FIG. 7 is a second side view thereof.

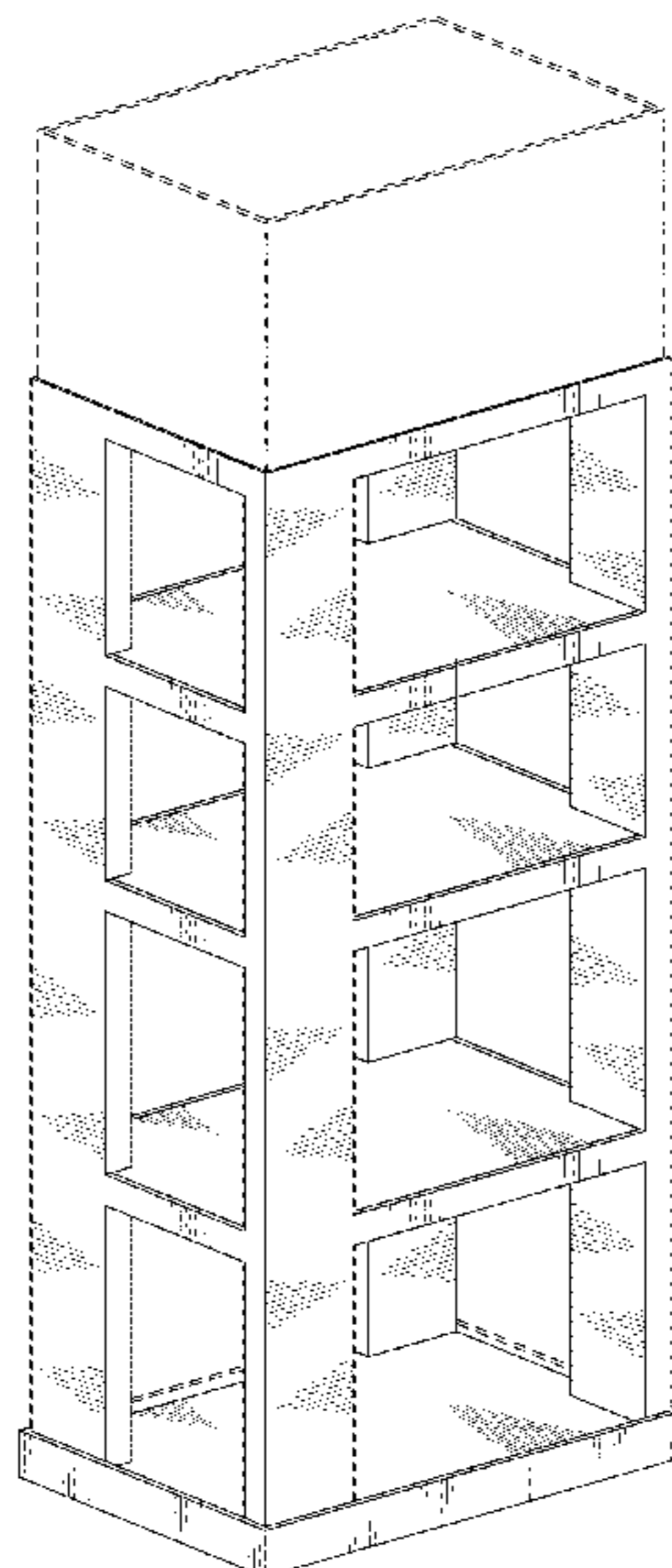

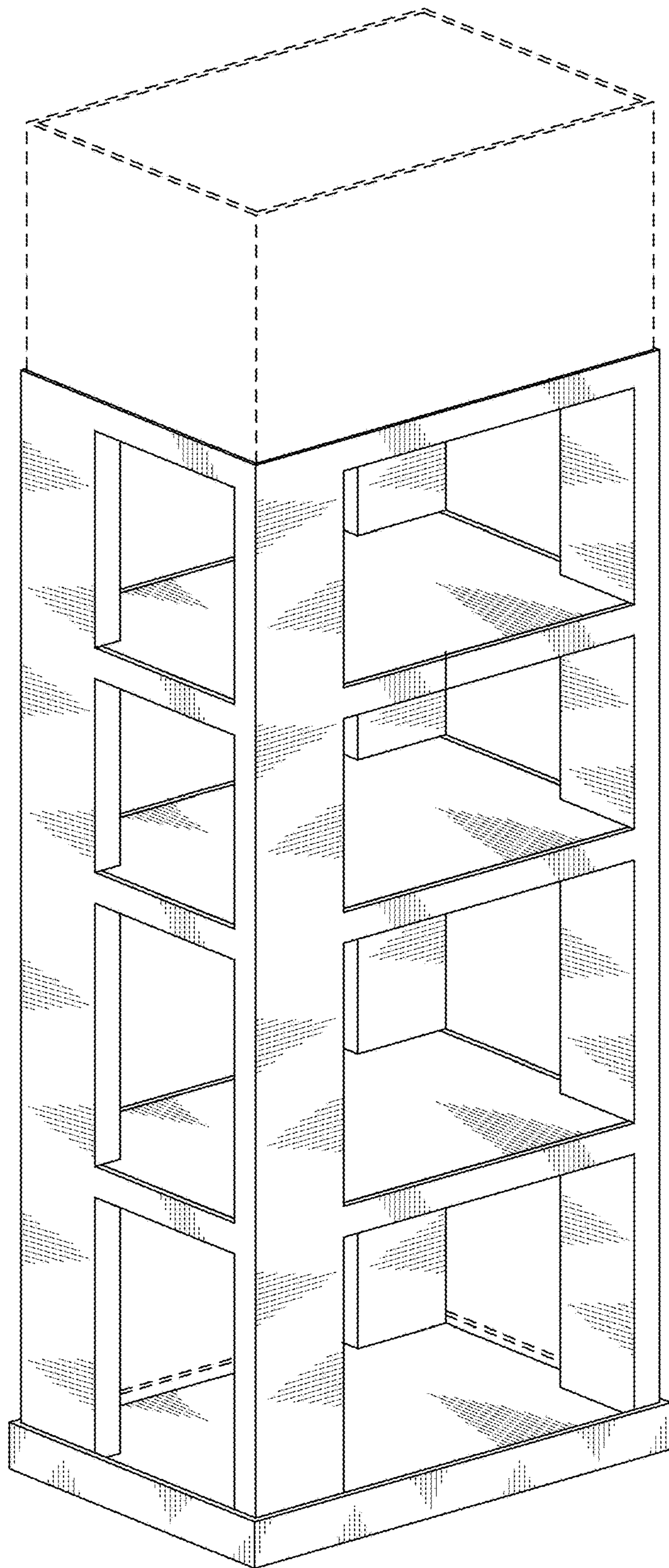

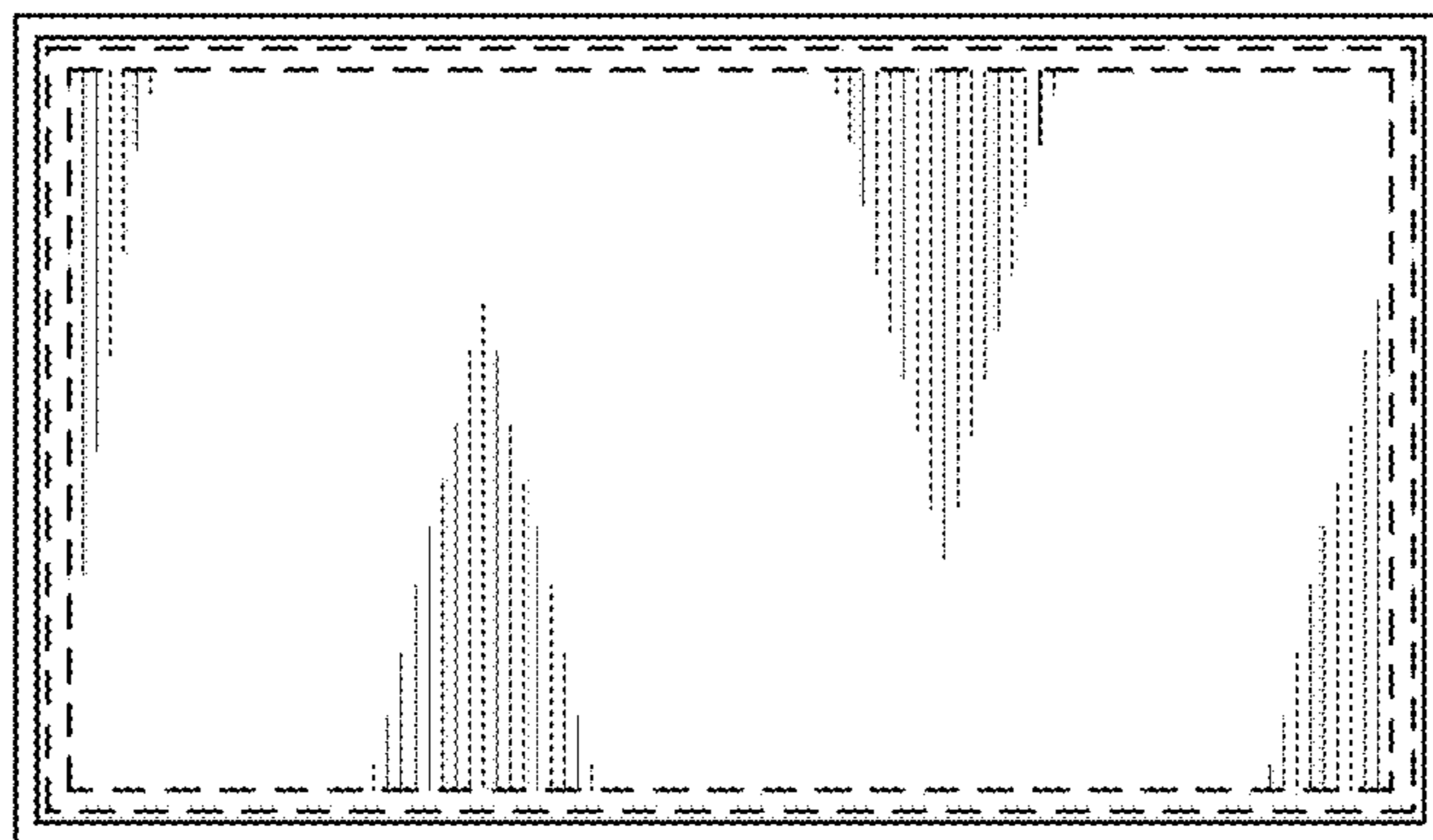

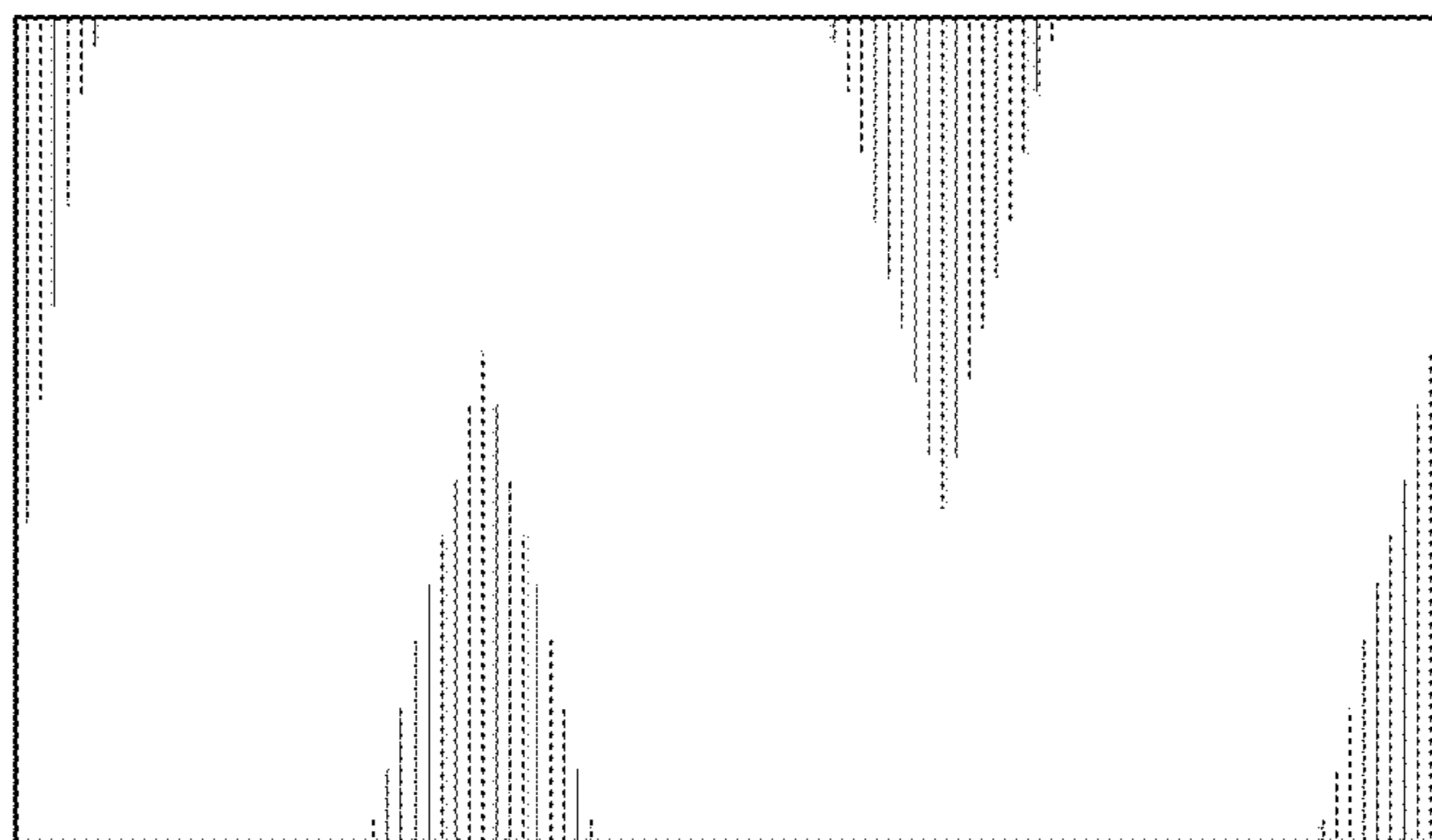

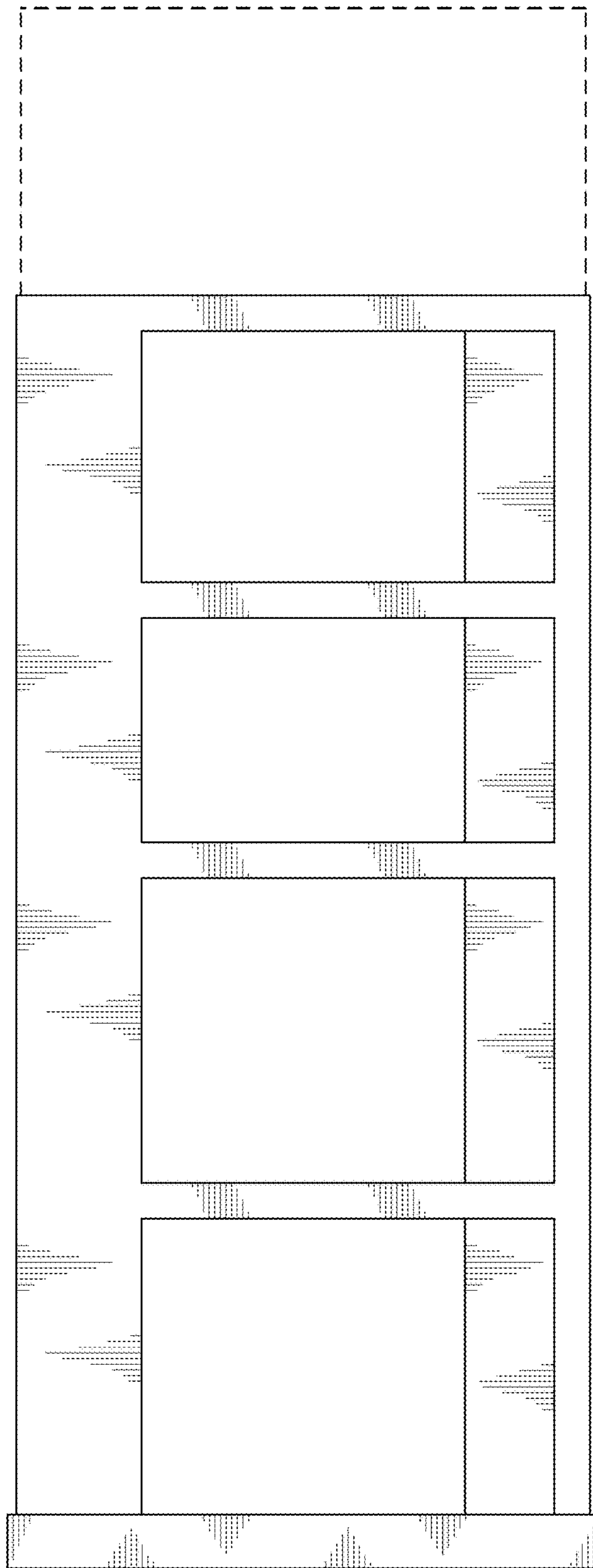

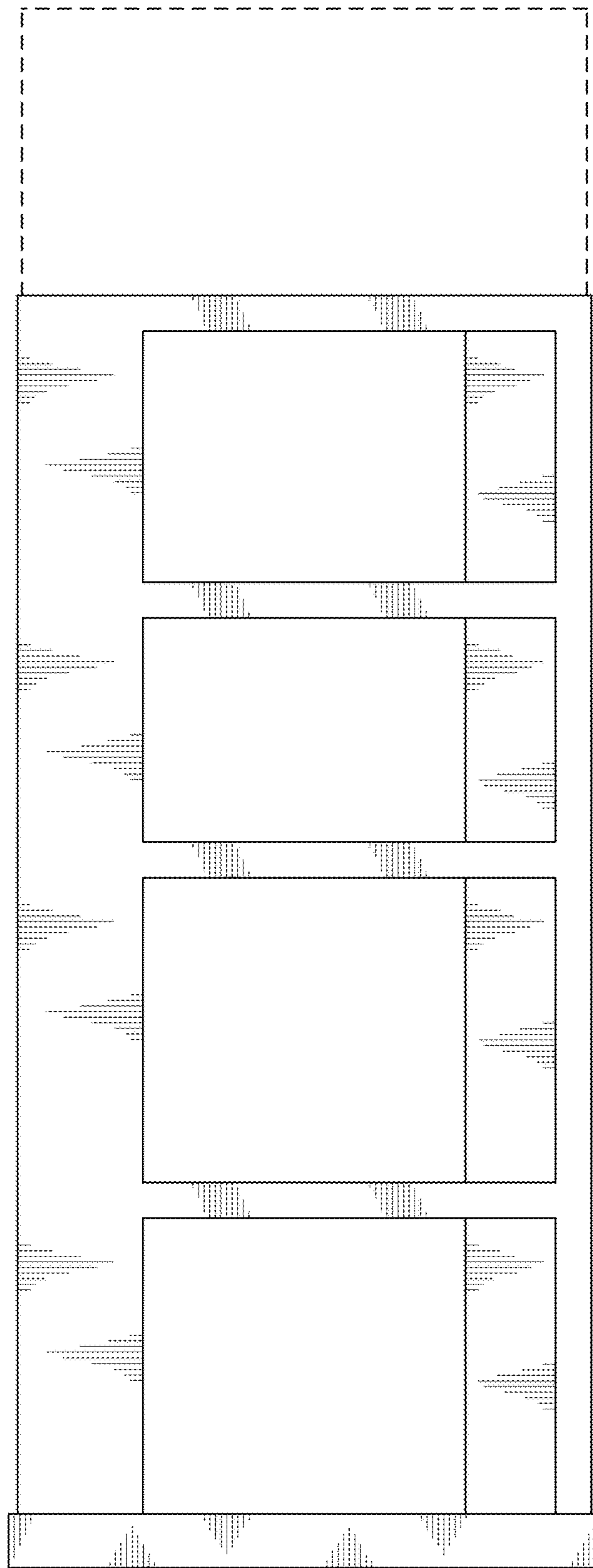

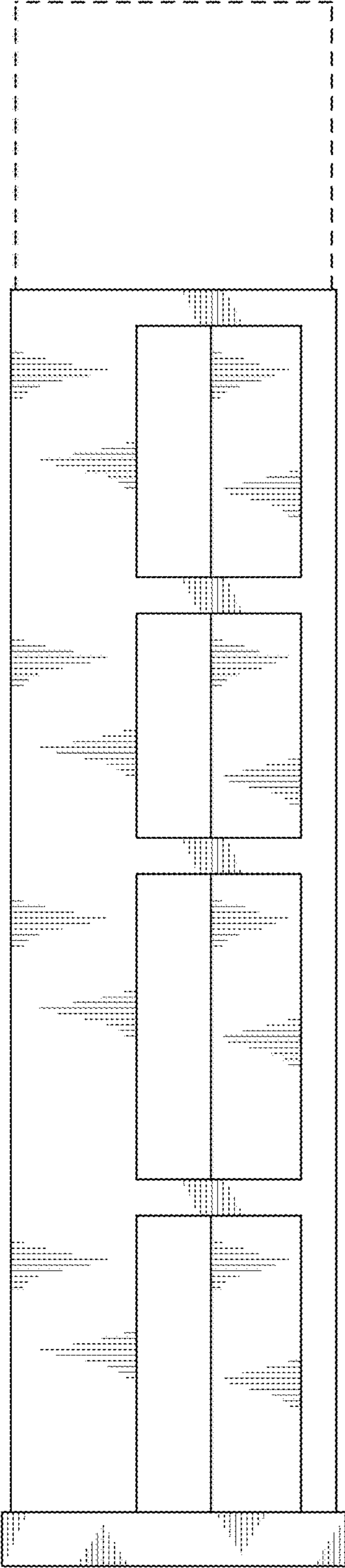

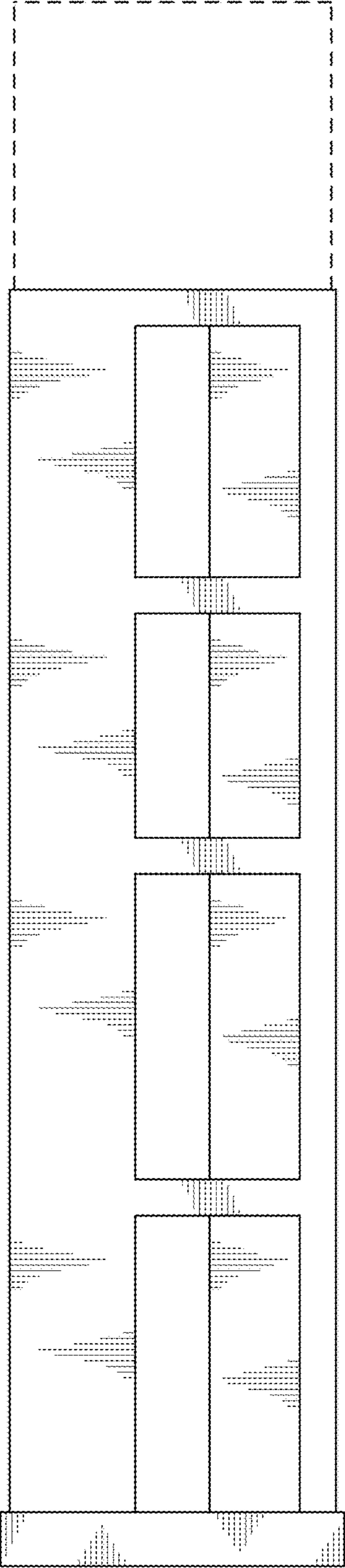
