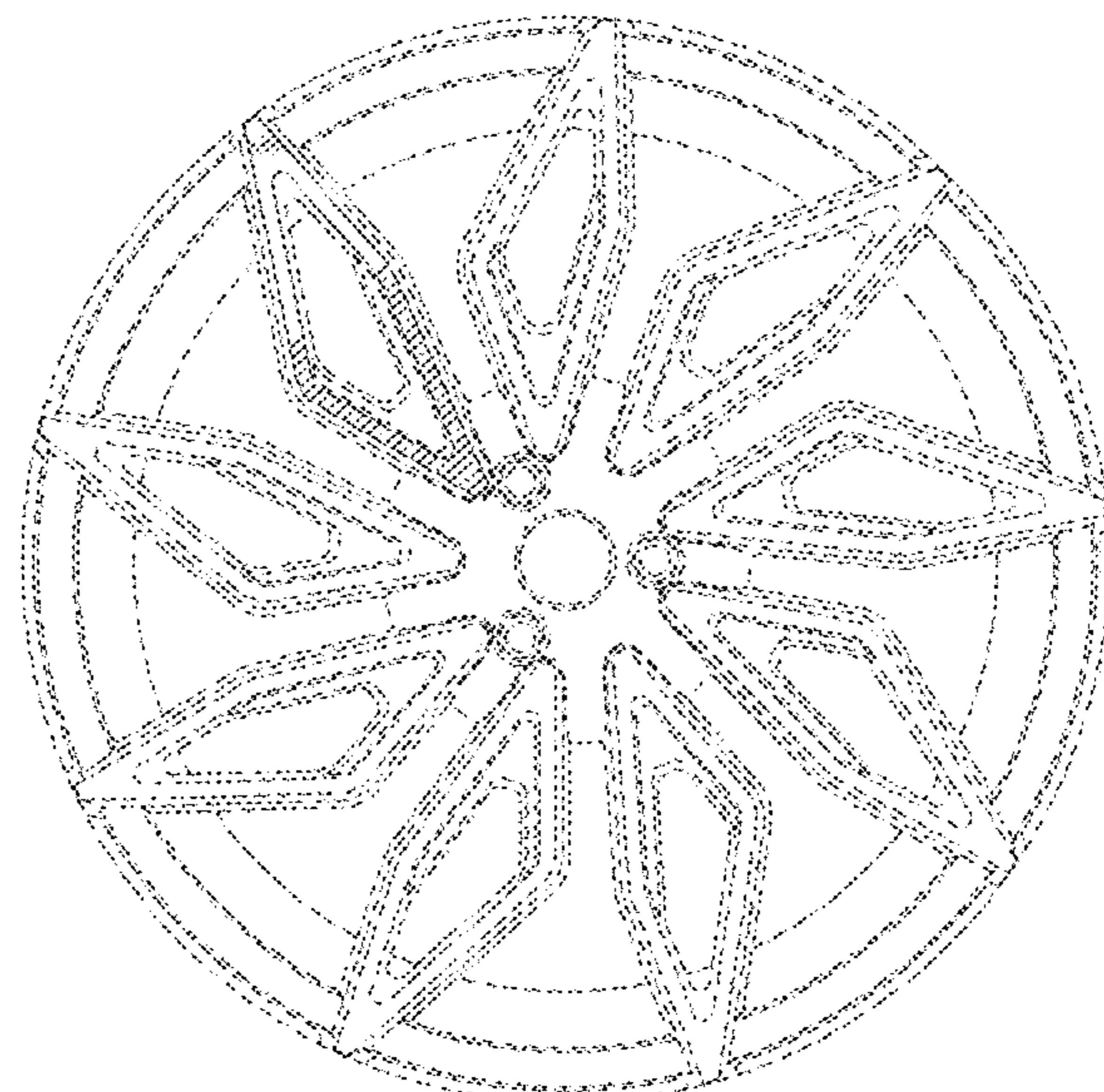
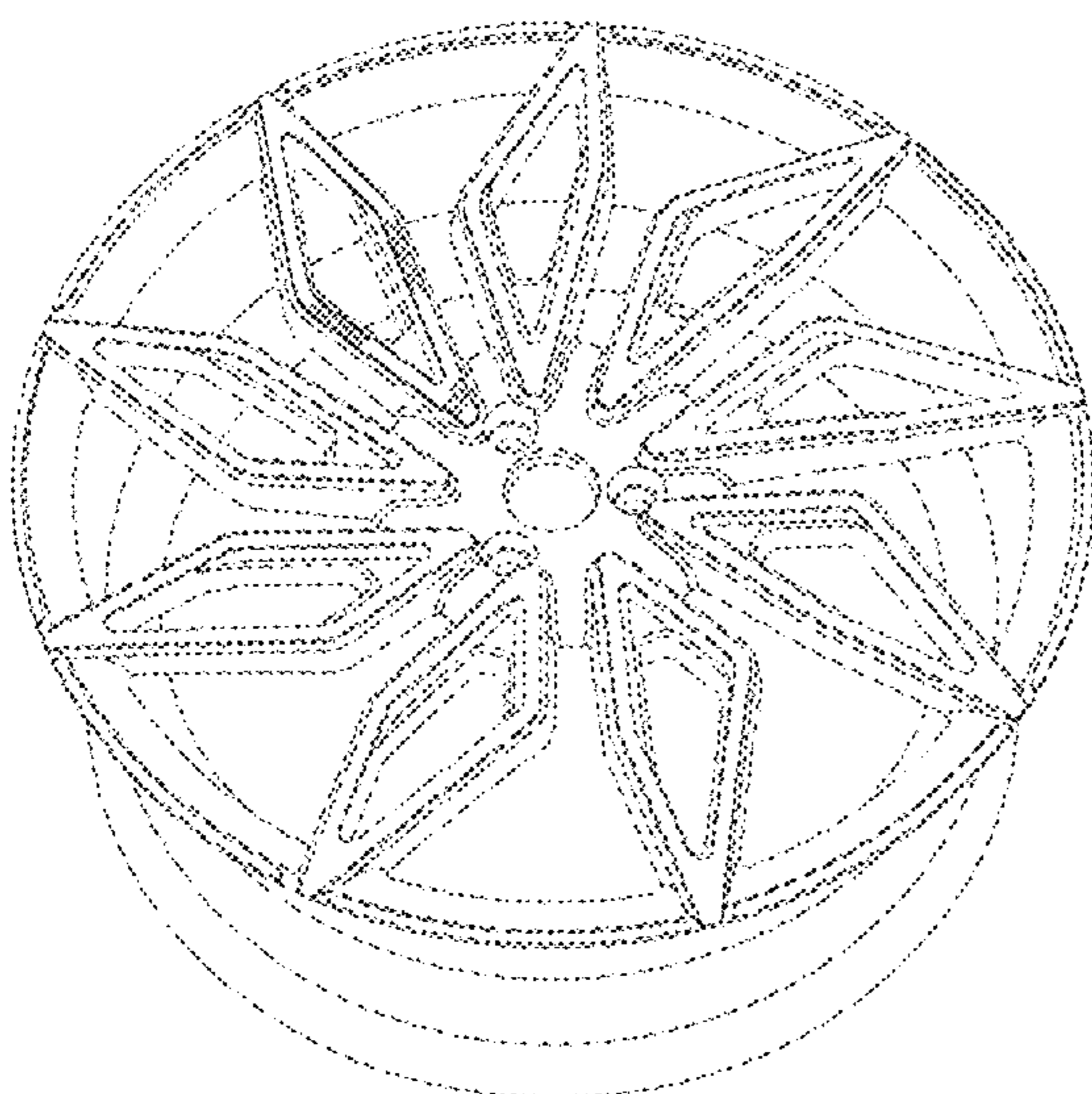
The ornamental design for a top portion of a spoke of a wheel, as shown and described.

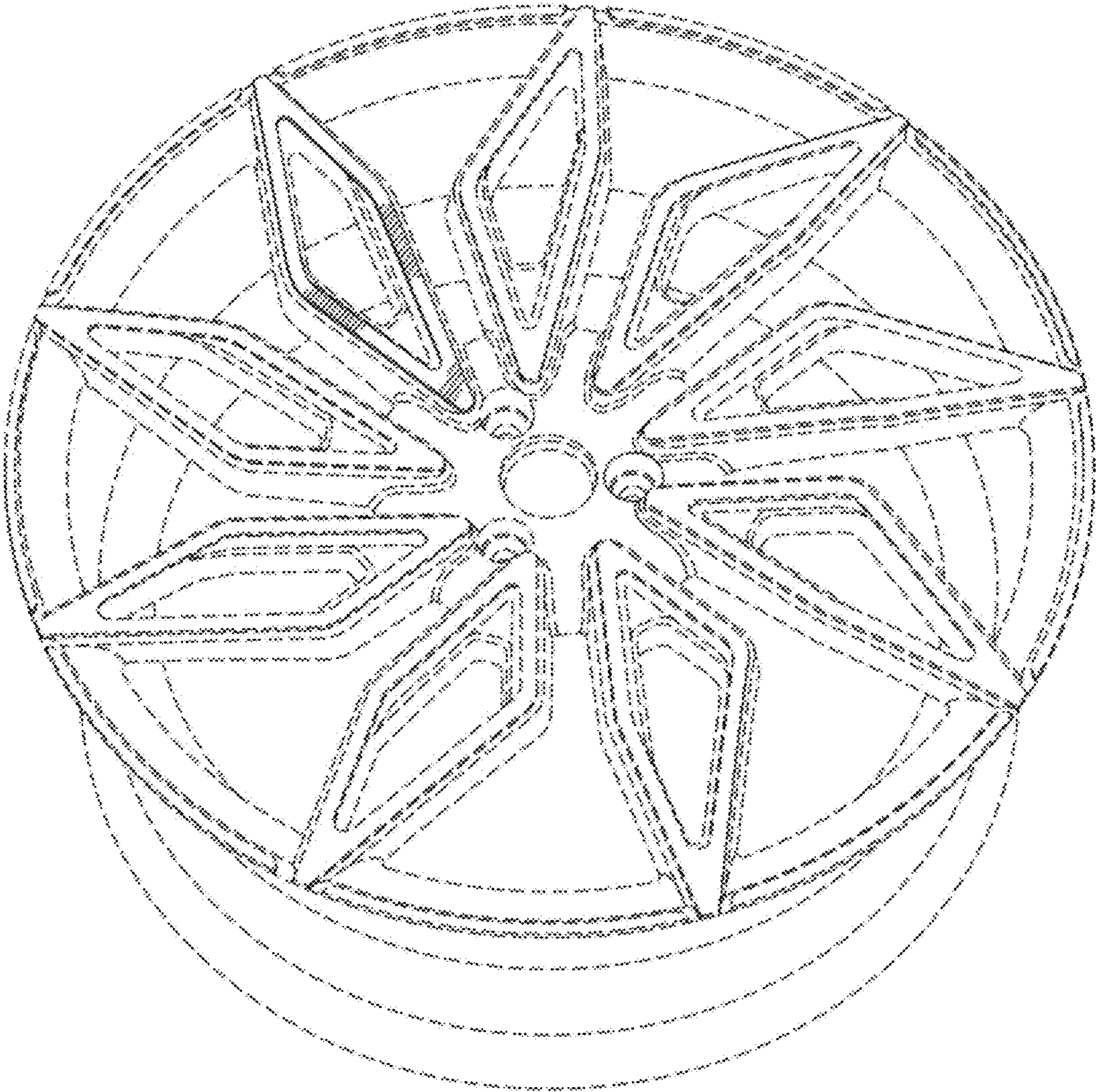

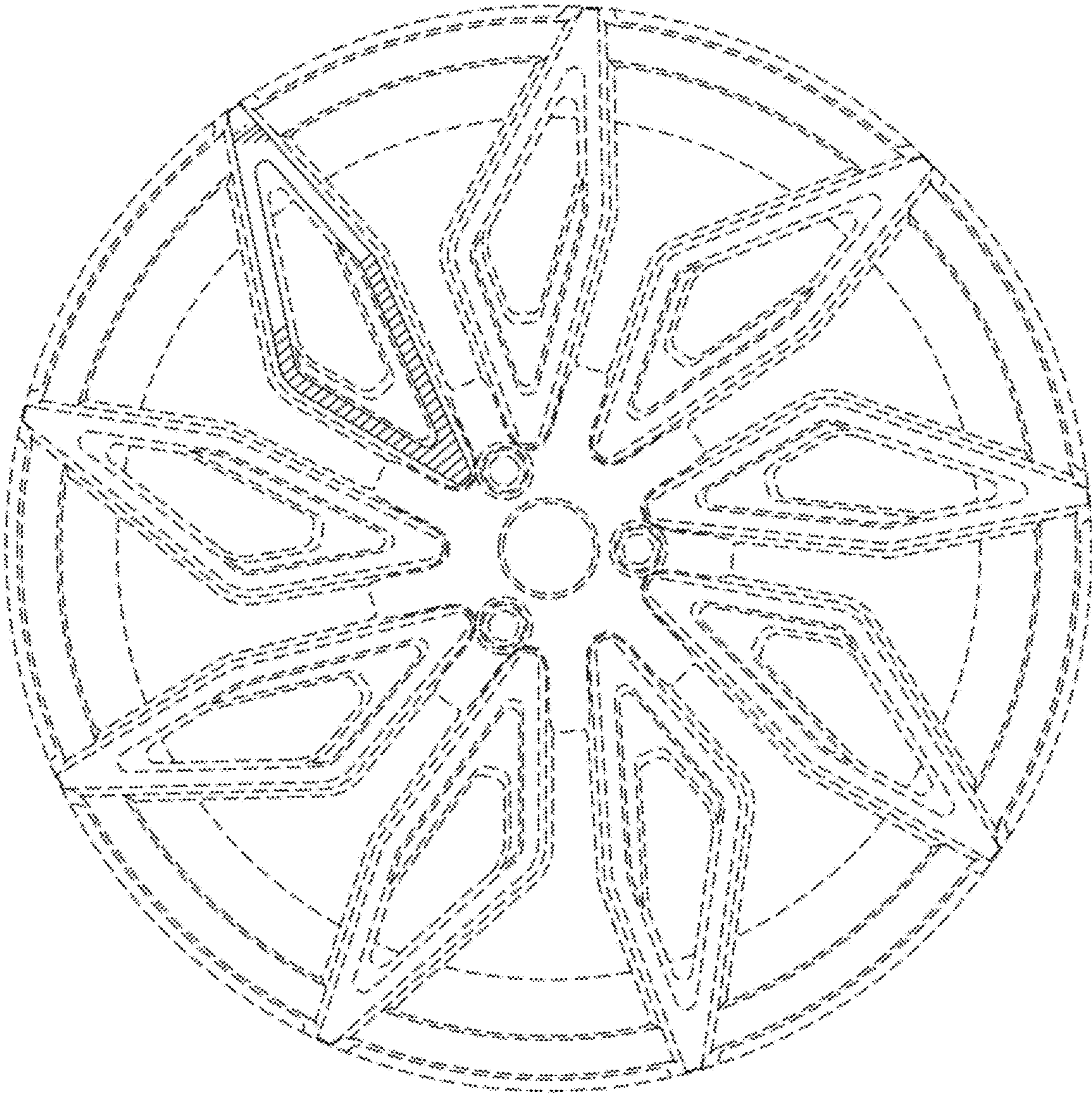
