(57) **CLAIM**

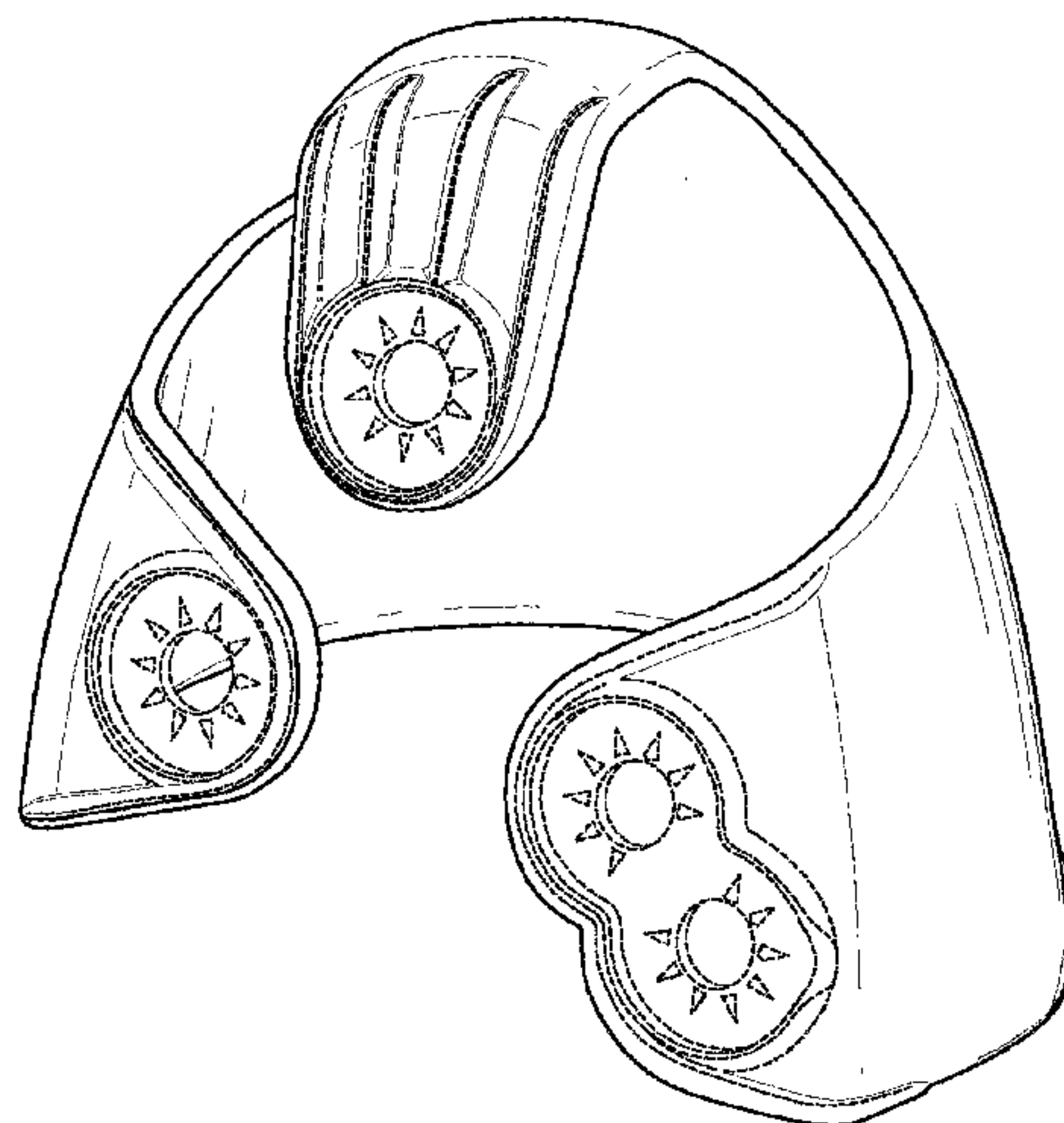
The ornamental design for a toe protector for athletic footwear having removable cleats, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a toe protector for athletic footwear having removable cleats, showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 5 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 6 is a front view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a rear view thereof.

The broken lines illustrate portions of the toe protector that forms no part of the claimed design.

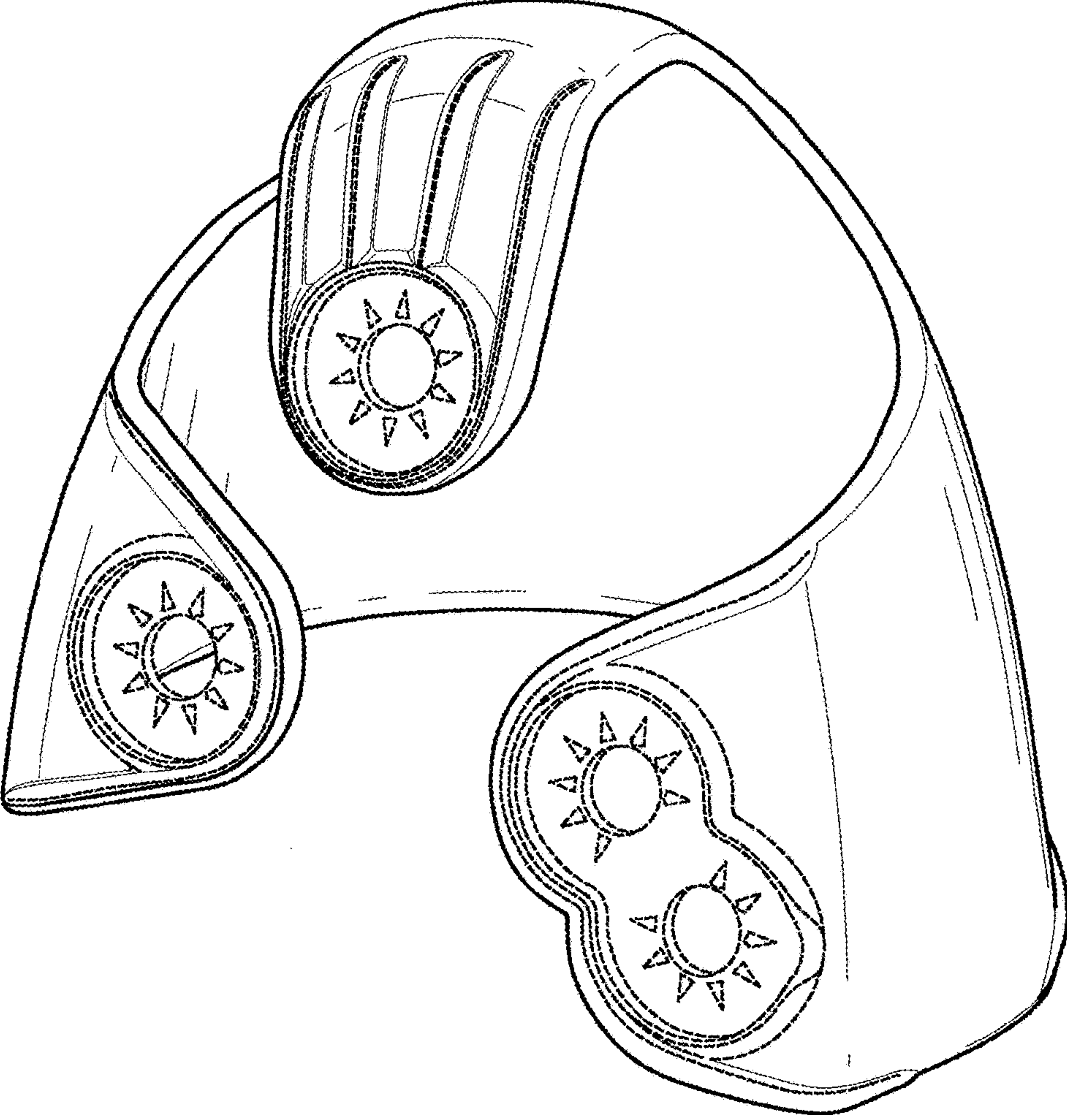

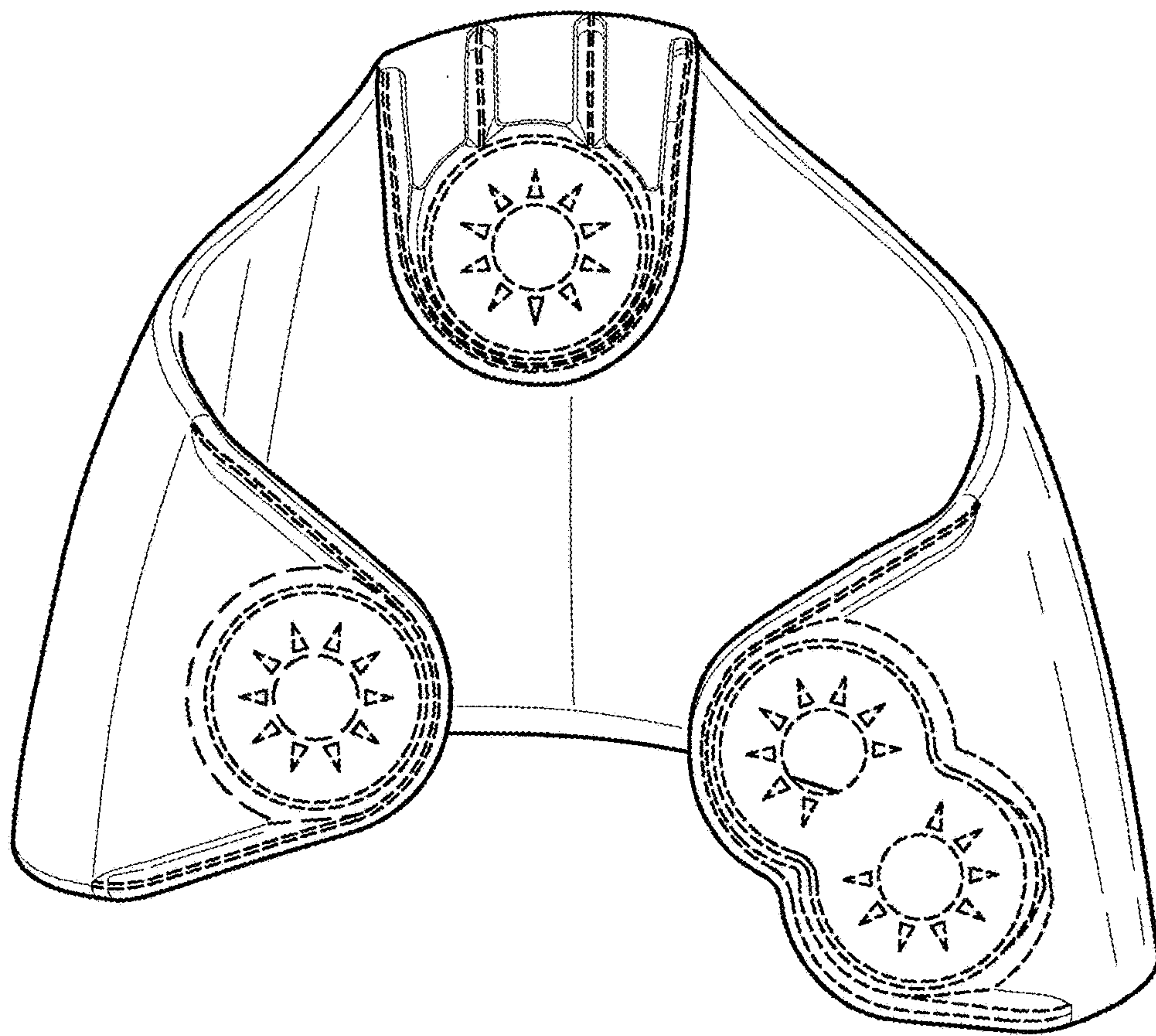

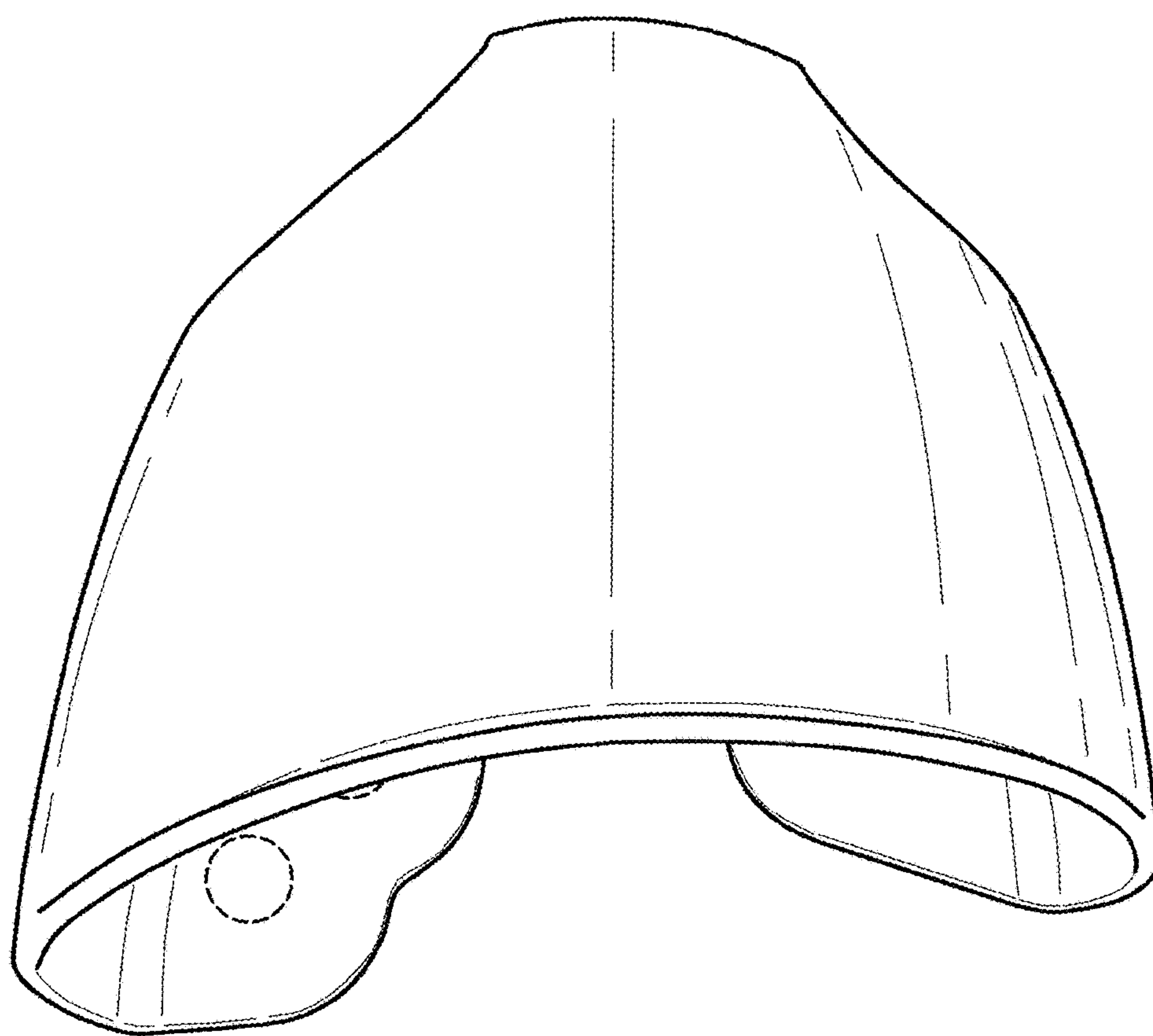

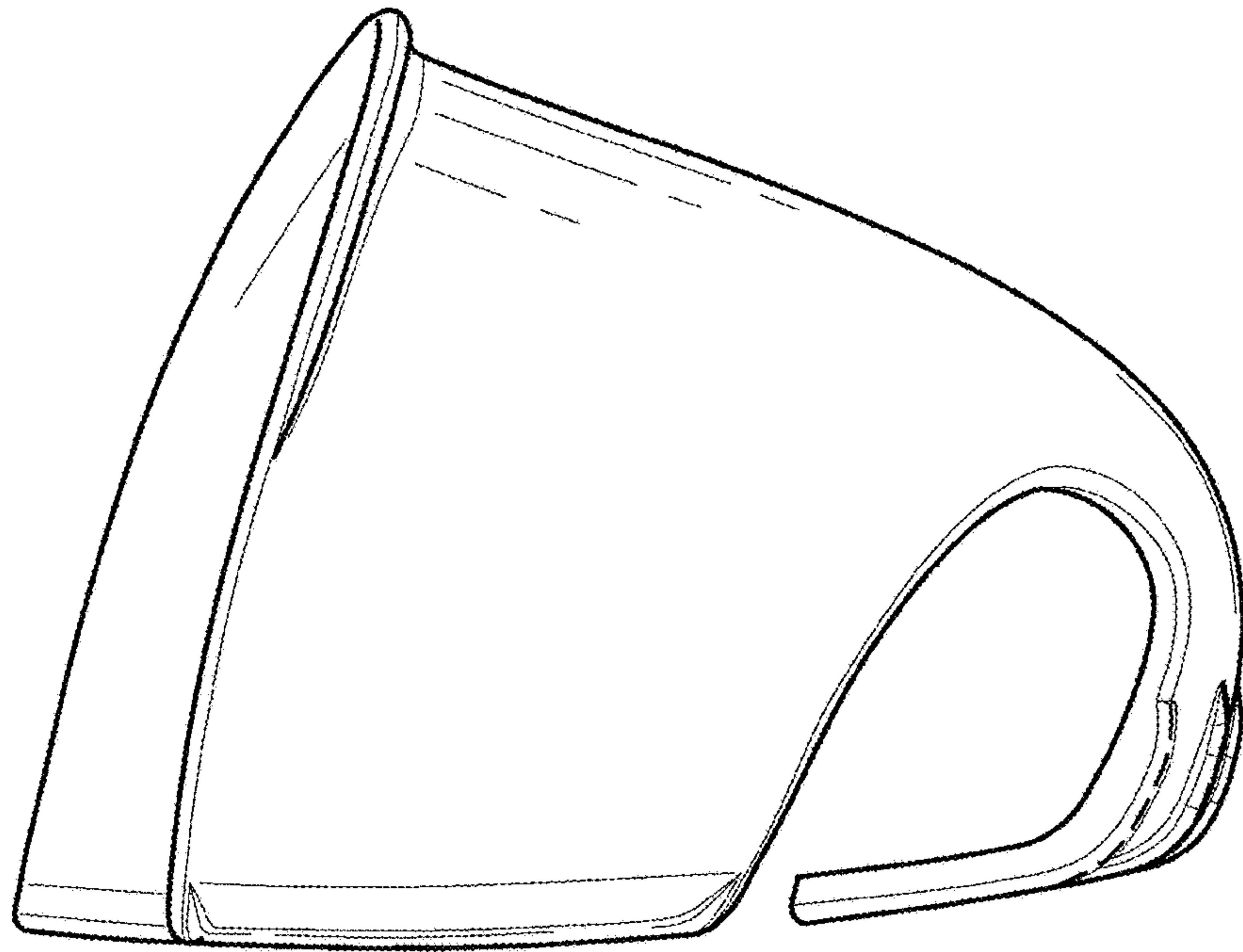

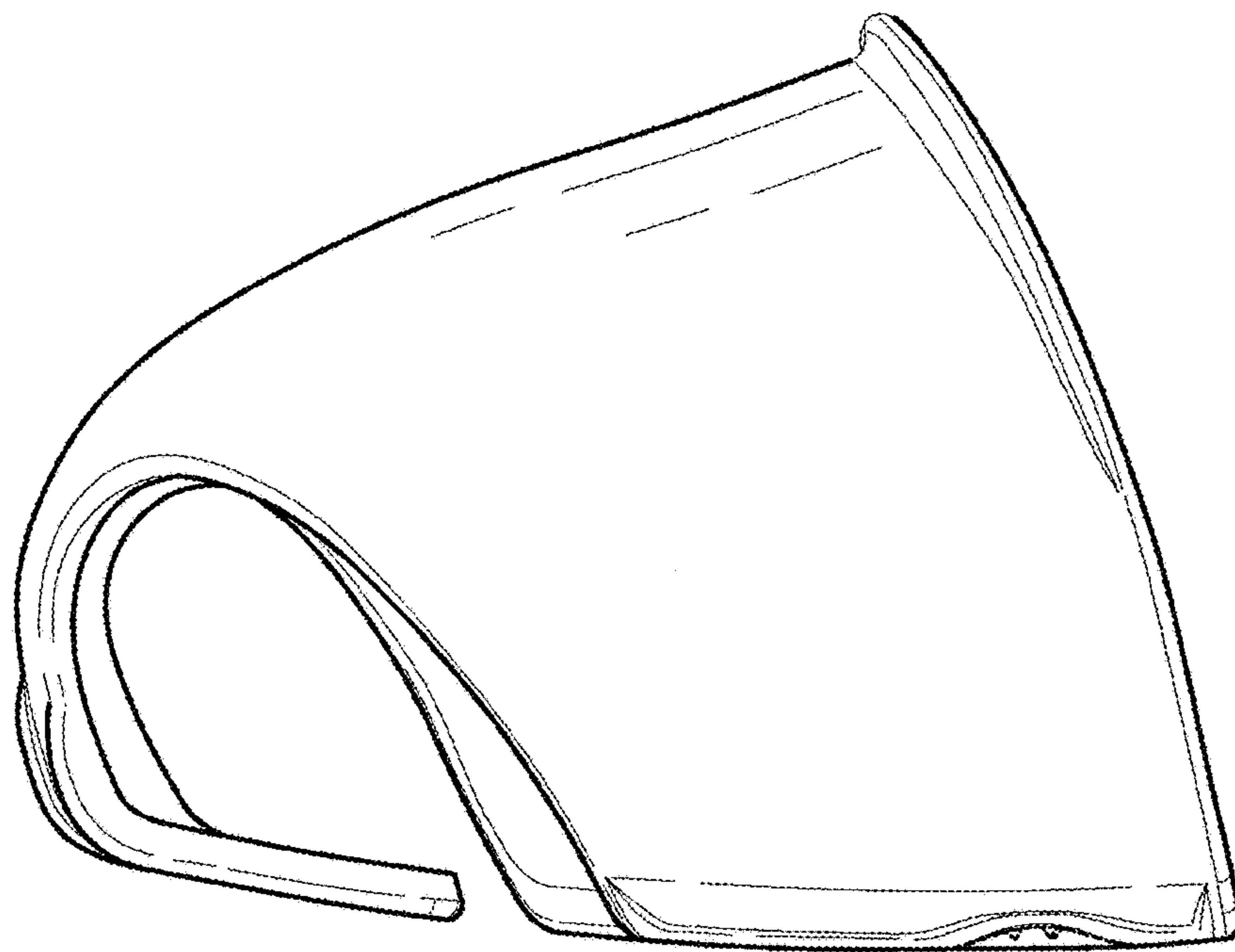

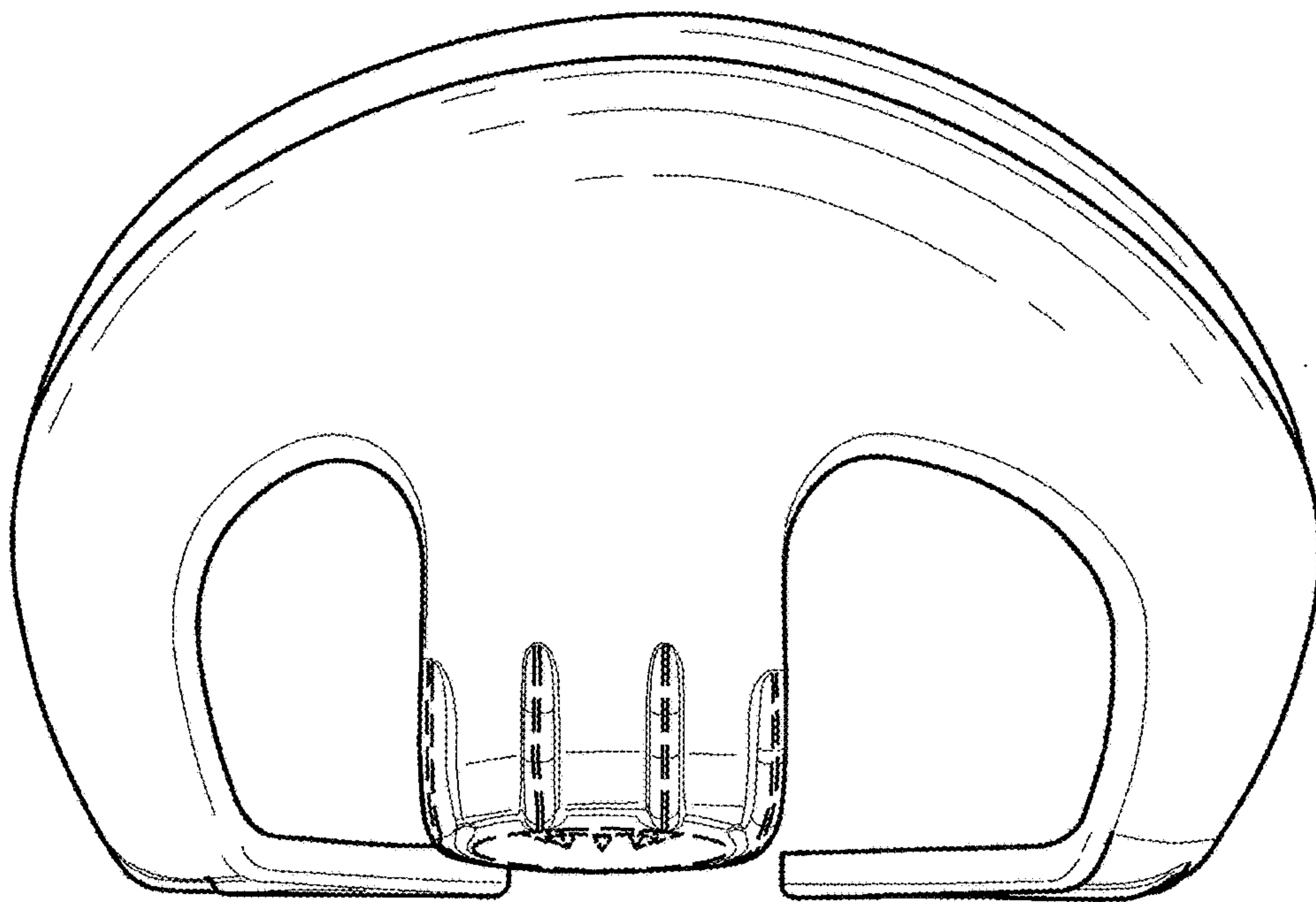

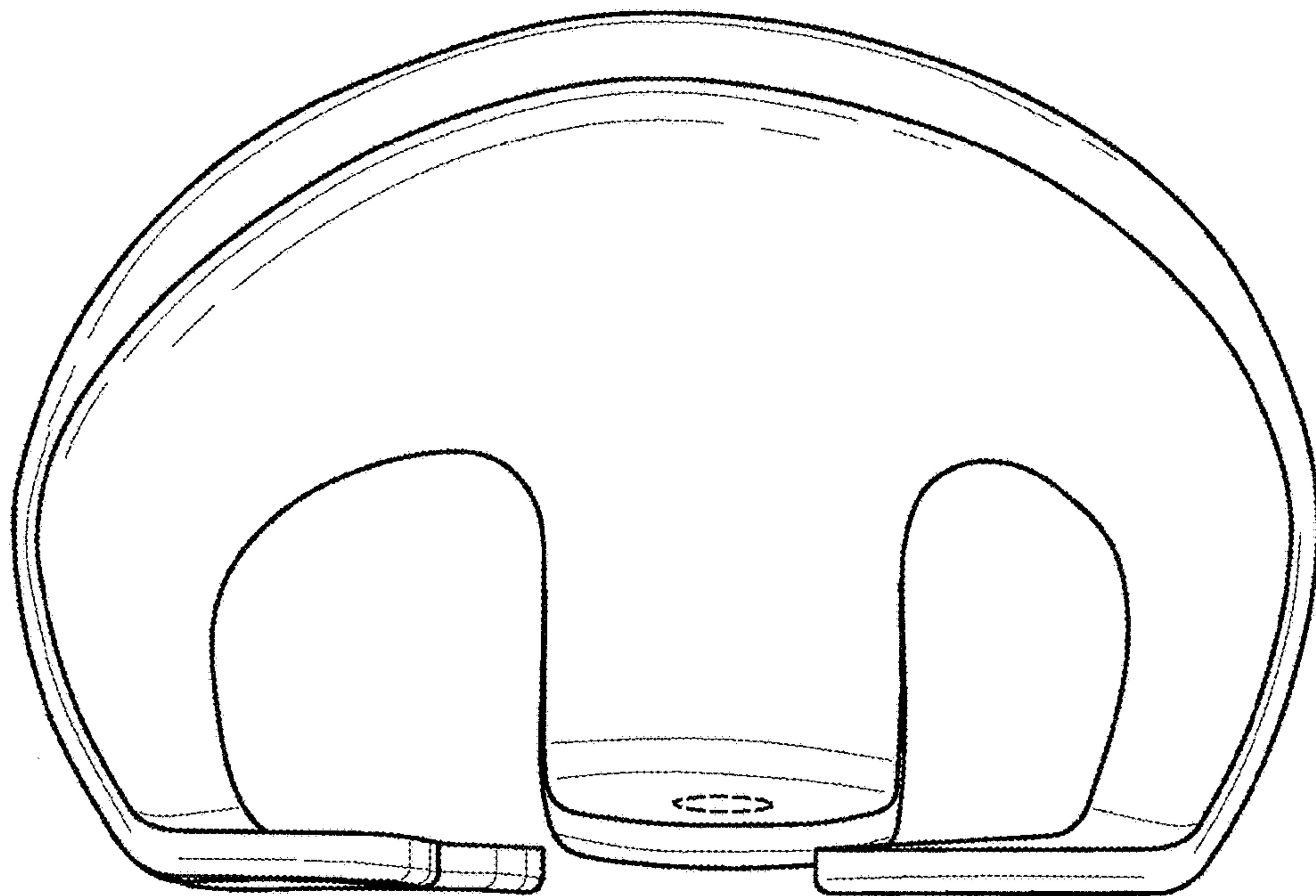
