We claim the ornamental design for an upright vacuum cleaner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of an upright vacuum cleaner showing the new design;

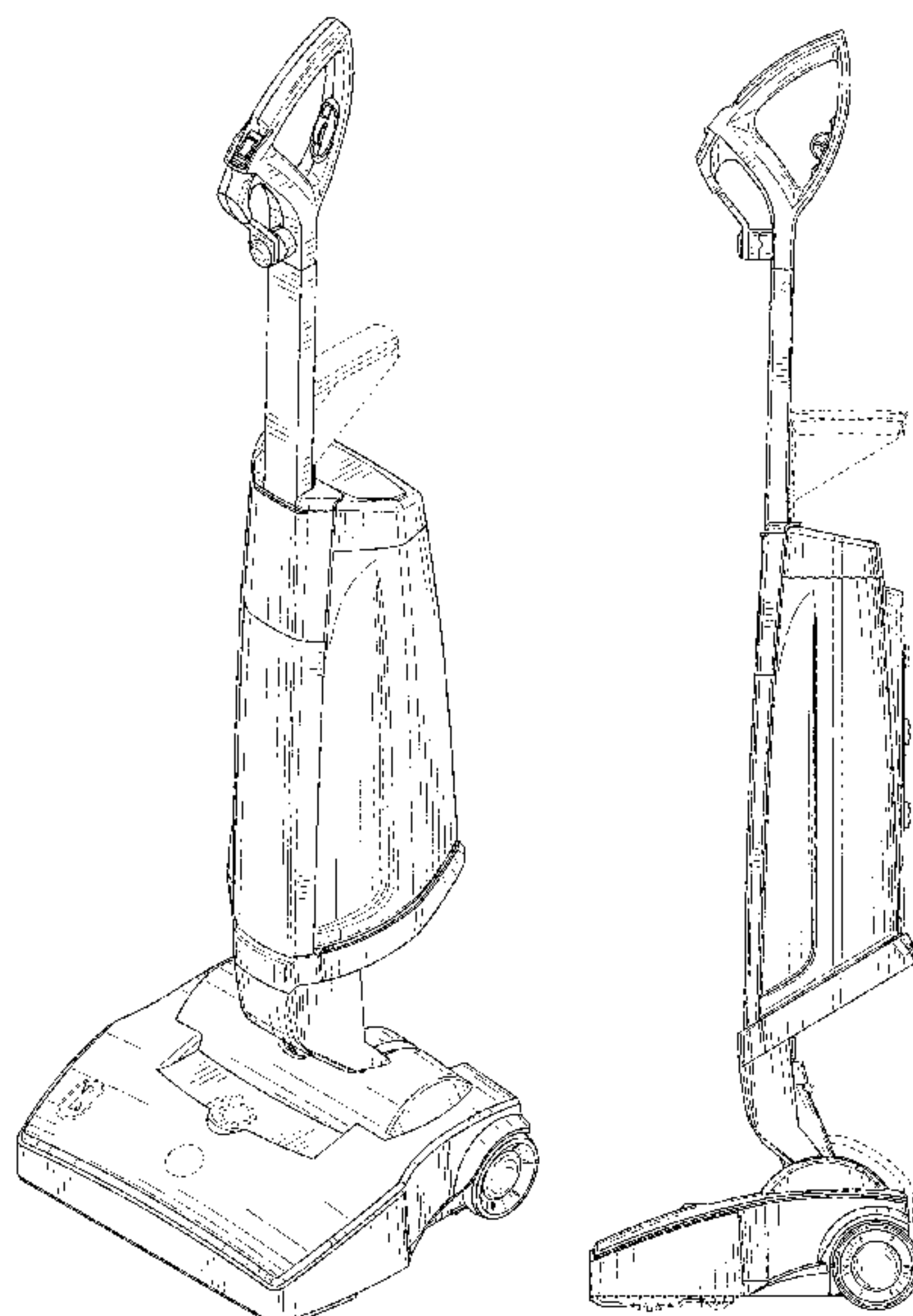
FIG. 8 is a rear view thereof.

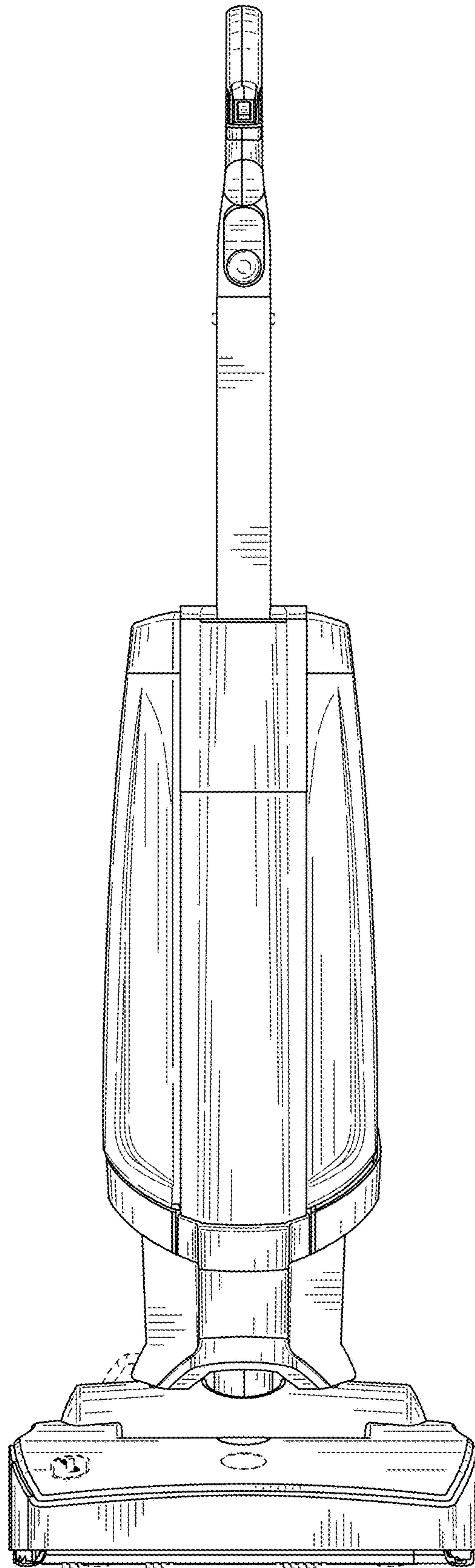

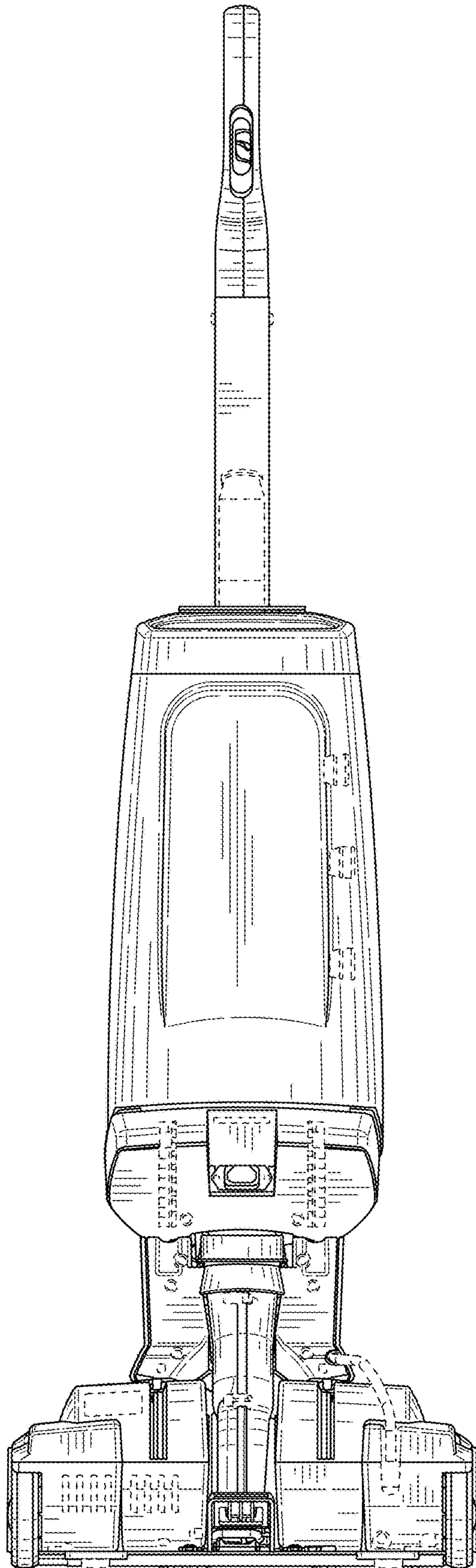

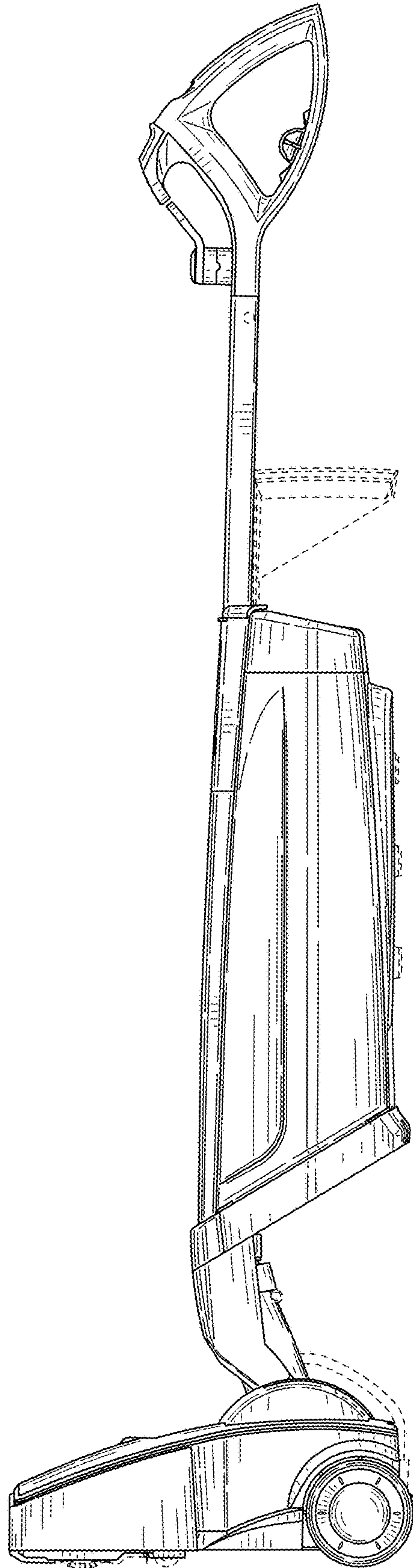

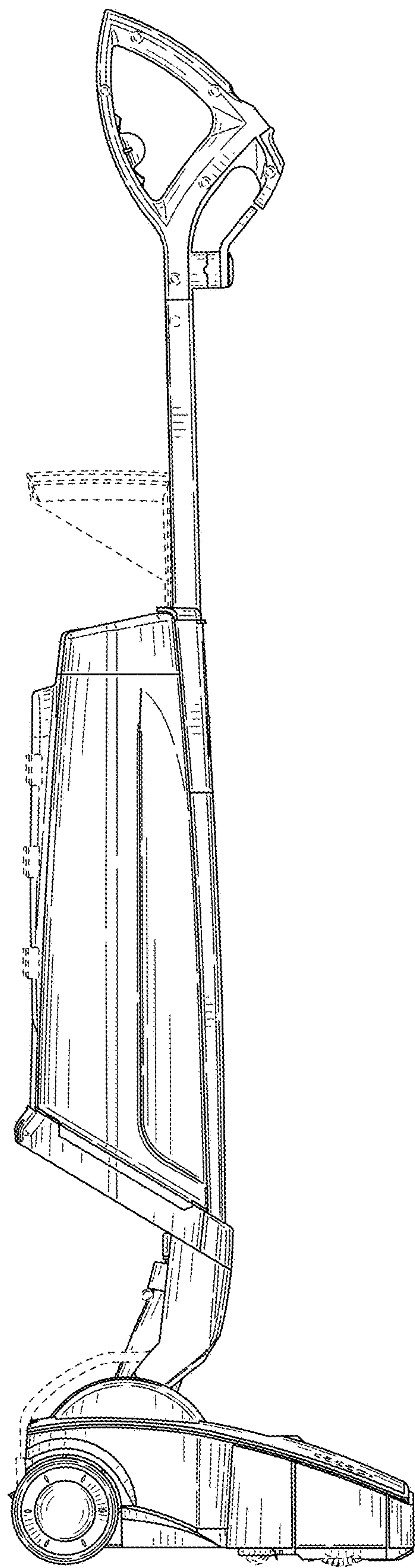

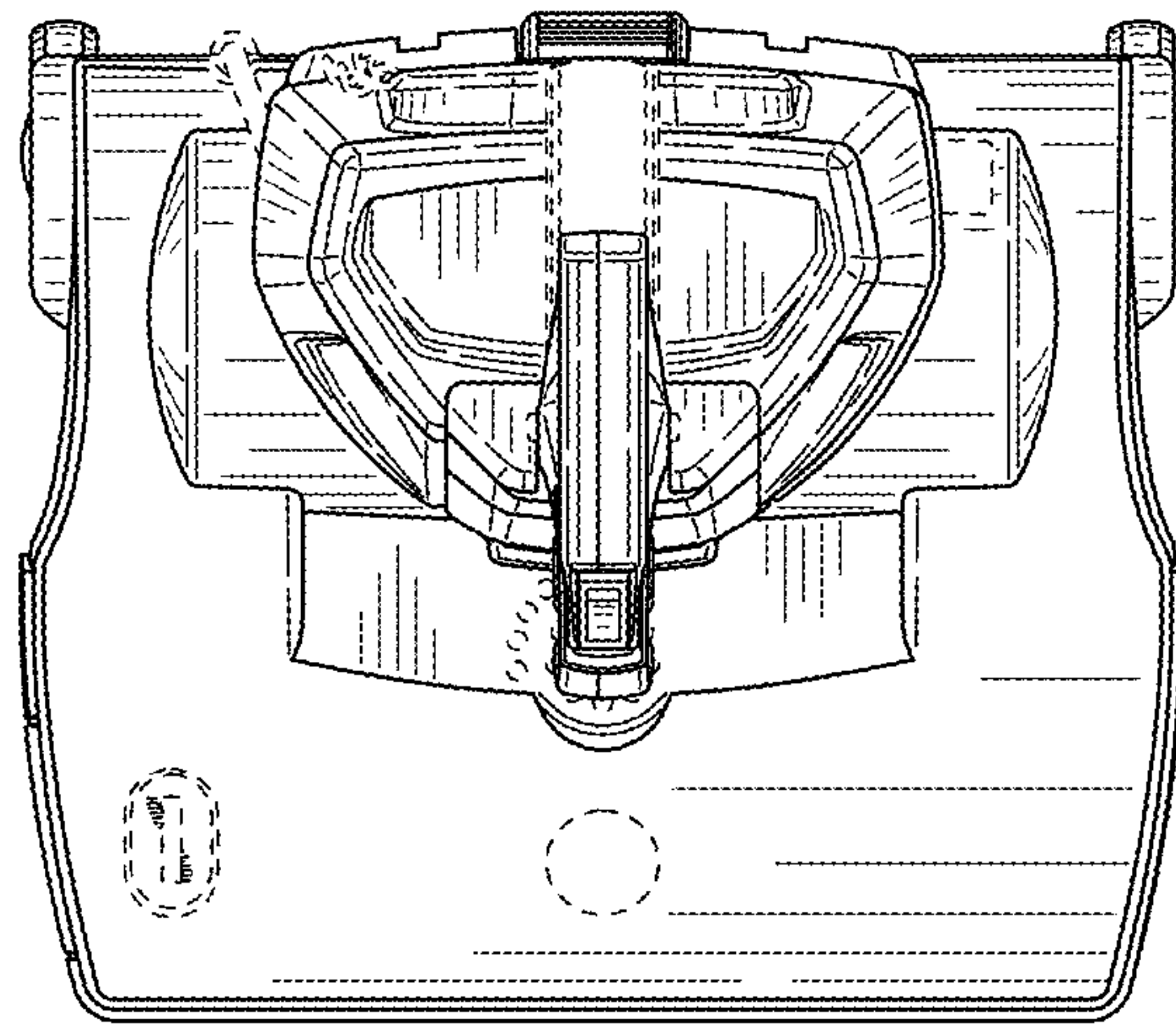

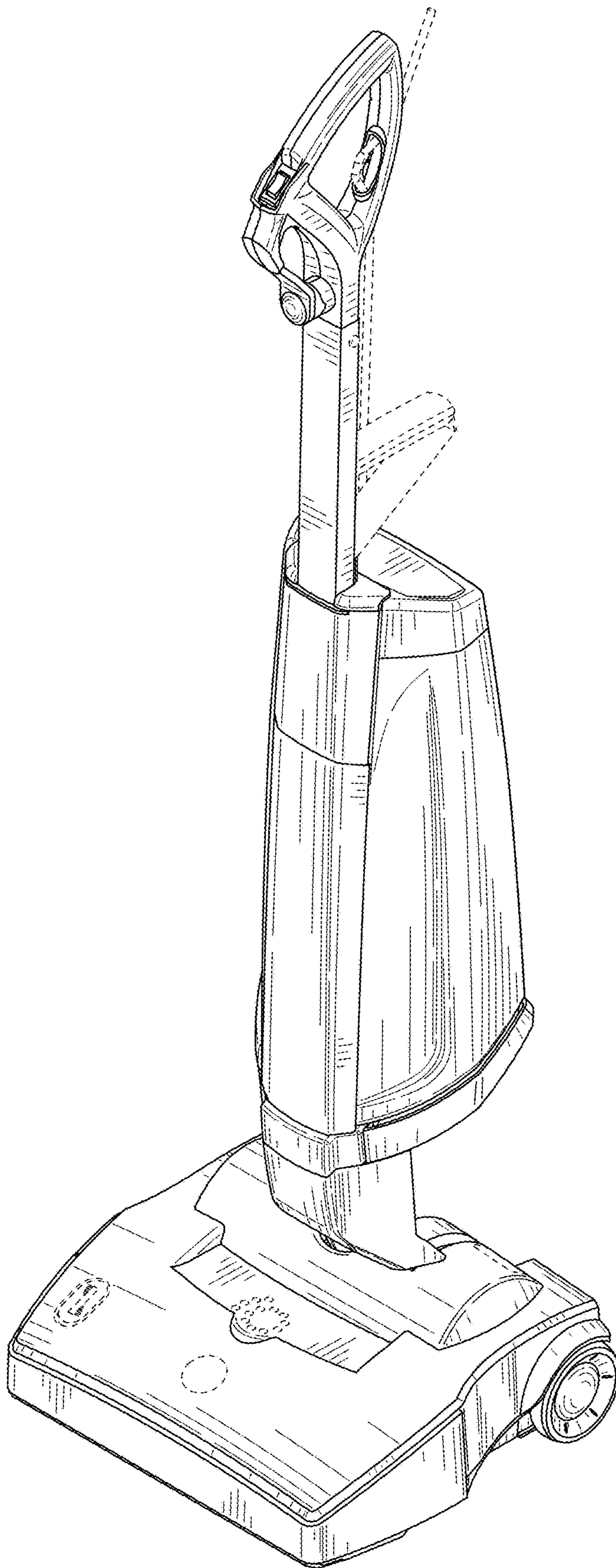

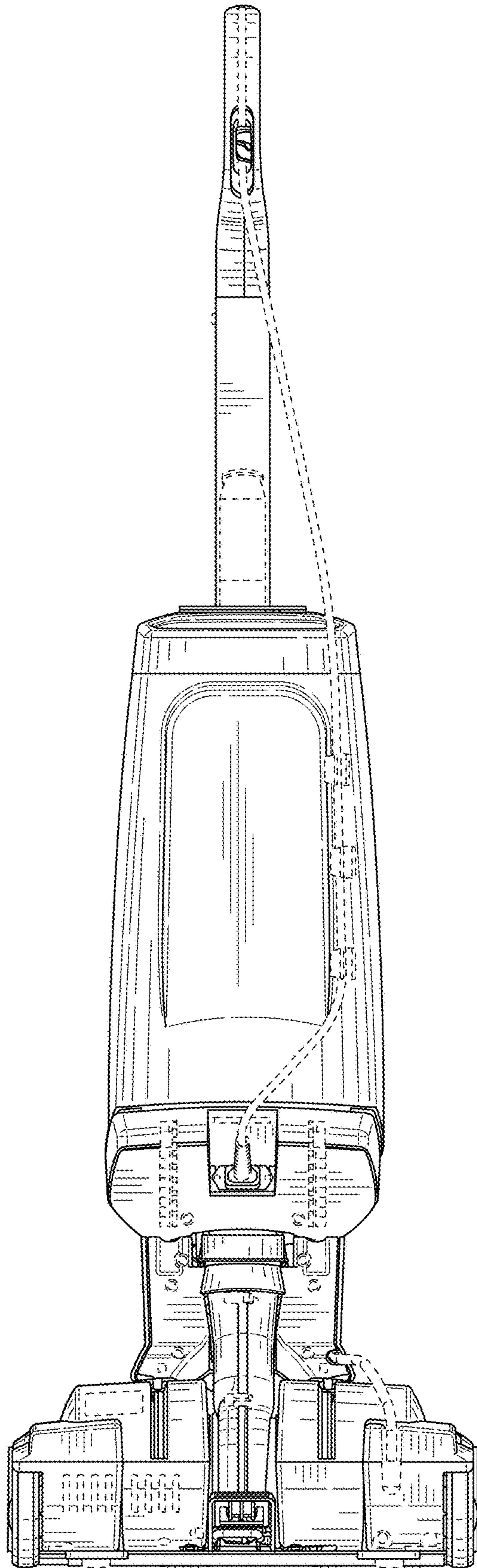

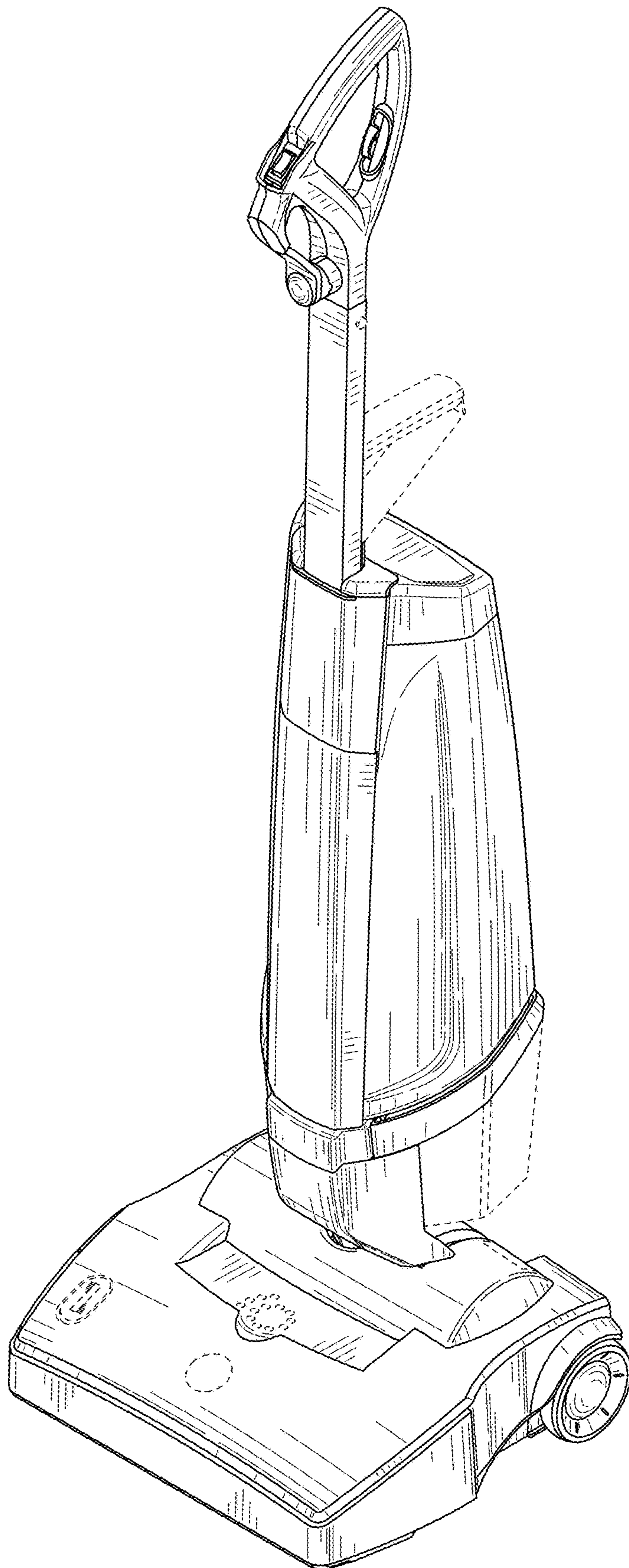

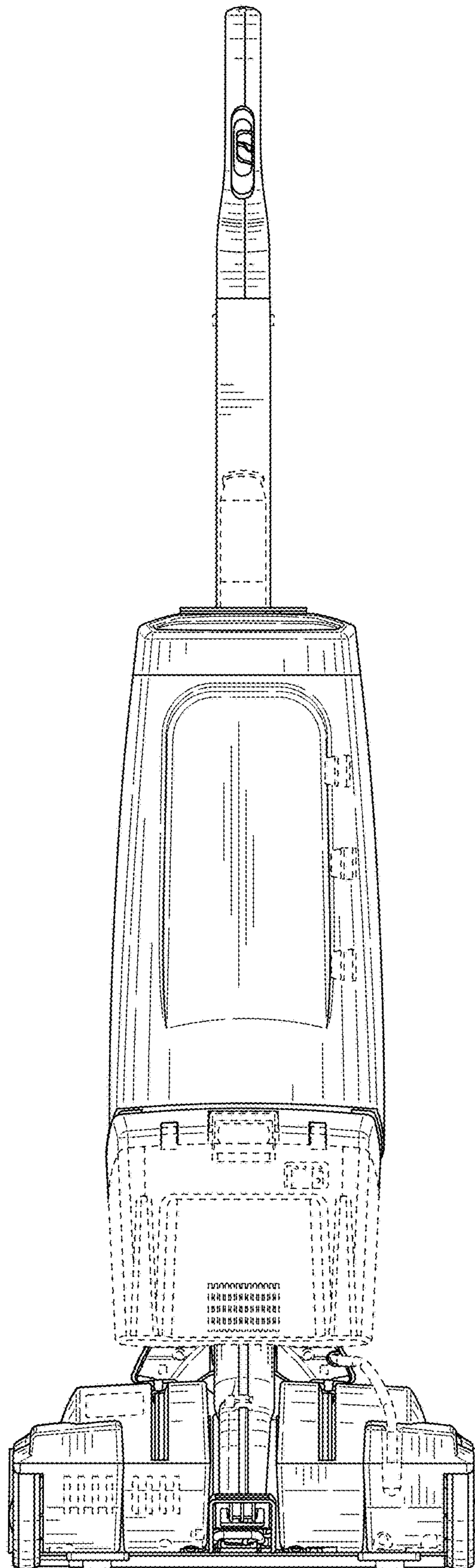
