FIG. 4 is a left-side elevational view of FIG. 2;

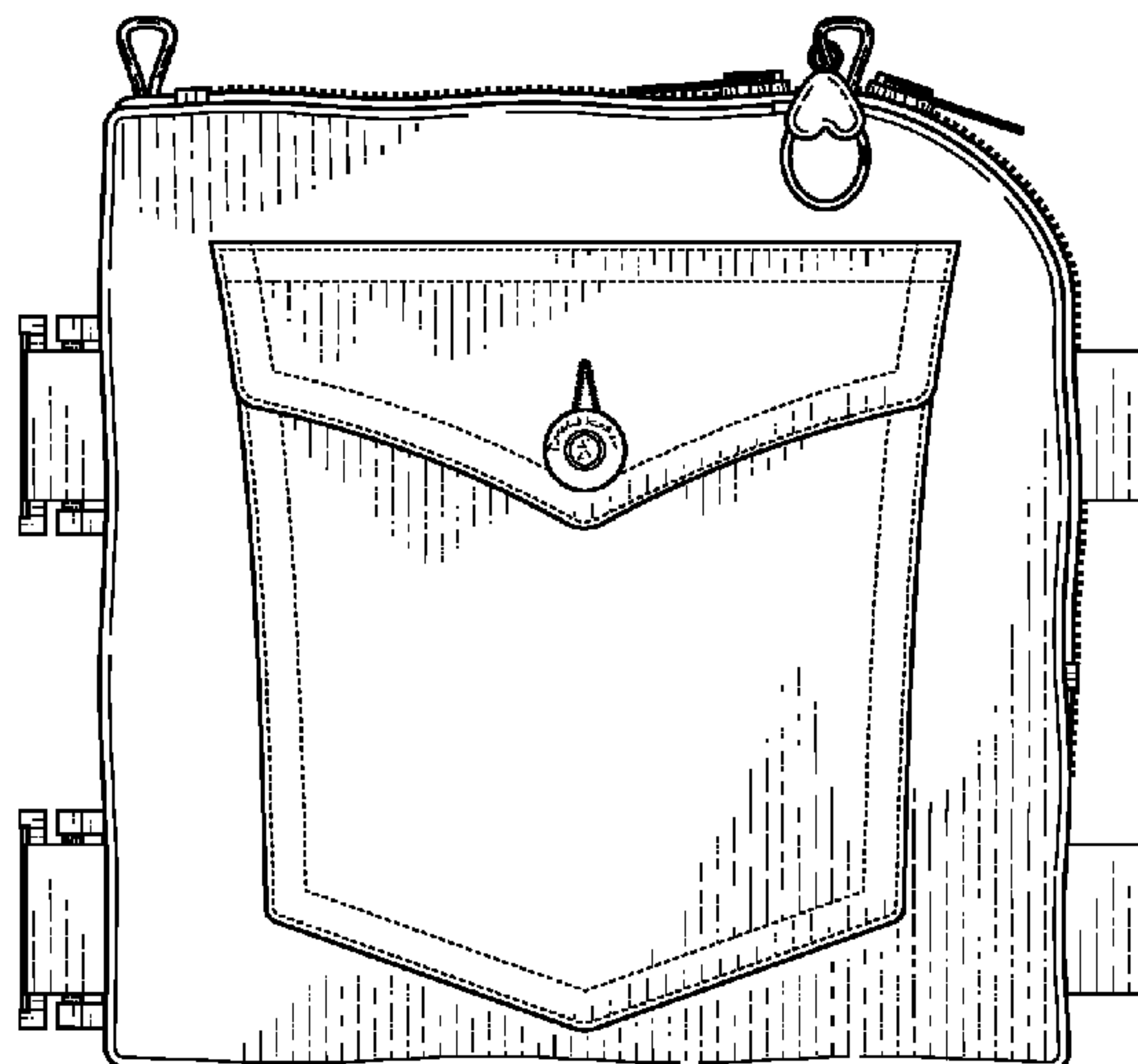
FIG. 5 is a right-side elevational view of FIG. 2;

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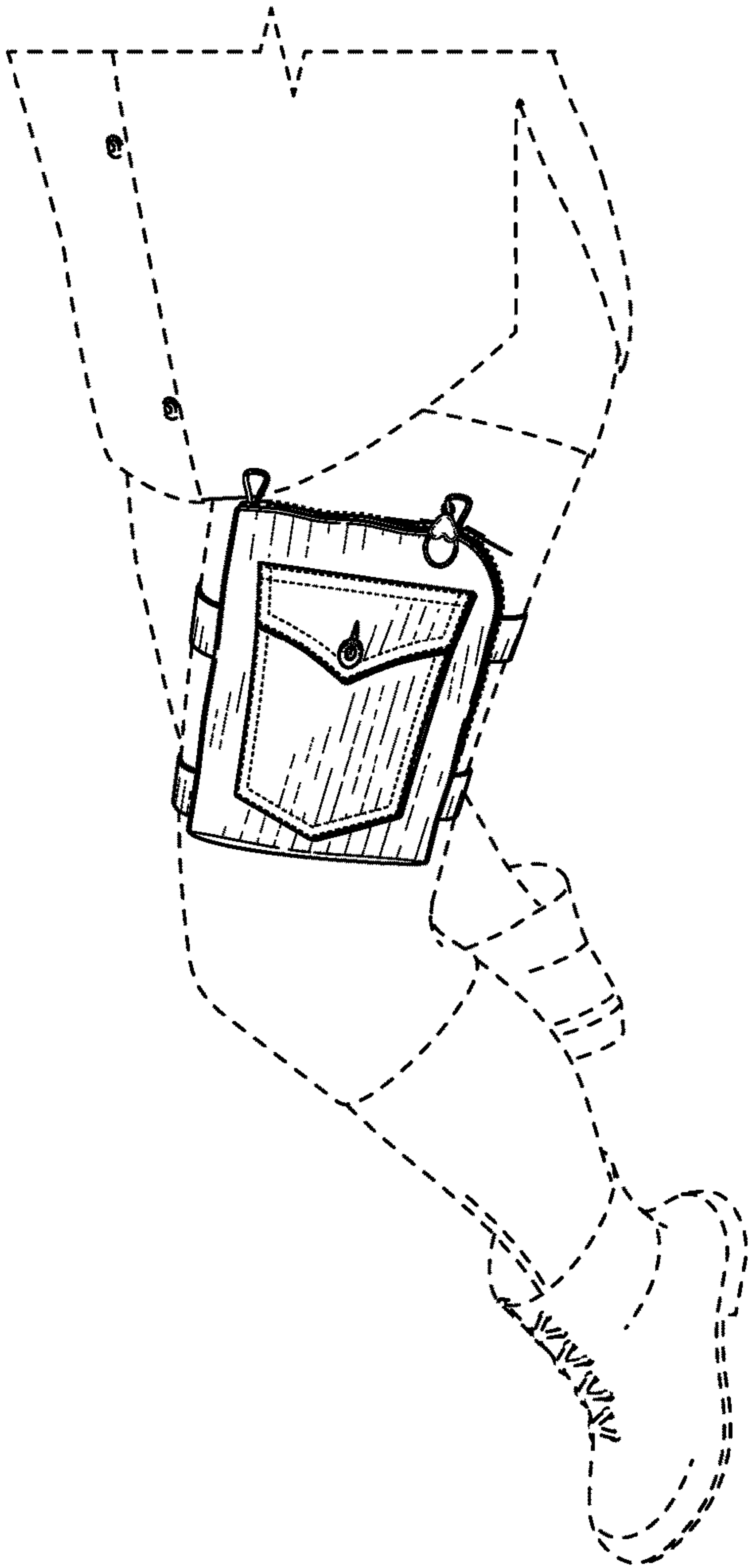

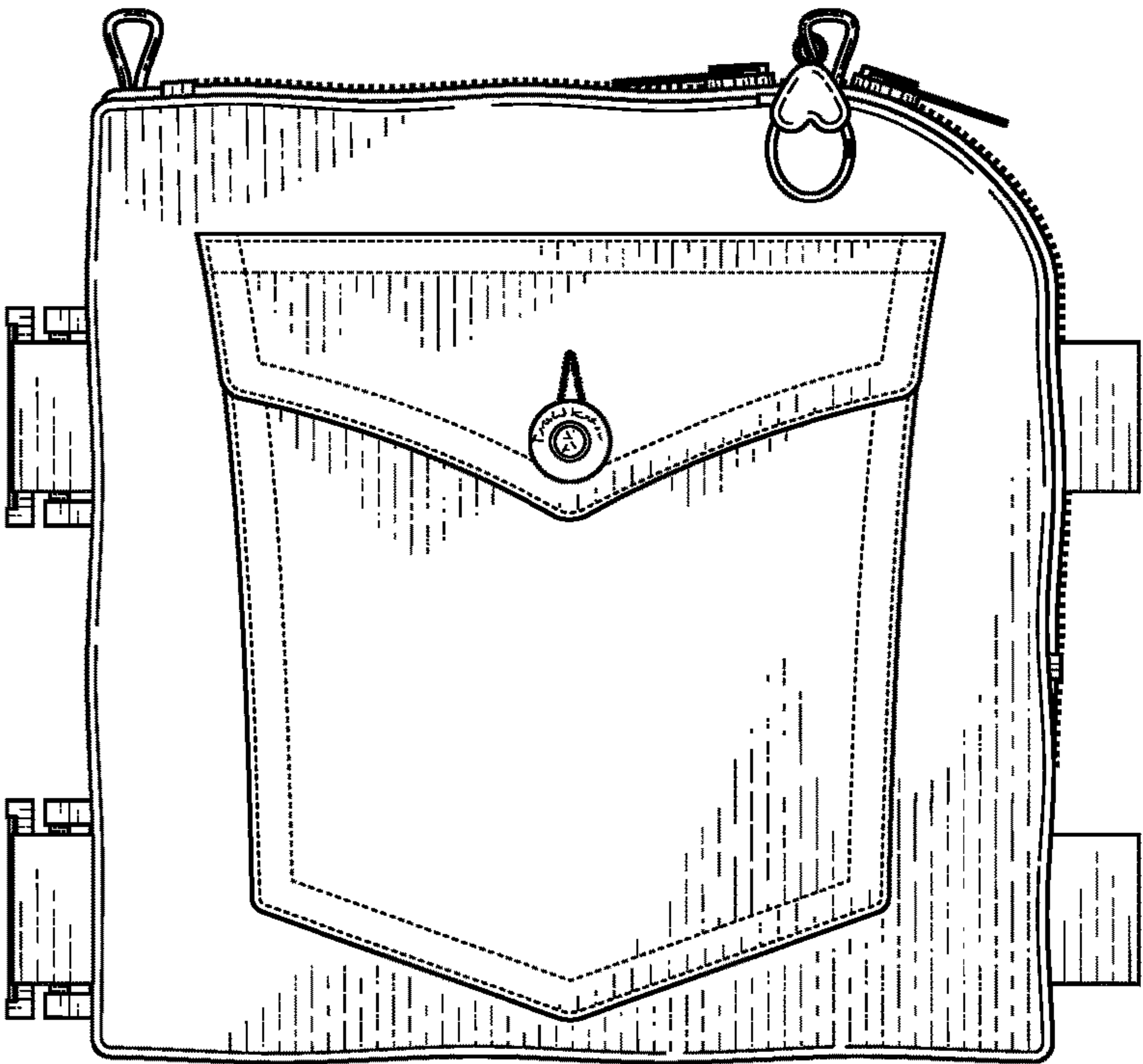

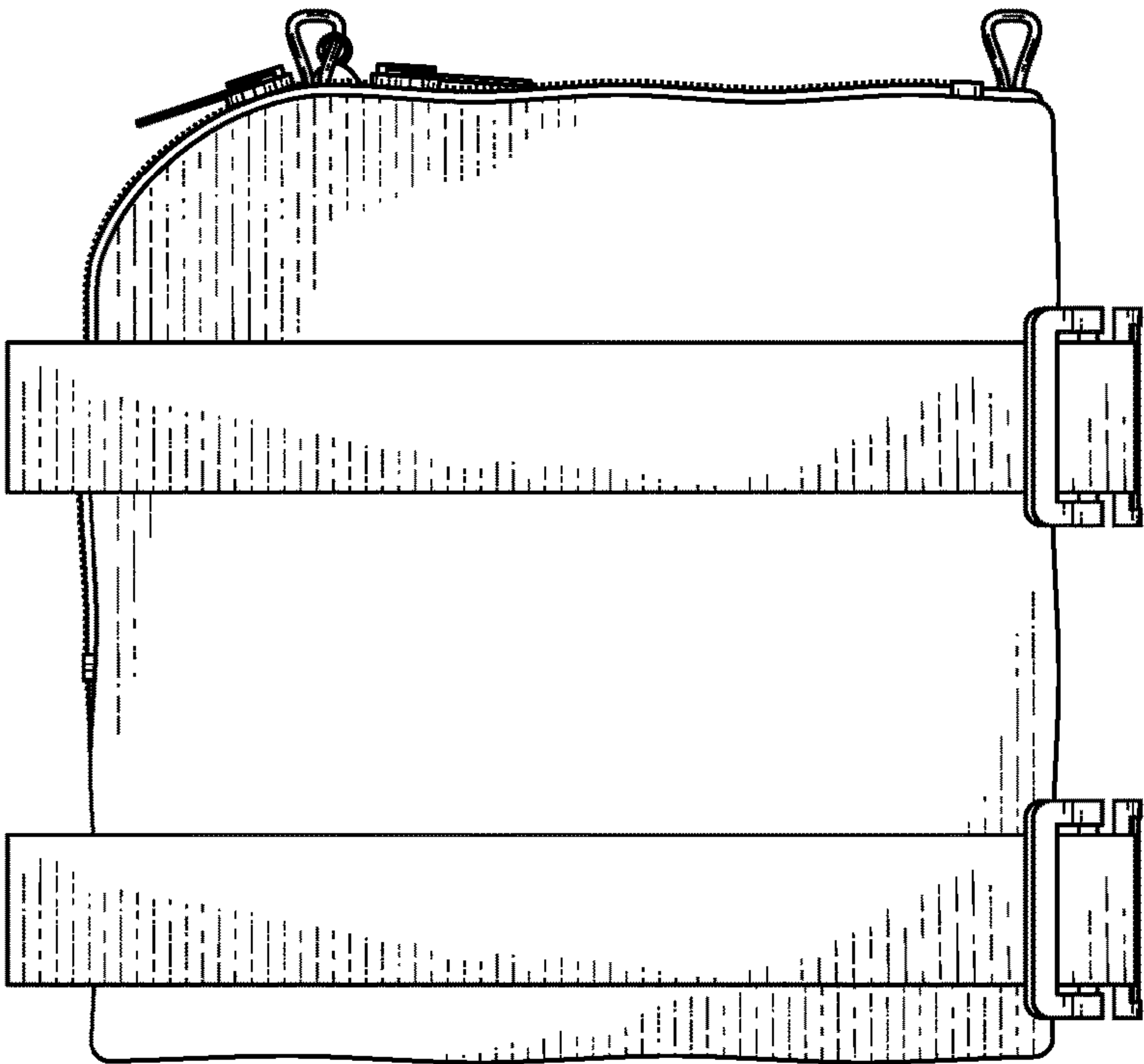

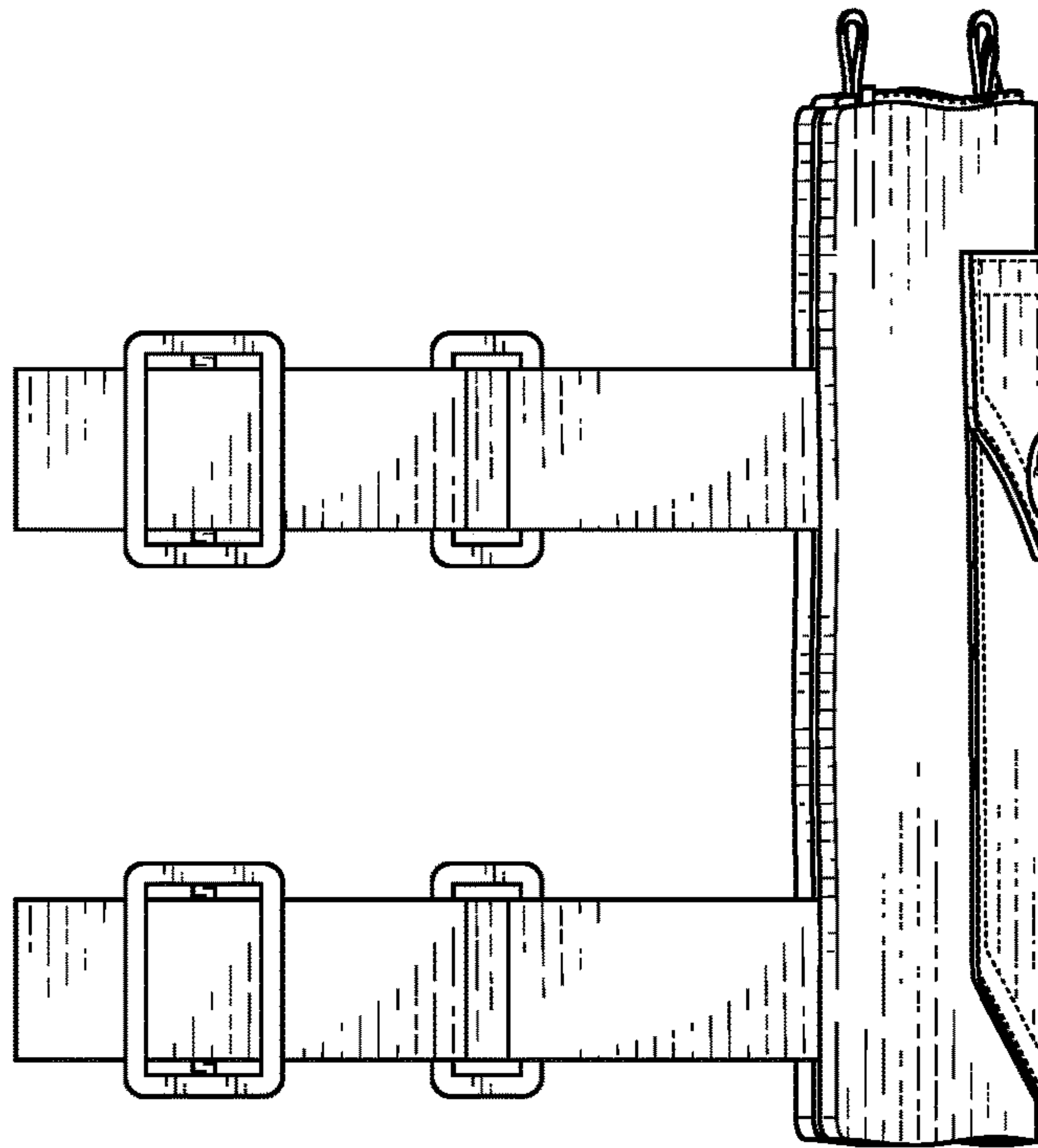

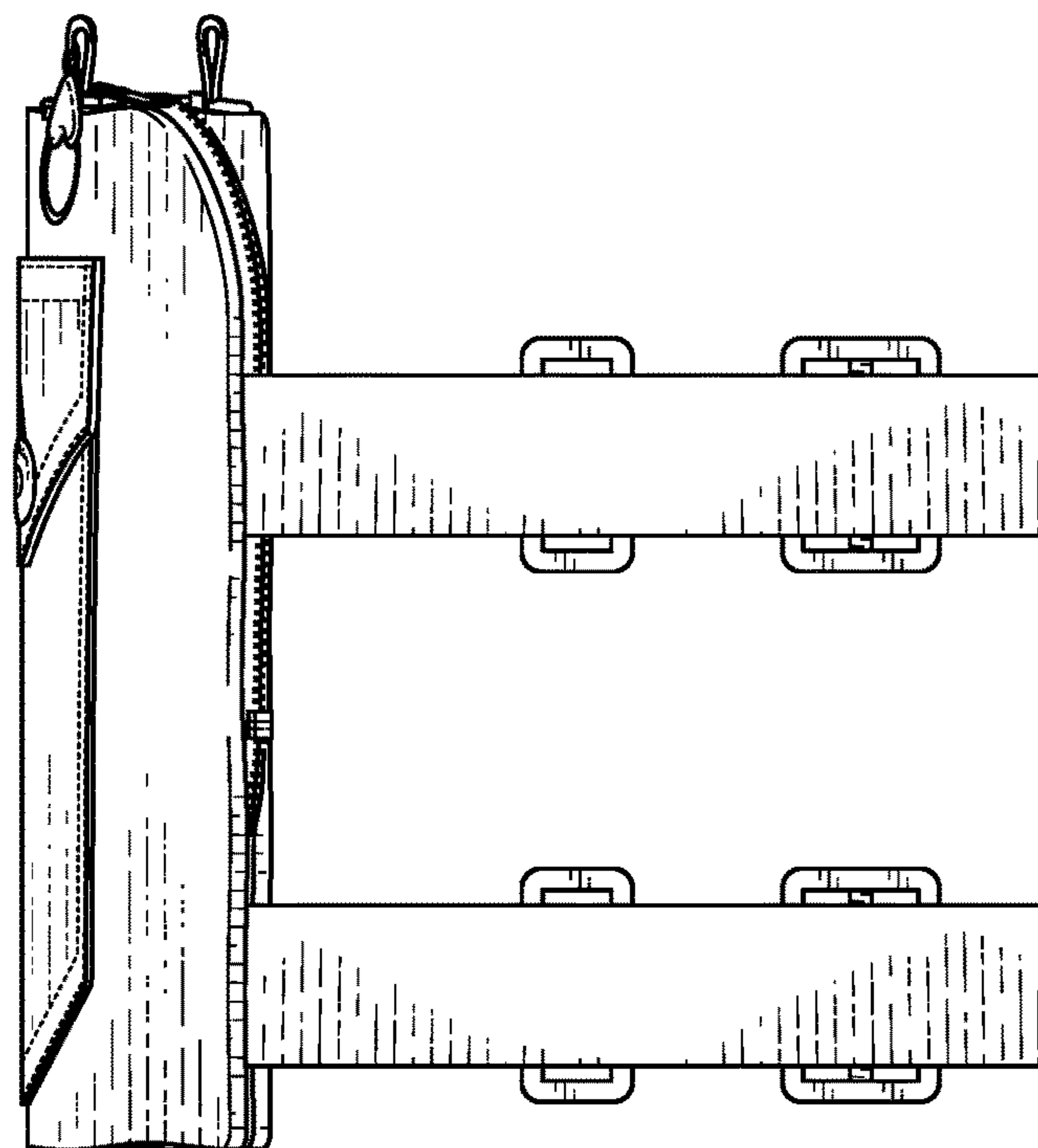

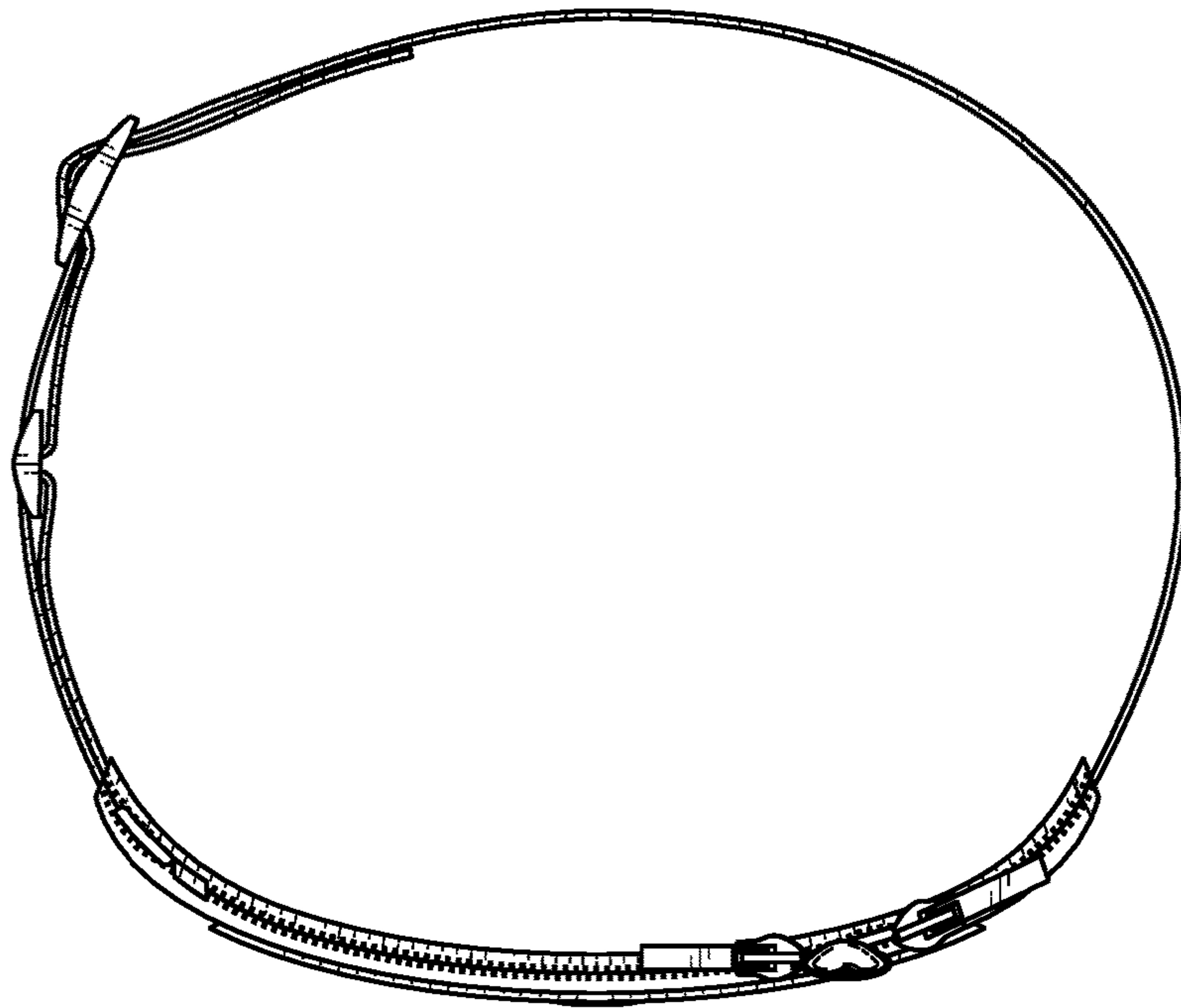

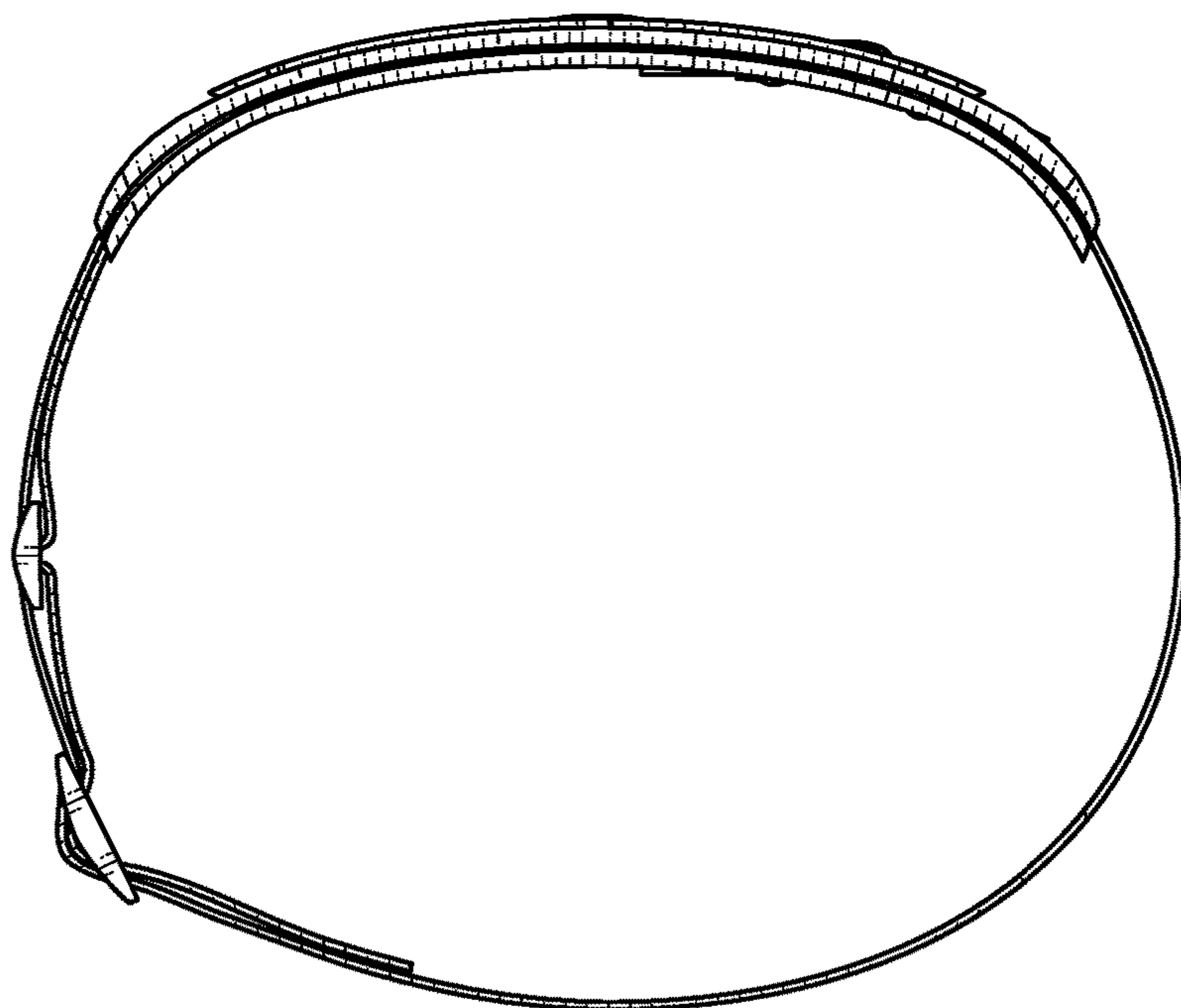
