FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of thereof.

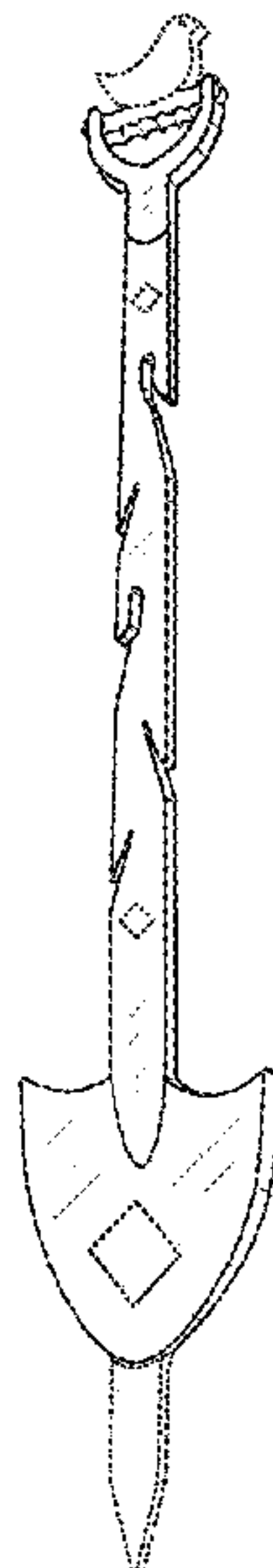
FIG. 8 is a top perspective view thereof looking from the top.

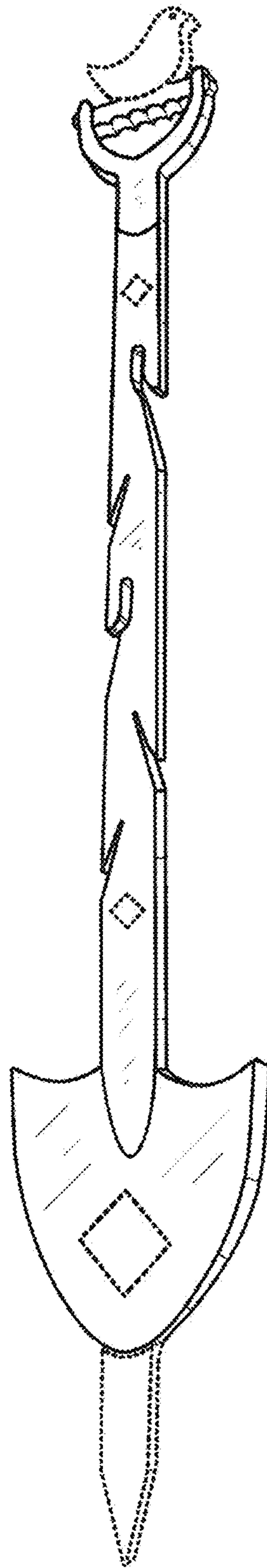

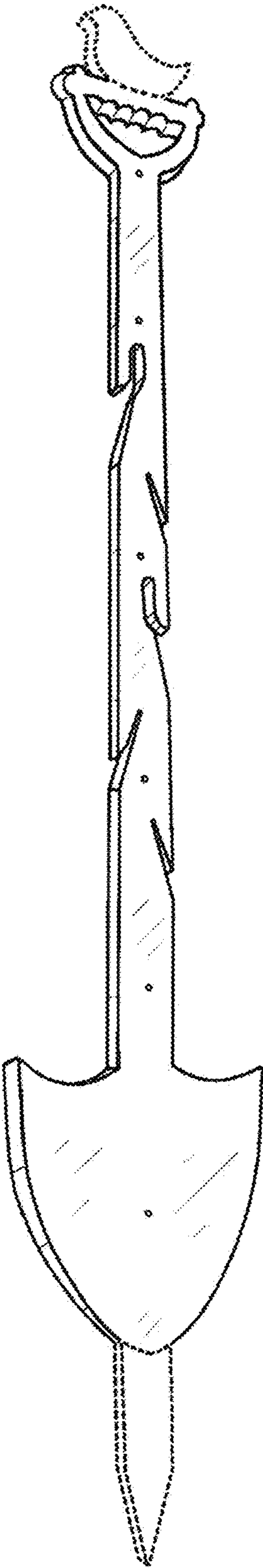

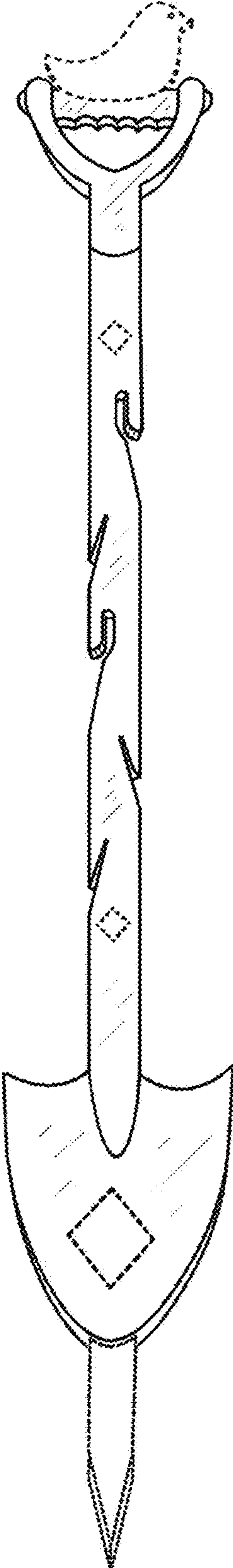

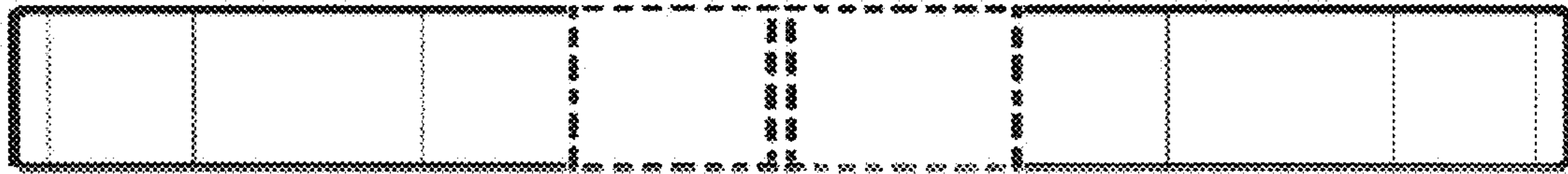

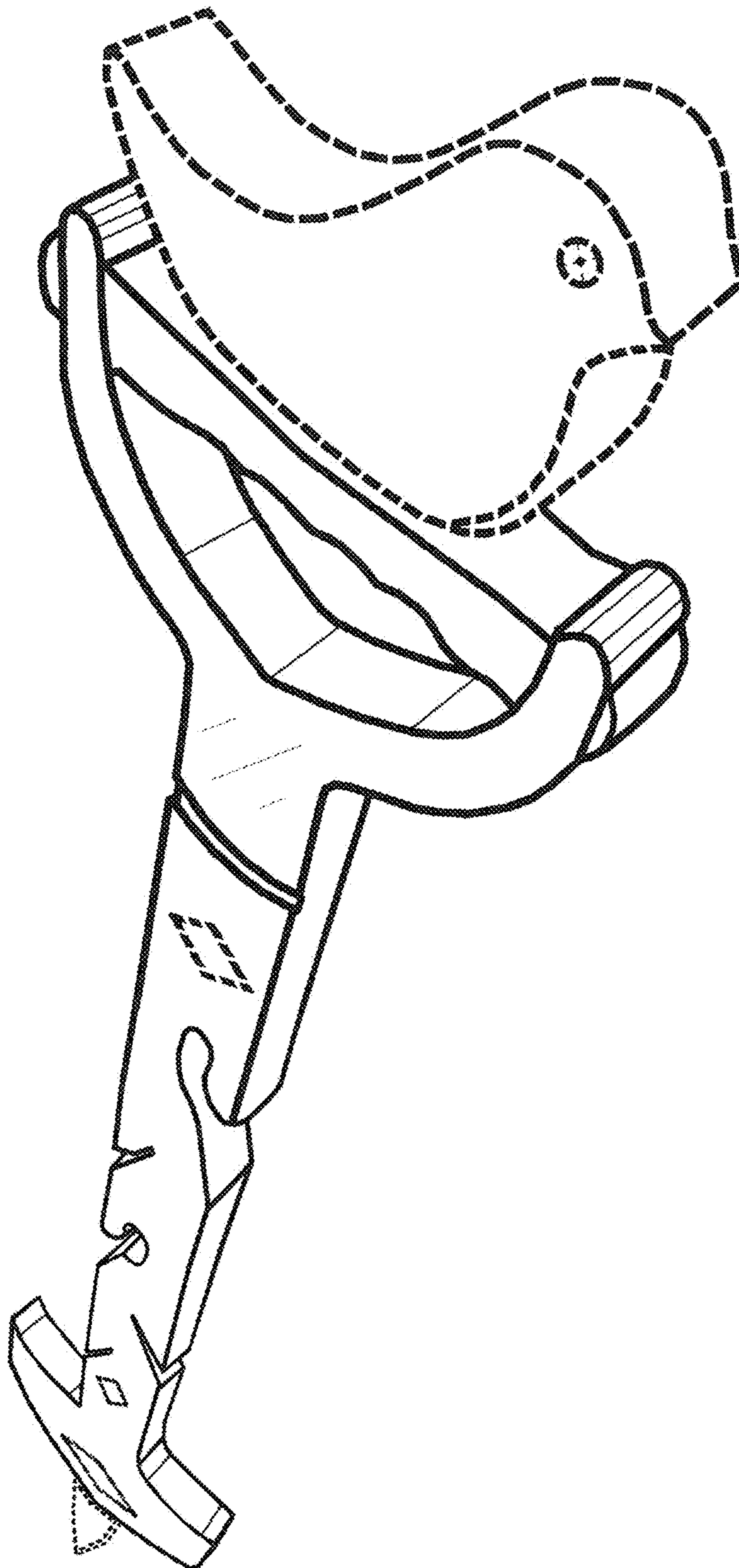

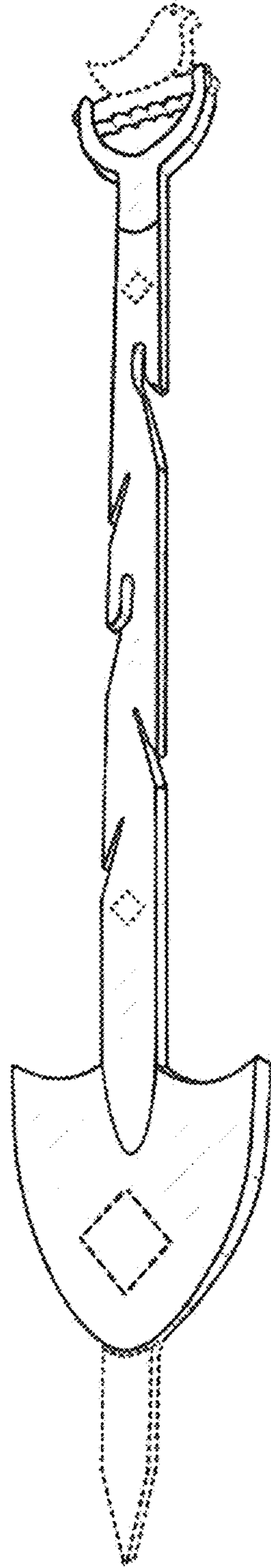

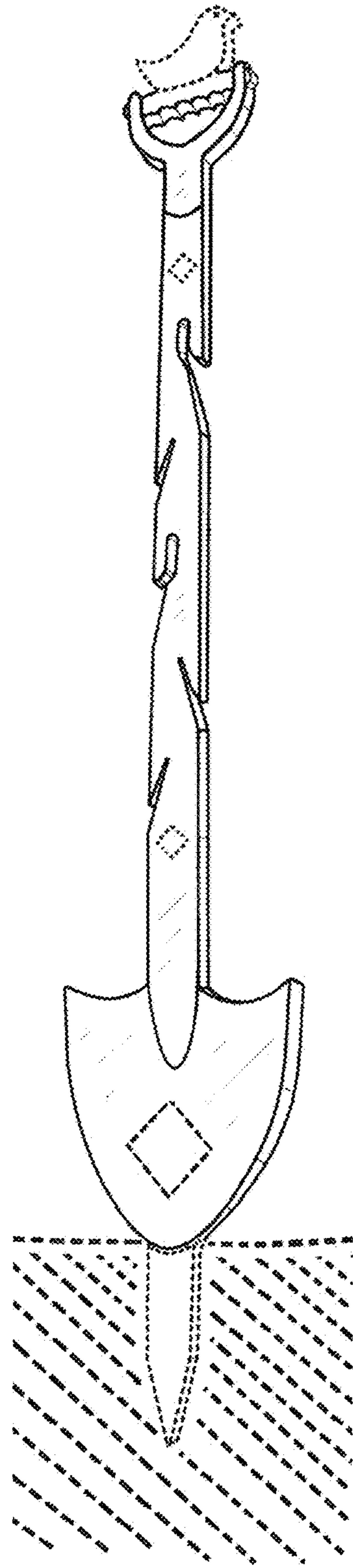
