FIG. 3 is an enlarged detail view thereof.

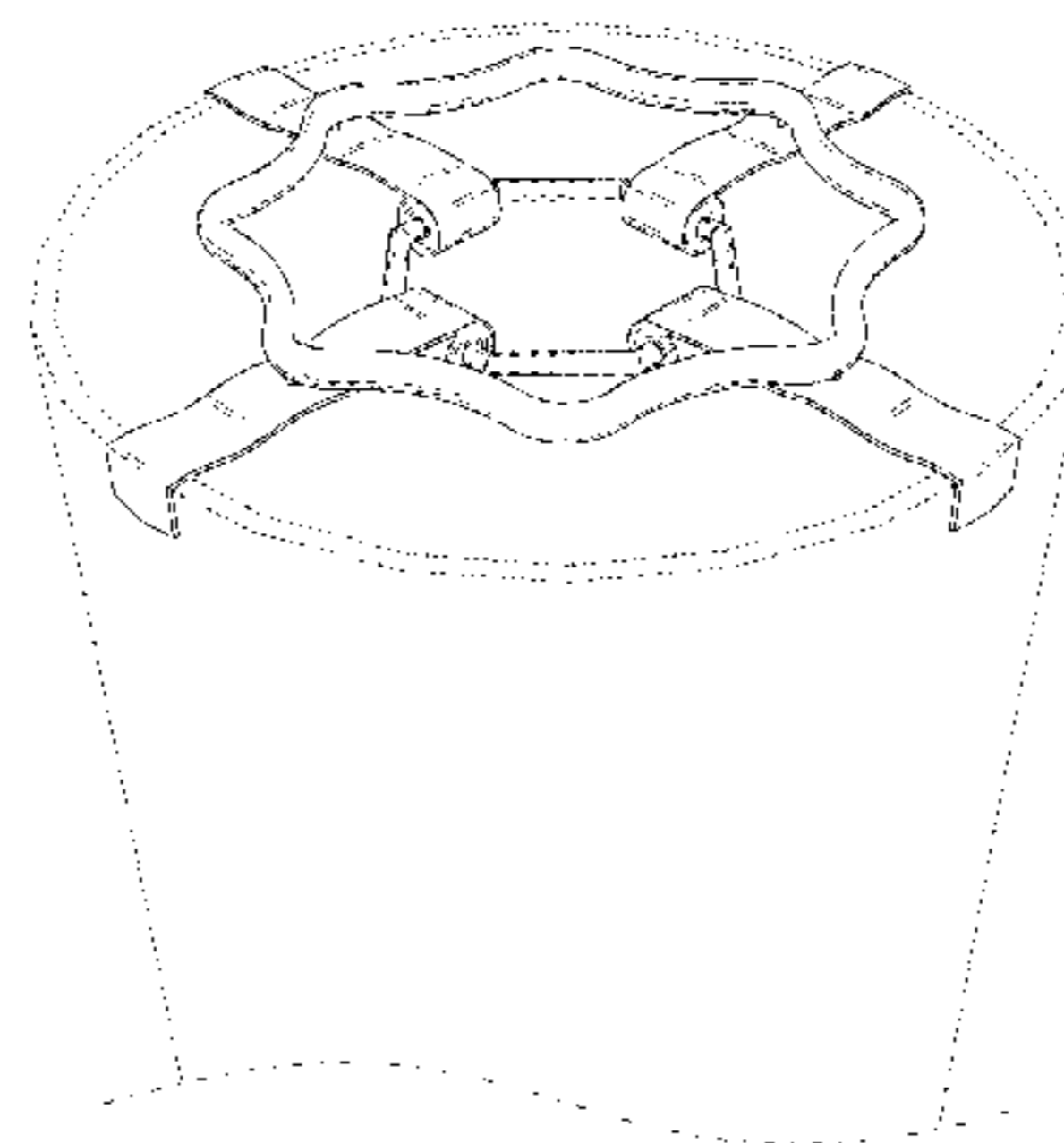
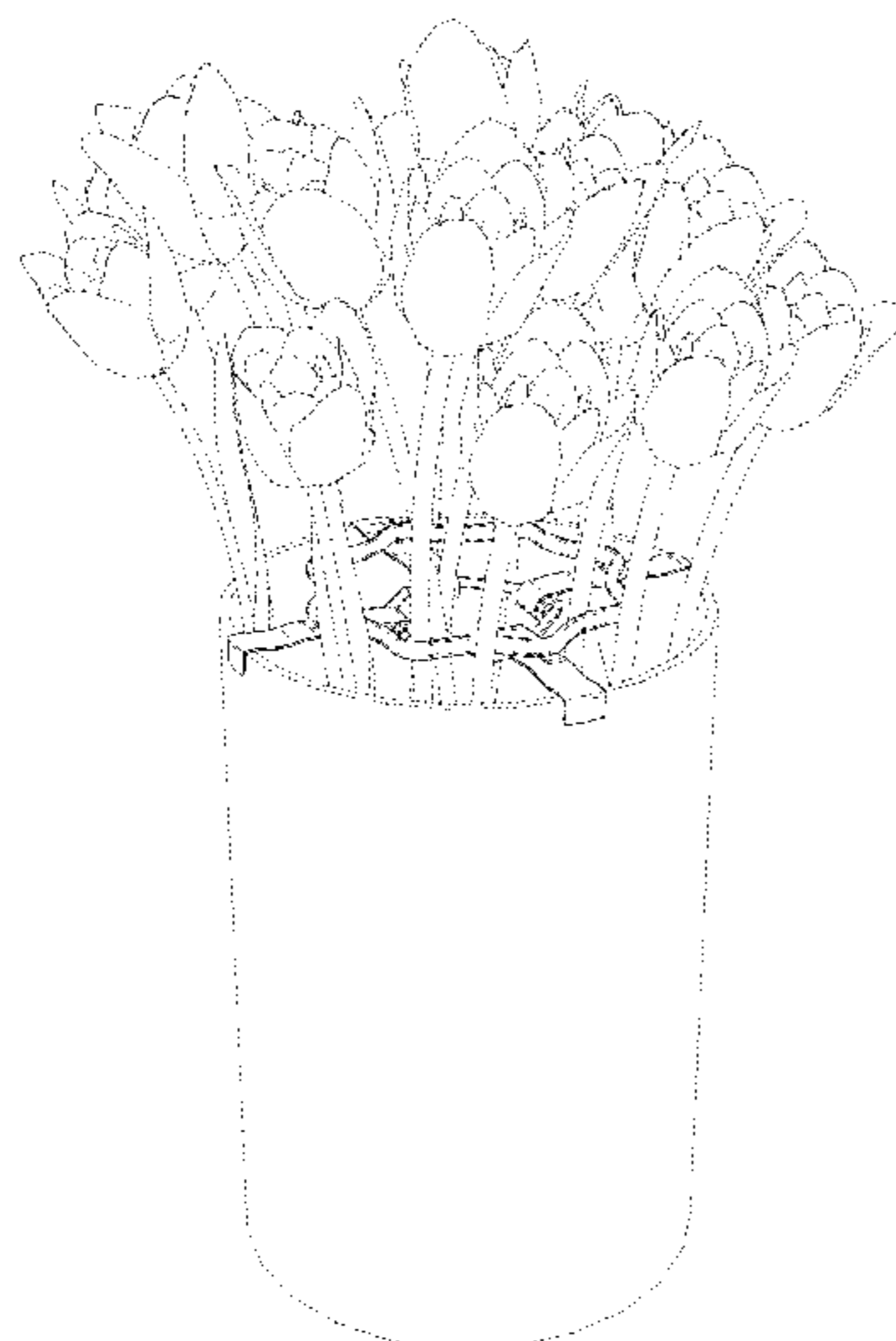
FIG. 4 is a side view of the vase brace of FIG. 1.

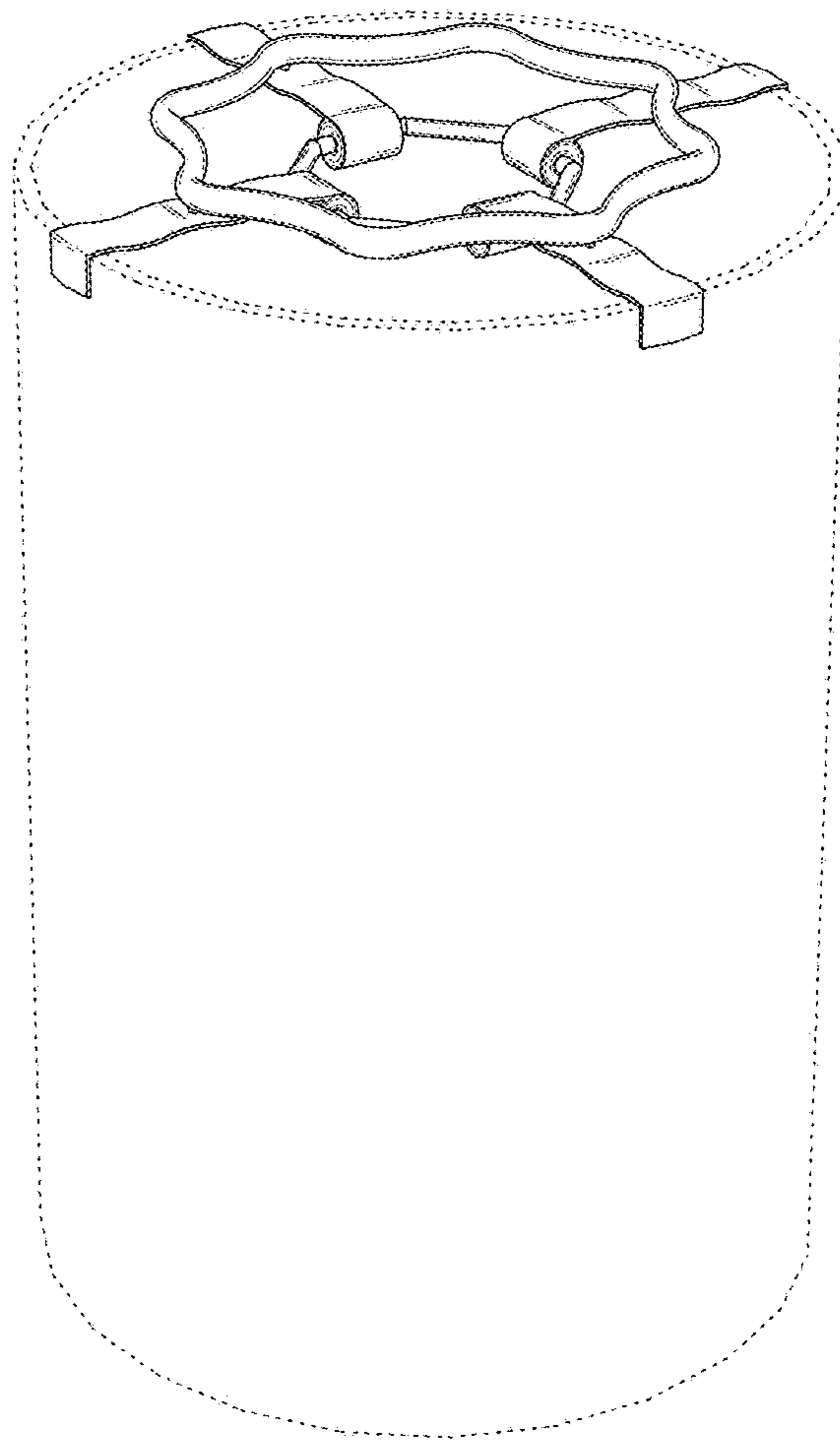
FIG. 5 is a top view of the vase brace of FIG. 1; and,

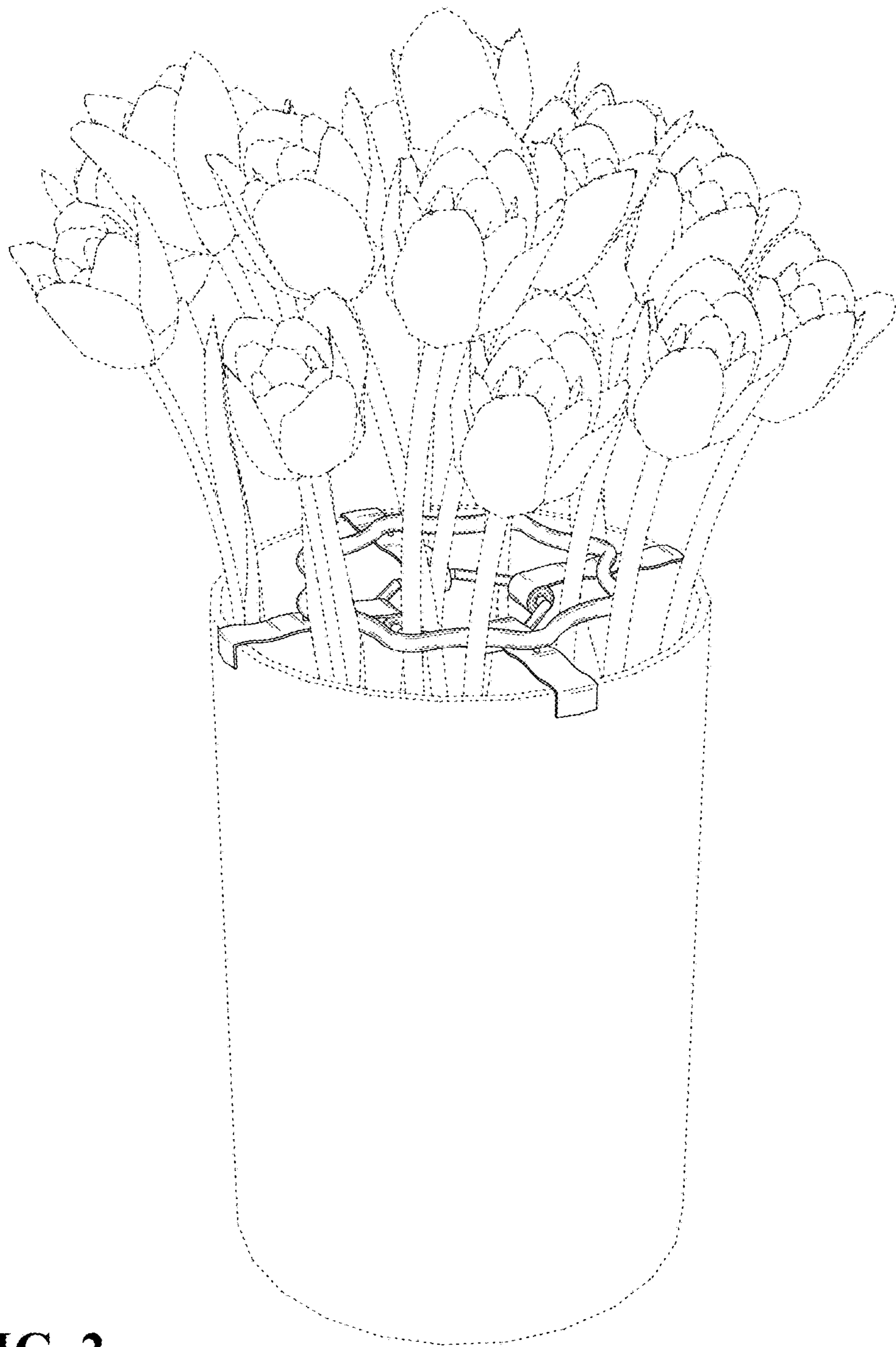

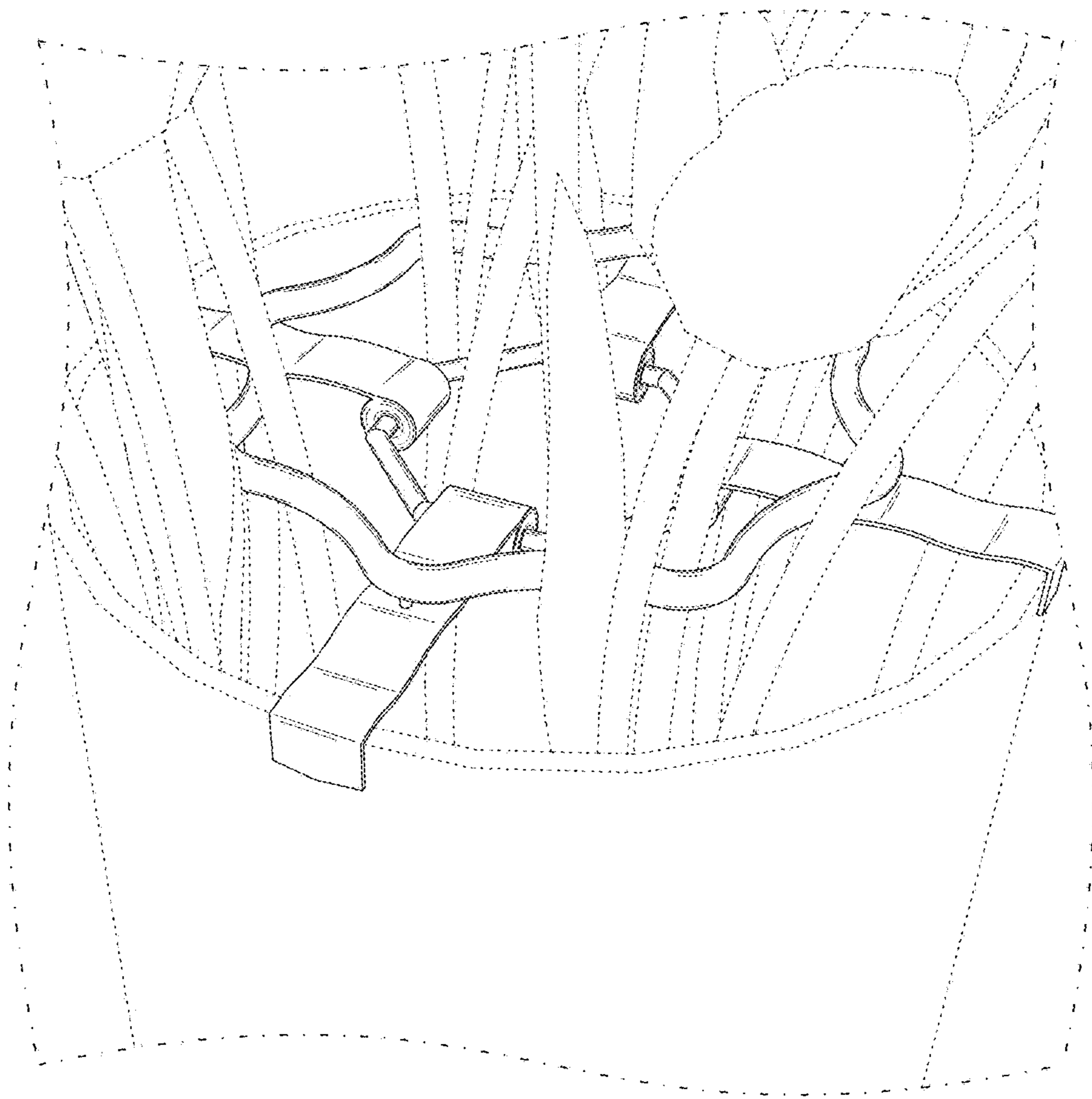




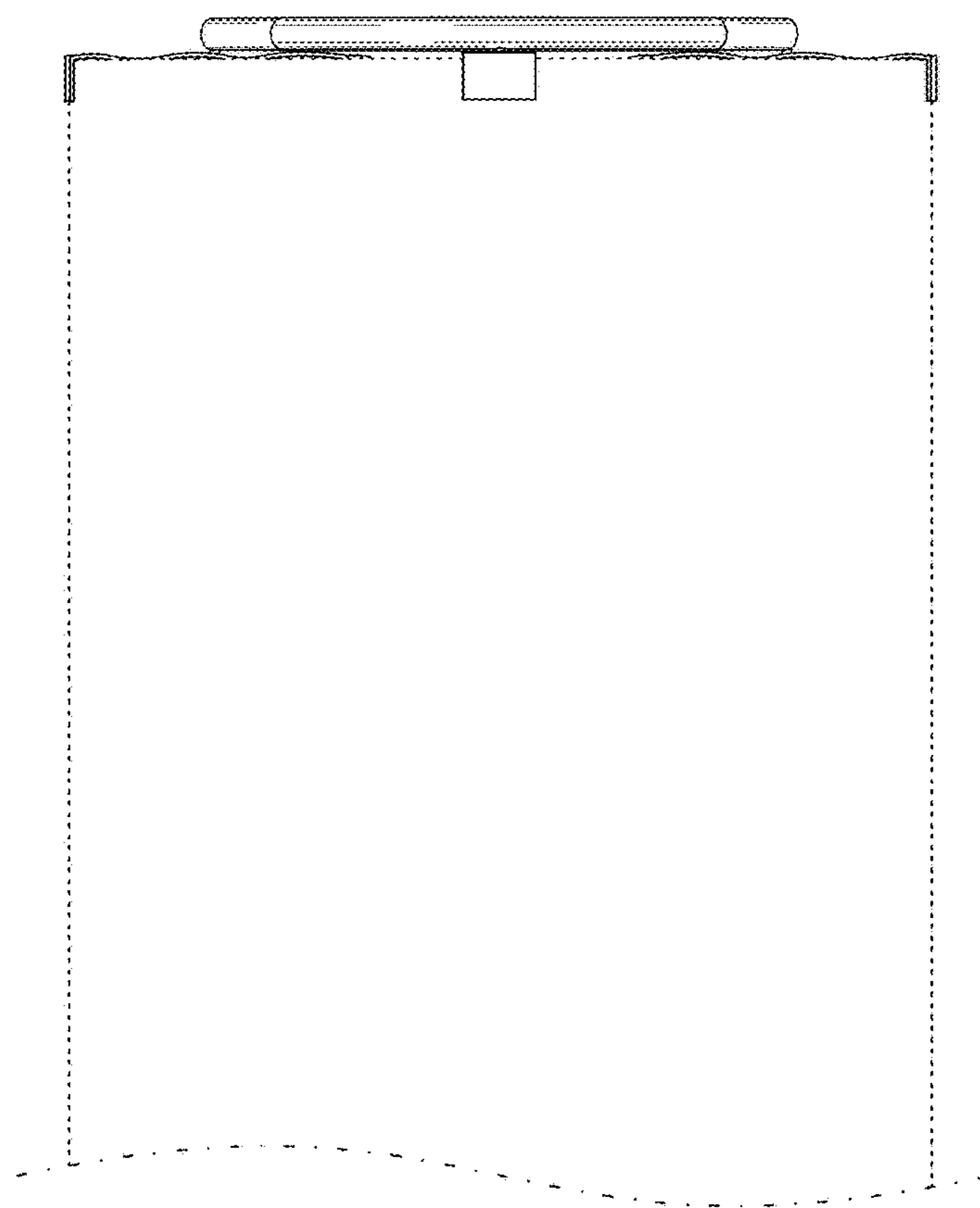

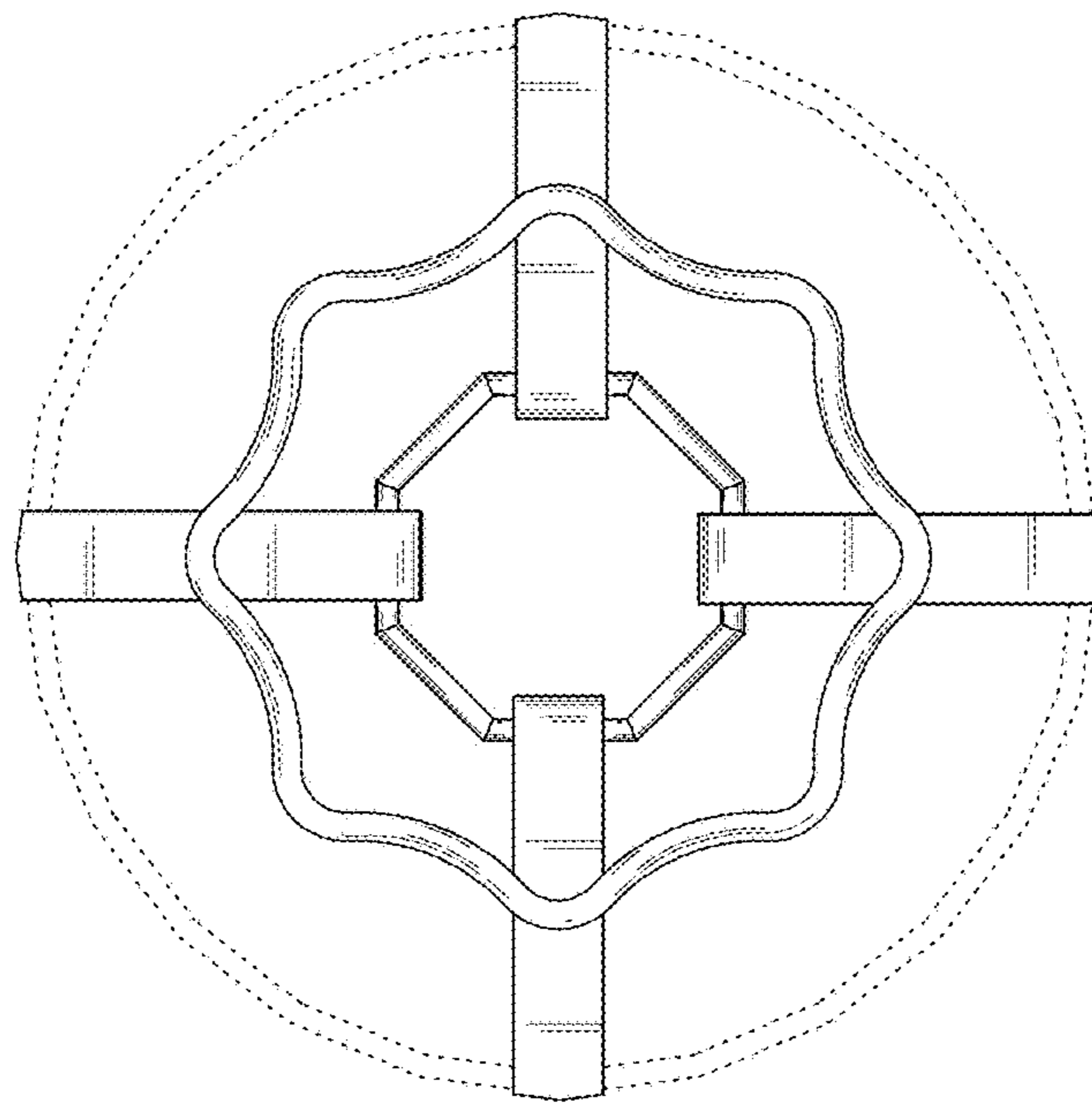

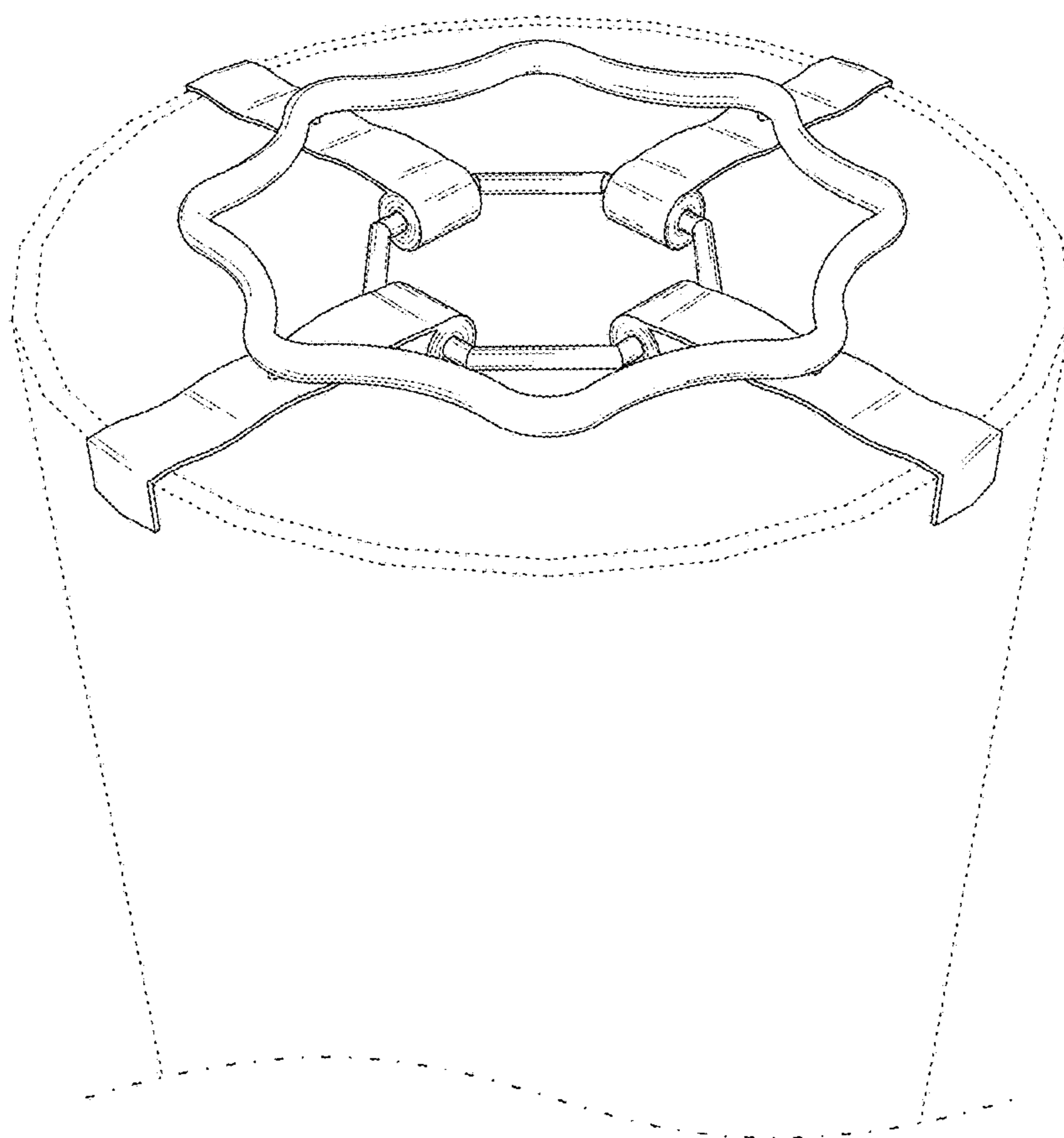
