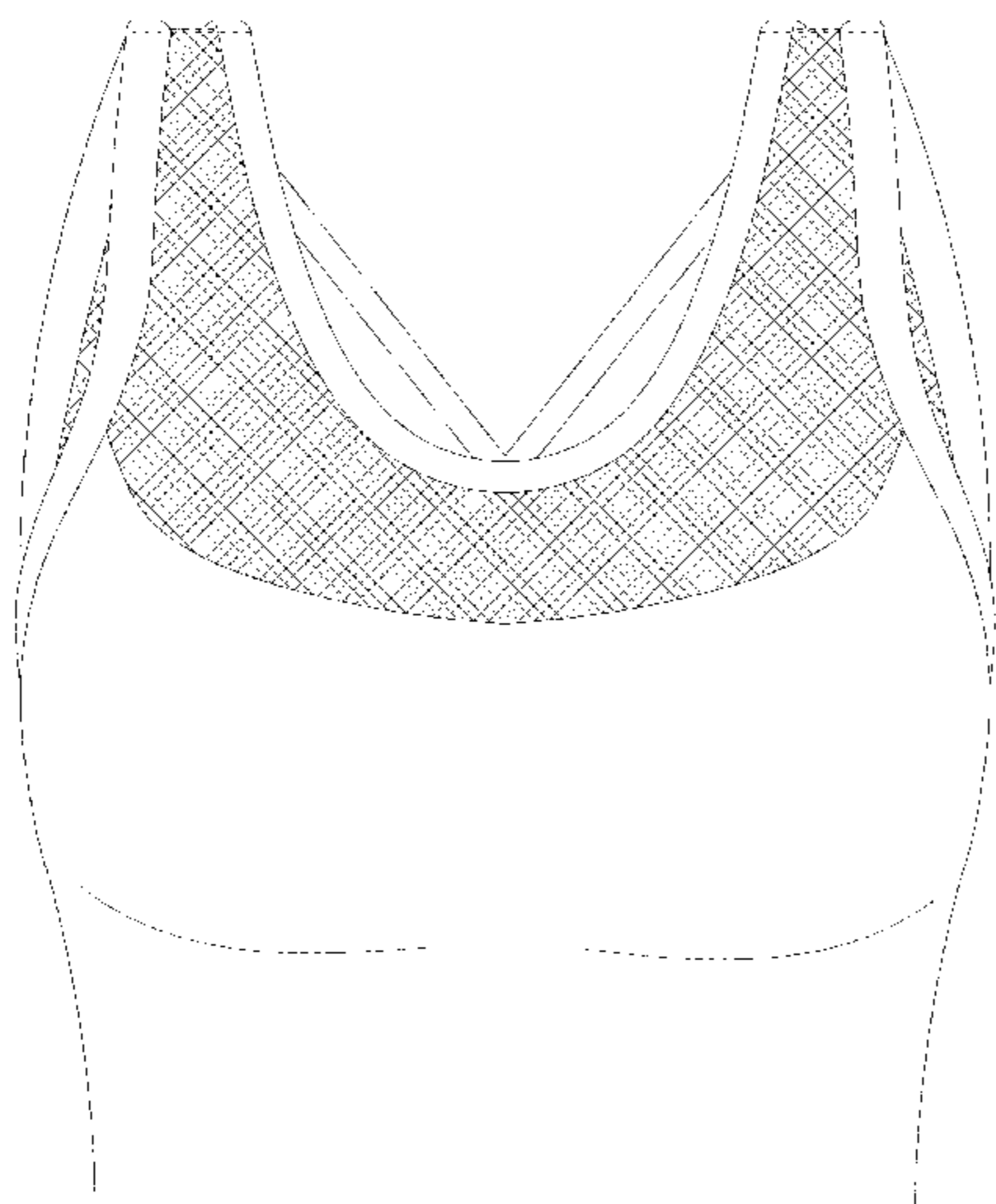
FIG. 7 is a top view thereof; and,

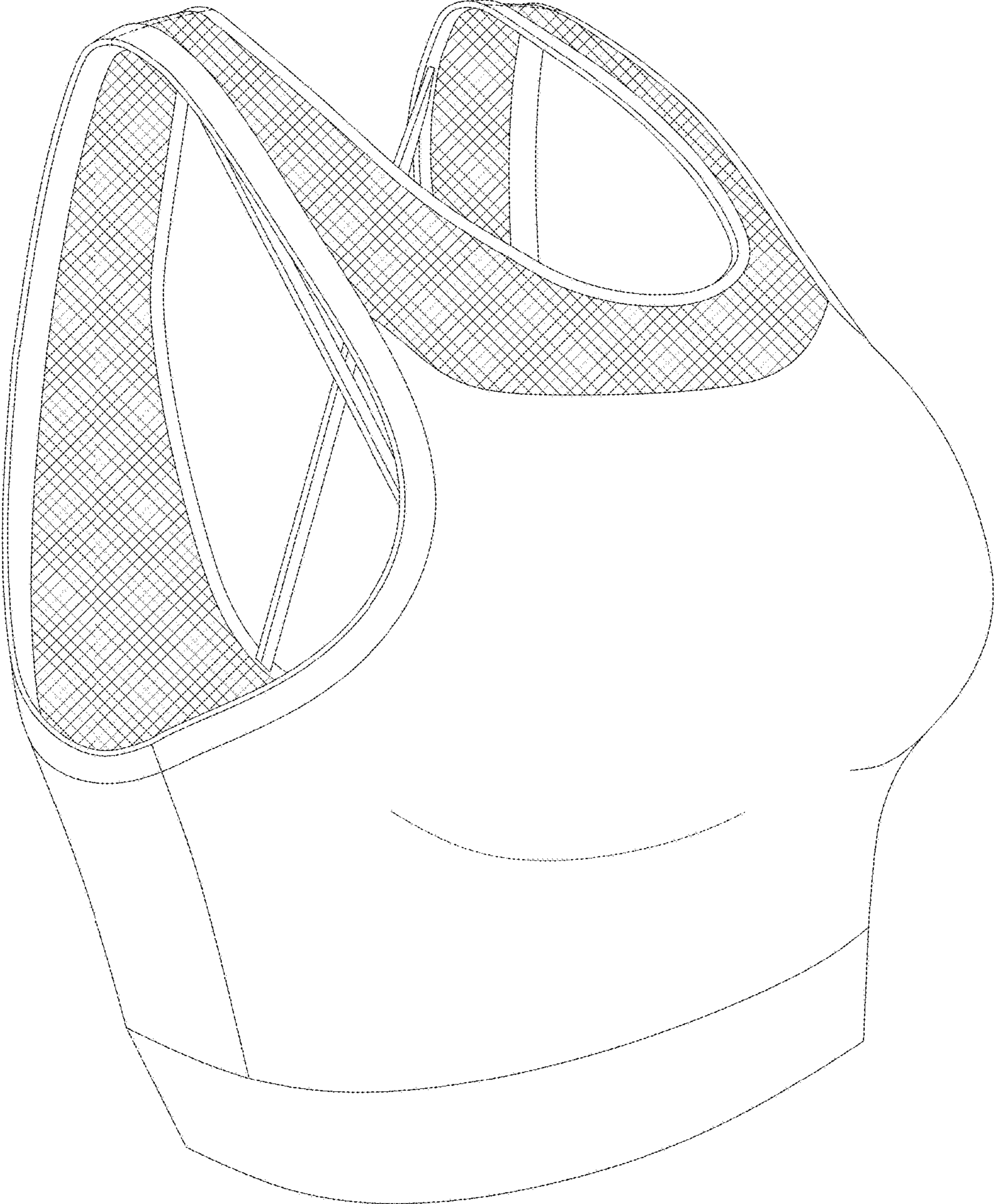

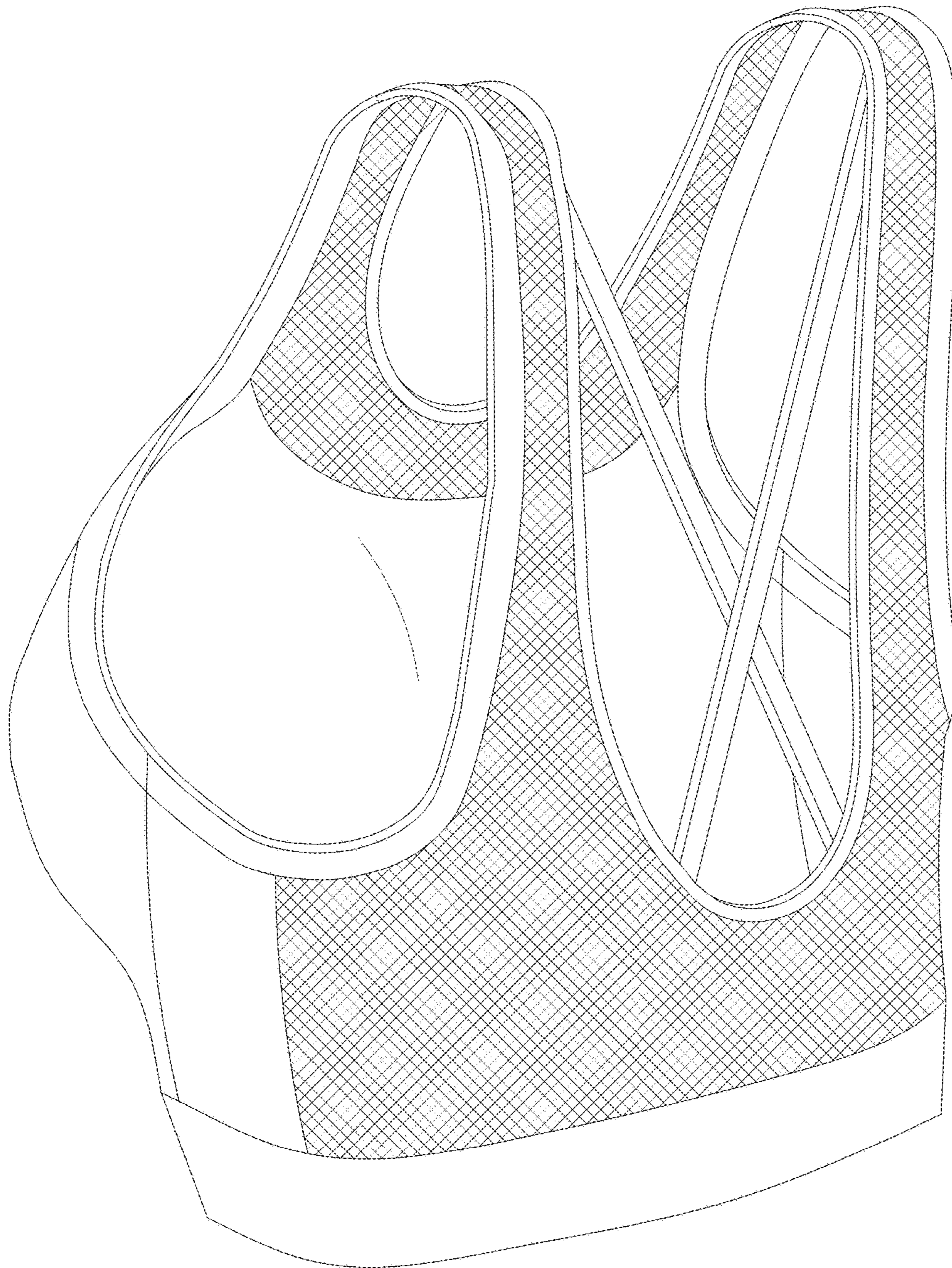

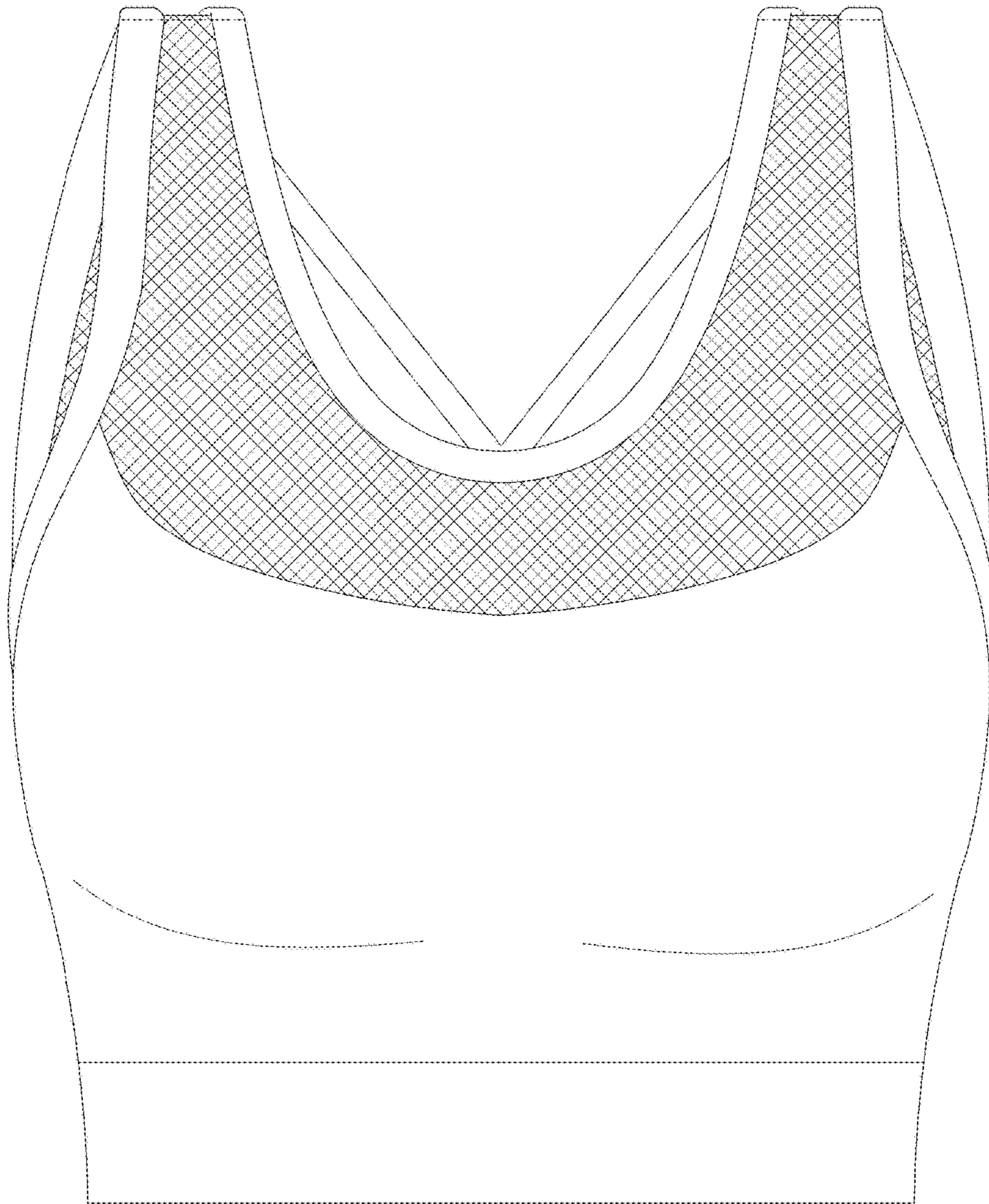

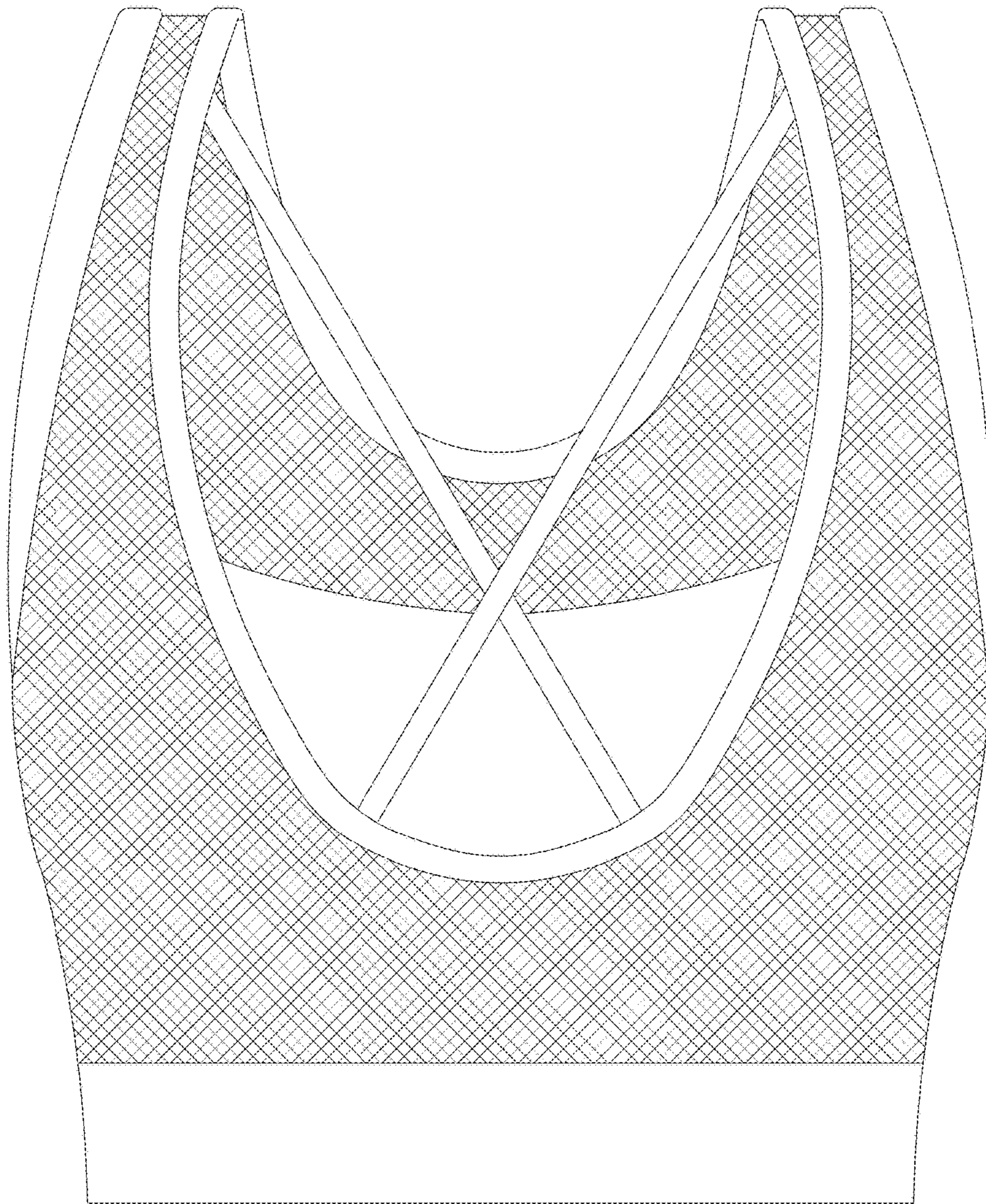

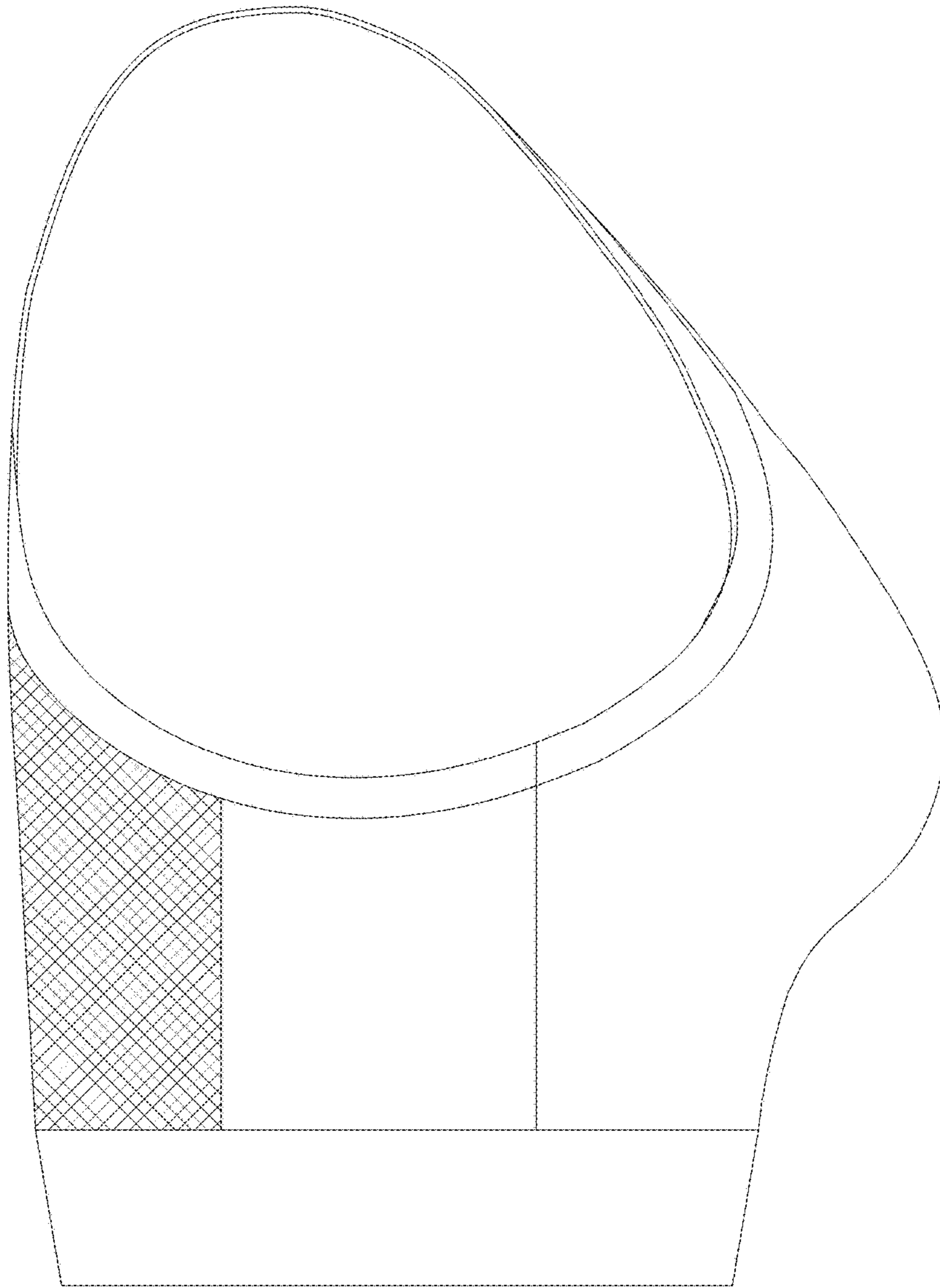

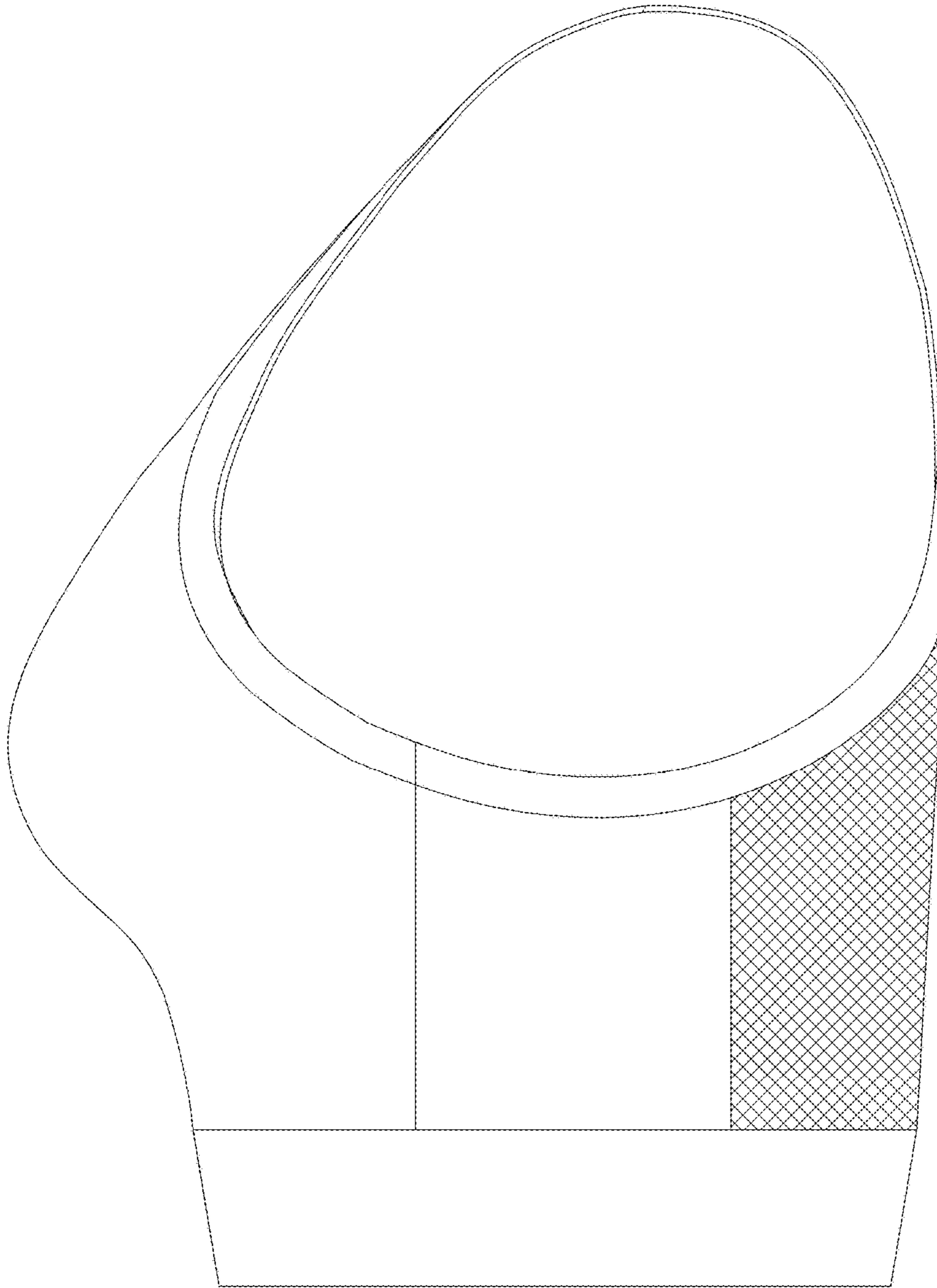

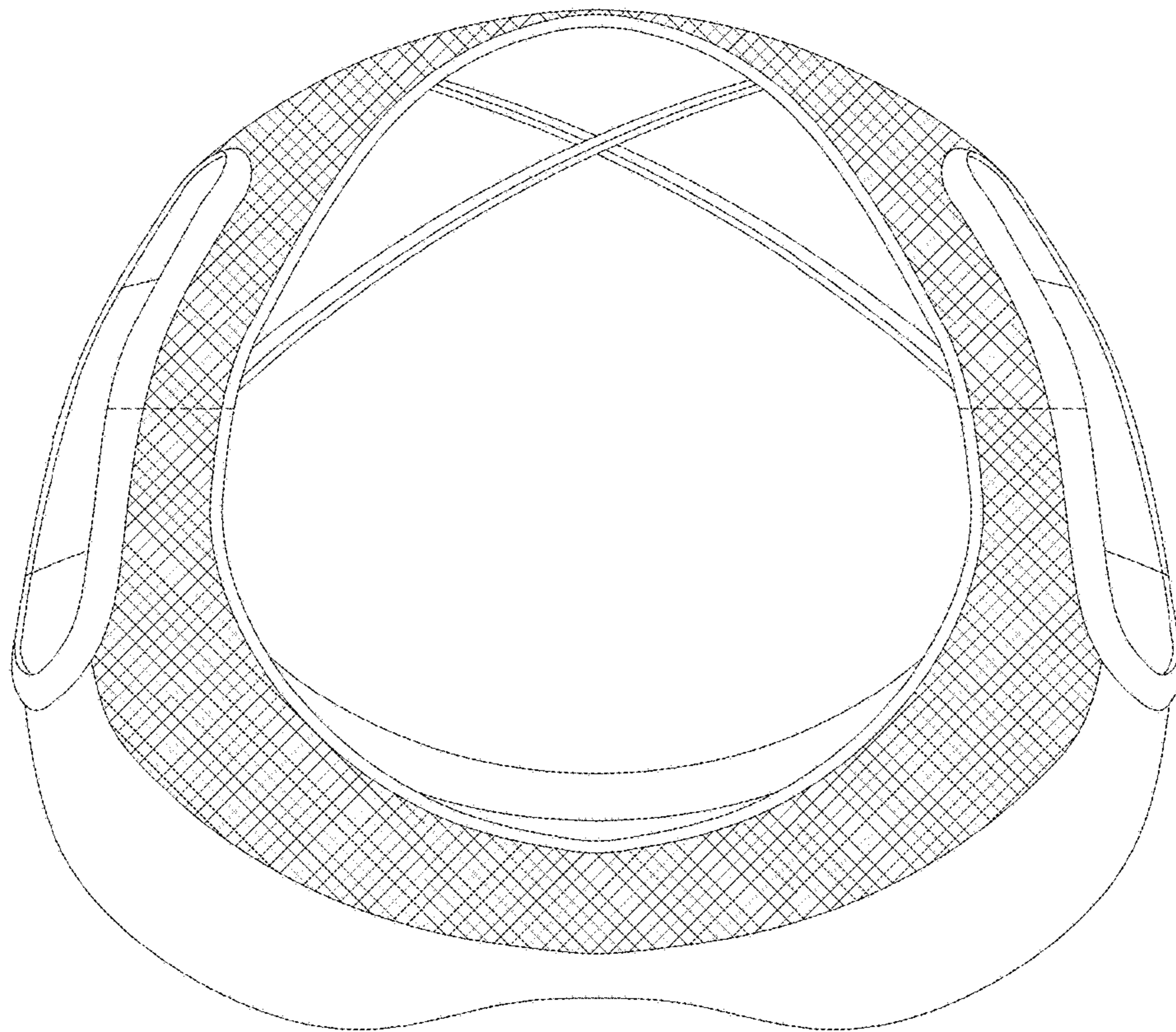

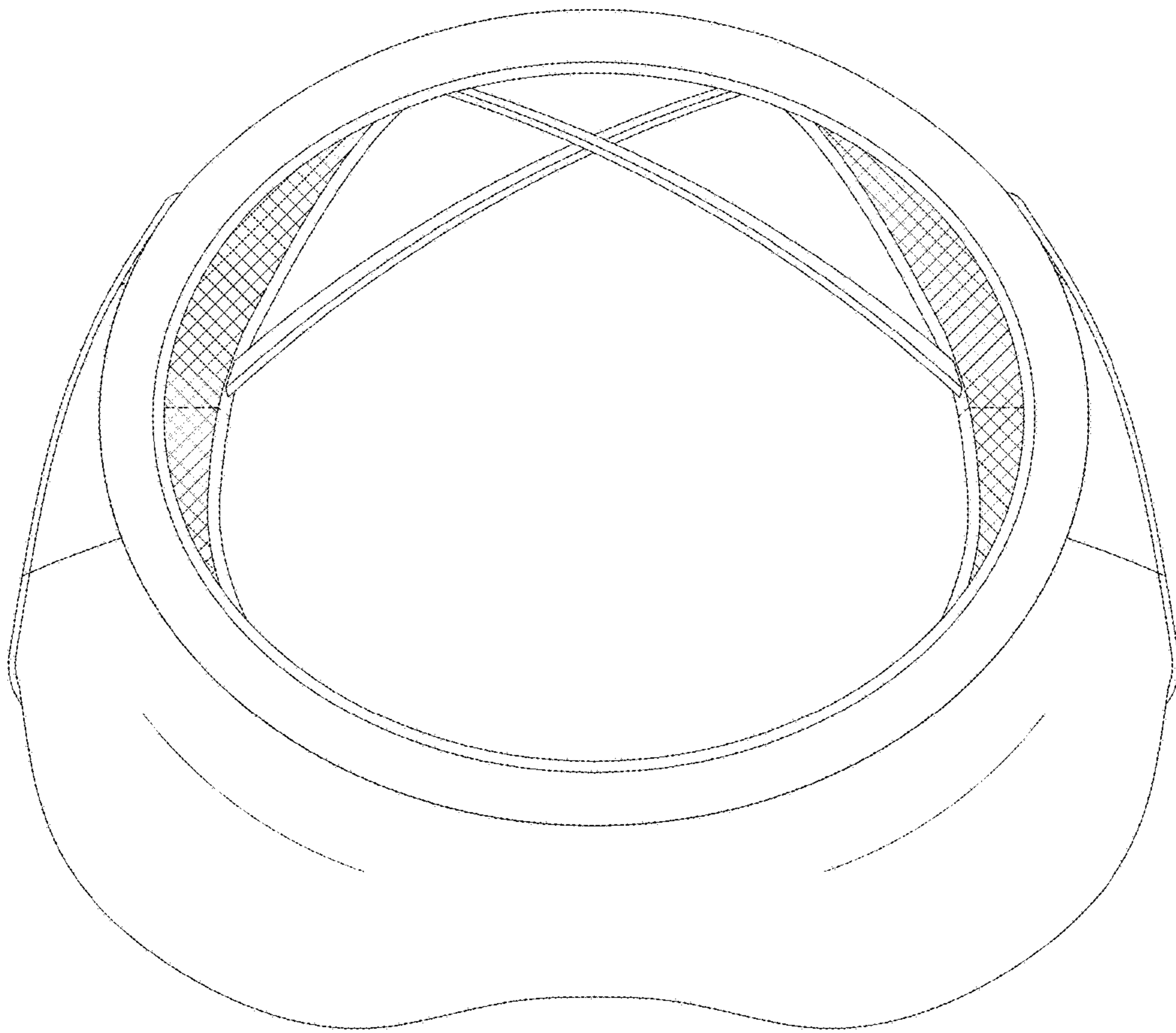
