DESCRIPTION

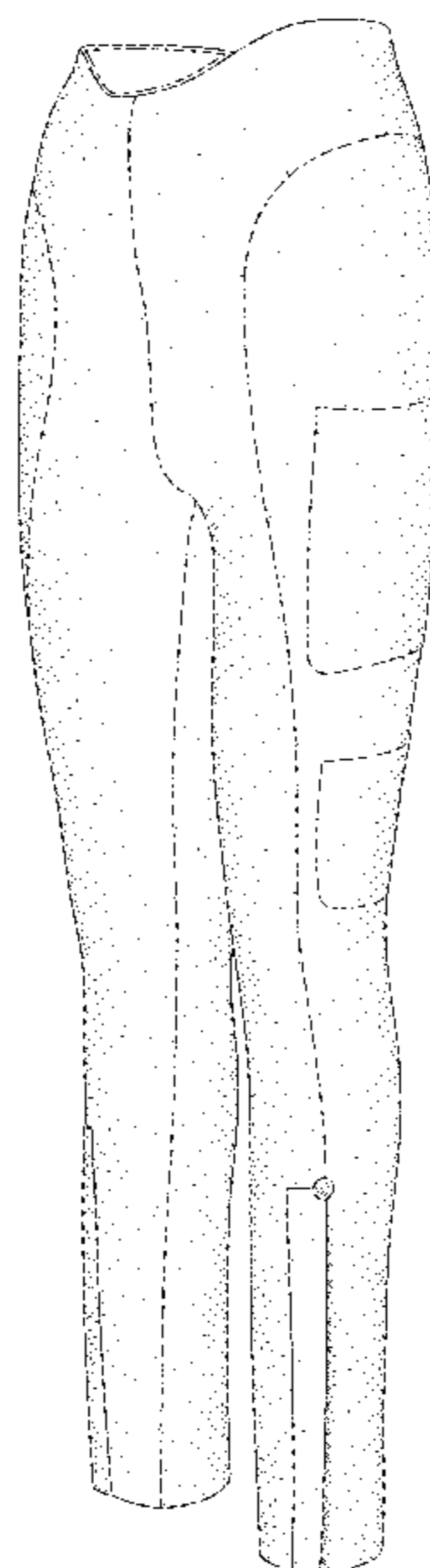
FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a garment showing my design;

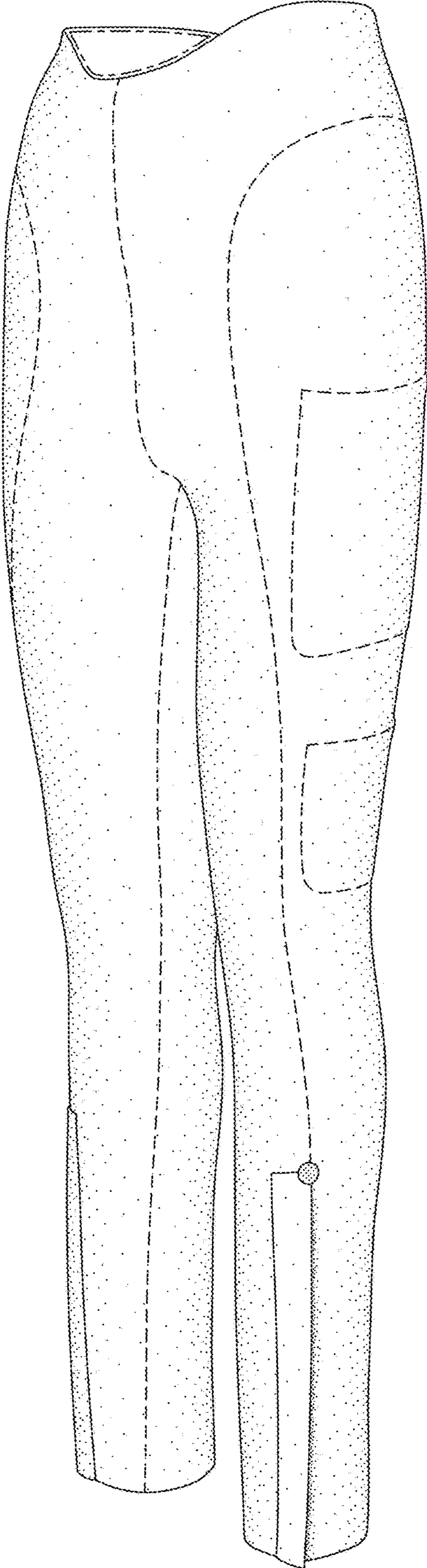

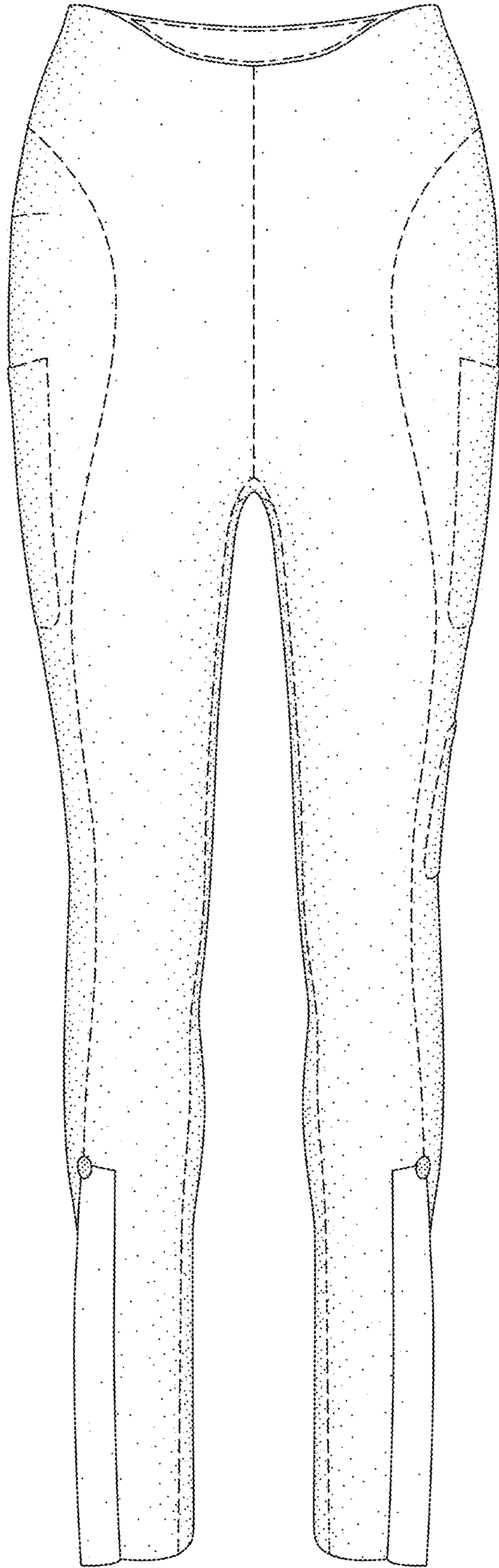

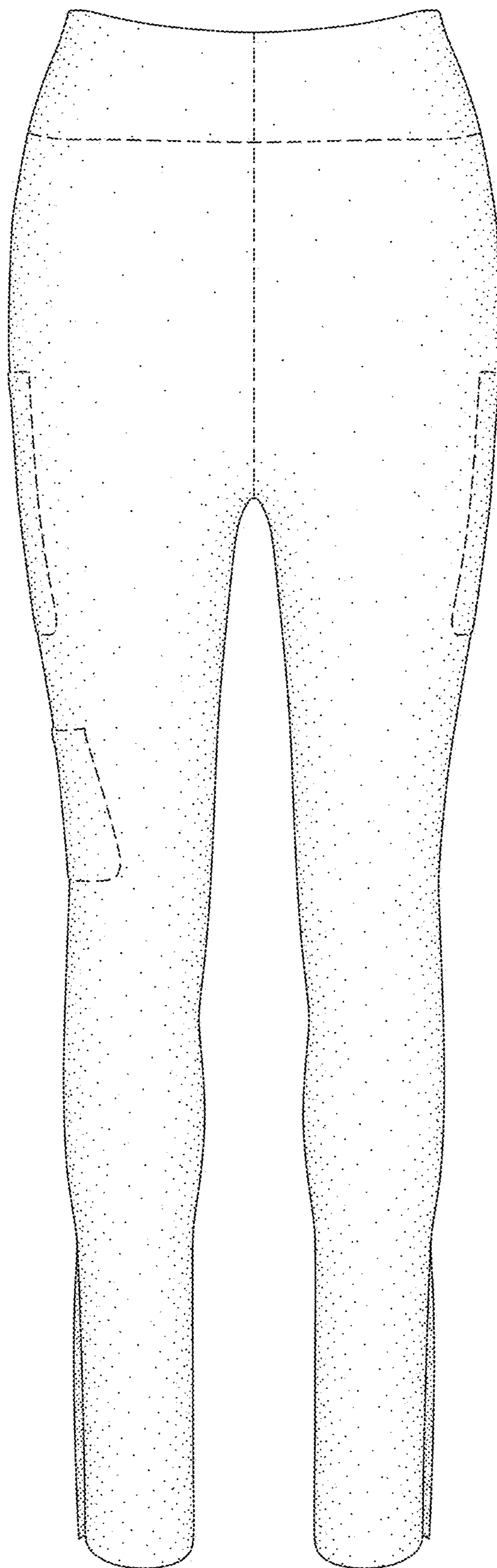

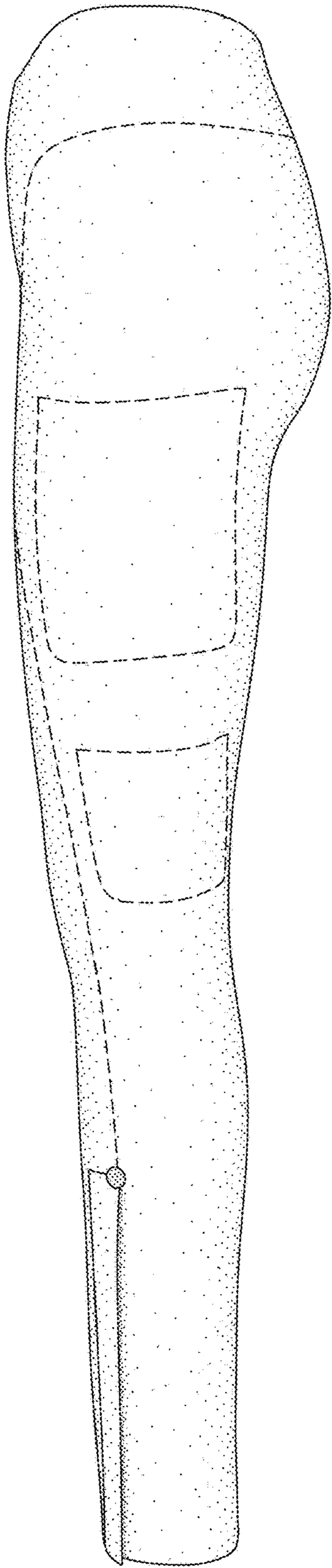

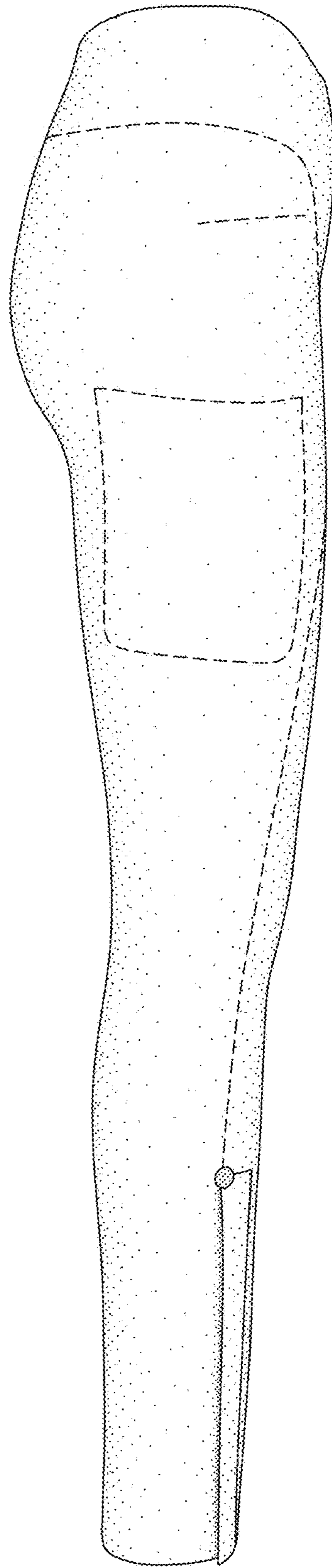

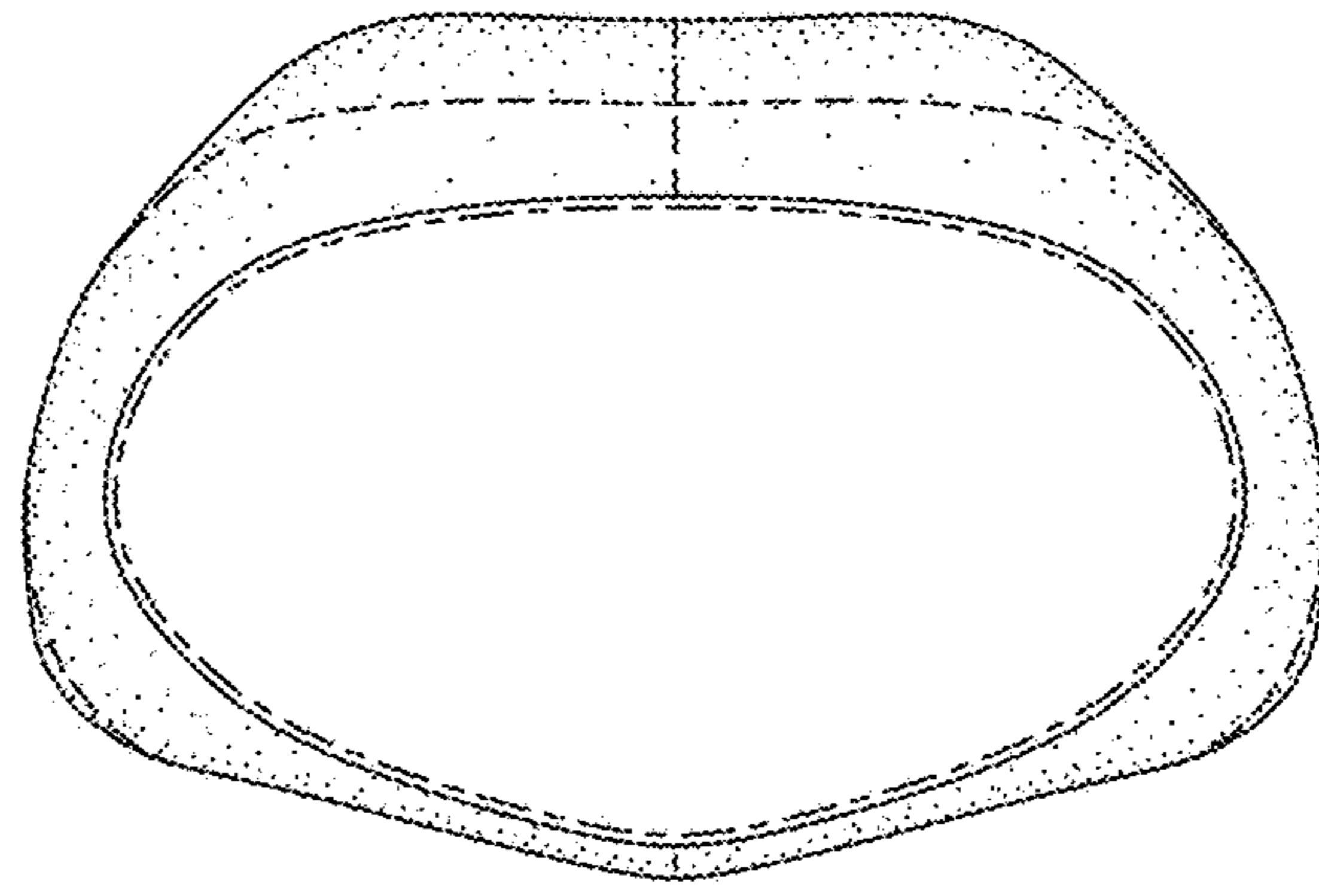

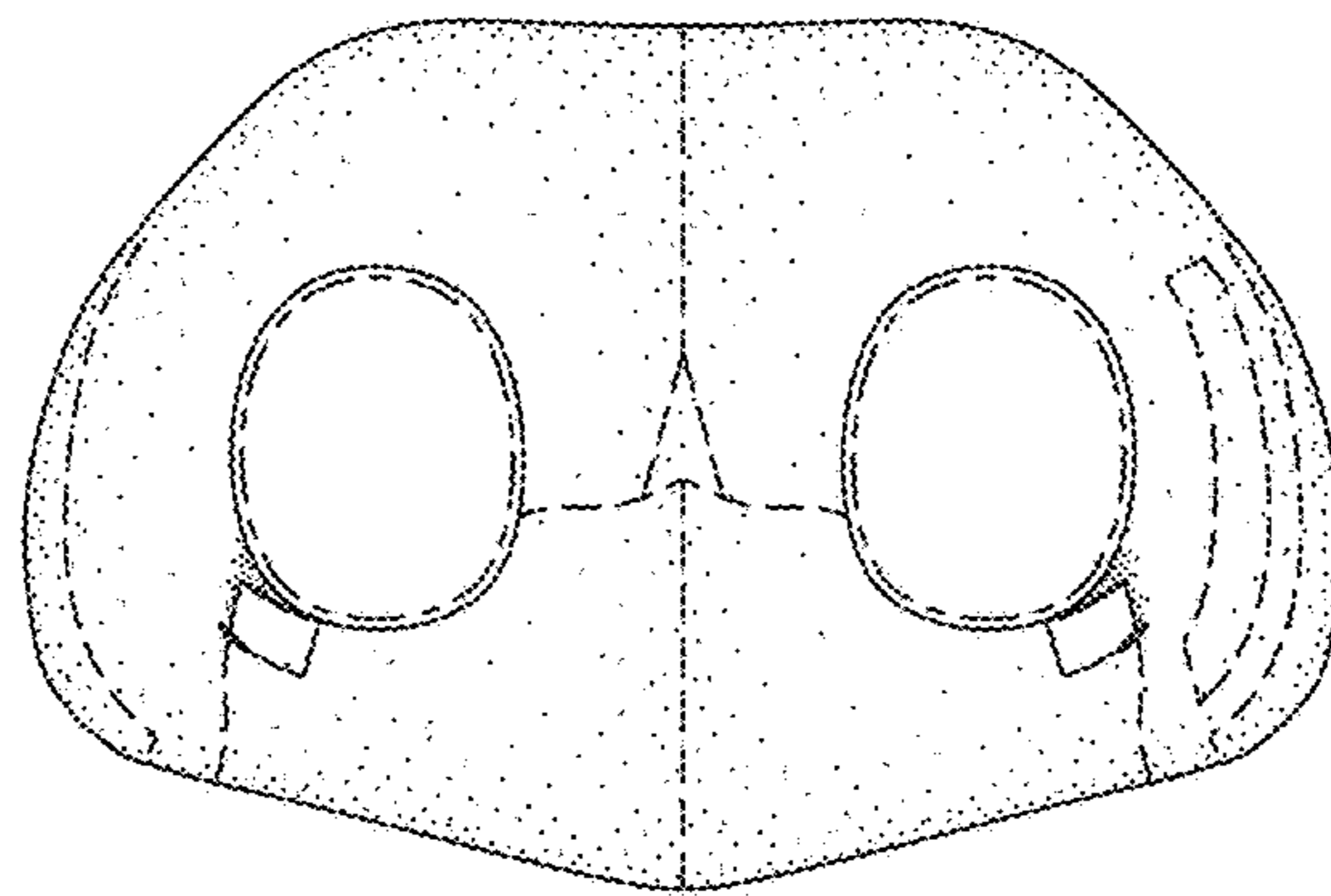
