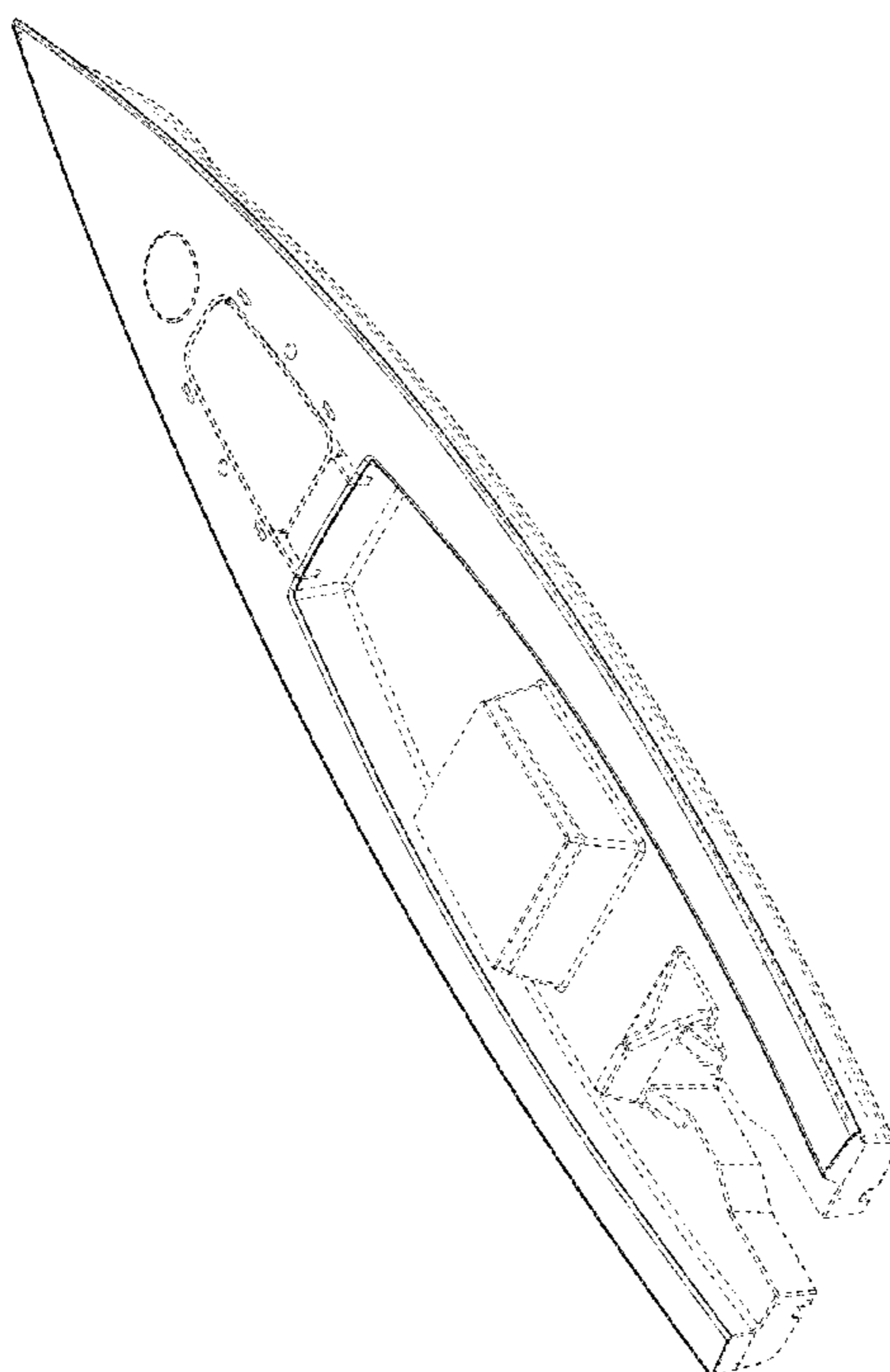
(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a deck of a vessel, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1. is a front view of a deck of a vessel according to the invention; and
FIG. 2. is a first top perspective view of the deck of a vessel of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 3. is a second top perspective view of the deck of a vessel of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 4. is a third top perspective view of the deck of a vessel of FIG. 1; and
FIG. 5. is a fourth top perspective view of the deck of a vessel of FIG. 1; and,
FIG. 6. is a rear view of the deck of a vessel of FIG. 1.

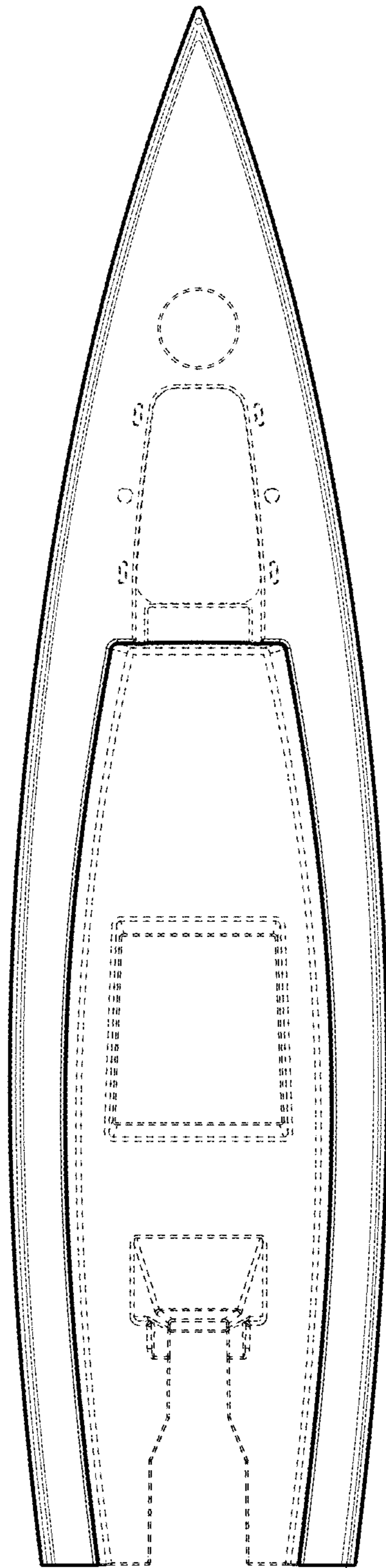

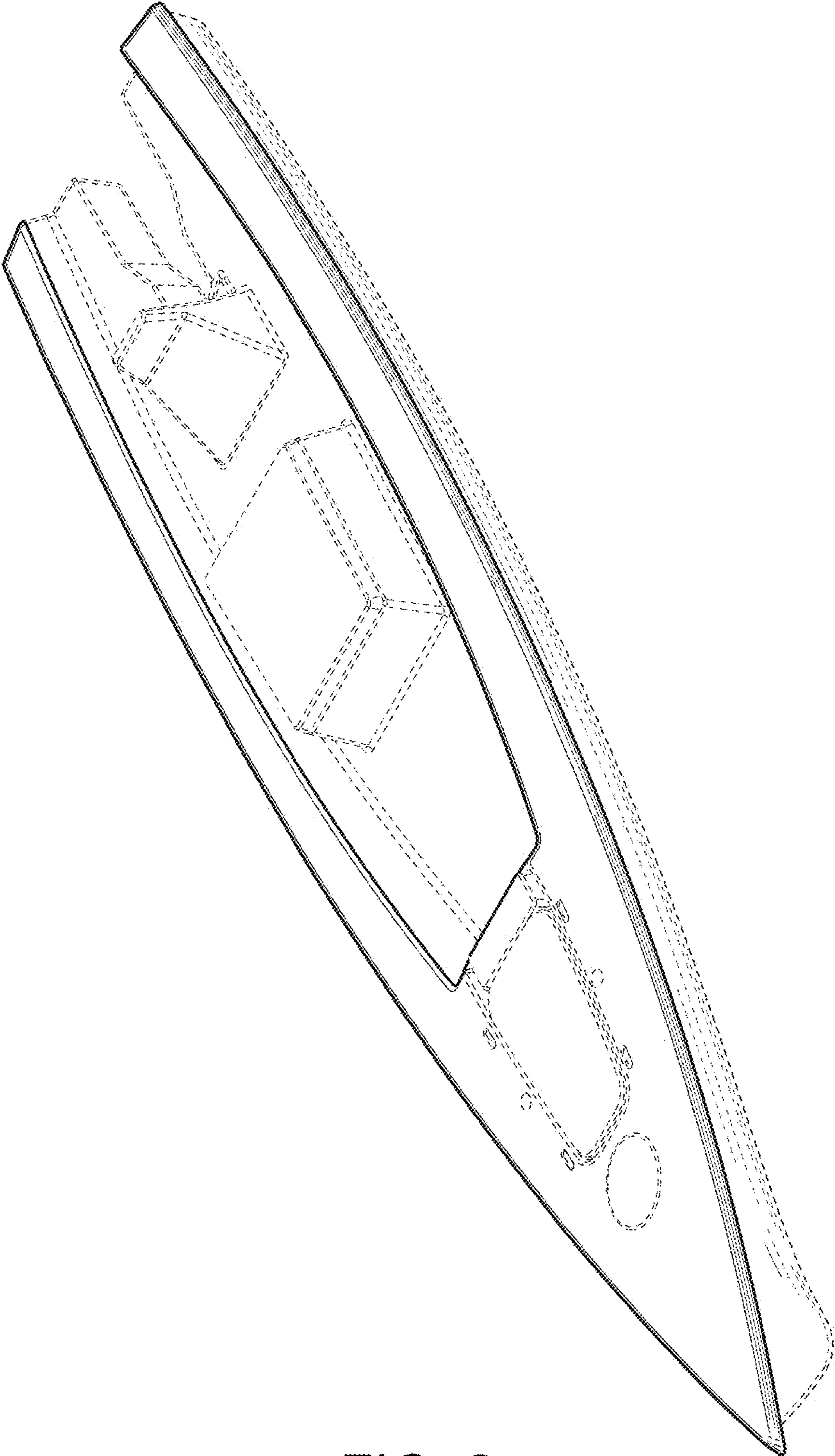

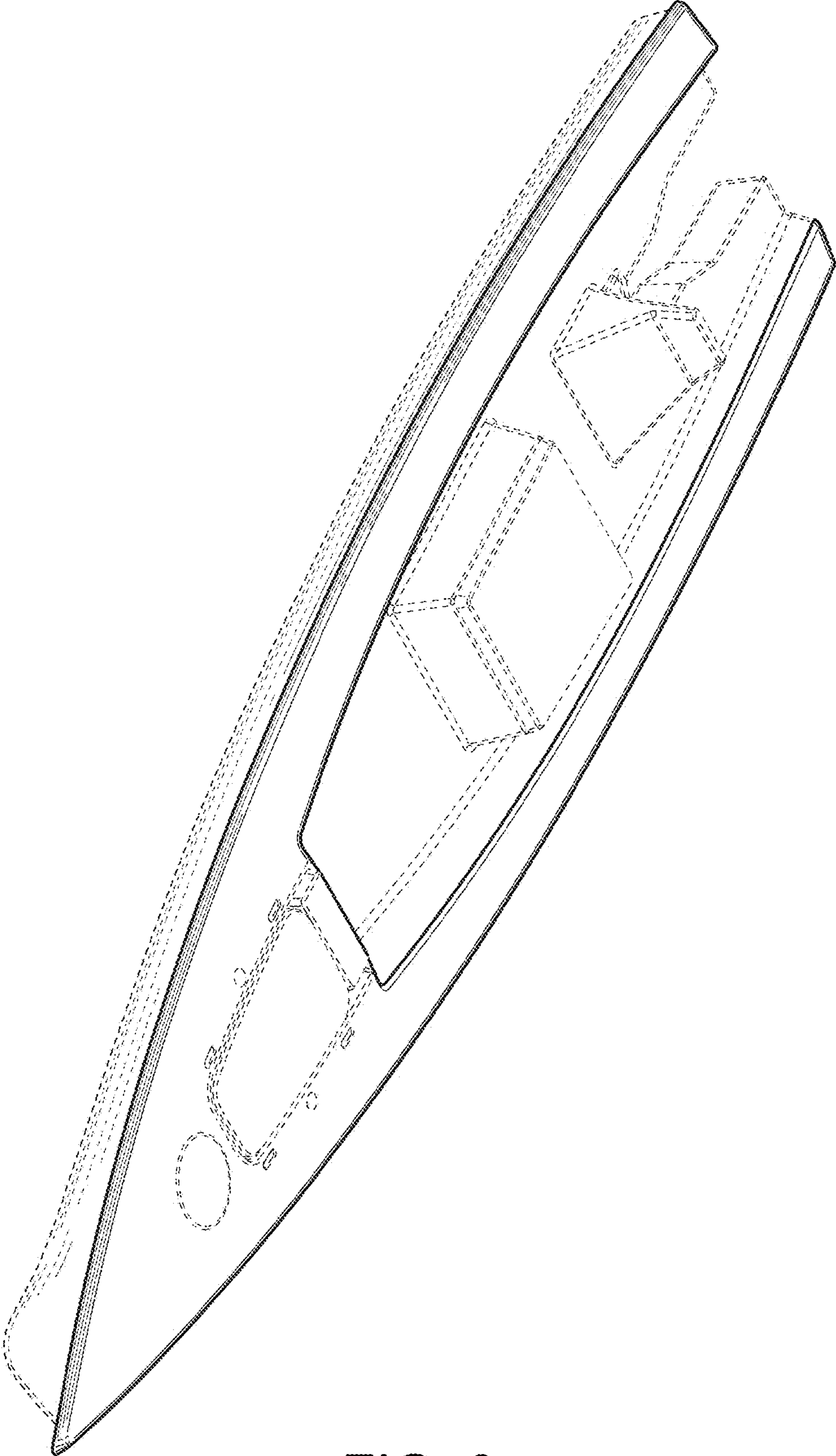

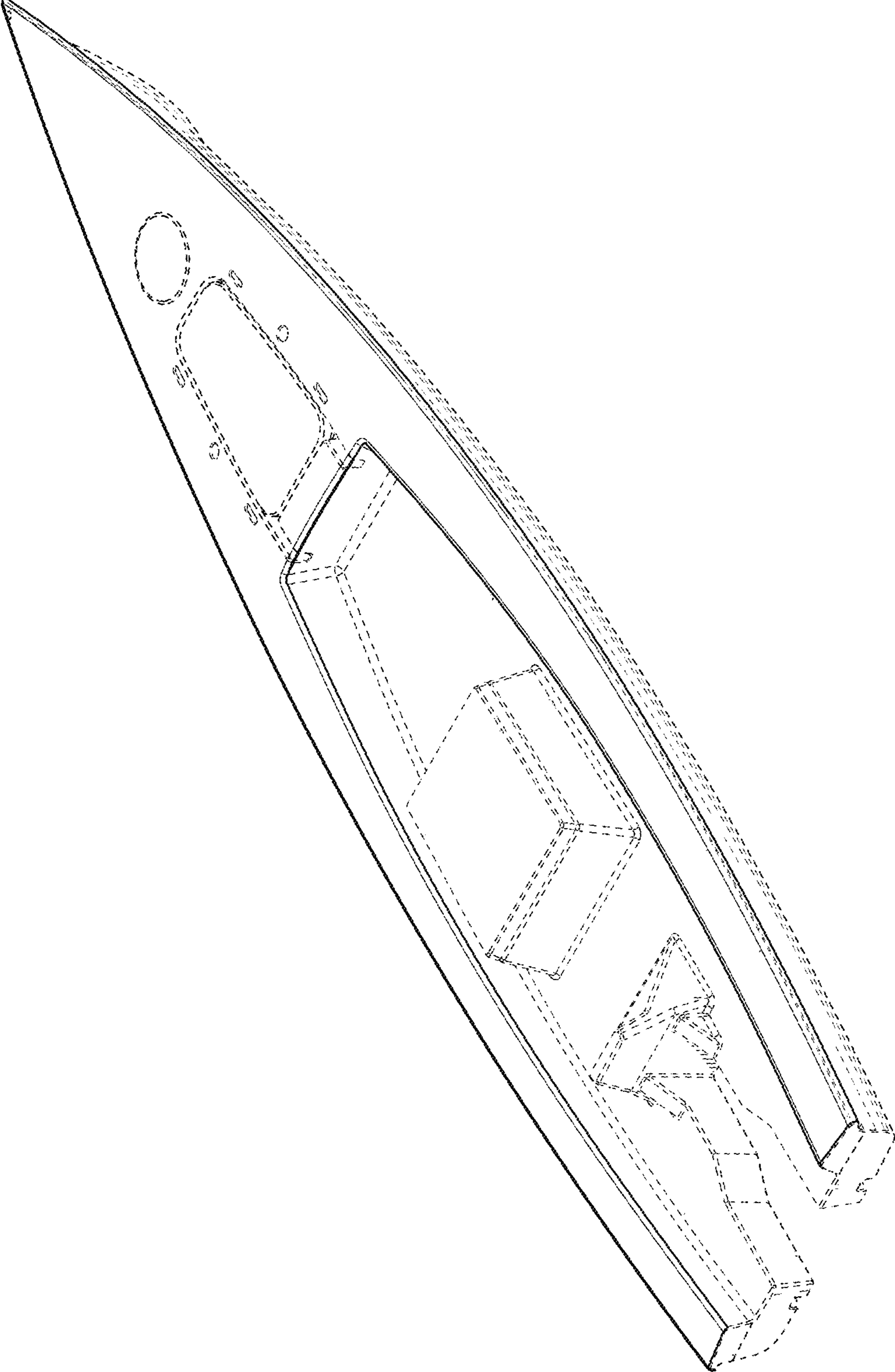

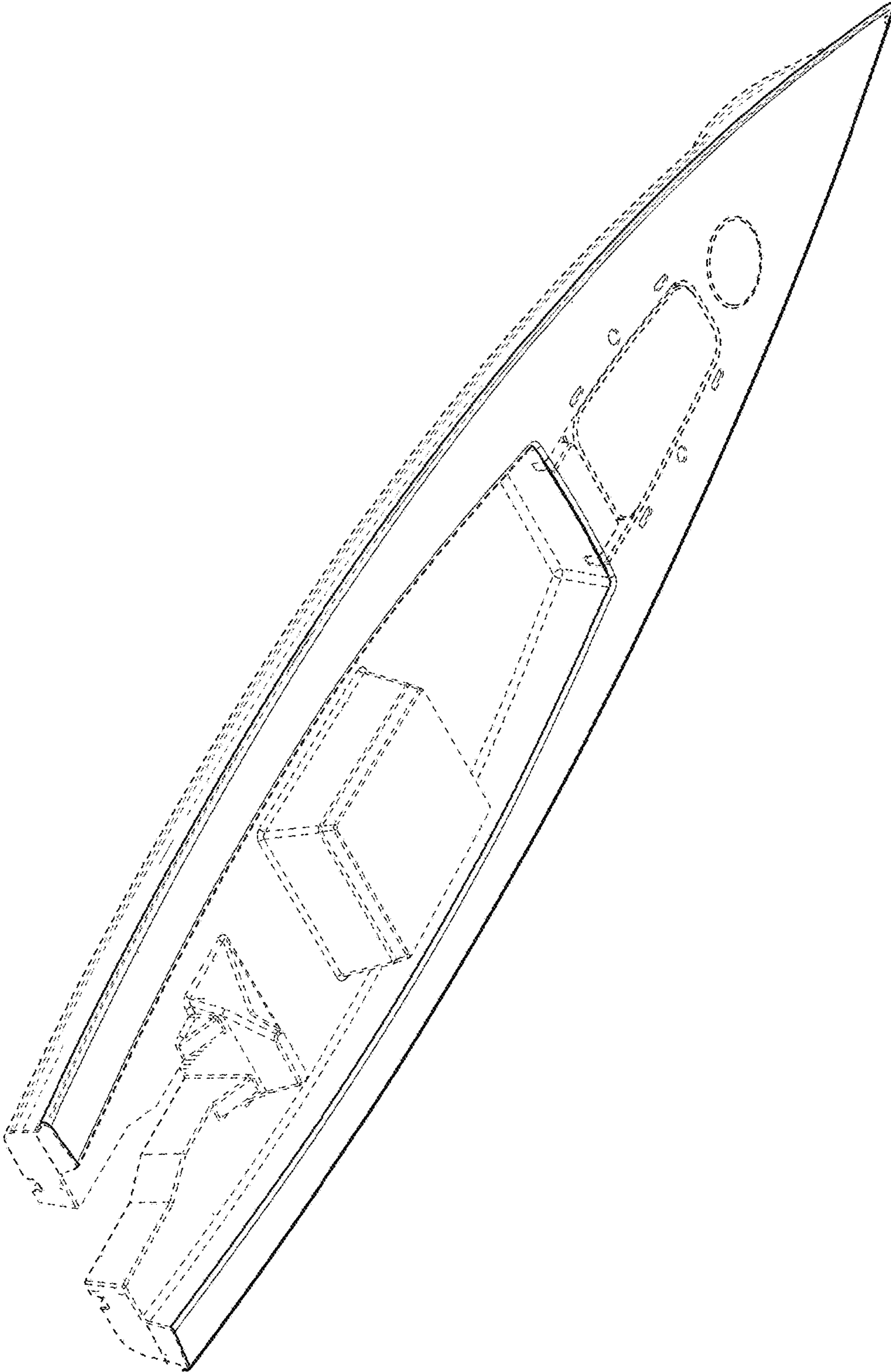

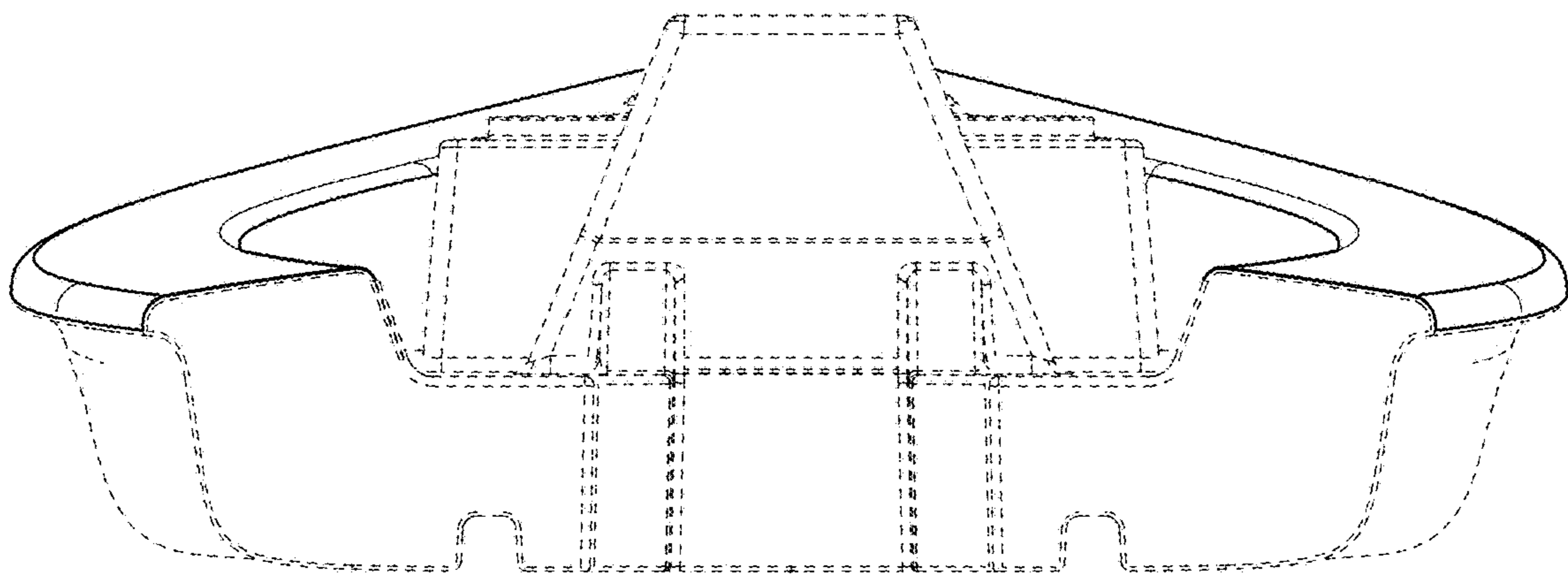
