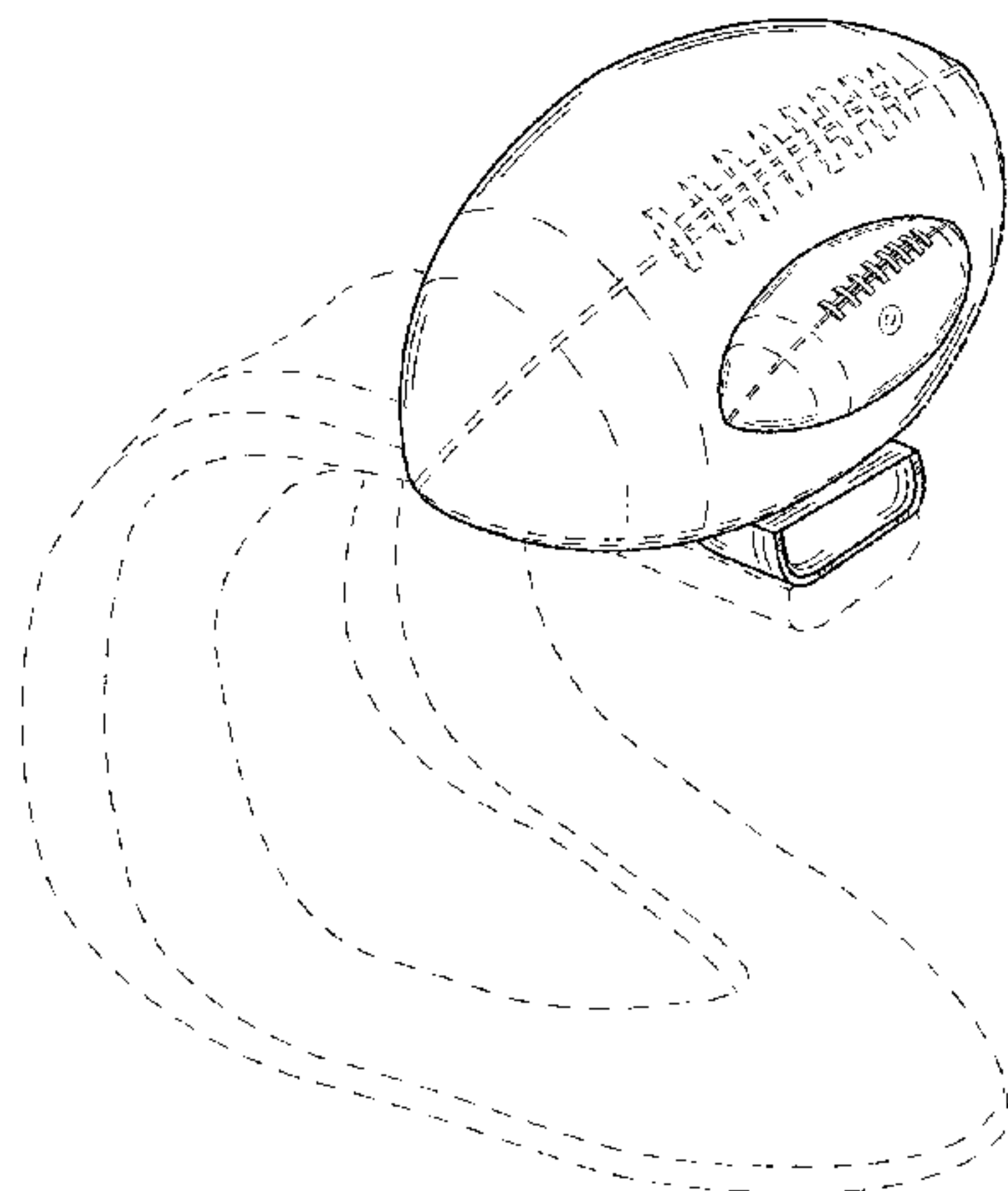
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a sports mailbox, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a sports mailbox showing our
new design;
FIG. 2 is a front view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a rear view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side perspective view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top view thereof; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.
The broken lines shown on the sports mailbox represent
surface ornamentation, and it is understood that the surface
which lies beneath the broken lines is part of the claimed
design, while the broken lines showing an exemplary base of
the sports mailbox form no part of the claimed design.

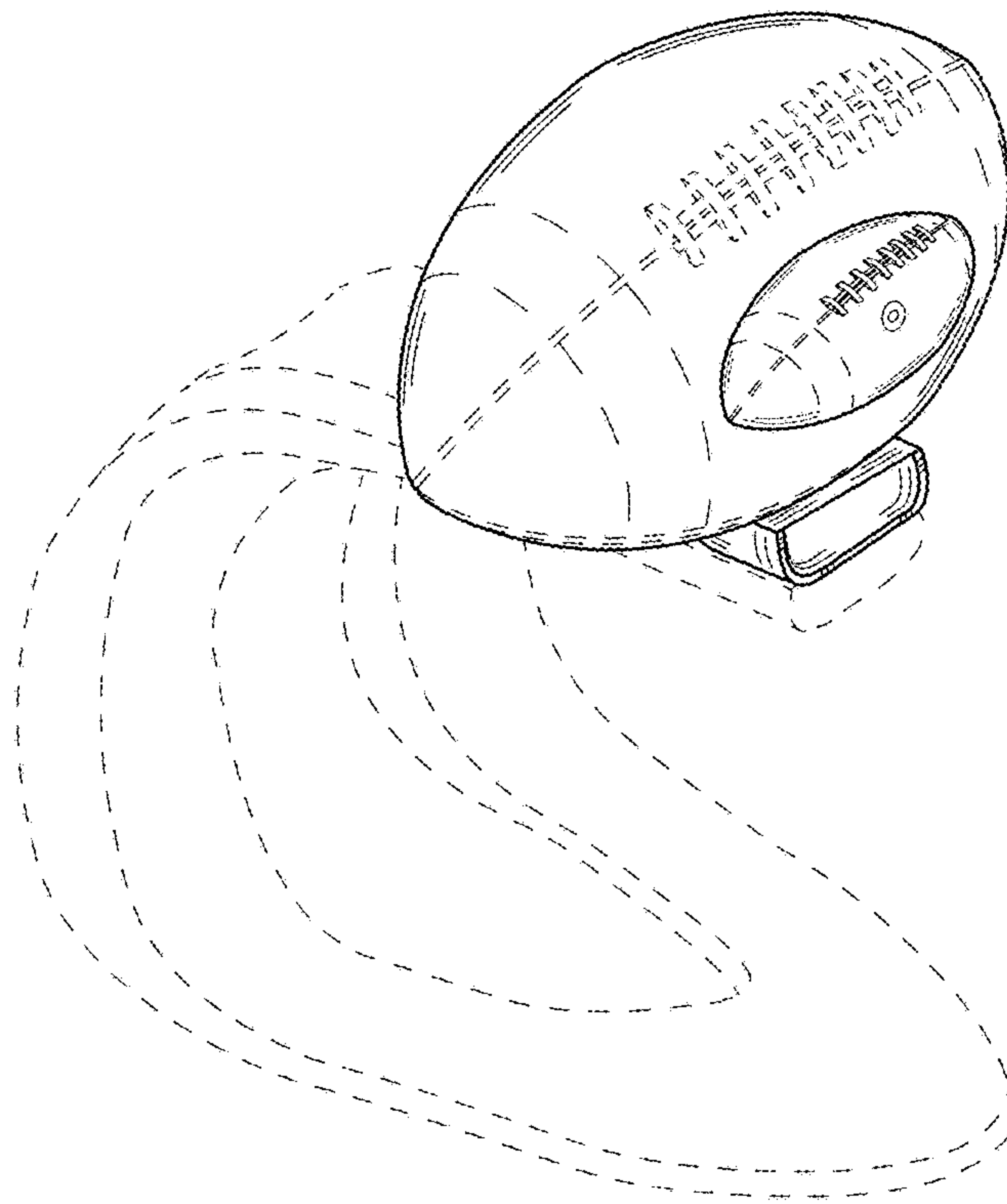

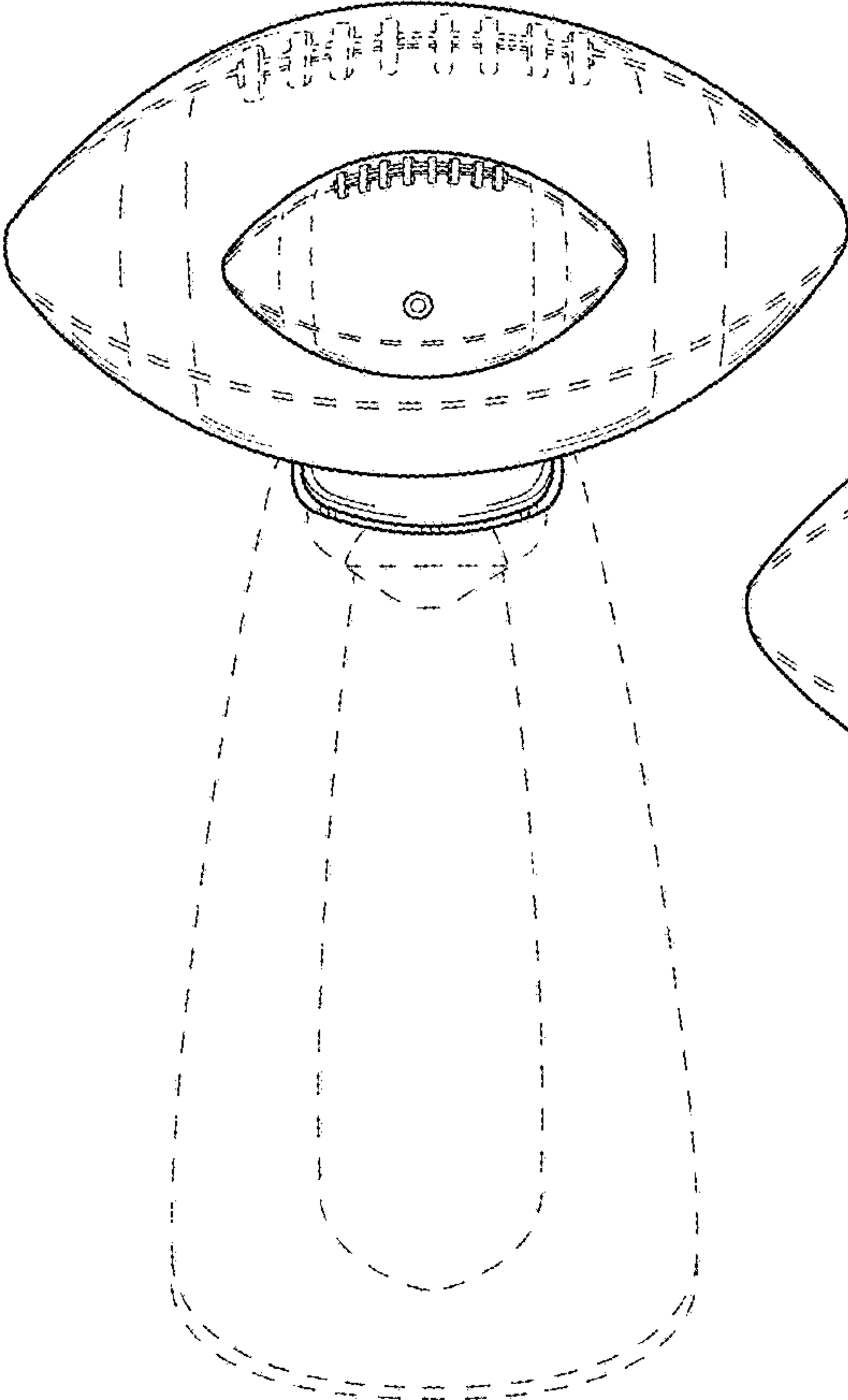

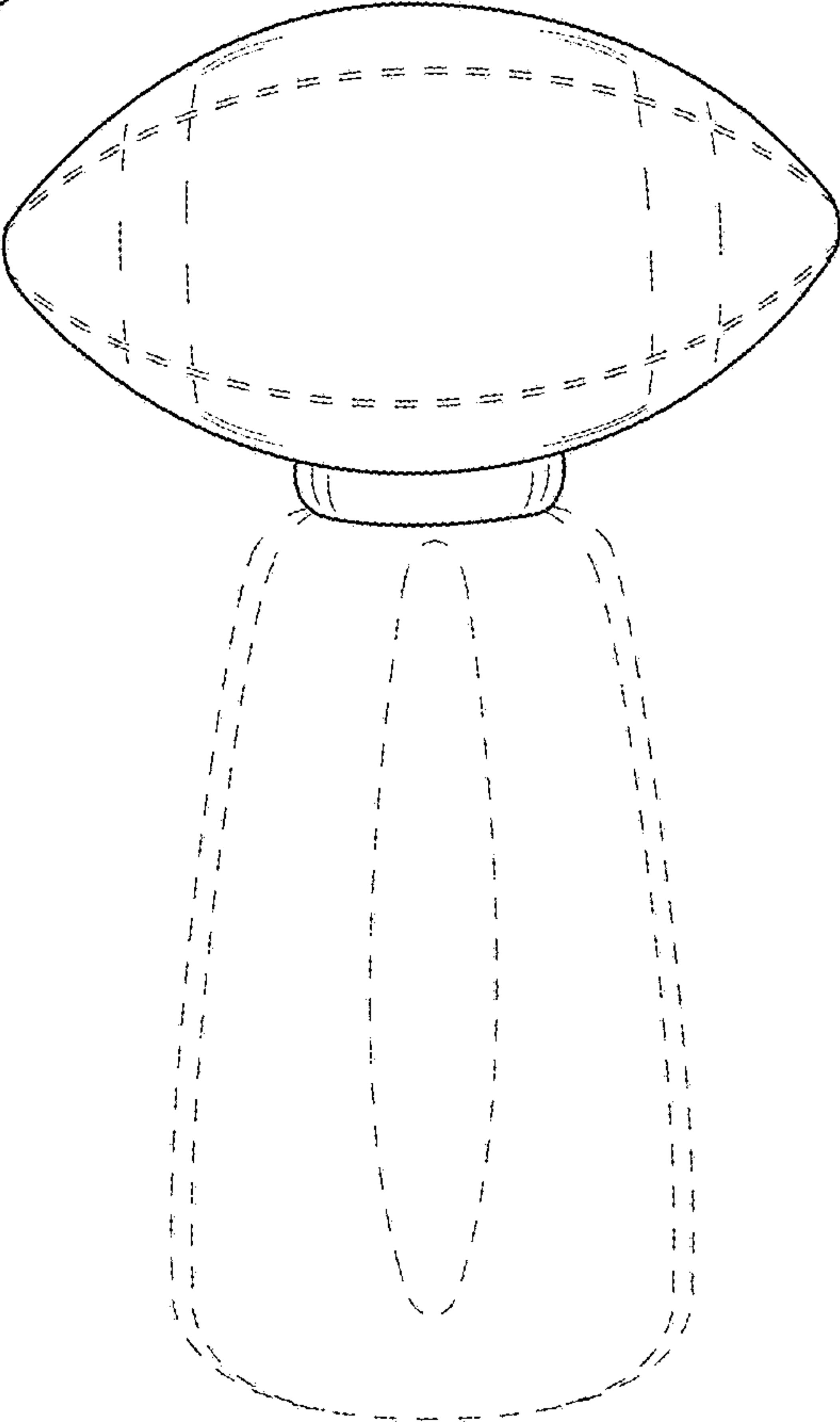

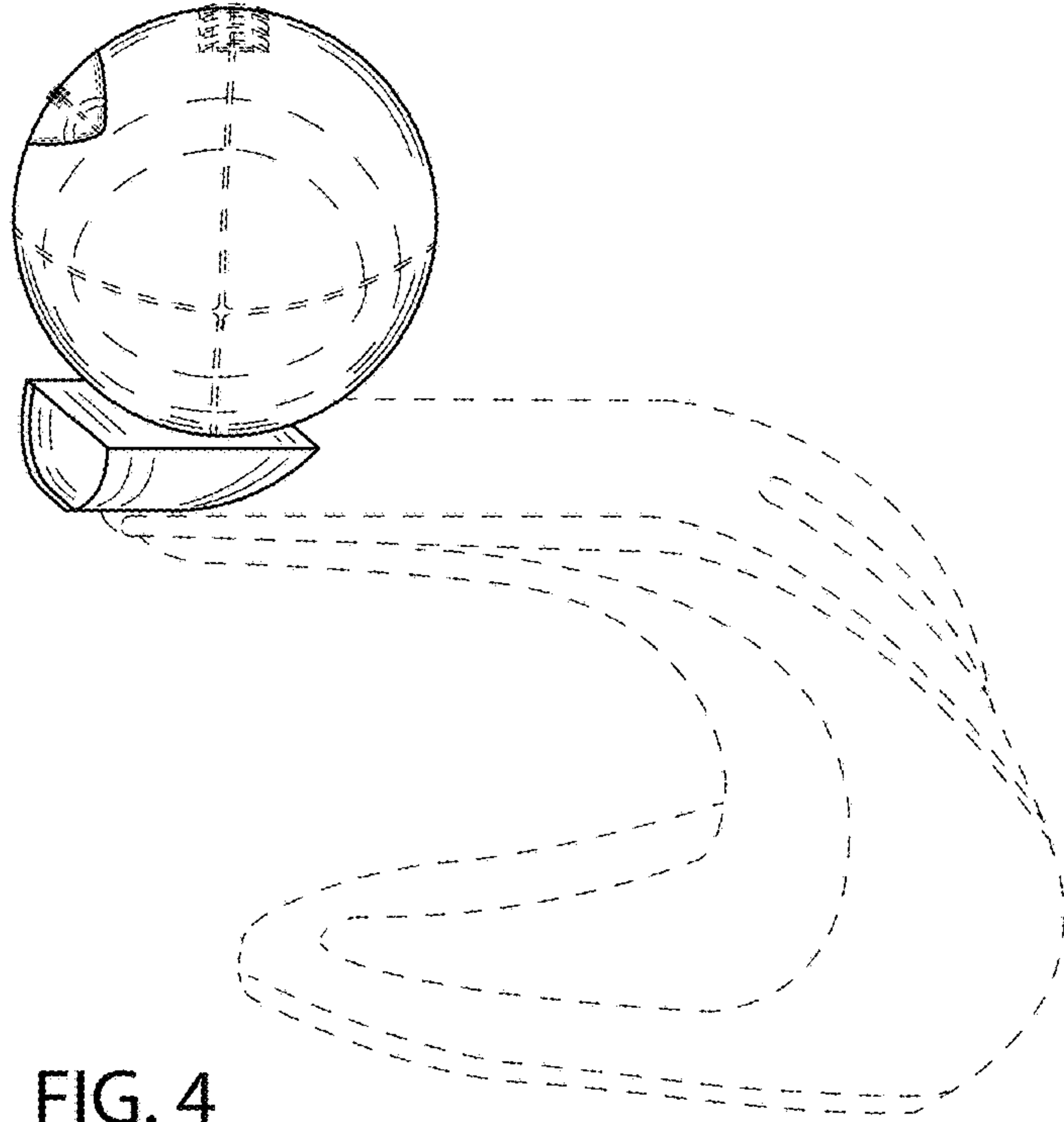

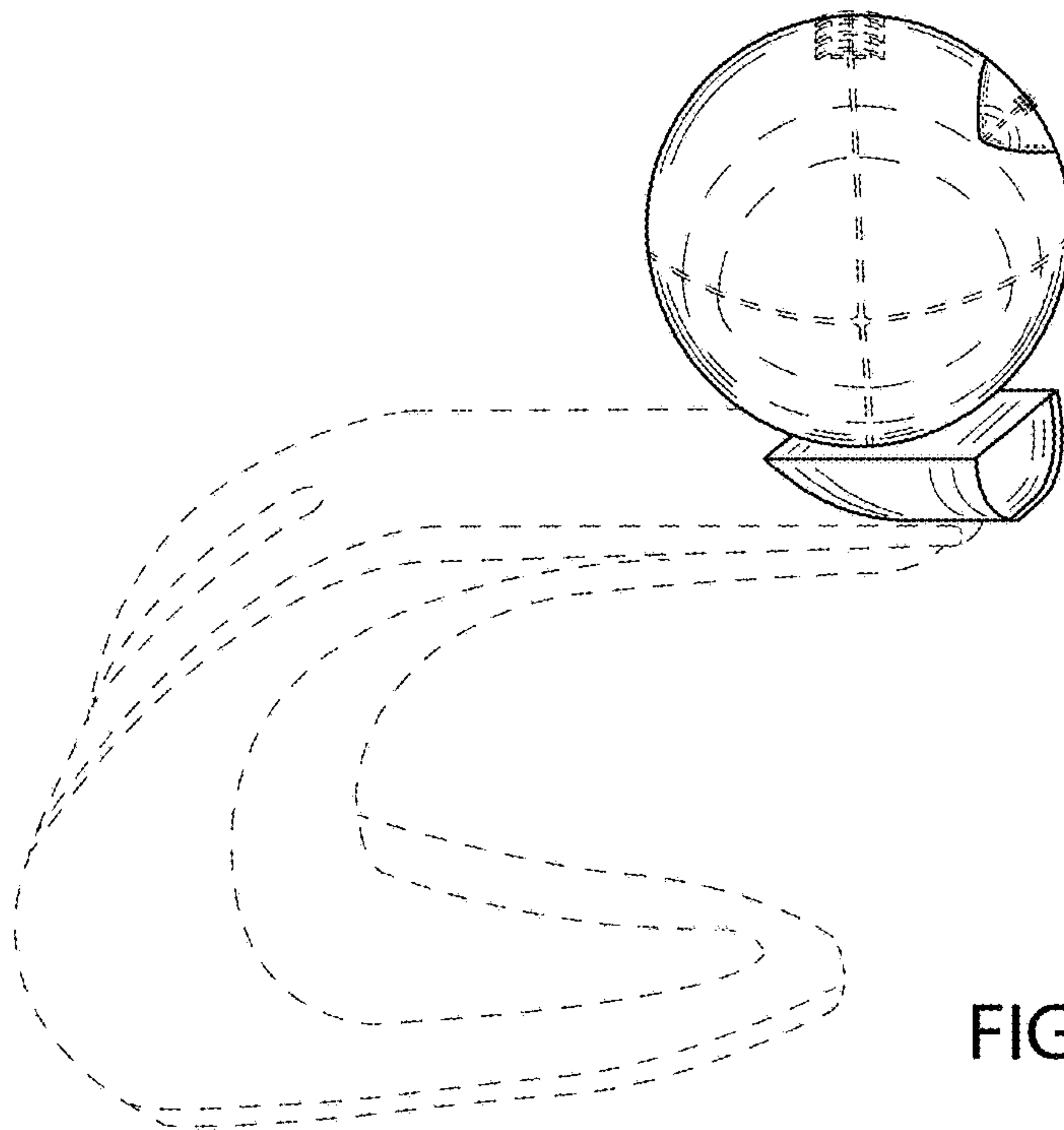

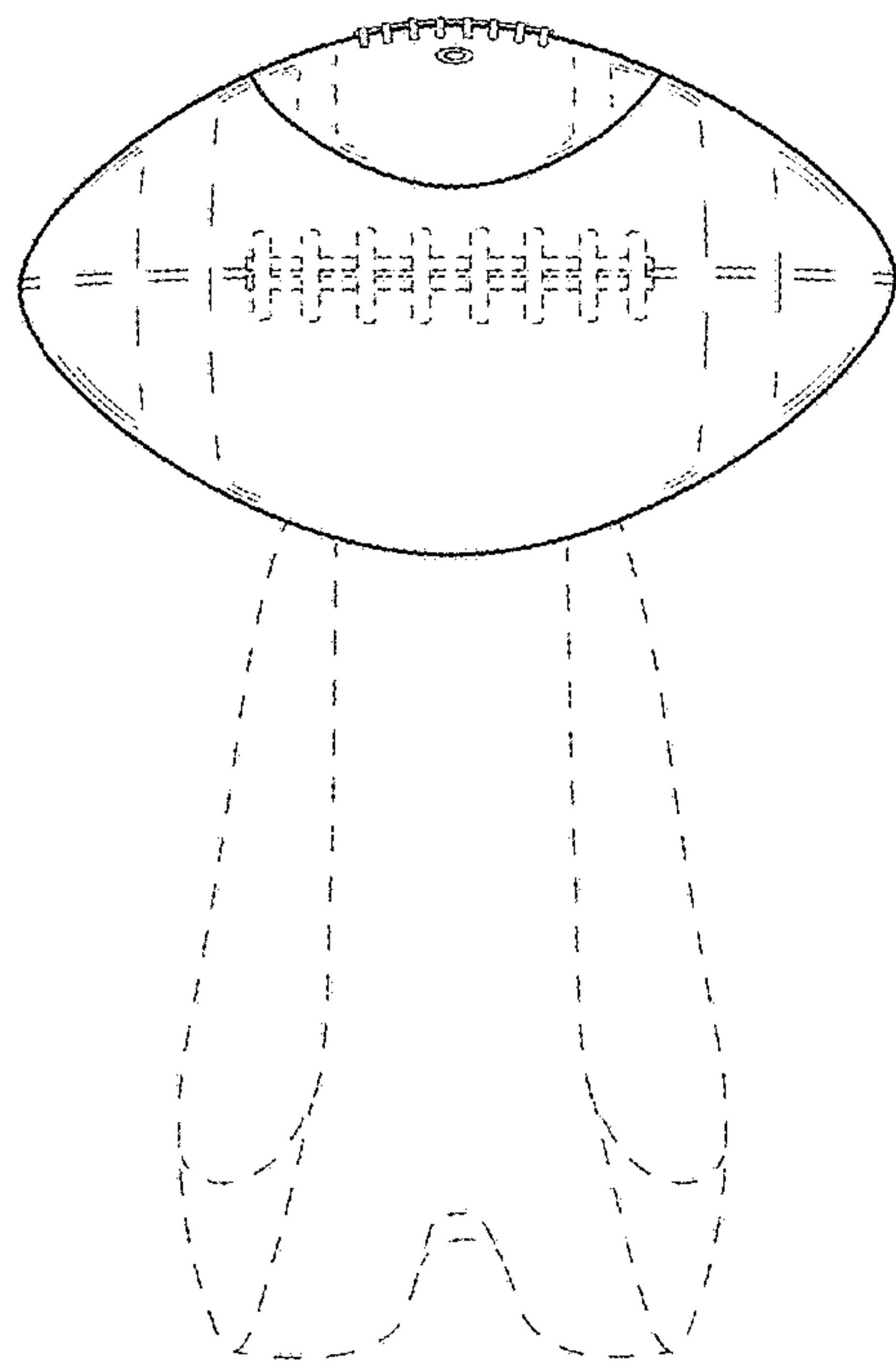

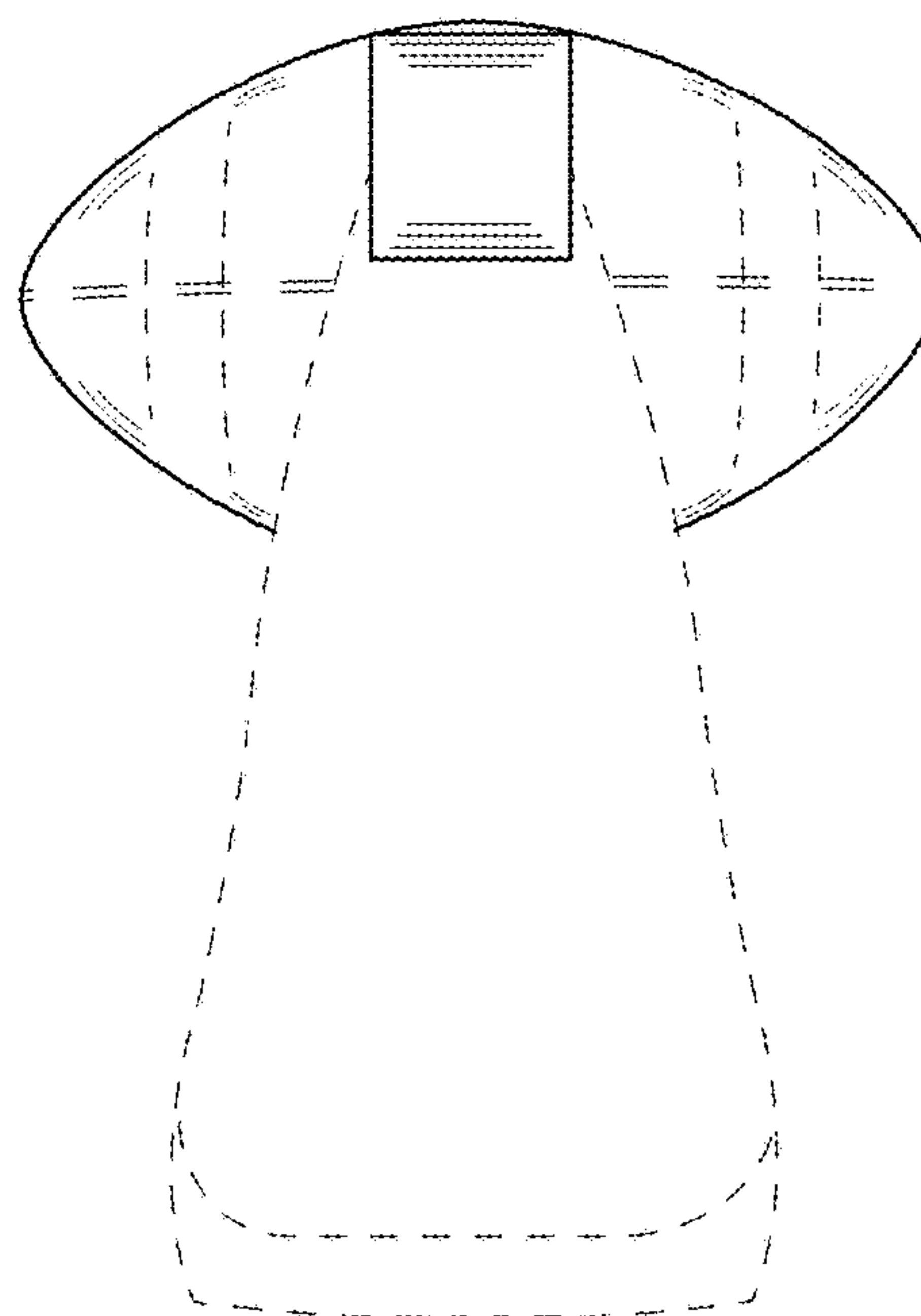
