DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, lateral perspective view of a shoe showing my design;

FIG. 3 is a rear, lateral perspective view thereof;

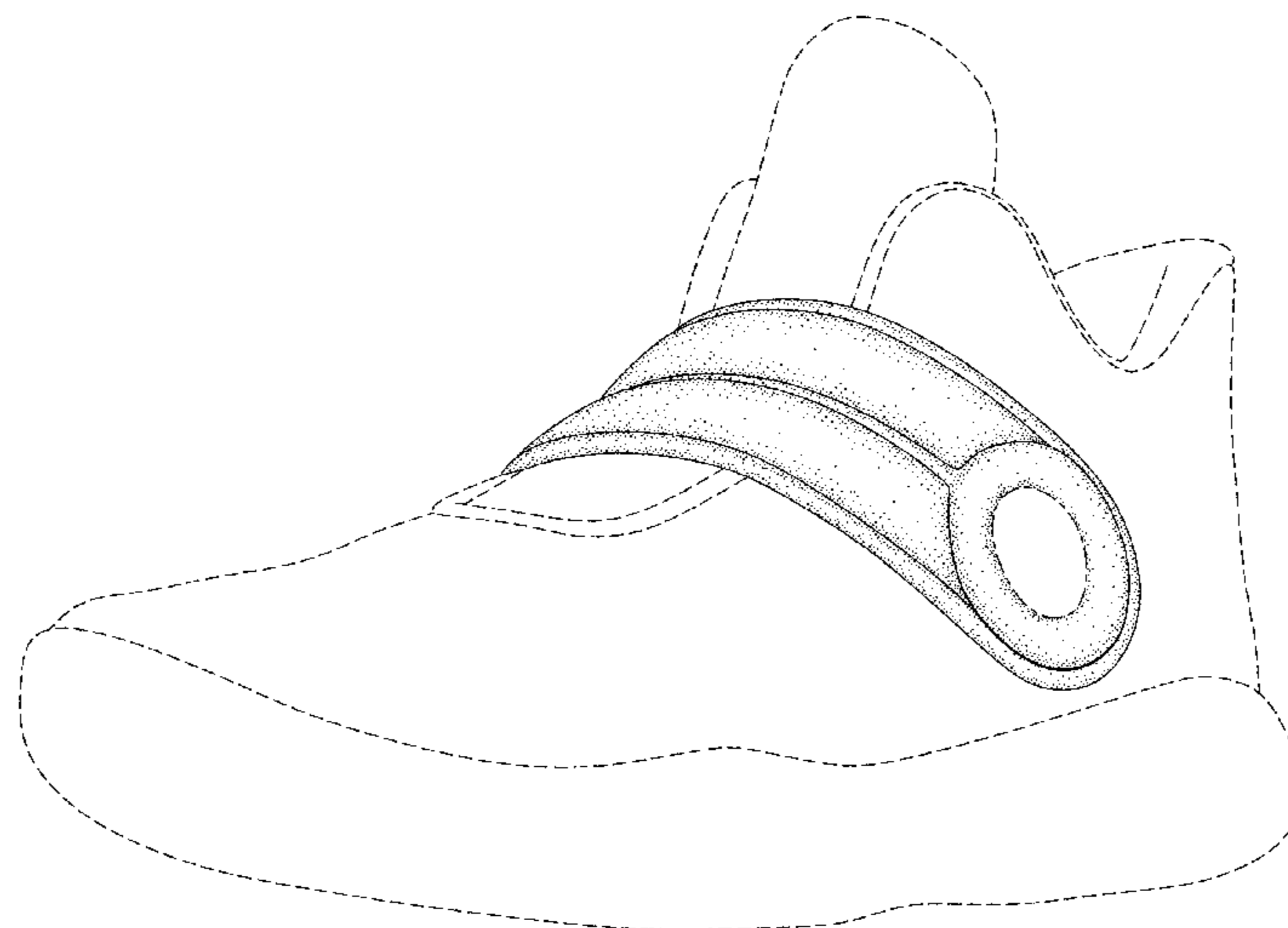
FIG. 4 is a top view thereof; and,

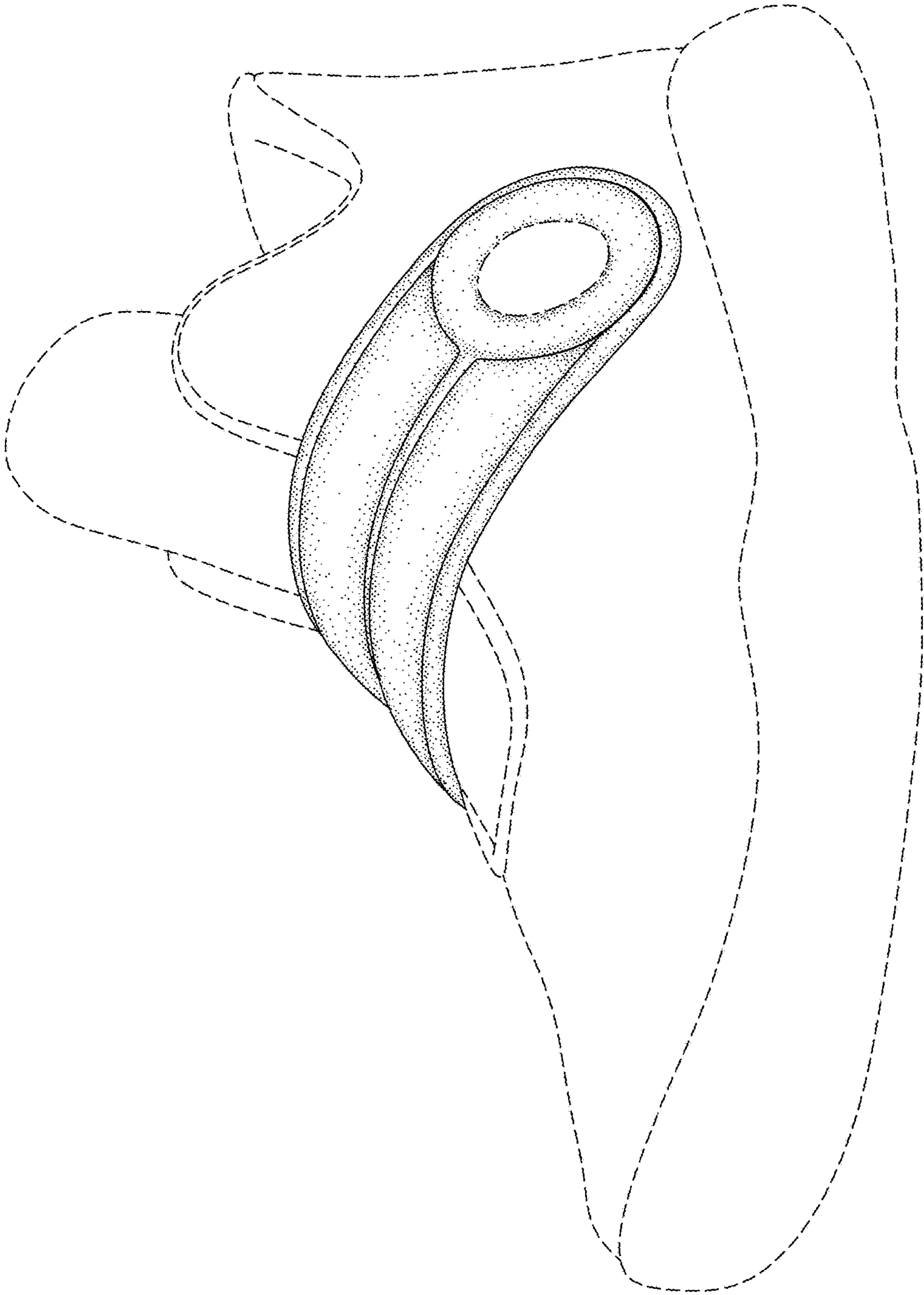

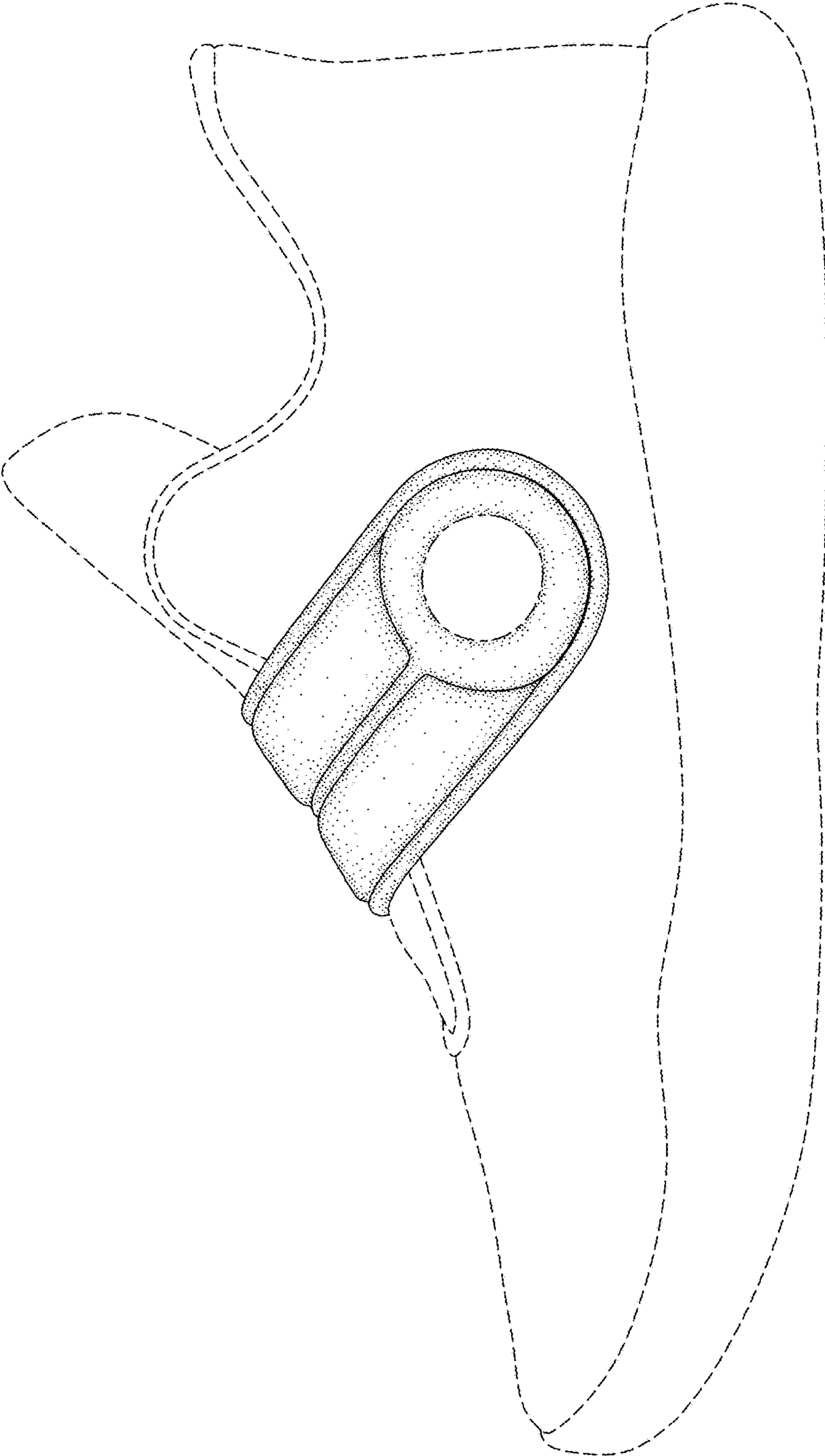

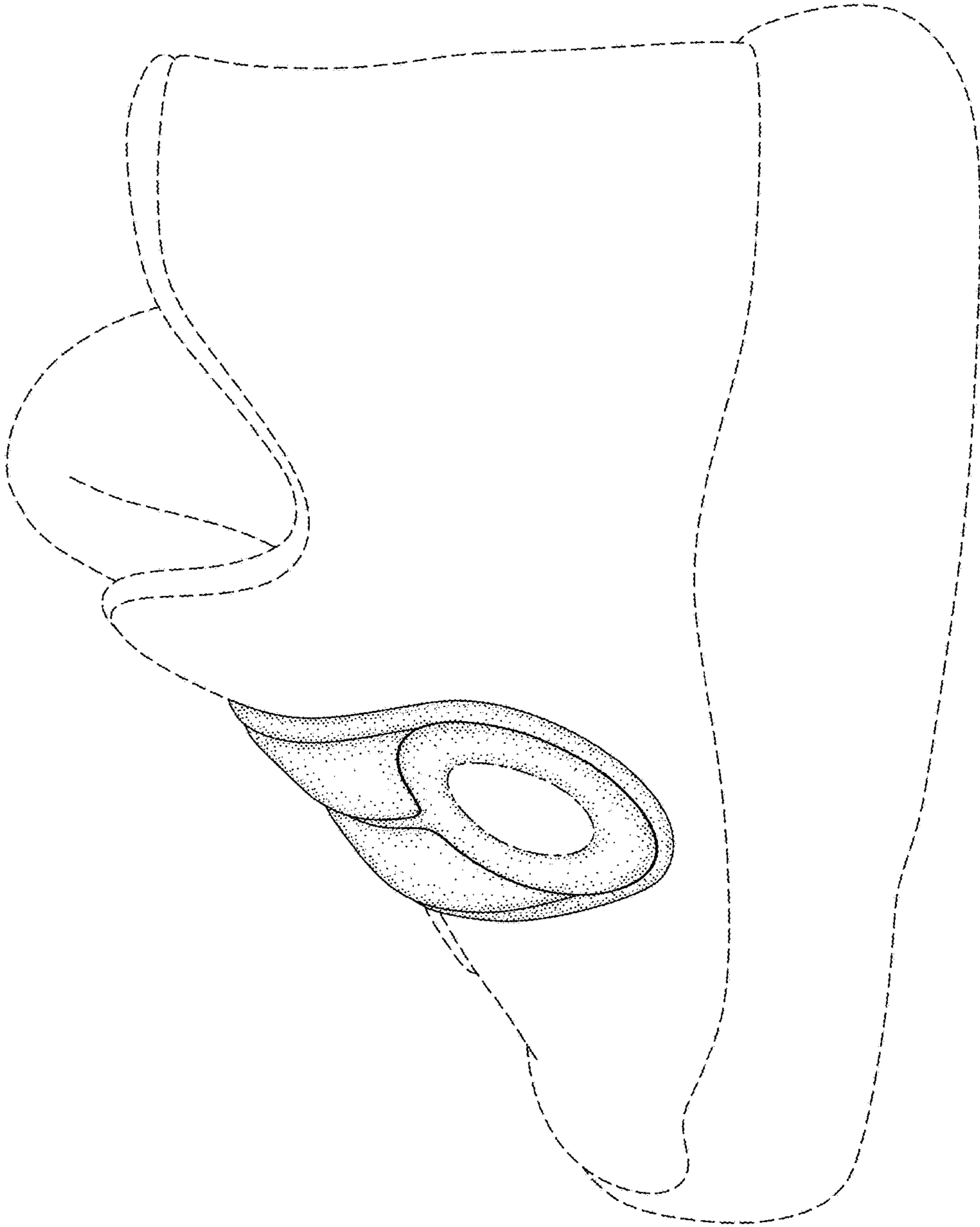

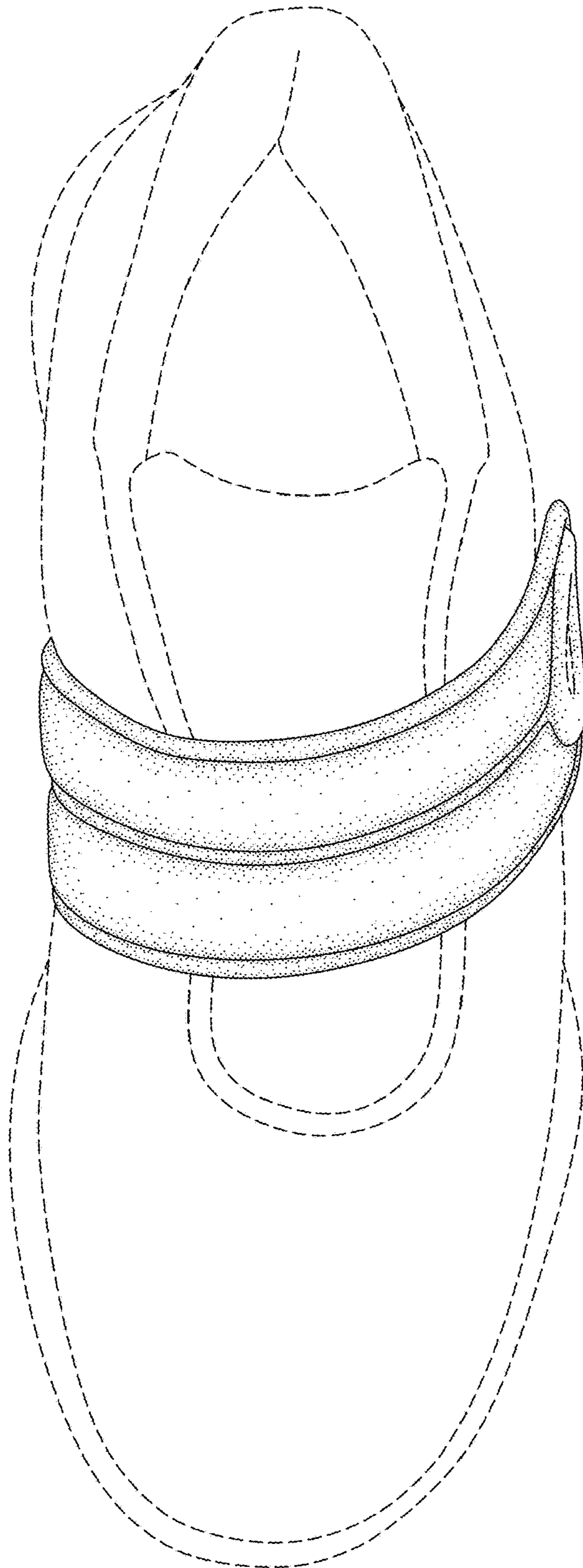

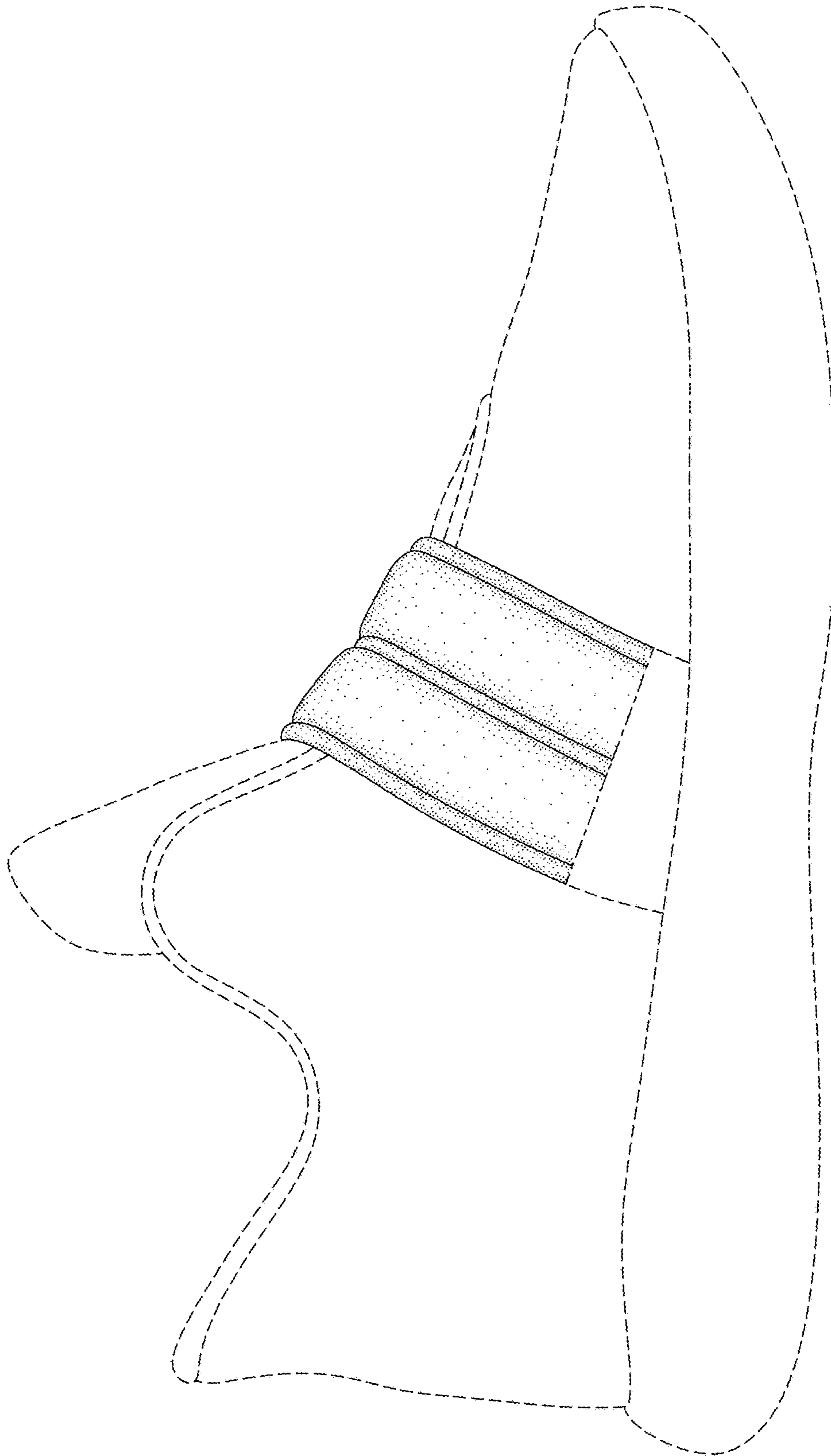
