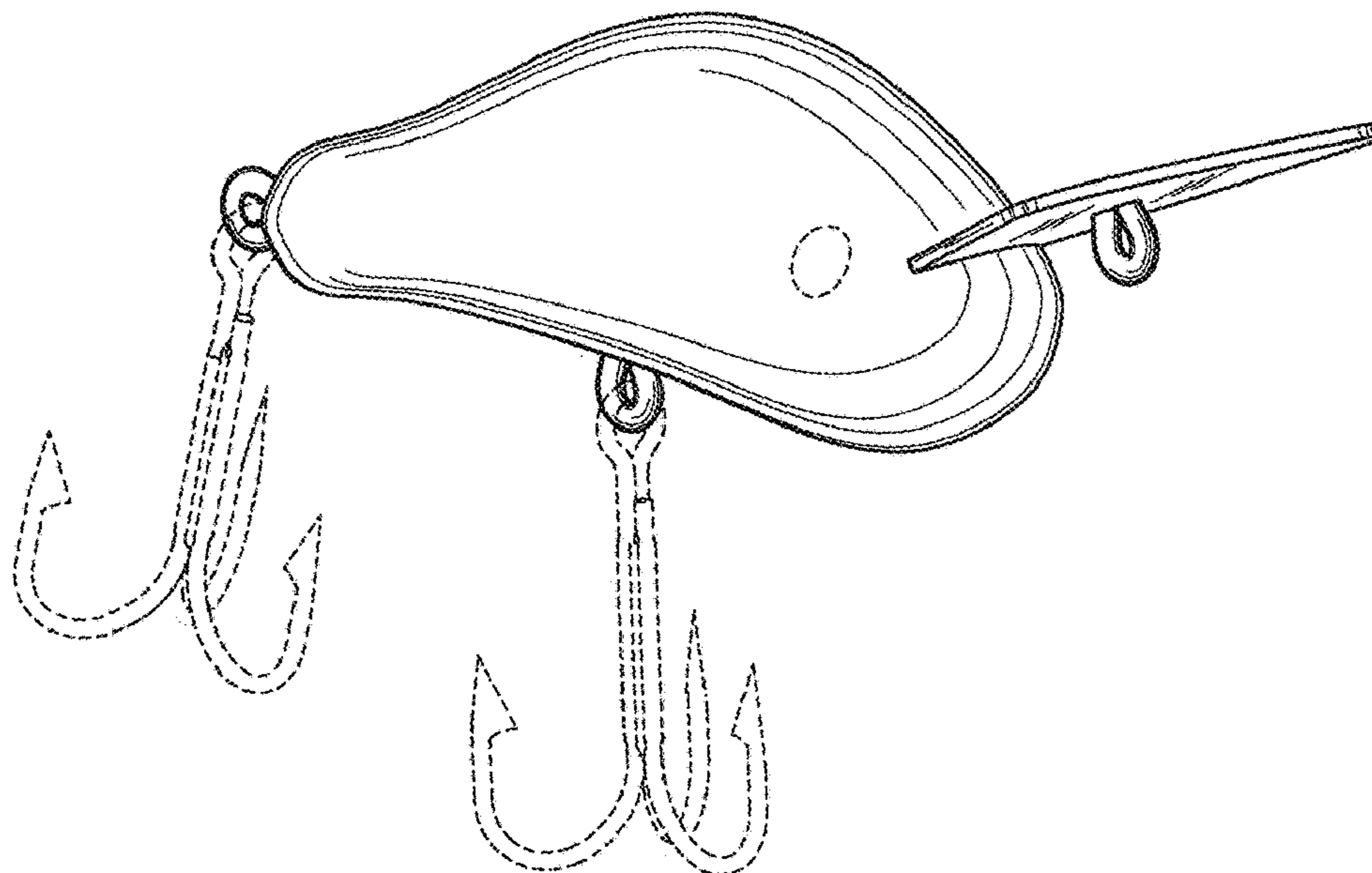
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a fish lure, as shown and

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right perspective view of a fish lure  
showing my new design;  
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view of the fish lure of FIG.  
1, the left side elevational view being a mirror image  
thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the fish lure of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the fish lure of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the fish lure of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the fish lure of FIG. 1.

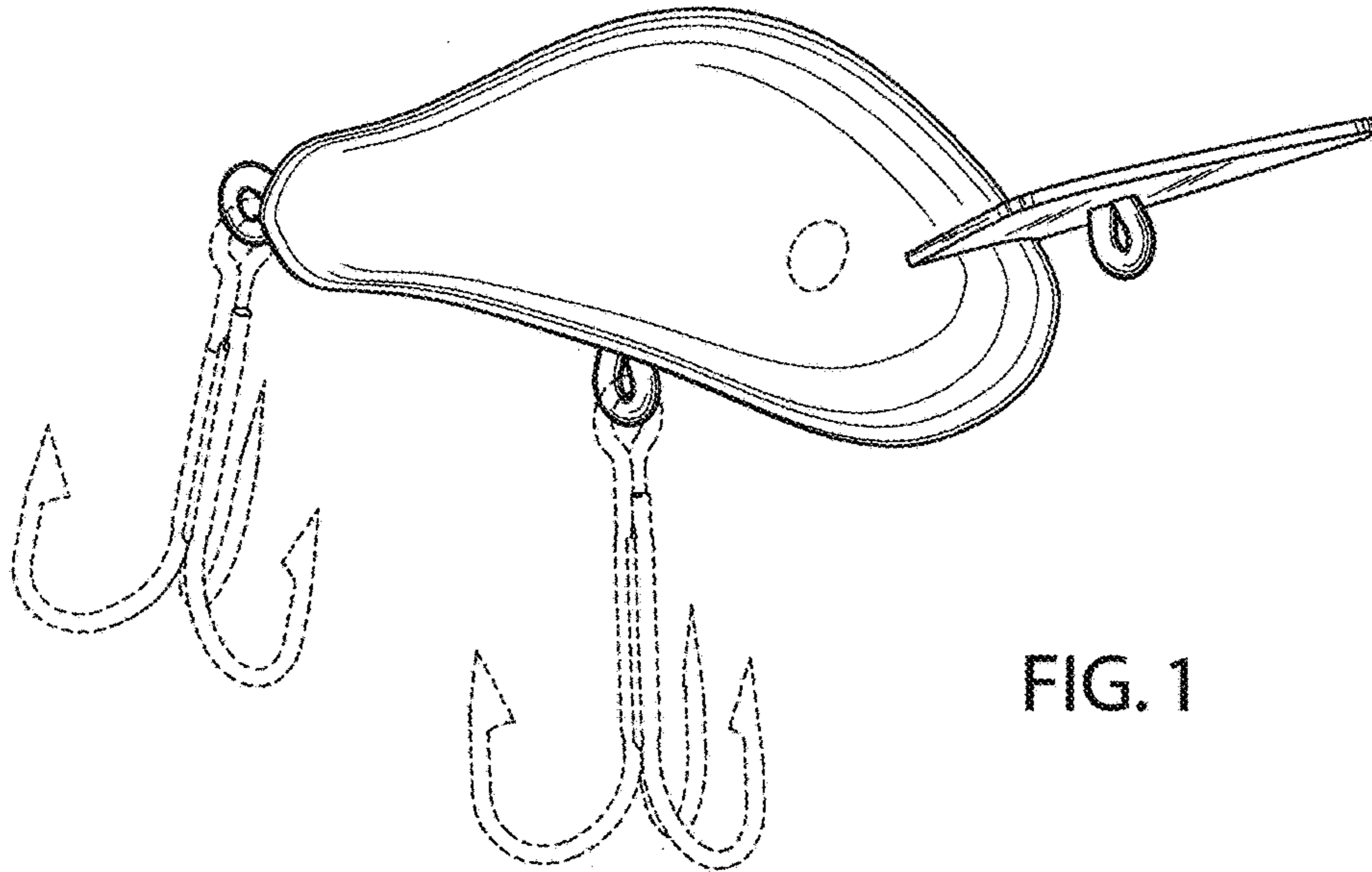

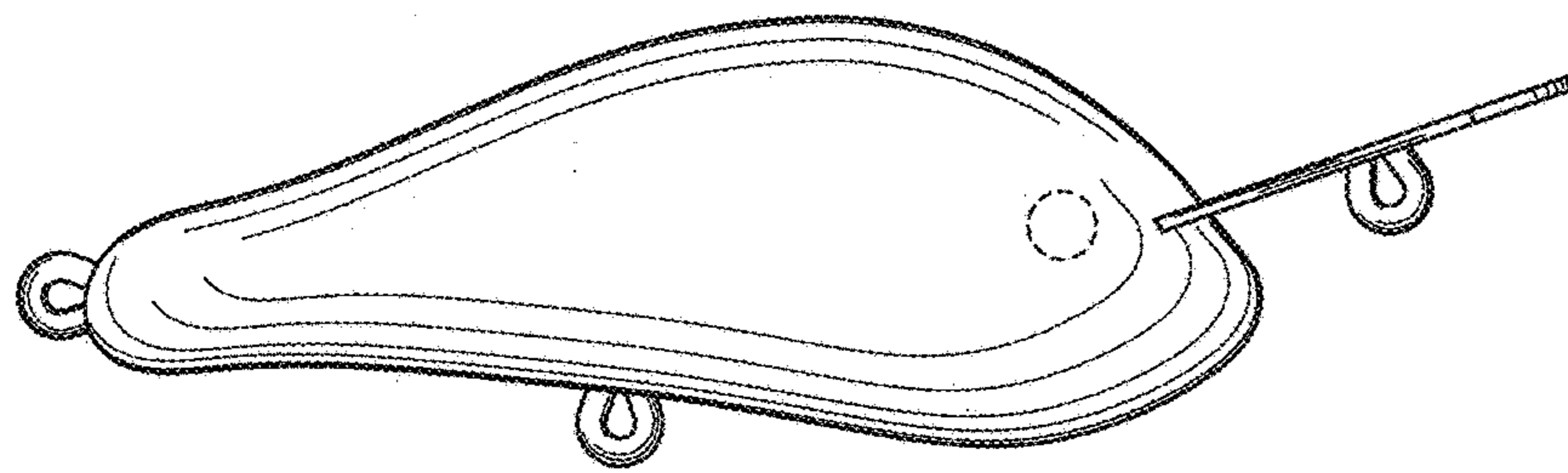

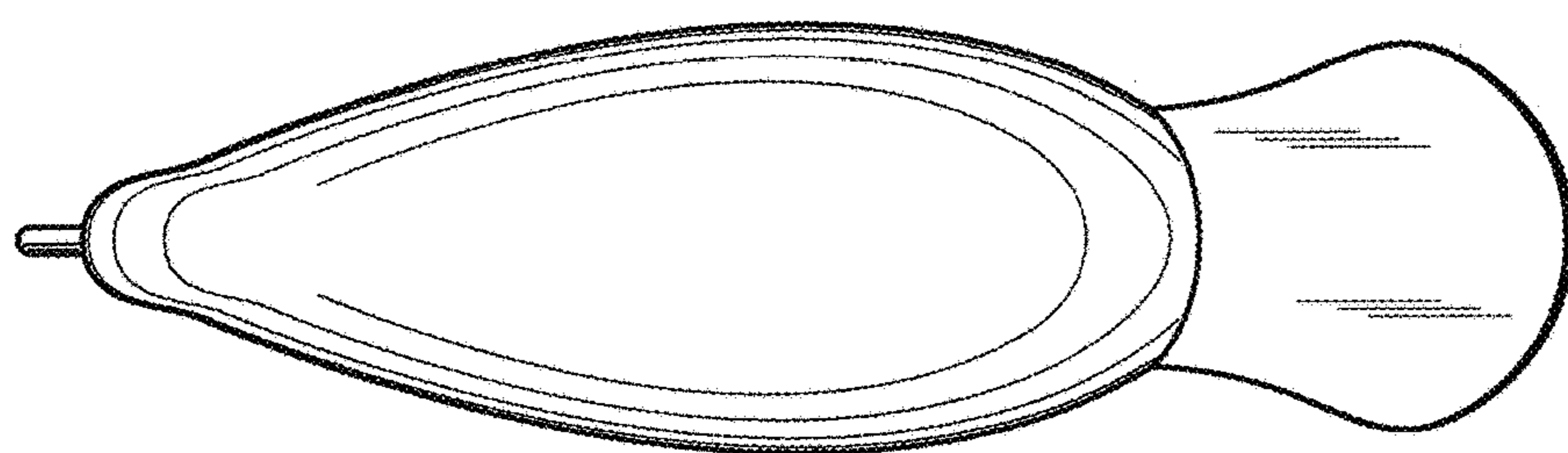

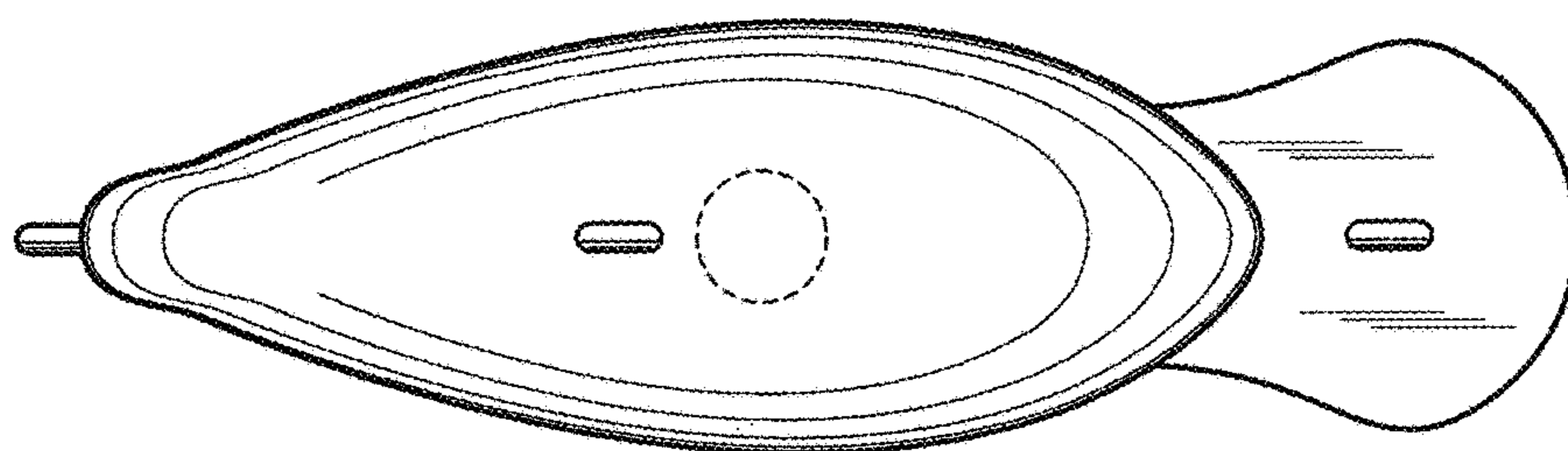

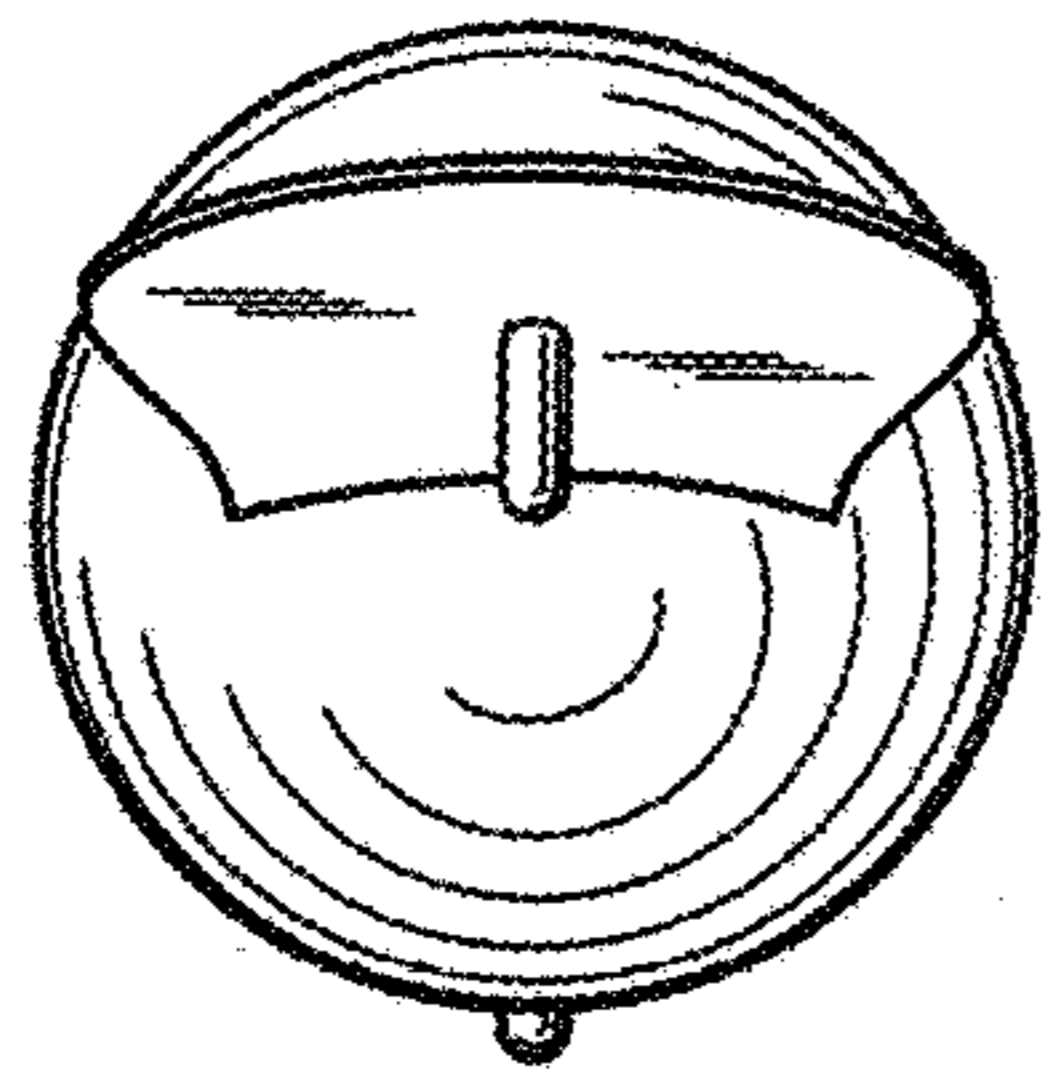

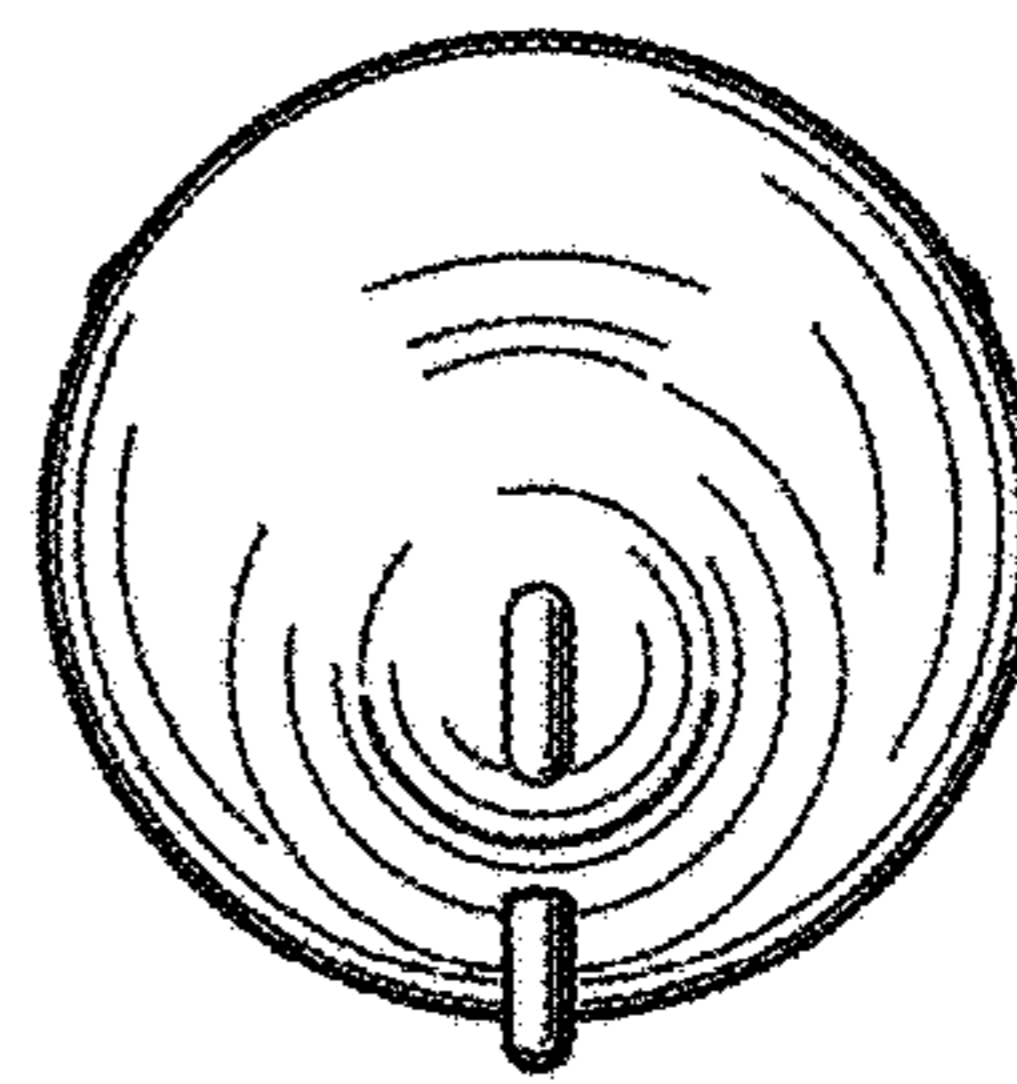
