FIG. 21 is a right side view thereof;

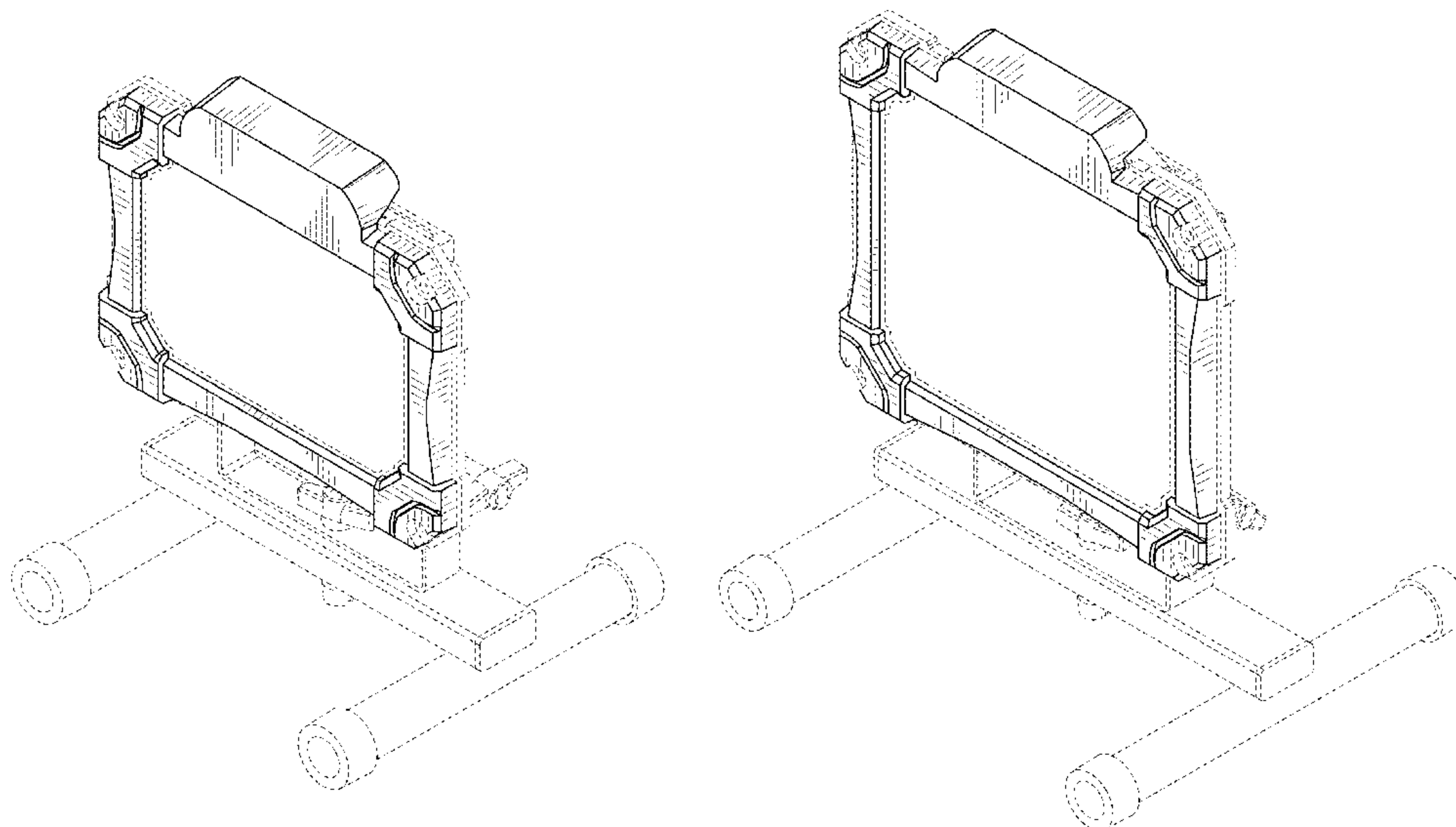
FIG. 22 is a top side view thereof;

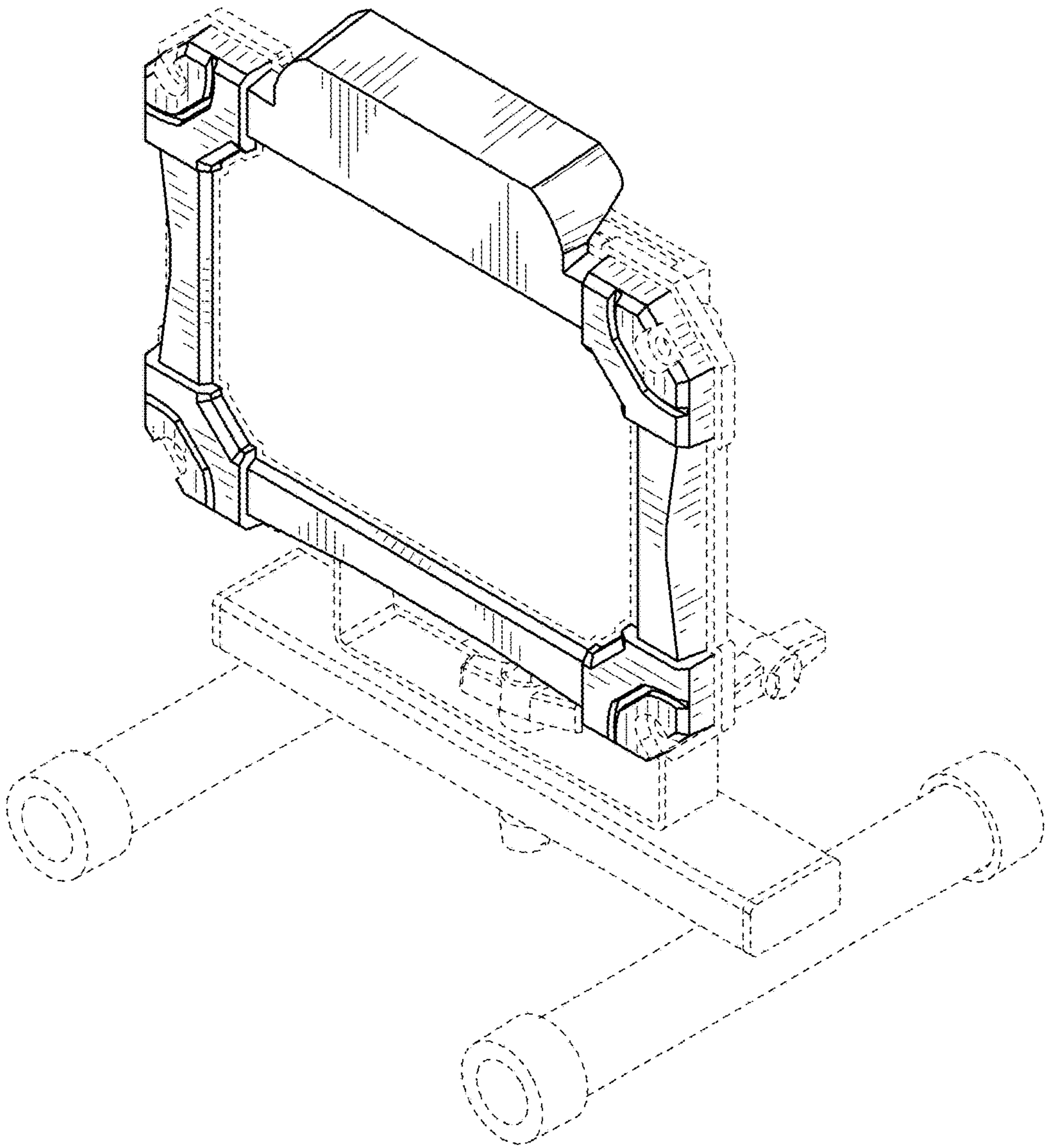

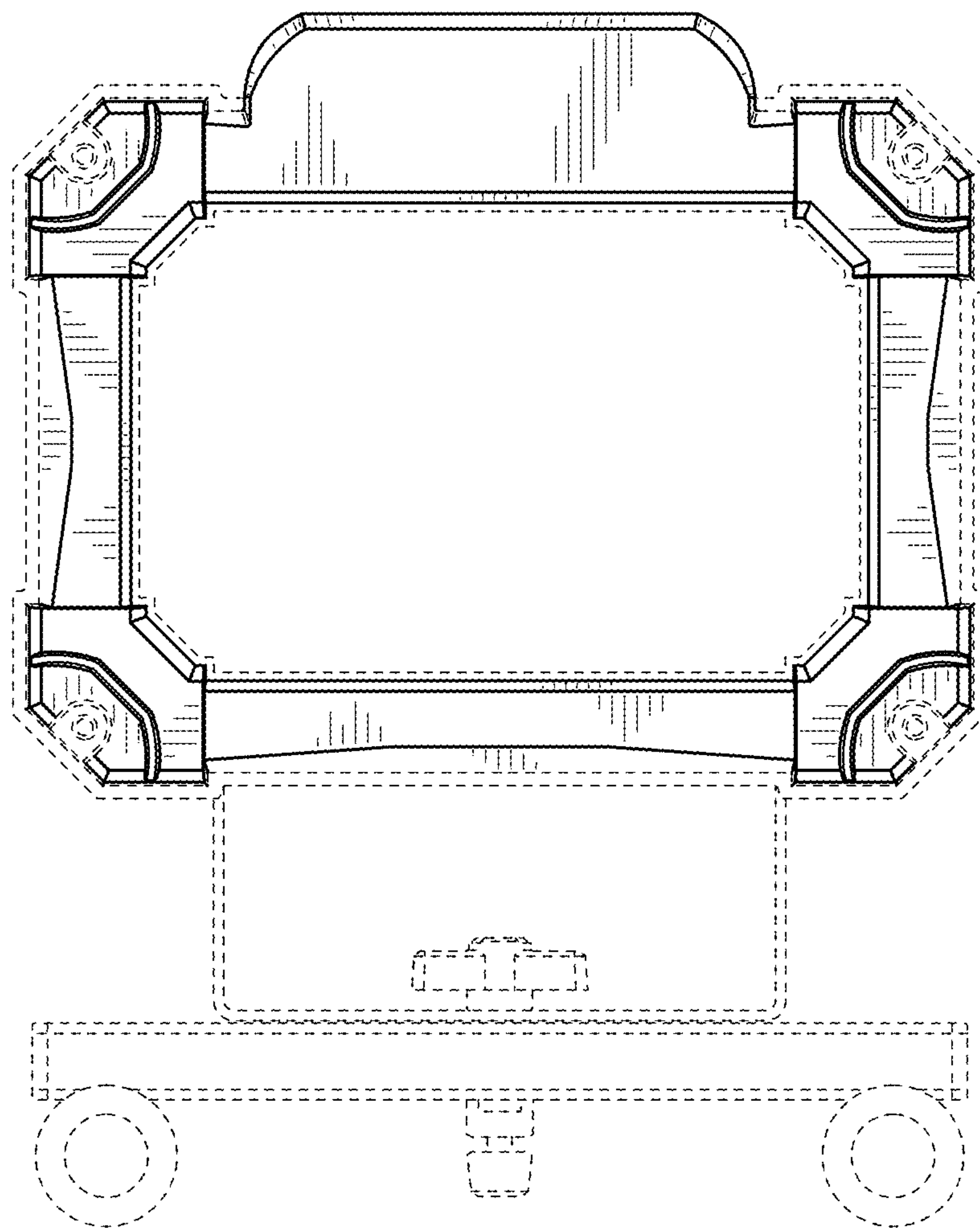

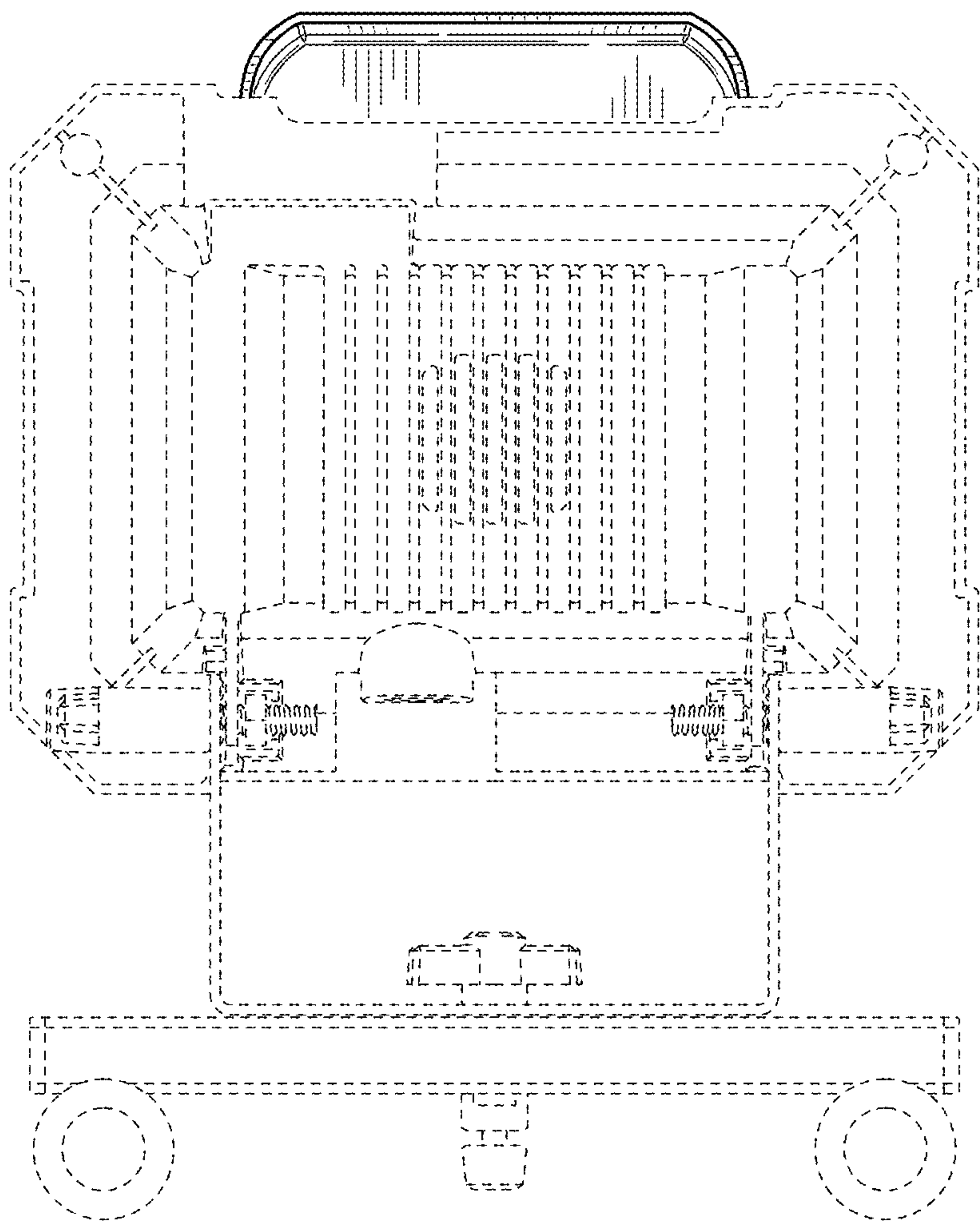

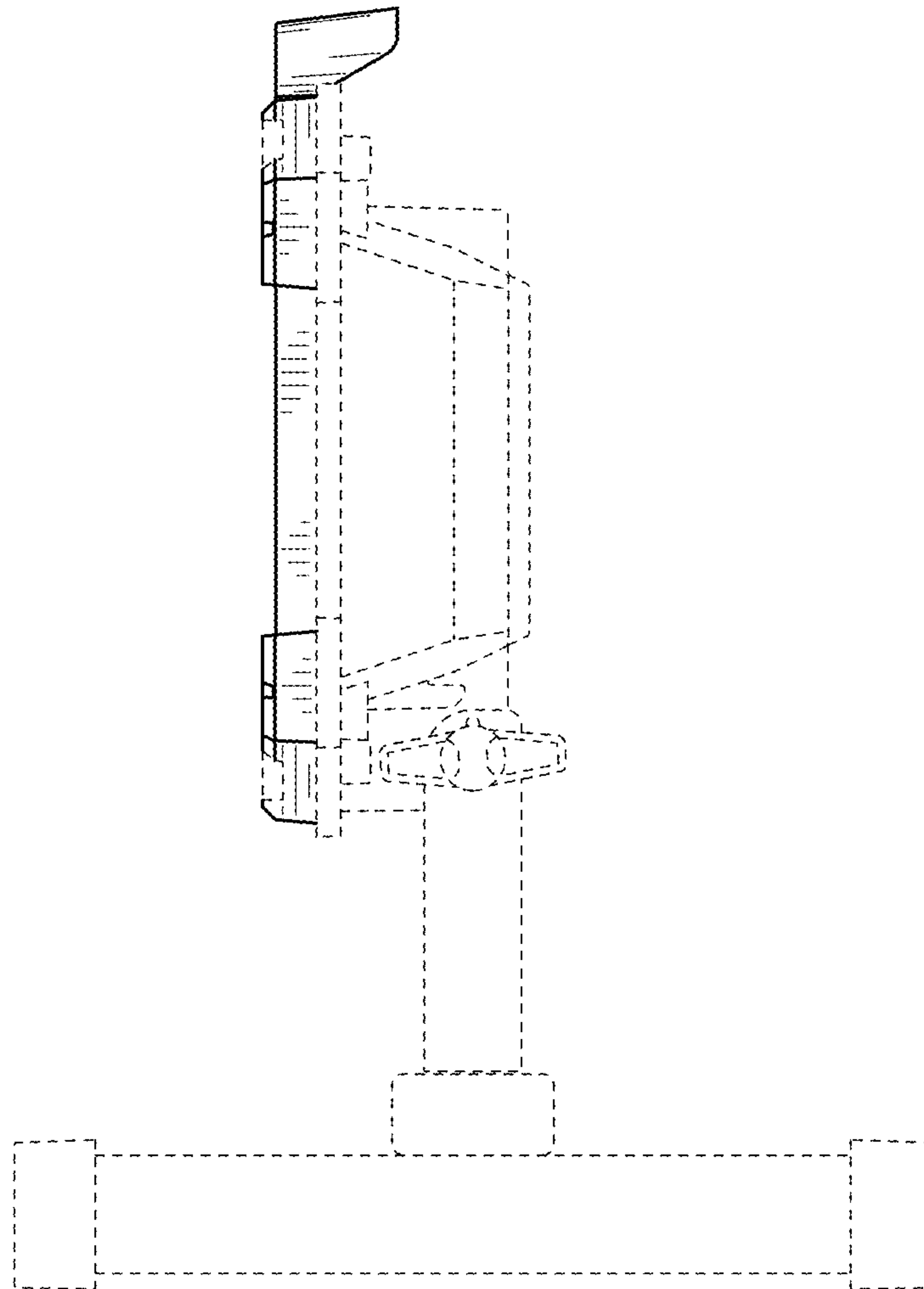

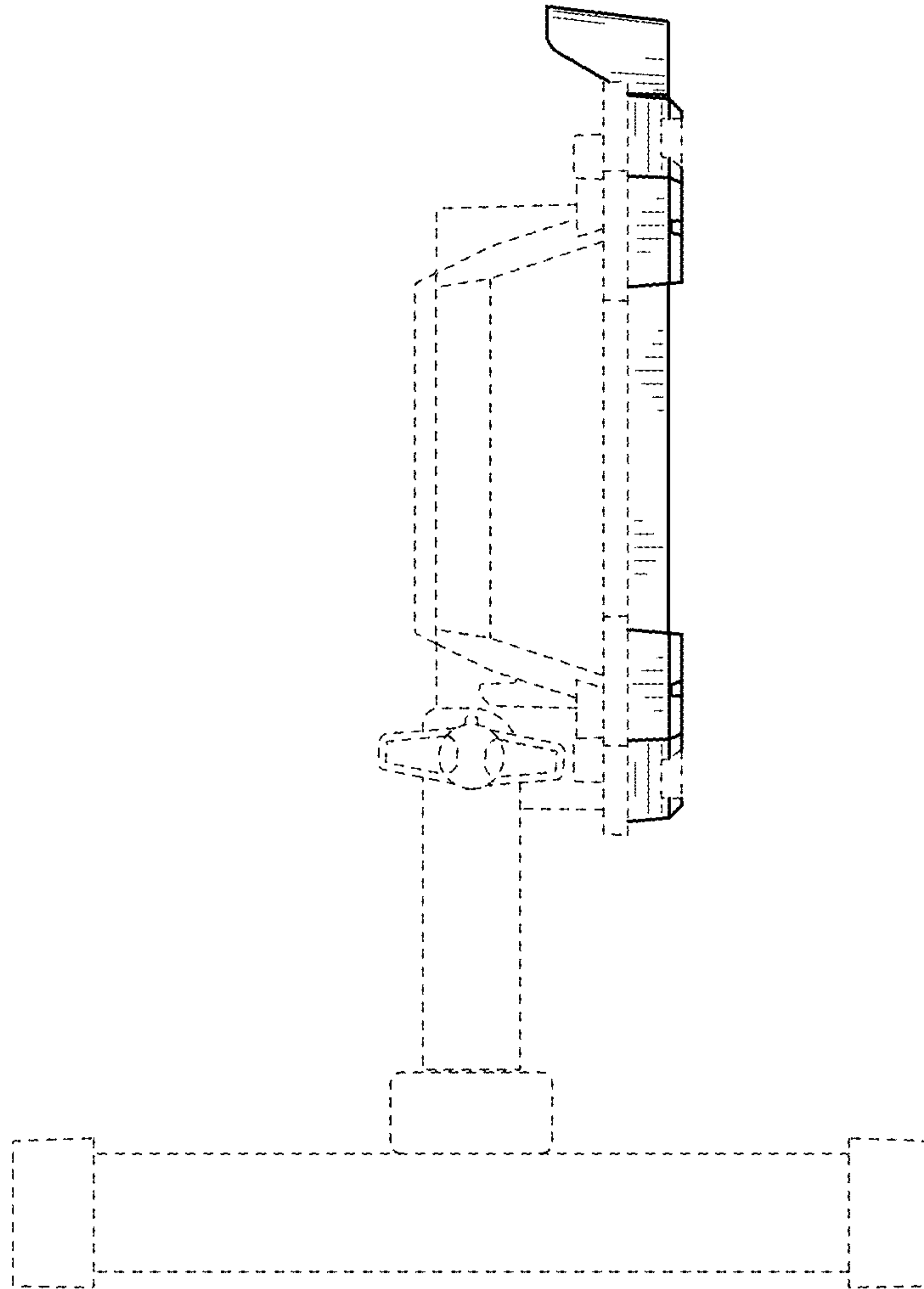

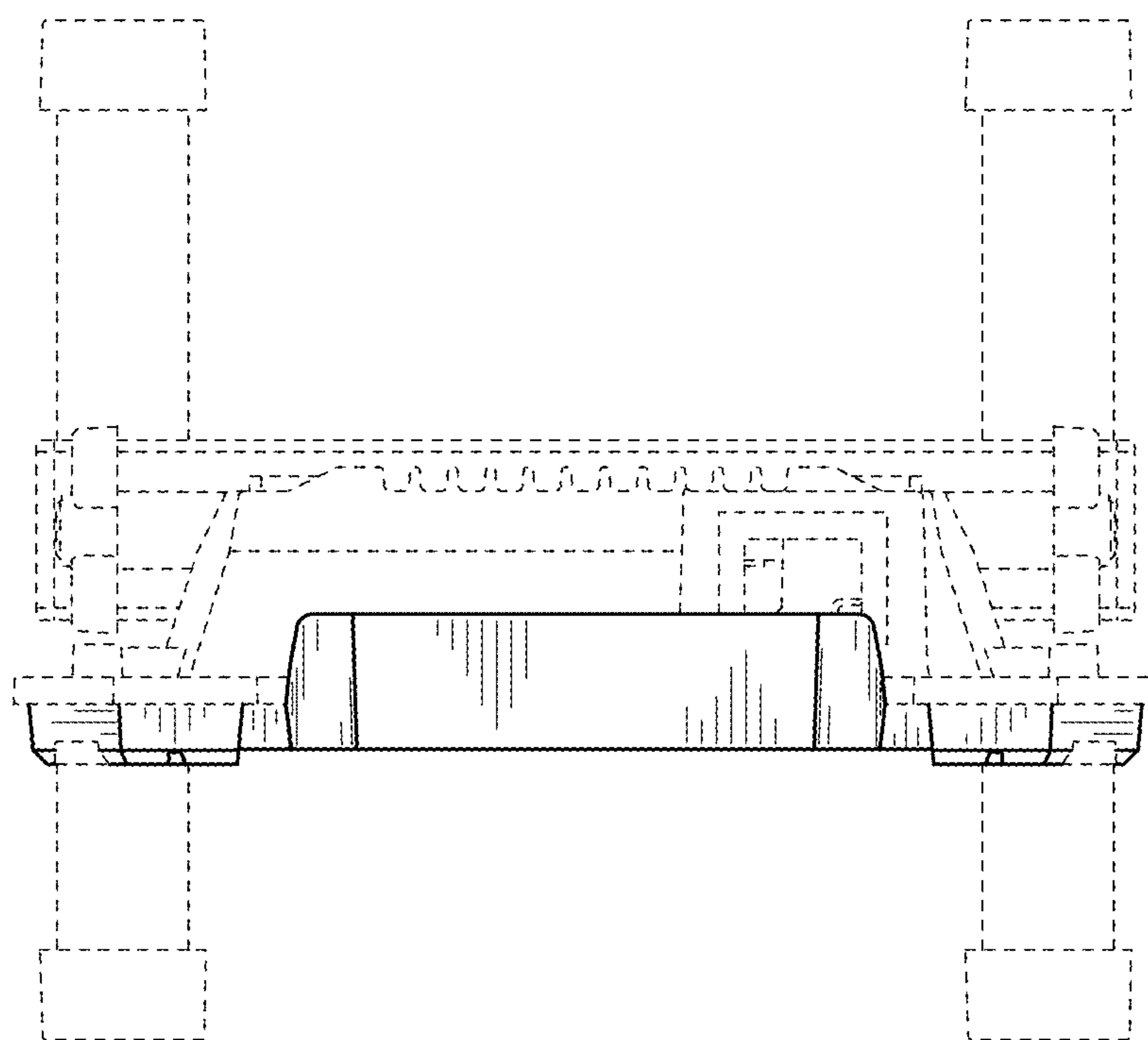

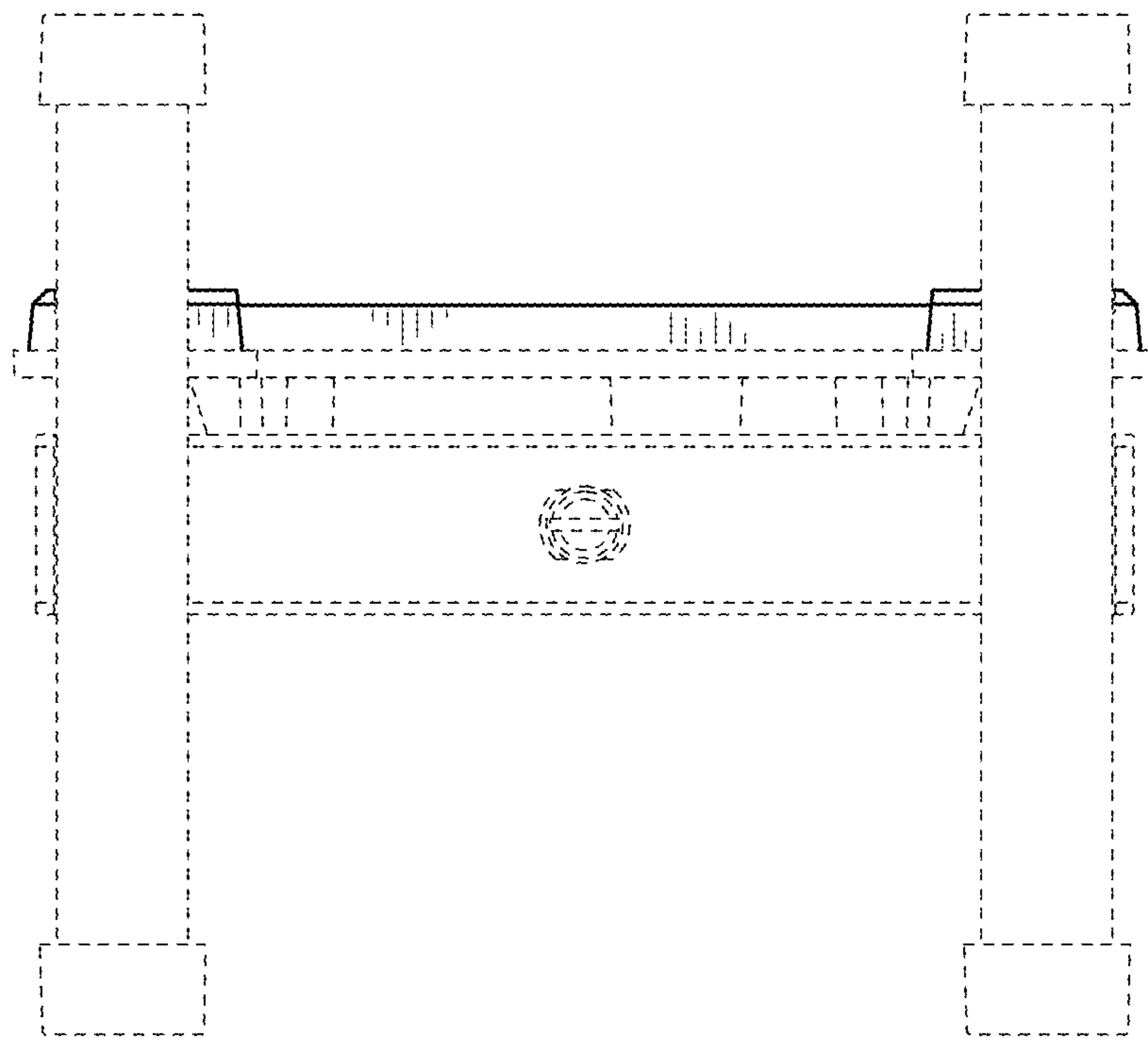

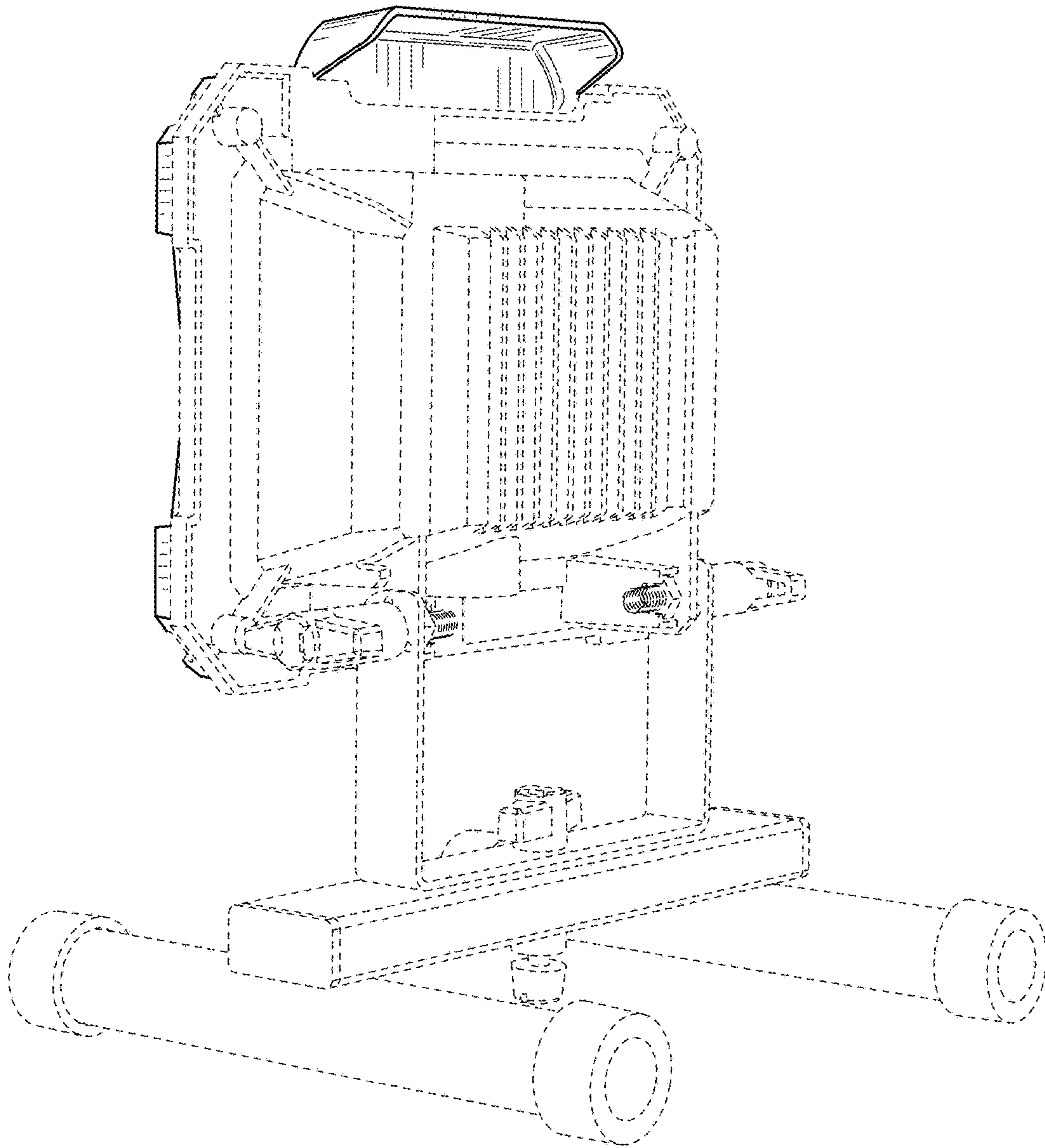

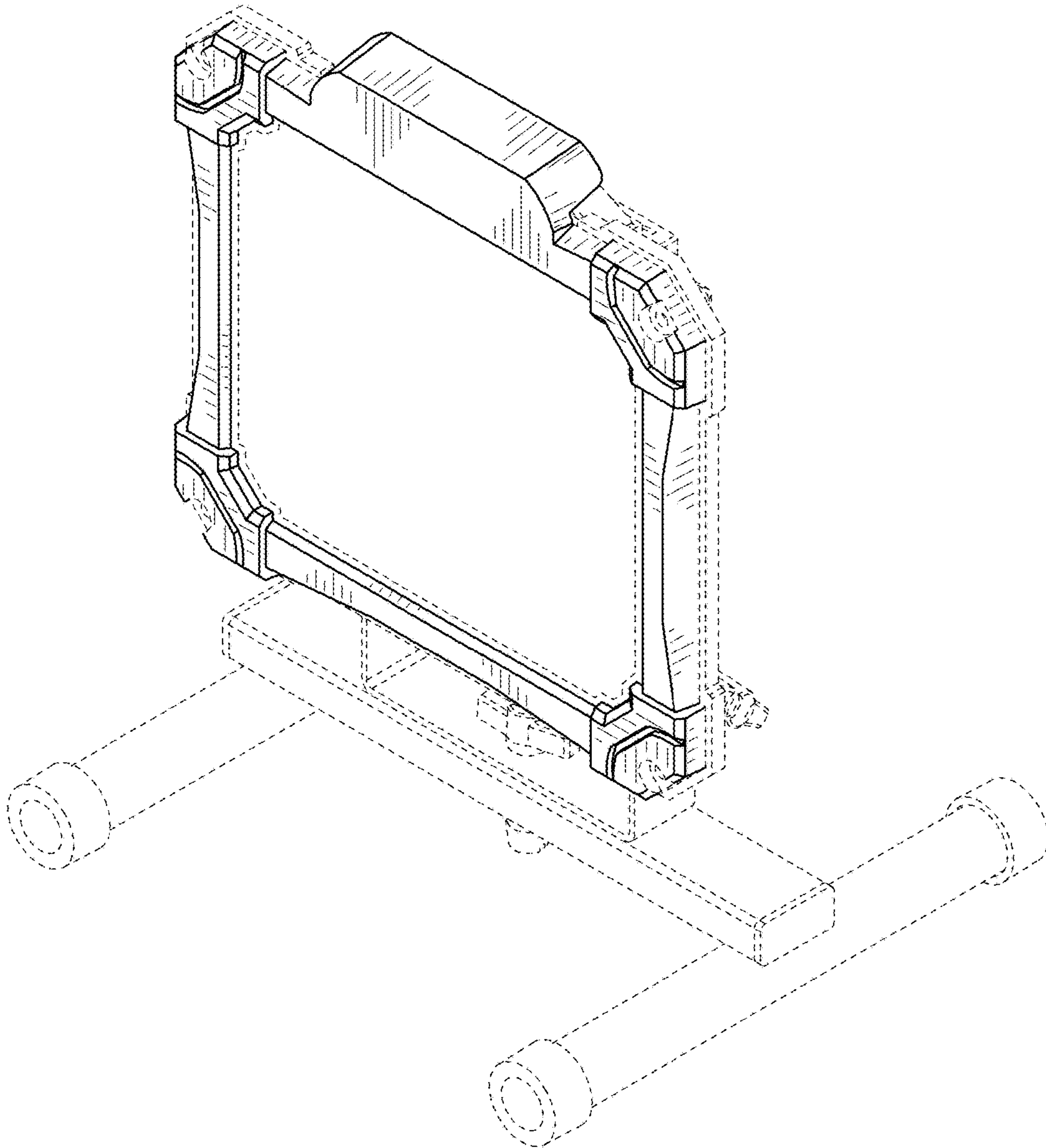

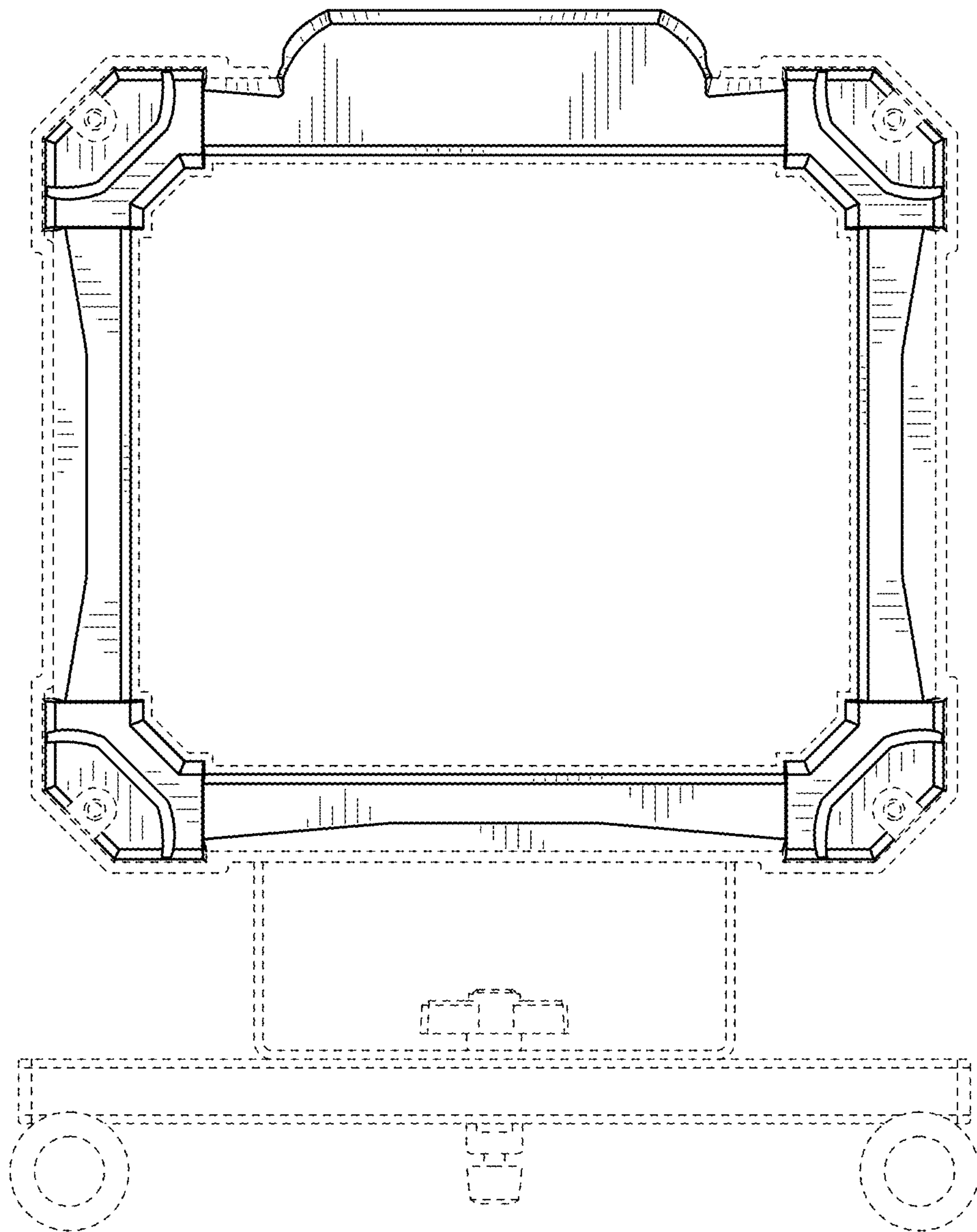

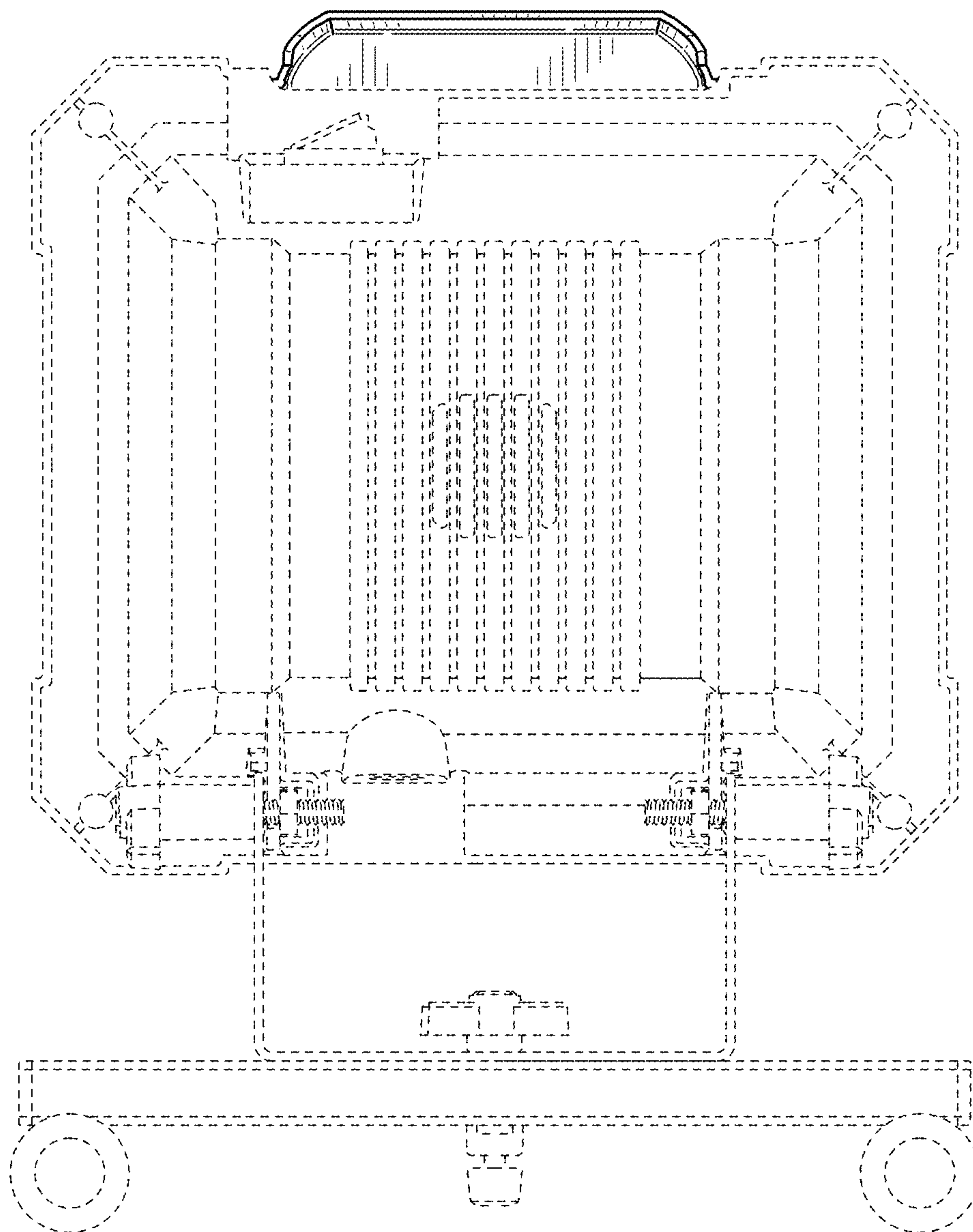

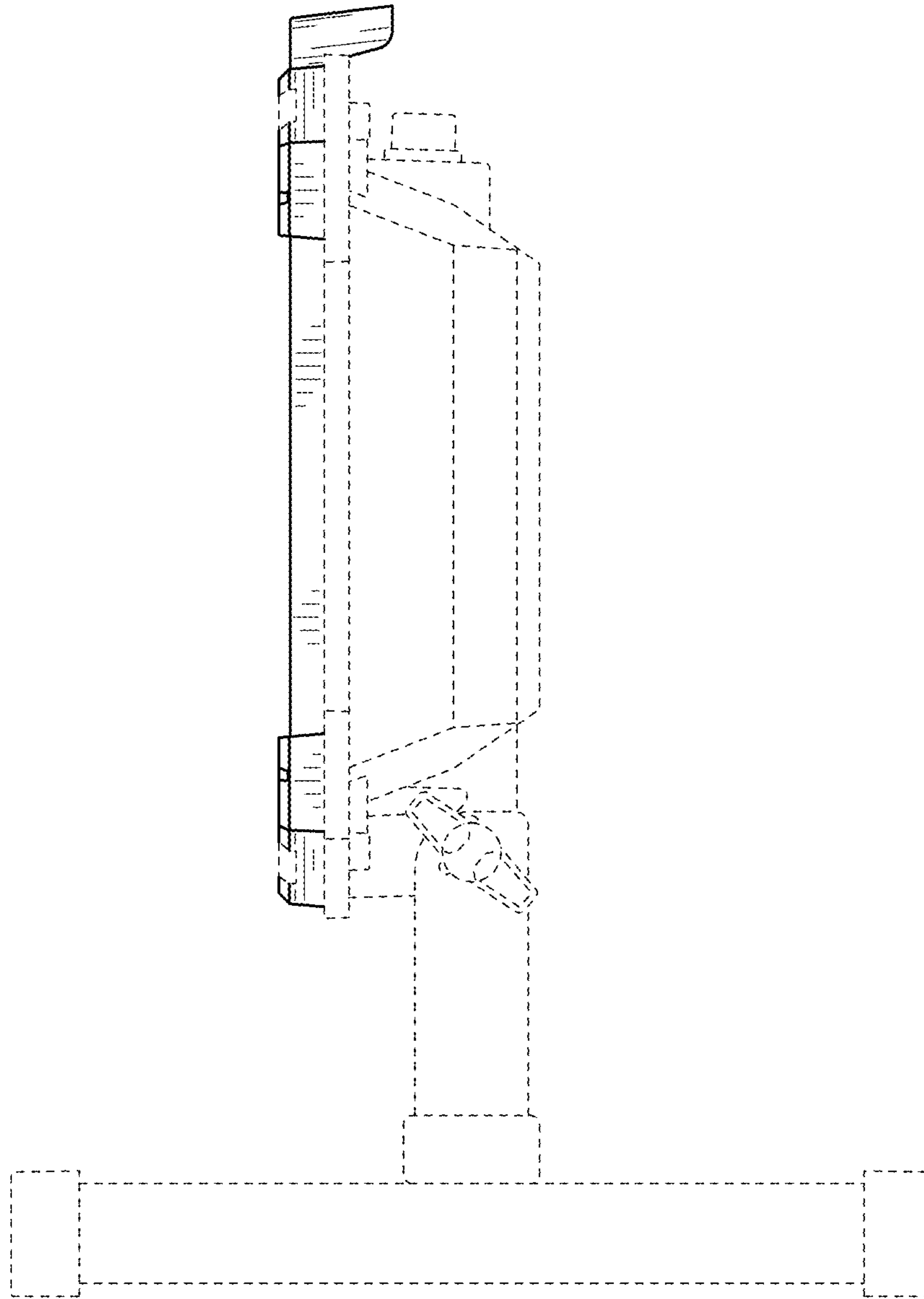

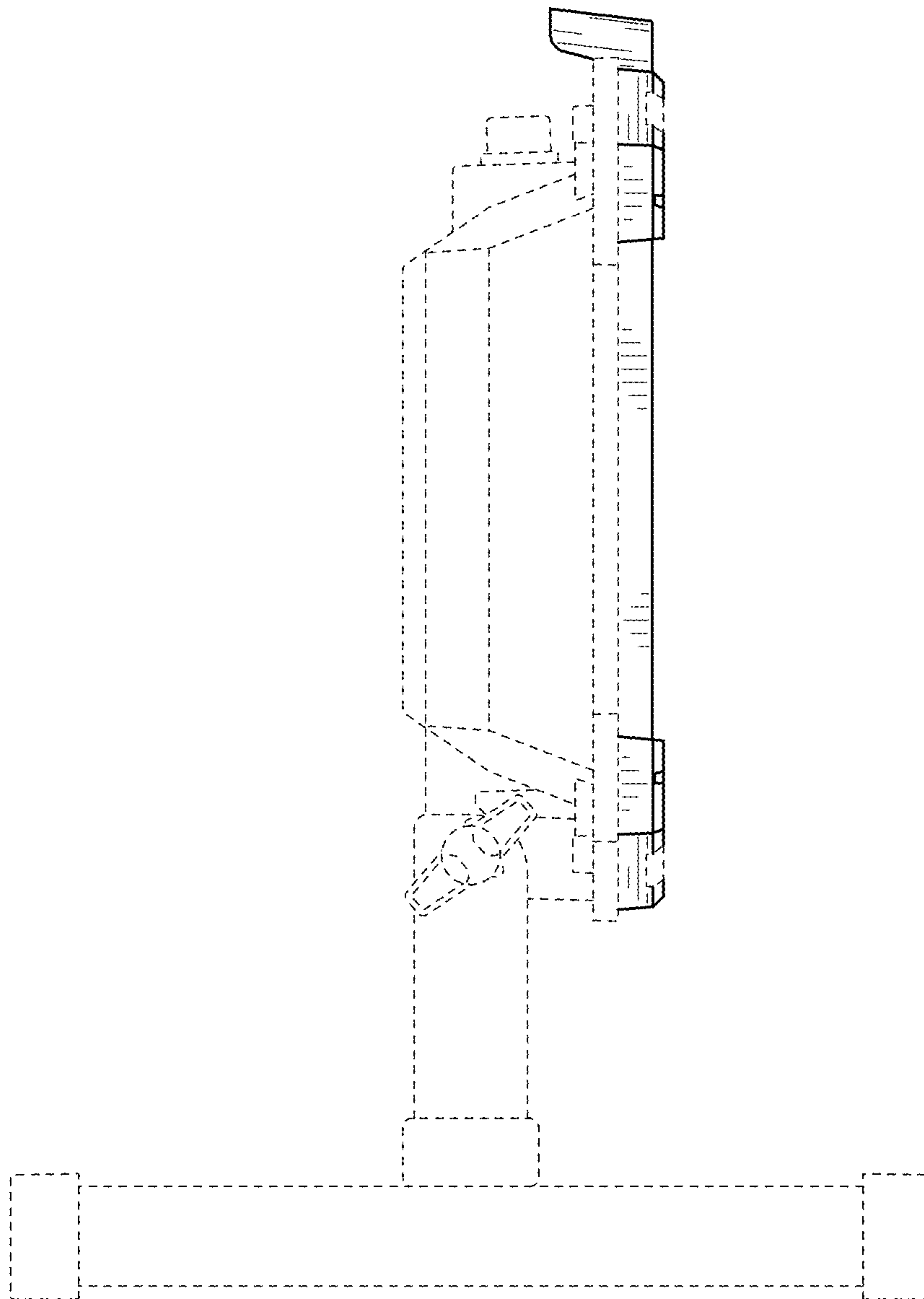

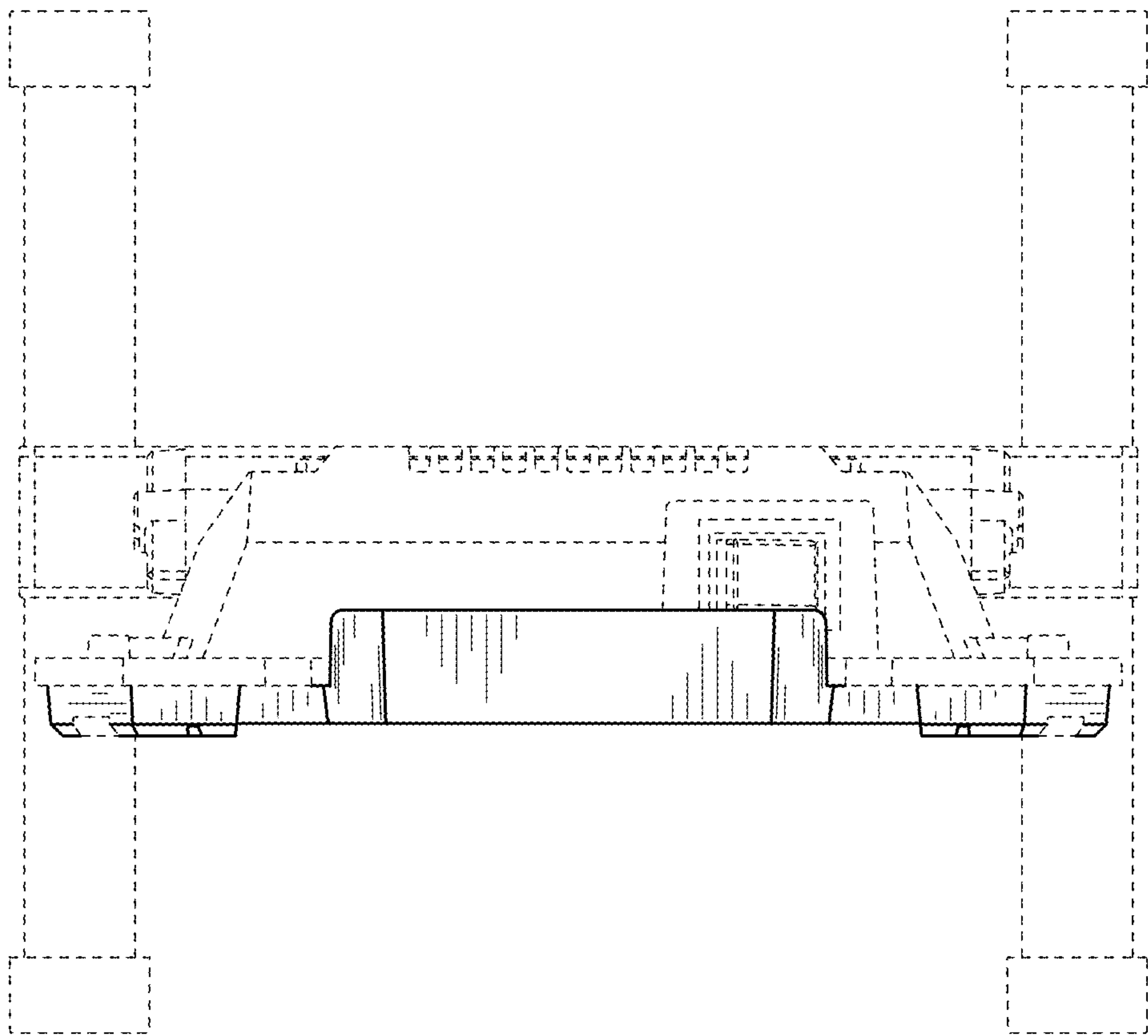

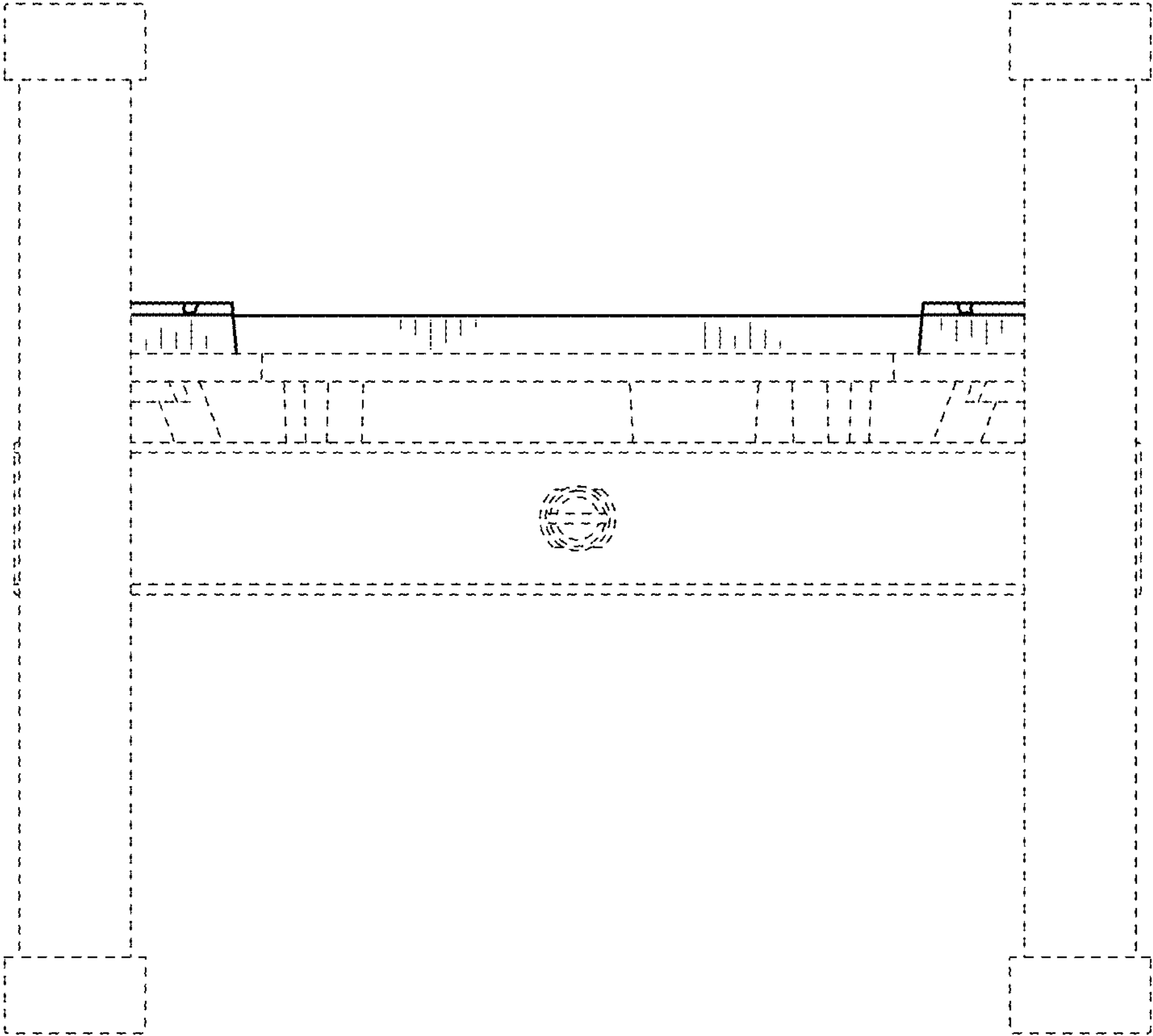

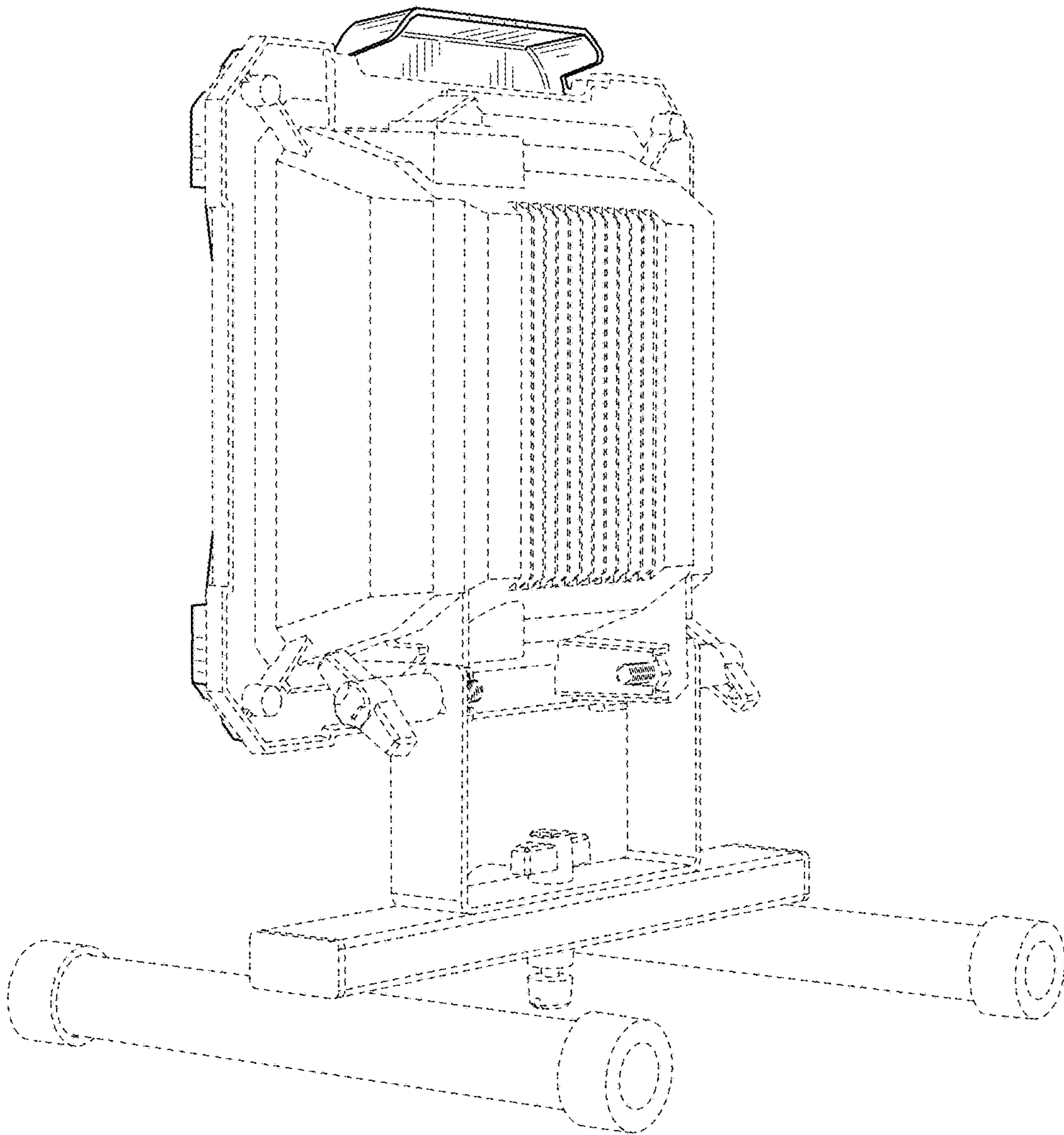

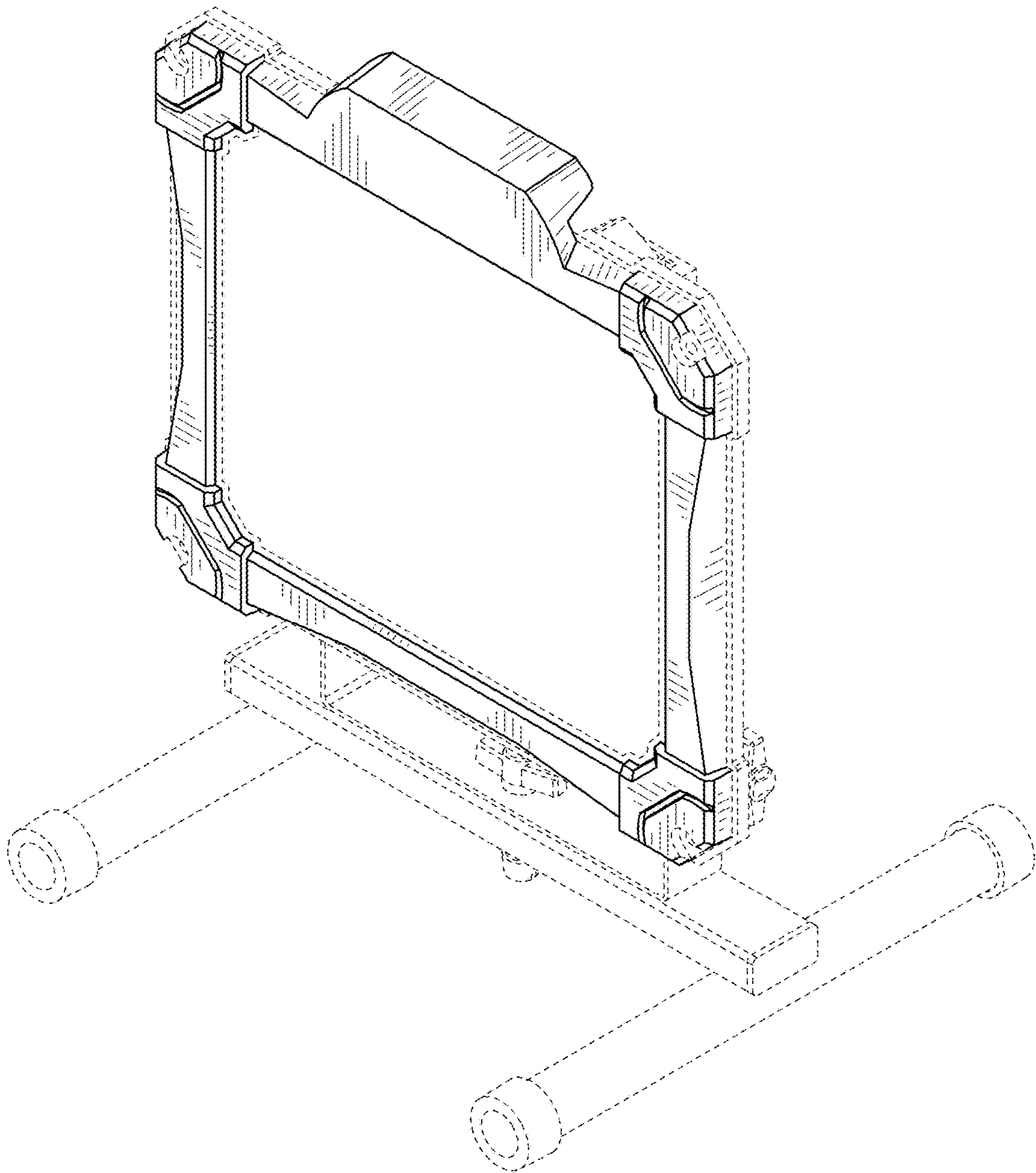

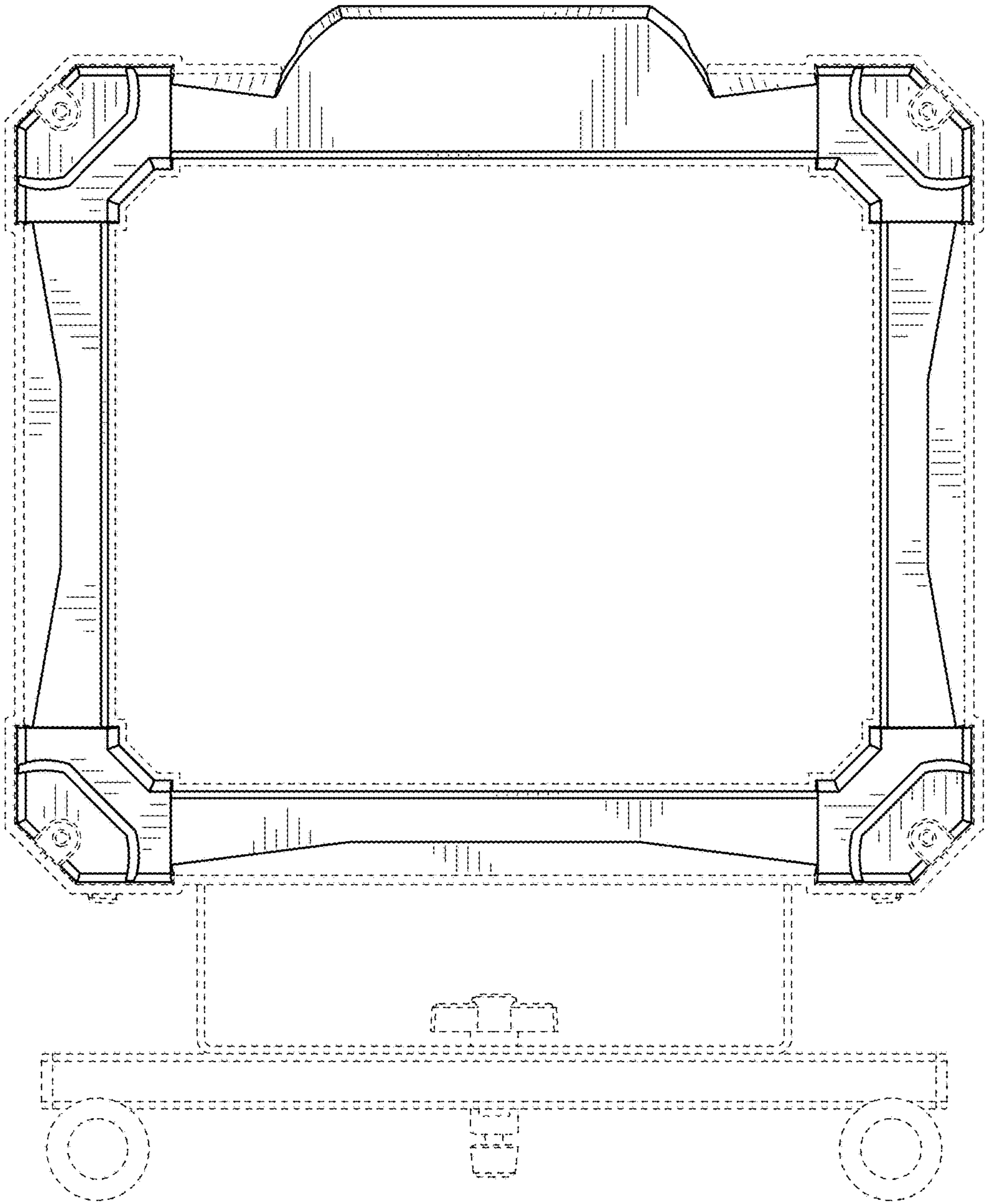

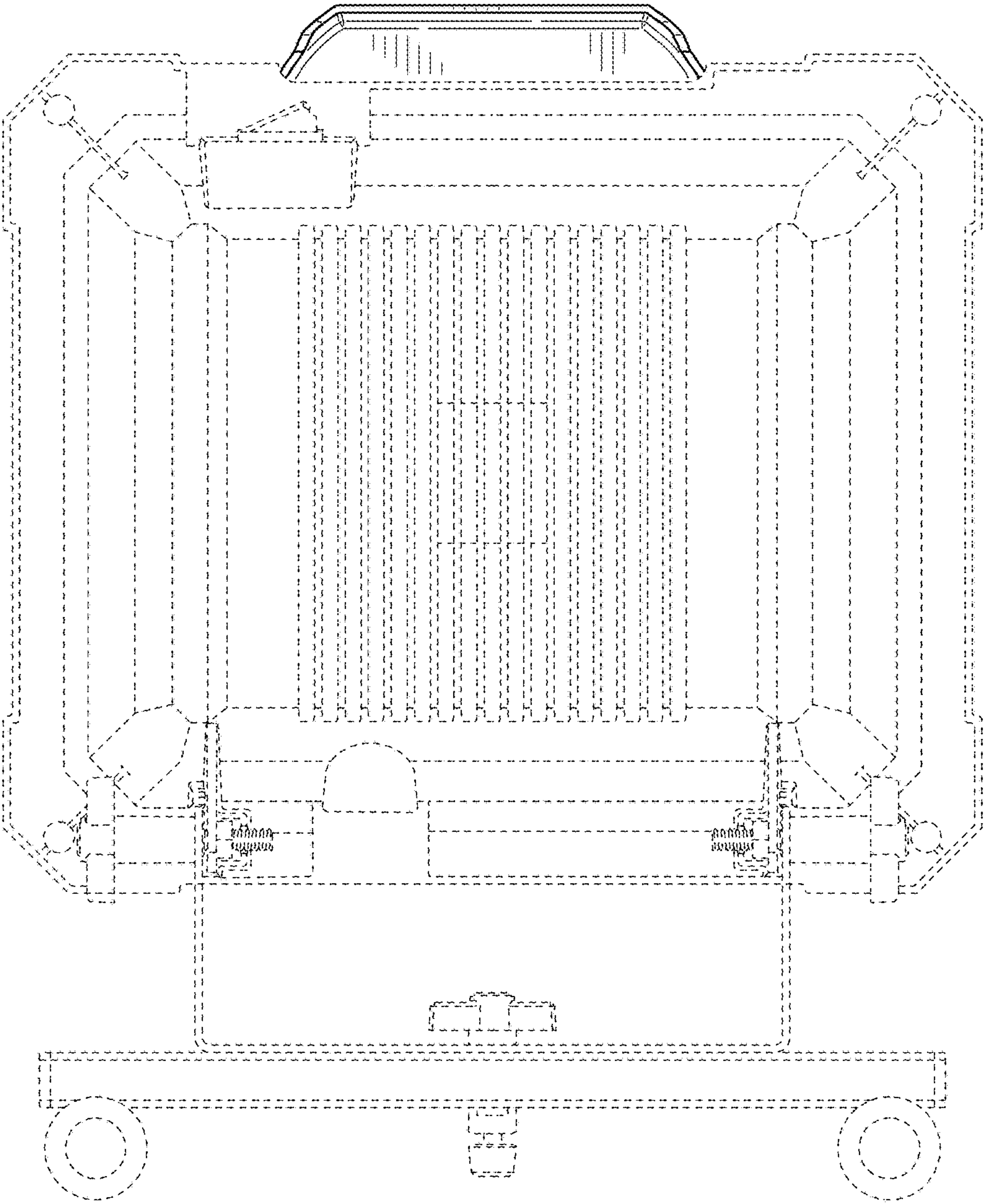

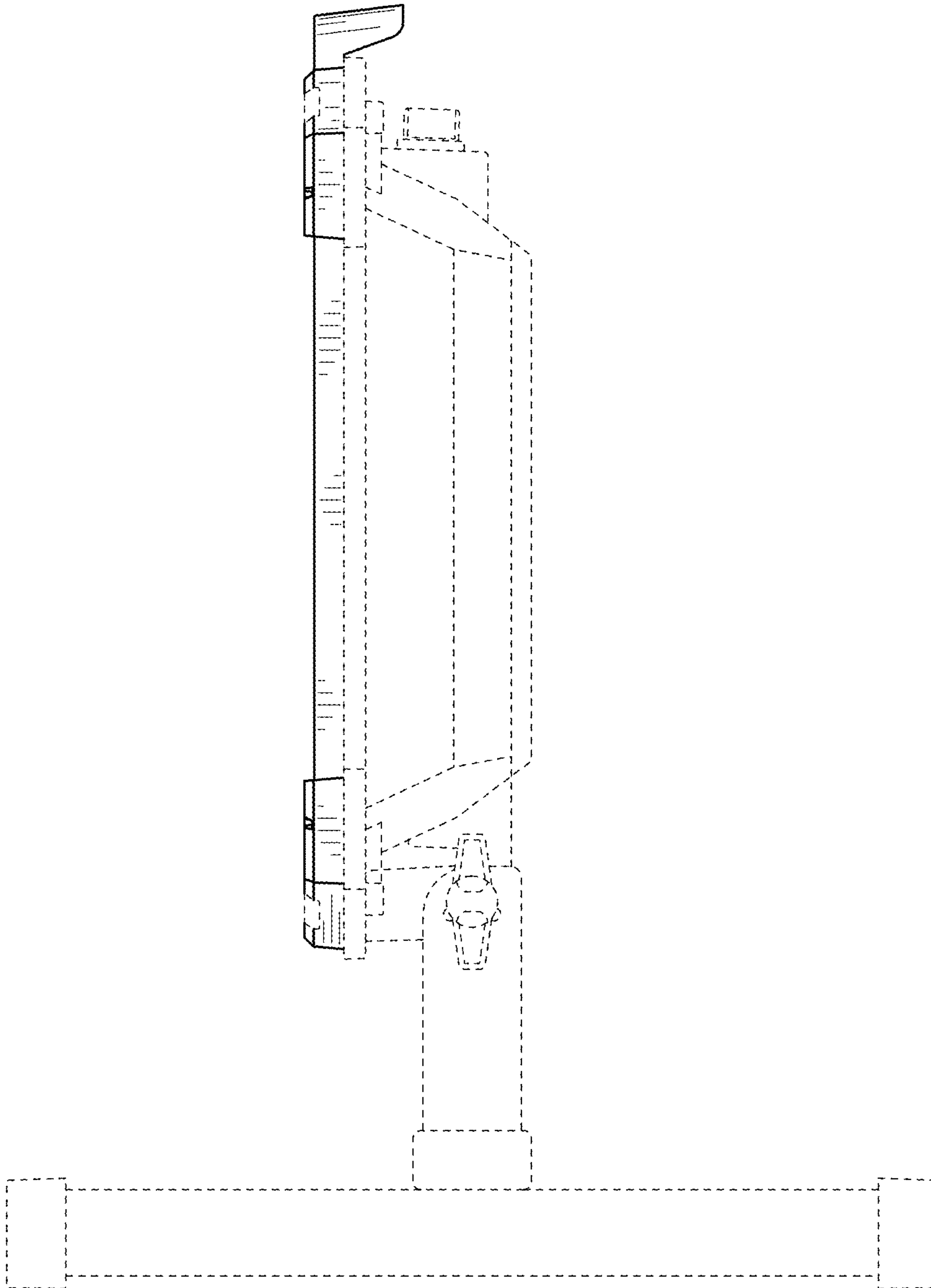

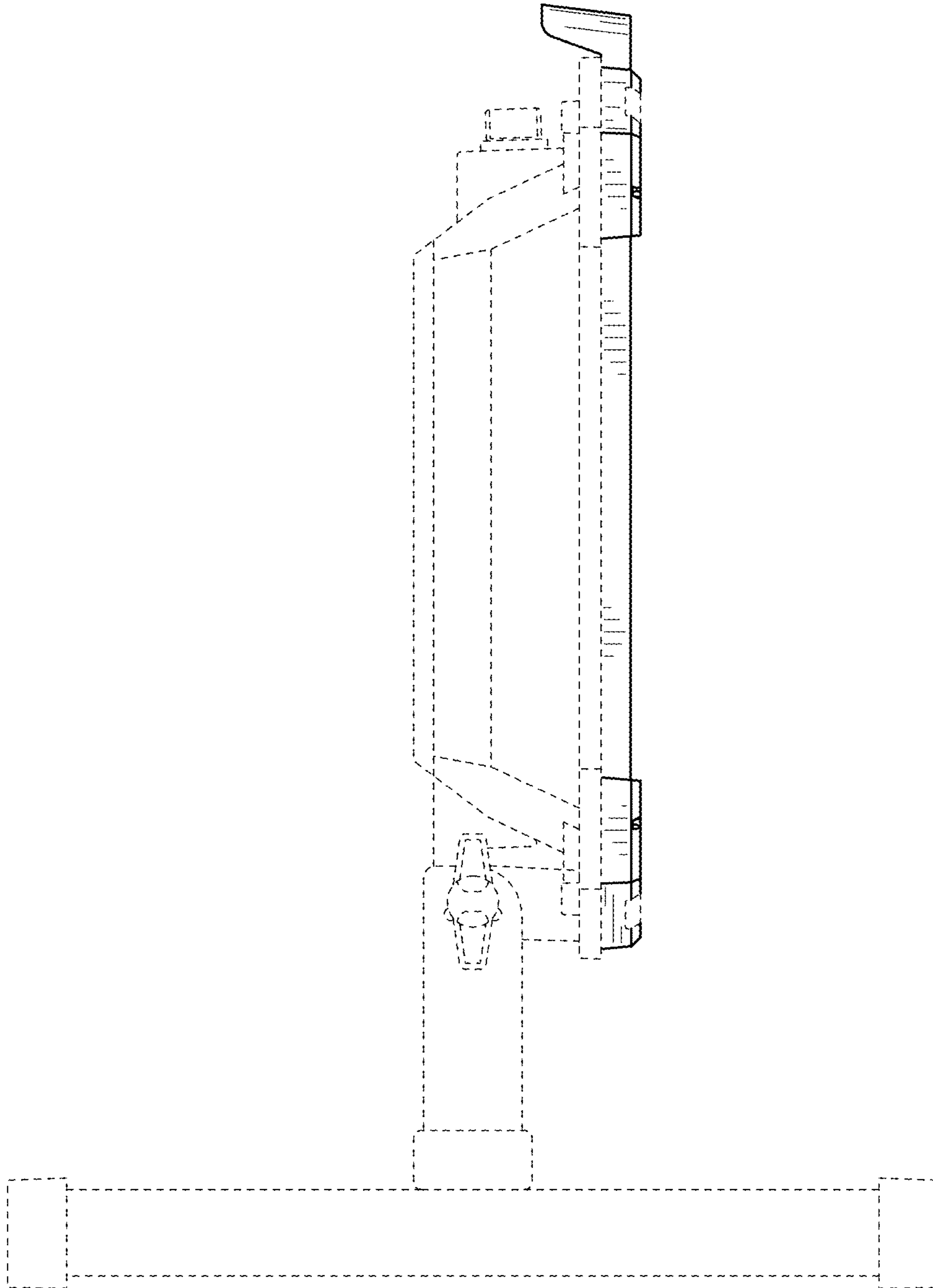

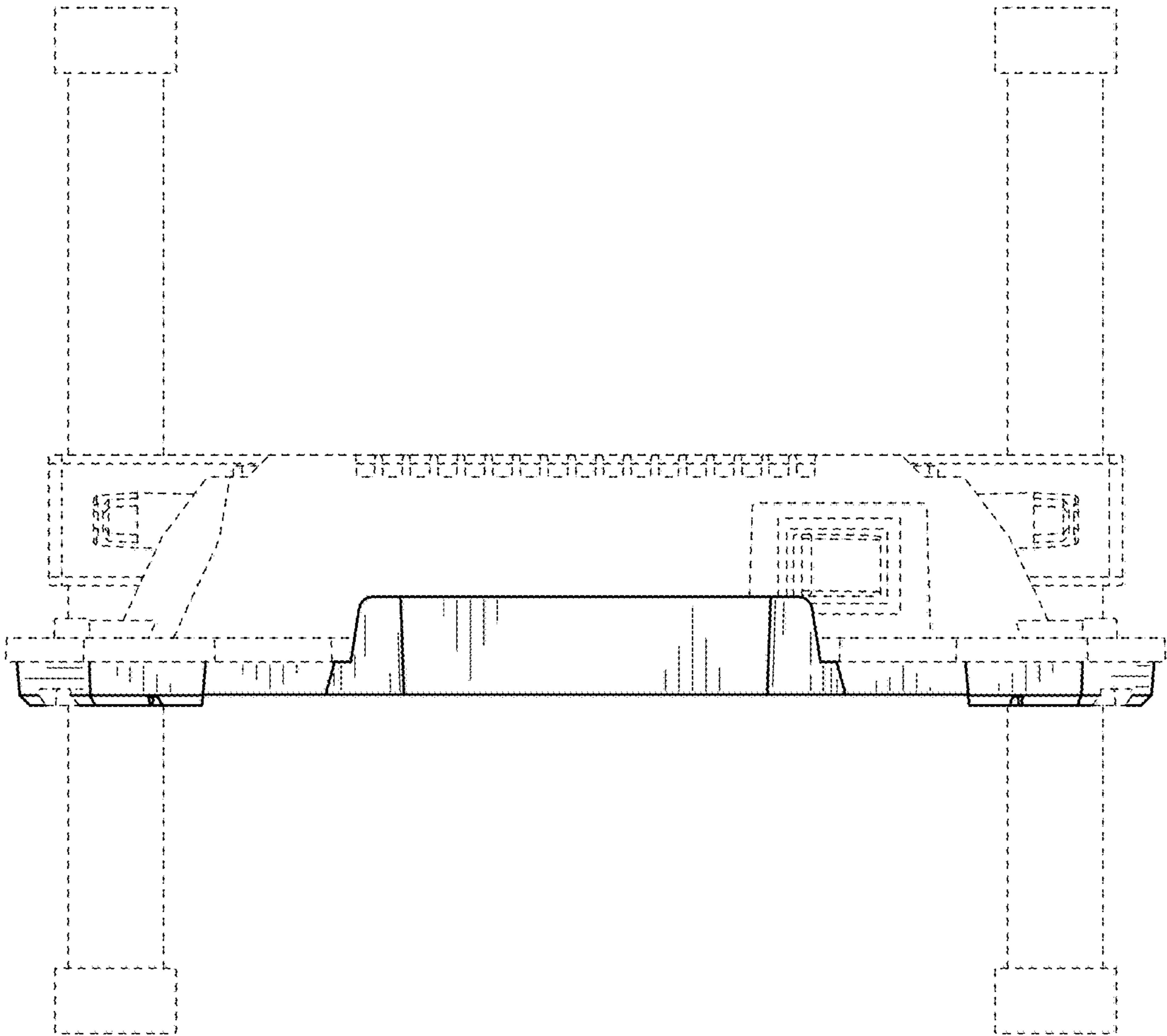

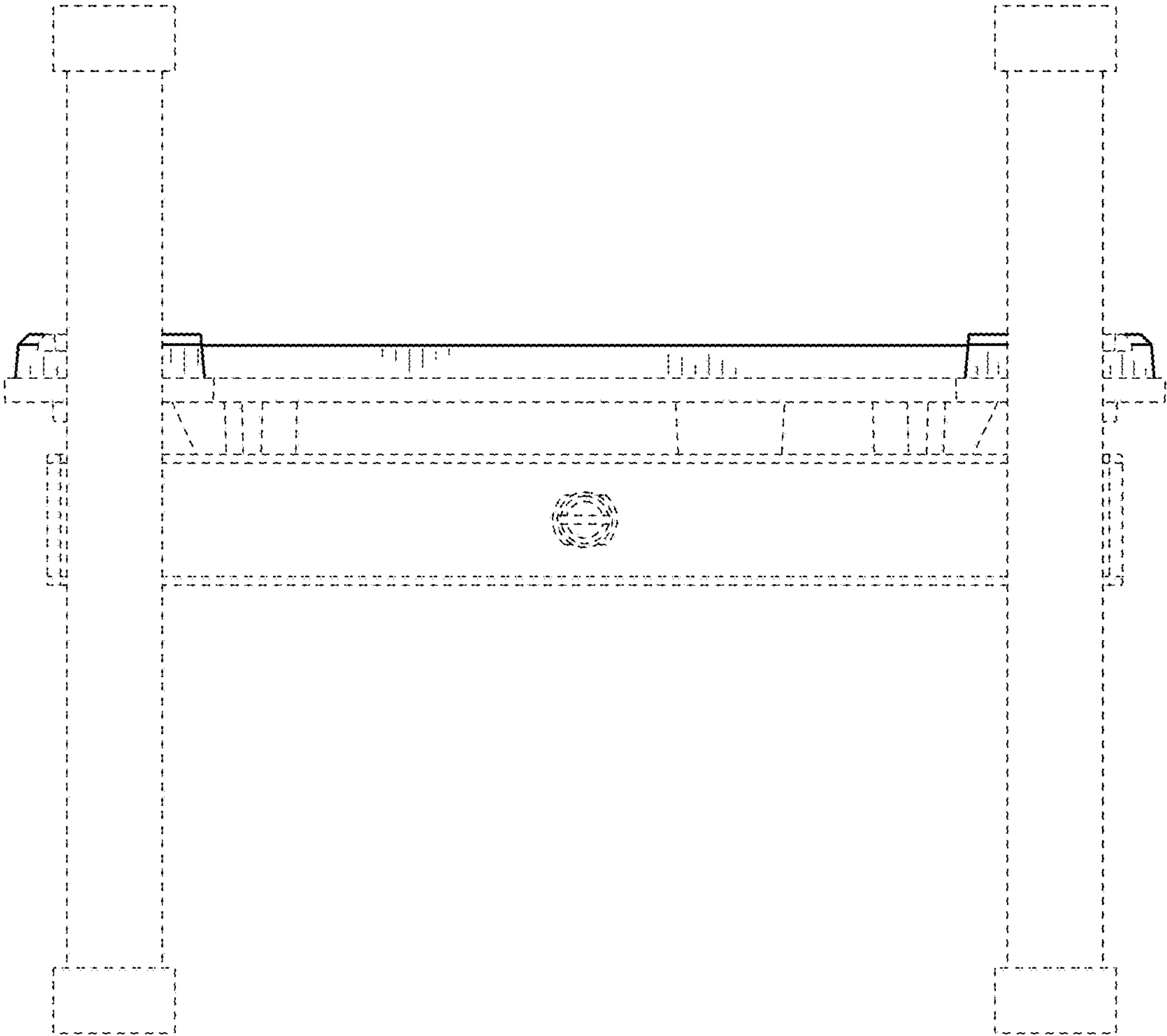

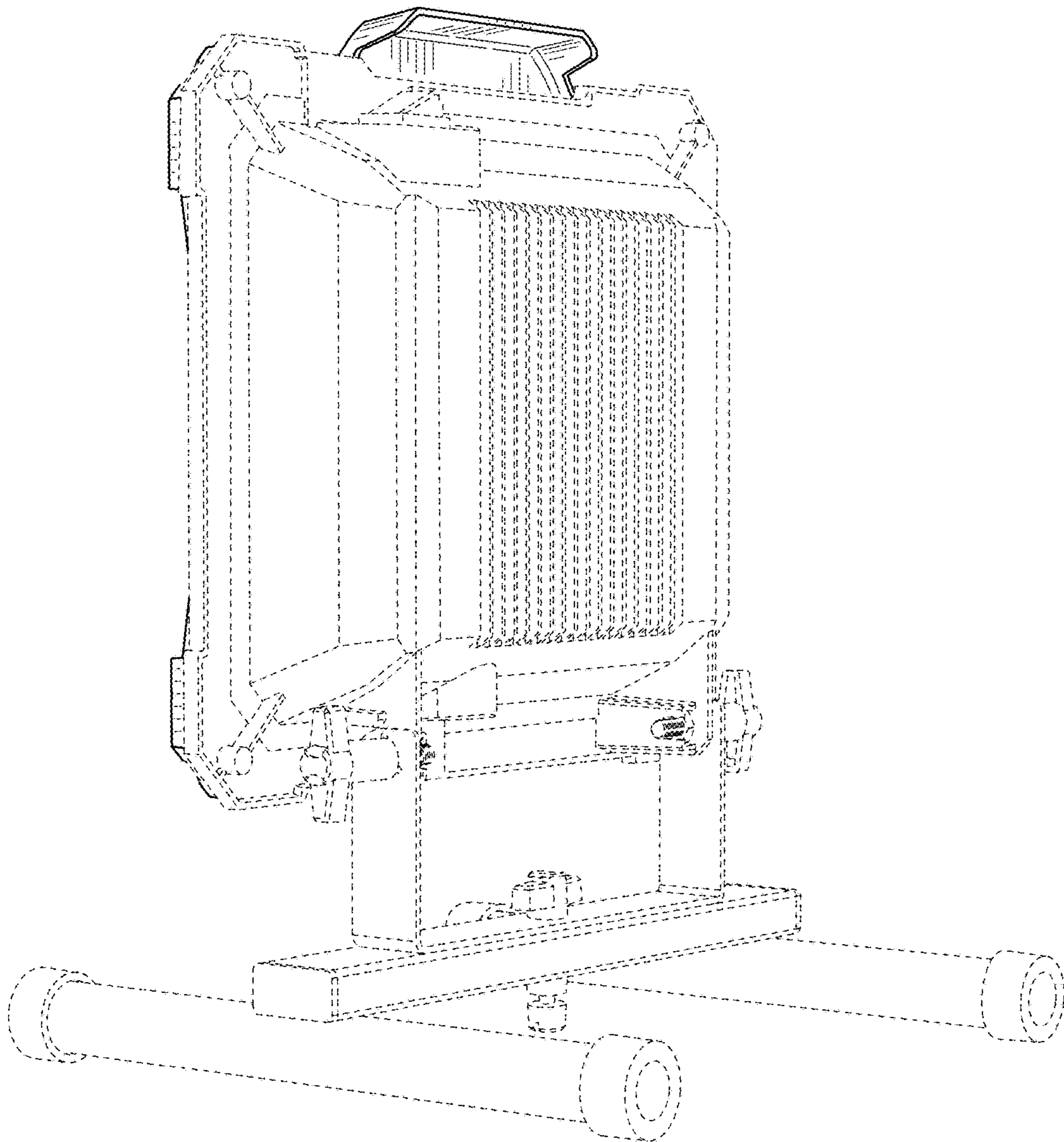
