The ornamental design for a lantern speaker, as shown and described.

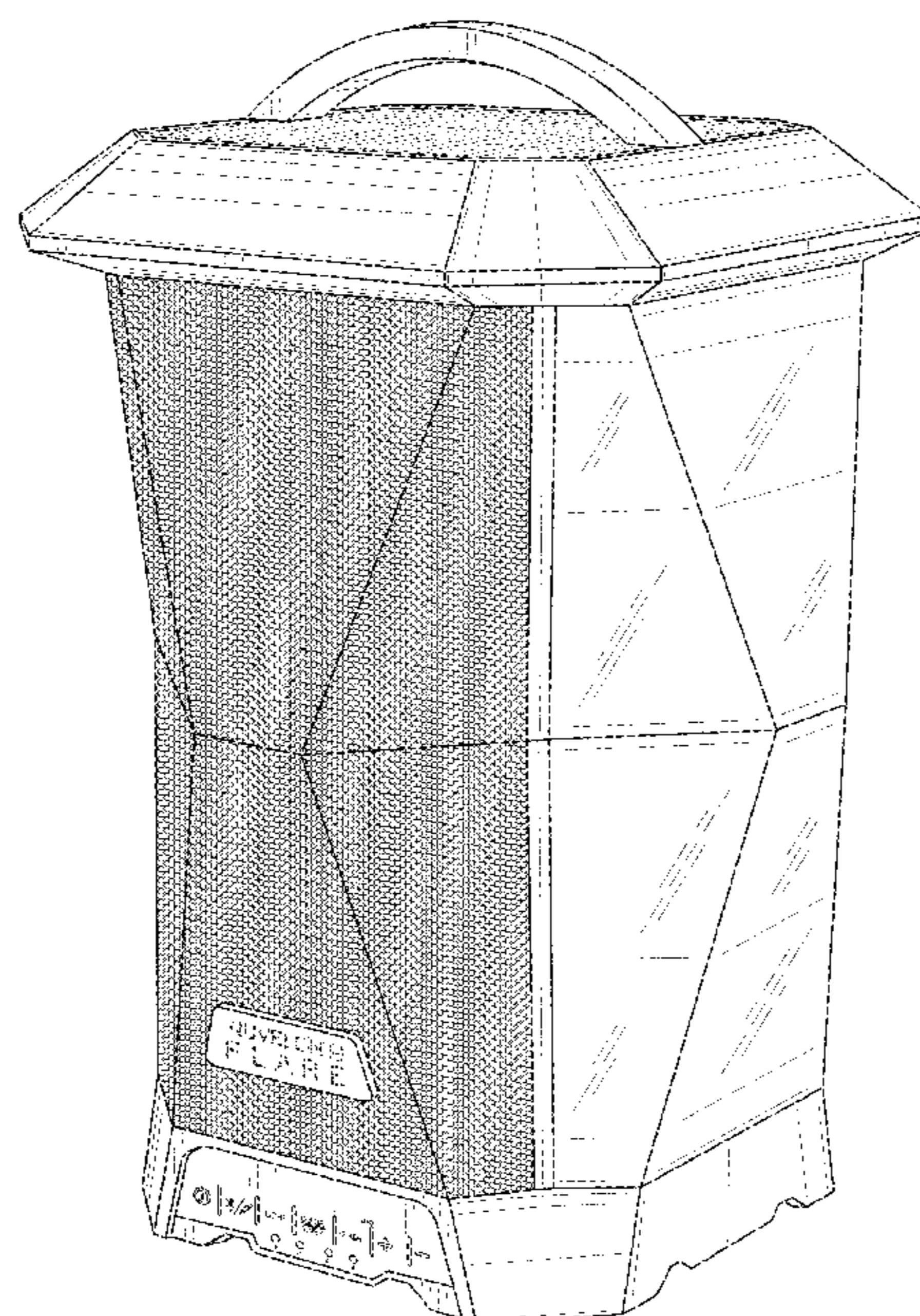
DESCRIPTION

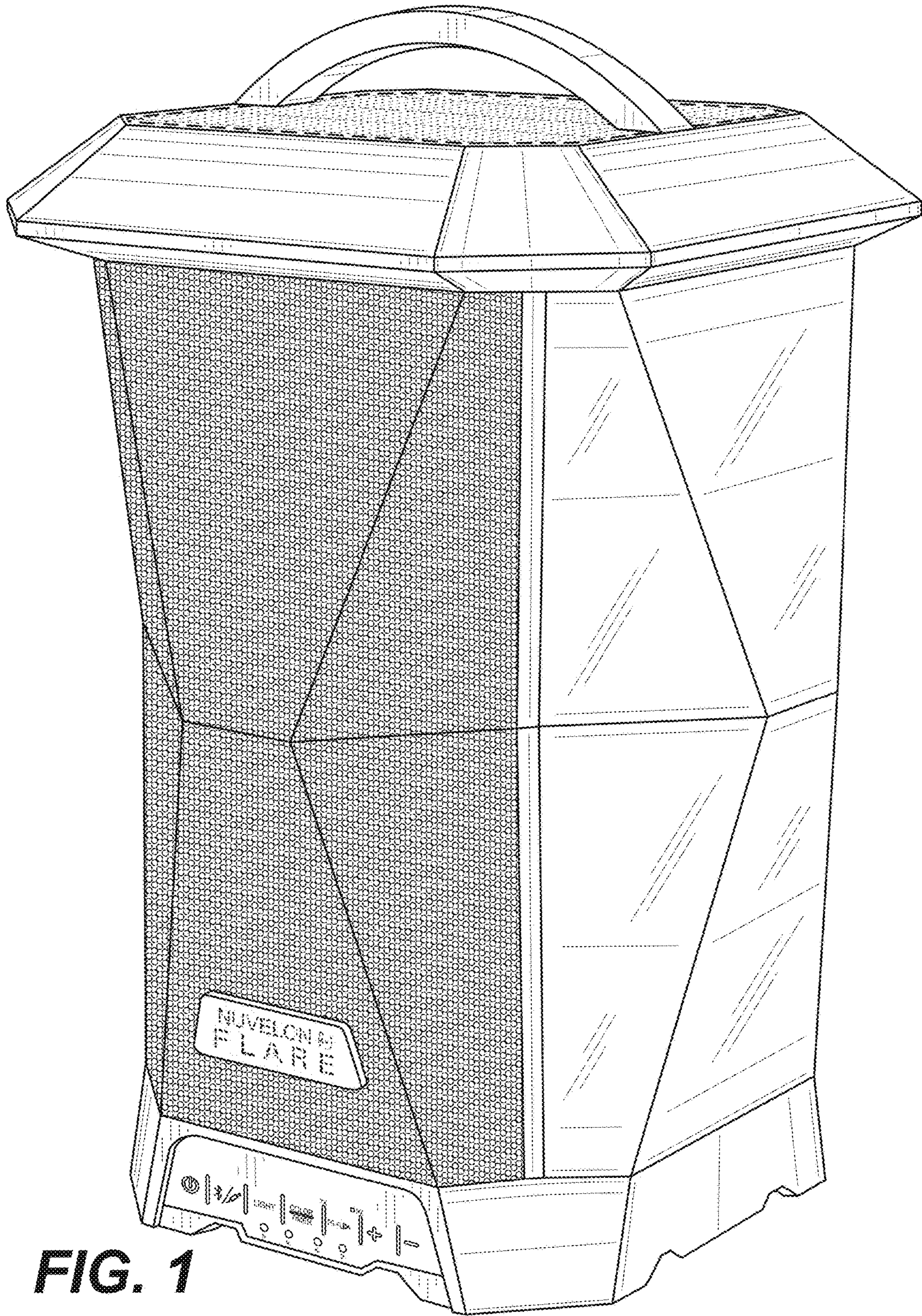

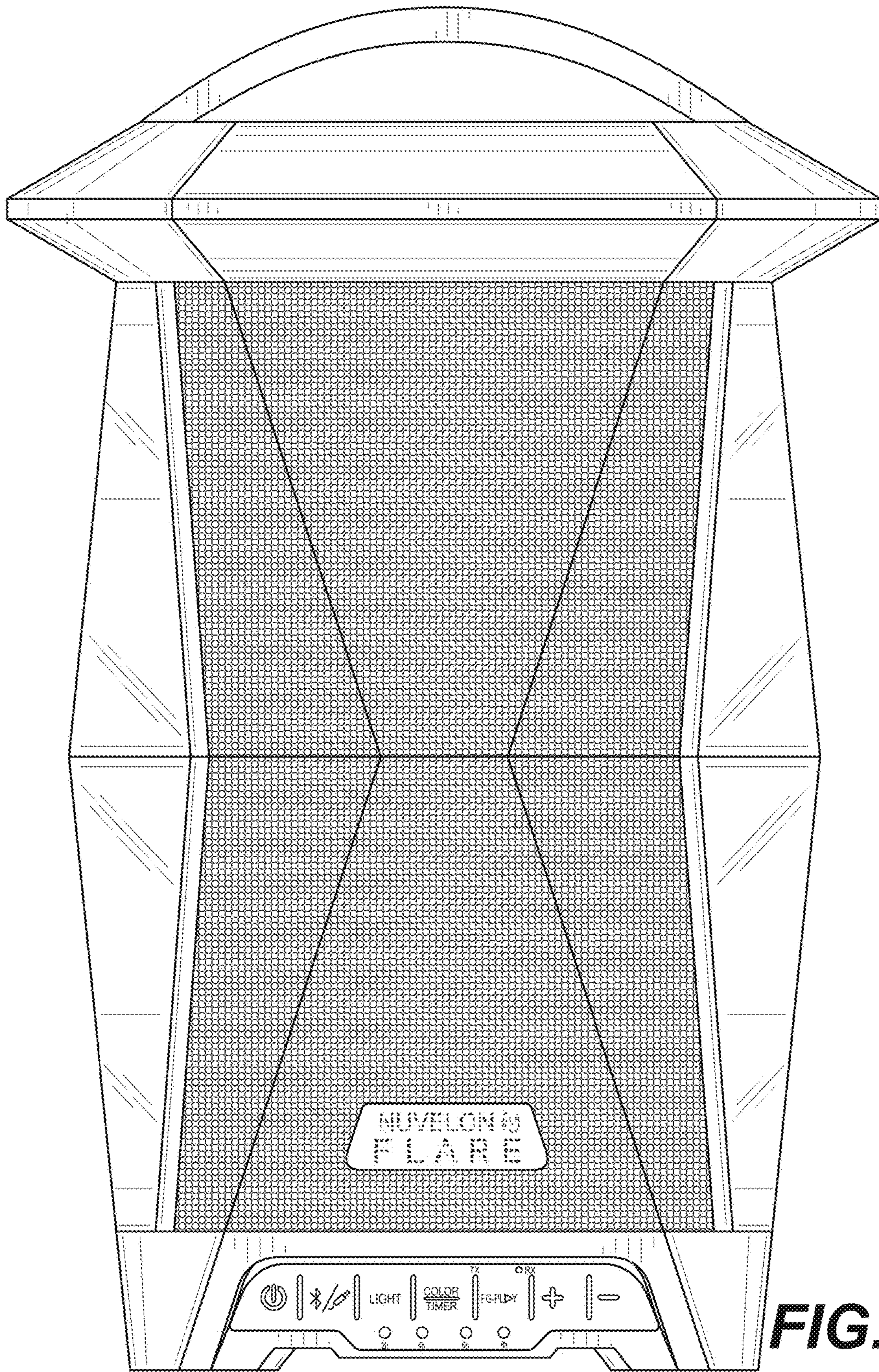

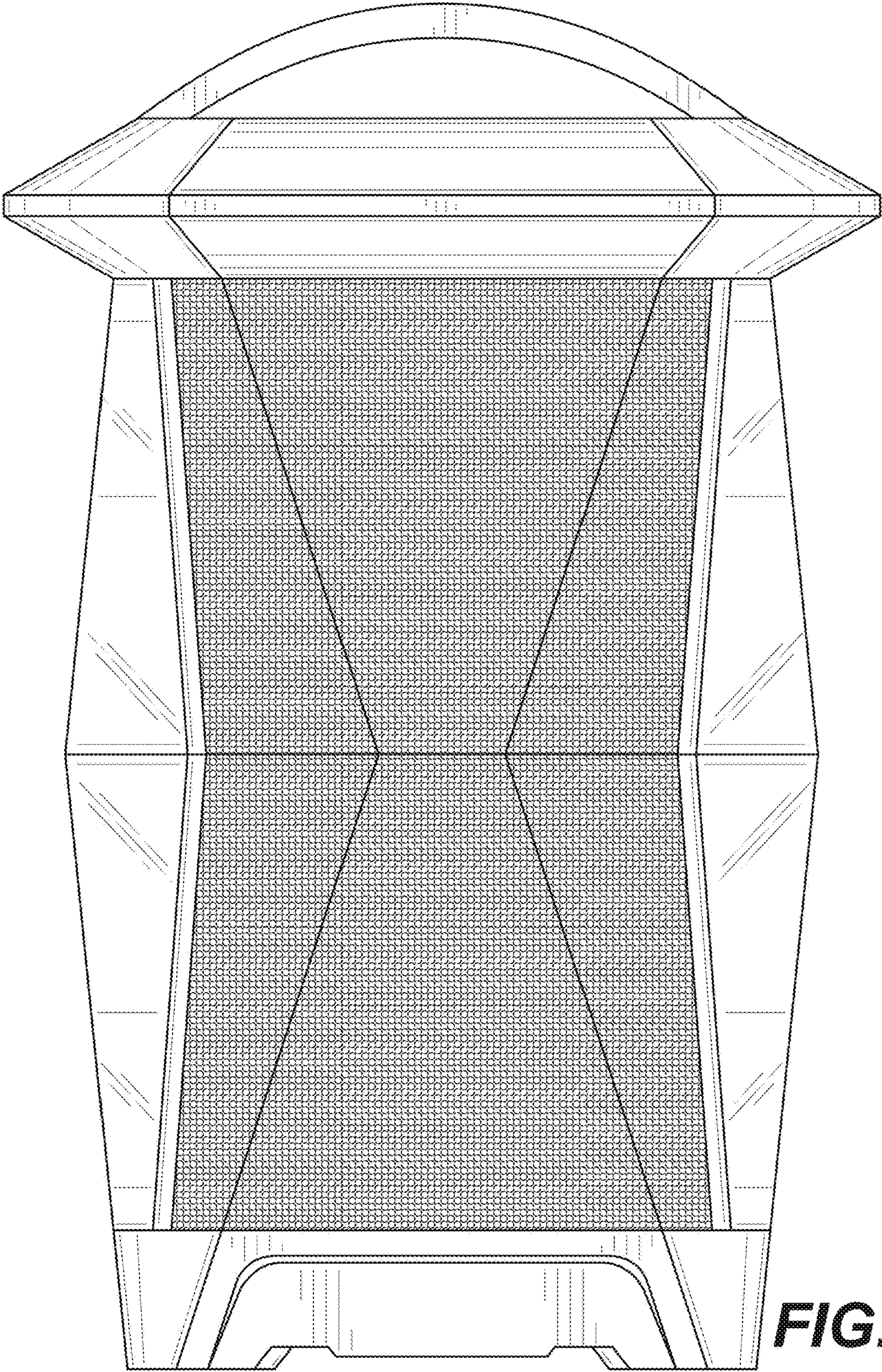

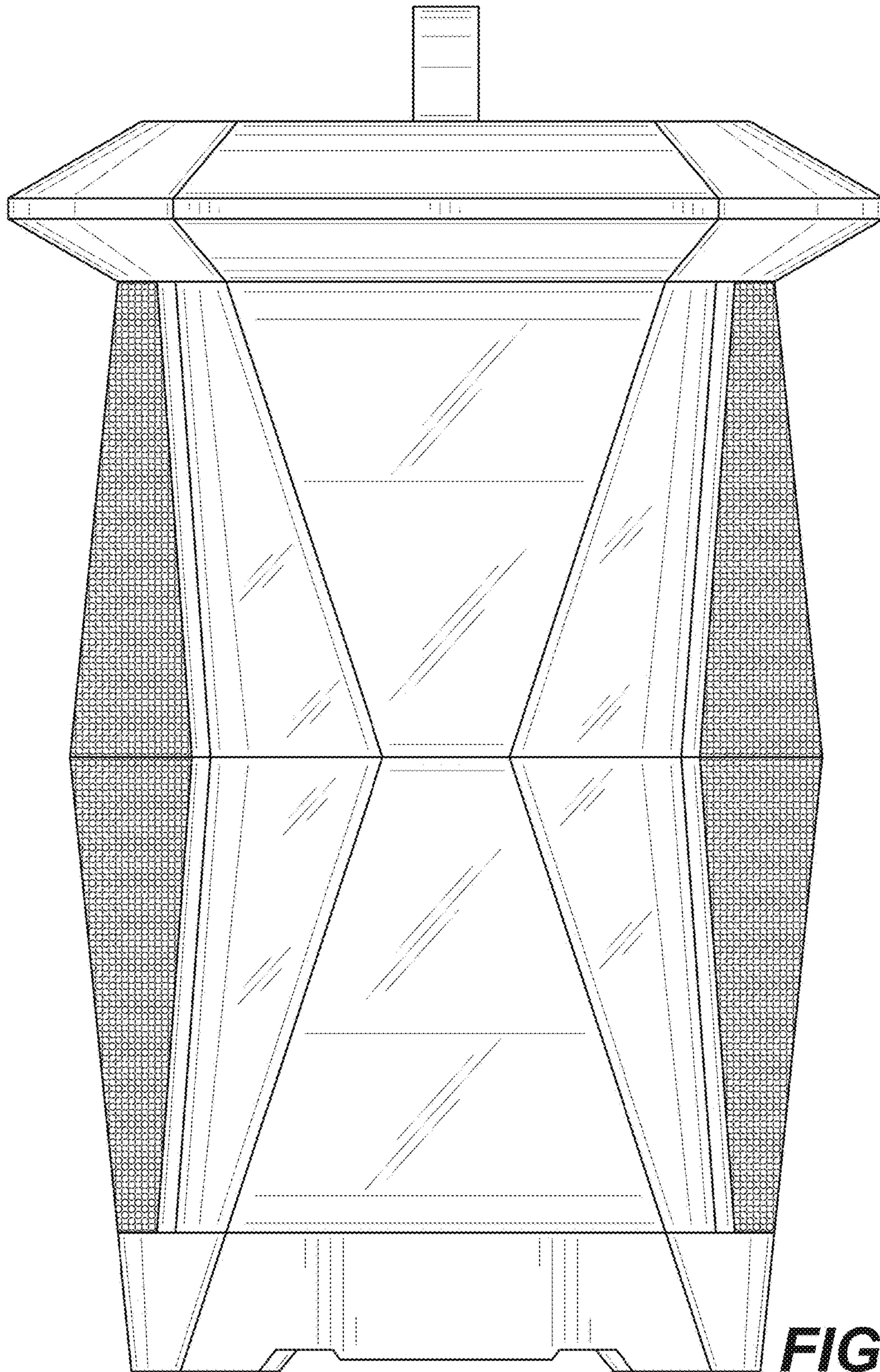

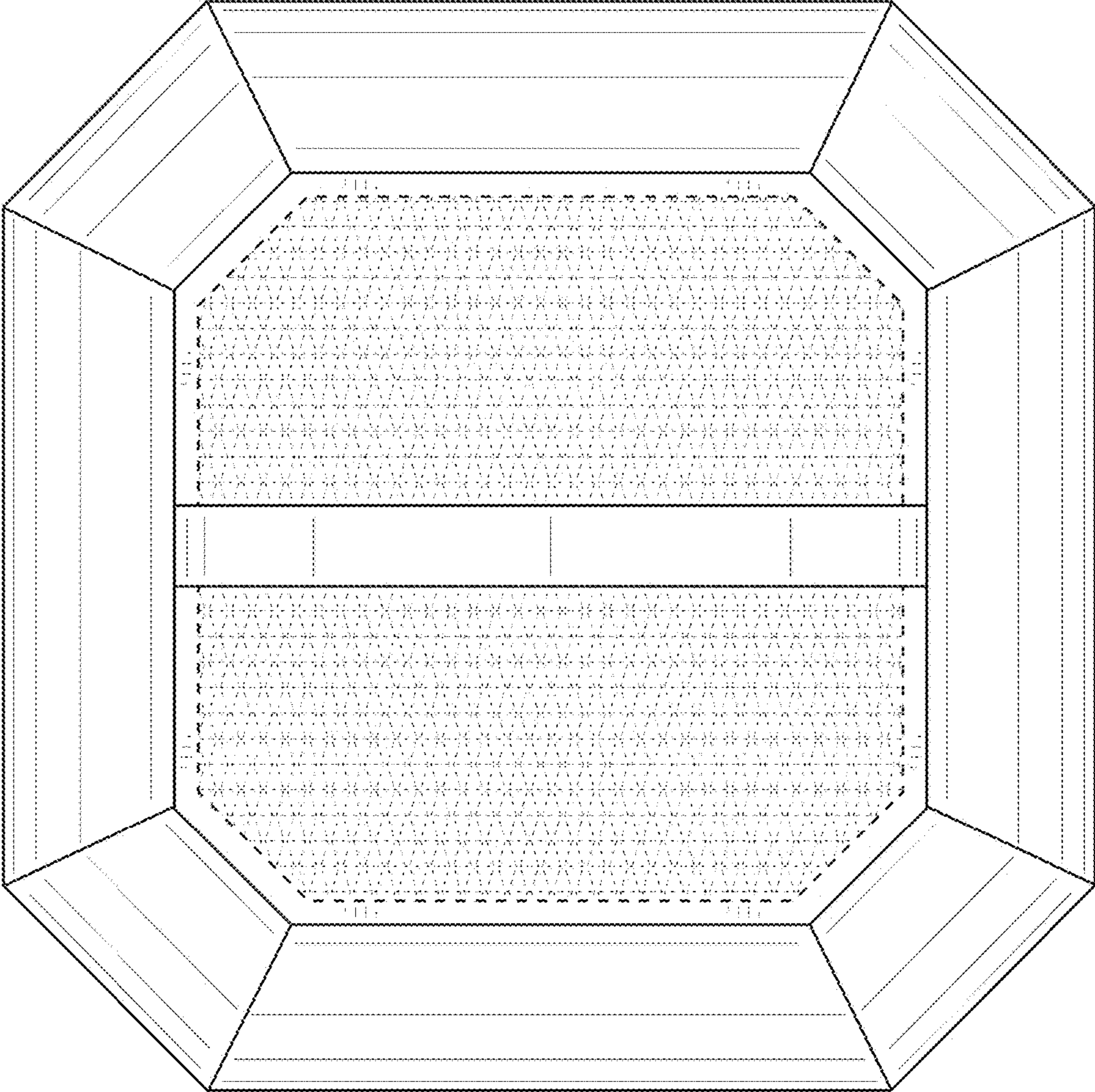

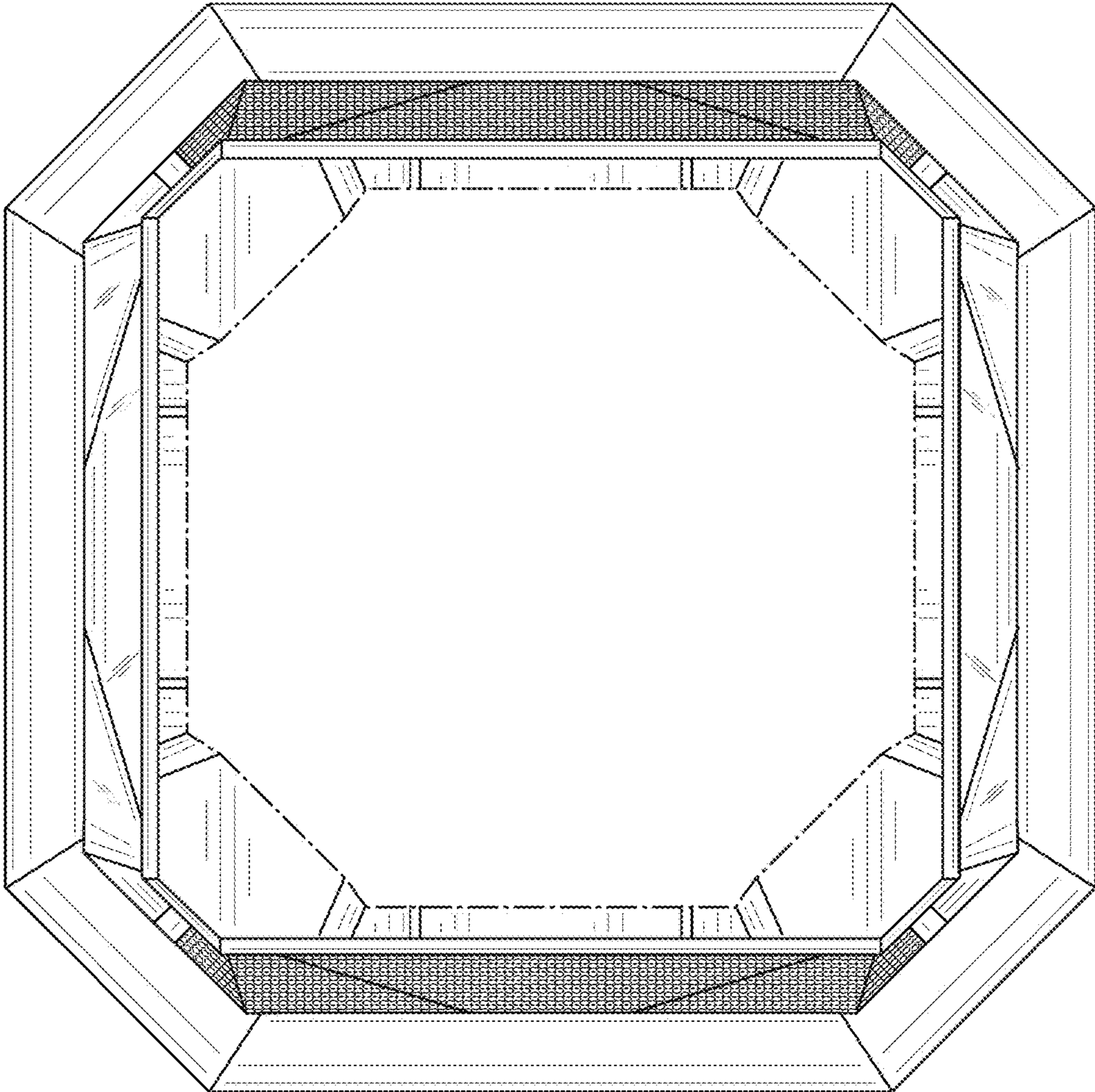
