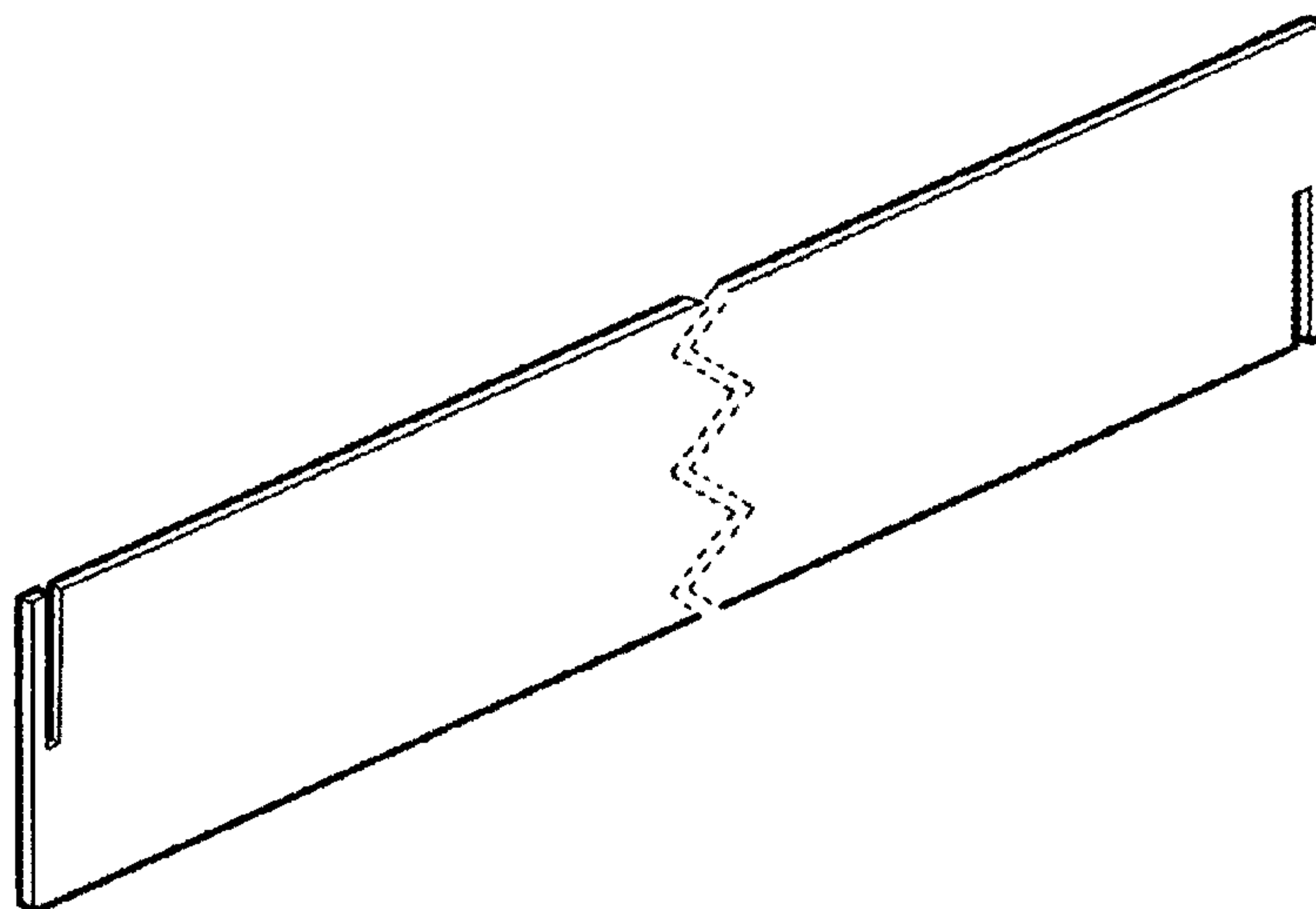
(57) **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front side profile view of the raised bed garden panel;

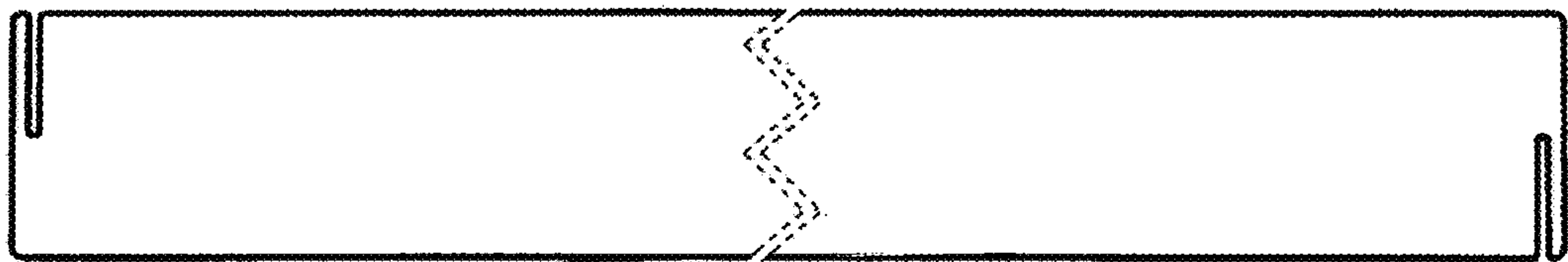

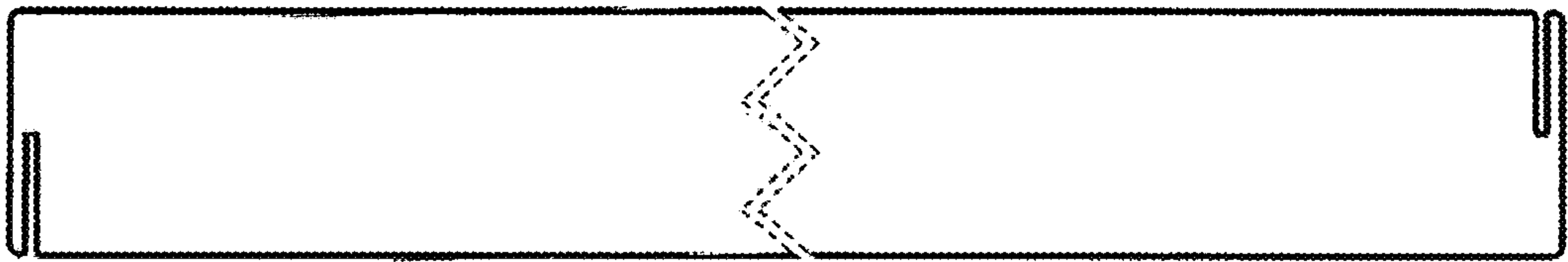

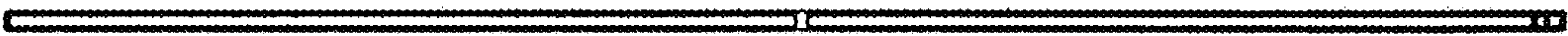

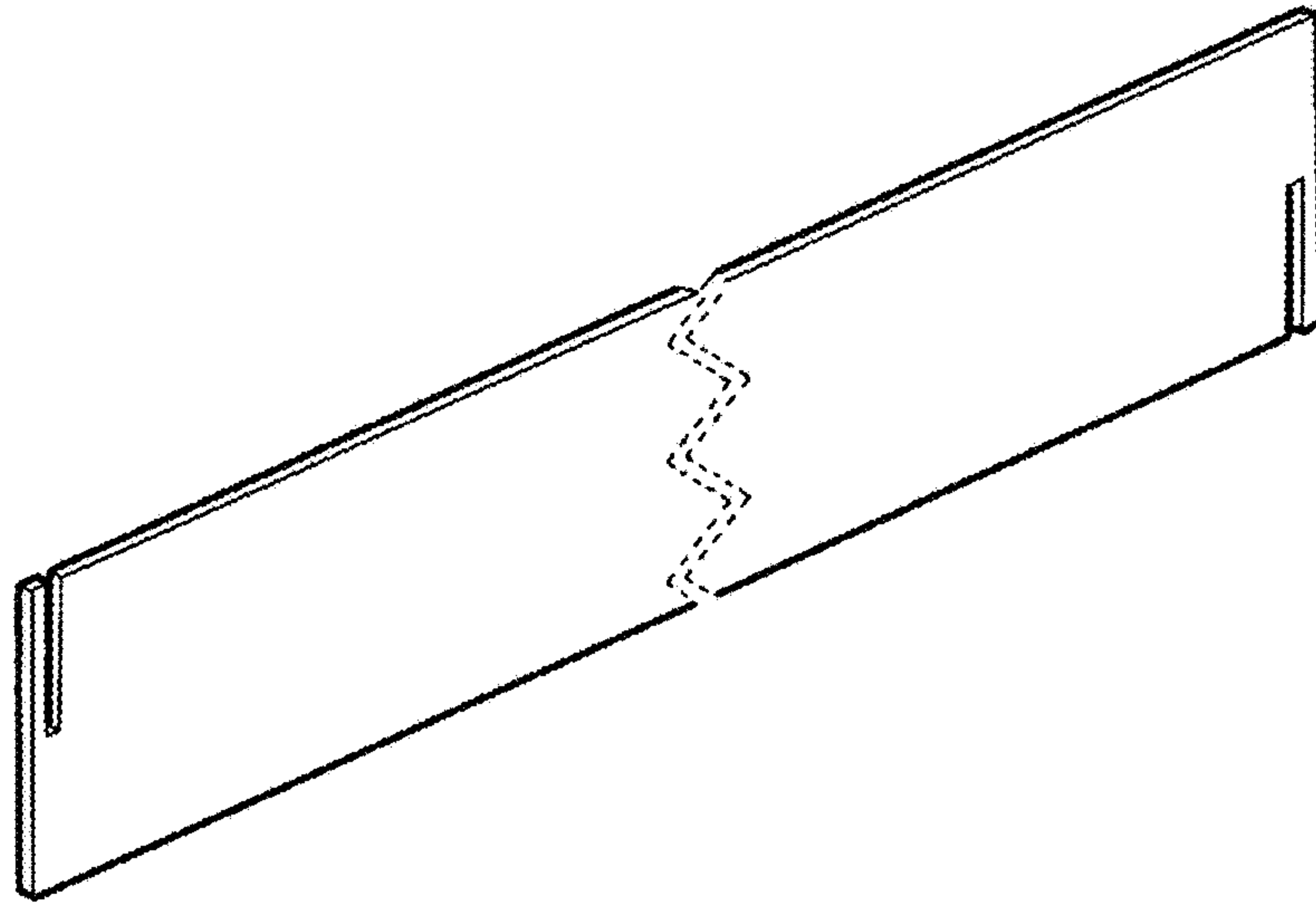
