DESCRIPTION

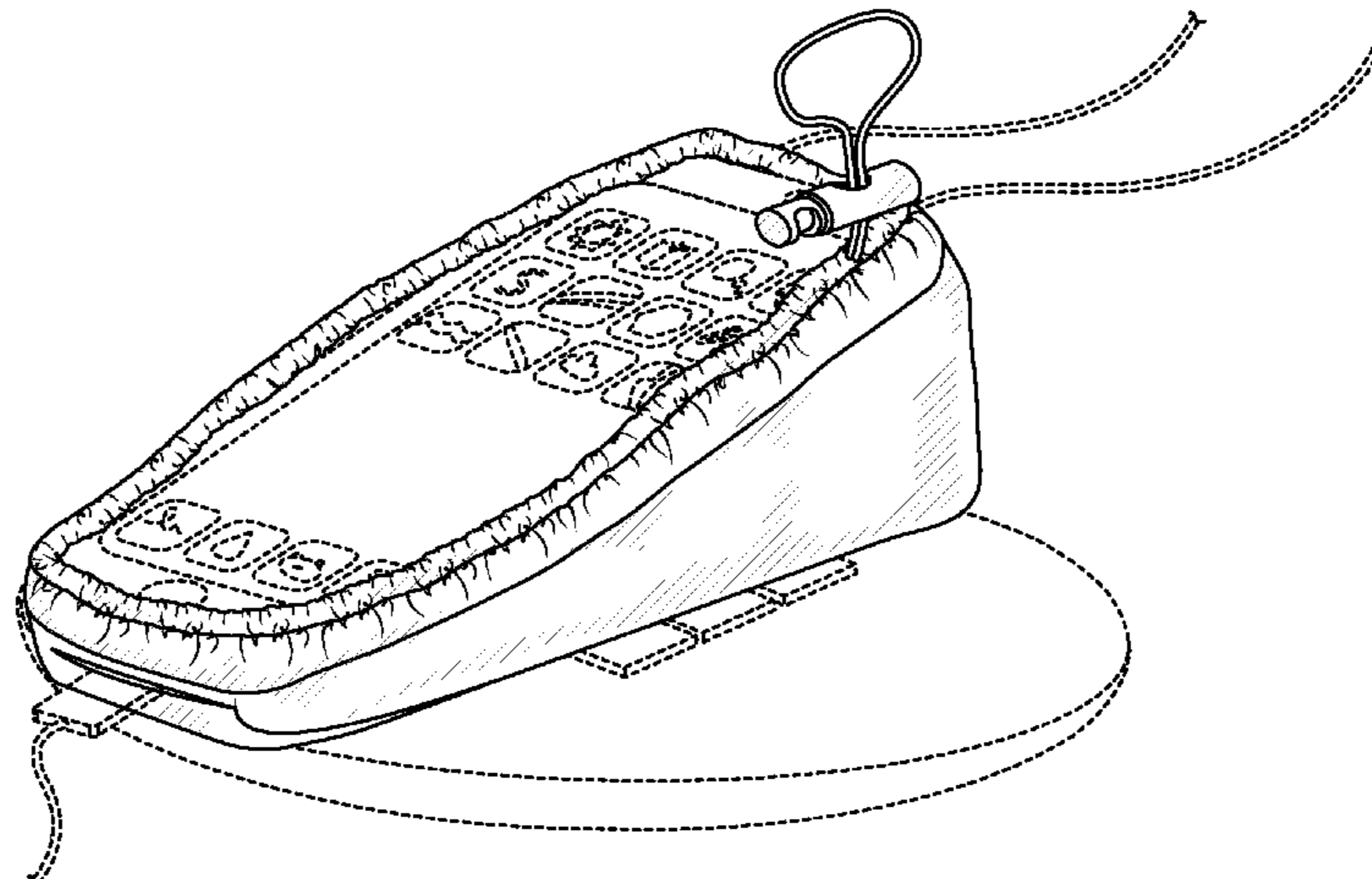
FIG. 1 is an environmental view of the mobile device holder;

The mobile device holder features a unique appearance over
prior art, including an angled base and a cinch.

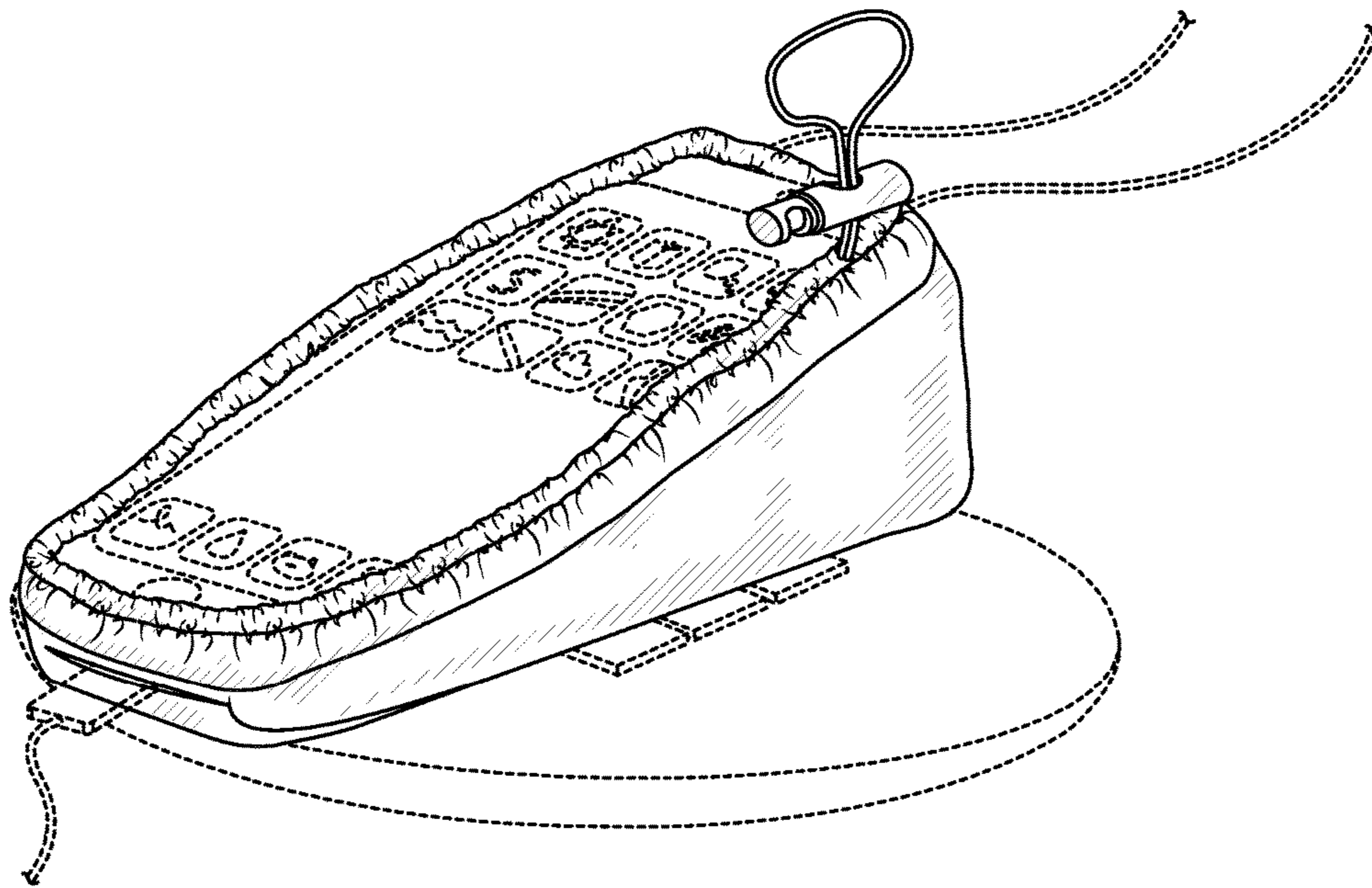

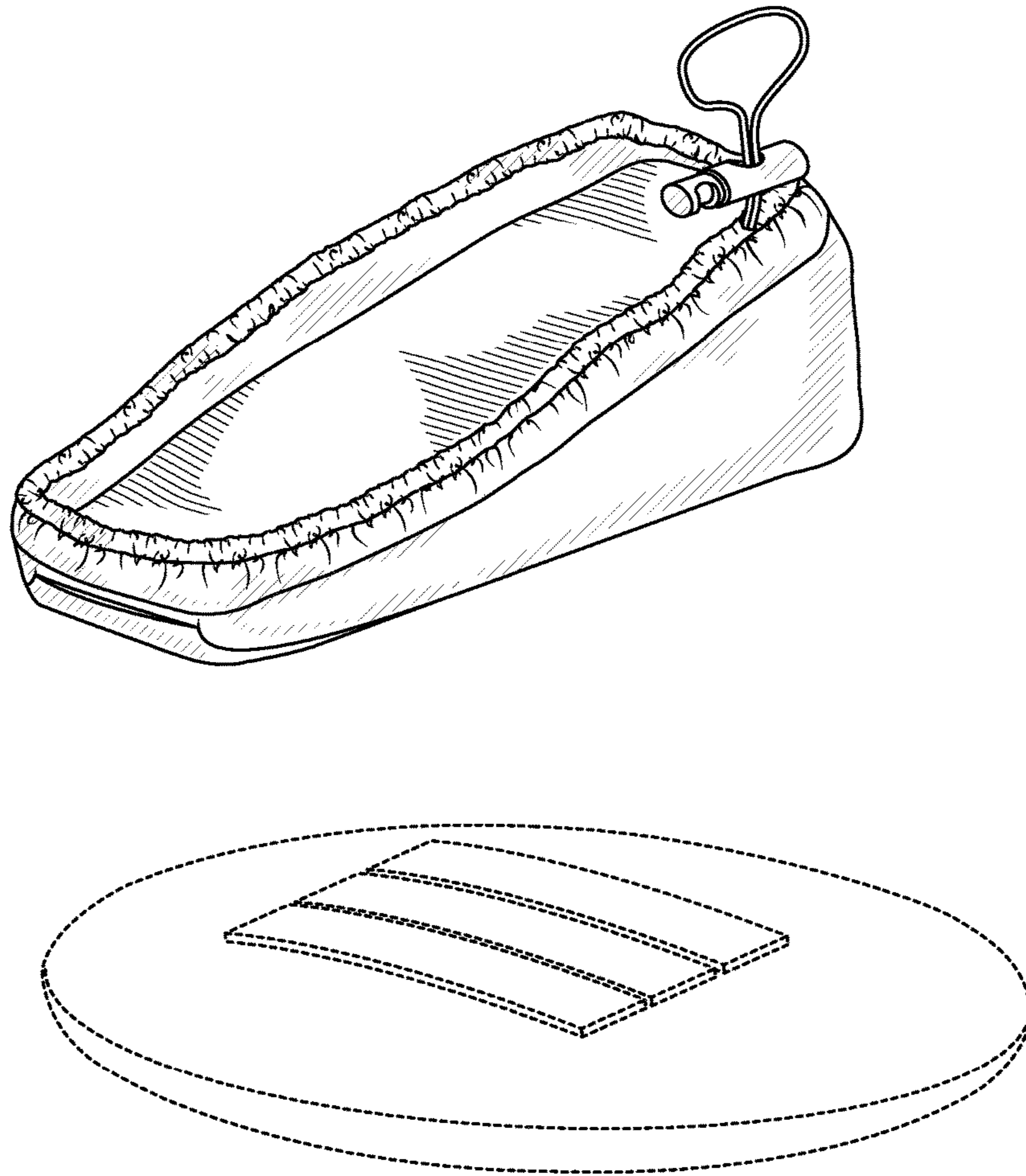

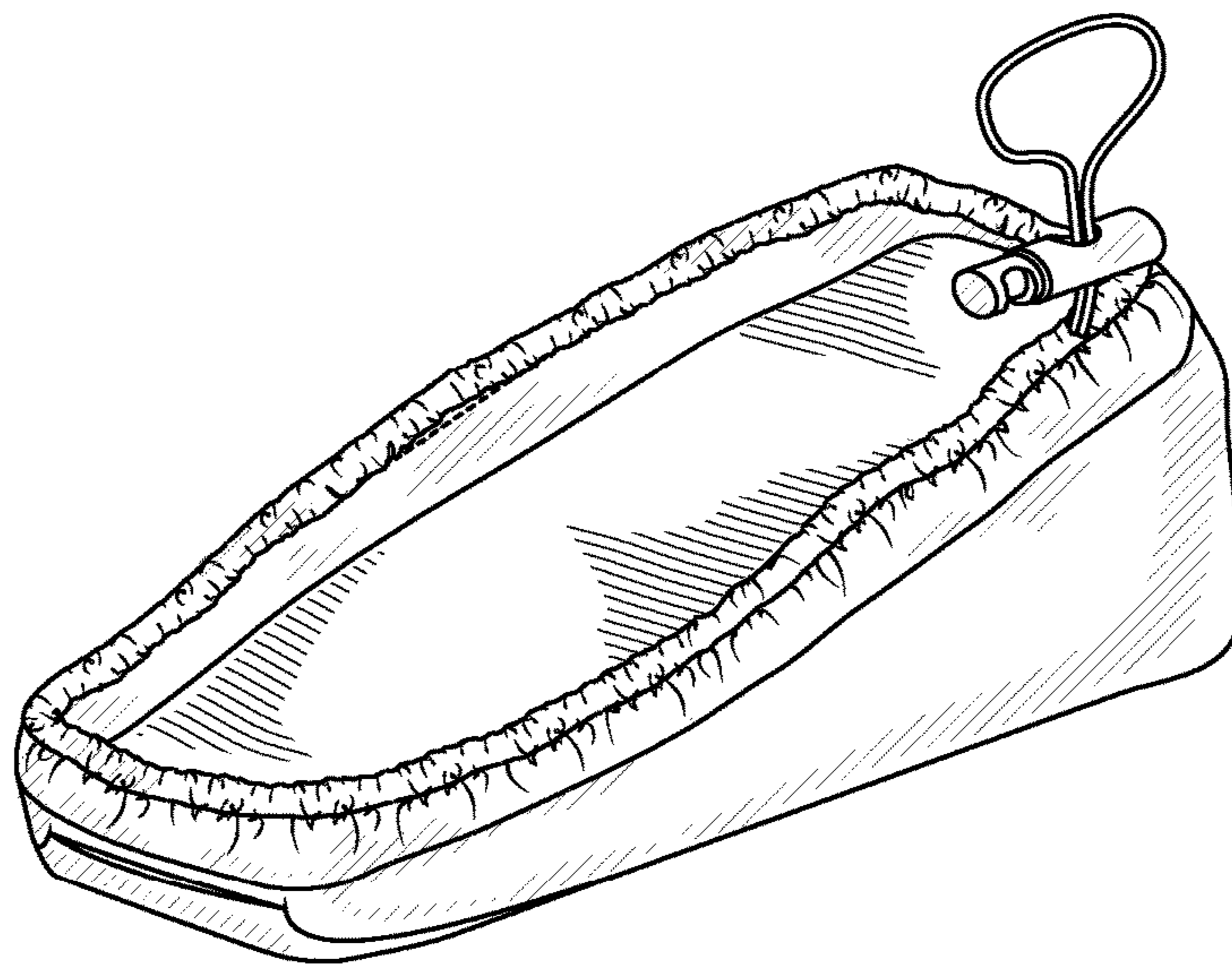

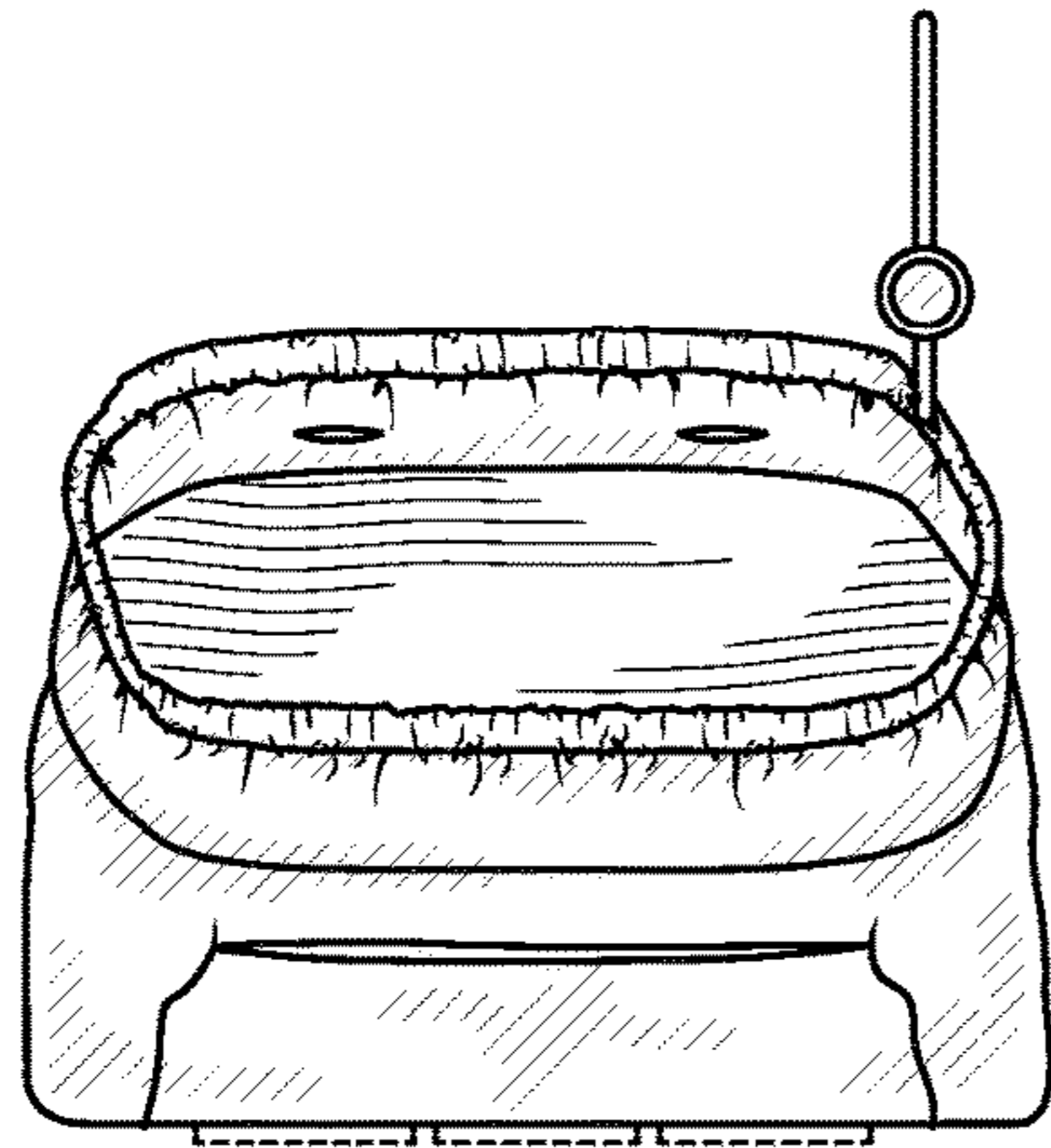

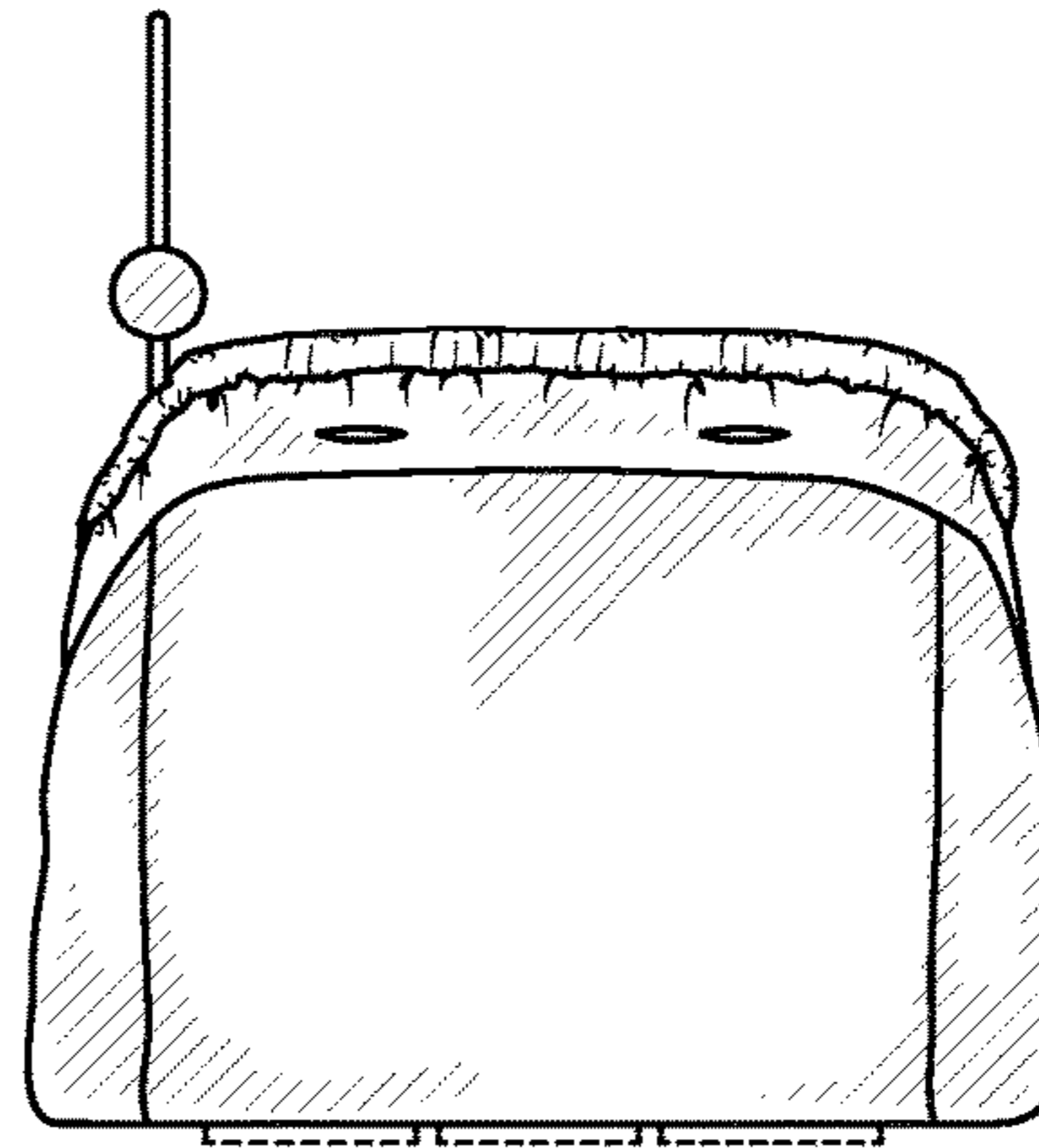

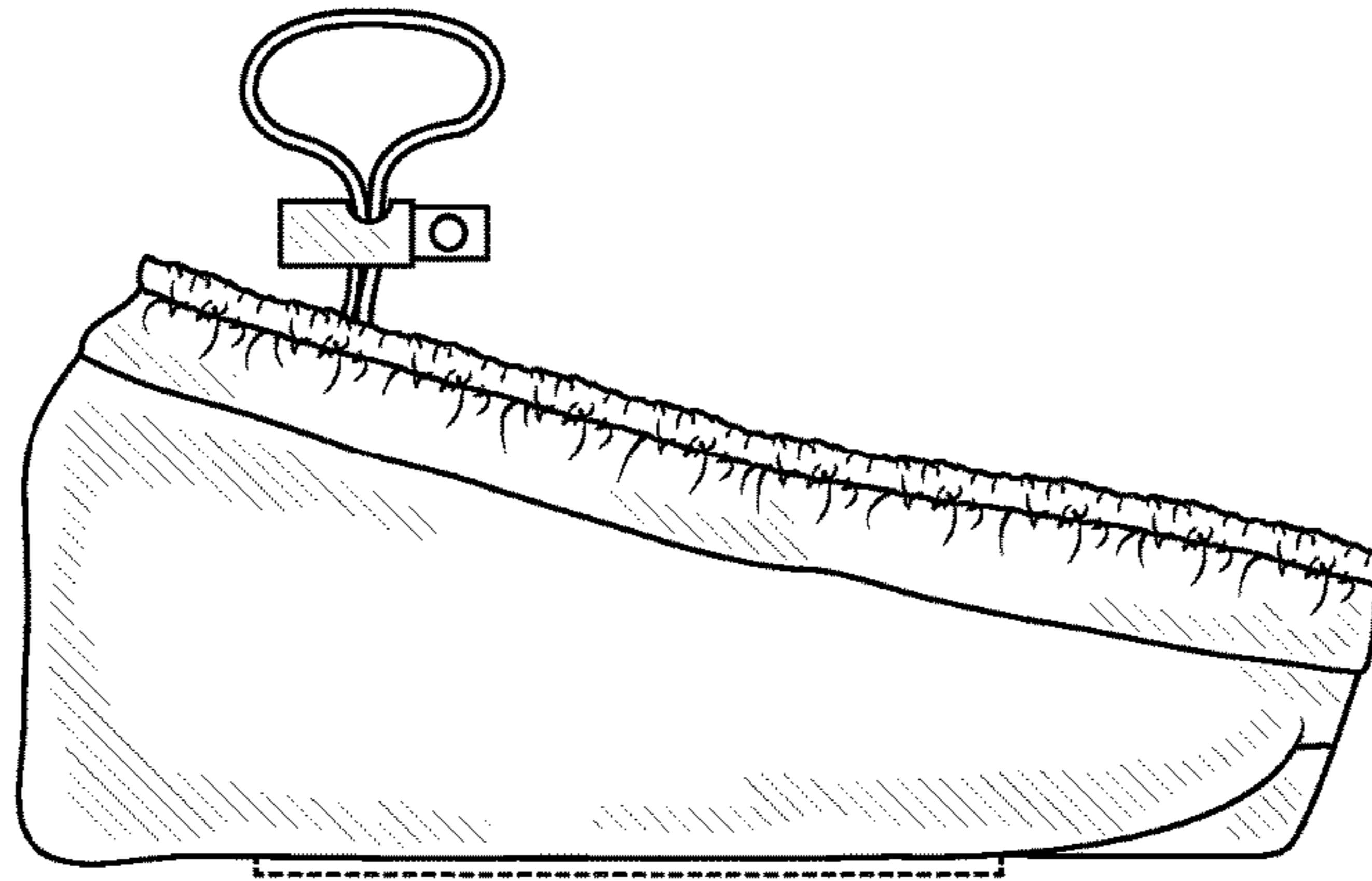

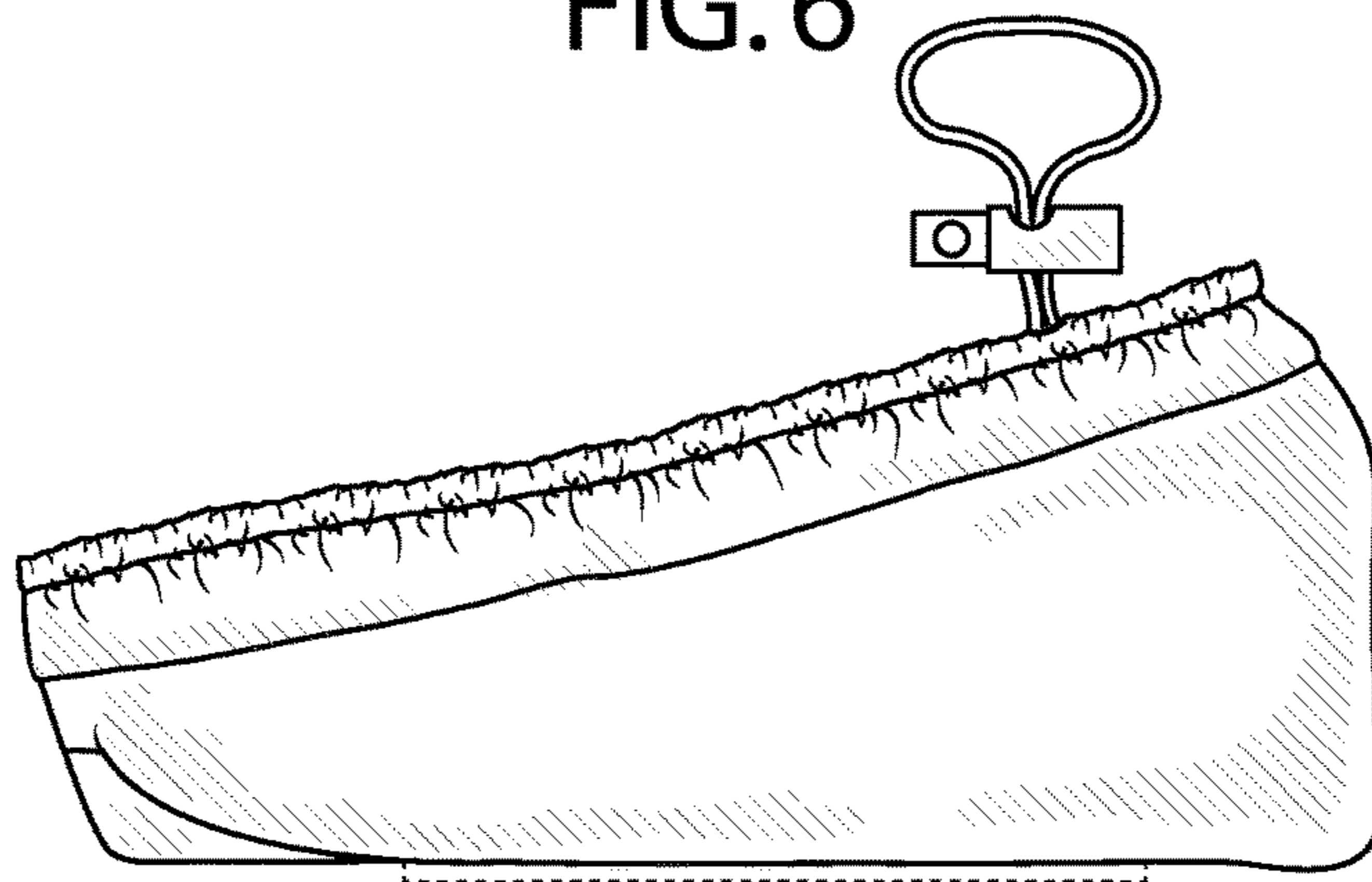

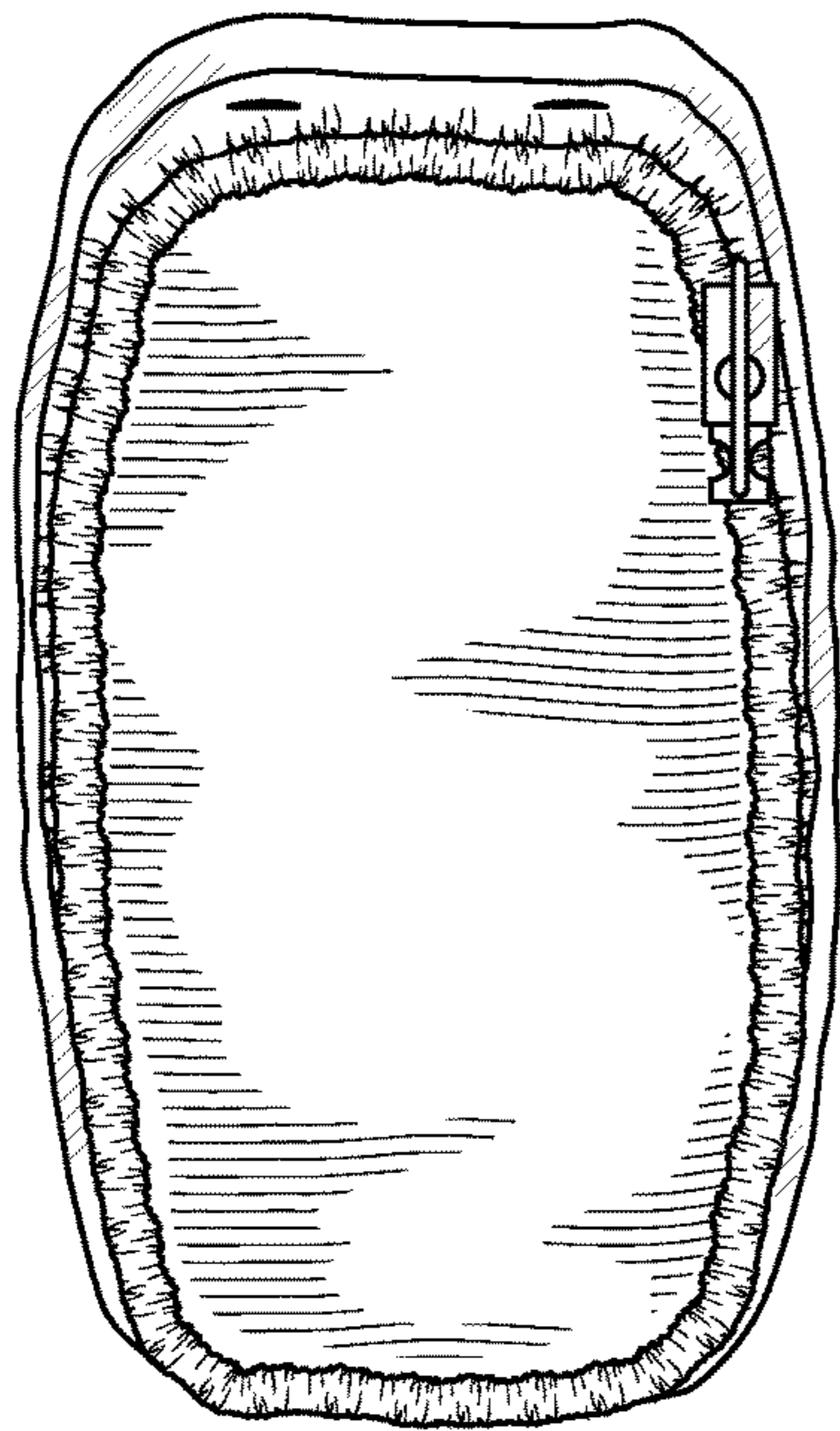

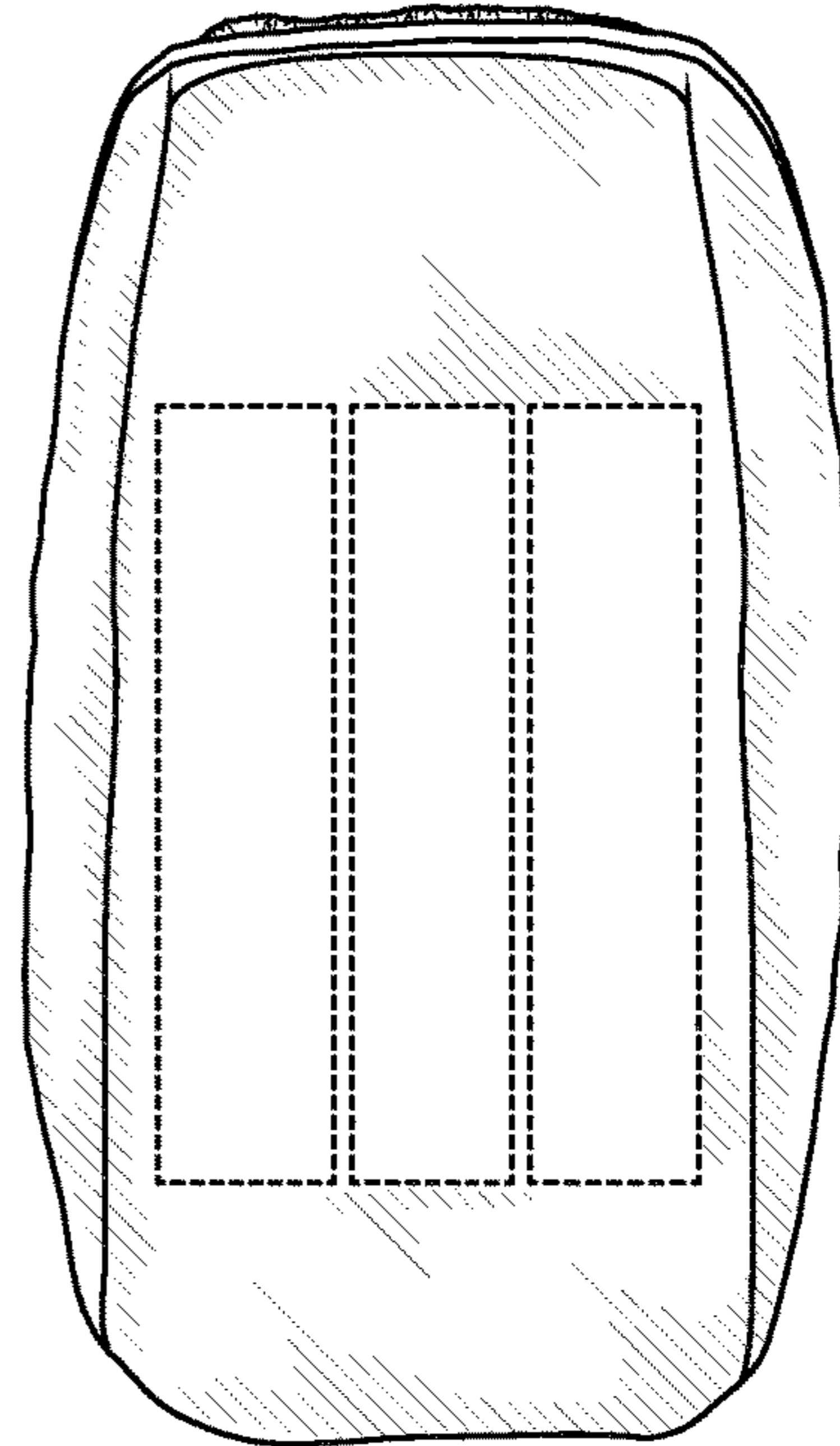
