FIG. 2 is a second side perspective view thereof;

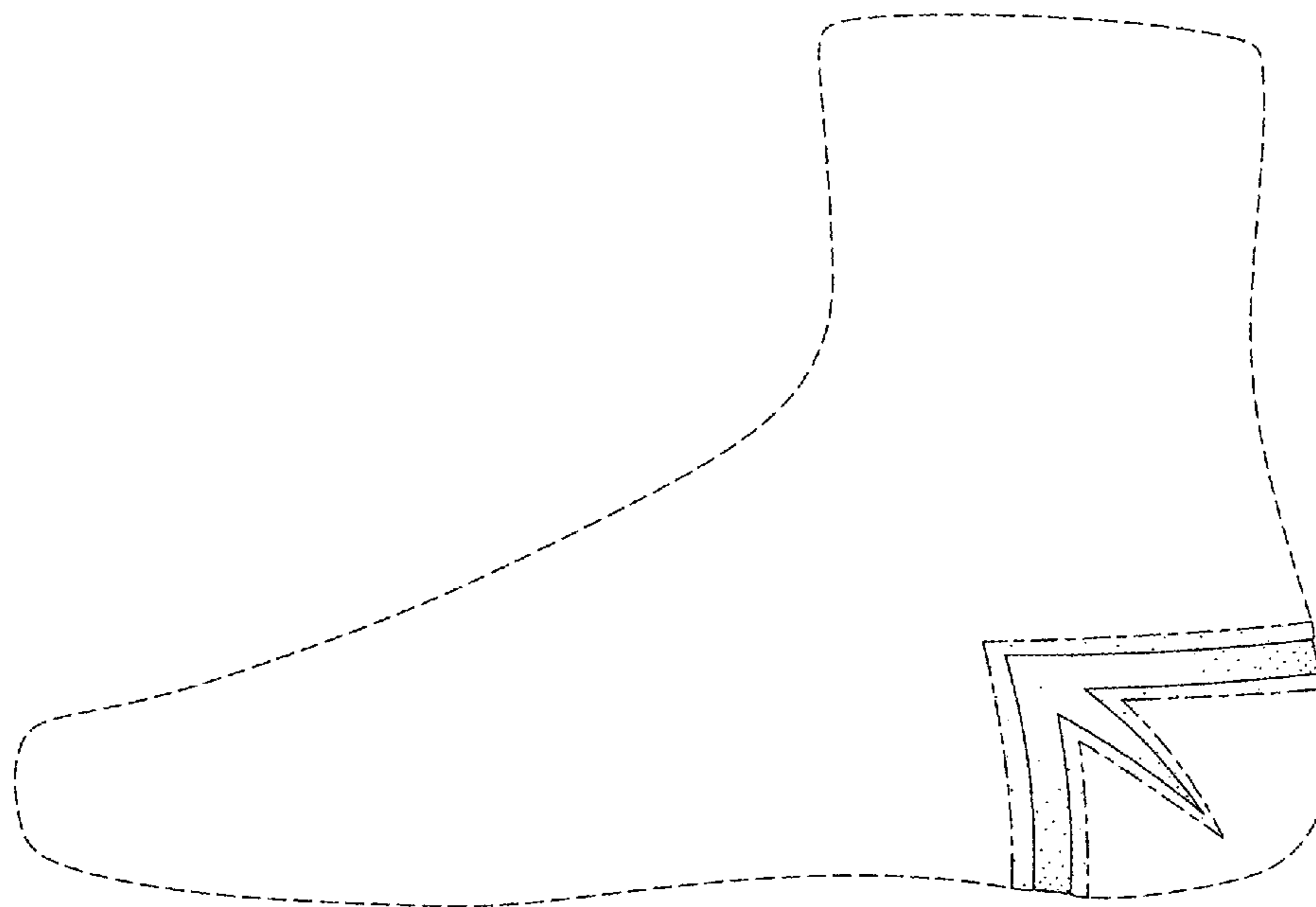
FIG. 3 is a first side view thereof;

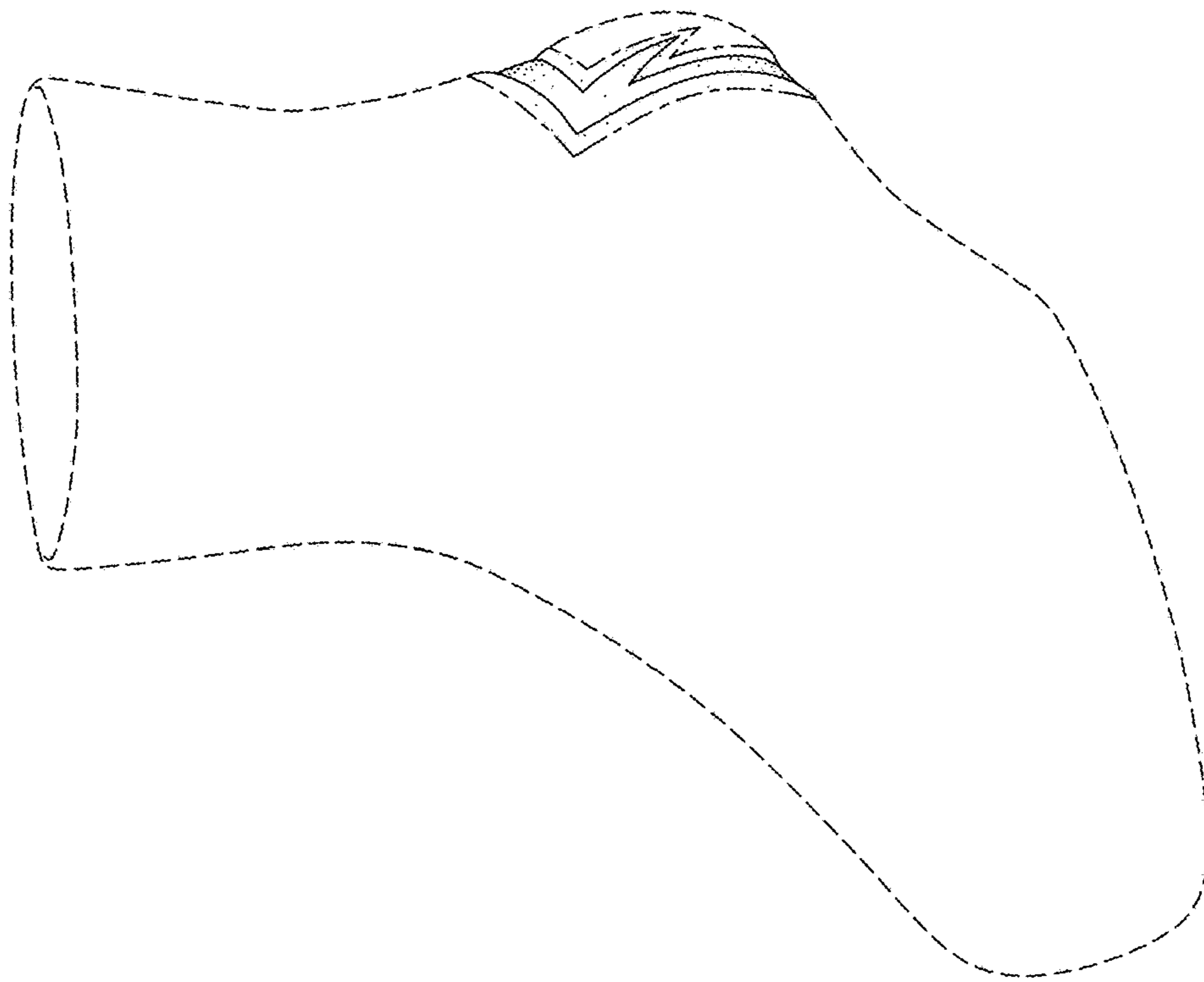

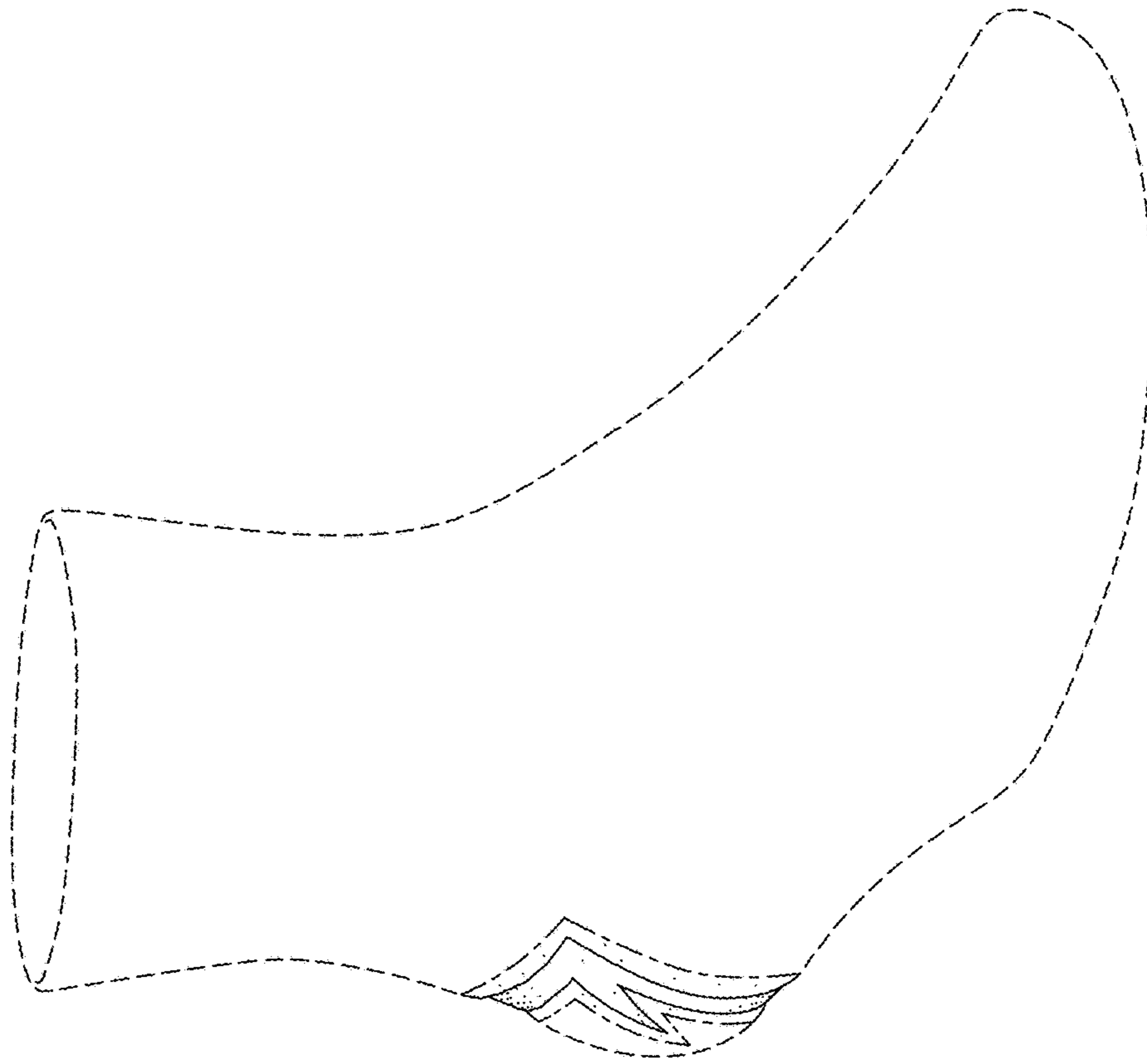

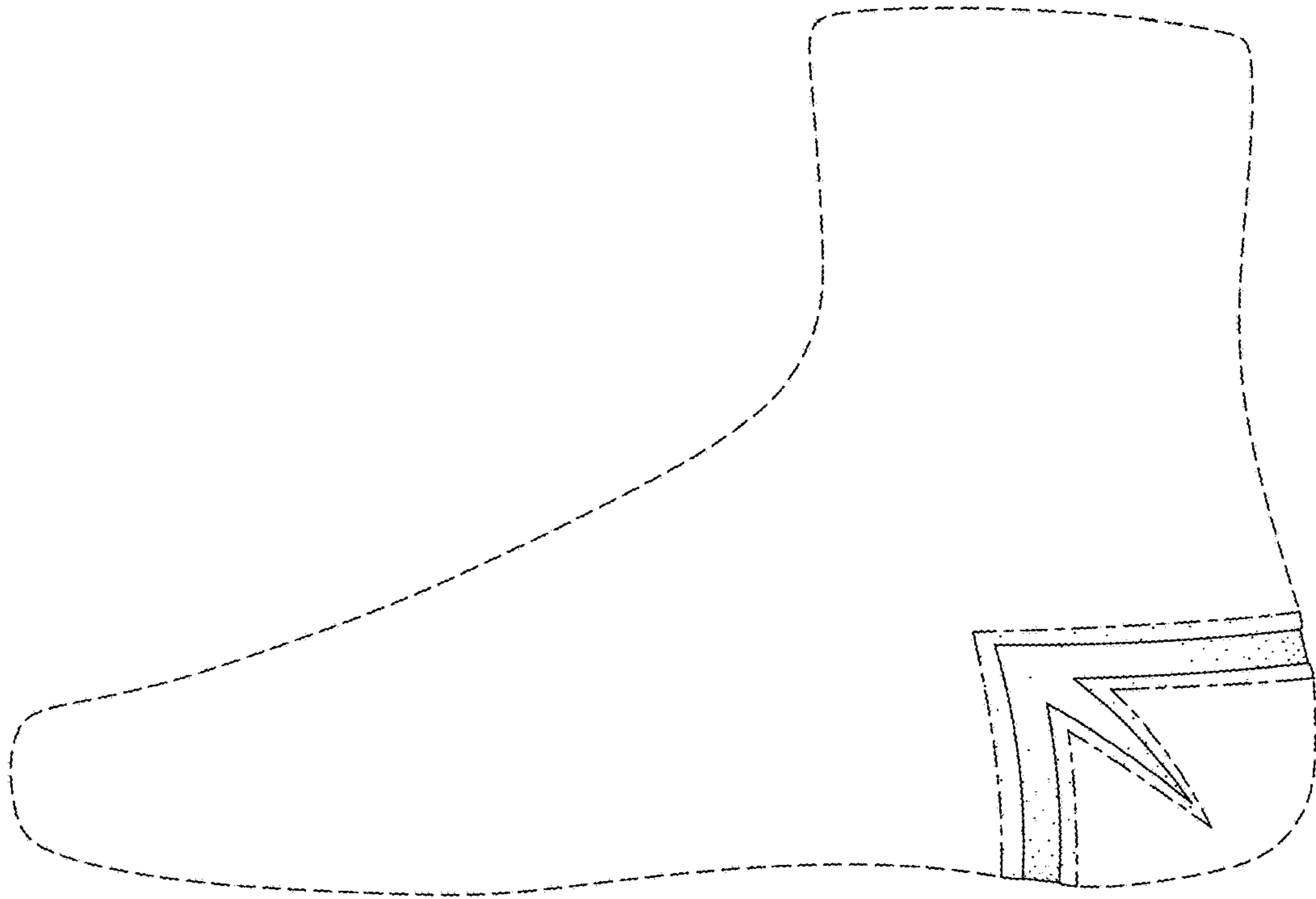

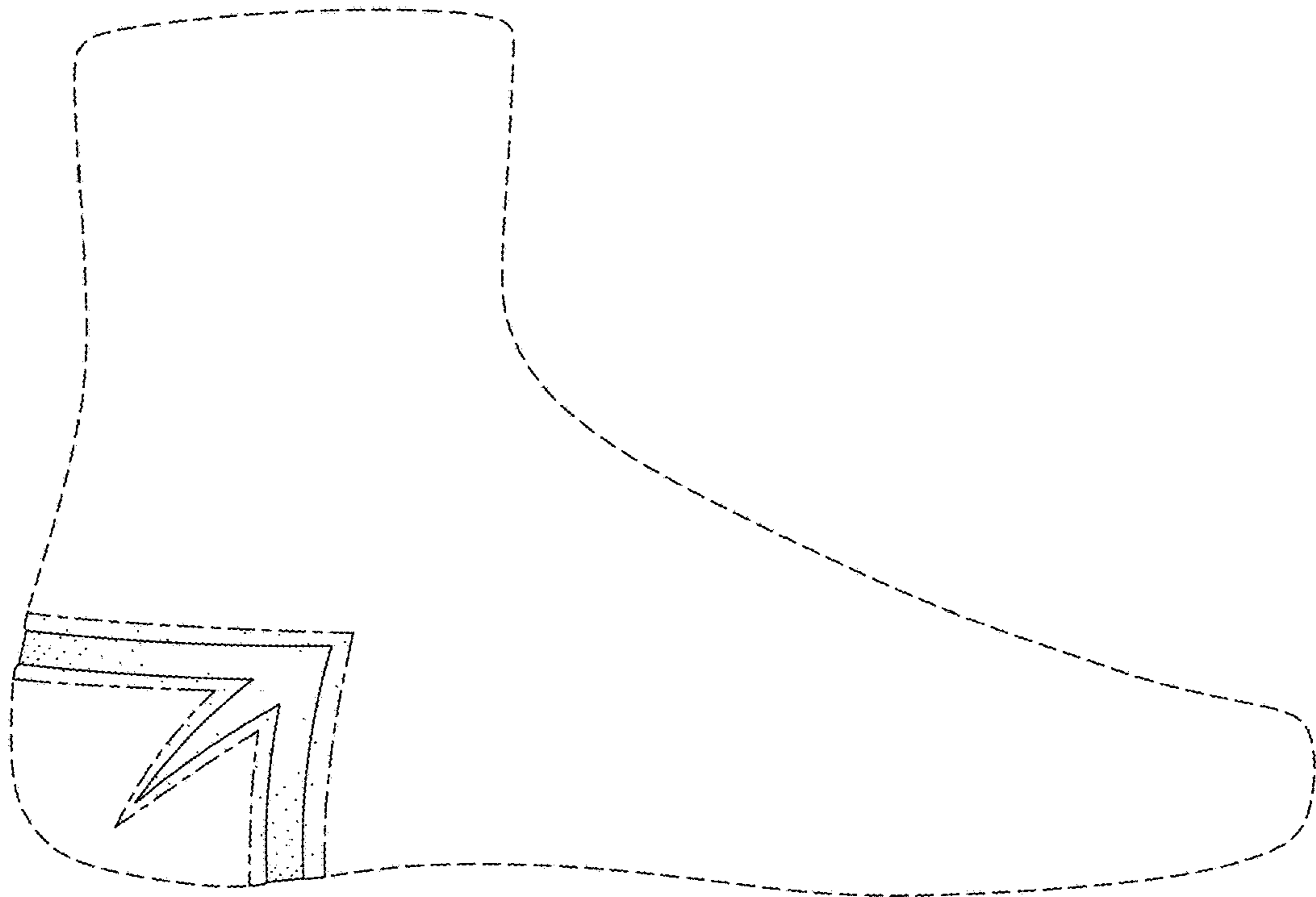

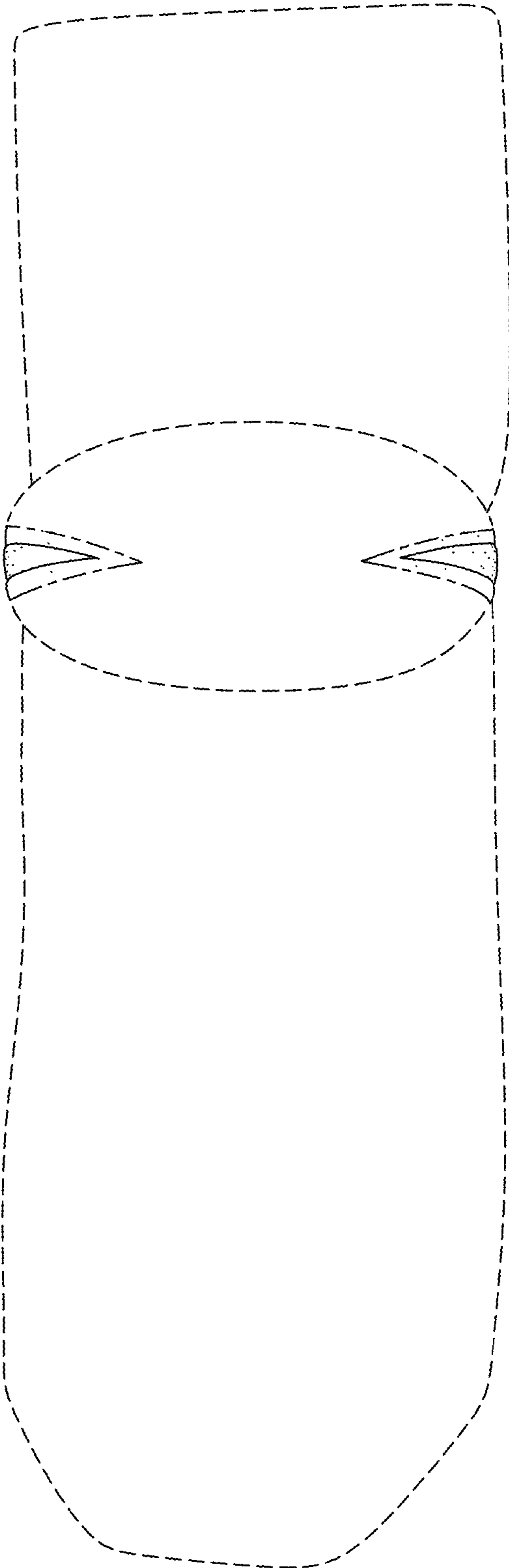
