The ornamental design for a magazine floor plate, as shown and described.

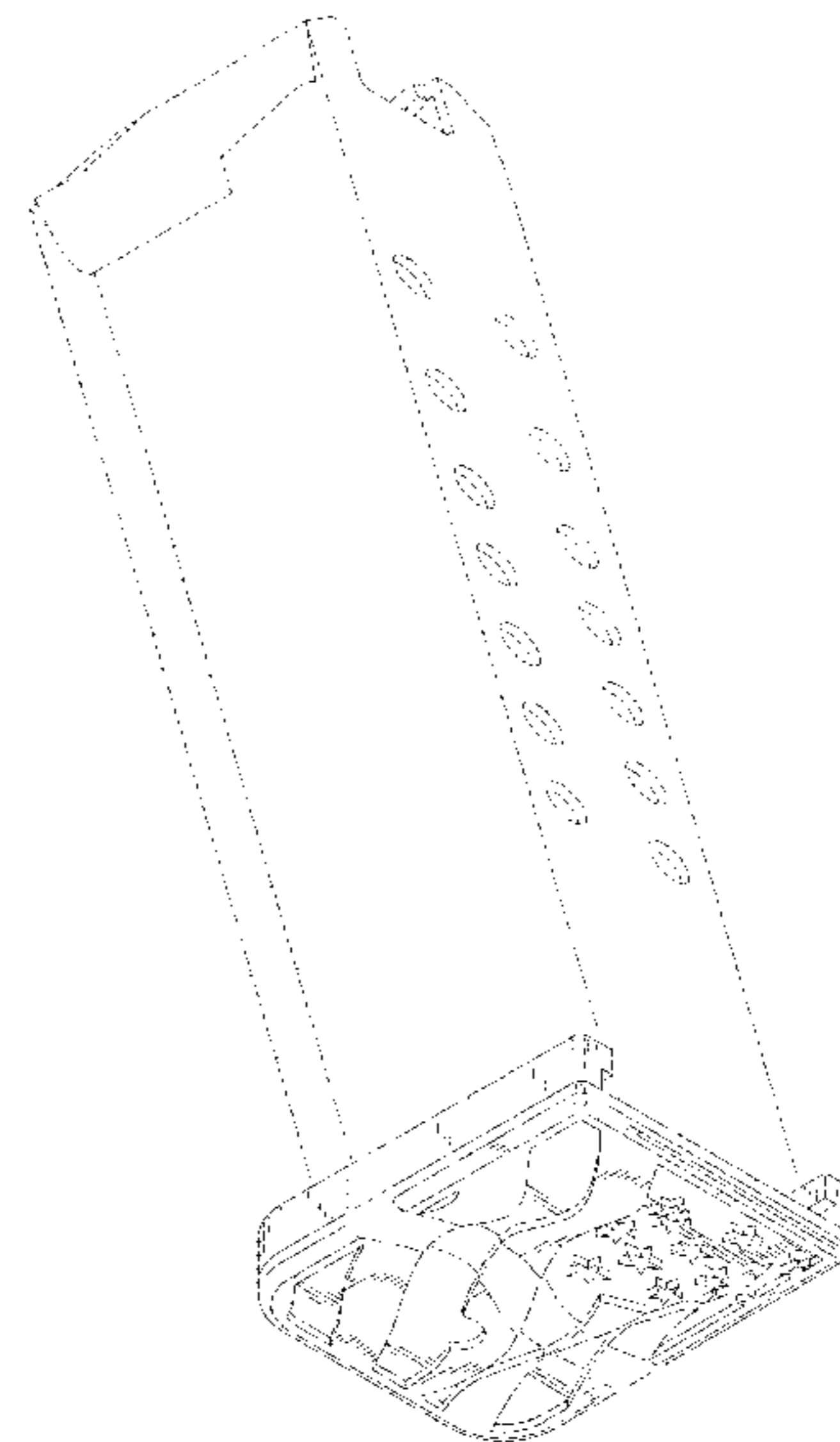
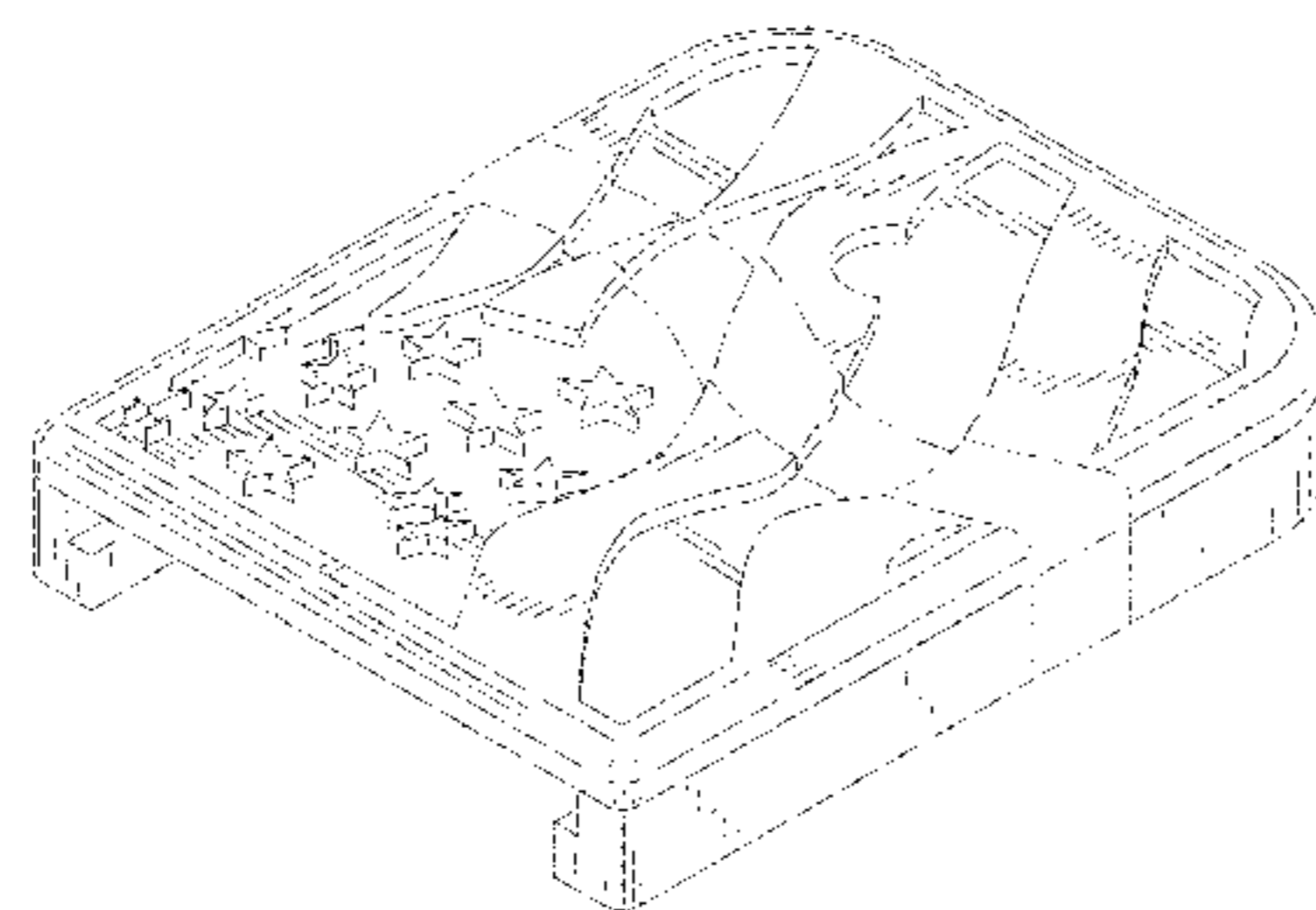
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the magazine floor plate showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; the left side being a mirror image thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a perspective view shown in use.

The broken lines shown in the drawings illustrate portions of the magazine floor plate that form no part of the claimed design.

The magazine floor plate is shown with a symbolic break in its length. The appearance of any portion of the article between the break lines forms no part of the claimed design. The broken lines in FIG. 7 showing the magazine floor plate in use illustrates environment and forms no part of the claim.

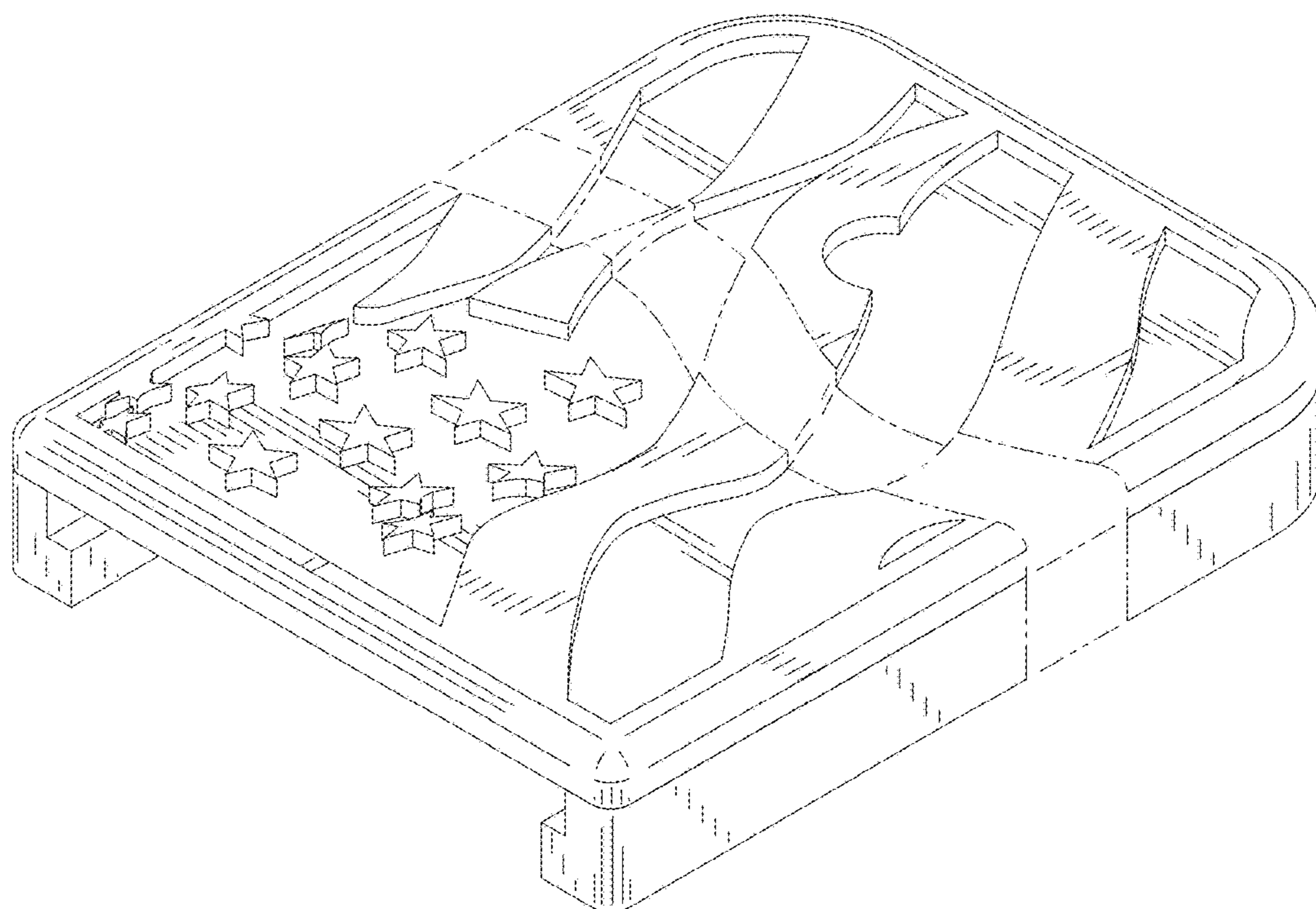

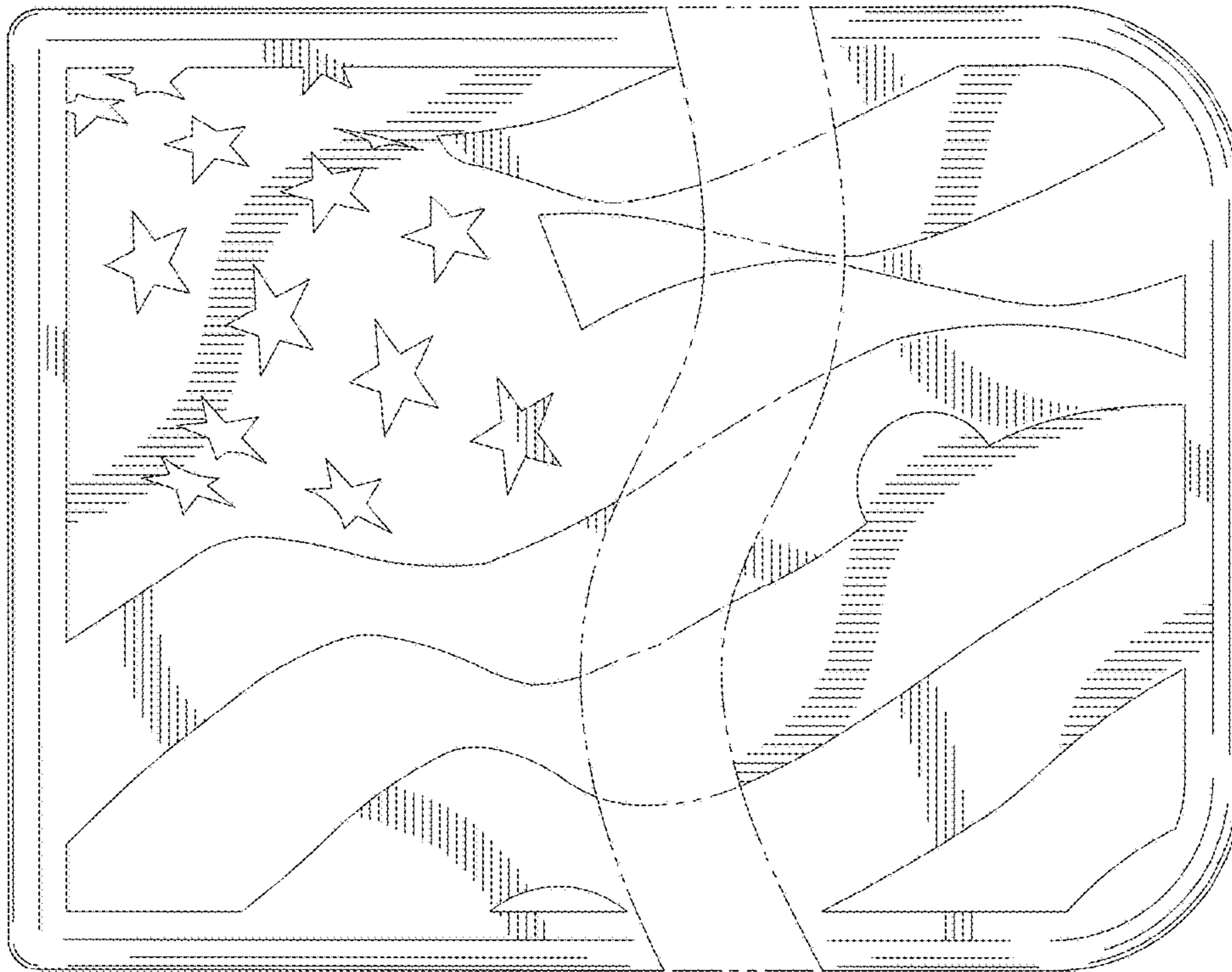

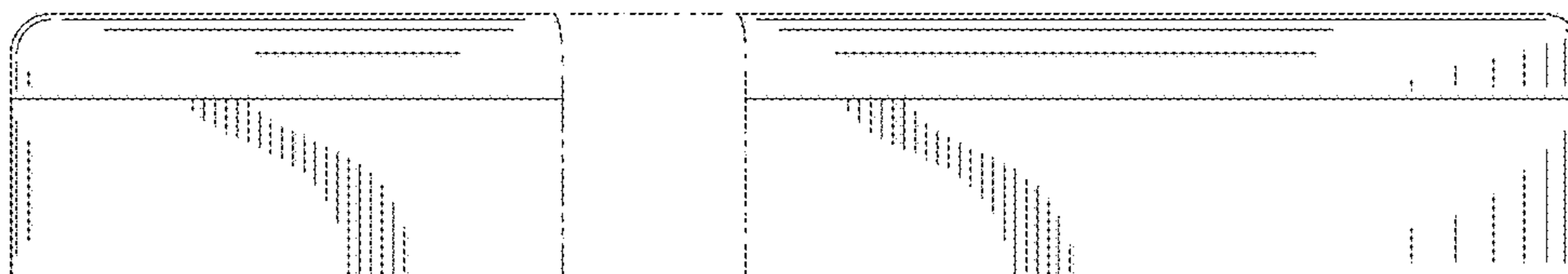

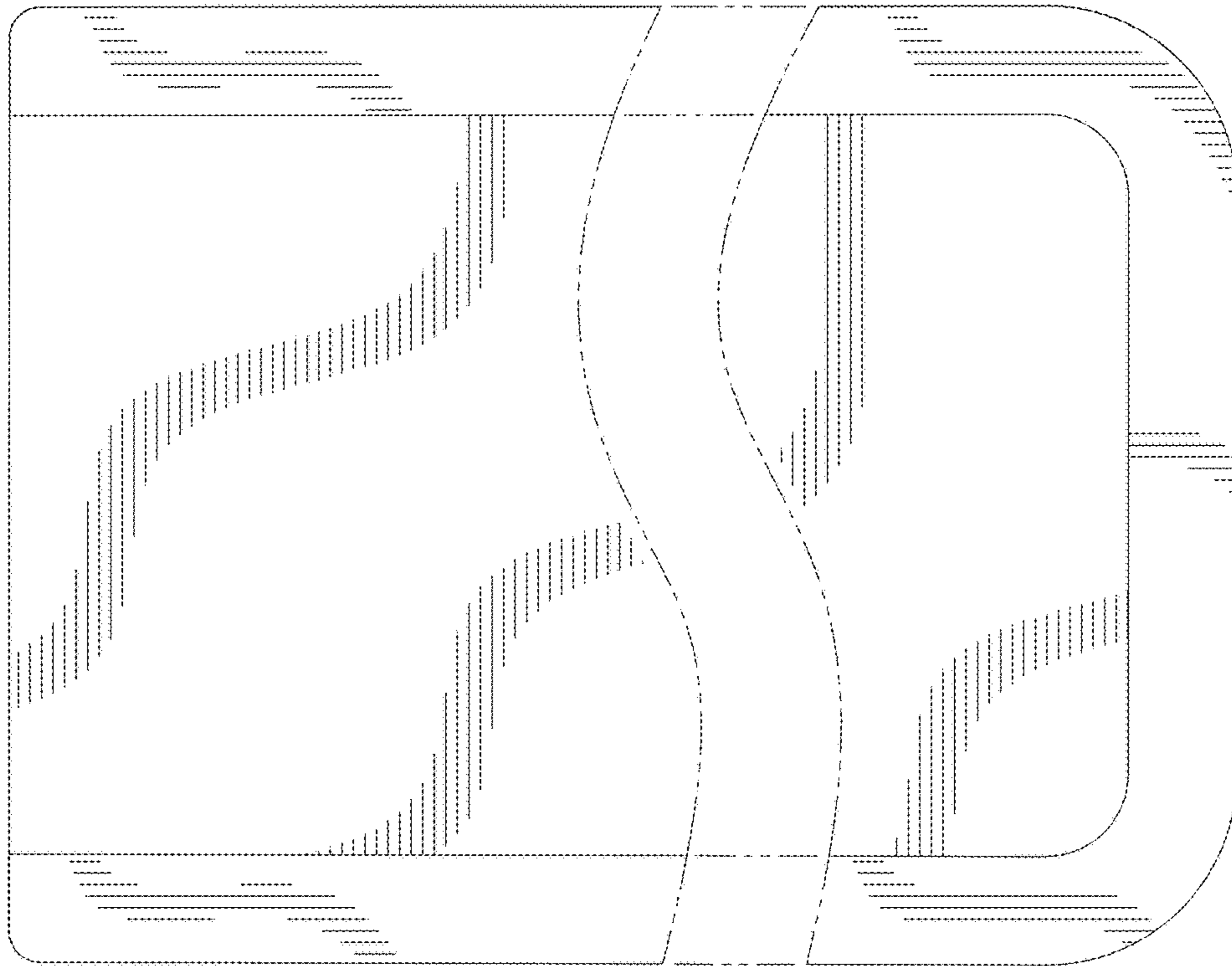

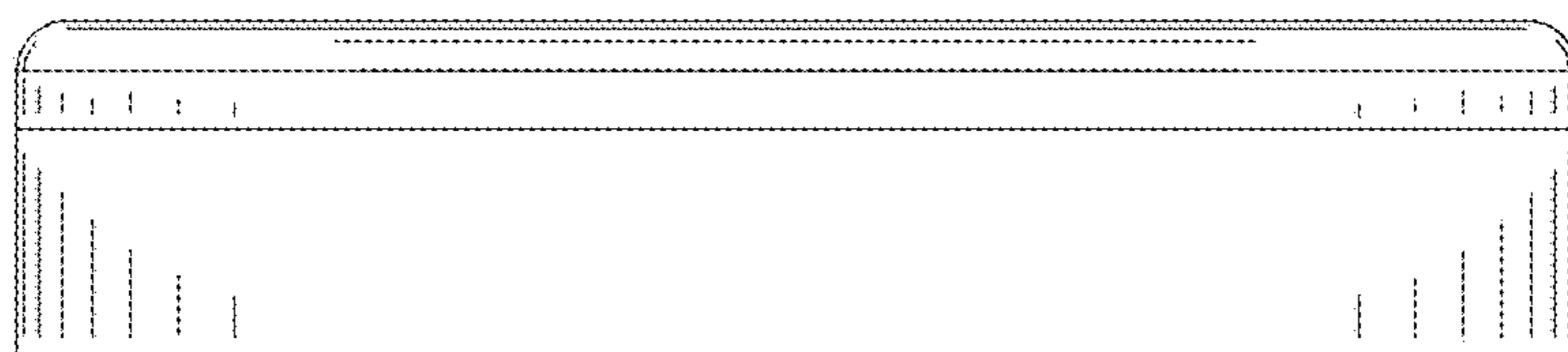

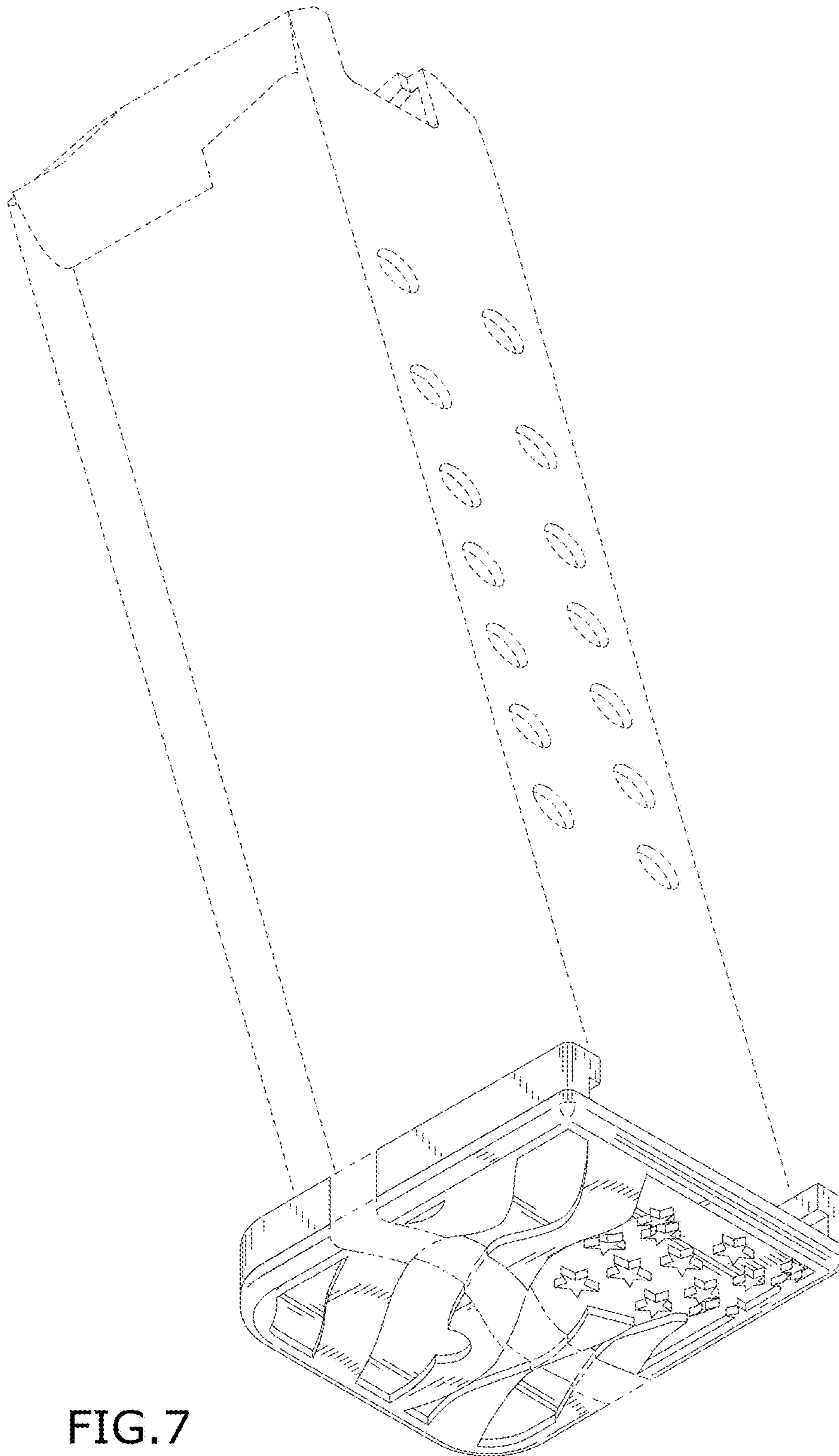
