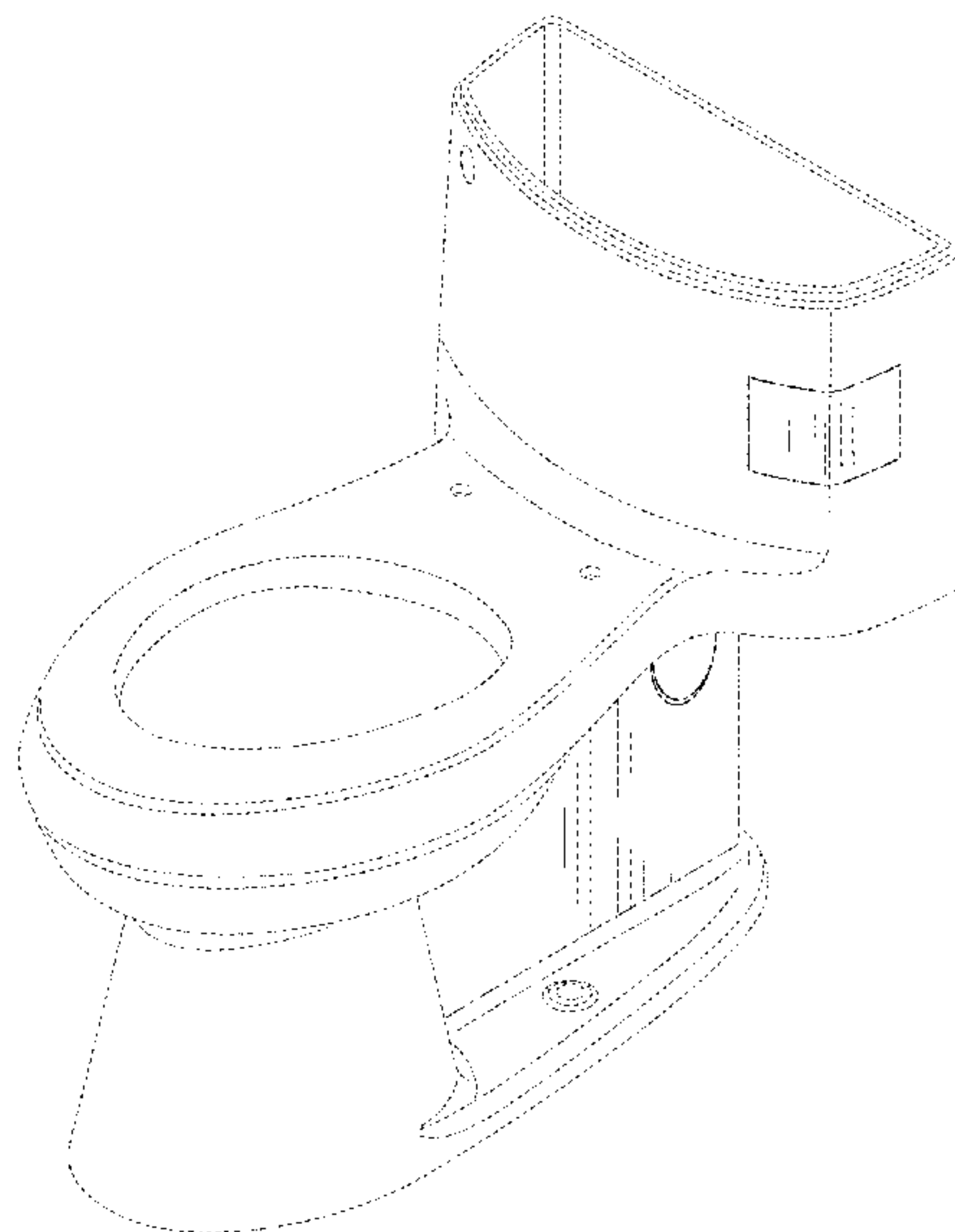
(57) **CLAIM**

We claim the ornamental design for a toilet, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an embodiment of the claimed design;
FIG. 2 is a left side plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 3 is a right side plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 4 is a front plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 5 is a rear plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the design shown in FIG. 1.

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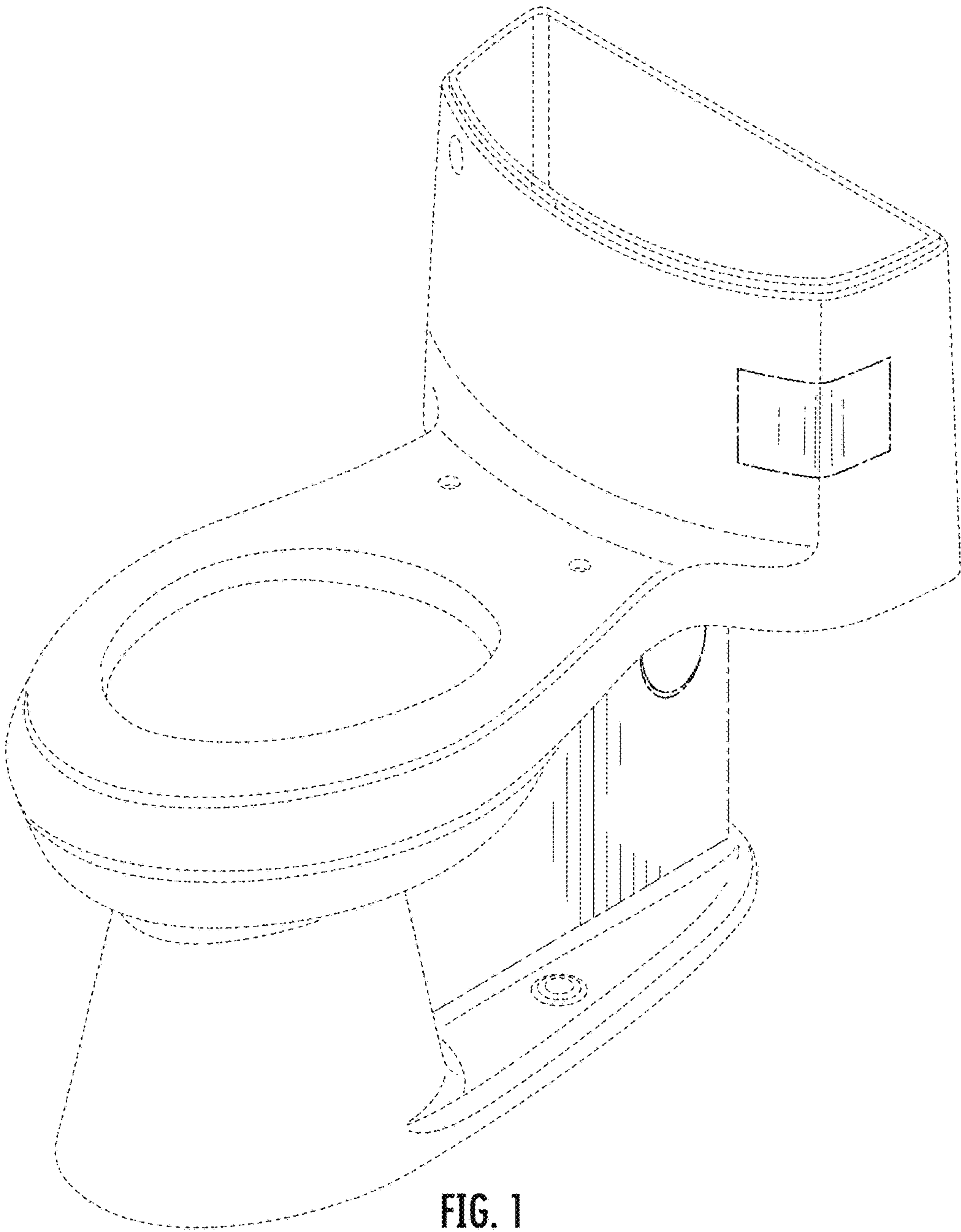
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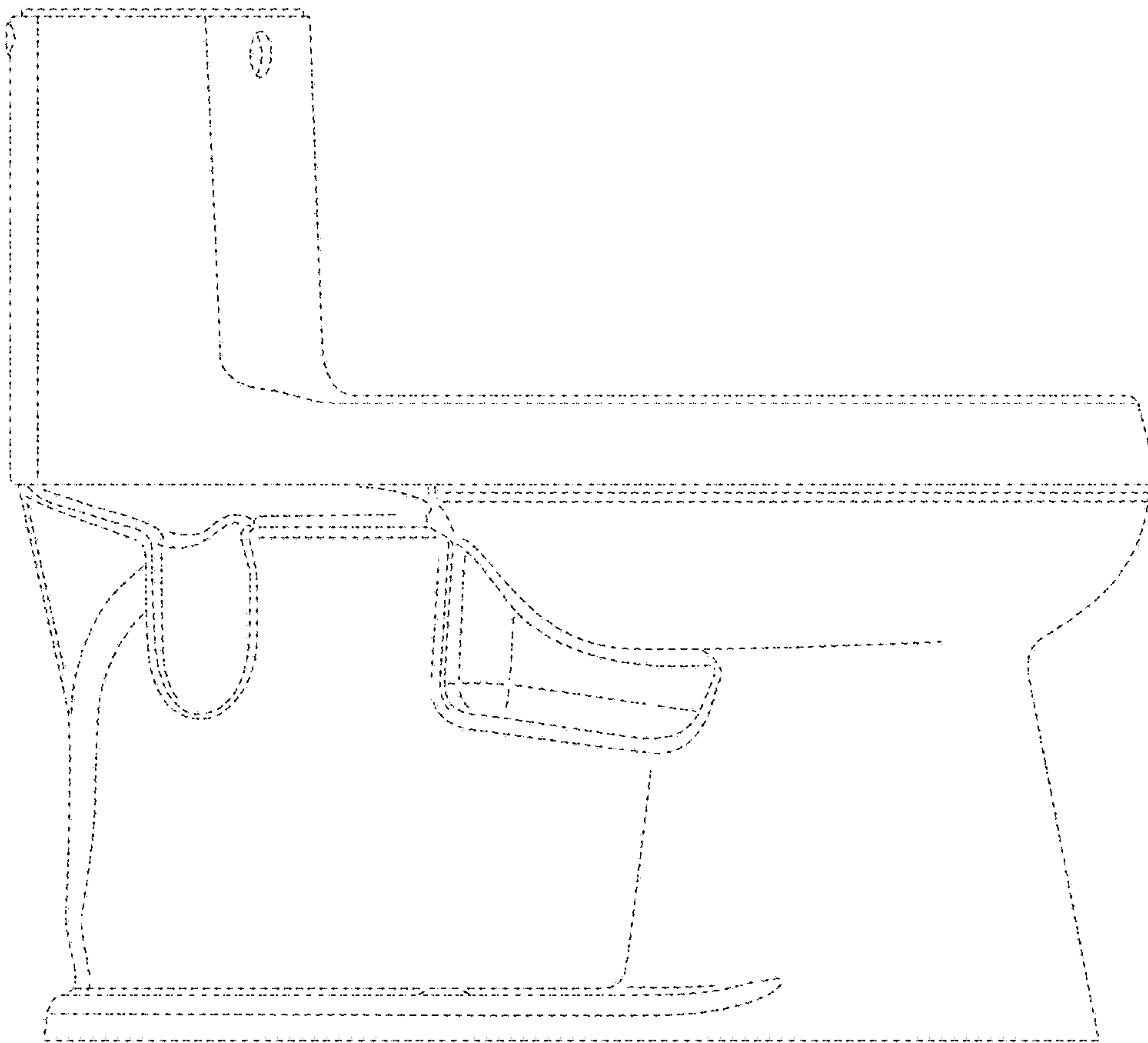

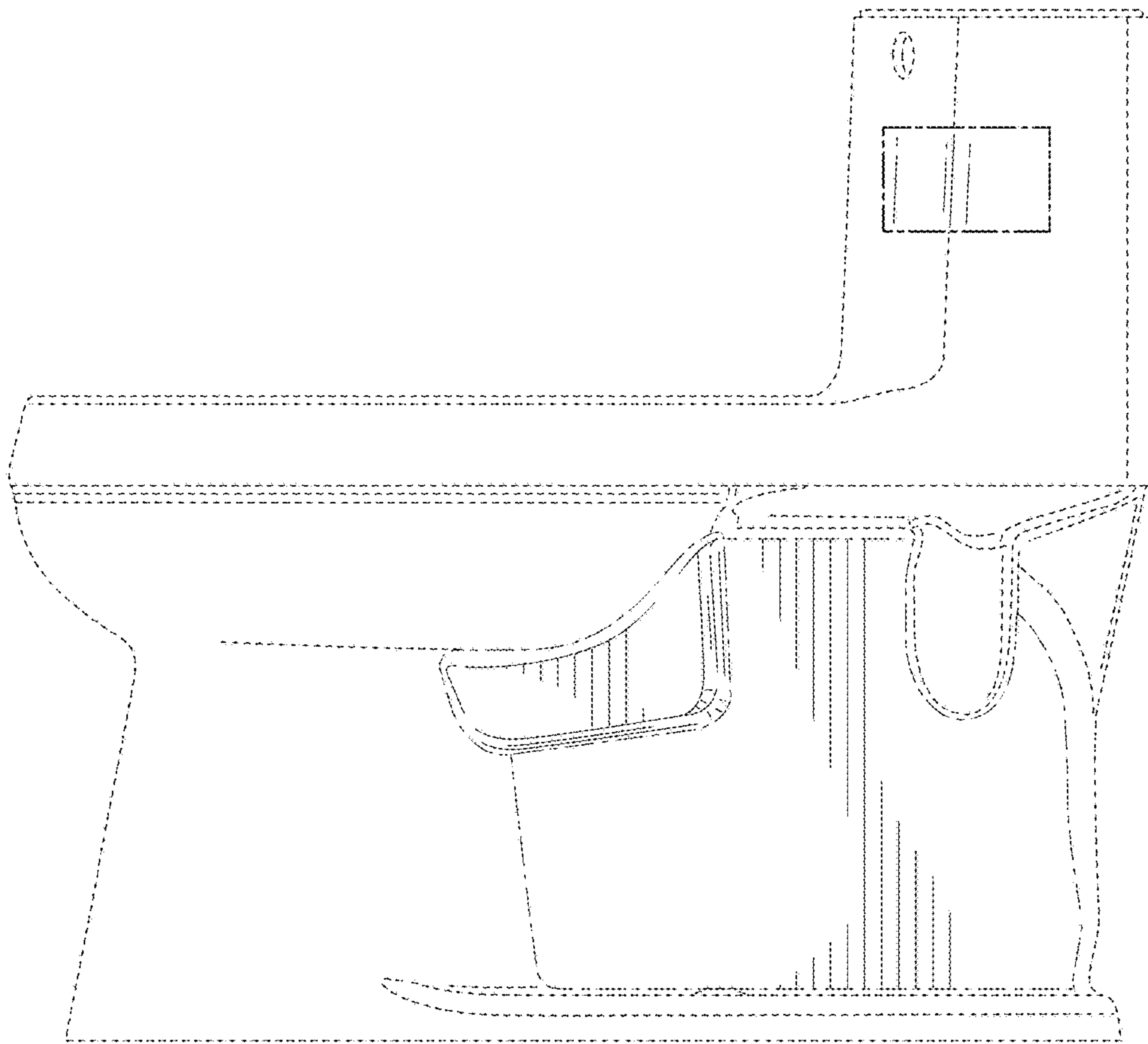

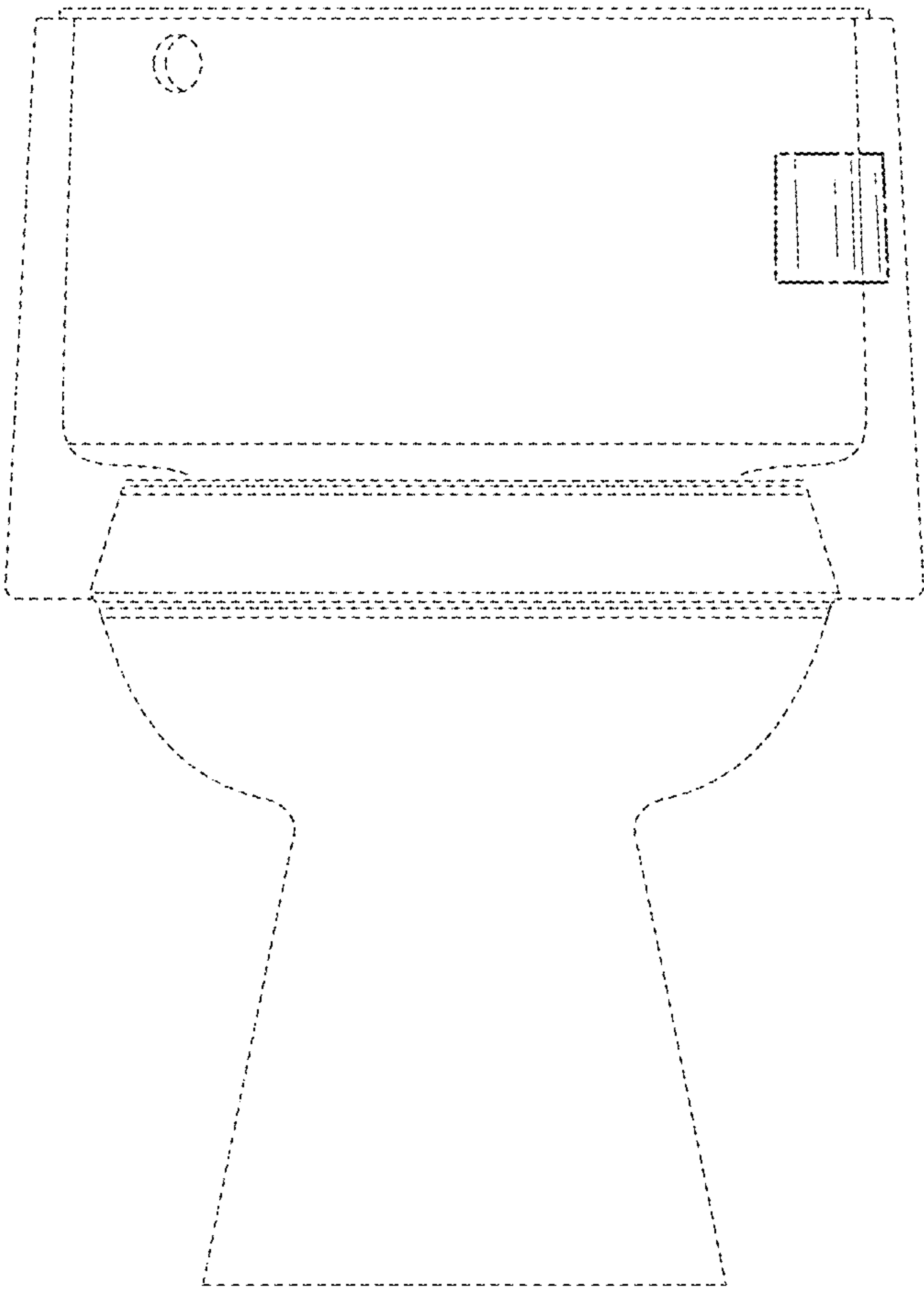

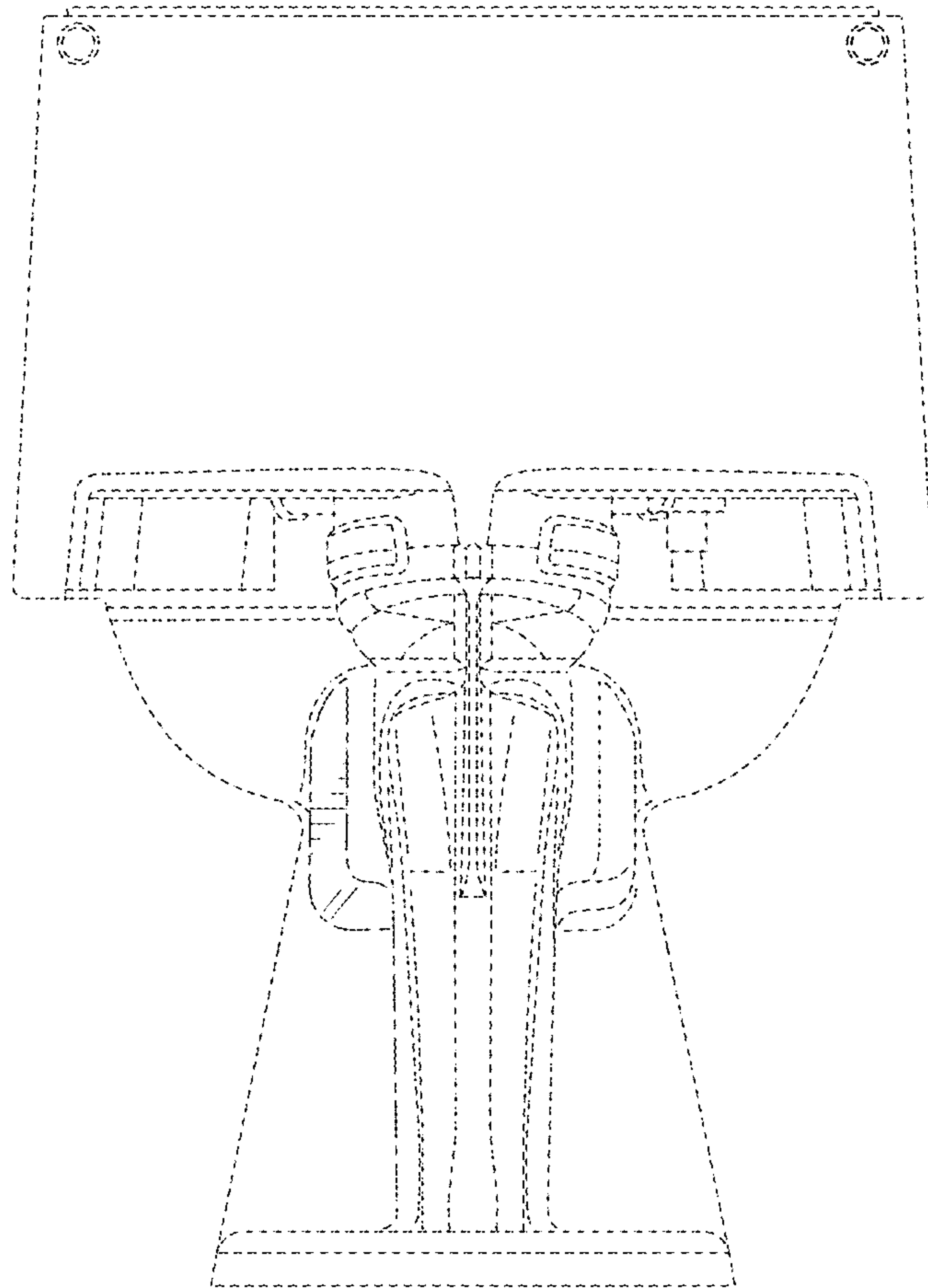

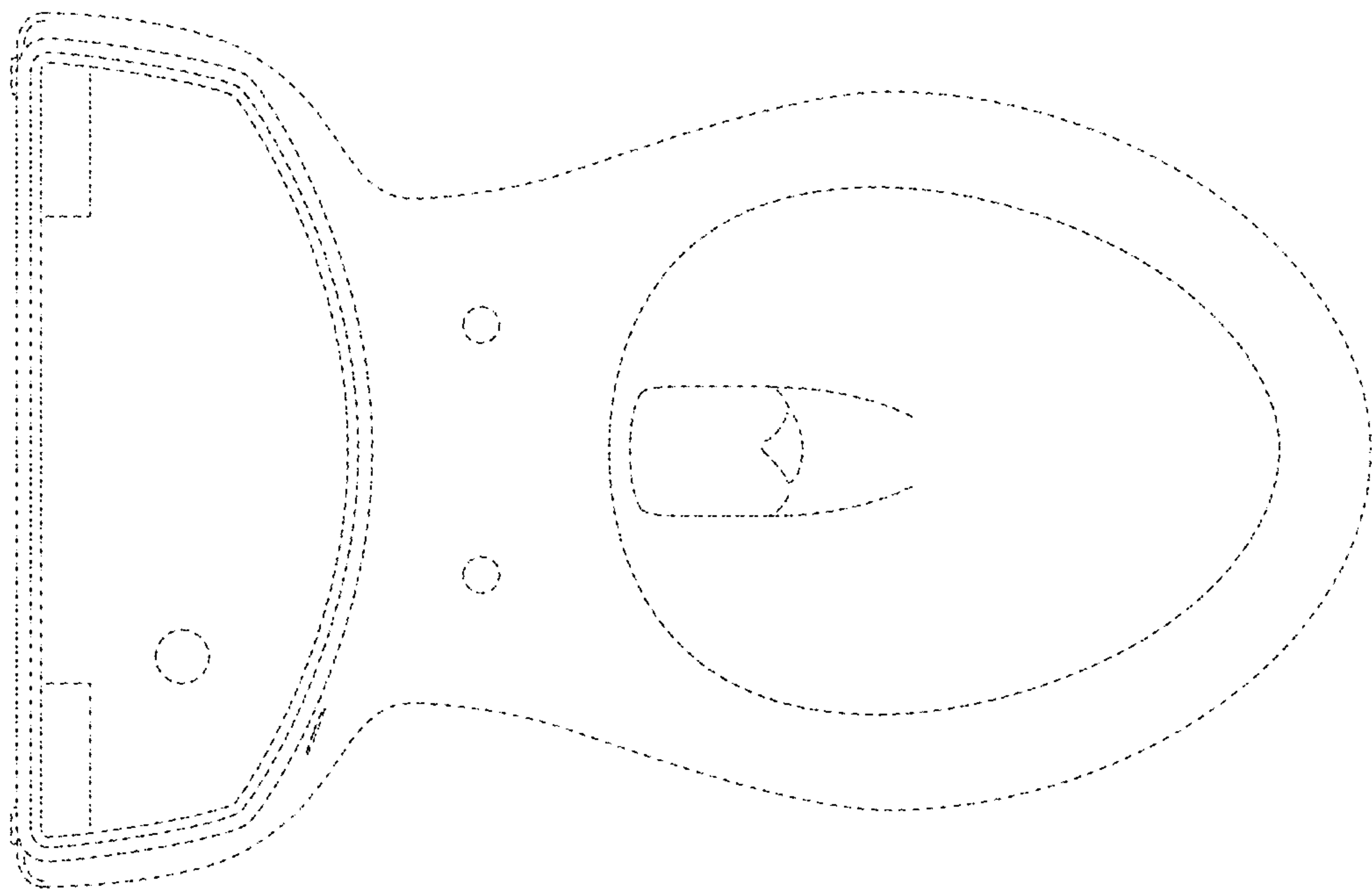

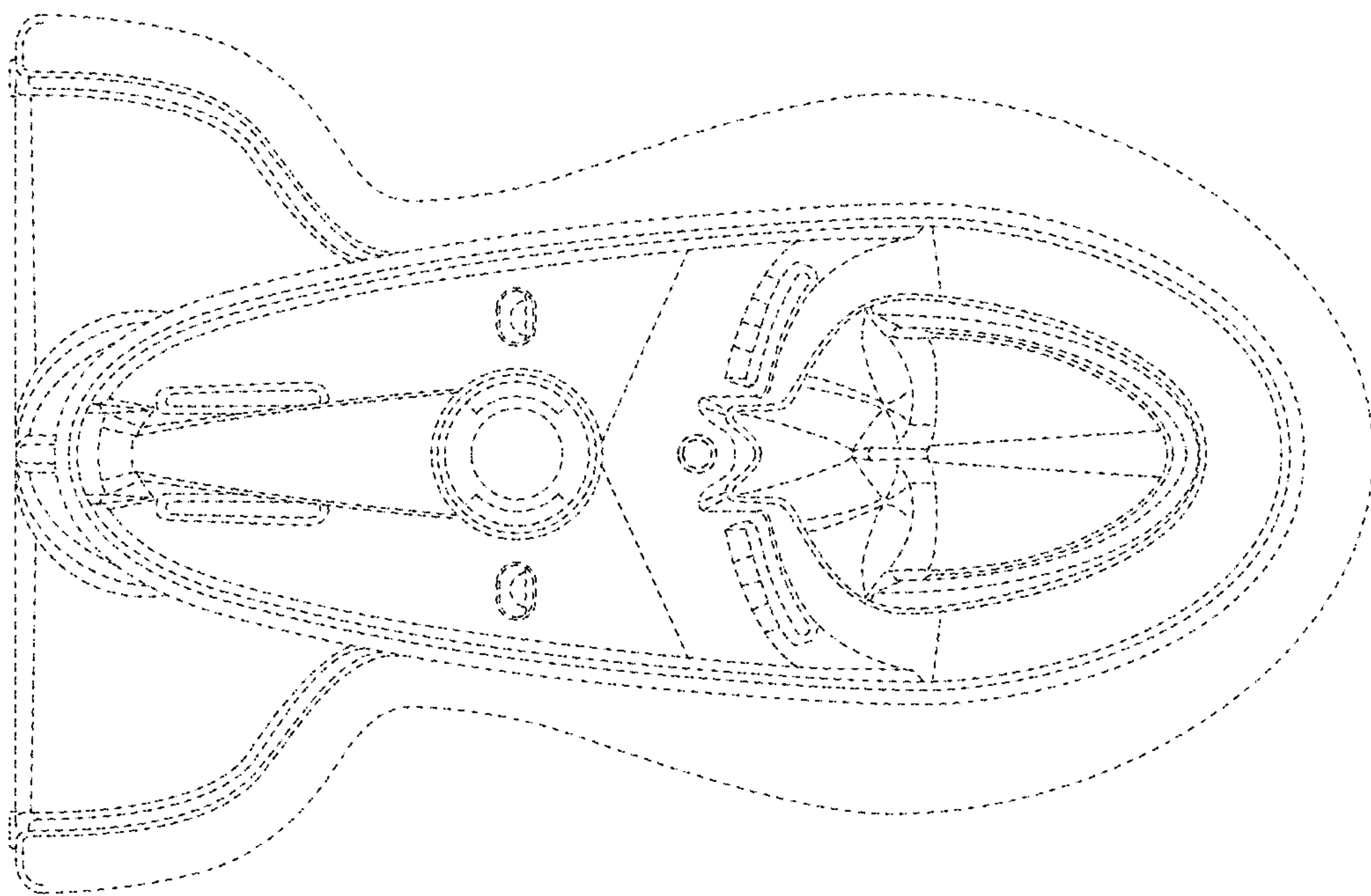
