(57) **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a tissue cleaner, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front view of a tissue cleaner according to an embodiment of the new design;

FIG. 2 is a right view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a front-right-bottom perspective view thereof;

FIG. 9 is a magnified view of a portion of the tissue cleaner shown in FIG. 8;

FIG. 10 is a front view of a tissue cleaner according to another embodiment of the new design;

FIG. 16 is a magnified view of a portion of the tissue cleaner shown in FIG. 15; and

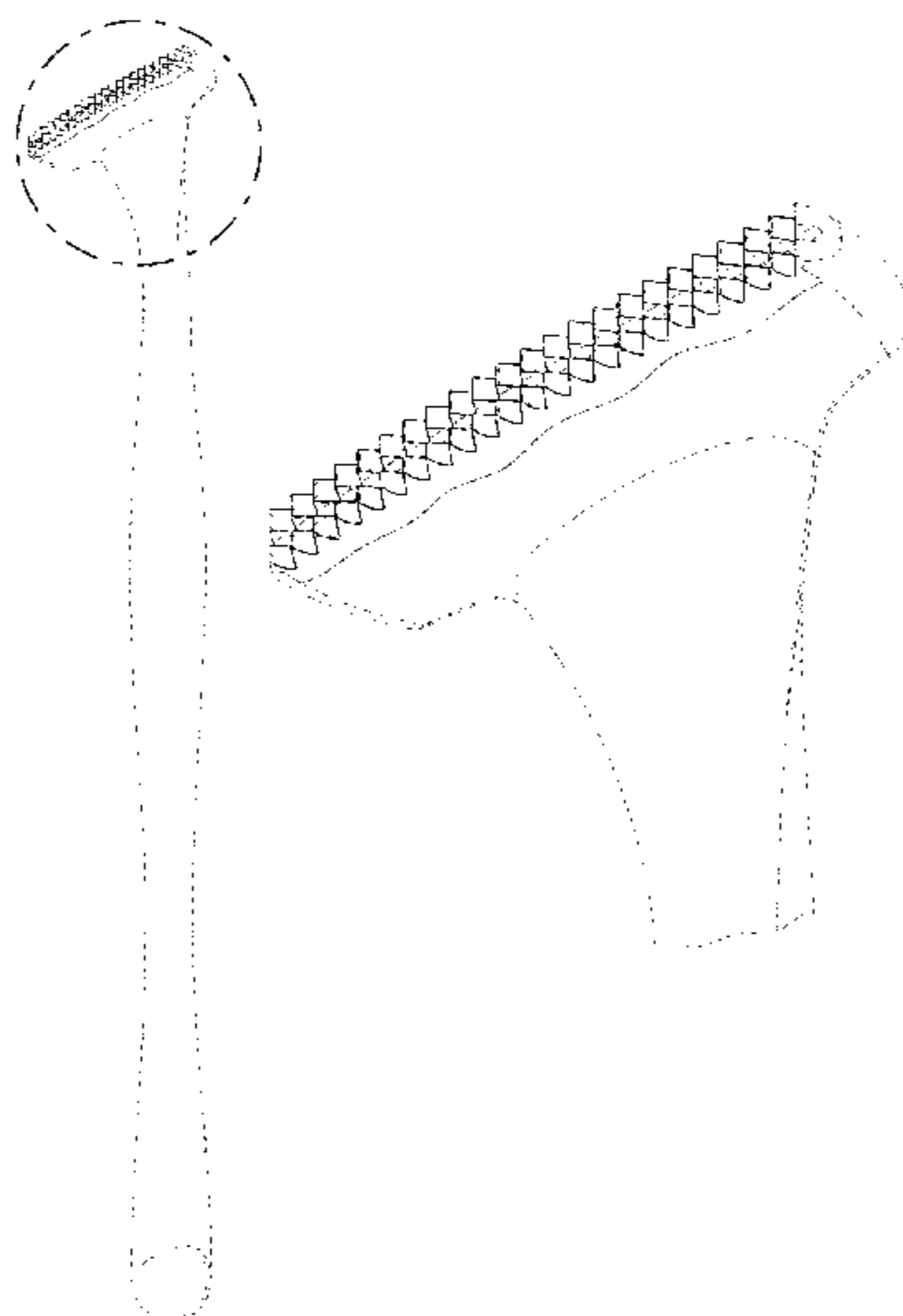
FIG. 17 is a front-left bottom perspective view thereof; and,

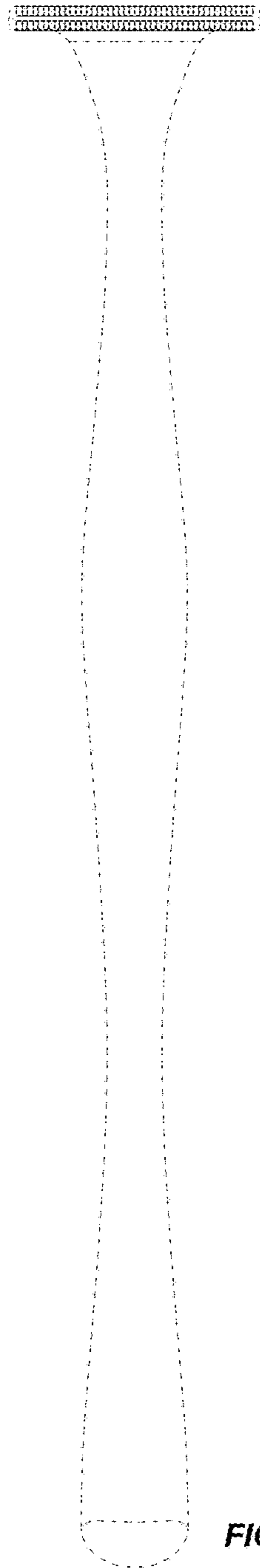

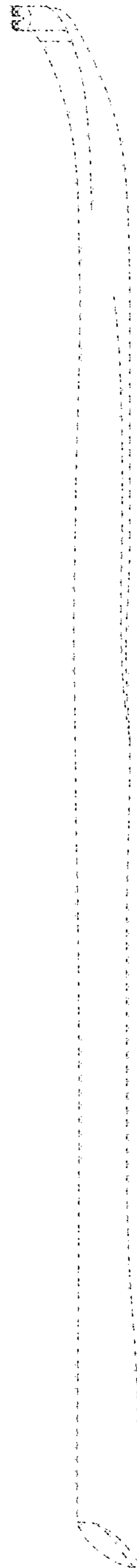

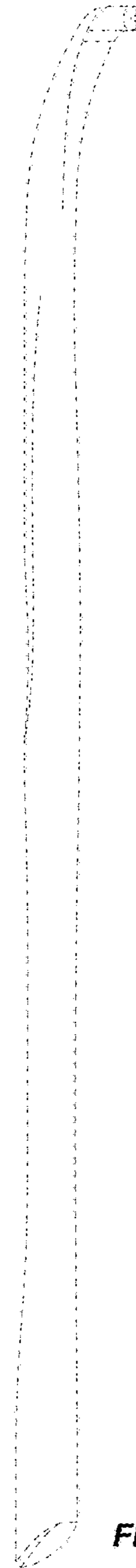

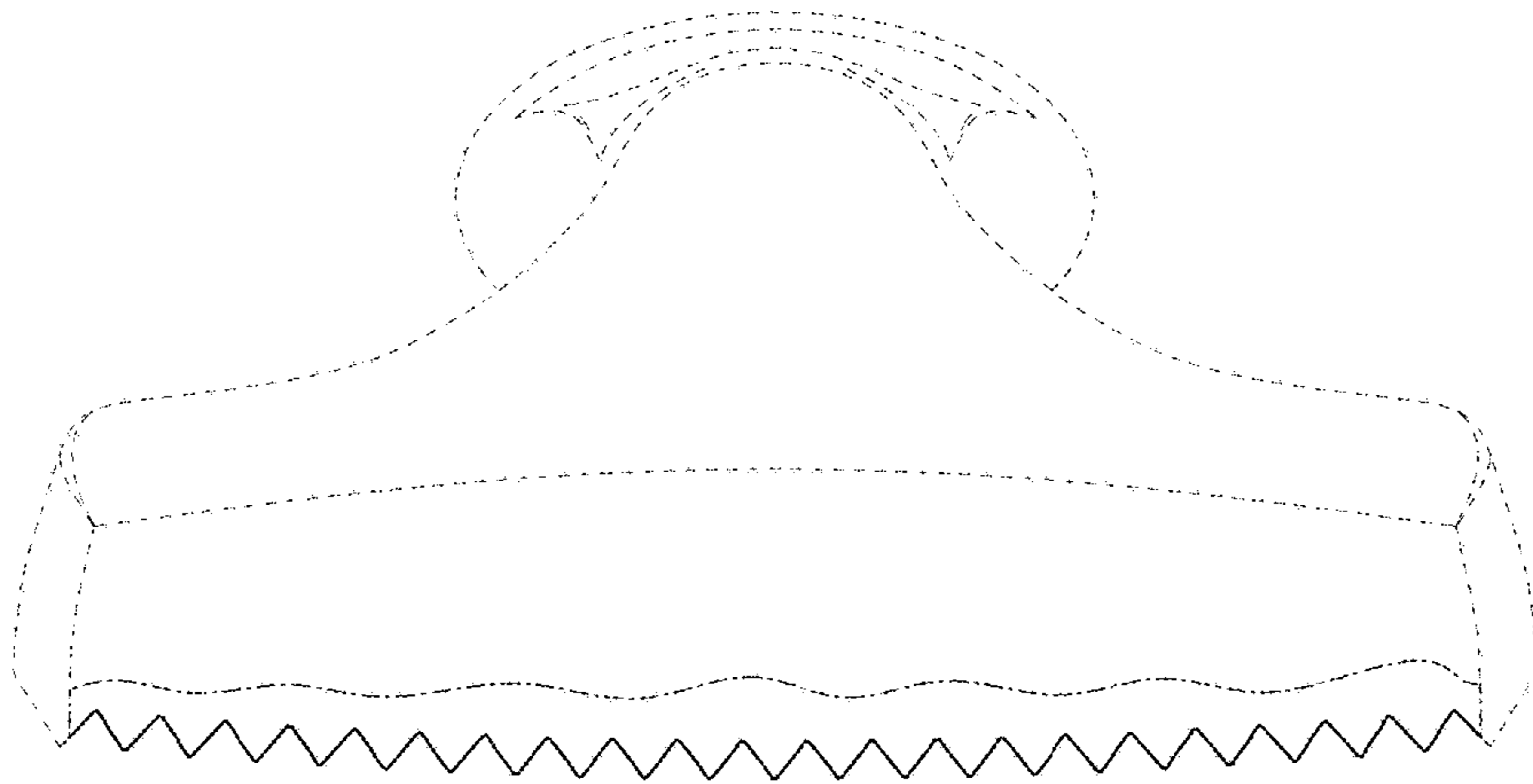

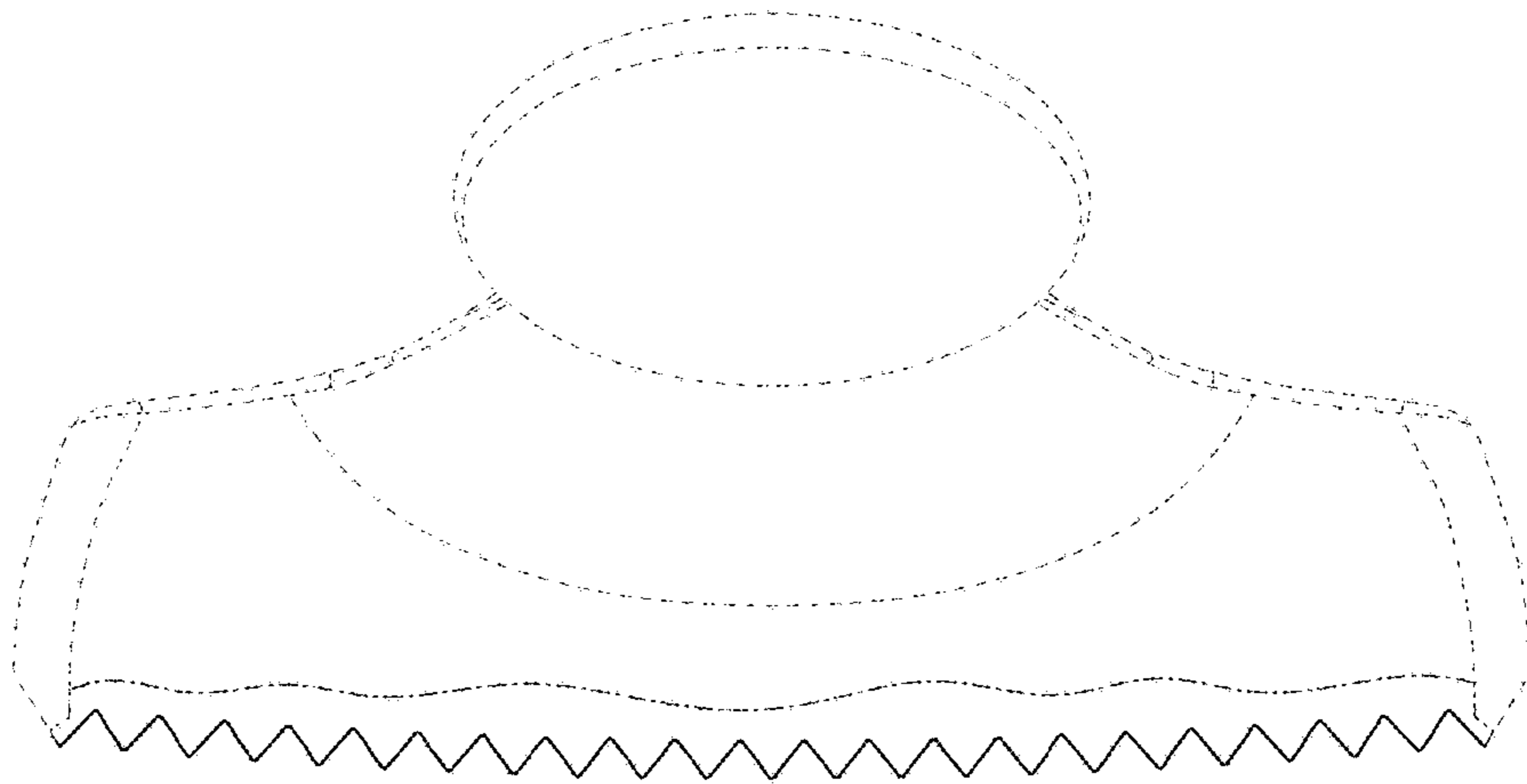

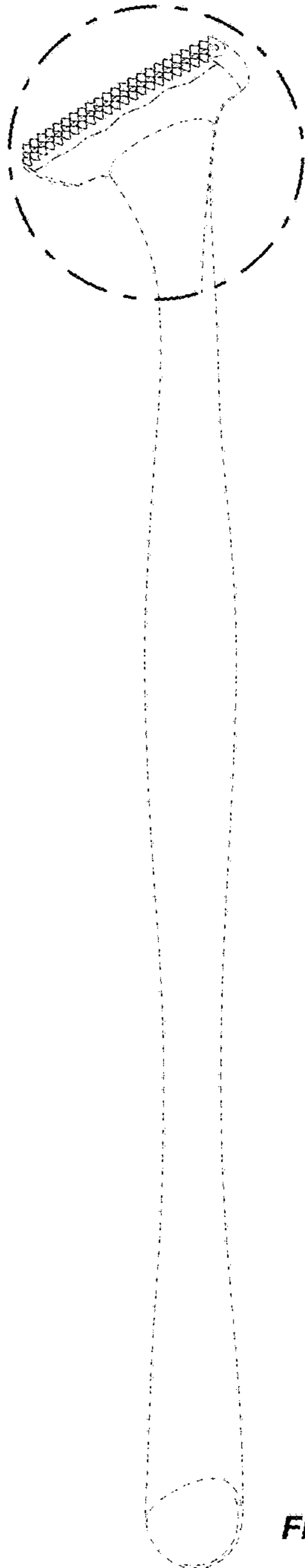

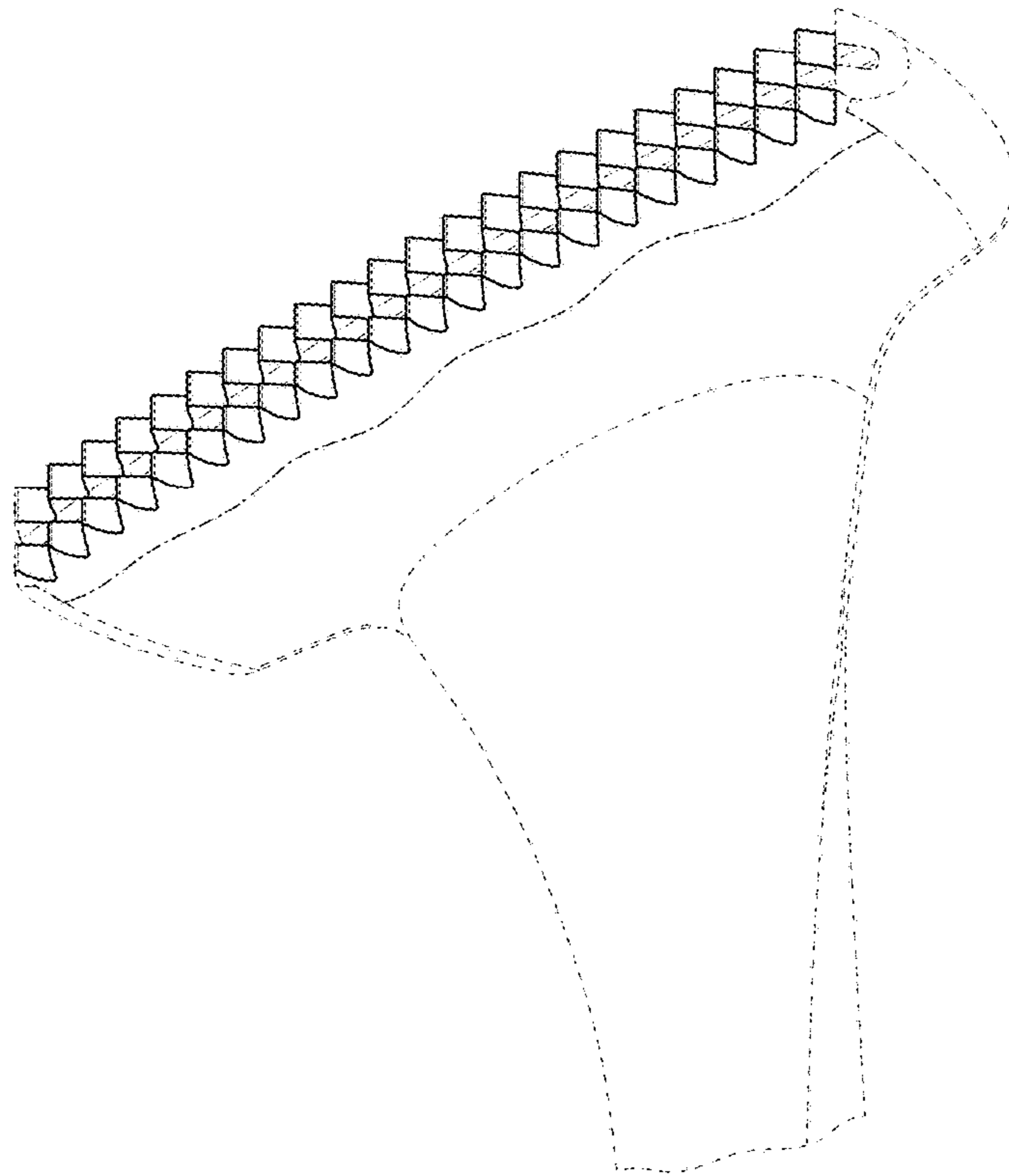

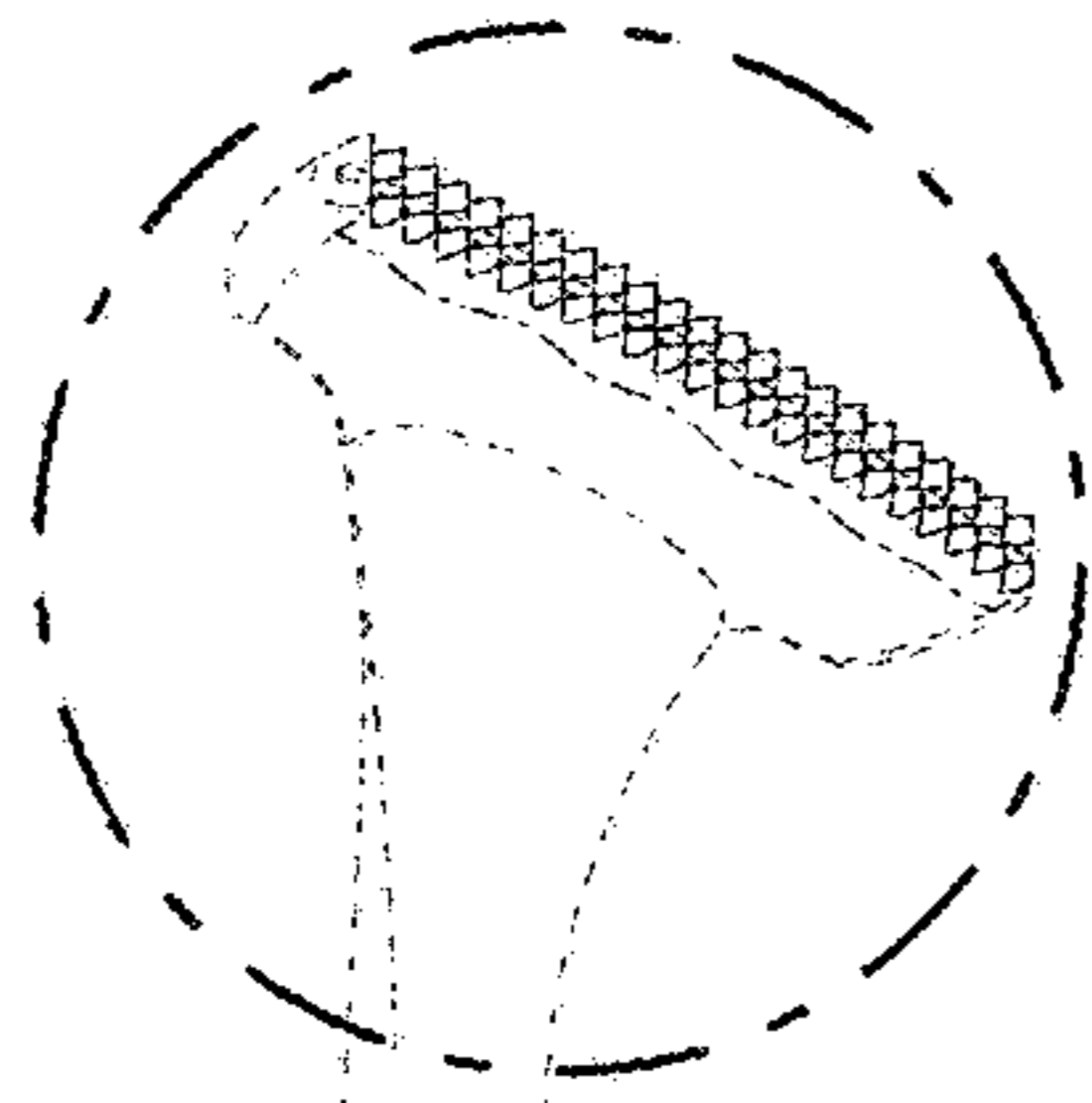

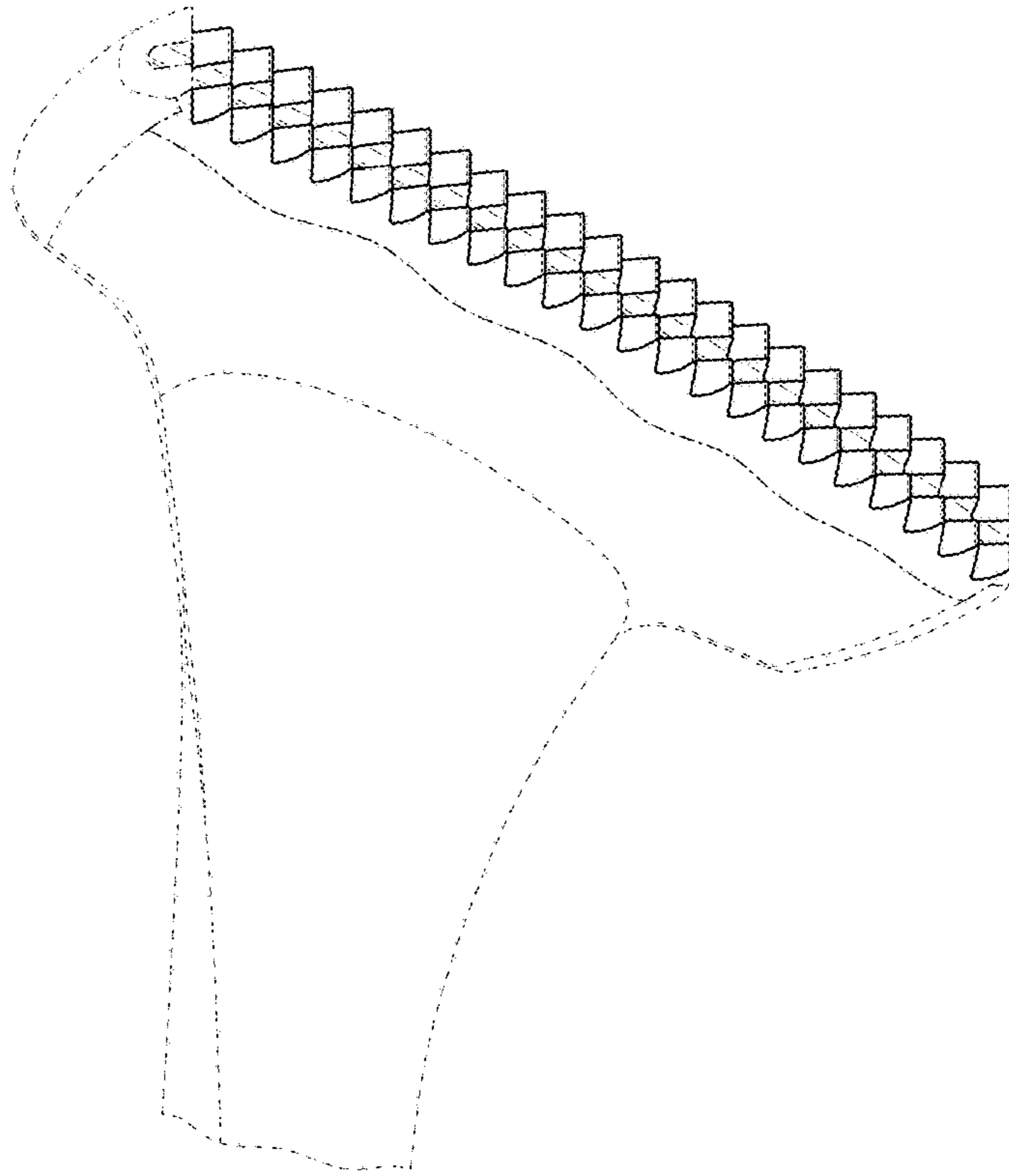

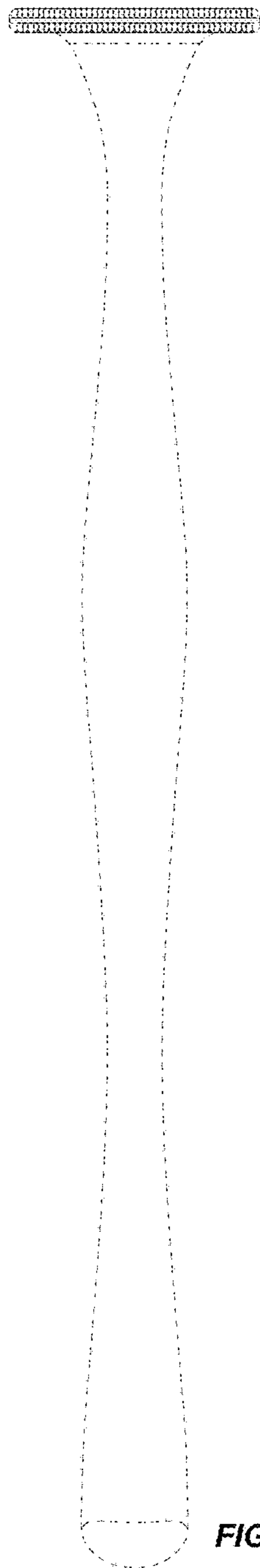

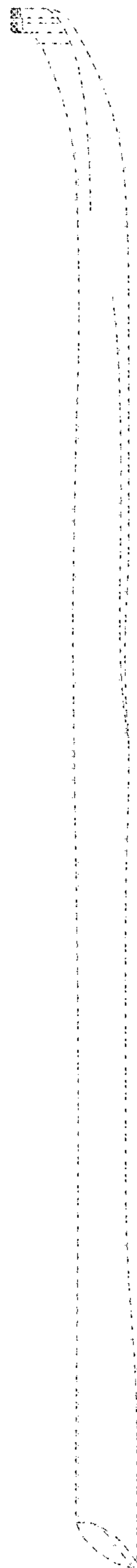

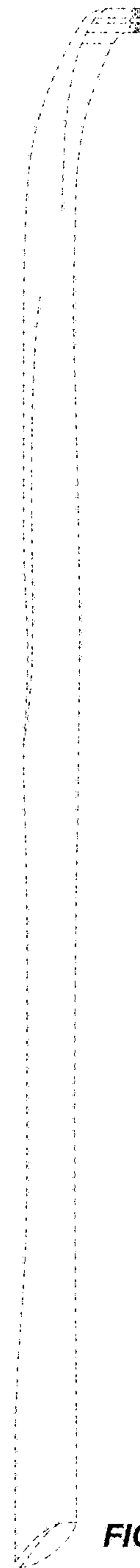

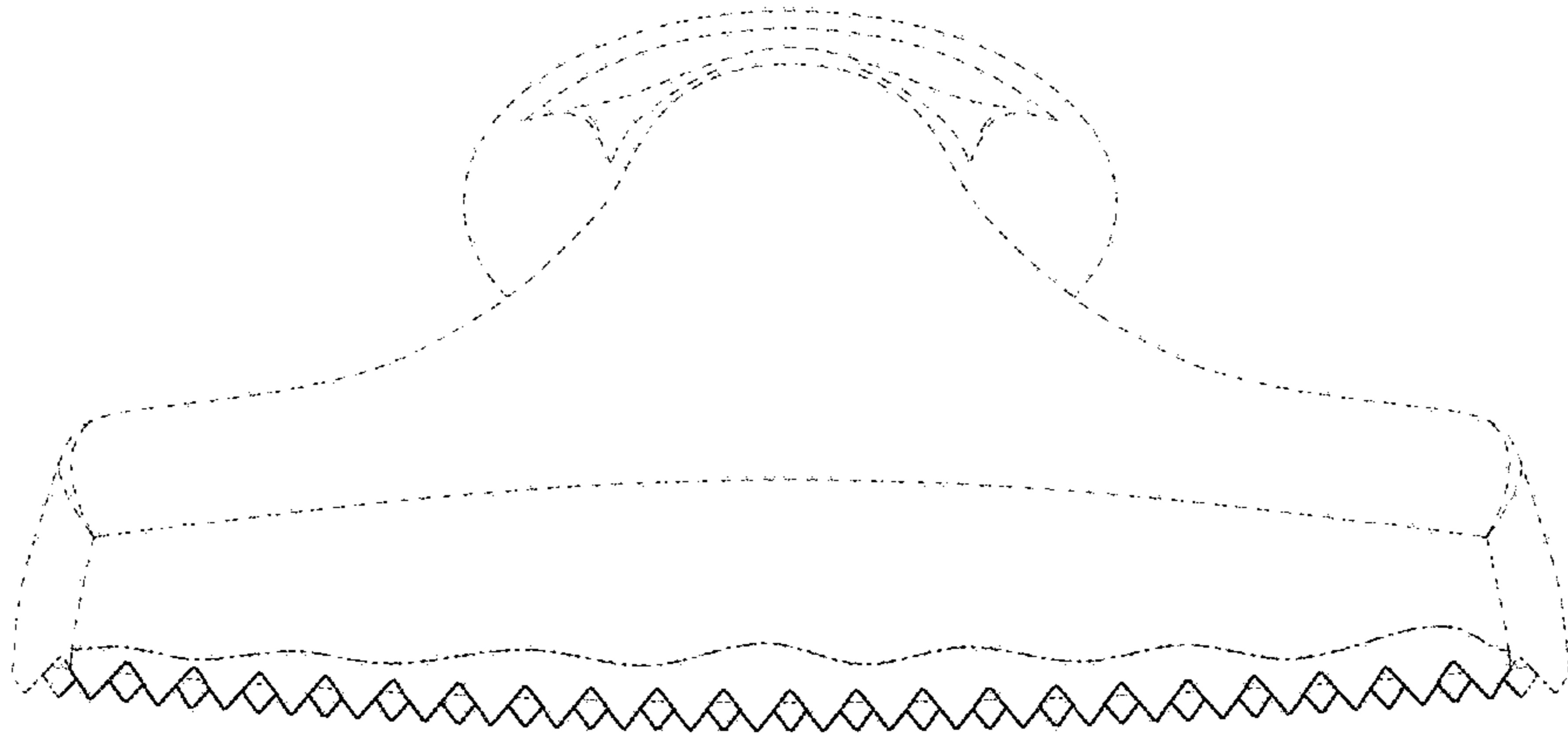

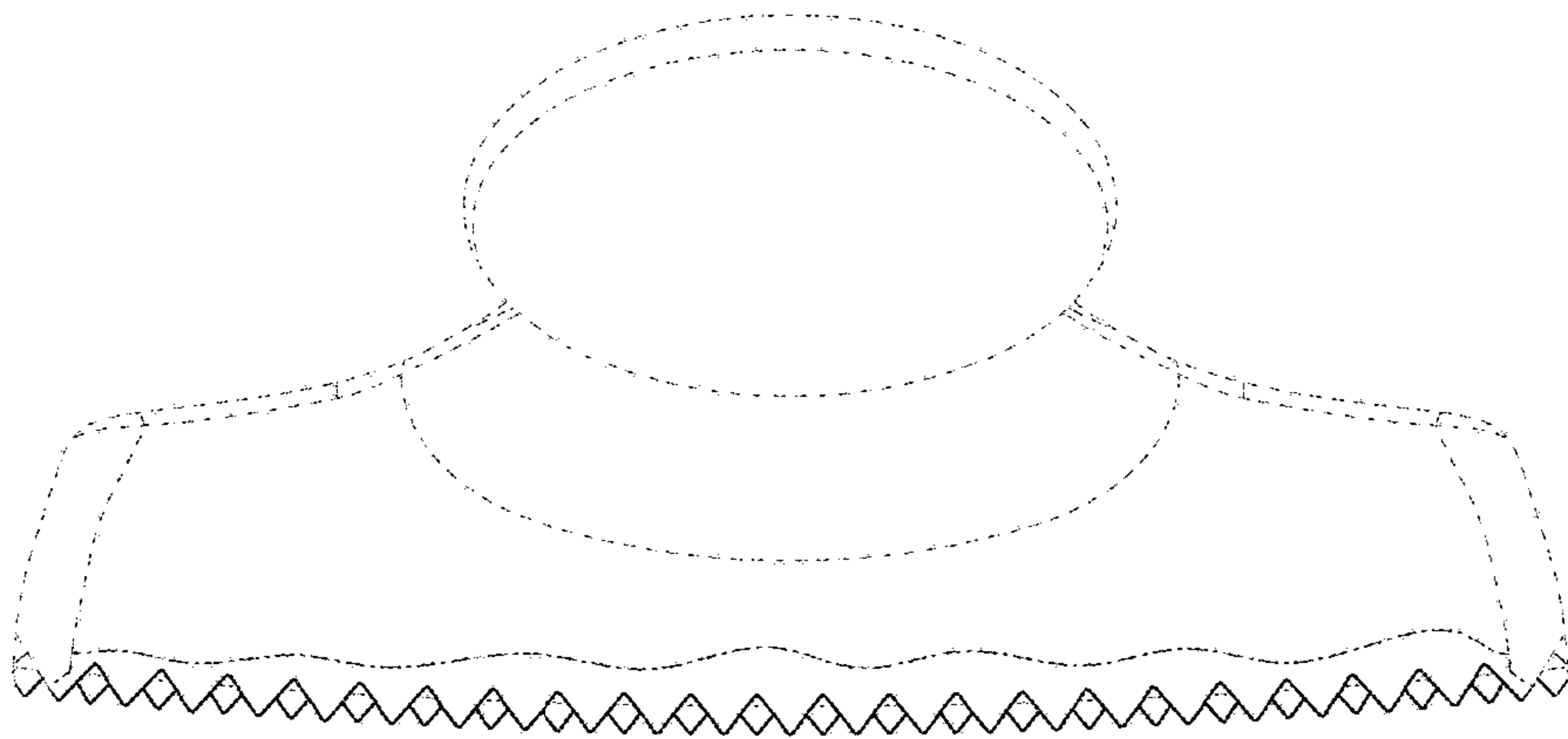

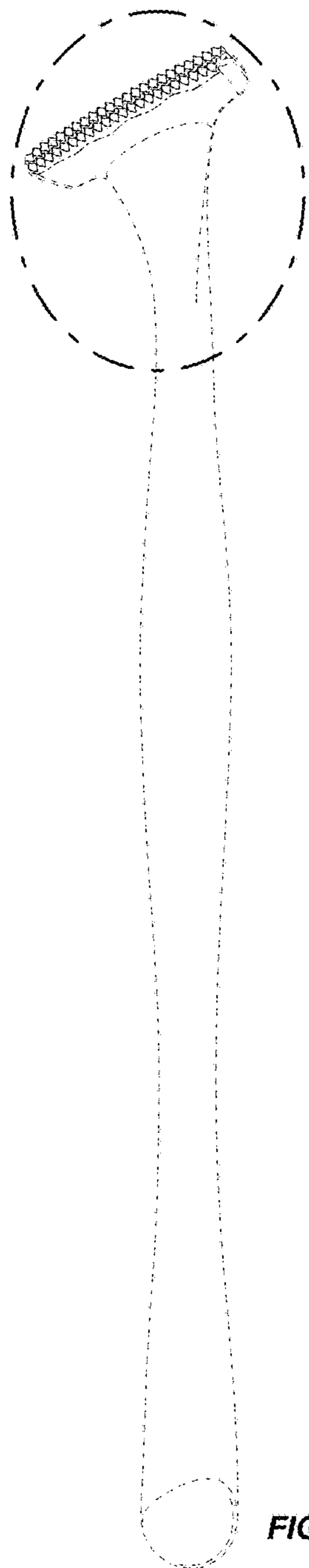

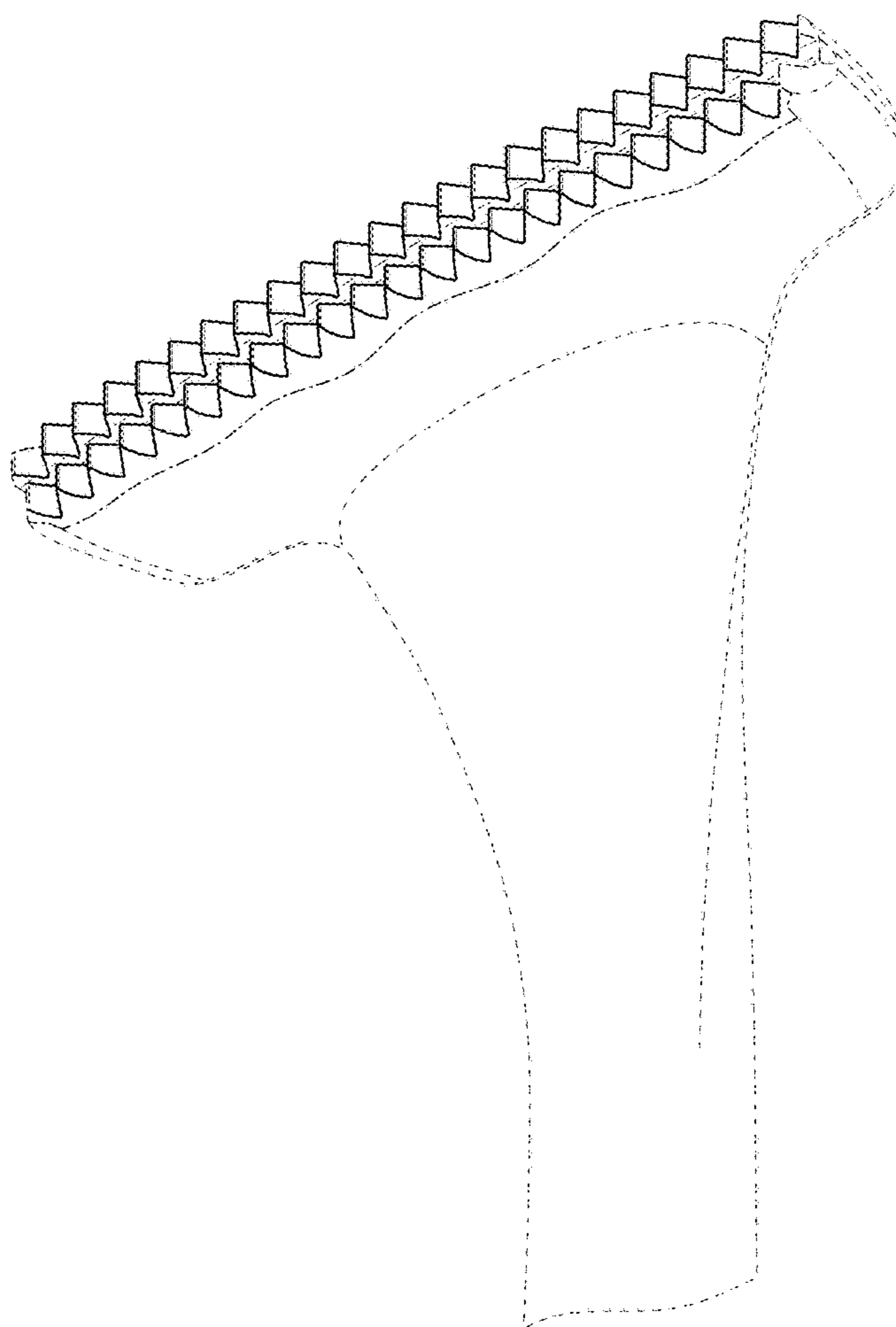
